'Pemutihan' kilang sepanjang sungai elak pencemaran berulang

Betapa kalutnya kehidupan jutaan pengguna apabila operasi Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) Sungai Semenyih dan Bukit Tampoi terpaksa dihentikan susulan insiden pencemaran air mentah di Sungai Semenyih yang menjadi sumber air mentah ke loji ini.

Lazimnya, selain masalah pencemaran sumber air mentah, faktor lain juga menyebabkan masalah gangguan bekalan.

Antaranya, kekurangan air, musim panas berpanjangan, tiada hujan di kawasan tadahan, kekurangan kawasan tadahan air, sekali gus diwartakan sebagai kawasan simpanan tetap, henti tugas loji atau kes pecah paip utama yang usang.

Proses pemulihan semula bekalan mengambil masa panjang. Rakyat pula bosan dan muak dengan masalah bekalan air yang sering terganggu, malah meluat dengan pelbagai alasan diberikan sejak sekian lama.

Apakah tidak ada jalan penyelesaian bagi mengatasi masalah ini daripada terus berulang?

Malaysia adalah negara mewah dengan sumber air, menerima hujan berterusan sepanjang tahun, memiliki banyaksungai dan sumber air bawah tanah yang belum digunakan sepenuhnya. Sepatutnya, masalah gangguan bekalan air seperti ini tidak berlaku!

Penguatkuasaan undang-undang lemah antara penyebab utama isu pencemaran air tidak berkesudahan. Pada 2018 sahaja, sembilan kali pengguna mengalami gangguan bekalan air.

Ibarat tradisi saban tahun, kali ini sebahagian penduduk Lembah Klang sekali lagi perlu menghadapi perkara sama buat kesekian kalinya.

Walaupun sungai mempunyai keupayaan secara semula jadi untuk menerima bahan cemar, ia bergantung juga isi padu air yang ada di dalam sungai itu.

Jika saiz sesebuah sungai kecil dan isi padu air berkurangan, maka kemampuan sungai menerima bahan cemar adalah kurang.

Begitu juga ketika musim kemarau, kadar pencairan dalam sungai berkurangan. Justeru, apakah tindakan penyelesaian jangka pendek dan panjang boleh dilakukan untuk meminimumkan masalah ini?

Lazimnya, apabila masalah gangguan air berlaku, pihak berkuasa hanya membuat 'bising' dan 'kecoh' dengan bertindak apabila isu masih panas dan diperkatakan.

Seharusnya tindakan lebih proaktif dan agresif diambil, khususnya langkah pencegahan sebelum insiden berlaku.

Antara paling mudah memantau lokasi dan status semua sungai yang menjadi punca bekalan air secara berkala dan berterusan. Pemantauan perlu merangkumi aktiviti di sekitar sungai terbabit.

Bagi tindakan jangka pendek, apabila gangguan bekalan air berlaku, pengguna dinasihatkan menyimpan bekalan air yang cukup untuk kegunaan sepanjang gangguan bekalan air.

Jika selama ini kita tidak pernah peduli dengan air hujan yang mencurah, apa kata mula menadah air hujan sebagai penyelamat pada saat genting. Tadahan air hujan boleh digunakan untuk menyiram tanaman atau mencuci kenderaan.

Sekiranya berlaku kerja pembaikan tidak berjadual seperti paip utama pecah atau tekanan rendah, syarikat pengendali air perlu mengambil tindakan segera dan menyediakan lebih banyak lori tangki air bagi menampung permintaan pengguna untuk sementara waktu.

Syarikat pengendali air juga perlu meletakkan tong di setiap kawasan yang kerap mengalami masalah gangguan bekalan air. Perlu juga dipastikan loji rawatan dalam keadaan baik.

Untuk tindakan jangka panjang, perlu dirangka pelan strategik bagi mengatasi masalah gangguan bekalan air ini daripada berterusan.

Antaranya memantapkan sekuriti air meliputi kuantiti dan kualiti air yang menjadi keperluan asas manusia sebagai keutamaan pihak berkuasa agar pengguna tidak lagi dibebani masalah gangguan bekalan pada masa akan datang.

Sahabat Alam Malaysia (SAM) misalnya, menggesa pihak berkuasa negeri berkaitan pencemaran bertindak tegas dengan melakukan 'pemutihan' kilang dan binaan berhampiran sungai.

Langkah ini penting bagi memastikan kebersihan dan keselamatan sungai sebagai sumber air terpelihara.

Selain itu, pengezonan semula kilang dan binaan berhampiran sungai di setiap negeri perlu dilakukan supaya sisa buangan tidak lagi dialirkan terus ke sungai.

Pihak menyediakan perkhidmatan air juga seharusnya boleh meramal bekalan sering dicemari, maka mereka perlu mempertingkatkan penguatkuasaan di sepanjang lembangan sungai.

Selain Jabatan Alam Sekitar selaku utama, peranan Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS) juga perlu diperkasa, bukan sekadar menjadi agensi pelaksana yang menguruskan badan air, tetapi boleh menguat kuasa.

Ketika ini, jika berlaku kesalahan berkaitan penerokaan dan pencemaran sungai khususnya, JPS tidak boleh mengambil tindakan.

Sebagai tambahan, Garis Panduan Manual Pembangunan Pesisiran Sungai perlu dipertingkatkan supaya menjadi peruntukan undang-undang.

Malah, pihak berkuasa tempatan sebagai yang mempunyai kuasa meluluskan operasi industri perlu memastikan tidak memberi sebarang kelulusan kepada industri untuk beroperasi di sepanjang sungai, selain mengambil

tindakan terhadap kilang haram yang beroperasi di sepanjang sungai.

Cadangan Kementerian Alam Sekitar dan Air membubuhkan Unit Jenayah Alam Sekitar pada masa terdekat bagi menangani isu pencemaran juga harus disokong.

Menurut laporan Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu mengenai Alam Sekitar (UNEP), jika manusia terus menggunakan air dengan kadar diamalkan sekarang, dua daripada tiga penduduk dunia akan hidup dalam keadaan sukar menikmati bekalan air menjelang 2025.

Oleh itu, rakyat juga perlu dididik secara berterusan tentang kepentingan dan keperluan menjimatkan penggunaan air per individu kerana penggunaan air dalam kalangan rakyat Malaysia amat tinggi.

Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (PBB) menyatakan keperluan penggunaan air bagi seorang individu adalah 165 liter, tetapi rakyat Malaysia secara purata menggunakan 220 liter air sehari - lebih daripada purata penduduk Amerika Syarikat dan Australia.

Menurut laporan Kementerian Tenaga Teknologi Hijau dan Air pada 2016, seorang rakyat Malaysia membazir 50,000 liter air setahun.

Pencemaran sungai di Malaysia satu masalah alam sekitar yang bertambah serius dari semasa ke semasa dan sehingga sekarang masih tiada kaedah penyelesaian benar-benar efektif untuk menangani masalah ini.

Hakikatnya, kemusnahan sungai berterusan akibat pencemaran boleh mengancam kehidupan masyarakat dalam jumlah yang ramai sama ada secara langsung atau tidak.

Justeru, penjenayah yang menimbulkan pelbagai kesusahan dan kesulitan kepada masyarakat wajar diheret ke muka pengadilan dan dijatuhkan hukuman berat serta setimpal sebagai pengajaran.

Air bersih di Selangor bukan lagi tanggungjawab Puncak Niaga

Shah Alam: Puncak Niaga Holdings Berhad (Puncak Niaga) tidak lagi bertanggungjawab ke atas semua urusan berkaitan air bersih di Selangor sejak lima tahun lalu.

Jabatan Perhubungan Awam syarikat itu, dalam satu kenyataan semalam, berkata urusan berkenaan sudah diambil alih Kerajaan Selangor pada 15 Oktober 2015.

Pada tarikh itu, Puncak Niaga memaklumkan, Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (SYABAS) diambil alih Kerajaan Selangor dan ditukar namanya kepada Pengurusan Air Selangor Berhad (Air Selangor).


"Oleh itu, segala urusan mengenai bekalan air bersih di Selangor tidak lagi diurus Puncak Niaga dan Tan Sri Rozali Ismail (Pengerusi Eksekutif) bermula 15 Oktober 2015. Segala urusan berkaitan air bersih di Selangor boleh dibincang dan berhubung terus dengan Air Selangor," menurut kenyataan itu.

Puncak Niaga ialah syarikat konsesi bekalan air yang membekal dan mengagihkan air dirawat kepada pelanggan di Selangor, Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur dan Putrajaya. SYABAS adalah anak syarikatnya sehingga 2014 apabila ia bertukar nama kepada Air Selangor.

Pada Februari 2015, media melaporkan Puncak Niaga dan Pengurusan Air Selangor memeterai perjanjian jual beli (SPA) bersyarat pada 11 November 2014, yang mana kedua-dua pihak bersetuju terhadap cadangan pelupusan satu sama lain.

Perjanjian berkenaan dimeterai bagi menyatu dan menstrukturkan semula industri air di Selangor, Kuala Lumpur dan Putrajaya.

Berikutan itu, industri air Selangor diuruskan sepenuhnya oleh kerajaan negeri berkenaan, manakala Kerajaan Persekutuan dapat menegerakan pembinaan Loji Rawatan Air Langat 2 dan sistem bekalan air terawat.

'Dalang perlu tanggung semua kos'

Kuala Lumpur: Pihak yang didapati bertanggungjawab melakukan pencemaran sungai perlu menanggung setiap kos kesan perbuatan berkenaan.

Pengerusi Ikatan Komuniti Selamat, Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye, berkata prinsip 'pencemar bayar' perlu dikuat kuasakan kerana situasi itu mengakibatkan penderitaan perlu ditanggung rakyat dan menjejaskan alam sekitar.

"Sebelum meminta pihak itu bertanggungjawab, mereka perlu dikenal pasti terlebih dulu. Persoalannya adalah mengapa pencemar tidak dikenali lebih awal?"

"Ia (pencemaran Sungai Semenyih) kejadian kedua selepas Sungai Gong. Kenapa pihak berkuasa hanya bertindak selepas ia berlaku dan bukan sebelumnya," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Beliau berkata, pihak berkuasa harus melakukan lebih banyak usaha mengelakkan kes seperti itu daripada berulang, malah perlu lebih berwaspada dan proaktif.

"Tidak sukar untuk mengenal

pasti kilang dan aktiviti di sepanjang sungai, di hulu, tengah dan hilir. Buat pemeriksaan berkala ke atas semuanya untuk memastikan kepatuhan terhadap peraturan dan undang-undang yang ada.

"Sekiranya perlu, pindahkan

kilang haram sebelum memberi lesen kepada mereka," katanya sambil menegaskan, rakyat mahukan pihak berkuasa bertindak pantas sebelum kejadian berlaku.

"Masukkan langkah baharu jika perlu untuk mengenal pasti

dan membetulkan keadaan. Betulkan juga soal urus tadbir untuk memastikan pengurusan air yang selamat setiap masa," katanya.

Pencemaran sumber air mentah utama untuk LRA Sungai Semenyih dan LRA Bukit Tampoi itu adalah yang kedua berlaku di Lembah Klang dalam tempoh kira-kira sebulan, selepas pencemaran Sungai Gong di Rawang, awal bulan lalu.

Dalam insiden terdahulu, sebanyak 1,292 kawasan di tujuh wilayah sekitar Lembah Klang mengalami gangguan bekalan air berikutan pencemaran Sungai Gong akibat pencemaran minyak dari industri berhampiran sehingga menjejaskan kira-kira lima juta pengguna.

Tujuh wilayah berkenaan ialah Kuala Lumpur, Petaling, Klang/Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Hulu Selangor, Gombak dan Kuala Langat. Susulan itu, empat ahli lembaga pengarah dan seorang pengurus syarikat membai-ki jentera berat didakwa di mahkamah sebelum dibenarkan ikat jamin.

LRA Sungai Semenyih mula operasi

Pengguna terjejas dapat bekalan air mulai jam 12 tengah malam tadi

Kuala Lumpur: Pengguna yang terjejas akibat penutupan dua loji rawatan air (LRA) di Selangor sejak Ahad lalu, dijadual mendapat bekalan air secara berperingkat mulai jam 12 tengah malam tadi.

Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif, Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor), Suhaimi Kamaralzaman, berkata ia susulan pengoperasian semula LRA Sungai Semenyih dengan penstabilan proses rawatan air sedang dijalankan sejak pagi semalam.

Katanya, air bersih itu akan melalui ujian kualiti dan pematuhan berdasarkan standard Kementerian Kesihatan, sebelum diagihkan kepada pengguna dengan pemuliharaan sepenuhnya dibahagikan kepada tiga kumpulan utama dengan pengguna terawal mula mendapat bekalan pada jam 12 tengah malam tadi.

"Bemula 15 Oktober 2015, segala urusan mengenai bekalan air bersih di Selangor tidak lagi diurus oleh Syarikat Puncak Niaga atau Tan Sri Rozali Ismail.

"Urusan tersebut diambil alih Air Selangor," jelas kenyataan tersebut.

Pada 11 November 2014, Puncak Niaga Holdings dan Air Selangor memeterai perjanjian jual beli bersyarat dengan kedua-dua pihak bersetuju terhadap cadangan pelupusan satu sama lain dengan bayaran tunai RM1.55 bilion.

Perjanjian itu dimeterai bagi menyatukan dan menstrukturkan semula industri air di Selangor, Kuala Lumpur dan Putrajaya.

Berikutan itu, industri Air Selangor kini diuruskan sepenuhnya oleh kerajaan Selangor, manakala kerajaan Persekutuan akan menyegerakan pembinaan Loji Rawatan Air Langat 2 dan sistem bekalan air terawat.

Namun sejak pengambilan alih oleh Air Selangor bekalan air masih kerap terputus dan kejadian itu menimbulkan tidak puas hati pelanggan.

Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Air Selangor, Suhaimi Kamaralzaman berkata, proses pemulihan dibahagikan kepada tiga kumpulan dengan yang pertama merangkumi 145 kawasan dija-

“Kumpulan kedua melibatkan 91 kawasan akan menerima bekalan pada pukul 6 petang, 8 Oktober dan kumpulan ketiga melibatkan 38 kawasan akan menerima air sepenuhnya pada pukul 6 petang, 9 Oktober,” kata beliau dalam sidang akhbar di sini semalam.

Menurut beliau, usaha merawat air mentah dan menstabilkan sistem loji rawatan air akan mengambil masa 12 jam sebelum bekalan air boleh diagihkan.

Menurut Suhaimi, setakat ini Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) Bukit Tampoi belum beroperasi dan bacaan pencemaran masih berada pada tahap tiga ton.

Polis tahu pencemar Sungai Batang Benar

SEREMBAN: Polis Negeri Sembilan akan menahan individu yang membuang sisa buangan hingga mencemarkan Sungai Batang Benar di Nilai dekat sini tidak lama lagi.

Timbalan Ketua Polis Negeri Sembilan, **Senior Asisten Komisioner Che Zakaria Othman** berkata, individu tersebut sudah dikenal pasti dan pegawainya sedang mengawasi individu itu yang berada di sebuah negeri.

“Selepas menerima laporan Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN), kami membuka kertas siasatan dan memburu individu yang mencemarkan Sungai Batang Benar.

“Kami yakin dapat menang-

kap individu itu dalam tempoh terdekat dan membawanya ke negeri ini untuk didakwa,” katanya ketika melawat lokasi pencemaran di Jalan Emas di Kawasan Perindustrian Nilai dekat sini.

Menurut beliau, kes tersebut disiasat mengikut Seksyen 430 Kanun Keseksaan kerana mencemarkan tali air atau sungai.

Sementara itu, Pengerusi Jawatan Kuasa Bertindak Kesihatan, Alam Sekitar, Koperasi dan Alam Sekitar, Koperasi dan Kepenggunaan, **S. Veerapan** berkata, pihak berkuasa menutup sebuah ladang ternakan angsa dan membersihkan tempat pembuangan haram di Ka-

wasan Perindustrian Nilai yang disyaki menjadi punca pencemaran Sungai Batang Benar.

“Kami mengesyaki aktiviti pembuangan sampah berlaku tiga atau empat hari lalu manakala ladang ternakan angsa ini sudah beroperasi secara haram empat tahun,” katanya.

Menurut beliau, Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) negeri mengambil sampel di tapak pembuangan haram untuk mengetahui sama ada ia bahan buangan berjadual atau bukan.

“Kilang ternakan angsa haram di Pajam yang disyaki mengalirkan bahan buangan ke sungai juga sudah diarahkan tutup serta-merta,” katanya.

Menurut Veerapan, pihakn-

ya menunggu analisis sampel sungai tersebut bagi mengetahui pencemaran di situ sama seperti sampel di Sungai Semenyih, Selangor.

“Pencemaran Sungai Selangor menyebabkan dua Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) dihenti tugas dan puluhan ribu penduduk di negeri itu tiada air,” kata beliau.

Kerajaan Selangor mendakwa aktiviti pembersihan ladang angsa dan sampah di kawasan Perindustrian Nilai 3 sebagai punca Sungai Batang Benar tercemar sebelum airnya mengalir ke Sungai Semenyih.

Sungai Batang Benar terletak sejauh kira-kira 30 kilometer dari LRA Sungai Semenyih.

ditangguhkan ke satu tarikh yang akan ditetapkan kemudian.

Peguam Datuk Seri Gopal Sri Ram yang mewakili perayu, Rosliza Ibrahim, 38, dan Peguam-Peguam Kanan Persekutuan, Suzana Atan dan Shamsul Bolhasan mewakili Jabatan Peguam Negara selaku *amicus curiae* (sahabat mahkamah) dalam rayuan itu tidak membantah terhadap permohonan tersebut.

Jumirah ketika ditemui media memberitahu, permohonan

penangguhan itu dibenarkan oleh Ketua Hakim Negara, Tun Tengku Maimun Tuan Mat yang sepatutnya mempengerusikan panel sembilan hakim pendengaran rayuan itu.

Beliau turut menyatakan mahkamah telah menetapkan 27 Oktober ini untuk pengurusan kes bagi menetapkan tarikh baharu pendengaran rayuan itu.

Pada 2015, Rosliza memfailkan saman pemula memohon perisytiharan bahawa dia bukan ber-

Kami dapati beberapa kali penambahbaikan

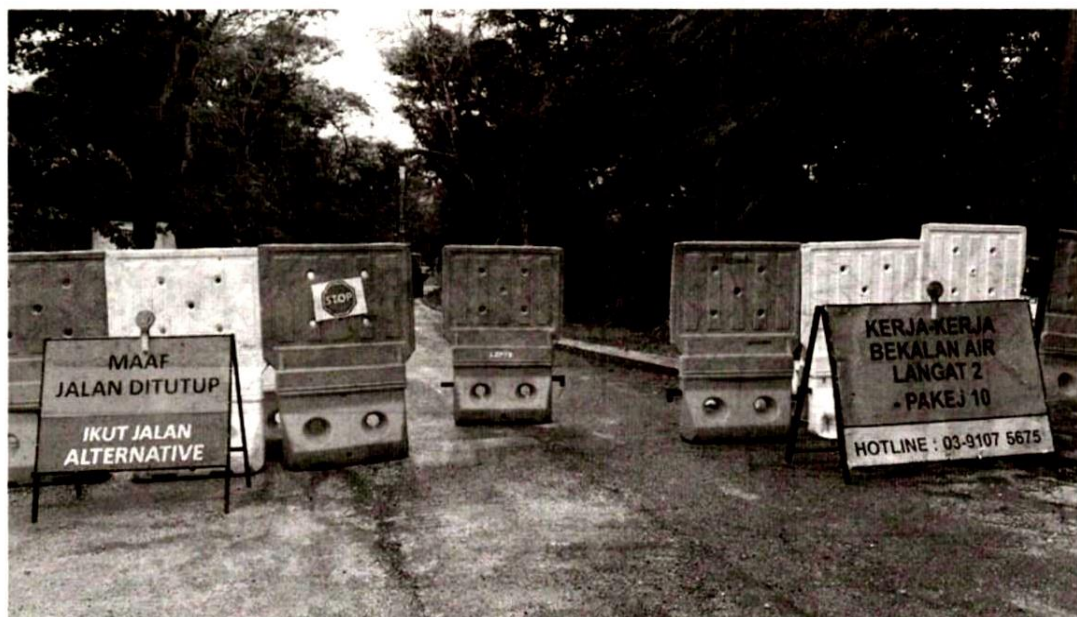

Polis kenal pasti suspek cemarkan sungai Batang Benar

SEREMBAN – Polis Negeri Sembilan sudah mengenal pasti suspek yang membuang sisa buangan hingga mencemarkan sungai Batang Benar di Nilai dekat sini dan yakin individu berkenaan dapat ditangkap tidak lama lagi.

Timbalan Ketua Polis Negeri Sembilan, Senior Asisten Komisioner Che Zakaria Othman berkata, pegawainya kini berada di sebuah negeri tempat suspek tinggal dan yakin individu itu dapat ditangkap seterusnya didakwa di mahkamah.

“Selepas menerima laporan Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN) mengenai insiden ini, kami membuka kertas siasatan dan seterusnya memburu suspek yang disyaki terbabit mencemarkan sungai Batang Benar ini.

“Kami yakin dapat menangkap suspek dalam tempoh terdekat dan membawanya ke negeri ini untuk didakwa,” katanya ketika melawat lokasi pencemaran di Jalan Emas di Kawasan Perindus-

trian Nilai dekat sini.

Ujarnya, kes berkenaan disiasat mengikut Seksyen 430 Kanun Keseksaan kerana mencemarkan tali air atau sungai.

Kelmarin sejumlah 309,687 akaun pengguna di wilayah Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat dan Sepang mengalami gangguan bekalan air tidak berjadual selepas operasi di Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) Sungai Semenyih dan Bukit Tampoi dihentikan.

Sungai Batang Benar mengalir terus ke Sungai Semenyih dan terletak sejauh kira-kira 30 kilometer dari LRA Sungai Semenyih.

Sementara itu, Pengerusi Jawatan Kuasa Bertindak Kesihatan, Alam Sekitar, Koperasi dan Kepenggunaan, S. Veerapan berkata, pihak berkuasa mengambil tindakan menutup sebuah ladang ternakan angsa di Kawasan Perindustrian Nilai yang disyaki menjadi punca pencemaran sungai Batang Be-

nar.

“Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) negeri sudah mengambil sampel di tapak pembuangan haram di Kawasan Perindustrian Nilai untuk mengetahui sama ada ia bahan buangan berjadual atau bukan.

“Kilang ternakan angsa haram yang terletak di Pajam dan disyaki mengalirkan bahan buangan ke sungai Batang Benar sudah diarahkan tutup serta-merta,” katanya.

Dalam pada itu, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Air Selangor, Suhaimi Kamaralzaman berkata, bekalan air di semua 274 kawasan terjejas dijangka pulih secara berperingkat bermula petang esok sehingga petang Jumaat.

Ujarnya, proses penstabilan rawatan air sedang dijalankan sebelum mula diagihkan kepada pengguna awal pagi ini.

“Setakat ini sampel air dari LRA Bukit Tampoi masih berada pada tahap tiga Ton dan pembersihan masih dijalankan,” jelasnya.

Dalam perkembangan lain, Suhaimi berkata, setakat terkini sampel air yang diambil dari LRA Bukit Tampoi masih berada pada tahap tiga ton dan kerja-

"Pengguna dinasihat untuk menggunakan air secara berhemat bagi memastikan proses pemulihan berjalan lancar seperti yang dijadualkan," katanya.

KUALA LUMPUR - Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) Sungai Semenyih yang dihenti tugas susulan pencemaran air mentah sejak Ahad lalu telah beroperasi semula pagi semalam.

Ketua Komunikasi Korporat Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor), Elina Baseri memaklumkan ujian persampelan yang dijalankan di muka sauk LRA Sungai Semenyih telah mencatatkan bacaan sifar ton sebanyak tiga kali berturut-turut.

Bagaimanapun, katanya, ujian persampelan yang dijalankan sehingga jam 6 pagi semalam masih mengesan pencemaran di muka sauk LRA Bukit Tampoi pada tahap dua ton.

Menurutnya, LRA Sungai Semenyih telah mula mengoperasikan pam air mentah pada pagi ini untuk kerja-kerja pembersihan paip air mentah dan tangki-tangki rawatan air.

“Usaha untuk merawat air mentah dan menstabilkan sistem LRA akan mengambil masa selama 12 jam sebelum bekalan air boleh diagihkan kepada pengguna.

“Bekalan air yang diagihkan akan melalui ujian kualiti

air dan pematuhan standard Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM),” katanya menerusi satu kenyataan di sini semalam.

Beliau berkata, Air Selangor akan memaklumkan jadual pemulihan bekalan air secara berperingkat mengikut kawasan apabila proses menstabilkan rawatan air dapat dilaksanakan sepenuhnya.

“Air Selangor telah menggerakkan sebanyak 92 lori tangki air ke premis-premis kritikal, sekolah-sekolah serta kawasan perumahan yang terjejas.

“Sebanyak 22 tangki statik, 10 stesen pengisian setempat, 9 Pusat Khidmat Setempat (PKS) dan 13 pili awam juga disediakan untuk kemudahan pengguna yang terjejas,” katanya.

Ahad lalu, empat daerah iaitu Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat dan Sepang dilaporkan berdepan gangguan bekalan air tidak berjadual susulan pencemaran air mentah di Sungai Semenyih.

Ia ekoran LRA Semenyih dan Bukit Tampoi terpaksa dihenti tugas sepenuhnya berikutan daripada insiden pencemaran tersebut.

“Kami positif bahawa suspek dapat dikesan dan polis kini sedang bekerjasama dengan semua pihak bagi tujuan itu,” katanya pada sidang akhbar selepas melawat lokasi pencemaran Sungai Batang Benar di Kawasan Perindustrian Nilai, Jalan Emas di sini semalam.

Menurutnya, polis telah pun membuka kertas siasatan mengikut Seksyen 430 Kanun

Keseksaan iaitu bagi kesalahan melakukan khianat dengan mendatangkan bencana terhadap perjalanan tali air susulan laporan yang dibuat oleh Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN).

Sementara itu Exco Kesihatan, Alam Sekitar, Koperasi dan Kepenggunaan negeri, S Veerapan yang turut berada di lokasi berkata, pihaknya masih belum dapat mengenal pasti sama ada bahan pencemaran yang ditemui di Kawasan Perindustrian Nilai, Jalan Emas yang mengalir di Sungai Batang Benar merupakan bahan buangan berjadual atau sebaliknya.

“Sampel air sudah diambil untuk dianalisa dan kita jangka keputusan akan diperoleh dalam beberapa hari lagi.

“Berdasarkan pemerhatian, bahan pencemaran itu dibuang dalam tempoh dua atau tiga hari ini dan JAS (Jabatan Alam Sekitar) dapat mengesannya apabila melihat keadaan rumput di kawasan sekitar yang sudah layu.

“Jumlah bahan yang dibuang belum dipastikan tetapi boleh dikatakan dalam kuantiti yang banyak kerana luas kawasan tercemar dianggarkan 15 hingga 20 meter,” katanya.

Sementara itu, mengenai pencemaran yang turut berkeungkinan berpunca dari Ladang Penternakan Itik di Kuala Sungai Pajam di sini, Veerapan berkata, arahan penutupan ladang berkenaan yang beroperasi secara haram sejak empat lalu akan diambil oleh pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT).

Di bawah perjanjian itu, Puncak Niaga menyerahkan anak syarikatnya - Puncak Niaga (M) Sdn Bhd dan Syabas kepada Air Selangor di bawah kerajaan negeri dengan pulangan RM1.55 bilion.

Pendaftar Mahkamah Persekutuan, Jumirah Marjuki memaklumkan pemberita bahawa pihak lain yang terlibat dalam kes itu tidak membantah permohonan tersebut.

Beliau berkata, permohonan bagi menang-

guhkan kes itu dibenarkan oleh Ketua Hakim Negara, Tun Tengku Maimun Tuan Mat yang dijadual mempengerusikan panel sembilan hakim untuk mendengar rayuan tersebut.

“Mahkamah telah menetapkan 27 Oktober untuk pengurusan kes bagi menetapkan tarikh pendengaran,” kata Jumirah.

Semalam, mahkamah sepatutnya mendengar rayuan Rosliza Ibrahim, 38, terhadap keputusan Mahkamah Rayuan yang menolak saman pemulanya bagi mendapatkan satu pengisytiharan bahawa beliau seorang penganut agama Buddha dan bukan Islam.

Peguam Datuk Seri Gopal Sri Ram yang mewakili Rosliza memaklumkan media bahawa beliau tidak membantah permohonan itu.

“Insiden seperti ini (Covid-19) boleh berlaku kepada sesiapa sahaja,” katanya ketika ditemui di Mahkamah Persekutuan. - *Bernama*

Abang Iskandar yang menjadi hakim tunggal, dalam kes itu juga memerintahkan pempetisyen membayar kos RM1,000 masing-masing kepada Kerajaan Selangor dan Majlis Agama Islam Selangor (MAIS) sebagai responden dalam kes tersebut.

Pada 21 Ogos 2019, Ketua Pendakwa Syarie menerusi pendakwa Syariah memutuskan un-

tuk mengemukakan pertuduhan di bawah Seksyen 28 Enakmen terhadap pemohon.

Pemohon dituduh cuba melakukan persetubuhan luar tabii dengan lelaki lain di dalam sebuah rumah di Selangor pada 9 November 2018.

Lelaki itu mengaku tidak bersalah dan perbicaraannya di Mahkamah Syariah ditangguhkan sementara menunggu keputusan permohonannya untuk mencabar keperlembagaan peruntukan dalam enakmen itu. - *Bernama*

tisyen itu berkata, mahkamah mendapati tiada alasan munasabah untuk membenarkan perintah dirahsiakan nama.

Abang Iskandar yang menjadi hakim tunggal dalam kes itu juga memerintahkan pempetisyen membayar kos RM1,000 masing-masing kepada Kerajaan Selangor dan Majlis Agama Islam Selangor (MAIS) sebagai responden dalam kes tersebut.

Pada 21 Ogos 2019, Ketua Pendakwa Syarie menerusi pendakwa Syariah memutuskan un-

tuk mengemukakan pertuduhan di bawah Seksyen 28 Enakmen terhadap pemohon.

Pemohon dituduh cuba melakukan persetubuhan luar tabii dengan lelaki lain di dalam sebuah rumah di Selangor pada 9 November 2018.

Lelaki itu mengaku tidak bersalah dan perbicaraannya di Mahkamah Syariah ditangguhkan sementara menunggu keputusan permohonannya untuk mencabar keperlembagaan peruntukan dalam enakmen itu. - *Bername*

Koperasi PBT disaran guna platform digital

PETALING JAYA

Angkatan Koperasi Kebangsaan Malaysia Bhd (Angkasa) menyarankan koperasi pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) menggunakan platform digital, JiMATbiz untuk menjalankan aktiviti perniagaan peruncitan.

Presiden Angkasa, Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah berkata, koperasi PBT dapat menjana pendapatan menerusi JiMATbiz di bawah program Pembekalan Barangan Asas 100 (BA100).

BA100 yang mendapat sokongan Kementerian Pembangunan Usahawan dan Koperasi (MEDAC) merupakan program perniagaan e-dagang yang mengumpul belian barangan asas secara pukal mengikut permintaan di kedai runcit milik koperasi dengan menawarkan barang keperluan harian pada harga yang lebih jimat berbanding pasaran biasa.

Beliau berkata demikian kepada pemberita selepas majlis penyerahan sumbangan barangan keperluan asas kepada 150 kakitangan Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya (MBPJ) yang juga merupakan petugas barisan hadapan di sini semalam.

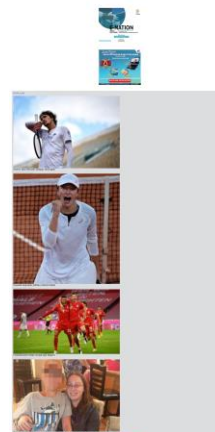

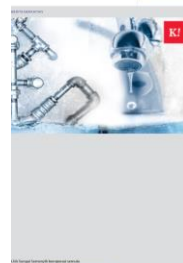

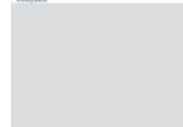

Menteri Dalam Negeri dan Air Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man berkata pemenuhan keajaiban tersebut dan keserasuan perkhidmatan di RA negeri Semenyih.

Menteri Besar Selangor Amirudin Shari juga berkata tugas negeri Semenyih untuk jualan dan bekalan mengenai RA itu. Beliau juga menekankan bahawa tugas tersebut.

'Allow foreign spouses to help at hawker stalls'

THE Selangor government is urged to allow locals with foreign spouses to assist them in their businesses.

Bukit Gasing assemblyman Rajiv Rishyakaran said the state government should reconsider the "no foreigners" rule, especially for hawker licence.

The hawker licences are issued to traders by the local council to operate at council premises, as well as morning and night markets.

He said foreigners married to Malaysians were never allowed to assist their spouses at the hawker premises within the city council's jurisdiction.

"These small scale businesses do not make huge profits. Most of them are managed by married couples and their family members.

"They need to pay about RM80 a day for local workers to assist them," said Rajiv.

He added that when a spouse is a foreigner, the situation became complicated.

"I support the ruling of only local traders regarding the hawker licence, but I hope there will be consideration given to their foreign spouses to help out with business," said Rajiv.

He added that he received appeals from five cases at Pasar Besar Jalan Othman and one case at the Section 14 market.

Rajiv said the authorities had carried out more enforcement of late due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.

He said there were 80,000 traders who had hawker licence in Selangor.

BUSINESS proprietors in Petaling Jaya can now utilise a new mobile app to promote their businesses and reach out to customers.

Traders and riders can use the Bazar@Pjkit mobile app available on Google Play store to advertise their products and services, while customers can search for what they need.

"This (app) allows traders and

entrepreneurs to increase their income and not be left out of the changing business environment," Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) said in a statement.

MBPJ is encouraging operators and traders to register with the app to fully enjoy its features.

Apart from the app, business operators can now renew and apply for business permits and licences

online via the smart licensing system.

Applicants can also print their licences via the system without having to physically go to MBPJ counters.

"This will be an integrated system whereby other agencies such as the police, Fire and Rescue Department as well as MBPJ technical agencies can provide their input for any

licence applications," MBPJ said.

Apart from digitising its services, MBPJ has initiated various programmes and assistance to hawkers (micro entrepreneurs) of the B40 group in Petaling Jaya.

Some of the initiatives include providing temporary permits for traders at their original site, but according to allocated sessions.

"The sharing of the space will

allow more traders to operate there and earn an income," added the city council.

To date, MBPJ has issued 401 temporary permits under the programme.

A pilot project for micro entrepreneurs has also been implemented at PJS 2/18 in Taman Dato Harun and the next one will be in Jalan Camar, Section 4, Kota Damansara.

Pressure's up for mums with dry taps

Unscheduled water disruption leaves families with young children exhausted

THE unscheduled water cut has caused tremendous stress to affected families in the Klang Valley who have to scramble to get access to clean water.

Mother of three, YV Poh, who is seven months pregnant, is on the verge of breaking down as she has to fend for her two school-going offspring and a toddler, as well as a pet dog.

"I am also far into my pregnancy. The stress is mounting. I feel like crying sometimes," she told *StarMetro*.

"Most of us did not see this coming, and we have used up all our water reserves from the tank.

"No water tankers were sent to our neighbourhood," she said.

Poh said her water reserves from her home tank only lasted three days.

"Unfortunately, we ran out of water faster this time round.

"We have large containers to save water but those are not enough when we have young children.

"My house porch needs to be cleaned often because of my dog to avoid the bad smell," she said, adding that she gave her children a short bath only once a day.

Poh has to depend on her friend who lives in Petaling Jaya for water supply.

"We already have to deal with the Covid-19 pandemic and the water cut just make things worse," she said.

The Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants

stopped operating on Sunday after pollution was detected in Sungai Semenyih – the raw water source for both plants.

This happened just a month after the odour pollution in Sungai Gong led to water disruption, affecting 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley and nearly 1.2 million consumer accounts.

Vatsala Nair, 36, from Taman Pinggiran Putra, Seri Kembangan, said she installed a jacuzzi outside her house for recreational use several years ago.

"It is now a water storage and rainwater catchment for non-essential use.

"I also add mosquito bait into the water.

"These water cuts are happening too often," she said, adding that she used the water from the jacuzzi to bathe the dog and to clean the porch.

Vatsala's job as an entrepreneur, who does hand casting made the situation more difficult as she relies on water supply for her craft work.

"I cannot make the casts now. Hopefully, I will not suffer too much loss in income," she said.

Vatsala still has water reserved in her home water tank for consumption.

Mother of two Shanti Nathan, 41, from USJ 9, said she has suffered back pain from carrying pails of water back and forth from her home.

"It will be bad if I miss the water tanker when it arrives in my neighbourhood.

"My husband will be away at

work when the tanks arrive, so I have to carry the pails on my own. My children are young so I cannot bring them along to fetch water," said Shanti.

She had to buy RM180 worth of water storage containers this time round.

"I have come to terms with the fact that water cuts are going to be part of the new normal, although it is unacceptable," she added.

Shanti has experienced water cuts in the past years for five days in a row during Deepavali.

"I hope there will be no such problem this year," she said.

Navin Sellapan, 39, from Setia Alam installed one large water tank and plans to add another to store more water in his house.

"This water cuts are no longer a rare occasion. I experienced it four times this year alone," he said.

More cases involving polls participants expected

KUALA LUMPUR: The recent Sabah state election appeared to have set off a string of new Covid-19 infections, with at least one minister and four assemblymen confirmed to be positive.

All five were among those actively campaigning on the ground during the state polls.

On Monday, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Religious Affairs) Datuk Seri Dr Zulkifli Mohamad Al-Bakri confirmed that he had tested positive for Covid-19.

This resulted in Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and several others, including ministers, having to undergo self-quarantine after all of them attended a meeting together on Oct 3.

They include Senior Ministers Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof and Dr Mohd Radzi Md Jidin, Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr Adham Baba, Health director-general Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah and Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Abdul Hamid Bador.

The assemblymen confirmed to have tested positive are Datuk Amiruddin Yusof (Ayer Limau), Shatiri Mansor (Kota Damansara), Lim Yi Wei (Kampung Tunku) and Azman Nasrudin (Lunas).

During campaigning from Sept 12-25, several leaders such as Umno information chief Shahril Sufian

Hamdan, Umno supreme council member Datuk Mohd Razlan Rafii, Barisan Nasional candidate for Pitas Sufian Abdul Karim and newly elected Sindumin assemblyman Datuk Dr Yusof Yacob also tested positive for Covid-19.

The number of cases is expected to rise in the coming days as more people, including politicians, media personnel and those involved in the campaigning, get their test results.

In Johor, Maharani assemblyman Nor Hayati Bachok confirmed that she had tested positive for Covid-19.

In a statement issued by her service centre, the Parti Amanah Negara national Wanita deputy chief said she returned from Sabah on Sept 26.

The first screening test came back negative.

"Even though there was no directive from the Health Ministry to self-quarantine, Nor Hayati took her own initiative to do so.

"She went for a second test on Sunday and continued self-isolating at home," the statement said.

The result of the second test, released on Monday, confirmed that she was positive.

"She has not attended any programmes since returning from Sabah. All of her close contacts have been identified by the Muar health office to undergo a Covid-19 test," the statement said.

THE light drizzle on a Saturday morning failed to dampen the spirits of some 90 university students who were committed to spending time outdoors doing good for the environment.

Arriving at the KL Forest Eco Park in Kuala Lumpur, students from Yayasan Universiti Kuala Lumpur and Kolej Universiti Islam Antarabangsa Selangor braved the morning chill to pick up litter strewn about the park.

"We want to instil the habit of keeping rubbish until it can be discarded at home if rubbish bins are not available outside.

"This is a popular spot among tourists and it is an eyesore to see rubbish strewn all over, especially plastic waste, among the greenery.

"We sought the permission of the Forestry Department before conducting this activity," he added.

Ismail said the programme was a continuation of a similar initiative it carried out last year with Perodua that focused on creating awareness among motorists on the importance of not littering roads.

"This programme will be expanded to people's housing projects across the country where we will collect used cooking oil, food waste and other recyclable items," he added.

TH executive director (operation) Mustakim Mohamad said the student participants were members of its Kelab Taha U, who had opened an account with the Islamic-investment board.

"The club holds many activities,

including educational and volunteering programmes for the students.

"These students were identified when they opened accounts via the mobile counters we placed at their respective university," he said.

Also present were SWCorp Federal Territories director Mohd Zahir Shari and Selangor and Federal Territories TH director Khairuddin Ahmad.

Separately, Ismail said SWCorp, which was under the Housing and Local Government Ministry, would embark on a campaign to encourage the wearing of reusable face masks.

He said the ministry would distribute reusable masks to schoolchildren from B40 communities across the country.

"This is because it is quite costly for parents to buy single-use masks for their children," said Ismail, who also reminded the public to dispose of their masks responsibly.

Cops on the heels of Negri water treatment polluters

NILAI: Police have obtained leads into the dumping of waste along a river at an industrial area here which is believed to have caused the closure of two water treatment plants and led to water cuts in parts of Selangor.

State deputy police chief SAC Che Zakaria Othman said the police were expecting to make the arrests soon.

"We are already on the trail of those behind this illegal act and we hope to arrest and charge them in Seremban.

"My officers are quite positive about the case," he said at the site where the waste was dumped.

However, he did not say how many suspects were expected to be

picked up or where they were from.

The dumping of the waste, believed to be liquid and semi-solid organic compounds, disrupted operations at the Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants on Sunday.

This led to a water cut to 309,867 account holders of Air Selangor in 274 areas in the Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang districts.

The supply is expected to resume in stages from today until Friday.

SAC Che Zakaria said based on preliminary findings, the waste dumped along the banks of Sg Batang Benar near here had been brought in from another state.

He declined to elaborate.

"We have opened an investigation paper and are working with our

counterparts from elsewhere including from Bukit Aman.

"We will be able to reveal more once we detain the culprits," he said, adding that the case was being investigated under Section 430 of the Penal Code for "mischief to works of irrigation or by wrongfully diverting water".

Those found guilty can be jailed between five and 30 years or fined, or both.

State environment, health, cooperatives and consumerism committee chairman S. Veerapan was also present to monitor clean-up works being carried out in the area.

He said the authorities were waiting for results from the Chemistry Department to verify the type of waste dumped.

"We have yet to establish if it was

scheduled or domestic waste and if it was the main cause of the contamination of Sg Semenyih.

"We are expecting the results from the Chemistry Department in the next few days," he said.

Veerapan said the waste was dumped in an area measuring 15m by 20m.

He appealed to the public to notify the authorities if they came across any dumping of waste-related activities.

"It is difficult to catch the culprits redhanded, as they will pick secluded areas.

"As such, we will also look into putting up CCTVs in certain areas," he said adding that the incident was the fifth illegal dumping case reported in the state since December last year.

Sudden unscheduled water cuts leave consumers high and dry

PUCHONG: Taman Bukit Serdang residents and business owners were caught off guard with the unscheduled water cut, with many of them unable to store enough water.

Niko Niko Onigiri restaurant along Jalan BS 4/1 said they could only serve limited bowls of ramen until the reserve of water supply ran out.

"Customers will have to temporarily use plastic spoons and forks for dine-in," said its manager Tammy Tan, 47.

Resident Kenagaran Kuppasamy said the water storage tank at his home has depleted as the supply was shared among seven family members.

"When we were told that Air Selangor water tanks were distributing water along Jalan Jinma 7, we quickly rushed there with all our buckets.

"We also had to ration our water usage before the supply resumed," said the 57-year-old.

Jewellery shop employee May Chew, 50, said she had to take water from her workplace in Kota Raya, Kuala Lumpur back home.

"Due to the unscheduled water cut, we did not save enough water and have been relying on the water tank at home," she said.

Separately, Puchong MCA started a signature petition against the Selangor government over the mismanagement of water supply in the state.

"We want the government to take responsibility and apologise to affected residents due to the frequent water problems.

"Unscheduled water cuts have been occurring often including a major disruption last month when four treatment plants were closed due to the contamination of Sungai Gong.

"Now, the odour pollution in Sungai Semenyih affects nearly 310,000 consumer accounts in the Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang districts.

"This clearly shows the inability of the state government to manage water issues," said its division chairman Liew Yuen Keong in a press conference.

Liew said the petition was aimed at stating the unhappiness of the people with the state government over the frequent water disruption.

"We also request for the Menteri Besar and the state exco in charge of water to take a RM10 pay cut.

"This is to show that they are committed to the people and will offer compensation or rebate to affected households for at least four months.

"Water is one of the basic needs of the people. These unscheduled water cuts will add to their burden," Liew said, adding that the people were already facing increased stress with the recent spike in Covid-19 cases.

'Water expected to be fully restored by Friday'

KUALA LUMPUR: Consumers in the Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang districts in Selangor should brace for a few more days of dry taps as water supply is expected to resume in stages and expected to be only fully restored by Friday.

Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) announced that resumption would be staggered into three main stages.

Of the 274 areas affected, 145 would have their supply restored completely by 6pm today in the first stage, said its chief executive officer Suhaimi Kamaralzaman.

"Another 91 areas in the second stage will have their supply restored completely by 6pm on Thursday and another 38 by 6pm on Friday in the third stage," he said during a press briefing at the Air Selangor headquarters in Bangsar yesterday.

Although the Sungai Semenyih water treatment plant resumed operations on Tuesday morning, supply did not resume immediately in order to allow for the water treatment stabilisation to work first, he said.

He assured that the supply would comply with the standards set by

the Health Ministry before being distributed to consumers.

The operations of Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants were stopped on Sunday after the authorities detected a "carcass-like" smell in Sungai Semenyih, which supplies raw water to both facilities.

The stoppage caused supply to some 310,000 user accounts involving 1.3 million consumers in Selangor to be disrupted.

In a statement earlier yesterday, Air Selangor said the samples taken at the uptake of the Sungai Semenyih plant recorded 0 TON (threshold odour number) three

times in a row.

However, Suhaimi said that the water at the Bukit Tampoi plant still recorded a reading of 3 TON yesterday and Air Selangor was unable to ascertain when this would be resolved.

"Consumers who get their supply from the Bukit Tampoi plant will receive water from the Sungai Semenyih plant instead," he said.

He said investigations would be made in response to *The Star's* front page photo yesterday that showed Puchong Jaya residents being supplied with dirty water via a mobile tanker.

Suhaimi, however, declined to disclose the pollution offender, saying instead that the matter should be referred to the relevant ministry.

Authorities had said that waste and chemical compounds found in a bush near the Nilai Industrial Area in Negri Sembilan, had caused the pollution, where the odour matched that which was detected near the Semenyih water treatment plant.

'Onus on state govts to safeguard water sources'

KUALA LUMPUR: The onus is on state governments to stop allowing high-risk premises from operating upstream from water treatment plants in order to minimise contamination risk for raw water.

Water quality specialist Dr Zaki Zainudin said state governments must begin by targeting new industries in order to prioritise raw water sources and protect the catchment areas.

"We can also opt to monitor the hundreds of outfits and beef up enforcement. However, it's extremely difficult to keep watch round-the-clock and identify who is dumping waste or unregulated effluents, legal or otherwise, as the stretches are extensive."

Zaki was commenting on the recent contamination issue which led to the shutdown of the Sungai Semenyih and the Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants on Sunday.

The closure of the plants affected water supply for more than 300,000 account holders in the Klang Valley. It was also the second major supply disruption for Klang Valley folk in a little over a month.

Zaki, meanwhile, said that in this case, the fact that the source

of the pollutants was traced to 30km away from the nearest treatment plant was testament to this.

He also noted that the extensive basin of the pollution-prone Sungai Semenyih was also littered with numerous industrial and agricultural industries.

Experts have long deemed the river problematic because of this.

Such pollution had also consistently led to the shutdown of the Sungai Semenyih Water Treatment plant over the years.

Zaki said the wiser way to prevent the pollution was to have the states enforce a ban on new high-risk establishments.

He said "high-risk" should be determined by experts by weighing the category of effluents, their quantities and type of operations.

Zaki also said the ban should cover the expansion of facilities that were already up and running in the upstream areas.

"This entire exercise should be done to eventually phase out all factories and establishments from operating upstream from water treatment plants.

"It requires political will and takes time, but in the interest of maintaining a sustainable supply

of water which is safe for drinking, this should be done."

Zaki said the state's proposal to channel water from Putrajaya was only a contingency measure and was unsustainable in the long run.

He feared that depending on engineering feats such as the Langkat 2 water treatment plant for a back-up was unsustainable and not practical in the long term as most river basins in the country are beset with the same problem.

Association of Water and Energy Research Malaysia president S. Piarapakaran said amendments to the Environmental Quality Act 1974 should include a clause to channel the compounds and court fines fully back to ratepayers via rebates in their water bills.

He said this, together with the Water Services Industry Act 2006, would give the government more muscle to prevent repeat incidents.

Semenyih water treatment plant resumes operations

KUALA LUMPUR: The Semenyih Water Treatment Plant's Threshold Odour Number (Ton) has dipped to 0 — the level required to allow for the resumption of water treatment operations.

Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) said the level was registered after a sampling at the facility yesterday morning.

Corporate communications head Elina Baseri said raw water pumps at the facility have been turned on to clean pipes and tanks.

“The effort to treat (water) and stabilise the plant system is expected to take 12 hours before the water can be redistributed to ratepayers. The water will also be tested by the Health Ministry.”

Air Selangor, however, said the Bukit Tampoi Water Treatment Plant Ton level was still 2 as of 6am yesterday.

A Ton level of 0 has to be reached in three consecutive sampling exercises before a treatment plant is cleared to operate.

WATER SUPPLY TO RESUME STARTING TODAY

Areas affected by water treatment plant closures will see services fully restored by Friday

WATER supply to the 274 areas affected by the latest disruption is expected to be restored in stages starting today at 6pm and will be fully restored Friday.

Some 1.3 million consumers from the Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang districts have been without water since Sunday following the shutdown of the Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants.

"By 12 midnight tonight users will start to see water trickling in," Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd chief executive officer Suhaimi Kamaralzaman said during a live press conference on Facebook yesterday.

He also confirmed that the treatment plant in Sungai Semenyih was up and running since yesterday morning.

Odour pollution had forced the utility company to shut down the water treatment plants on Sun-

day afternoon.

On Monday, Environment and Water Minister Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man said the odour pollution was suspected to have originated from the Nilai Industrial Estate in Negri Sembilan.

He said preliminary investigations found that the polluted water entered Sungai Semenyih from Sungai Batang Benar, which is close to the industrial area.

Selangor Environment, Green Technology and Consumer Affairs Committee chairman Hee Loy Sian said a duck and chicken farm near Sungai Pajam was also one of the establishments under suspicion as it had done a major

clean-up on the morning of the incident.

Asked if the source of the pollution had been found, Suhaimi told reporters to check with the ministry.

He said the treated water would be tested to ensure that it complied with the Health Ministry standards of quality and safety.

This disruption comes on the heels of a similar incident last month that affected 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley, Petaling, Klang/Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Hulu Selangor, Gombak and Kuala Langat for almost a week.

At the time, Air Selangor reported that pollution at Sungai

Gong, the raw water source for Sungai Selangor's water treatment plants in Phases 1, 2 and 3, as well as Rantau Panjang had forced the plants to shutdown.

A total of 98 tankers have been deployed by the state-owned utility company. Some 26 static tanks, 11 filling stations, 9 local service stations and 13 public taps have been made available.

SHAH ALAM: Two more politicians have tested positive for Covid-19. They are Kampung Tunku state assemblyman Lim Yi Wei and Kota Damansara state assemblyman Shatiri Mansor.

In a post on her Facebook page yesterday, Lim confirmed she was infected, while Shatiri made the announcement in a video on his website.

According to Lim, she underwent Covid-19

screening at klia2 upon her return from Sabah on Sept 27 and was placed under home quarantine.

She said when the results came on Sept 30, it was negative, but she had the symptoms and took the test again on Oct 2, which turned out positive.

Meanwhile, Shatiri, his wife, their son and seven staff of his service centre underwent

screening at klia2 on Sept 27 upon their return from Sabah, following which they were placed under a 14-day home quarantine.

"However, yesterday I received a call from the Petaling Health centre saying I tested positive for Covid-19, and so did my wife and our son. All of us were taken to Sungai Buloh Hospital for treatment," he said.

Three of his staff tested negative. - Bernama

➤ Eatery owner laments hardship, losses brought on by pollution of Sungai Semenyih

PETALING JAYA: The patience of residents at Precint 15 in Putrajaya have dried up, just like their taps have over the last few days.

Business owner Adzim Ab Rahman is at his wits' end, as the situation has made it difficult to operate his two eateries.

"I'm losing RM2,000 to RM3,000 a day," he told *theSun* yesterday, adding that he had only recently opened his eateries.

"I have 15 employees, including part-timers, to worry about. On top of that, there is the bank loan. I feel helpless," the father of one said.

Adzim is one of more than 300,000 parties whose water supply have been disrupted as a result of pollution in Sungai

Semenyih. The contamination has forced the closure of two water treatment plants, leaving 274 areas in the districts of Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang in Selangor without water supply.

Adzim said if the water cut continues for another week, he will have to consider closing shop.

"I can't continue operating a business that is heavily reliant on clean water supply."

He said other businesses near his eateries have already put up signs to state that they are closed.

The extent of losses incurred by businesses in the latest round of water cuts has yet to be ascertained, but is expected to be extensive.

In September, aggrieved consumers filed a class-action suit against a factory owner and others responsible for water disruption

to more than a million households in Selangor and Kuala Lumpur.

Consumers Association of Penang member Uma Ramaswamy said a royal commission of inquiry should be set up to investigate the failure of the relevant authorities to address the frequent water cuts in Selangor.

"Water is a basic right and should not be compromised," she said.

Stakeholders have also called for a single authority to safeguard the country's water resources.

As of press time, the source of the Sungai Semenyih water pollution had yet to be determined. However, Negri Sembilan executive councillor S. Veerapan had earlier cited leachate from duck farms and an egg processing plant as the possible cause of the pollution.

In a statement yesterday, Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd said the raw water pumps at the Sungai Semenyih water treatment plant resumed operations in the morning and operations to clean the pipes and treatment tanks were ongoing.

However, Lim decided to undergo a second swab test after experiencing some Covid-19 symptoms.

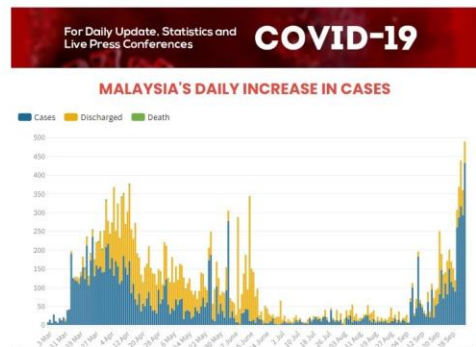
"Upon PKD's advice, I took a second swab test on Oct 2 and continued to self-quarantine until I received the news from PKD today," she said.

Lim said her team had also been observing self-quarantine since returning from Sabah.

"They tested negative on their first swab test and will be doing a second test.

"I apologise to all health ministry staff members, my colleagues and all who are inconvenienced, despite all the precautions that I have taken since day one," she said.

Lim also urged those who had been in contact with her during the last 14 days to undergo Covid-19 screening at the nearest health clinic.

will issue a schedule for the restoration of water supply to those areas that receive water from the Sungai Semenyih once the process of stabilising the water treatment is completed. — Picture by Yusof Mat Isa KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 6 — It looks like taps could start flowing again soon for the over 300,000 households in the Klang Valley that are currently experiencing water cuts.

In a statement, Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd said that the Sungai Semenyih water treatment plant (LRA) started pumping raw water this morning so that the raw water pipes and water treatment tanks can be cleaned.

The utility company added that samples and tests conducted at the Sungai Semenyih LRA had recorded 0 TON (three odour number) at least three times consecutively this morning.

However, Bukit Tampoi LRA is still at 2 TON, it added.

"Efforts to treat the raw water and stabilise the LRA system will take 12 hours before water supply can be distributed to consumers."

"The distributed water supply will go through water quality testing and standard compliance by the Ministry of Health Selangor stated.

Air Selangor added that it will issue a schedule for the restoration of water supply to those areas that receive water from the Sungai Semenyih LRA once the process of stabilising the water treatment is completed.

It also advised affected consumers to check the Air Selangor app, Air Selangor official channels on social media as well as visit their website at www.airselangor.com for regular updates.

On Sunday, Air Selangor confirmed that odour pollution had caused the Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants to cease operations temporarily at around 4.30pm.

The shutdown has left 309,687 consumer accounts in 274 areas in the districts of Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang without water.

That same day, Environment and Water Minister Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan said that the odour pollution is suspected to have originated from the Nilai Industrial Estate in Negri Sembilan.

He added that preliminary investigations found that the polluted water entered Sungai Semenyih from Sungai Batan Besar, which is close to the industrial area.

This latest disruption comes on the heels of a similar incident last month that affected 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley including Klang/Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Hulu Selangor, Gombak and Kuala Langat for almost a week.

At the time, Air Selangor confirmed that pollution at the raw water source had also halted operations at the Sungai Selangor water treatment plants in Phases 1, 2 and 3, as well as Rantau Panjang.

Johor Environment Dept raids factories in Sungai Sembong over river pollution, RM230,000 in compounds issued

Johor Bahru: On 5 - A total of 115 compounds, worth a total of RM230,000, were issued by the Johor Department of Environment (JDE) to factories located along Sungai Sembong in Klang, following a recent operation in the area.

The two-day operation, called 'Ops Sungai Sembong', started on September 30 and saw a permit being inspected after a river pollution case occurred in the area in June and July this year.

Johor Health and Environment Committee chairman K. Velupillai said the operation involved a total of 40 Johor JDE enforcement personnel following the river pollution incidents which affected the business of Klang Ash in the nearby area.

He said a total of 55 premises were inspected according to the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and as a result several actions have been taken.

The two LRTs involved are the Sungai Sembong and Bukit Tampoi.

Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari yesterday was quoted as saying that the source of pollution was detected in Sungai Klang Besar, which is 30 kilometres from the Sungai Sembong LRT.

A total of 115 compounds were issued with RM230,000 each. 55 notices were issued for not complying with the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and 58 notices were issued for not managing their scheduled waste properly.

"Besides that, the operation also saw the seizure of three operational equipment and an investigation paper initiated because as a permit did not have the required Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) certificate from DOE," said Velupillai in a statement issued here today.

On June 2 and July 13, dead fish were found floating in parts of Sungai Sembong and had impacted the livelihood of the Orang Asli community in the area.

Following that, Johor JDE conducted an operation and suspended the licence of the premises that was suspected to have caused the pollution under Regulation 4 of the Environmental Quality (Polluting Regulations) 1977 and Environmental Quality Act 1974.

Velupillai said the latest operation was a follow-up to the pollution incident a few months ago and the Johor Dept has been targeting pollution case seriously which affected the livelihoods of the Orang Asli community.

He added that the operation will continue to be carried out while regular enforcement and monitoring of industrial causes that release wastewater to Sungai Sembong and other rivers in Klang will be conducted.

Speaking in Selangor, the state's water utility company (Pegagaun Air Selangor) said that the Selangor in a statement stated that a total of 300,000 account holders in Prating, Mulu Lintang, Kuala Langat and Klang areas have experienced intermittent water supply disruptions after operations of two Water Treatment Plants (WTP) were being suspended due to pollution.

The two LRTs involved are the Sungai Sembong and Bukit Tampoi.

SEREMBAN, Oct 5 — The Negri Sembilan government is waiting a detailed report from state Department of Environment (DoE) on river pollution in Batang Benar, Nila.

State Health, Environment, Cooperatives and Consumerism Committee chairman S. Veerapan said apart from that, he is also waiting for a detailed report from the state Water Regulatory Body (WRB).

"Based on the investigation conducted last night, state DoE director Azuri Azizah Saedon said that the cause is still unknown and thus far, it is based on assumptions.

"First, the pollution is likely from duck farms in Kuala Sungai Pajam, which borders Negri Sembilan and Selangor, leachate from Pajam landfill and then from Nilai 2 industrial area, possibly from chicken egg processing plant," he said in a statement here today. .

NILAI, Oct 5 — The incident of pollution in Sungai Batang Besar, here, is believed to be using the same modus operandi as the three other cases of river pollutions in Negri Sembilan prior to this.

State Secretary, Datuk Razali Ab Malik said the contaminants were believed to have been dumped in the state by parties from outside Negri Sembilan.

“The wastes were brought in by lorries and dumped in the area and we are taking measures to prevent them from ending in the river.

“We will conduct cleaning work after samples of the contaminants are taken for analysis by the Chemistry Department,” he told Bernama when met at the scene, here, today.

Due to the dumping incident, he said the area was closed to the public.

“Previously, three waste dumping cases were also detected in the state. Sungai Anak Air Garam, in Mambau, and Sungai Belihol, in Mantin, were polluted with oil and chemical wastes, respectively, in December last year while Sungai Batang Nilai, here, was polluted with waste oil in August this year.

Commenting further, he said the state government would continue to monitor the area to prevent the dumping incidents from recurring.

The Ministry of Environment and Water (Kasa), in a statement today, announced that a shrubby area in jalan Emas, on the fringe of the Nilai Industrial Area, here, had been identified as the main location of the wastes.

The ministry said a number of wastes including organic compounds were found at the site.

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 5 — The over 300,000 households in the Klang Valley that are currently hit by water cuts are in second day of disruption as the raw water supply to the affected treatment plants remains contaminated.

In a statement this morning, utility provider Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd said, as a result, the Sungai Semenyih Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants were not fully operational as of 7.30am today.

"As of 7.30am, pollution is still detected at Sungai Semenyih and is at the level of 7 TONNE (threshold odour number) the Bukit Tampoi water treatment plant and 5 TONNE at the Sungai Semenyih water treatment plant respectively," A Selangor said in the statement.

It added that since the pollution was first reported over 14 hours ago, the plants have not been able to produce the million litres a day required by consumers in the 274 affected areas.

Air Selangor also said that it cannot pinpoint an exact time as to when the water supply will be restored in full.

"At this time, we have yet to determine when the water supply can resume again," it added.

Air Selangor advised affected consumers to check the Air Selangor app, Air Selangor official channels on social media, well as visit their website at www.airelangor.com for regular updates.

Yesterday, Air Selangor confirmed that odour pollution had caused the Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi water treatment plants to cease operations temporarily at around 4.30pm.

The shutdown has left 305,687 consumer accounts in 274 areas in the districts of Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang without water.

Last night, Environment and Water Minister Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan said that the odour pollution is suspected to have originated from the Nilai Industrial Estate in Negeri Sembilan.

He added that preliminary investigations found that the polluted water entered Sungai Semenyih from Sungai Batan Benar, which is close to the industrial area.

"Currently, we have to wait for the odour pollution to subside before the plant can operate again.

"As of now, we are not sure how long it will take because we are still investigating the cause," he was quoted as saying national news agency Bernama during a press conference at the Sungai Semenyih Water Treatment Plant Raw Water Pump Station.

This latest disruption comes on the heels of a similar incident last month that affected 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley, Petaling, Klang/Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Hulu Selangor, Gombak and Kuala Langat for almost a week.

At the time, Air Selangor confirmed that pollution at the raw water source had also halted operations at the Sungai Selangor water treatment plants in Phases 1, 2 and 3, as well as Rantau Panjang.

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 4 — Over 300,000 households in the Klang Valley will have to suffer water cuts because of raw water pollution in Sungai Semenyih, the second of such incident in the space of a month.

In a statement today, utility provider Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd said this has caused Sungai Semenyih and Bt Tampoi water treatment plants to cease operations temporarily, affecting some 274 areas and 309,687 accounts, involving the Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang districts.

"Air Selangor has activated an Emergency Action Plan to help affected customers following this incident," said Elna E Air Selangor's head of communications.

Air Selangor also said it has reported the incident to the state's water authority and is in the midst of investigating the source of the pollution.

"Air Selangor have reported the incident to Selangor Water Management Authority (SUAS) and actions have been taken to identify the source of the raw water pollution along Sungai Semenyih and streams surrounding Sungai Semenyih," said the statement.

"At this time, we have yet to ascertain the period of when the plant and the [water] supply can resume again," added statement.

The recent water supply disruption came after a similar incident last September which saw some 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley, Petaling, Klang/Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Hulu Selangor, Gombak and Kuala Langat facing water disruption. This subsequently affected some 1.2 million consumers within the Klang Valley.

This was due to Air Selangor ceasing operations at the Sungai Selangor water treatment plants in Phases 1, 2 and 3, well as Rantau Panjang due to pollution at the raw water source.

Water supply to resume in stages, latest by Friday

WATER supply to affected households in several districts in Selangor will resume in stages over the next three days starting midnight yesterday.

Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) CEO Suhaimi Kamaralzaman said in a statement yesterday that the resumption will be spaced out into three main stages.

"The first stage will see supply restored to 145 areas by 6pm on Wednesday, while another 91 areas in the second stage will have their supply restored completely by 6pm on Oct 8.

"The third stage will involve 38 areas that will receive supply by 6pm on Oct 9," he said.

According to Suhaimi, the Sungai Semenyih water treatment plant (LRA) had resumed operations yesterday morning.

Earlier, Air Selangor said sampling tests carried out at the Sungai

Semenyih LRA came out with readings of zero TON (threshold odour number) three times consecutively.

However, a pollution of Level 2 TON was still detected at the Bukit Tampoi LRA from a sampling test conducted until 6am yesterday.

The water provider noted that the Sungai Semenyih LRA had begun pumping raw water yesterday morning for the cleaning of the pipes and treatment tanks.

"Efforts to treat raw water and stabilise the LRA system will take 12 hours before water supply can be distributed to consumers.

"The water supply will go through quality testing and standard compliance by the Health Ministry," it said in a statement.

The schedule for water supply restoration will be informed in stages once the process of water stabilisation treatment can be implemented fully.

"Air Selangor has mobilised 92 water tanker trucks to critical premises, schools and affected residential areas, while 22 static tanks, 10 local charging stations, nine local service centres and 13

public taps are provided for the convenience of the affected users," it said.

The unscheduled water supply disruption has affected 309,687 households in four districts, namely Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang caused by raw water pollution.

Due to the pollution, both Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi LRAs have halted work on Sunday.

Air Selangor said it will also update information on unscheduled water supply disruption from time to time through all Air Selangor communications and social media platforms, including Twitter, Facebook, Instagram and its website www.airselangor.com.
