Pembangunan semula flat PPR usang dikaji

Inisiatif atasi masalah kos baiki kerosakan struktur bangunan

Ampang: Kementerian Perumahan dan Kerajaan Tempatan (KPKT) sedang mengkaji keperluan untuk melaksanakan pembangunan semula di flat Projek Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) yang usang.

Menterinya, Zuraida Kamaruddin, berkata kementerian dan kerajaan Selangor akan duduk semeja bagi memperincikan mengenai hal itu.

Beliau berkata, tindakan itu bagi menangani permasalahan kos membaiki kerosakan kerap kali berlaku pada struktur bangunan berkenaan.

"Ada banyak rumah yang rosak bukan sahaja di PPA1M (Projek Perumahan Awam 1 Malaysia). Jadi kita sedang melihat dan mengkaji rumah yang berusia 30 dan 40 tahun, terutama di Selangor."

"Kami akan berbincang dengan kerajaan negeri untuk membuat pembangunan semula kerana jika membaiki bumbung, lif dan kecocoran...ia tidak *economical* kerana harga jauh lebih mahal."

"Lebih baik kita buat pembinaan yang baharu. Ini dalam perancangan. Kita susun jadual

ataupun memuktamadkan model itu," katanya pada sidang media selepas majlis penyerahan pelitup muka di Sekolah Kebangsaan Ampang di sini, semalam.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika mengulas mengenai kerosakan yang berlaku di PPA1M.

Mengulas lanjut, Zuraida berkata model pembangunan semula itu sudah mula dilaksanakan di beberapa perumahan antaranya di Flat PPR Colombia Keramat dan Pandan.

Dalam perkembangan lain, KPKT mengesahkan proses pengambilalihan tanah kondominium Highland Towers berada pada peringkat akhir.

Zuraida berkata, kementerian sedang menunggu kelulusan peruntukan berjumlah RM8.9 juta bertujuan membayar kos pengambilalihan tanah di Highland Towers daripada kerajaan negeri.

"Sekarang kita dalam proses pengambilalihan tanah. Jadi KPKT harus membelanjakan RM8.9 juta untuk pengambilalihan tanah sebagai tanah PTP (Perusuhjaya Tanah Persekutuan) dan kemudian tanah yang ada tiga blok itu akan jadi hak kerajaan Persekutuan."

"Saya tengah tunggu proses. Sebaik sahaja wang diluluskan, proses akan berjalan dan boleh robohkan blok dan selepas itu pembangunan boleh bermula."

"Proses pengambilalihan tanah sudah diputuskan. Saya harap kita dapat robohkan struktur blok di Highland Towers pada hujung tahun ini," katanya.

Mengenai pelan asal ia merangkumi pembinaan taman rekreasi



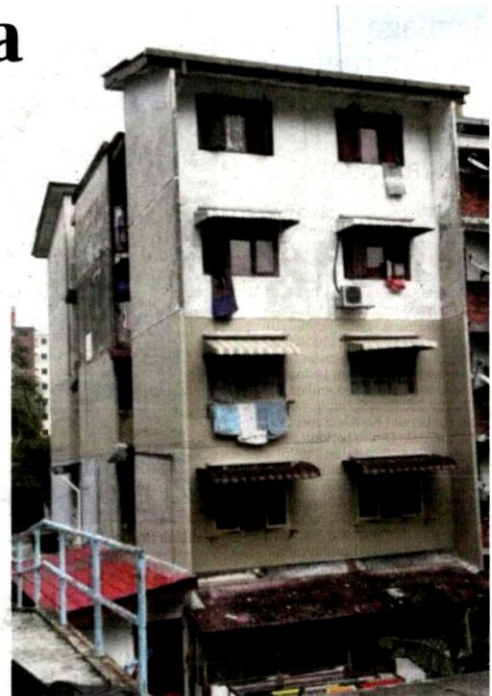

di tanah berkenaan yang akan dikekalkan.

Katanya, pihaknya sudah beberapa kali melalui program libat urus bertujuan bertemu dengan pemilik asal untuk membincangkan mengenai pengambilalihan tanah itu.

"Saya sudah bertemu beberapa kali dengan mereka dalam sesi libat urus pada 2019. Kita dapat selesaikan dengan Jabatan Insol-

vensi, bank dan kerajaan negeri.

"Kerjanya agak rumit. Alhamdulillah, semua sudah selesai. Saya harap kita dapat robohkan blok berkenaan."

"Kita akan kekal dengan rancangan asal. Di situ kita akan bina taman rekreasi. Kita tidak akan bina bangunan," katanya.

Pada Ogos 2018, Zuraida pernah mencadangkan tapak Highland Towers dibangunkan semula

la sebagai lokasi taman rekreasi.

Cadangan itu dibuat memandangkan struktur tanah di kawasan terbabit tidak sesuai untuk pembinaan perumahan.

Pada 11 Disember 1993, satu daripada tiga blok Kondominium Highland Towers di Taman Hillview Ulu Klang runtuh dalam tragedi yang meragut nyawa 48 orang.

'Rasul Melayu' kembali aktif sebar ajaran sesat ditahan

Shah Alam: Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) menahan 'Rasul Melayu' yang kembali aktif menyebarkan ajaran diharamkan pada 1991 bersama 16 pengikutnya, di tiga lokasi berbeza di sini, malam kelmarin.

Pengarahnya, Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad, berkata 'Rasul Melayu' atau nama sebenarnya Abdul Kahar Ahmad ditahan di sebuah rumah di Kemensah, Ulu Klang selepas empat tahun dibebaskan.

"Dia bersama 16 pengikut, iaitu sembilan lelaki dan lapan wanita berusia antara 14 hingga 70 tahun, ditahan di tiga rumah di Kemensah, Ulu Klang, Sungai Long dan Keramat.

"Dia dipercayai mengamalkan Ajaran Haji Kahar Bin Ahmad yang difatwakan sesat, pada 28

Mac 1991 dan diwartakan pada 29 Ogos 1991 oleh Majlis Fatwa Negeri Selangor," katanya pada sidang media selepas majlis Mesra Media 2020, di sini, semalam.

Melalui risikan dan maklumat awam yang diterima JAIS, katanya, ajaran itu dipercayai kembali aktif menggunakan modus operandi baharu dan berinteraksi dengan pengikutnya menerusi kumpulan sembang WhatsApp dan Facebook.

"Susulan penangkapan 17 individu ini, JAIS sedang mengesan 80 lagi ahli ajaran sesat itu berdasarkan penyertaan mereka mereka dalam kumpulan WhatsApp," katanya.

Beliau berkata, mereka disiasat mengikut Seksyen 7, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Doktrin Palsu); Seksyen 8, Enak-

men Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Dakwaan Palsu) dan Seksyen 12(c), Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Menghina Pihak Berkuasa Agama).

Selain itu semua mereka turut disiasat mengikut Seksyen 13, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Pendapat yang Bertentangan Dengan Fatwa); Seksyen 16, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Penerbitan Agama yang Bertentangan Dengan Hukum Syarak) dan Seksyen 52, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Percubaan).

Pada Oktober 2009, Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah memerintahkan Abdul Kahar dipenjara 10 tahun, denda RM16,500 dan enam sebatan bersabit kes penyebaran ajaran sesat sebelum dibebaskan pada Mei 2016.

Empat universiti bantu pulih Sungai Kim Kim

Usaha jadikan kawasan pusat rekreasi masyarakat

Johor Bahru: Empat universiti akan bekerjasama untuk menjayakan proses rehabilitasi Sungai Kim Kim di Pasir Gudang melalui beberapa inisiatif yang dijangka dilaksanakan pada November depan.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Kesihatan dan Alam Sekitar Johor, R Vidyananthan, berkata universiti terbabit ialah Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM), Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM), Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia (USIM) dan Universiti Teknikal Malaysia Melaka (UTeM).

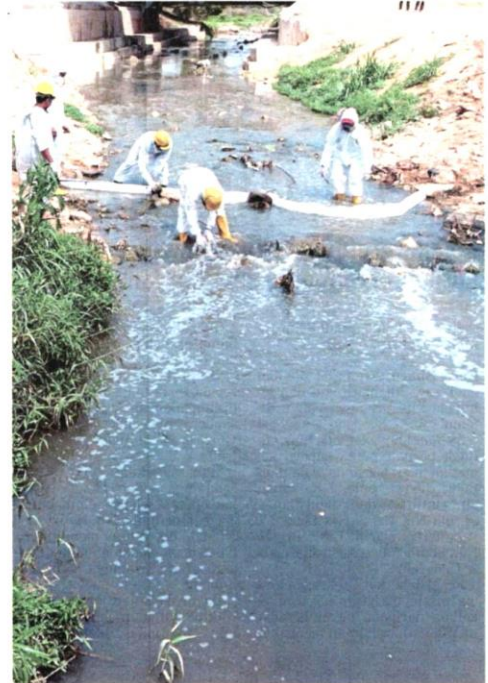
Beliau berkata, usaha itu sejajar dengan penekanan kerajaan negeri bawah pimpinan Menteri Besar, Datuk Hasni Mohammad, yang memandang serius isu berkenaan.

"Setiap universiti terbabit ada memberi input mengenai Sungai Kim Kim. Kita bukan saja mahu ia

bersih tanpa pencemaran tetapi juga mengubah kawasan itu menjadi pusat rekreasi untuk kegunaan masyarakat.

"Ia akan membabitkan landskap yang mesra masyarakat dan tidak nampak seperti kawasan perindustrian," katanya pada sidang media selepas program Syarahan Perdana Profesor di Dewan Sultan Iskandar UTM, di sini, semalam.

Menjelaskan lanjut, Vidyananthan berkata, hasil kajian mahupun input daripada universiti sudahpun dibawa kepada perhatian Menteri Besar Johor, selain penganjuran beberapa siri taklimat.

Beliau berkata, usaha itu turut membabitkan kerjasama Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS), Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran Malaysia (JPS) serta Unit Perancang Ekonomi Negeri (UPEN).

"Bagi mengelakkan insiden pencemaran Sungai Kim Kim daripada berulang, kerajaan negeri dengan kerjasama JAS akan membuat pemeriksaan dan pemantauan secara berkala terhadap kawasan perindustrian di sekitar sungai itu," katanya.

Vidyananthan berkata, peruntukan bagi usaha memulihkan Sungai Kim Kim itu diharap akan dimasukkan ke dalam Belanja Negeri 2021.

Selangor pindah kilang berisiko cemar sungai

Klang: Semua kilang di Selangor yang berada dalam kawasan berisiko tinggi atau berpotensi mencemarkan sungai, akan dipindahkan ke lokasi lebih sesuai.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Tetap Kerajaan Tempatan, Pengangkutan Awam dan Pembangunan Kampung Baru negeri, Ng Sze Han, berkata kilang berlesen juga berpotensi mencemarkan sungai sekiranya tidak mematuhi syarat ditetapkan pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) dan Jabatan Alam

Sekitar (JAS).

“Jika terletak di kawasan rizab sungai, sudah tentu kilang terbabit perlu berpindah. Bukan kilang haram saja boleh mencemarkan sungai, ini kita perlu jelas.

“Kita akan melihat perkara ini secara menyeluruh. Kilang berisiko perlu berpindah ke satu lokasi yang sesuai dengan mematuhi syarat, terutama berhubung alam sekitar,” katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian pada sidang media selepas Majlis Tak-

limat Program Pematuhan Syarat dan Penguatkuasaan Kilang Tanpa Kebenaran di Selangor di Majlis Perbandaran Klang (MPK), di sini, semalam.

Justeru, Sze Han berkata, kerajaan negeri akan menubuhkan jawatankuasa khas bagi menangani isu berkenaan, dengan fungsi utama melihat permasalahan kilang berisiko mencemarkan sungai.

Bagaimanapun, katanya, jumlah keseluruhan kilang yang berisiko itu belum dikenal pasti.

Mengulas isu pemutihan kilang haram di Klang pula, beliau difahamkan ada 1,127 kilang tidak berlesen di daerah ini tetapi hanya 395 yang membuat pemutihan.

“Sebanyak 732 kilang belum menyerahkan dokumen kepada Pejabat Tanah Daerah untuk penentuan status tanah daripada perantaraan kepada industri. Malah, ada yang belum mengemukakan rancangan bangunan untuk menghalalkan struktur,” katanya.

Tanjung Karang: Berkat kesabaran menetap dan menjaga kedua ibu bapa yang uzur selama tiga tahun membawa kegembiraan kepada seorang peniaga makanan, Juliyah Mohd Ishak, 49, apabila menerima bantuan bina rumah Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS), semalam.

Juliyah yang juga ibu kepada 11 anak berusia 11 hingga 31 tahun berkata, dia tidak menyangka akan mendapat bantuan itu dan bersyukur permohonannya diterima LZS.

"Sebelum ini, saya menyewa di Parit 2, Sungai Burong. Namun, disebabkan mak ayah semakin uzur terutama ayah yang lumpuh dan buta kedua-dua mata, saya mengambil keputusan untuk menetap bersama mereka.

"Apa yang saya terkilan, ayah tidak sempat duduk di rumah baharu ini kerana meninggal dunia ketika malam Aidiladha lalu," katanya ketika ditemui *BH* di Lorong 13, Parit 1, Kampung Sungai Sireh, di sini.

Juliyah antara 10 keluarga asnaf fakir dan miskin bagi daerah Kuala Selangor yang menerima bantuan bina rumah oleh LZS dengan jumlah keseluruhan RM 882,815.

Majlis disempurnakan Pengerusi LZS, Tan Sri Syed Anwar Jamalullail.

Yang turut hadir, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif LZS, Saipolyazan Mat Yusop.

Juliyah berkata, dia bersana suami, Wahid Alib, 59 dan anak bongsu mereka berusia 11 tahun

bercadang membawa ibunya, Suliah Kasan, 86 untuk tinggal bersama mereka.

Dalam pada itu, Saipolyazan berkata, pihaknya membina 2,281 rumah asnaf fakir dan miskin serta muafak dengan nilai keseluruhan berjumlah RM 99.8 juta sejak 2010.

Beliau berkata, kos pembinaan untuk sebuah rumah bernilai di antara RM90,000 hingga RM 93,000 mengikut keadaan tanah.

"Nilai ini termasuk kos tambahan untuk kerja pembersihan dan pemuliharaan tapak sebelum pembinaan rumah dapat dimulakan," katanya.

Kata Saipolyazan, proses baik pulih pula membabitkan sejumlah 3457 rumah asnaf dengan jumlah keseluruhan RM54 juta.

Lelaki dakwa 'Rasul Melayu' ditahan lagi

SHAH ALAM: Empat tahun lalu, lelaki yang mengaku dirinya 'Rasul Melayu' dibebaskan selepas mengisytihar telah bertaubat menyebarkan ajaran sesat.

Bagaimanapun, Abdul Kahar Ahmad, 70, nampaknya tidak serik apabila mengaktifkan semula ajaran salahnya menerusi media sosial Facebook dan aplikasi WhatsApp.

Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS), Mohd. Shahzihan Ahmad berkata, Abdul Kahar Ahmad, 70, ditahan di Kemensah, Hulu Kelang manakala 16 lagi pengikutnya ditahan dalam serbuan di Sungai Long, Kajang dan Keramat di Kuala Lumpur kelmarin.

Kesemua yang ditahan terdiri sembilan lelaki dan lapan wanita berusia 14 hingga 70 tahun.

Menurutnya, pihaknya melakukan risikan selama dua bulan berdasarkan maklumat orang awam.

"Dalam serbuan tersebut kita rampas barangan seperti buku, telefon bimbit, komputer riba, al-Quran terjemahan dan risalah berkaitan ajaran itu," katanya selepas menghadiri majlis Mesra Media 2020 di sini semalam.

Mohd. Shahzihan berkata, pihaknya juga akan mengesan pengikut Rasul Melayu yang dianggarkan seramai 97 ahli.

Ajaran Abdul Kahar difatwakan sesat pada 28 Mac 1991 dan diwartakan pada 29 Ogos 1991 oleh Majlis Fatwa Negeri Selangor.

"Setakat ini, kita mengenal pasti 17 lagi ajaran sesat baharu yang aktif. JAIS tidak akan teragak-agak untuk mengambil tindakan terhadap penganut ajaran sesat," ujarnya.

Tambahnya, kesemua tang-

kan itu disiasat mengikut Seksyen 7 Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor)1995 (Doktrin Palsu), Seksyen 8,Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Dakwaan Palsu), Seksyen 12(c), Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor)1995 (Menghina Pihak Berkuasa Agama).

"Mereka turut didakwa mengikut Seksyen 13, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor)1995 (Pendapat yang Bertentangan Dengan Fatwa), Seksyen 16, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor)1995 (Penerbitan Agama yang Bertentangan Dengan Hukum Syarak) dan Seksyen 52, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Percubaan)," katanya.

Pada Oktober 2009, Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah memerintahkan Abdul Kahar dipenjarakan 10 tahun, denda RM16,500 dan enam sebatan bersabit kes penyebaran ajaran sesat.

TMJ dedah 'cerita dalam kain' FAS

KUALA LUMPUR: Selangor bukan saja ditimpa kekalahan memalukan 6-1 kepada Johor Darul Ta'zim (JDT) tetapi sebaliknya keputusan itu turut membuka cerita 'dalam kain' pengurusan Persatuan Bola Sepak Selangor (FAS).

Pemilik JDT, Tunku Ismail Sultan Ibrahim mendedahkan masalah dalaman yang dihadapi pengurusan baharu FAS sehingga membawa kerosakan kepada pasukan *Red Giants*.

"Pesanan ikhlas saya kepada pengurusan baharu FAS buat kerja dan fokus kepada pasukan sendiri. Takda nak sibuk bandingkan diri dengan JDT atau anggap dah setanding JDT. Dalam padang lawan, luar padang hormat antara satu sama lain."

"Takda nak provokasi sini sana macam dah menang sesuatu sedangkan belum menang piala apa-apa dan stadium pun tak ada."

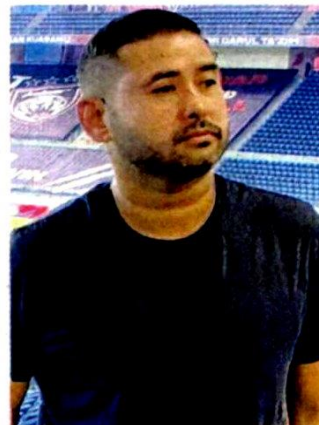

Katanya, ada pihak pengurusan berlagak seperti jurulatih menyebabkan pemain hilang semangat untuk bermain.

"Cerita kepada penyokong kenapa pemain hilang semangat kerana ramai orang pengurusan nak jadi jurulatih."

"Bilik persalinan hancur pasal ramai sangat nak campur tangan cerita kepada pemain siapa kekal dan siapa keluar."

Abdul Kahar ditahan bersama pengikut sebar ajaran sesat melalui kumpulan WhatsApp

'Rasul Melayu' yang kembali aktif menyebarkan ajaran diharamkan pada 1991 ditahan bersama 16 pengikutnya oleh Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) di tiga lokasi berbeza, malam kelmarin.

Pengarah Jais, Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad berkata, Rasul Melayu atau nama sebenarnya Abdul Kahar Ahmad kembali ditahan di sebuah rumah di Kemensah, Ulu Klang selepas empat tahun dibebaskan.

"Dia bersama 16 pengikutnya yang berumur antara 14 hingga 70 tahun ditahan di tiga rumah di Kemensah di Ulu Klang, Sungai Long, Kajang dan Keramat, Kuala Lumpur dalam Operasi Khas Penguatkuasaan Jais ke atas kumpulan itu.

"Penahanan itu susulan risikan dan maklumat orang awam yang banyak membantu sejak beberapa bulan lalu sehingga Jais berjaya menahannya malam tadi (kelmarin).

"Dia dipercayai mengamalkan Ajaran Haji Kahar bin Ahmad yang difatwakan sesat pada 28 Mac 1991 dan diwartakan pada 29 Ogos 1991 oleh Majlis Fatwa Negeri Selangor," katanya pada sidang media di Majlis Mesra Media 2020 di SACC di sini, semalam.

Mohd Shahzihan berkata, melalui risikan dan maklu-

mat awam yang diterima oleh Jais, ajaran berkenaan dipercayai kembali aktif dengan modus operandi (MO) baharu.

"MO mereka ialah berinteraksi dengan pengikut di seluruh negara, ada kumpulan WhatsApp dan kumpulan Facebook, aktif beri pandangan dan sebarakan ajarannya," katanya.

Beliau berkata, mereka disiasat mengikut Seksyen 7, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Doktrin Palsu), Seksyen 8, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Dakwaan Palsu) dan Seksyen 12(c), Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Menghina Pihak Berkuasa Agama).

"Mereka juga disiasat mengikut Seksyen 13, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Pendapat yang Bertentangan Dengan Fatwa), Seksyen 16, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Penerbitan Agama Yang Bertentangan Dengan Hukum Syarak) dan Seksyen 52, Enakmen Jenayah Syariah (Selangor) 1995 (Percubaan).

"Dalam operasi itu, Jais turut menyita buku, telefon bimbit, komputer riba, al-Quran terjemahan dan risalah berkaitan ajaran," katanya.

Menurutnya, mereka yang ditahan membabitkan sembilan lelaki dan lapan wanita dibawa ke Ibu Pejabat Jais

untuk siasatan lanjut.

"Dalam group WhatsApp itu, ada 97 orang, yang ditahan 17, jadi Jais sedang mengesan saki-baki ahli kumpulan ajaran sesat ini.

"Jais juga sedang menyasat, memperhalusi dan memperincikan 17 lagi kumpulan ajaran sesat termasuk beberapa ajaran sesat yang baharu," katanya.

Pada Oktober 2009, Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah memerintahkan Abdul Kahar dipenjara 10 tahun, didenda RM16,500 dan enam sebatan bersabit kes penyebaran ajaran sesat sebelum dia dibebaskan pada Mei 2016.

Antara penyelewengan ajarannya ialah mendakwa Tuhan melantiknya menjadi Rasul Melayu menerusi surah Yasin, sembahyang lima waktu adalah tidak wajib, tidak percaya al-Quran yang ada sekarang sebagai al-Quran sebenar dan orang Islam tidak perlu mengerjakan haji ke Makkah sebaliknya ibadah haji boleh dilakukan di mana-mana sahaja.

Klang: Status kilang haram dan kilang berlesen di Selangor yang berada di kawasan berisiko tinggi atau berkemungkinan untuk mencemarkan sungai tidak akan diputihkan.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Tetap Kerajaan Tempatan, Pengangkutan Awam dan Pembangunan Kampung Baru negeri, Ng Sze Han berkata, semua kilang itu perlu berpindah ke tempat lain yang lebih sesuai.

"Kalau kilang itu terletak di rizab sungai, sudah tentu kilang itu kena pindah, malah bukan kilang tanpa kebenaran sahaja boleh mencemarkan sungai, ini kita perlu jelas.

"Kilang berlesen juga ada kemungkinan mencemarkan sungai sekiranya mereka tidak mematuhi syarat

ditetapkan pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) dan Jabatan Alam Sekitar (Jas).

"Jadi kami akan melihat perkara ini secara menyeluruh, kilang berisiko, itu tidak sesuai, kena pindah ke satu lokasi sesuai dengan mematuhi syarat khususnya alam sekitar," katanya dalam sidang media selepas hadir Majlis Taklimat Program Pematuhan Syarat dan Penguatkuasaan Kilang Tanpa Kebenaran di Selangor di Majlis Perbandaran Klang, di sini, semalam.

Menurutnya, kerajaan negeri akan menubuhkan satu jawatankuasa khas untuk melihat isu itu bagi mengelak pencemaran sungai

berlaku pada masa depan.

"Fungsi utama jawatankuasa khas ini adalah melihat masalah membabitkan kilang di tepi sungai di mana kilang yang perlu dipindah, kena pindah, yang tanpa kebenaran atau haram itu kena roboh.

"Kalau kilang itu sah, ada sijil layak menduduki, ada lesen, tetapi berisiko tinggi, kerajaan negeri akan fikirkan satu cara untuk mereka berpindah ke kawasan sesuai," katanya.

Bagaimanapun, Ng berkata, jumlah keseluruhan kilang yang berisiko itu belum dikenal pasti.

Mengenai pemutihan kilang haram di Klang, katanya, beliau difahamkan 1,127

kilang tidak berlesen di daerah itu, tetapi hanya 395 kilang membuat pemutihan.

"Sebanyak 732 kilang belum menyerahkan dokumen ke Pejabat Tanah Daerah untuk penukaran tanah dari pertanian ke industri, malah ada yang belum mengemukakan rancangan bangunan untuk menghalalkan struktur," katanya.

Dalam pada itu, katanya, pemutihan kilang tidak berlesen sepatutnya berakhir pada 30 September ini, tetapi kerajaan negeri memanjangkan tempoh itu selama tiga bulan lagi hingga 31 Disember ini.

"Ini peluang terakhir diberikan kepada kilang tidak berlesen untuk membuat pemutihan operasi kilang mereka mulai sekarang hingga Disember ini," katanya.

Sebanyak 732 kilang belum serah dokumen ke Pejabat Tanah Daerah

Juliyah berkata, dia bersama suami, Wahid Alib, 59, dan anak bongsu mereka berusia 11 tahun bercadang membawa ibunya, Suliah Kasan, 86, untuk tinggal bersama mereka.

Sementara itu, Saipolyazan berkata, pihaknya membina 2,281 rumah asnaf fakir dan miskin serta muafal dengan nilai keseluruhan berjumlah RM99.8 juta sejak 2010.

SHAH ALAM – Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) berjaya meringkuk cubaan seorang lelaki yang juga ketua ajaran sesat selepas didakwa mahu menghidupkan semula fahaman 'Rasul Melayu' yang dikesan kembali aktif sejak April lalu.

Dalam operasi bermula pukul 9 malam kelmarin, pihak berkuasa menahan lelaki berusia 70 tahun itu yang bertindak sebagai ketua 'Rasul Melayu' bersama 16 pengikutnya terdiri daripada lapan lelaki dan lapan perempuan yang berusia 14 hingga 70 tahun.

Kemera mereka ditangkap dalam serbuan di tiga lokasi berasingan di Kemensah, Hulu Klang, Sungai Lene, Kajang dan Keramat, Kuala Lumpur.

Pengarah JAIS, Mohd. Shabzhan Ahmad berkata, risiko yang dibuat paskawanya mendapati fahaman ajaran itu disebarkan dalam kalangan pengikut seramai 97 orang menerusi pembentukan kumpulan aplikasi laman sosial Facebook dan WhatsApp.

"Sebagai serbuan dilakukan di sebuah rumah di Kemensah, kita mendapati lelaki tersebut sedang bertingkah dan bermesyuarat bersama pengikutnya.

"Dalam operasi itu, kita telah menyita beberapa buku, telefon bimbit, komputer riba, al-Quran terjemahan dan risalah berkaitan ajaran tersebut."

Susulan tindakan yang dilakukan lelaki tersebut, dia telah ditangkap dan didakwa sebelum dipergara selama 10 tahun bersabit kes penyebaran ajaran sesat oleh Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah pada Oktober 2006.

Rapinamapan, pada 16 Mei 2016, lelaki tersebut telah dibebaskan dengan parole dan mengaitkannya dirinya bertepatan.

Mengulas lanjut, Mohd. Shabzhan mengatakan kesesama tanggapan yang dibuat kelmarin akan disiasat mengikut Seksyen

Gaji, elaun rakyat jangan disentuh

ISU pemotongan gaji atau elaun sememangnya sensitif bagi rakyat Malaysia. Isu ini boleh mendatangkan kemarahan kerana tiada sesiapa pun suka duit mereka dikurangkan.

Baru-baru ini, elaun nazir, siak, bilal dan petugas masjid serta surau di seluruh Selangor pun dikurangkan.

Ramai pihak di luar sana tidak setuju dengan pemotongan elaun itu yang dianggap hampir 50 peratus, tidak sepadan dengan status Selangor yang merupakan sebuah negeri yang kaya.

Dakwa pihak tertentu, sewajarnya elaun itu ditambah lagi atau sekurang-kurangnya dikekalkan. Ia mengambil kira kepentingan petugas masjid atau surau yang melancarkan pengurusan institusi agama Islam serta khidmat mereka kepada ahli kariah.

Berdasarkan laporan *Kosmo!* minggu lalu, jumlah elaun bulanan yang diberikan kepada petugas masjid dan surau sebanyak RM1,430 terpaksa dikurangkan kepada RM880 bagi memberi keutamaan kepada golongan asnaf yang lebih memerlukan di negeri itu.

Ia berikutan kutipan zakat di Selangor menurun sehingga 31 peratus iaitu sebanyak RM44.9 juta pada Mac tahun ini berbanding RM65.7 juta dalam tempoh sama tahun lalu.

Puncanya kerana kekangan kewangan yang dihadapi pembayar zakat susulan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) bagi membendung penularan Covid-19 sejak Mac lalu.

Bagaimanapun, isu itu akhirnya selesai apabila Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari bersetuju untuk mengembalikan semula elaun tersebut kepada kadar asal, iaitu RM1,430.

Ternyata, bukan senang kerajaan untuk memotong gaji atau elaun rakyat, namun jika gaji menteri dipotong, ia dianggap wajar dilakukan terhadap pemimpin negara yang berpendapatan besar.

Gaji menteri pernah dipotong selama dua bulan pada Mac lalu untuk disalurkan ke Tabung Covid-19 bagi membantu golongan yang terkesan dengan virus itu.

Pada Mei 2018 pula, gaji asas menteri pernah dipotong sebanyak 10 peratus bagi menunjukkan prihatin terhadap masalah kewangan negara.

Pemotongan gaji menteri disambut amat baik, tetapi jangan sekali menyentuh gaji atau elaun rakyat waima jika di peringkat cadangan sahaja.

April lalu, seorang usahawan terkenal mencadangkan gaji penjawat awam dipotong berikutan krisis Covid-19 dan penjimatan wang kerajaan dapat digunakan bagi membantu golongan yang terkesan akibat PKP.

Cadangan itu ternyata menyentap hati kira-kira 1.6 juta penjawat awam di negara ini. Kecoh satu Malaysia dalam kalangan kakitangan kerajaan yang tidak berpuas hati dengan usul tersebut.

Selain pemotongan gaji atau elaun, isu kenaikan harga juga amat sensitif. Tak kiralah kenaikan harga petrol atau tarif elektrik, seboleh-bolehnya rakyat tak mahu dengar.

Illegal factories have until Dec 31 to get licensed

UNLICENSED factories located near rivers in Klang district with the potential to cause pollution will not be allowed to operate.

Selangor executive councillor in charge of local government, public transportation and new village development, Ng Sze Han said unlicensed factories that posed a high risk of causing pollution, due to the nature of their business, must move.

"Even licensed operations which may directly or indirectly pollute the state's water bodies with harmful effluence that can put the public at risk, must be reconsidered.

"We need to relook at licensed operations that process raw sewage near rivers or water bodies," he said to the media after meeting factory owners at Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Dewan Hamzah on having their operations licensed.

He disclosed that more than 700 unlicensed factories in the Klang district were at risk of being shut down by authorities if owners failed to legalise them before Dec 31.

Selangor govt offering discounts for land premiums in status conversions

"Klang has 1,127 unlicensed factories and only 395 are legalised.

"A total of 732 have not submitted documents to the district land office for land conversion from agriculture to industrial.

"Others have not even submitted building plans to legalise the building structures," he added.

Ng said the campaign to legalise unlicensed factories was supposed to have ended on Sept 30 but the state government decided on a three-month extension.

"The Selangor government is strict about its Dec 31 deadline.

"It is the final opportunity for unlicensed factories to legalise their operations," he warned.

Ng told factory owners that the government's steps were in line with the National Land Code 1965.

MPK Town Planning director Zailani Panot, who briefed factory owners on application steps to get their buildings approved, said the state's programmes to legalise illegal factories had been around

since 2005.

"Only 395 have been legalised in Klang in recent months," he said.

He noted that many owners waited till the last minute before taking action.

"The state has decided not to have anymore extensions as people are not making the effort to legalise their business operations no matter how much time is given," he said.

Ng said Selangor government was offering incentives such as discounts on land premiums for land conversions and this offer must be accepted.

"It is an opportune time. Those who pay up within six months will get a 10% discount while those who pay up within four or two months will get 20% or 30% discounts respectively.

"Should the land status conversion premiums be too high for some, the government is offering a nominal payment of only 10% but a caveat will be placed on the

land," he explained.

He said the owners of illegal factories must see the bigger picture as the programme was for everyone's benefit.

"Owners of factories who convert their land and get approval for their buildings can easily develop their businesses.

"For the government, there will be more revenue and it will be good for the economy.

"It will also be easier for the authorities to supervise factories that pollute our waterways," he added.

Ng said the highest concentration of illegal factories was in the Klang district as it was near the port, making it easy for companies to move raw materials and finished products.

MPK president Dr Ahmad Fadzli Ahmad Tajuddin said the council would organise a one-stop consultation centre to guide factory owners on how to legalise their land or buildings.

Must be licensed to sell exotic meat

Restaurants required to display permit from Perhilitan

THE days of unlicensed restaurants selling exotic meat dishes may be numbered as the authorities are intensifying efforts to crack down on illegal wildlife trade.

Wildlife and National Parks Department (Perhilitan) director-general Derek Abdul Kadir Abu Hasbain said consumers should bear the responsibility of ensuring the eateries serving exotic meat that they patronised were licensed to do so.

He pointed out that only seven restaurants in Selangor were licensed to sell such meat, but did not disclose their names.

Abdul Kadir said these operators were given permission to sell animals that could be hunted such as wild boar, porcupine and langkote which they got from licensed hunters.

"If they (the hunters) are licensed, then it is not illegal for them to sell exotic meat," he said.

He elaborated that licences were issued by the department for the sale of exotic meat under the Wildlife Protection Act 1970.

"Customers need to ask the eateries proprietors whether they have the required licence when patronising such eateries. The public can lodge a complaint with Perhilitan," Abdul Kadir said in an e-mail interview.

He added that consumers should be able to see the licence as proprietors were required to display the compulsory permits at their premises.

Licence holders are also required to keep detailed records of all wild animal meat acquired and sold to ensure that the meat is legally obtained.

Most exotic meat is sourced from licensed predators or hunters with valid gun permits and hunting licences.

"From a conservation aspect, there are hunting seasons for wild animals where the population of a particular species are constantly monitored to ensure their numbers are not threatened," said Abdul Kadir.

He said the most common type of exotic meat sold at eateries was wild boar, while consumption of

species such as tiger, leopard, serow and bear was forbidden.

Traditional remedies

Chinese traditional medicine halls in Selangor are warned not to offer endangered wildlife parts in their remedies.

Selangor local government, public transportation and new village development executive councillor Ng Lee Han said those who did so would have their

trading licence revoked immediately.

He added that all local councils in Selangor must keep tabs on traditional medicine shops to ensure they did not use prohibited items.

According to local and Klang and Kuala Langat, snake chins from porcupine, shark fin and other animal parts are remedies sourced from critically endangered animals sold in some medicine halls.

One local told StarMetro that people believed leopard stones could help patients with certain diseases. The stone is ground into powder before being added to soups.

Ng urged consumers to stop consuming parts of endangered animals and opt for herbal products instead.

"Herbal alternatives could be safer for consumption," he said.

He urged local authorities to work with the Federation of Chinese Physicians and Medicine Doctors Association of Malaysia to close unscrupulous operators.

Sellers beware

A crackdown on the unlawful sale of exotic meat and wildlife

trade is being intensified under the (Pakatan Harapan) (PH) government which was launched in September last year.

Last month, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Abdul Razali Ibrahim said he wanted to ensure all districts were free of such activities.

He had given all OCRTs nationwide a month, until Sept 18, to submit a report on the sale of illegal animals in shops and restaurants.

OCRTs involve the police, Perhilitan, Customs, Forestry Department as well as other federal and state enforcement agencies across the country, with support from non-governmental organisations.

Restaurants suspected of selling exotic meat will be raided and OCRTs are tasked with monitoring the situation closely to make sure that such businesses do not reopen.

There had been arrests of several suspects by police and the seizure of wild animal meat in several districts in Johor.

Meanwhile, a check with local authorities revealed that their enforcement power was limited.

Klang Municipal Council (MPC) Licensing Department director Dennis Ibrahim Abdul Aziz said the council did not grant licences or permits for the sale of protected wildlife.

Put a stop to wildlife trade

OCRTs urged to submit reports of illegal sale of exotic animals

Our department issues an annual trading licence for businesses. If we find that the traditional medicine shops or other businesses are dealing in endangered wildlife parts or selling exotic meat, they will revoke the licences immediately," he said.

A Selangor Municipal Council spokesman said the council did not have a list of restaurants that served exotic meat.

"We issue licences based on the nature of business and in the case of restaurants, we do not require details on the dishes that should or should not be served," the spokesman said.

Kajang Municipal Council public relations head Kamariah Izzah Sulaiman said that it, too, did not have information on restaurants that sold exotic meat.

The police have yet to seek assistance from us and we will cooperate should they need our help.

However, we do not have such an inventory," he said.

Meanwhile, a Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) spokesman confirmed that the use of exotic meat and wildlife did not fall under DBKL's jurisdiction.

"However, we will assist in terms of enforcement if there is a request from the police," he said.

Azmin, Anifah condemn Mohamaddin over remarks

KOTA KINABALU: Datuk Mohamaddin Ketapi has been labelled a traitor following his alleged mockery of the sacrifices made by the country's security forces during the Lahad Datu incursion in 2013.

In lambasting Mohamaddin over his alleged remarks, Perikatan Nasional (PN) information chief Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali said the former cabinet minister's statement was unpatriotic and inflammatory.

Azmin, who is also senior international trade and industry minister, said Mohamaddin's remarks went against the obligation of every Malaysian to defend the country's sovereignty.

Mohamaddin is Parti Warisan Sabah's candidate for the state seat of Segama.

"Any statement or speech which belittles the country's sovereignty is not only unpatriotic but inflammatory and traitorous.

"Based on that principle, I condemn the statement made by the Warisan top leader and candidate for the Segama state seat, Datuk Mohamaddin Ketapi.

"He has insulted the deeds and

sacrifices of the security forces that laid down their lives to defend the country's sovereignty when Sabah was attacked by terrorists in 2013," Azmin said.

In a two-minute-30-second video clip, Mohamaddin is seen delivering his speech in which he said there was a war in Tanduou before the 13th General Election (GE13) in 2013.

"The (fighter) jet came into Tanduou, bombarded the people's oil palm, destroying their plantation. The people's houses were damaged from shootings.

"Later, (army) tanks entered villages to go to war with the

chickens. (The army was) fighting with who? Chickens. And dogs. Then when the election was over, there was no war," he said in the video.

Mohamaddin went on to say when he was the Parti Bersatu Sabah elected representative for Lahad Datu in 1986, there were no people armed with guns to fight or seize Sabah.

"At the time when it was said Umno would lose (in the 2013 general election), there was a war in Tanduou. Many people died because of the 'sandiwaru' — a theatrical lie," he added.

The Lahad Datu standoff took place in February 2013 and lasted until March. It saw the deaths of 10 members of the security forces.

GE13 was held on May 5, 2013, which saw Barisan Nasional retaining the federal government, as well as the Sabah state government.

Azmin said Mohamaddin's words could sow division among

the people and reflected Warisan's non-commitment to the sovereignty of the state and the safety of Sabahans.

"I am confident that the security forces, the family members of those who died in the clash and all patriotic Malaysians cannot accept his uncouthness.

"PN urges Mohamaddin to retract his insults and immediately apologise to all Malaysians and the families of those who died defending our country.

"Sabahans must reject those who mock the country's sovereignty to score points in narrow political agendas."

Earlier, Parti Cinta Sabah (PCS) expressed disappointment over Mohamaddin's remarks.

PCS president Datuk Seri Anifah Aman said Mohamaddin's words were an insult to the security forces and a betrayal of Sabah.

"During the 2013 intrusion in Kampung Tanduou, Lahad Datu, 235 terrorists landed in Sabah from Siminul Island in the Philippines.

"Ten Malaysian security personnel were killed in the fighting,

including several ambushes. This Warisan leader has described their sacrifices as a 'drama'.

"Where is the respect of the Warisan leader for the Malaysian security forces who have been killed while defending Sabah's sovereignty?" he asked.

Anifah said such a statement, coming from an election candidate, not only hurt the comrades-in-arms, but also family members of the security forces.

Anifah remarked that Warisan should be ashamed of Mohamaddin's statement and the people should reject such a leader. **By Avila Geraldine and Izwan Abdullah**

Time to implement 'polluter pays' principle

FOUR company directors and a factory manager suspected of being responsible for dumping effluents into Sungai Gong, near Rawang, Selangor, appeared in court last Tuesday to answer charges under Section 430, read together with Section 34, of the Penal Code and Section 25(1) of the Environmental Quality Act 1974 (EQA).

They pleaded not guilty and the case was fixed for further mention on Oct 27. They were denied bail. The pollution incident caused the suspension of operations at four Sungai Selangor water treatment plants, disrupting water supply to 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley.

Expressing sadness for his subjects in the state, the sultan of Selangor asked for stricter enforcement measures to be put in place. He wanted "more stringent legislation" to be passed, containing heavier penalties for polluters of rivers and the environment, including mandatory jail terms and maximum fines. He also instructed that there should not be any "political interference" in enforcement matters

pertaining to the pollution of the environment.

This is not the first time river pollution had caused a major disruption to water supply in Selangor. Unless immediate measures are put in place, it will not be the last. In 2016, river pollution had caused the Semenyih water treatment plant to be shut down four times, leading to a chaotic water disruption in Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat, Sepang and Petaling.

What distressed many in Selangor is that the illegal factory causing the pollution of Sungai Gong last week is actually a "repeat offender", having been compounded RM60,000 in the past. According to recent news reports, the state government had given the

landowner and factory operator until the end of this year "to put things right".

This had led some quarters to question the reason for such "kid-glove treatment". They asked: "Sudah 12 tahun pemilik kilang haram diberi masa, kenapa beri muka lagi kepada mereka?"

It is still not too late for Malaysia to implement the "polluter pay" principle (PPP), under which a convicted polluter of the environment (including rivers) is required to pay a certain amount to the state to cover the cost of restoring the damaged environment to its former condition.

New South Wales in Australia had done so by establishing its Environment Protection Authority under its Protection of the Environment Administration Act 1991. The European Union did the same under a directive in 2004. France implemented it under Article 4 of its Charter for the Environment, while Ghana implemented it in 2011. England and Wales passed their respective Environmental Damage (Prevention and Remediation) Regulations in 2009.

Under the Zimbabwe Environmental Management Act 2002, any person convicted of environmental offences is required to bear the cost of decontaminating the polluted environment. The polluter pay principle is actually grounded in Principle 16 of the Rio Declaration on the Environment and Development 1992 (the Rio Declaration), to which Malaysia is a party.

But nothing concrete in implementing it has been done over the past three decades. In 2017, the then natural resources and environment minister, Datuk Seri Dr Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaa-far, stated that the federal government intended to enact a new law, known as the Environmental Protection Act (EPA), to empower a federal department to act against polluters, including the power to demolish or relocate illegal factories.

He then explained that the pollution of Sungai Semenyih was caused by illegal factories, but federal agencies under his ministry were unable to do anything because the matter was under the jurisdiction of the local authorities. He told reporters the new

law will solve cross-jurisdictional issues.

In May 2019, when the pollution of Sungai Kim Kim in Pasir Gudang caused water disruption that affected some 6,000 residents living in the area, the then minister in charge of the environment, Yeo Bee Yin, also said the federal government was considering a new law to replace the existing EQA, with a heavier penalty for polluters. Sadly, nothing has come from both promises.

To sum up — we have an old EQA waiting for reform. We have earlier announcements about a new EPA. We have local authorities who seem unable to cope with the magnitude and frequency of our river pollution problem.

We have a federal department, which (according to federal ministers) does not have jurisdiction to do anything about it. We made a solemn promise in Brazil in 1992 to implement PPP, but we have not done so.

Time to reassess water management system

RECENTLY, Klang Valley saw two water-related issues: an unscheduled water disruption as a result of odour pollution in Sungai Gong and flash floods that overwhelmed areas in the heart of Kuala Lumpur.

Having both water issues happen within a week of each other shines a spotlight on the urgent need to reassess our water management system and ensure it is able to provide for the needs of those in the community in the long term.

In 2016, Akademi Sains Malaysia published a report titled "Transforming the Water Sector: National Integrated Water Resources Management Plan", which provided a comprehensive assessment of our water sector and recommendations to safeguard this crucial resource.

The main recommendation was

for states to set up an Integrated Water Resources Management plan. States will be able to integrate planning, monitoring, enforcement and management of water resources on a river-basin basis. This will not only improve response rates, but also serve as a preventive tool to ensure our water sources remain secure.

Enforcing reactive measures is justified when it concerns repeat offenders. However, the primary focus should be in ensuring that preventive measures are well in place within the framework as it will lead to a society that is aware of the impact of their actions.

Businesses should prove that they have mechanisms in place to ensure they are not discharging wastewater or effluents into waterways at the risk

of inconveniencing those in the area. Civil servants responsible for safeguarding our water supply should be empowered with technical and technological know-how to assess a business premises' compliance level.

If anything, the water disruption has brought home the fact that we are heavily reliant on this natural resource to survive. Water is a vital ingredient — it is needed from residences to hospitals to businesses.

Managing the water sector is a joint responsibility of all — public and private sectors as well as communities — as it cuts across multiple sectors of land use management, multiple water agencies and governance.

Sacking for Selangor coach after heavy loss to JDT

THE axe finally fell on Selangor chief coach B. Satiananthan yesterday, and the head which rolled was also quite a distinguished one - that of the president of the Malaysian Football Coaches Association.

The fans cried for Satiananthan's head and they got what they wanted.

By yesterday morning, after a conversation with FA of Selangor (FAS) president Tengku Amir Shah Sultan Sharafuddin Idris and deputy president Datuk Seri Shahril Mokhtar, Satiananthan was relieved of his Selangor job.

Though Selangor, seventh in the 11-team table, still have three more matches to go, Satiananthan's contract with the FAS was terminated with immediate effect.

He paid the price for these results: beating Sabah 2-1, 0-0

against PJ City, 1-1 against Melaka United, and losing badly 6-1 to JDT.

The crushing defeat to JDT was the one that triggered his downfall. What Satiananthan feared most and warned his men against - a heavy defeat by JDT - came true.

After seeing the JDT juggernaut steamroll Perak 7-0 a week earlier, Satiananthan had warned his men to dig in and avoid a heavy defeat. But to no avail.

"I was terminated, so I have to leave the team and it's because of the performance, with the (6-1) defeat to JDT. And they say the team are not playing to expectation," said Satiananthan yesterday.

"They told me at 10am in person and no, I didn't get to say goodbye to the team.

"There's training in the evening, so someone will have to take over, I don't know... I don't want to know.

"I respect their decision, wish them good luck and they have

an easy three games ahead to get nine points which could end up with a top two or three finishing.

"Whoever is taking over have to make sure they get the points because after this is the Malaysia Cup, good luck."

Satiananthan said he will take time off to rest before looking at talks with other interested clubs.

FAS, who issued an official statement yesterday on the termination of Satiananthan's contract, announced that their technical director and current Selangor II coach Michael Feichtenbeiner will act as interim coach for the first team.

FAS secretary general Dr Johan Kamal Hamidon said the removal of Satiananthan was based on the team's performance.

"This is something that has been discussed before and it's not like it's something new," he said.

"We wish coach Satiananthan all the best in his future endeavours."

AMID a team crisis following the sudden removal of coach B. Saitiananthan, the Selangor camp found themselves facing startling allegations by JDT owner Tunku Ismail Sultan Ibrahim.

want to interfere in the dressing room.

TMJ disclosed that Selangor had offered national winger Mohamadou Sumareh a three-year contract from next season with a monthly salary of RM70,482. And it comes with a RM3 million release clause.

He also released WhatsApp screenshots of conversations said

to be between Sumareh and several FAS individuals.

Johan confirmed that Selangor had offered Sumareh, 26, a playing contract after checking with FAM on his status following his controversial departure from Pahang over a salary dispute.

525 premises guilty of water pollution as of August

LOCAL authorities have taken action against 525 premises for water pollution offences between January and August this year under the Environmental Quality Act (EQA) 1974.

Environment and Water Minister Datuk Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man said the Environment Department's latest figures showed that authorities had taken 815 enforcement actions.

These included 224 written notices, 517 compounds worth RM1.03 million, 20 equipment seizures, six revocations of licenses and 48 investigation papers for cases to be referred to court.

Over the six months, 39 premises were found guilty of offences under the EQA 1974 by the court and have been ordered to pay penalties worth RM1.05 million in total, the minister said in a recent parliamentary written reply.

"The enforcement actions taken by the regulator underscored the government's commitment to punish wrongdoers," Tuan Ibrahim said.

He was responding to Senator Idris Ahmad who asked the minister to state the number of factories that have been prosecuted for dumping contaminants into the river and the value of fines imposed

on such factory operators from January to August 2020.

The recent water outage in Klang Valley had caused a huge uproar online, sparking concerns and renewed debates on industrial

activities near local water catchment areas, tougher laws for callous offenders, and vulnerabilities in the water supply network that could threaten national security.

The supply cut was attributed to the dumping of industrial oil by a heavy machinery maintenance factory into Sungai Gong, which flows into a tributary of Sungai Selangor.

The pollution had forced the closure of four water treatment plants, affecting 1.4 million consumers in 1,292 areas.

The company responsible has been identified as Yip Chee Seng & Sons Sdn Bhd located in Rawang, Selangor.

Four company directors and a factory manager linked to the workshop have since been charged under Section 430 and 34 of the Penal Code and Section 25 of the EQA 1974.

The company has also received an eviction notice from the district land office, forcing them to clear the land and demolish the factory

building within the next three to four months.

Its water and power supply will also be cut to stop the company from operating.

Despite the tough actions taken, many remain unsatisfied and are demanding that resolute actions be put in place to solve the pollution problem once and for all. Both federal and state lawmakers have vowed to beef up various environmental laws to tackle the nagging problem.

Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the state government will be looking to double the fine for water pollution to RM1 million from the current RM500,000 under the Selangor Water Management Authority Enactment 1999.

Sathianathan no longer Red Giants' head coach

The termination of the contract comes less than 48 hours after Selangor lost 1-6 to league leaders JDT

THE Football Association of Selangor (FAS) yesterday terminated the contract of B Sathianathan as head coach after the Red Giants squad only recorded a single win since the Super League competition resumed in August.

The termination of the 62-year-old's contract comes less than 48 hours after Selangor lost 1-6 to league leaders Johor Darul Ta'zim (JDT) at the Sultan Ibrahim Stadium, Iskandar Puteri, on Saturday.

This was confirmed by Sathianathan after a meeting yesterday with the top leadership of FAS, including its president Raja Muda Selangor Tengku Amir Shah Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah and

deputy president Datuk Seri Shahril Mokhtar.

"I was fired. I was expecting this

and had seen the signs. When you are fired, you have to accept (it)," he told *Bernama*.

Besides the drubbing by JDT, Selangor only managed one win and two draws since the resumption of the Super League after the competition was suspended for almost five months following the spread of Covid-19 in the country.

The latest results left the 33-time Malaysia Cup champions in seventh place with just 10 points after a total of eight matches played. The Red Giants is four points from the relegation zone.

Sathianathan, whose contract was until the end of the season, admitted that he was a little upset as he was unable to fulfil his duties until the end of season.

"The season is not over, we still have the Malaysia Cup after this, so anything can happen. I believe Selangor can win the remaining three Super League matches and end the league in second or third place.

"I hope Selangor achieves that

goal with the new coach. I know the existing line-up of players is good enough for Selangor," he said.

Sathianathan, who is a former national coach, served two seasons with Selangor after being appointed as the Red Giants head coach in November 2018.

In a separate development, Melaka also failed to take advantage of playing before their fans after being held to a 1-1 draw by Petaling Jaya City FC (PJ City) in a match held at Hang Jebat Stadium, Melaka on Sunday.

The outcome did not change the standings of Melaka and PJ City who are in the fifth and 10th spots respectively in the Super League table with 11 and seven points after eight games.

Felda United and Pahang also shared a point each after playing to a 2-2 draw at Tun Abdul Razak Stadium in Jengka. — *Bernama*
