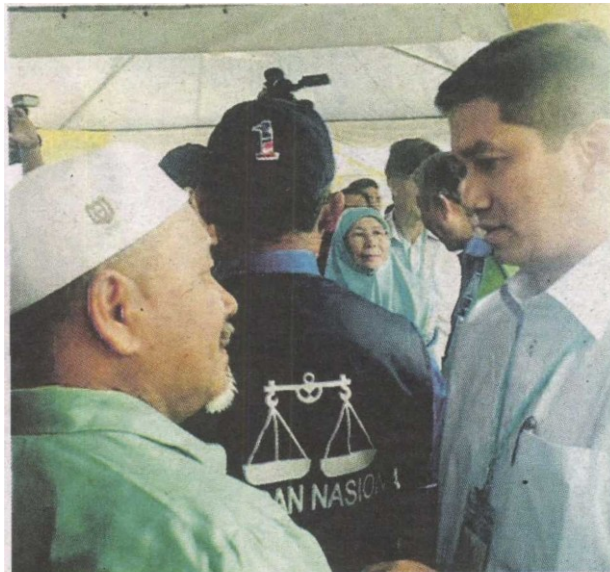
Azmin minta ahli parti berkempen

SUNGAI BESAR - Proses penamaan calon bagi PRK Parlimen Sungai Besar menyaksikan pertandingan tiga penjuru antara BN, Pas dan Parti Amanah Negara (Amanah).

Pengumuman itu diumumkan Pengurus PRK Sungai Besar, Khairuddin Md Som di pentas pekarangan Dewan Seri Bernam, di sini, jam 10.30 pagi, semalam.

Tiga calon iaitu Budiman Mohd Zohdi dari BN, Dr Abdul Rani Osman (Pas) dan Azhar Ab Shukor (Amanah) yang mewakili Pakatan Harapan menyerahkan borang pencalonan masing-masing.

Sebelum itu, Adun Sungai Panjang, Budiman, 44, diiringi Timbalan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi; Pengerusi Umno Selangor, Datuk Seri Noh Omar berarak dari Umno Cawangan Sungai Besar, kira-kira 1 kilometer dari pusat penamaan calon pada jam 8.30 pagi.

Kira-kira 3,000 pemimpin dan penyokong BN berarak ke pusat penamaan calon.

Manakala Pas yang menamakan Adun Meru, Abdul Rani, 58, sebagai calon parti itu diiringi Timbalan Presiden

Pas, Datuk Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man.

Turut mengiringi, Ketua Dewan Ulama Pas Pusat, Datuk Dr Mahfodz Mahmud; Naib Presiden Pas, Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad; Ketua Lajnah Penerangan Pas Pusat, Nasrudin Hassan bersama penyokong parti itu.

Sementara Amanah yang bertanding atas tiket Pakatan Harapan mempertaruhkan Azhar, 51, yang diiringi Presiden Amanah, Mohamad Sabu.

Beberapa pemimpin Pakatan Harapan turut hadir antaranya Penasihat DAP, Lim Kit Siang; Presiden PKR, Datuk Seri Wan Azizah Wan Ismail dan

Timbalan Presiden PKR, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali.

Suruhanjaya Pilihan Raya (SPR) menetapkan PRK Sungai Besar diadakan serentak dengan PRK Kuala Kangsar pada 18 Jun ini, manakala pengundian awal pada 14 Jun.

Pada PRU13, Allahyarham Tan Sri Noriah Kasnon mendapat 18,695 undi dengan majoriti 399 undi mengalahkan calon Pas, Mohamed Salleh M Hussin (18,296 undi).

Sungai Besar mempunyai 42,836 pengundi berdaftar dengan 67.18 peratus pengundi Melayu, Cina (30.68 peratus), India (1.91 peratus) dan kaum lain (0.23 peratus).

Mahu bela nasib penduduk

SUNGAI BESAR – Calon Pas, Dr Abdul Rani Osman berhasrat membela kebajikan penduduk Parlimen Sungai Besar jika dipilih pengundi pada pilihan raya kecil (PRK) parlimen itu pada 18 Jun ini.

Dr Abdul Rani berkata, apa jua permasalahan dihadapi rakyat akan dibawanya pada Sidang Parlimen untuk dibahaskan agar mendapat pem-belaan pihak berwajib.

“Kita minta pengundi beri peluang kepada Pas sebab kita nak lebih banyak suara Pas di Parlimen.

“Kalau kita menang, sebenarnya bukan untuk calon.. tetapi mewakili parti Pas untuk bela rakyat di parlimen ini,” katanya selepas penamaan calon di Dewan Seri Bernam, di sini, pagi semalam.

Sementara itu, pada si-

dang medianya di Markaz Pas Simpang Lima, Dr Abdul Rani meluahkan rasa kesal apabila Parti Amanah Negara (Amanah) yang mempunyai hasrat sama dengan Pas bagi menumbangkan BN tetap meletakkan calon di kerusi itu.

“Fokus kita nak jatuhkan BN dan sesiapa saja. Kalau dia (Amanah) betul-betul nak jatuhkan, Amanah tak perlu bertanding di kerusi tradisi Pas.

“Apabila masuk campur di Sungai Besar, itu akan berikan kelebihan kepada Umno dan BN di Sungai Besar,” katanya.

Dalam pada itu, Dr Abdul Rani yang juga Adun Meru berkata, tahaluf siyasi antara parti itu dan PKR dalam pentadbiran Selangor masih wujud dan beliau sendiri masih berkawan dengan pemimpin PKR.

“Tidak timbul masalah kerana apa yang berlaku di Selangor ini berbeza dengan negeri lain. Kita masih meneruskan Pakatan Rakyat (PR),” katanya.

Pada sidang media sama, Pesuruhjaya Pas Selangor, Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad berkata, pertandingan tiga pen-juru itu membuktikan politik negara ini matang.

“Saya lihat ini bukan satu masalah..ini adalah ujian kematangan politik di Malaysia.

“Sudah berlaku di negara lain seperti di United Kingdom yang membentuk kerajaan campuran dua parti pada 2005 hingga 2010.

“Jadi tidak ada masalah kalau kita benar-benar matang dan kalau kerajaan terus berjalan walaupun bertembung pada PRK,” katanya.

Lif rosak dibaik pulih

SUBANG JAYA – Masalah kerosakan lif di Pangsapuri Sri Tanjung USJ 16, di sini sejak beberapa tahun lalu akhirnya menemui jalan penyelesaian apabila ia dibaik pulih menggunakan peruntukan di bawah Skim Ceria kerajaan negeri.

Pengerusi Perbadanan Pengurusan (MC) pangsapuri itu, Mohd Nizam Abdullah berkata, kerosakan kemudahan lif di empat blok rumah pangsa itu semakin ketara sejak tiga tahun lalu.

Menurutnya, setiap kali rosak, ia menimbulkan kesukaran kepada kira-kira 4,000 penduduk terutama golongan warga emas, ibu mengandung dan kanak-kanak.

"Masalah berkenaan kemudiam diutarakan kepada wakil rakyat dan permohonan peruntukan daripada Program Skim Ceria kerajaan negeri dipohon pihaknya.

"Lif berkenaan sering rosak mungkin kerana sudah beroperasi tanpa henti sejak 16 tahun lalu selain perbuatan vandalisme.

"Kami bersyukur permohonan Skim Ceria diluluskan dan kerja pembaikan dilakukan sejak Oktober tahun lepas," katanya.

Mohd Nizam mengucapkan terima kasih kepada kerajaan negeri dan Adun Kinrara, Ng Sze Han yang menghulurkan bantuan hingga kerja baik pulih dapat dilaksanakan.

"Saya ingin mengingatkan penduduk supaya sama-sama jaga harta yang baru dibaik pulih... jika tak, mungkin perlukan belanja kos lebih besar jika ia rosak lagi," katanya.

Sementara itu, Sze Han berkata, pihak MC menanggung 20 peratus daripada kos baik pulih berjumlah

RM1.13 juta manakala baki selebihnya ditanggung kerajaan negeri.

"Dasar tanggung kos bersama dilaksanakan kerajaan negeri ini adalah langkah tepat supaya penduduk turut jaga dan hormati harta bersama.

"Pengurusan pangsapuri kos rendah dan pangsapuri kos sederhana lain yang ingin memohon peruntukan menerusi skim ceria boleh berurusan dengan Lembaga Perumahan dan Hartanah Selangor (LPHS)," katanya.

Seperti dijangkakan, Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK) Parlimen Sungai Besar menyaksikan pertembungan tiga penjuru antara Barisan Nasional (BN), PAS dan Parti Amanah Negara (PAN).

Lebih menarik pertembungan itu membabitkan dua Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Selangor manakala calon PAN muka baru.

Calon BN Budiman Mohd

Zohdi yang juga ADUN Sungai Panjang dicabar wakil PAS dan ADUN Meru Dr Abdul Rani Osman.

Manakala calon PAN Azhar Abdul Shukur mencuba nasib kali pertama mewakili parti serpihan PAS itu.

Sebelum itu, Budiman diiringi Timbalan Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi dan Pengerusi BN Selangor Tan Sri Noh Omar bersama penyokong parti berarak ke pusat penamaan calon dari Data-ran Tonggak 10, di sini.

Penyokong ketiga-tiga parti dipisahkan dengan kawalan ketat anggota Polis Diraja Malaysia.

50,601 kes denggi sejak Januari

➔ Selangor terus jadi penyumbang tertinggi jangkitan

Sejumlah 50,601 kes denggi direkodkan di seluruh negara sejak Januari hingga kelmarin.

Berdasarkan data dikeluarkan Bilik Gerakan Denggi Kebangsaan, Pusat Kesediaan Krisis dan Tindak Balas (CPRC) Kementerian Kesihatan, bagi tempoh itu, Selangor terus menjadi penyumbang kes denggi tinggi iaitu 27,165 kes.

Ia diikuti Johor dengan 6,857 kes, Kuala Lumpur (3,480), Perak (1,945), Pulau Pinang (1,765), Terengganu (1,519), Negeri Sembilan (1,359), Sabah (1,296) dan Pahang (1,231).

Selain itu, jumlah kumulatif kematian akibat denggi dari Januari sehingga 21 Mei lalu adalah sebanyak

109 kematian berbanding 136 kematian bagi tempoh sama tahun 2015, iaitu pengurangan sebanyak 19.9 peratus atau 27 kematian.

Cuaca tak menentu

Sebelum ini, Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Datuk Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah, berkata musim hujan yang diselang-seli dengan keadaan cuaca panas akan meningkatkan lagi risiko penularan demam denggi akibat pengumpulan air pada bekas yang sesuai untuk

pembiakan nyamuk aedes.

Justeru, beliau menyeru orang ramai supaya memastikan kediaman serta kawasan persekitaran masing-masing bebas daripada tempat pembiakan nyamuk aedes dengan meluangkan hanya 10 minit setiap minggu, untuk aktiviti cari dan musnah.

Selain itu, katanya bahan pembunuh jentik-jentik hendaklah digunakan terutama bagi bekas yang menampung air.

Kementerian Kesihatan juga menasihatkan orang ramai supaya mendapatkan rawatan segera di klinik atau hospital sekiranya mempunyai gejala dan tanda demam denggi untuk mencegah komplikasi akibat penyakit berkenaan.

Pertembungan PAS, PAN curi tumpuan

Pagi cuti hujung minggu di pekan Sungai Besar semalam meriah dengan kehadiran orang politik mewakili pelbagai parti, masing-masing untuk mengiringi calon parti mereka ke pusat penamaan calon.

Kerusi Parlimen P93 kosong selepas kematian penyandang, Tan Sri Noriah Kasnon dalam nahas udara yang turut mengorbankan bekas Ahli Parlimen Kuala Kangsar, Datuk Wan Mohammad Khair-il Anuar Wan Ahmad di Sebuyau, Sarawak, pada 5 Mei lalu.

Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK) Sungai Besar dan Kuala Kangsar mencipta sejarah tersendiri kerana ia medan pertama menyaksikan calon PAS dan Parti Amanah Negara (PAN) berentap untuk merampas kerusi milik Barisan Nasional (BN).

Kubu kuat BN

Kerusi Parlimen Sungai Besar dimenangi BN sejak persempadanan semula pada 2003 dan boleh dikatakan antara kubu kuat parti itu di Selangor, walaupun pada Pilihan Raya Umum Ke-13 (PRU13) Noriah hanya menang dengan majoriti 399 undi.

Bukan sekadar pertembungan musuh, kehadiran PAN yang mewakili Pakatan Harapan (PH) juga dilihat sebagai mahu menyaingi PAS yang 'diceraikan' mereka tahun lalu.

Berdasarkan itu, tidak silap jika semua menjangkakan kempen PAN yang direstui DAP dan tentunya PKR, lebih hebat jika tidak setara gerak kerja jentera BN dan PAS kerana yang sejak awal lagi sudah memasang bendera dan membuka pusat operasi.

Hakikatnya, beberapa hari se-

belum hari penamaan calon, bendera PAN hanya dilihat terselit di sebalik kemeriahan warna biru laut dan hijau pekat parti dacing dan bulan, tidak setara dengan nada parti pilihan pembangkang itu yang bersungguh mahu menumbangkan BN.

Elak bertemu pemberita

Pelbagai isu yang melanda kerajaan Selangor, khususnya Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali, dikaitkan dengan kesu-raman kempen mereka, terutama selepas hampir sebulan seperti

mengelak bertemu dengan pemberita.

Ketiadaannya pada program pengenalan calon PAN, Rabu minggu lalu juga menguatkan spekulasi, wujud puak dalam parti itu walaupun Presidennya, Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, tegas menyatakan itu keputusan kepe-mpimpinan parti yang 'simpati' dengan kedudukan Mohamed Azmin dan hubungannya dengan PAS yang masih berada dalam pentadbiran Selangor.

Sudah tentu apabila kelibat Mohamed Azmin tidak kelihatan berarak pagi semalam, ramai mula tertanya-tanya apakah beliau sudah menjauhkan diri daripada kepimpinan utama Pakatan Harapan.

Kemunculan tepis spekulasi

Namun, Mohamed Azmin muncul juga di Dewan Seri Bernam untuk menepis spekulasi kedudukannya dalam parti dan pentadbiran negeri, selain menjanjikan jentera PKR akan turun berkempen bagi calon PAN dalam usaha parti itu merampas kerusi Sungai Besar dari tangan BN.

PKR kini 'tersepit' dengan perbalahan di antara PAS dan Pakatan Harapan yang dianggotainya dengan DAP dan PAN.

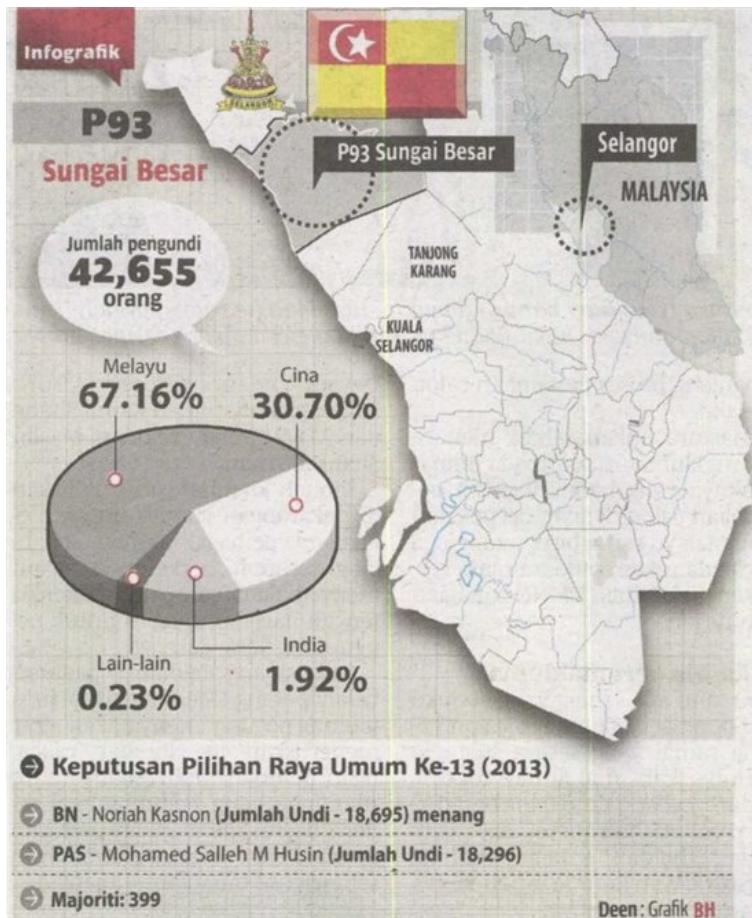

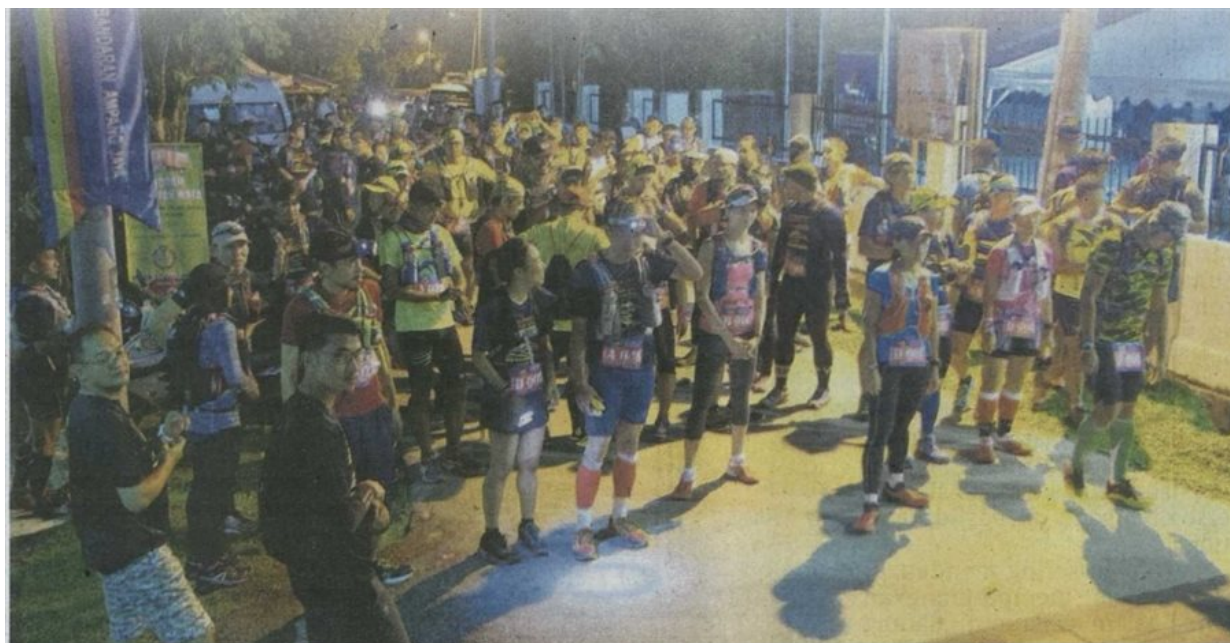

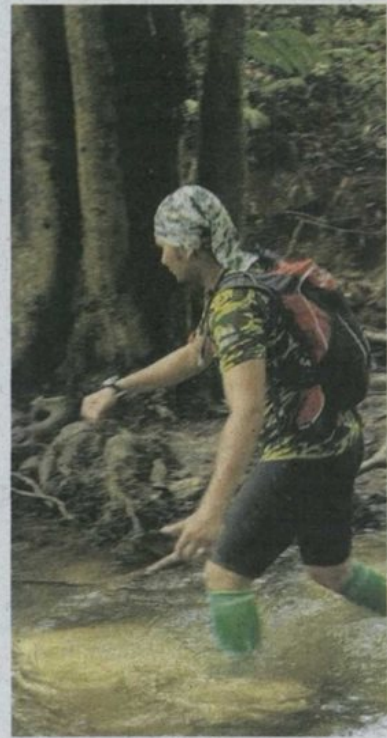

BN in three-cornered fight

By-election starts out friendly despite fierce battle ahead



SUNGAI BESAR: Barisan Nasional will lock horns with PAS and Amanah in a three-cornered tussle for the parliamentary by-election here.

Barisan Nasional candidate Budiman Mohd Zohdi, 44, was the first to submit his nomination papers at 9.03am at Dewan Sri Bernam here, followed by Amanah's Azhar Abdul Shukur, 51, and Dr Abdul Rani Osman, 58, from PAS.

The nomination process went smoothly, with returning officer Mohd Khairuddin Md Som emerging at around 10.30am to announce that things had gone smoothly.

Both Budiman and Dr Abdul Rani are the Sungai Panjang and Meru assemblymen, while Azhar is the son of former Tanjong Karang MP and Sungai Burong assemblyman Datuk Abdul Shukur Siraj of Barisan.

The battle for the seat, as well as that for Kuala Kangsar, is expected to be fiery due to the face-off between PAS and Amanah.

The two by-elections will also be an indication for both PAS and Amanah to see if voters in these two constituencies will choose the Islamist party or its splinter group.

Top party leaders, including Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, MCA president Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai,

Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman, MCA Youth chief Chong Sin Woon, PKR president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail and her deputy Datuk Seri Azmin Ali, turned up to support their candidates.

Earlier, political rivalry seem to have been set aside when party leaders took the rare chance to mingle with each other while waiting for the nomination process to be over.

Dr Ahmad Zahid and several Barisan Nasional leaders sat with

PAS deputy president Datuk Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man and election director Datuk Mustafa Ali, attracting media attention.

Surprising many, Azmin showed up, putting paid to talk that he might not appear due to conflict of interest as his state government still had PAS assemblymen.

He also congratulated Selangor Barisan chief Tan Sri Noh Omar on

the award conferred to him by the King.

Despite reports of recent animosity, DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang struck up a conversation with Mustafa and other PAS leaders.

Dr Ahmad Zahid also appeared cordial when Azhar approached to shake hands with him, even adjusting his party's scarf.

PAS: No risk of split in unity of Selangor government

SUNGAI BESAR: PAS has given assurance that its cooperation with PKR in the Selangor government will not be jeopardised, despite PKR endorsing its rival, Amanah, in the by-election here.

Selangor PAS commissioner Datuk Iskandar Samad said this should not be seen as a problem because such a move has been done in other countries.

Iskandar said that in Britain, Conservatives and Liberal Democrats managed to maintain their unity government for five years despite having clashed in several by-elections.

"There's no problem really and we should be politically mature about this," the Cempaka assemblyman told reporters at the PAS operations centre here yesterday.

PAS is no longer part of the Opposition pact after having fallen out with DAP, while some of its members later left the Islamist party to form Amanah.

Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azmin Ali turned up earlier for the

nomination, despite talk that he might not show up because PAS members were part of his state government.

However, PAS deputy president Datuk Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man said Azmin's presence was in his capacity as the menteri besar, who was the host.

"He told me that he was there as menteri besar and it's normal for him to mingle with everyone," he said.

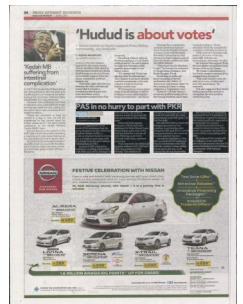
PAS election director Datuk Mustafa Ali said the politicians managed to set aside their differences.

"I've met leaders from Barisan Nasional and Amanah. It is normal for us to do this before the campaign. Nothing extraordinary, really," he said.

However, PAS candidate Dr Abdul Rani Osman said he was upset that Amanah "chose to interfere" in a seat that his party had traditionally contested.

"If we want to deny Barisan a victory, they shouldn't contest," he said.

PAS in no hurry to part with PKR

DESPITE suggestions at last week's PAS muktamar that the party should sever ties with Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), a political observer believes PAS is not in a hurry to part ways with its partner from the now defunct Pakatan Rakyat (PR).

Instead, it will continue to maintain a working relationship with PKR and DAP in Selangor at

least until the 14th general election is held to prevent the state government from falling apart.

Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) associate professor Dr Mohd Faisal Syam Abdol Hazis opined that PAS will find it harder to break off

with PKR than with DAP, *Oriental Daily News* reported yesterday.

"PAS can sever ties with DAP because without PAS, DAP and PKR can continue to rule Penang. The situation in

Selangor is different: once PAS breaks off with PKR, the state government could fall apart," he told the daily.

He said PAS will not leave the Selangor government but continue to govern the state alongside PKR and DAP to avoid being punished by the voters in the next general election.

Among the highlights of the just-concluded PAS muktamar

was its relationship with PKR, with the women's wing calling for an end to the ties, a call rejected by the top leadership.

Nevertheless, the muktamar concluded that it would leave it to the Syura Council to reassess the current political cooperation between the two parties.

Mohd Faisal said before it comes to a final decision, PAS needs to consider the benefits it derives from cooperating with PKR.

He believed PAS would still be willing to work with PKR after the 14th general election if it means forming the next Selangor government with Pakatan Harapan.



Guidelines ignored



It was an era when the Little Napoleons ruled the roost. Their word was the law. Not adhering to their demands and not abiding by their commands meant trouble. They were the “king makers” who could do anything, albeit sometimes illegal, and get away with it.

It was an era where the sports club became a conduit for bribes. In a sort of way, black money was laundered to white. Anyone wanting to erect billboards had to make a “donation”. There was even a tariff – RM10,000 per billboard. There was no need for licences or permission from the owners of the land. Money did wonders and the powers that be watched it all happen because some of them were in cahoots with the operators.

Millions were collected and spent but members of the sports club did not know the numbers. It was operated by a handful of people who received and dispensed the money and were not accountable to anyone.

Billboards sprouted all over the city uncontrolled. In 2007, the council had licensed fewer than 100 billboards, but there were five times that number. Even a rebuke from the state ruler put little fear into them.

Dear readers, the follies of the Petaling Jaya City Council, perpetrated in some cases by councillors, came to an end with the general election of March 2008. Like

new brooms, they came in to sweep the

council of all the muck, dirt and sewage that had accumulated over the previous decades. It was not an easy task – there were blockades placed by interested parties including staff of the council.

But the show had to move on. If previously the unofficial licence fee was sent to the sports club or someone's pocket, no one cared. The new councillors demanded accountability. Instead of plonking a unipole on the road reserve which belongs to the state, now they had to get a temporary occupation licence for the use of the land. The council would apply for it for a fee – which went officially into the government's coffers.

A meeting with all industry players – advertising agencies, advertisers and billboard companies – ended with a set of guidelines which everyone had to adhere to. All parties signed on the dotted line.

For a good five years, the good times lasted. In total, over RM25 million was credited to the council. However, at the end of 2013, many councillors were replaced. Even those with good track records had to make way for party workers who had pasted posters, those who drove winning candidates and the like.

The rot started setting in. With hardly anyone on their backs, the council staff went back to their old bad ways. Guidelines were ignored and it appeared that the “mafia” had taken grip of the planning department.

Billboards were set up everywhere – including at road junctions which were categorically banned under the guidelines. Almost every other rule in the book was thrown out.

Today, Petaling Jaya has re-emerged to live up to its old name – Billboard City. While money is not going to the sports club, it is ending up elsewhere.

In 2008, the council had brought down a billboard along the LDP for infringing the guidelines. Last week, a new billboard was erected on the site.

Derek Fernandez, who had previously pushed for reforms and drew up the guidelines, returned as councillor after a three-year hiatus only to discover the mess that had been created.

In a note to the council president, he said: “Something is seriously wrong. Of late several approvals of new sites to companies have been on places previously rejected by previous billboard committees as they clearly breached the guidelines.”

The guidelines, he added, cannot be changed by MBPJ without the consent of the state as they apply to the whole of Selangor.

He also noted that new sites were not being given for those waiting in line for replacement sites, but to companies that don't qualify for replacement sites.

Many residents including this writer, organisations and residents' groups campaigned ardently to bring about some semblance of law and order when it came to billboards.

Unfortunately, it has descended to the dark days when money called the shorts.

The changing face of Kepong

Property experts believe that the area – one of Kuala Lumpur's oldest suburbs – will attract younger residents and investors with the new infrastructure projects and more modern developments that have come up in recent years. What can potential buyers look forward to? See **Hannah Rafee's** story on Page 4.

Improved connectivity to spur developments

With a predominantly Chinese population, Kepong is home to many traditional shops, heritage shops and family-style restaurants. During weekends, city dwellers head for Kepong to enjoy the local delicacies, such as the famous Mee Kepong, and seafood dishes.

The suburb is also known for its greenery, as well as a variety of recreational spots. The Forest Research Institute of Malaysia's Canopy Walk offers hiking in the treetops while Taman Rekreasi (Lake Gardens) Bandar Manjalara and Bukit Sri Bintang have scenic views to enjoy. The 223-acre Kepong Metropolitan Park offers running and cycling tracks and plenty

of playgrounds.

Although Kepong has a number of modern, contemporary developments, it still has a reputation as one of the more old-fashioned spots in the Klang Valley. Established in 1860s, the area around the former tin mine has seen much growth as developments were built and property values soared over the years.

The older townships in Kepong include Bandar Manjalara, Taman Sri Bintang, Desa Aman Puri, Desa Jaya, Jinjang Utara, Jinjang Selatan, Kepong Baru, Kepong Baru Tambahan, Taman Bukit Maluri, Taman Bukit Desa, Taman Daya, Taman Ehsan, Taman Fadason, Taman Indah Perdana, Taman Kemacahaya and Taman Kepong.

More recent developments include

Desa ParkCity by Perdana ParkCity Sdn Bhd, Bandar Sri Damansara by Sri Damansara Sdn Bhd, Metro Prima by Magna Prima Bhd, Plaza Manjalara by UOA Group, Fortune Perdana by Asian Pac Holdings Bhd and Laman Rimbunan by Rimbunan Melati Sdn Bhd.

Brem Mall, Tesco and AEON are the go-to-places for shopping and The Waterfront in Desa ParkCity offers entertainment. There are also the Crystal Crown Hotel, several mosques, Chinese temples and churches. There are a number of schools in the area, such as The International School @ ParkCity, Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Kepong and Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Sinar Bintang.

and Selangor.

"Kepong is located on the fringe of Kuala Lumpur and is roughly bounded by Jalan Kuching, Jalan Ipoh and Selayang to the east, Sungai Buloh to the north, Bukit Lanjan to the west and Segambut to the south. Part of Kepong is located in Kuala Lumpur and part of it is in Selangor," says Tang Chee Meng, chief operating officer of Henry Butcher (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd.

The suburb's reputation has been somewhat marred by its image of being an "old" neighbourhood. "Kepong is one of the earliest townships in Kuala Lumpur's history. In the early years, it comprised mainly village-type dwellings, traditional shops, godowns and factories, with the populace engaging in numerous trades and businesses and manufacturing activities," says Chen King Hoaw, managing director of LandServe Sdn Bhd.

"Kepong is now a mature locality. It is generally regarded as an older, predominantly Chinese neighbourhood and its image is not as sexy as, say, Mont'Kiara or even Petaling Jaya. This is why some developers tried to disassociate their projects from Kepong with their names and built a different image for their products, for example Bandar Sri Damansara and Desa ParkCity," says Henry Butcher's Tang.

"A few sizeable developments came up in Kepong in the early 2000s, such as Metro Prima, an 86-acre mixed-use development by Magna Prima, Taman Fadason by Fadason Holdings Sdn Bhd and Fortune Perdana. Subsequent to these more sizeable developments, new launches in Kepong were mainly pocket developments comprising condominiums, apartments and shophouses."

Despite the current weak market sentiment, demand for properties in Kepong remains consistent. "In Kepong, the demand is still good for landed properties. However, it is important to note that new supply is limited. Demand for strata residential properties, on the other hand, is still good for those priced below RM500 psf but slower for those priced at RM700 psf and above," says Tang.

"Since the announcement of the alignment of the MRT2 line, with four stations in Kepong (Kepong Sentral, Metro Prima, Jinjang and Sri Delima), prices for all types of properties in the area (or near the stations) have increased," says James Wong, managing director of VPC Alliance (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd.

LandServe's Chen says, "The proposed Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya MRT2 line will also have stations in Kepong and its surroundings. We expect this to further boost demand for landed and non-landed homes in Kepong.

"Other than Jalan Kuching and Jalan Ipoh, which connect Kepong directly to the city centre, the area is also served by the Middle Ring Road (MRR2), the Duta-Ulu Klang Expressway (DUKE), Lebuhraya Damansara-Puchong (LDP), Jalan Kuala Selangor and the North-South Expressway. There are also two KTM stations in the suburb — Kepong and Kepong Sentral on the KTM Komuter Rawang-Seremban route.

"Its strategic location on the northern fringe of Kuala Lumpur, which is served by a network of modern highways and roads, has been the key driver for the suburb's growth in recent decades."

A growing community

"Prices of [landed] residential projects continue to increase steadily while rents have more or less stayed flat. For instance, prices of houses in Areca Residence have increased sharply from RM1.8 million in 2011 to RM3.05 million this year. That represents a 69.4% increase. However, rental yields are low, averaging 2%," Chen says.

"Yields are low because such properties [in Kepong] cannot command much higher rents than those of condominiums in the same locality. Unlike other areas that are popular among expatriates, these properties do not fetch high rents. Locals will not pay high rents for such properties in Kepong.

"On the other hand, prices of units in First Residence condo have increased by 23.1% over the same period from RM520,000 in 2011 to RM640,000 this year. Their yields are higher, at 5%, than landed homes in Kepong. Such condominiums cater for low- to medium-income households. There is demand among Malaysians for such properties as the rents are more affordable. Given their lower prices, such rents offer higher yields."

VPC's Wong says, "Price appreciation for terraced homes in Kepong is not as high as that of high-rise residential developments."

Chen says the prices of terraced homes, especially the older ones, have sort of peaked in today's market. "High-rise residential developments are much

more affordable, attracting greater demand from a larger pool of homebuyers and investors. The market needs a stronger push before the prices of such landed homes will go up as rapidly as in the past."

According to data from VPC and Jabatan Penilaian Dan Perkhidmatan Harta, from 2011 to 2015, one- and two-storey landed homes in Taman Sri Kepong Baru have recorded the highest price appreciation of 84.2% from 2011 to 2015, followed by houses in Jalan Antoi in Kepong Baru (79.3%), Bandar Manjalara (66%) and Taman Megah Kepong (48.9%). The lowest growth rate of 29.8% was recorded at Taman Bukit Maluri. The yields of these landed homes range from 2.1% to 4.1%.

Among non-landed homes, Fortune Court saw the highest growth of 109.8%, followed by Casa Magna (87.1%), Vista Mutiara (86.7%), Fortune Avenue (84.0%) and Casa Prima (76.6%). The yields range from 3.4% to 4.3%.

"The best-selling property types in Kepong are one- and two-storey terraced houses and high-rise apartments," Wong says.

"As families residing in Kepong are more traditional, the preferred residential property type is landed properties. However, due to the lack of new supply of landed residences, house buyers in Kepong settle for high-rise condominiums and apartments. The most popular type would be the medium-cost condominiums priced around RM500 psf or less," says Tang.

"As Kepong is easily accessible to Kuala Lumpur and Petaling Jaya via various highways and has mature amenities, the target market is mostly people who work in Kuala Lumpur, Petaling Jaya and Shah Alam," VPC's Wong says.

According to the Population Census 2010 published by the Department of Statistics, Kepong — which covers Jinjang and Kampung Kepong — has a population of 14,155. Most of the residents in Kepong are Chinese.

"The target market for landed homes in Kepong is mainly families who have either been living or working in Kepong or its surroundings. Its condominiums and apartments cater more for young families and singles," Chen says.

"One of the catalysts for the growth of Kepong would be well-planned townships with better infrastructure. This would certainly boost prices and values in the area, such as Desa Park-

City and Sierramas," Wong says.

Most of the buyers are owner-occupiers. "The newer condominiums are designed to cater for small, young families and first-time homeowners. Although they are also investors, we believe most buyers are those buying for their own occupation," says Chen. "However, as Kepong is set to benefit from the proposed Sg Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya MRT line, we foresee there will be more investors in the future."

"We are seeing more launches of condominiums in Kepong, with more modern designs and a range of facilities to cater for the younger generation of residents, who are now grown up and in the market to buy their own homes. They often have higher expectations, especially those who are in a position to upgrade from their previous homes," says Henry Butcher's Tang.

A good long-term investment

Wong says living in Kepong has its perks. "Residents have easy access to the LDP, New Klang Valley Expressway, MRR2 and Jalan Kuching. And there are also plenty of ready amenities and infrastructure as well as the proposed stations along the new MRT2 line. But the cons include narrow roads, old housing areas and haphazard development."

He adds that one of the key challenges in Kepong is that most developments are not gated and guarded.

Tang believes people still see Kepong as an "old" neighbourhood. "Kepong needs an image change to attract the younger house buyers who are more brand, status and location conscious.

"Kepong is a fairly mature area that is already quite well developed, although there are still opportunities in the form of small pockets of land available for development. The locality is popular with house buyers, especially the Chinese in the area. In the future, it will be served by the MRT2 line. This will enhance the livability of the area and attract more interest, which could then lead to higher property values and rents," Tang says.

"Price appreciation in Kepong has not been dramatic, unlike other areas like Mont'Kiara, but it has shown stable growth. Prices and rents are still affordable. We foresee further capital appreciation once the MRT2 line is in operation and when people begin to see Kepong in a different light with the completion of the newer, more modern developments," Tang says, adding that Kepong is not a market for speculators. It is more for owner-occupiers and long-term investors.

Chen sees a positive outlook for Kepong. He believes the suburb will benefit tremendously from developments in Kuala Lumpur, particularly the MRT2 line. "We also expect prices of landed and non-landed homes in Kepong to increase, in view of the limited parcels of land that are available for development," Chen says.

Upcoming residential projects in Kepong include Kepong 5 @ North Kiara in Jalan Lang Emas — a condominium by QO Properties Sdn Bhd, Enesta @ Jalan Kepong — condominium and RumaWIP (Federal Territory Affordable Housing Policy) by Amona Land Sdn Bhd, Residensi Kepongmas

and The Henge — a RumaWIP and condominium by Sinerjuta Sdn Bhd and VIM3 Menjalara — a small office, home office by VST Development Sdn Bhd. RumaWIP was first introduced in 2013 to enable city folk, especially those residing in Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya and Labuan, to purchase homes at affordable prices.

"Investors and owner-occupiers looking to purchase and rent in Kepong must take note of the locations of the proposed MRT2 stations and how the line's alignment is going to affect the properties there. As for those who wish to purchase or rent a non-landed home, such as a condominium or apartment, the quality of maintenance and management is another factor to take into account to ensure the sustainability of their investment," Chen says.

"Despite the current poor market conditions, lack of confidence, tightening credit facilities and various government measures to curb speculation, the Kepong market is expected to remain optimistic in terms of values, driven by the scarcity of land in Kuala Lumpur, affordable pricing and improving infrastructure such as the four MRT2 stations," Wong shares. "Generally, with more new affordable housing that will be launched in Kepong, and the affordable prices of high-rise and landed residential properties, we suggest buyers purchase for their own stay due to affordability."

According to Wong, property prices in Kepong are relatively low, especially compared with high-rise developments in other parts of Kuala Lumpur. "There is an opportunity for investors to buy for capital appreciation." **E**

无拉港5日讯 | 加影市议会将从即日起，于无拉港8个地区展开铺路工程，民众受促在施工期间移开轿车，避免阻碍工程而被拖车！

无拉港州议员黄田志指出，加影市议会今年共获得5500万令吉的大马道路档案系统 (MARRIS)，并分发予市议会、公共工程局、水利灌溉局和土地局，以展开道路、山坡和沟渠等维修工程。

港再也主要道路、敦胡仙翁镇及蕉赖再也花园等区的工程经已完工，剩余的蕉赖柏兰岭第7区、蒂沙白杜丽主要道路、春山园及蕉赖11哩新村，明日起分阶段施工。」

无需额外缴费铺路

他是今日连同蕉赖11哩新村村长林志远视察当地的道路情况后，召开记者会时，这么指出。陪同出席者还包括加影市

议员苏仁强。

他说，雪州政府自去年规定承包商必须将住家前方路段，列为铺路工程的范围，居民无需额外缴费铺路。

此外，他表示，每当承包商展开工程时，往往会被一些不愿移开车辆的车主阻碍工程，故他呼吁村民在施工期间移开车子。「市议会已授权铺路的承包商，一旦发现车主不愿配合，即有权拖走车子到其他地方，因此，民众应尽量给予配合，否

则将将被拖车。」

他强调，其实市议会在展开铺路工程的前一周，都会派发通知信函予涉及的居民，要求在施工期间多加留意；然而，这项措施却引起民众争论，包括一些居民声言没有收到通知。「我希望市议会张挂有关承包商授权拖车咨询的布条，同时会要求市议员向市议会反映问题。」

苏仁强盼村民给予合作，而市议会也将给予密切配合，甚至会派遣基建小组到场监督工程。林志远则说，一旦民众发现承包商额外收费，欲为住家前方展开铺路工程，应尽快告知，以展开应对措施。

河边路居民促拆电讯塔

巴生5日讯 | 河边路居民不满家园邻近惊现电讯塔，促请巴生市议会介入下达指令，要电讯公司立即拆除新竖立的电讯塔，还居民安乐窝。

河边路里茂卡斯杜里11路的路口小空地，5月中旬突然出现一座3楼高度的电讯塔，仅隔邻近单层排屋50公尺距离，居民担心一旦启用后，会影响居民的健康。

当地居民周日通过直落玻璃居民协会投诉，电讯公司一开始兴建一座约与街灯同高度的电讯塔，居民当时不以为意，直到电讯塔增建高度至约近20至30公尺高，形同一栋3楼高建筑的高度。

居民陈金财说，电讯塔目前只是设立塔身，还未正式投入操作，他们希望市议会尽快

采取行动，禁让电讯公司批准操作。

他说，居民坚决反对电讯塔是基于担心发出幅射，会带来危害影响健康。

没获市会批准

居民周金利则表示，之前特向市议会了解情况，发现电讯公司并未向市议会申请批准，这意味着是非法兴建电讯塔。

他说，根据市议会条例，电讯公司要在住宅区兴建电讯塔，必须提前获得居民一致同意并收集签名，市议会才会批准通过设立电讯塔。

因此，他促请市议会尽快向电讯公司下达拆除令，居民才能放下心头大石。

该居协主席吕福财对此表示，他将向当地领养市议员反映问题，要求对方跟进问题。

出席投诉者包括居协财政陈威仲、理事庄祥发、周翠红等。

另一方面，河边路住宅区近年面对木屋区居民公开焚烧垃圾，以及重型拖格罗里违例停放在路旁的困扰。

居民周金利申诉，木屋区居民每天傍晚约计5时许都会在路边非法焚烧垃圾，他曾于2014年向市议会作出投诉，官员却以捉不到人而作罢，未再有下文。

「同时，住宅区于3、4年前开始出现重型拖格罗里停放在路旁的问题，我也是向市议会反映，一样是不被受理。」

周金利也促请，市议会必须正视该区所面对的一箩筐民生问题，不能坐视不理。

他昨晚出席巴生港口天福宫李府童子爷公千秋平安晚宴时，如此表示。出席者有该宫名誉主席拿督斯里郑明发、拿督许瑞珍、稽查陈泉成、民主行动党莲花苑州议员张菲倩及巴生港口州选区协调官阿兹尼占。

张菲倩说，经济萎缩，马币疲弱，雪州政府并没坐视不理，本月开始已在每个州选区发放米粮和日常用品给穷苦人家，与全民共度艰难。

她指出，雪州政府推出各

种利民政策，包括婴儿初生基金、学生免费补习计划、乐龄亲善基金、托儿辅助基金、青年结婚奖励金、子女大学辅助金等，确保每一分每一毫都用在子民身上。

此外，她说，行动党坚决反对伊斯兰党在国会提呈伊刑法私人法案。只要有行动党在的一天，是不会让伊刑法能推行。行动党的立场不会动不动就U转，只会与人民一同前进。

保护各族和谐

阿兹尼占说，他作为一名穆斯林，不能反对伊刑法，不过也不能容许伊刑法沦为别有居心者的政治工具。

「某些人士或组织想要挑起宗教和种族课题，破坏我国各族人民之间的和谐，我呼吁大家不要坠入陷阱。」

他说，巴生港口州议员丹斯里卡立目前已是独立议员，他被州政府受委为该区协调官，服务巴生港口选民。

「我出任协调官迄今已4个月，服务中心每早10时开放至晚上10时，斋戒月则有2段时间，即上午10时至傍晚5时，晚上8时30分至10时。欢迎民众有事上门求助。」(410)

逾百盞燈柱電線被偷 巴生數區民摸黑過夜

疑因巴生南区武吉丁宜第一区、第二区、绿林镇及良木园的灯柱电擎开关处设在下方，结果当地估计逾80%、超过百盏街灯电线被毛贼所偷，导致入夜后四周漆黑一片，令外地人调侃犹如走入“森林”。

巴生社会工作者叶金发今日召开记者会提到，经观察后发现，巴生市议会的街灯灯柱因开关处位于灯柱下方，让人容易撬开偷取电线和电板。

他认为，巴生市议会应检讨街灯开关处的设置，避免毛贼轻易造案。

他建议市议会把开关处设置在更高的位置，同时也可参考国能的洋灰电柱，避免让毛贼轻易撬开。

他将针对此事，向当地市议员杨文来反映，希望问题可获正视。

此外，叶金发声称，除了许多街灯因电线被偷而失灵外，冷岳路衔接良木园和武吉丁宜的高架天桥下方8盏照明灯也告失灵，导致天桥在入夜后照明欠佳。

他指出，有关天桥的使用率极高，

（巴生5日讯）直落玻璃居民申诉，位于直落玻璃利茂卡斯杜里路11路（Jalan Limau Kasturi 11）近日突然竖起一座电讯塔，令他们担忧不已。

据知，电讯塔款式犹如电灯柱，即塔中间部分伸出3个装有灯罩的臂膀，让居民一度误以为是电灯柱，直到电讯塔建设完工才得以确认。

居民声称，有关电讯塔是在5月份兴建，工作人员率先安装电灯部分，乍看下以为是电灯柱，距离电讯塔50公尺处就是住宅区，让居民担心电讯塔开始运作后，恐影响当地至少100户人家。

他们曾向市议会查询后发现，任何电讯塔的兴建工程，都须获居民同意，方可展开工程，惟他们却没接获相关工程的讯息。

居民表明，他们并不清楚

有关电讯塔公司是否已获市议会批准。

另一方面，当地居民也反映，重型罗里频频出入英达花园，而且车速相当快，恐危及居民的安全。

他们形容，18个轮胎的重型罗里经过时，屋子会有震动感，好像发生地震一样。有关情况已长达3年，每次向市议会投诉，市议会却建议居民向陆路公共交通委员会反映，最终不了了之。

居民也希望市议会可关注该区常有露天焚烧的问题。

接获投诉的居民协会主席吕福财召开记者会说，他将向当地市议员反映此事，也会向市议员投诉有关露天焚烧及重型罗里出入的问题。
