# 'Kerajaan negeri boleh beli vaksin'

Selangor, Sarawak dibenar dengan syarat bekalan mesti daftar NPRA

**Kuala Lumpur:** Menteri Penyelaras Program Imunisasi COVID-19 Kebangsaan (PICK), Khairy Jamaluddin, memberi maklum balas positif kepada kerajaan negeri yang berhasrat membeli sendiri bekalan COVID-19.

Beliau berkata, kerajaan negeri Selangor dan Sarawak yang membuat permohonan itu, boleh berbuat demikian dengan syarat vaksin yang ingin dibeli mesti berdaftar dengan Bahagian Kawal Selia Farmasi Negara (NPRA).

"Bagi kerajaan negeri Sarawak, saya mengadakan beberapa sesi libat urus dengan Timbalan Ketua Menteri, Datuk Amar Douglas Ungah Embas dan memaklumkan bahawa bekalan vaksin Kerajaan Persekutuan mencukupi untuk menampung keperluan pelaksanaan PICK di Sarawak.

"Beliau memohon untuk kerajaan negeri membeli vaksin. Saya memberi respon positif dengan syarat vaksin yang ingin dibeli oleh kerajaan negeri Sarawak mesti berdaftar di bawah NPRA terlebih dahulu.

"Ia memandangkan jenis

vaksin yang dikehendaki oleh kerajaan negeri Sarawak masih dalam proses penilaian oleh NPRA," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Khairy turut menafikan dakwaan Ketua Pembangkang, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, bahawa kerajaan Selangor menunggu berbulan lamanya untuk kelulusan mendapatkan dua juta dos bagi rakyat Selangor.

"Ini tidak benar. Dalam perbincangan saya dengan Menteri Besar Selangor, beliau ada sebut secara lisan perancangan Selangor untuk membeli vaksin.

"Saya memberi respon positif, namun sehingga kini saya belum menerima apa-apa permohonan rasmi daripada pihak kerajaan negeri," katanya.

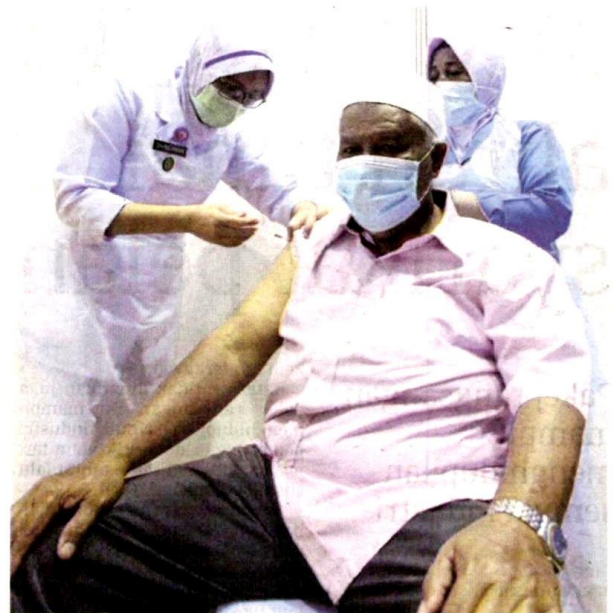
Khairy yang juga Menteri Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi, turut menyatakan kesediaan disoal, dikritik dan disiasat berhubung perolehan vaksin serta segala yang berkaitan dengannya.

Beliau menyatakan keterbukaan itu susulan kenyataan Anwar yang menuntut supaya siasatan bebas dibuat berhubung PICK dan perolehan vaksin.

Khairy berkata, beberapa

kontrak pembelian vaksin bersama jadual penghantaran dan harganya sudah didedahkan kepada Jawatankuasa Kira-Kira Wang Negara (PAC) Parlimen pada 5 Januari lalu.

"Antara ahli PAC yang hadir dan memperhalusi kontrak perolehan vaksin pada hari berkenaan adalah Ahli Parlimen Permatang Pauh, Nurul Izzah Anwar.

"Saya juga telah mengadakan sesi libat urus bersama Ahli Dewan Rakyat pembangkang pada 19 Mac lalu yang mana saya bantangkan secara panjang lebar pelaksanaan PICK, termasuk menjawab pelbagai soalan secara terperinci.

"Ketua Pembangkang tidak

hadir pada sesi berkenaan," katanya.

Kelmarin, Anwar menggesa satu badan siasatan bebas ditubuhkan segera oleh kerajaan bagi menyiasat kadar pemerolehan vaksin yang rendah di negara ini.

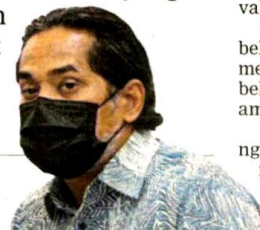
Beliau dilaporkan berkata, langkah itu perlu bagi menjawab pelbagai persoalan termasuk mengapa cuma tiga peratus rakyat Malaysia sudah mendaftarkan vaksin untuk melawan COVID-19.

Khairy menegaskan, PICK dilaksanakan mengikut fasa yang diumumkan sejak 14 Februari lalu.

"Perancangan PICK dibuat dengan mengambil kira jadual penghantaran vaksin yang diberi oleh syarikat pembekal vaksin.

"Jadual ini diumumkan sebelum ini. Saya sudah jelaskan mengikut unjuran kerajaan, bekalan vaksin kita akan mula ampuh bermula Jun.

"Ini juga mengikut perancangan PICK yang mana vaksinasi massa fasa tiga dijadualkan bermula Jun ini," katanya.

# Bazar Ramadan Greenwood gagal patuh SOP diarah tutup

**Kuala Lumpur:** Majlis Perbandaran Selayang (MPS) mengarahkan Bazar Ramadan Greenwood, Gombak, Selangor ditutup empat hari bermula hari ini hingga 25 April ini kerana gagal mematuhi prosedur operasi standard (SOP) ditetapkan.

Pengarah Jabatan Korporat MPS, Mohamad Zin Masoad dalam kenyataan media berkata, arahan penutupan bazar dibuat selepas mengambil kira kebajikan peniaga yang siap memasak untuk jualan semalam.

Katanya, penyerahan notis tutup bazar mengikut Seksyen 18 (1)(f), Akta Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit 1988 (Akta 342) diserahkan kepada wakil pengelola JKP Zon 3 di Jabatan Pelesenan, semalam.

“Penyerahan notis penutupan ini dikeluarkan pegawai yang diberi kuasa mengikut Akta Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit 1988. Pada masa sama, MPS menerangkan SOP dan tindakan pematuhan yang perlu dipatuhi bagi tujuan pembukaan semula bazar kepada wakil pengelola,” katanya.

MPS turut memaklumkan sudah menetapkan kepada semua penganjur dan pengelola melaksanakan SOP tambahan, antaranya penggunaan kad nombor giliran kepada pengunjung, mewujudkan laluan sehalu di dalam bazar dan larangan masuk ke bazar Ramadan bagi kanak-kanak di bawah umur 12 tahun dan warga emas 65 tahun ke atas.

# Lelaki hadapi tuduhan seks luar tabii dilepas tanpa dibebaskan

**Tertuduh tarik balik permohonan semakan kehakiman cabar Ketua Pendakwa Syarie Selangor**

**Kuala Lumpur:** Seorang lelaki yang sebelum ini mencabar Seksyen 28 Enakmen Kesalahan-Kesalahan Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995, dilepas tanpa dibebaskan oleh Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah Shah Alam atas tuduhan cuba melakukan seks luar tabii dengan seorang lelaki.

Lelaki berusia 36 tahun itu dilepas tanpa dibebaskan oleh Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah pada Isnin lalu berikutan keputusan Mahkamah Persekutuan pada 25 Februari lalu yang membatalkan pertuduhan dihadapinya.

Sebelum ini, panel sembilan hakim diketuai oleh Ketua Hakim Negara, Tun Tengku Maimun Tuan Mat mengisytiharkan Seksyen 28 Enakmen Kesalahan Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) yang disandarkan bagi mendakwa lelaki itu adalah tidak sah.

Sehubungan itu, lelaki berkenaan menarik balik permohonan semakan kehakiman bagi mencabar tindakan Ketua Pendakwa Syarie Negeri Selangor yang mendakwanya.

Peguam, Tay Kit Hoo yang mewakili lelaki itu selaku pemohon, memberitahu bahawa Mahkamah Tinggi kemudian membatalkan semakan kehakiman itu selepas membenarkan permohonan

berkenaan.

“Tiada bantahan daripada Penolong Penasihat Undang-Undang Negeri Selangor, Husna Abdul Halim yang mewakili responden pertama dan kedua (Ketua Pendakwa Syarie Negeri Selangor dan Kerajaan Negeri Selangor) terhadap permohonan itu.

“Mahkamah membatalkan permohonan semakan kehakiman tanpa perintah terhadap kos,” katanya dihubungi media selepas selesai prosiding pengurusan kes di hadapan Timbalan Pendaftar Mahkamah Tinggi, Firdaus Sidqi Sharil Azli.

Pada 21 Ogos 2019, ketua pendakwa raya syarie membuat keputusan untuk mendakwa lelaki berkenaan di bawah Seksyen 28 Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Negeri Selangor) 1995. Dia didakwa cuba melakukan persetubuhan di luar tabii dengan lelaki lain di sebuah rumah di Selangor pada 9 November 2018.

Pada 20 November 2019, lelaki itu memfailkan permohonan semakan kehakiman untuk memohon satu deklarasi bahawa Seksyen 28 bercanggah dengan Artikel-Artikel 5 (1), 8 dan 10 Perlembagaan Persekutuan dan dengan itu ia batal dan tidak sah. Dalam permohonan itu, lelaki

terbabit juga memohon satu perintah *certiorari* selaras dengan Aturan 53 Kaedah 8 (2), Kaedah-Kaedah Mahkamah 2012 untuk memasukkan keputusan Ketua Pendakwa Syarie Negeri Selangor yang mendakwanya di Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah Selangor pada 21 Ogos 2019 dibatalkan serta-merta. Permohonan semakan kehakiman itu dibenarkan oleh Mahkamah Tinggi pada 16 Januari tahun lalu.

## Kariah Masjid Al- Khairiyah reda

**PETALING JAYA:** Meskipun terpaksa menggantikan puasa terbatal, para penduduk yang terkesan kerana berbuka puasa tiga minit lebih awal menzahirkan rasa reda selain memahami kejadian berlaku akibat kesilapan teknikal masjid.

Mereka sebaliknya tidak memarahi pentadbiran Masjid Al-Khairiyah, Taman Seri Gombak dekat sini kerana silap melaungkan azan Maghrib bukan pada waktu sebenar.

Bercakap kepada *Utusan Malaysia*, Ahli Jawatankuasa Masjid Al-Khairiyah, Mohd. Rasihan Mohd. Ikhlik berkata, mereka amat faham dengan keadaan berlaku.

“Alhamdulillah, Jabatan Mufti Selangor telah pun berikan penjelasan bahawa puasa perlu diqada (diganti).

“Nasib baik kerajaan Selangor tidak membenarkan majlis berbuka puasa di masjid seperti setiap kali Ramadan sebelum ini, kalau tidak, lebih ramai terkesan dengan akibat kesilapan ini,” katanya.

Masjid Al-Khairiyah yang dirasmikan pada 9 Julai 2004 mempunyai kapasiti sebanyak 4,000 jemaah dalam satu-satu masa.

Hujah menggantikan puasa berkenaan mengambil kira pandangan jumahur ulama Hanafi, Maliki, Syafie dan ramai di kalangan ulama Hanbali .

## Pengurusan akui tersalah laung azan

**Gombak:** Pengurusan Masjid Al-Khairiyah, Taman Seri Gombak di sini, mengakui terkhilaf dalam laungan azan Maghrib pada Isnin lalu bersamaan 7 Ramadan yang menyebabkan kariahnya berbuka puasa tiga minit lebih awal.

Nazir masjid itu, Wan Nawawi Wan Dagang bagaimanapun berkata, kesilapan terbabit cepat disedari dan laungan azan mengikut waktu sebenar segera dibunyikan selepas itu selain turut memberi penjelasan kepada semua ahli kariah.

Katanya, pihaknya memaklumkan kekeliruan yang berlaku menerusi hebahan di kumpulan WhatsApp masjid dan secara bersemuka, malah menerangkannya isu berkenaan kepada Jabatan Agama

Islam Selangor (Jais).

Beliau sekali gus mengesahkan kandungan WhatsApp yang tular di media sosial berhubung perkara itu adalah benar.

"Kenyataan yang tular itu memang sah daripada saya. Cuma (ketika hari kejadian) tidak sempat pun

habis azan, kami minta bilal hentikan (selepas sedar terkhilaf) dan apabila masuk waktu sebenar, azan sekali lagi.

"Kami sedar (salah waktu) apabila (ahli jawatankuasa masjid) lihat jam tangan masing-masing, (manakala) bilal ketika itu azan di tempat berasingan yang berpandukan jam digital (yang salah kerana memaparkan waktu lebih awal).

"Apabila melihat jam awal tiga minit, kami beritahu bilal untuk hentikan azan, (dan) kemudian barulah azan semula (sepenuhnya) bila masuk waktu sebenar," katanya ketika ditemui, semalam.

Wan Nawawi berkata, pengurusan masjid turut berbincang sebelum membuat keputusan untuk me-

nerangkan perkara itu menerusi WhatsApp.

"Kami pastikan dahulu kejadian itu dan tidak sewenang-wenangnya dikeluarkan

kenyataan. Tak sangka ia (kenyataan) tular di media sosial.

"Jika (kariah) yang tiada dalam kumpulan WhatsApp masjid, kami sudah maklumkan melalui hebahan sewaktu solat fardu dan hebahan verbal (lisan bersemuka)," katanya yang memberitahu perkara berkenaan sudah selesai di peringkat kariah dan Jais.

Beliau juga menegaskan kenyataan yang dikeluarkannya sebelum ini khusus untuk pengetahuan ahli kariah masjid itu sahaja, manakala orang di luar kariah tidak memerlukannya kerana mempunyai surau dan masjid sendiri.

Katanya, ahli kariah yang mendapat maklumat mengenai kekeliruan azan itu perlu menggantikan puasa mereka.

"Penyerahan notis penutupan ini dikeluarkan pegawai yang diberi kuasa mengikut Akta Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit 1988.

"Pada masa sama, MPS menerangkan SOP dan tindakan pematuan yang perlu dipatuhi bagi tujuan pembukaan semula bazar kepada wakil pengelola," ka-

tanya.

**Putrajaya:** "Saya sentiasa terbuka untuk disoal, dikritik dan disiasat berhubung pelaksanaan program vaksinasi terbesar negara," ujar Menteri Penyelaras Program Imunisasi Covid-19 Kebangsaan Khairy Jamaluddin.

Merujuk tuntutan Ketua Pembangkang Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim supaya siasatan bebas dilakukan di bawah Parlimen terhadap program itu serta perolehan vaksin sudah pun didedahkan sepenuhnya kepada Jawatankuasa Kira-Kira Wang Negara (PAC) Parlimen pada 5 Januari lalu.

"Pendedahan itu adalah

bersekali dengan jadual penghantaran dan harga yang dibayar," katanya yang juga Menteri Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi.

Beliau berkata, antara ahli PAC yang hadir dan memperhalusi kontrak perolehan vaksin pada hari berkenaan adalah Ahli Parlimen Permatang Pauh Nurul Izzah.

Sesi libat urus bersama ahli Dewan Rakyat pembangkang juga sudah diadakan pada 19 Mac lalu berhubung pelaksanaan program imunisasi itu di mana dia membentangkan secara panjang lebar mengenai pelaksanaannya namun Anwar tidak hadir pada sesi itu.

Dalam satu kenyataan semalam, sebagai maklum balas terhadap kenyataan Anwar berhubung program imunisasi itu, Khairy berkata, dakwaan kerajaan negeri Selangor terpaksa menunggu lama bagi mendapat kelulusan membeli vaksin Covid-19 adalah tidak be-

nar kerana tiada permohonan rasmi dibuat oleh kerajaan negeri itu setakat ini.

Menurutnya, Menteri Besar Selangor Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari ada menyebut secara lisan perancangan Selangor untuk membeli vaksin dalam perbincangan mereka.

"Saya memberi respons yang positif. Namun, sehingga kini saya

belum menerima apa-apa permohonan rasmi dari pihak kerajaan negeri," katanya.

Anwar antaranya mendakwa kerajaan Selangor "menunggu berbulan lamanya hanya untuk mendapat kelulusan yang diperlukan... untuk mendapatkan 2 juta dos buat rakyat Selangor."

Mengulas dakwaan sama oleh Anwar mengenai Sarawak, Khairy berkata dia sudah mengadakan beberapa sesi libat urus dengan Timbalan Ketua Menteri Datuk Amar Douglas Unggah Embas dan memaklumkan bahawa bekalan kerajaan Persekutuan mencukupi untuk menampung keperluan

pelaksanaan program imunisasi di Sarawak.

Menurut Khairy, Unggah juga sudah memohon untuk kerajaan Sarawak membeli vaksin dan beliau sudah memberi respons yang positif mengenai permohonan itu namun menetapkan syarat yang vaksin itu mestilah berdaftar Bahagian Regulatori Farmasi Negara (NPRA).

Beliau berkata, vaksin yang ingin dibeli oleh kerajaan Sarawak mestilah berdaftar di bawah NPRA terlebih dahulu memandangkan jenis vaksin yang dikehendaki Sarawak masih dalam proses penilaian oleh NPRA. - Bernama

Pada 16 Januari tahun lalu, lelaki tersebut memperoleh kebenaran daripada Mahkamah Tinggi di sini untuk memulakan prosiding semakan kehakiman itu.

Lelaki itu memfailkan permohonan tersebut pada 20 November 2019, antaranya memohon deklarasi bahawa Seksyen 28 Enakman Kesalahan-Kesalahan Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 bercanggah dengan Artikel-Artikel 5 (1), 8 dan 10, Perlembagaan Persekutuan dan dengan itu ia batal dan tidak sah.

Dalam permohonan itu, lelaki tersebut juga memohon perintah carterasi selaras dengan Ajaran 53 Kaedah 8 (2), Kaedah-Kaedah Mahkamah 2012 untuk memajukan keputusan Ketua Pendakwa Syarie Negeri Selangor yang mendabekannya di Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah Selangor pada 21 Ogos 2019 dibatalkan serta-merta.

Pada 25 Februari lalu, Mahkamah Persekutuan membenarkan pengisytiharan dipohon lelaki itu bahawa Seksyen 28 Enakman Kesalahan-Kesalahan Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 yang mempromosikan kesabahan dan hukuman terhadap persembahan bertentangan dengan hukum tabii, adalah tidak sah dan tidak mengikat perlembagaan.

## NIA an answer to our foreign investment outflow

**PETALING JAYA:** Amid mounting criticism on the exit of foreign investments out of Malaysia, the government has approved the National Investment Aspirations (NIA) framework to attract high-quality investments into the country and create high-income jobs.

The framework, which has five core parameters, will also serve as a guide in introducing more targeted and effective investment promotion and facilitation strategies to attract quality investments.

The NIA mandates the establishment of a National Investment Council to be chaired by the Prime Minister.

The council, which will formulate overarching investment policies and provide resolutions for key implementation issues, will include relevant ministries and agencies, as well as government-linked companies (GLCs) and government-linked investment companies (GLICs), led by Khazanah Nasional Bhd.

Membership may also be extended to other relevant stakeholders.

The International Trade and Industry Ministry (Miti) said that investment policy reforms will be rooted in the NIA, which in

turn will be guided by the “essence of the Shared Prosperity Vision 2030”.

“The NIA is a product of comprehensive stakeholder consultations and has taken into account views and feedback from ministries and agencies, GLCs and GLICs, the private sector, as well as research organisations and think tanks,” the ministry said in a statement yesterday.

Meanwhile, Senior Minister and Minister of International Trade and Industry Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali pointed out that the NIA will be central in the efforts to revitalise Malaysia’s investment climate.

Going forward, Azmin said Malaysia must adopt a comprehensive approach to reinvigorate the investment ecosystem and respond adequately to emerging megatrends as well as the evolving needs of investors.

The country needs to continuously enhance its unique value propositions, which span across a wide array of elements such as incentives, facilitation, talent, infrastructure, as well as legal, regulatory, procedural and institutional mechanisms.

“In order to enable further diversification

and ventures into more complex industries, emphasis should also be accorded towards fostering a robust and dynamic tax and incentives regime, building our talent pool in close collaboration with the relevant industries, improving our licensing and regulatory frameworks and augmenting the facilitation elements such as customs procedures”, according to Azmin.

The NIA would focus on inclusivity and sustainability that is compatible with the environmental, social and governance (ESG) goals, as new investments that are anchored upon these elements will propel growth in the technologically-sophisticated sectors, as well as strengthen forward and backward linkages.

“This will also provide a pathway for investors to access new market opportunities, particularly in developed countries that have mainstream sustainability throughout their value chain.

“In this context, the NIA takes into account the global interest surrounding carbon-neutrality, including the use of technology to help reduce carbon foot-print,” stated Miti.

Khairy: Condition is that vaccines must be NPRA-approved

**PETALING JAYA:** State governments can procure their own Covid-19 vaccines as long as they are approved for use in Malaysia, says Khairy Jamaluddin.

The National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme coordinating minister clarified that he had given "positive responses" to the Selangor and Sarawak governments which had expressed an intention to procure their own supply of vaccines.

"In my discussion with the Selangor Menteri Besar, he mentioned Selangor's plans to procure vaccines.

"I responded positively but until now I have not received any official request from the state government," Khairy said in a press statement yesterday.

He added that he had also arranged for several engagement sessions with Sarawak Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Amar Douglas Uggah Embas on the matter.

"He, too, requested for his state government to procure vaccines and I had given a positive response with the condition that the vaccine to be procured must be registered under NPRA

(National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency).

"This is because the type of vaccine that the Sarawak government wishes to procure is still being evaluated by NPRA," he said.

He was responding to Opposition Leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's criticism that both state governments faced delays in obtaining approvals for procuring their own supply of vaccines.

Khairy also responded to Anwar's statement that to date, fewer than 3% of Malaysians have been vaccinated against Covid-19.

"The immunisation programme is being carried out according to the schedule of vaccine delivery that is given by the manufacturers. This schedule has been announced beforehand.

"I have also explained that according to the government's projections, our vaccine supplies will accumulate rapidly starting June," he added.

In his statement on Tuesday, Anwar said he was "disturbed at the level of inefficiency on the part of ministerial leadership" in regard to the vaccination rates in Malaysia.

The PKR president has demanded that the Federal Government support the efforts of the state governments and private sector to pro-

cedure the approved vaccines, and also called for an independent investigation under the auspices of Parliament into the causes of procurement bottlenecks.

Vaccine supplies have been steadily arriving in Malaysia since February, especially as Phase Two of the national inoculation programme intensifies.

In May, Malaysia is scheduled to receive another 1,038,960 doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine and another 500,000 doses of the Sinovac finished product.

By October, Malaysia is expected to have enough vaccine doses to cover 80% of the population, or 27 million people.

So far, the Malaysian government has sealed a deal with Pfizer-BioNTech for a total of 32 million doses of their vaccines to be delivered this year.

The country is also expected to receive a total of 14 million doses of Sinovac's vaccine by September, as well as a supply of 3.5 million doses of CanSino's vaccine in stages.

Malaysia has also signed deals to secure 6.4 million doses of Sputnik V and a total of 12.8 million doses of AstraZeneca vaccine, though this is pending a decision by the authorities on whether to proceed with the latter.

# App to assess eateries' cleanliness

Shah Alam council's initiative aimed at improving awareness and enforcement

A NEW app by Shah Alam City Council (MBSA) will enable self-assessment of hygiene at licensed food premises. The i-Gred app requires restaurant owners or operators to conduct inspections and assess the level of cleanliness and food safety in their respective premises.

Acting Shah Alam mayor Mohd Rashidi Ruslan launched the app during a monthly gathering with employees at Auditorium MBSA in Shah Alam.

"Through this app, inspection and assessment of cleanliness at food premises is done in an integrated manner involving three parties, namely the food operator, customer or public and MBSA health inspector," said MBSA Corporate and Public Relations head Shahrin Ahmad in a statement.

"Operators or owners of food premises need to get feedback from customers through the i-Gred app as a method of monitoring their cleanliness.

"The minimum is 30 customers for one premises per month. "Food premises then need to send a monthly hygiene level assessment report to MBSA using the app," he added.

Also present at the launch were MBSA Information Technology Division head Umi Aida Ab Malik, management and legal sector deputy secretary Asmah Mohd Zin, councillor Papparaidu Veraman, operations sector deputy secretary Yunus Suri and Environmental Health Department director Norhisham Mohammad.

MBSA is targeting 200 premises to use the app consistently, with some already registering their intention with the city council.

"The i-Gred app is an ongoing commitment by MBSA to improve awareness and knowledge of cleanliness as well as enforcement of regulations.

"It is also an initiative to encourage these operators to be aware of cleanliness at all

times and to make improvements when needed quickly," said Shahrin.

Food premises that consistently maintain a Grade A level of cleanliness will have their businesses promoted on MBSA's website and social media platforms.

Later the same day, a memorandum of understanding was signed with 99 Speedmart for the MBSA Cares Food Basket Programme.

The programme, which started on Feb 8, involves the purchase of packages covering basic food items as well as infant formula that will then be channelled to those in need, particularly households from the B40 group.

"As of March 31, some 6,000 people have contributed to the MBSA Cares Food Basket Programme amounting to a total cash contribution of RM90,910.

"MBSA has identified 1,884 recipients for the programme and allocated RM50,000 to kickstart it.

"Selangor socio-economic development,

social welfare, workers empowerment committee chairman V. Ganabatrau also contributed RM10,000.

"A portion of the RM130,000 contributed by 99 Speedmart to the state government's plastic bag charge will also be used for this purpose," said Shahrin in a statement.

The public can contribute by purchasing vouchers for the basic food items and infant formula, with prices ranging from RM10 to RM50 per package.

The vouchers are available for purchase at any 99 Speedmart outlet under MBSA's jurisdiction.

Those who contribute towards the MBSA Cares Food Basket Programme will be presented with special vouchers and certificates of appreciation.

The programme is in line with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals to ensure that no one is left behind. — **By JADE CHAN**

# Khairy denies Anwar's claims about vaccine

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Khairy Jamaluddin has denied claims that the Selangor government waited for months to get approvals to procure two million vaccine doses for people in the state.

Khairy, who is the coordinating minister for the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (NIP), yesterday said Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari did verbally mention Selangor's plan to buy vaccines.

"I gave a positive response. However, until now, I have yet to receive any official application from the state government."

Khairy was responding to opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, who claimed that the government was too busy figuring out ways to control the NIP, resulting in delays faced by the Selangor government.

Anwar on Tuesday claimed that Sarawak also faced the same problem in obtaining approval from the federal government.

As for Sarawak, Khairy said several sessions were held with Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Amar Douglas Uggah Embas.

"I told him that the federal gov-

ernment's supply is sufficient to meet the needs of the NIP implementation in the state."

Khairy said Uggah also applied for the state government to procure vaccines.

On Anwar's demands for an investigation to be conducted under Parliament into the NIP and vaccine procurement, Khairy said he was open to questioning, criticism and investigation.

"Once again, I would like to remind him that I have fully disclosed several vaccine purchase contracts to Parliament's Public Accounts Committee (PAC) on Jan 5, along with the delivery schedule and price.

"PAC members who attended and refined the vaccine procurement contract included Permatang Pauh member of parliament Nurul Izzah Anwar.

"I held an engagement session with opposition MPs on March 19, in which I presented at length the implementation of NIP, as well as answering questions in detail. The opposition leader (Anwar), however, was not present."

He said he hoped Anwar would follow the implementation of NIP, and then give thoughtful criticism for him to answer.

# GREENWOOD BAZAAR SHUT 4 DAYS FOR FLOUTING S.O.P.

Selayang council also sets additional rules for market organisers to follow upon reopening

**T**HE Greenwood Ramadan bazaar in Gombak, Selangor, has been ordered to close for four days from today for failing to comply with standard operating procedures (SOP) to curb the spread of Covid-19.

Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) corporate department director Mohamad Zin Masoad said since vendors had started preparing their food yesterday, the council

decided to let the closure order start today.

He said the closure notice was issued in accordance with Section 18(1)(f) of the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1988 (Act 342).

"The closure notice was issued by officers who were authorised under Act 342.

"At the same time, MPS will continue to explain the rules that (bazaar) organisers must follow before the bazaar can be reopened," he said in a statement yesterday.

He said MPS had also issued additional SOPs for bazaars to follow.

They include issuing queue numbers to shoppers, creating a one-way route and banning children aged below 12 and senior citizens aged above 65.

"To ensure the SOP is adhered to, MPS will check all Ramadan bazaars under its purview.

"Visitors and traders are reminded not to be complacent. Obey the SOP so the Covid-19 chain of infection can be controlled."

# Focus more on high-value investments

**T**HE announcement that International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali will table a Cabinet paper on Malaysia's new investment policy this week is welcome news.

Less welcome are the reports that it focuses on innovation, technology and digital investments, which raises concerns that it might miss the target in creating wider value in the economy.

The announcement comes hard on the heels of Microsoft's US\$1 billion (RM4.1 billion) five-year investment in Malaysia which is expected to generate US\$4.6 billion (RM19 billion) in revenue and create around 19,000 jobs for Malaysians, including 4,000 related to information technology.

While this investment does signal foreign investor confidence in Malaysia, we must also clarify whether the RM19 billion in revenue will benefit Malaysians more widely or whether it will just be absorbed into Microsoft's global revenue stream.

When businesses evaluate investments they do so in financial terms, using risk-adjusted return on investment for example.

Policymakers must evaluate the wider economic impact not just the private financial impact on Microsoft nor the high-tech nature of the investment. Neither of these measure total value-added.

For example, the 4,000 technology-related jobs are welcome but what about the remaining 15,000? Are they high-tech, high value-added jobs too or not? What will be the spill-over to the local economy? Will Malaysian firms benefit in the Microsoft supply chain and if so what will the benefit be?

We had a similar narrative welcoming high-tech foreign investors when Volkswagen announced its new, high-tech, 50,000 sq ft supply chain and logistics hub, otherwise called a warehouse, in Johor.

This is certainly a high-tech investment by a world-class company but the technology used automates the warehouse processes and reduces the need for employees.

This lowers costs, improves productivity and raises profits which will be absorbed outside of Malaysia into the global profit of the Volkswagen group.

It is an example of a high-tech, low-cost and low value-added investment to Malaysia which boosts the profitability of global mega-brands but adds relatively little locally.

Relatively few Malaysians will be employed for example and, as in the Microsoft case, a large number will not be high-tech, high-paid jobs.

Take another example from home grown tech-driven investments such as Grab the e-hailing app that has now expanded into a wide range of

product segments.

The e-hailing app itself is novel, if not very high-tech and even the business model is innovative while drawing on similar models such as its erstwhile competitor, Uber.

The "success" of this company is demonstrated to many people not just by its growth and market capture but also by the US\$39.6 billion valuation placed on its upcoming public listing.

What fewer people notice is that it had cumulated losses of US\$10 billion and net losses of more than US\$2 billion for at least three consecutive years up to 2020, according to documents released prior to its listing announcement.

Also, while many people point to the creation of much needed employment, especially during the pandemic, we are beginning to recognise that these are very low-paid and precarious jobs with few, if any, social protections such as insurance, medical or pension cover.

Indeed, just as these jobs have boomed during the lockdown there are signs that they will bomb after the lockdowns when demand is expected to plummet.

In addition, we all know that although Grab originated in Malaysia it is now a Singapore-based company so most of the revenues and profits will accrue outside of Malaysia.

The value-added here, such as it is, will be measured in low-paid, precarious jobs driven by high-tech,

multinational investments.

The costs of social protection will fall either on the drivers and riders or on the Malaysian taxpayer.

For the avoidance of doubt, none of the companies have done anything wrong and we hope that the investments will be successful.

Nonetheless, they are examples of a fundamental error in the presentation of policy that equates high-tech with high-value.

It does not follow that innovation will lead to net economic value-added if those innovations replace people through automation.

Technology and especially the technology of the Fourth Industrial Revolution or Industry 4.0 can and does have the effect of creating profits for company owners at the expense of their employees.

Automation, digitalisation and robotisation at the heart of the Industry 4.0 is specifically designed to reduce costs by replacing people.

This does not mean that we should resist such technology like 19th Century Luddites, who destroyed weaving looms to save jobs.

Rather it means that we must anticipate the economic and social effects of such innovations, and provide a plan within the new investment policy to mitigate the worst effects.

In the language of the social market economy we must not privatise the profits and socialise the costs but combine a market-friendly

investment environment with social policies that establish both fair competition and social equity.

The government's new investment policy must recognise that left to its own devices a market-driven approach to high-tech investments may lead to the low-cost development model that they are trying to avoid.

They should adopt the idea of ordoliberalism, or ordered liberal markets, which emphasises the need for the state to create policies that ensure that the free market produces results as close to its theoretical potential as possible.

There must be a sense of social justice and solidarity so that the economic growth from high-tech investments facilitates poverty reduction and prevents widening income disparities to the disadvantage of certain sections of the population.

For this reason, the new investment policy must focus on high-value investment, not just high-tech investment, otherwise we will face a post-Covid environment of low-cost jobs, precarious employment and displaced workers with no real prospect of high-value, high-salary work.

**KJ denies claims state governments have to wait for months**

Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Khairy Jamaluddin denied claims that the Selangor state government had wanted for months to get the necessary approval to procure two million vaccine doses for its people.

In a statement today Khairy, who is also the coordinating minister for the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (NIP), said Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim did not verbally mention Selangor's plan to buy vaccines.

"I gave a positive response. However, until now, I have yet to receive any official application from the state government for such."

Khairy was responding to opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim who claimed that the Perak-based National NIP government was too busy trying out ways to control the NIP resulting in undue delays faced by the Selangor state government.

In the statement yesterday, Anwar claimed that Selangor also faced the same predicament in obtaining approval from the federal government.

As for Selangor, Khairy said several engagement sessions were held with Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Anwar Ibrahim Daggat Emran.

**RELATED ARTICLES**

- I have said that the federal government's supply is sufficient to meet the needs of NIP implementation in the east.
- Khairy said Daggat also applied for the state government to procure vaccines.
- I have given a positive response on the matter. However, the vaccine must be registered with the Health Ministry's National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency (NPRA).
- This, in the topic of vaccine required by the Selangor state government is still in the process of evaluation by the NPRA.
- Meanwhile, Anwar's demands for an independent investigation to be conducted in Parliament into the NIP and vaccine procurement, Khairy said he was always open to questioning, criticism, and investigation.
- "Once again, I would like to remind that I have fully disclosed several vaccine purchase contracts to the Parliament's Public Accounts Committee (PAC) on Jan 6, along with the delivery schedules and prices. Amongst the PAC members who attended and reviewed the vaccine procurement contract was Permatang Pauh MP Ahmad Anwar.
- I did not do an engagement session with the opposition MP on March 18, in which I promised at length the implementation of the NIP as well as answering various questions in detail.
- "The opposition leader (Anwar), however, was not present during the session."
- Khairy said he hoped that Anwar would follow the implementation of the NIP closely and subsequently give thoughtful criticisms for him to attend.
- The government launched the NIP on Feb 24. Under Phase 1, vaccines are being administered for free to medical and non-medical frontliners.
- The second phase of the NIP which started on Monday involves senior citizens aged 60 and above, high risk groups, and the disabled involving some 8.4 million people, while Phase 3 from May to February 2022 will cover both adolescents and pre-adolescents aged 18 and above, targeting more than 13.7 million people.

PUTRAJAYA, April 21 — Coordinating Minister for National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme Khairy Jamaluddin said always open to questions, criticisms and investigations over the implementation of the country's biggest vaccination programme.

Referring to Opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's demand that an independent investigation into the procurement of the vaccines be carried out under the auspices of Parliament, he said several purchase contracts had already been fully disclosed to the Parliament's Public Accounts Committee (PAC) on January 5.

"The delivery schedule and prices paid were also revealed," he said adding that among the PAC members who vetted through the vaccine procurement contract that day, was Permatang Pauh MP Nurul Izzah.

Khairy said an engagement session was also held with the opposition MPs on March 19, where he presented at length the implementation of the immunisation programme, but Anwar was not present at the session.

In a statement today Khairy said the claims that the Selangor state government had to wait a long time to get approval to procure the Covid-19 vaccine was not true as to date, he has not received any official application from the state government.

He said Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari had verbally mentioned Selangor's plan to procure the vaccine in their discussions.

"I responded positively, but till today there is no official letter from the state government," he said.

Anwar had among others claimed that the Selangor government "waited for months just to get the necessary approval to get two million vaccine doses for its people."

Commenting further on the allegation made by Anwar, the science, technology and innovation minister said he had several engagement sessions with Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Amar Douglas Unggah Embas where he had informed the federal government's supply was sufficient to meet the needs of the immunisation programme in Sarawak.

According to Khairy, Unggah had also applied for the state government to procure the vaccines and he had given a positive response on condition that the vaccine must be registered with the National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency (NPRA).

He said the type of vaccine the Sarawak government wanted had to be registered under the NPRA first as it is still in evaluation process.

Meanwhile Khairy said the immunisation programme is being implemented according to phases as announced on February 14, taking into account the delivery schedule given by the supplier companies.

"I had explained earlier that according to the government's projection our supply of vaccines should be stabilised from June onwards and this is in accordance with our planning where phase three has been scheduled to begin in June," he said. — Bernama

### Malaysia's investment policy reforms to be rooted in National Investment Aspirations, says Azmin

**KUALA LUMPUR, April 21** — The Cabinet has approved the National Investment Aspirations (NIA), a forward-looking growth framework that will outline the basis for Malaysia's investment policy reforms.

In a statement today, Senior Minister cum International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali said the NIA would be central to realising Malaysia's investment climate, attract high-quality investments into the country, create high-income jobs, particularly post-Covid.

"Moving forward, Malaysia must adopt a comprehensive approach to reinvigorating the investment ecosystem and respond adequately to emerging megatrends, as well as the evolving needs of our investors.

"Malaysia needs to rise to this challenge by continuously enhancing our unique value propositions which span across wide array of elements such as incentives, facilitator, talent, infrastructure, as well as legal, regulatory, procedural a institutional mechanisms," he said.

Mohamed Azmin said NIA at its core, would focus on coherence and cohesiveness, with these aspirations being reflective across all national policy documents and initiatives related to investment, including the Fourth Industrial Masterplan the 12th Malaysia Plan.

He said the five core parameters framing the NIA would be integral to enhance the nation's competitiveness and ensure that Malaysia remains a preferred investment destination.

"These aspirations would bear the foundation for Malaysia to become a regional investment hub, which would increase economic diversity and complexity through the development of sophisticated products and services, with high local research and development (R&D) as well as innovation.

"It would also create high skill jobs to provide better income for the rakyat, expand and integrate domestic linkages regional and global supply chains by improving their resiliency, as well as develop new and existing clusters focusing high productivity anchors, including local products and services while improving inclusivity to contribute towards the socio-economic developmental agenda," he said.

In order to enable further diversification and ventures into more complex industries, Mohamed Azmin said emphasis should also be accorded towards fostering a robust and dynamic tax and incentives regime, building a talent pool in collaboration with relevant industries, improving licensing and regulatory frameworks and augmenting facilitation elements such as Customs procedures.

The senior minister also said the NIA recognised the significant role of investment promotion strategies in attracting quality investments.

In this context, the NIA will guide policy and non-policy prescriptions that place a specific emphasis on more targeted relevant and effective investment promotion and facilitation strategies, he said.

"This is pivotal to ensure that investments in the identified priority sectors are able to flow into the country and lead positive economic spillover effects," said Mohamed Azmin.

In addition, he said the NIA would focus on inclusivity and sustainability that is compatible with the environmental, social and governance (ESG) goals, as new investments that are anchored upon these elements would propel growth in the technologically sophisticated sectors, as well as strengthen forward and backward linkages.

"In the long term, the NIA encourages sustained flow of quality investments in new and possibly complex growth areas to foster innovation and sophistication, create greater job opportunities and improve income prospects.

"It will also further build investors' and business confidence in Malaysia, as we continue to remain competitive and resilient as the epicentre for economic and business activities in the region," he added. — Bernama

**KUALA LUMPUR, April 21** — Hulu Kelang assemblyman Saari Sungb cautioned the Selangor government against rule with arrogance today, particularly in the proposal to degazette the Kuala Langat Utara Forest Reserve (HSKLU).

*Malaysiakini* reported the Amanah lawmaker as urging the Pakatan Harapan state government to take note of non-governmental organisations' allegations that the move would violate the rights of some state natives as well as irreparably harm local biodiversity.

"If the two allegations are true, the things that will happen will be even worse and worse" he said.

"It involves the imposition of an ironclad power policy and an arrogant attitude of not wanting to listen to the views of experts in areas that maintain political and administrative stability of the state," he was quoted as saying.

Saari also questioned why the proposal to degazette the forest reserve was made by the state executive council as a matter of such significance should have been presented to the state assembly.

He said the state assembly could be a check-and-balance mechanism as it was a venue with diverse views and expertise.

"As a member of the Selangor state assembly, I have asked for clarification from the MB (mentri besar) and the infrastructure and agriculture exco.

"I believe the principles of democracy are still upheld in the decision-making process," he said.

On February 5 last year, the Selangor Forestry Department unveiled the plan to degazette the forest reserve to make way for mixed development projects through announcements in several newspapers.

The proposal to demolish 931.17 hectares out of 957.63 hectares of HSKLU was submitted by the Selangor state government in early February 2020.

Since then, some NGOs and media outlets have reported that HSKLU was home to a generation of Orang Asli from the Temuan tribe, with a population of around 2,000 at present.

# Khairy slams Anwar's 'stonewalling' accusation

SCIENCE, Technology and Innovation Minister Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar yesterday rubbished accusations made by Opposition Leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim who said the federal government is stopping state governments from procuring their own vaccine supply.

On Tuesday, Anwar said both Selangor and Sarawak state governments are facing lengthy delays and "stonewalling" in their attempt to source their own vaccines.

He called for an investigation into these procurement bottlenecks that have been faced by the federal and state governments and the private sector.

Yesterday, Khairy, who is the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (NIP) Coordinating Minister also said the Selangor government's claim that it had been waiting for months to get the approval for the two million vaccines needed is not accurate.

"When I discussed with Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri

Amirudin Shari, he verbally mentioned the state's plans to purchase the vaccines.

"My reaction was a positive one, but until today, I have not received

any official request from him," he said in a statement yesterday.

He said in regards to the Sarawak government, discussions have been entered with Deputy Chief

Minister 1 Datuk Amar Douglas Uggah Embas with a reassurance that the vaccine supplies are enough.

"He requested for the state to purchase some supplies as well and I informed him that all vaccines must be registered with the National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency first.

"I am open to being questioned, investigated or critiqued. I would like to remind Anwar that all the purchase contracts of the vaccines have been shown to the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) on Jan 5, 2021, alongside the scheduled delivery and prices paid," he said.

On NIP, Khairy said the programme is moving forward according to its phases as previously mentioned on Feb 14, 2021.

He said the programme's planning took into consideration the delivery of the vaccines with its suppliers.

"I have explained the projection and timeline of NIP, we have enough vaccines to last until June 2021, which is when the third phase is also expected to begin," he said.

## 被盜身份開假賬號 梁德志議員吁民衆勿上當

(巴生21日讯)班达马兰州议员梁德志的身份遭人盗用，创建Instagram假账号，并向加入的追随者索取电话号码，意图不明。

梁德志今天在脸书贴文揭发此事时，促请民众不要上当给资料，否则恐会跌入骗局。

“这是我首次遭人盗用身份，相信是纯属骗局，不存在政治阴谋。”

他指出，他的友人收到一个以其英文名字账号发出的讯息，向友人索取电话号码，但友人感到疑惑，致电给他了解状况，才揭发有人盗用他的身份。

“由于假账号盗用我的照片为人头像，相信让一些人信以为真，才会追随假账号，目前已有36个追随者。”

梁德志说，实际上他的IG账号追随者大约有400人。

他透露，由于假账号涉嫌向追随者索取电话号码，因此他不排除对方有所意图，所以在脸书上贴文，提醒大家不要相信此账号，也呼吁大众不要轻易泄露个人资料。

他也不排除假账号已向多人使用同样

的“招数”。

另一方面，梁德志说，若有人通过社交平台私讯，凡要讨电话、钱、个人资料、链接、密码、代码等，即便对方是家人或好友，最好能亲自致电给对方，以辨认真伪。

“在这科技发达的时代，恐怕只要有一组电话号码，就能骇入各种社交平台，进行诈骗或其他违例的行为。”

他举例，班达马兰新村管委会主席柯金胜的夫人，其脸书就曾遭人骇入，结果朋友被骗走了1000令吉，所以他呼吁大众不要随便给别人资料。(TSI)

# 3天前生病仍如常到校上課 中學生傳染3共餐同學齊確診

■雪州万挠斯里卡令国中的累计确诊学生人数已增至5人。

(万挠21日讯) 一名就读雪州万挠斯里卡令国中 (SMK SERI GARING) 的中学生于3天前出现不适后, 接下来3天仍如常到学校上课, 结果, 这名学生周三证实确诊冠病后, 另外3名曾与他一起用餐的学生也相继确诊。



万挠区州议员蔡伟杰披露, 截至目前为止, 该校已累计5位学生确诊冠病。

“据悉, 在5位确诊学生当中, 其中一人是于本月17日确诊, 周三再有另4名学生确诊。”

他致电向校长查询后也获证实, 该校周三确有4名中学生确诊。

他说, 校方已于下午向县教育局和县卫生局呈报, 目前正等待教育局和卫生局发出最新指示, 包括是否关闭相关班级, 或让全校停课。

“在最新确诊的4位学生当中, 其中一人是于3天前开始出现不舒服的症状, 但他接下来3天仍天天到校上课, 并在学校和同学一起用餐。”

他披露, 随着这名学生的检测结果呈阳性反应, 7名曾和他一起用餐的学生也前往接受检测, 结果, 目前已知有其中3人确诊, 另外4人的检测报告还未出炉。

“这所中学有2000多名学生, 万挠州选区也有许多学校的学生人数是超过千人的, 若冠病毒在学校蔓延的话, 后果不堪设想。”

因此, 他呼吁教育部及卫生部, 在学校有学生确诊后, 应更果断和快速的发出指示予校方, 或下放权力给学校, 让学校在有学生确诊后可即时采取应对措施, 无须再耗时等候县教育局和县卫生局的指示。

“我也对教务人员的处境深表同情, 在未获得县教育局或县卫生局指示之前, 校方不能擅自决定关闭班级或学校, 也没有权力作出决定, 但却得面对家长的指责和压力。”

他说, 家长也有权评估是否让孩子到学校上课, 但家长和学生也要负起责任, 尤其是家里有家人、亲人确诊或是孩子出现不适、生病的情况时, 家长最好勿把孩子送到学校上课, 而应直接把孩子送往医院检查, 避免把问题带来学校, 以致其他学生和教师都面对感染病毒的风险。

### 料明天完成

傻傻然艺术协会会长黄美向记者表示，由于少女壁画风波一事越演越烈，引起了许多不必要的误解，所以他与负责作画的两位巫裔艺术家，昨

日就赶快向警方和瓜雪县议会官员解释，而当局听取解释后，给予认可和接受。

他说，艺术家目前已继续作画，预料周五就能完成壁画创作，惟完工后会再给予当局过目，但相信不会有问题。

### 误解形态构图

他强调，艺术家并没有以裸女图为壁画，只是在作画时，一般上都必须先构图，把形态画出来，再一层层把颜料补上去，画作才算完成，但遗憾还未完工的壁画，却被有心人扭曲。

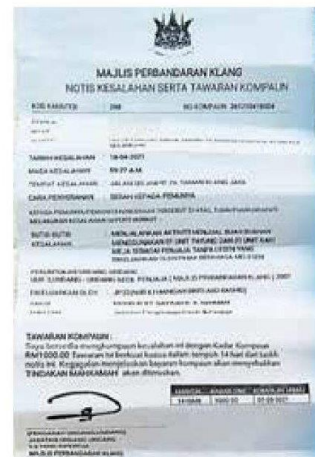

## 無牌小販提心吊膽擺檔 葉金發吁當局速批執照

(巴生21日讯) 自冠病疫情在大马爆发后，就有不少人失业，被迫转行或投入当小贩，因此就有不少小贩到巴生良木园早市和其他早夜市摆摊，但这些本地无牌小贩申请合法化毫无下文，还频频遭到取缔和罚款，甚至档口货品还被充公，让他们损失惨重，欲哭无泪。

对此，巴生市区流动小贩公会主席叶金发呼吁巴生市议会，应批准执照给当地的本地无牌小贩，好让这些无牌小贩能安心摆摊，至少还能赚取微薄收入，渡过疫情难关。

他说，许多国人因受到疫情的打击，才会选择当小贩，至少能赚一点收入，帮补家计。

### 屡遭罚款货品被充公

“就以良木园早市为例，如今每个周末大约有40多档，惟估计合法的约20多档，其余的就无牌摆摊。尽管小贩摆摊并没有造成阻碍，但他们却遭到市议会警告。”

叶金发说，他了解到许多小贩的苦衷，所以于上个月以公会的名义，就协助数个早夜市大约250名小贩向巴生市议会申请执照，不过至

今没下文。

他披露，小贩等不到执照，但却换来遭到执法组取缔，仅在良木园早市，就有大约10个小贩接获罚单，都是1000令吉的罚单，而且档口和货品也被充公。1000令吉对于小贩已经是很多天的收入，一旦被开罚，小贩都无力偿还。

他说，在这疫情艰困时刻，小贩们只想赚取糊口，但无奈申请执照无下文，摆摊时被迫“鬼鬼祟祟”，避免被取缔。

他指出，他曾向当地市议员反映此事，惟一样没有进展，希望今次新闻见报后，能获得市议会和州政府的关注，帮帮这些小贩。(TSI)

## 市會至少可批臨時執照

叶金发透露，有些小贩申请执照已经超过好几个月，甚至1年时间，但始终得不到市议会的回复或批准，还一直面对取缔的风险。

他认为，市议会无论批准或否决，应该给小贩一合理的回复，而不是让这些无牌小贩“痴痴地等”。

他强调，面对疫情的打击，这些小贩都很惨了，市议会至少可以临时执照给他们，协助他们度过疫情难关。

此外，叶金发说，公会并不是要助长非法小贩的风气，公会只帮助符合资格的本地无牌小贩申请执照，对于那些聘请外劳或转租给外劳的档口，公会绝对不会给予帮助。

他也呼吁小贩要严格遵守防疫标准作业程序，否则被市议会取缔或开罚，公会也帮不到小贩。(TSI)

他说，针对安华指雪州政府用了数月时间，等待中央政府批准为雪州人民取得 200 万剂疫苗的指控并不正确，因为他曾与雪州大臣进行讨论，而大臣也口头上说明了雪州购买疫苗的计划。

“我给予正面的回应。但是截至目前，我还没有获得来自雪州政府的正式申请。”

至于砂拉越政府方面，他已与砂拉越副首长拿督阿玛道格拉斯进行多次的沟通，并告知阿玛道格拉斯中央政府的疫苗，足够应付砂拉越的疫苗接种计划。

“阿玛道格拉斯也要求让州政府购买疫苗，我也给予正面回应，但州政府购买疫苗的公

司必须得到国家药剂监管局 (NPRA) 注册，因为砂州政府欲购买的疫苗还未经过药剂监管局的评估。”

凯里今日 (21 日) 发表文告说，针对安华建议透过国会针对疫苗接种计划及购买疫苗进度进行监督，本身一直都开放询问、批评及调查。

“我要再次提醒国会反对党领袖，我已经在今年 1 月 5 日，向国会公共账目委员会 (PAC) 公开了几分购买疫苗的合约，同时附上运送日期及价格。当天出席会议者包括公正党峇东埔国会议员努鲁依莎。”

他说，自己也曾在 3 月 19 日针对疫苗接种计划，向国会议员进行汇报，同时回答国会议员的问题，但安华当时缺席汇报会。#
