MUSIM lepas semasa kerajaan Perikatan Nasional (PN) berkuasa 17 bulan, pelantikan Timbalan Perdana Menteri (TPM) kelihatan dibuat secara tergesa-gesa. Dilakukan kurang empat jam sebelum mesyuarat Majlis Kerja Tertinggi (MKT) UMNO.

Pelantikan yang diumumkan sekitar 5 petang, 7 Julai tahun ini itu hanya diisi selepas jawatan nombor dua kerajaan itu 'lompong' selama satu tahun empat bulan selepas Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin angkat sumpah 1 Mac 2020.

Kata Pejabat Perdana Menteri kelapan (PM8), TPM yang dilantik akan dapat "membantu Muhyiddin menguruskan pentadbiran negara dan memenuhi keperluan rakyat dalam keadaan negara sedang menghadapi krisis kesihatan dan ekonomi pada masa ini".

Namun ibarat 'telah karam maka bertimba', malam hari sama Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob dilantik TPM itu, MKT dipengerusikan Presiden UMNO, Datuk Seri Dr. Ahmad Zahid Hamidi membuat keputusan menarik sokongan terhadap kerajaan PN dan mendesak Muhyiddin berundur.

Susulan penarikan sokongan kira-kira 15 ahli Parlimen UMNO terhadap kerajaan pimpinan Muhyiddin itulah membolehkan Ismail Sabri yang tidak sampai dua bulan mengisi jawatan TPM, diberi kepercayaan menggalas tanggungjawab besar sebagai pemimpin nombor satu negara.

Muhyiddin mengemukakan peletakan jawatan PM8 pada 16 Ogos susulan kehilangan sokongan majoriti ahli Dewan Rakyat. Ia selang dua minggu selepas Ahli Parlimen Lenggong, Datuk Seri Dr. Shamsul Anuar

Nasarah meletak jawatan Menteri Tenaga dan Sumber Asli.

Maka selepas 44 hari PM9 angkat sumpah pada 21 Ogos, adakah jawatan TPM yang tidak dinyatakan dalam Perlembagaan Persekutuan itu masih relevan untuk diisi oleh Ismail Sabri? Adakah keperluan mengisi jawatan TPM ini akan meletakkan Naib Presiden UMNO itu dalam tekanan meskipun itu hak prerogatif Perdana Menteri?

DUA PILIHAN

Setakat ini, pilihan yang ada sekarang adalah dua pemimpin daripada Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia (Bersatu) iaitu Datuk Seri Hamzah Zainuddin, 64, dan Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali, 57. Hamzah yang juga Setiausaha Agung Bersatu diakui pengkritiknya seorang pemimpin tegar Bersatu.

Walaupun semua maklum beliau diketahui membawa kira-kira enam bekas ahli Parlimen UMNO ke dalam parti, Bersatu difahamkan bergantung kepada 'buah fikiran dan strateginya'.

"Kalau tidak kerananya, masakan PN sampai boleh menerajui Sabah pada 26 September tahun lalu di bawah Pengerusi Bersatu negeri, Datuk Seri Hajiji Noor. Banyak perancangan Bersatu membuahkan kejayaan... hasil tangan Hamzah," kata pengkritiknya, yang sekali gus mengukuhkan kepercayaan Menteri Dalam Negeri itu.

Azmin pula yang merupakan timbalan presiden PKR sebelum bergabung dengan Bersatu, diketahui membawa 11 ahli Parlimen ketika Langkah Sheraton. Blok 11 ahli Parlimen itu ramai dan masih bersama dengannya.

Azmin dipercayai lebih disukai Muhyiddin. Menteri Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri itu dinamakan oleh Muhyiddin beberapa hari selepas mengumumkan barisan Kabinet baharunya 9 Ogos tahun lalu sebagai "menteri kanan yang akan memperkerusi mesyuarat Kabinet sewaktu ketiadaan saya". Yang giliran keduanya adalah Ismail Sabri (yang ketika itu juga menteri kanan).

Daripada sumber-sumber yang layak dipercayai kepada *Utusan Malaysia*, nama Azmin masih disebut setakat Julai lalu oleh Muhyiddin sebagai 'pilihan Bersatu'. Maka apa pilihan Ismail Sabri?

CALON SABAH DAN SARAWAK

Ketika asyik memperkatakan dua calon pilihan ini, ada pandangan yang tiba di selekoh, supaya TPM juga perlu dilantik dari Sabah dan Sarawak. Pernah ada gesaan supaya Kerajaan Persekutuan melantik dua orang lagi TPM, masing-masing dari dua negeri itu untuk membendung perasaan tidak puas hati warga Malaysia Timur.

"Lantik seorang timbalan perdana menteri untuk setiap wilayah dan perdana menteri akan dipilih oleh wakil rakyat atau menerusi sistem penggiliran," kata ADUN Sabah, Datuk Jeffrey Kitingan di sebuah forum bertajuk 'Perjanjian Malaysia 1963 (MA63)' di Kuala Lumpur pada Jun 2014.

Jeffrey mencadangkan Semenanjung Malaysia kekal dengan 11 negeri sementara Sarawak dibahagikan kepada sembilan negeri manakala Sabah, lima negeri. Tambah beliau, perlunya tiga TPM masing-masing satu untuk Semenanjung, Sabah dan Sarawak. "Kita perlu selesaikan masalah ini, jika tidak kita harus berpisah dari Malaysia," katanya waktu itu.

Begitupun, hari ini selepas tujuh tahun isu MA63 itu dibangkitkan Jeffrey, banyak kejayaan sebenarnya telah ditempa dari rundingan MA63 yang terkandung dalam memorandum persefahaman (MoU) Transformasi dan Kestabilan Politik antara Kerajaan Persekutuan.

Dan pada 13 September lalu, Ismail Sabri juga telah menyatakan komitmennya

terhadap MA63 dengan memasukkan enam transformasi ke dalam MoU Transformasi dan Kestabilan Politik yang dimeterai antara Kerajaan Persekutuan dan Pakatan Harapan (PH). Melalui MoU itu, transformasi MA63 akan memperkukuh usaha ke arah pelaksanaan perkara yang termaktub dalam perjanjian itu dengan dokumen yang berkaitan dengannya.

Meskipun usaha meneruskan MA63 disenangi setakat ini oleh Sabah dan Sarawak, keperluan melantik TPM dari kalangan pemimpin kedua-dua negeri masih boleh difikirkan.

Apa lagi pula dengan Sarawak akan menyaksikan Pilihan Raya Negeri Ke-12 selepas Darurat berakhir Februari tahun depan, sekurang-kurangnya jawatan TPM yang diperuntukkan kepada pemimpin negeri itu akan terus memberi imej baik rakyat negeri itu kepada Pusat.

Dan setidak-tidaknya menerusi pelantikan TPM dari Sabah dan Sarawak akan 'menyejukkan' isu yang barangkali cuba dicetuskan oleh pengkritik terhadap calon TPM dari Semenanjung.

Ismail Sabri bagaimanapun dipercayai lebih maklum isu pelantikan TPM - setelah belajar banyak dari pengalaman 17 bulan bersama PN meskipun menginjak begitu pantas dari menteri kanan ke Perdana Menteri.

Jika diterima hujah di atas tadi, adakah calon TPM itu Ketua Menteri Sarawak, Datuk Patinggi Abang Johari Tun Openg, 71, dan Hajiji, 65?

Golongan ditetapkan kerajaan wajib ambil vaksin

Hukum penggunaan vaksin Covid-19 adalah harus dan wajib diambil oleh golongan yang ditetapkan kerajaan, kata Mufti Selangor, Datuk Dr Anhar Opir.

Menurut Anhar, ketetapan itu dibuat menerusi Jawatankuasa Fatwa Negeri Selangor Kali Ke-1/2021 yang bersidang pada 9 Februari lalu dan turut diperkenankan Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah Alhaj.

Beliau berkata, berdasarkan fatwa berkenaan, beberapa per-

kara perlu difahami oleh masyarakat di mana hukum harus kepada orang awam adalah merujuk kepada pilihan sendiri sama ada ingin mengambilnya atau tidak.

"Hukum wajib pula merujuk kepada kemestian tanpa sebarang pilihan yang memberi implikasi berdosa jika tidak mengambilnya ke atas golongan yang ditetapkan oleh kerajaan.

"Dan kerajaan adalah bermaksud kerajaan Malaysia, kerajaan negeri atau ketua agama negeri termasuk pihak berkuasa yang dilantik," katanya dalam satu kenyataan pada Sabtu.

Mengulas lanjut, Anhar berkata, berdasarkan penjelasan fatwa berkenaan, sesiapa yang telah ditetapkan oleh Uli al-Amri (pemerintah) bagi mengambil vaksin Covid-19 adalah wajib untuk mendapatkannya.

"Ini termasuk semua guru Kelas al-Quran dan Fardu Ain (KAFA), ahli jawatankuasa (AJK) masjid dan surau dan Penolong Pendaftar Nikah di negeri ini dan seumpamanya," katanya.

Pada September lalu, Sultan Sharafuddin menzahirkan rasa dukacita apabila dimaklumkan hanya 203 daripada 873 orang

guru KAFA, AJK masjid dan jurunikah di Selangor hadir pada program vaksinasi khas Covid-19 Frontliner Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS).

Menerusi kenyataan di laman Facebook Selangor Royal Office, lebih mendukacitakan baginda apabila 96 daripada 203 orang yang hadir menolak untuk divaksin.

Berikutan itu, baginda juga akan meneliti nama-nama guru KAFA, AJK masjid dan jurunikah terlibat yang memutuskan untuk tidak divaksin dalam program berkenaan.

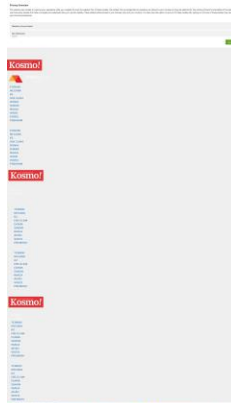

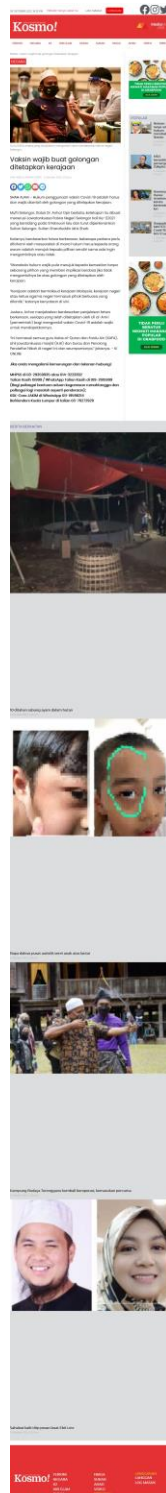

Repurposing single-use plastics

Material turned into usable items to be sold at MBPJ's recycling centre

SINGLE-use plastics do not benefit the environment, and extending the lifespan of the plastic is only a temporary solution.

Nevertheless, it is still important to repair, reuse or recycle such plastics instead of having them discarded as landfill.

Plastic waste can take hundreds of years to decompose and repurposing it will help avoid the slow process of dumping.

This waste also pollutes the marine environment and causes many kinds of

environmental hazards.

As a short-term measure to address this issue, Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) has embarked on several activities such as polyethylene (PE) recycling and the making of eco-bricks by communities.

To underscore the importance of these activities, MBPJ set up the PJ Eco Recycling Plaza in SSK, Petaling Jaya.

Petaling Jaya Solid Waste Management and Public Cleansing Department director Lee Ian Shivan said they wanted to raise awareness of recycling.

However, the ultimate goal is for the public to stop single-use plastics altogether.

Recycling waste

At the PJ Eco Recycling Plaza, polystyrene recycling was carried out prior to the inventory control order as part of the city council advocacy work to spread the message to residents.

Once the pandemic is over, the recycling process would be open for the public to view, said Lee, adding that the process was educational.

At the centre, donated polystyrene such as foam from nurseries, offices and schools, is recycled and turned into various items such as photo frames or wall art.

for boxes.

"Polystyrene such as those used to pack laboratory sets are chosen for use of better quality compared to the ones discarded after transporting material to the market," said Lee.

He explained that the recycling process involved physically breaking the polystyrene boxes into smaller pieces.

It is then fed into a machine that melts the polystyrene pieces.

The melted blocks are shaped into small or thick.

"The problem is, sometimes the public do not compress the plastics into the bottle well."

"So I would then need to compress the plastics again."

"The plastics must also be cleaned before being stuffed into the bottle."

"A lot of plastic bags are required to fill up a bottle, so the process is time-consuming."

Each month, about 10 bottles are dropped off at the plaza by the public.

Residents groups in the city are urged to help make the eco-bricks.

The council plans to build a recycling centre at Kompleks C, Dealing Jaya using these bricks.

These are then sent to the respective industry's factories to be remoulded into other usable items. The end product would be displayed and sold at the plaza since the pandemic is over, said Lee.

The recycling plaza also makes eco-bricks and toys from them from the Public for Real.

Rani said the eco-bricks concept was introduced in the country in 2015.

These bricks are mainly used in countries such as Indonesia and the Philippines which do not have a good waste management system.

However, in Malaysia, eco-bricks are commonly used to make tables, tables with and benches.

Lee said building houses using the material came with a different set of challenges.

"They would make benches with steel and products."

"I think local councils can learn from them and further expand the use of eco-bricks," he concluded.

Step 1: Used polystyrene is separated according to cleanliness level.

Step 2: The polystyrene is broken into smaller pieces manually.

Step 3: Small pieces of broken polystyrene are inserted into the recycling machine.

Step 4: The recycling machine melts the polystyrene.

Step 5: The melted polystyrene is shaped into blocks and sent to the factory to be repurposed into items such as picture frames and skirting.

Step 6: The final repurposed product. Picture frames made of recycled polystyrene.

This was because there were regulations to be followed so that recycling could be installed in these buildings, he said.

Fabul said ultimately, Malaysia must head towards a circular economy.

"Everything created must be sustainable and recyclable."

"We must work towards zero-waste eco-bricks as a temporary solution to our waste problem," he stressed.

Fabul noted that the pandemic had resulted in a worsening waste problem.

"We are using more plastics as demand for food takeaway and online shopping soars."

"Even I had more plastic waste during the lockdown because I brought more items online," he said.

He added that more waste must be found for eco-bricks and noted that they were suitable to be made into street furniture.

Fabul called on local councils to work in this matter, adding that students had done this successfully here.

Damaged Kajang road to be resurfaced with concrete

AUTHORITIES in Kajang are finalising plans to repair a badly damaged portion of Jalan Simpang Balak.

Once approved by Kajang Municipal Council (MPKj), work on the two-lane road is expected to begin in the middle of this month and take nine months to complete.

Previous attempts to repair the road with asphalt did not produce any lasting solution to the damaged 170m stretch, which is frequently used by residents and heavy vehicles from surrounding industrial areas.

MPKj councillor Sangeetha Chandra Mohan said the solution proposed was to resurface the entire stretch with concrete.

"This is a long-standing issue in the area and I have received numerous complaints on the condition of the road in the past

few months.

"The number of heavy vehicles using it to travel between industrial areas makes it worse.

"The most recent repair (with asphalt) was done a few weeks ago and look at what it's become now," said Sangeetha, adding that repairs had been carried out at least three times in the past year.

During the site visit, some of the potholes were as wide as one metre and as deep as 20cm.

Balakong assemblyman Wong Siew Ki said the project was estimated to be costly as utility mapping done by consultants showed that there were many pipes and cables running beneath the road which would require relocation.

"MPKj is willing to fix this road and is awaiting the final proposal from the consultants," Wong said.

She acknowledged that it was the main road for people in Kampung Simpang Balak as well as the industrial areas, and that nine months

was a considerable period of time.

But the job could not be rushed, she said, as a mistake could cause disruption to utilities, which would make the situation worse.

"I have received several complaints of vehicles getting damaged from using this road, especially after rain as the potholes covered

by water were not visible.

"There have been over 20 reported accidents this year alone, but thankfully, there were no serious injury or deaths," she said.

Sangeetha, meanwhile, said new drainage would be added to resolve the flooding issue there, which is a low point between two slopes.

MCA calls for faster info on unscheduled water cuts

A UTILITY company has been taken to task for keeping affected residents in the dark over a recent and apparent unscheduled water disruption in a number of localities in Serdang.

MCA Central Committee member Lau Chin Kok said Air Selangor should have responded faster to queries by affected residents.

"The company did not have a timely response on the issue, resulting in complaints on its Facebook page."

Those who made the complaints

had shared their experience over the water supply disruption last Thursday.

The company had responded that it was investigating the matter.

On Saturday morning, Air Selangor said on its Twitter account that there was temporary water disruption in the areas due to low water levels and that water would be fully restored by noon.

However, as of noon on Sunday, some users were still complaining that water supply had yet to be

restored in their homes.

In the press statement, Lau said that such frequent water disruptions in Selangor was unacceptable.

"What are the people supposed to do without knowing when water supply would return?" he questioned.

Previously, MCA had suggested a KPI system to keep relevant authorities in check, as well as possible salary cuts if water disruptions continued to happen.

"Even if the water disruptions

are not 100% due to the operator's negligence, as the water authority, it is their responsibility to keep the people informed of what has happened as well as their plans to resolve the situation," said Lau, who also urged Air Selangor to review its SOP.

"There seems to be no end to these issues despite Selangor being a developed state.

"We urge the state government to start taking concrete steps in finding out the causes and addressing them," added Lau.

SELANGOR aims to enhance its response at disaster-stricken areas by setting up special centres to coordinate rescue efforts and distribute aid to affected communities.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the centres would be manned by Skwad Bencana, which would comprise volunteers from local communities as well as personnel from relevant agencies.

“The volunteers will be given the proper training to respond to emergencies in their respective state constituencies.

“They will work closely with the Civil Defence Department, Fire and Rescue Department and the local authority.”

Amirudin said this when met after the official launch of the centre at a community hall in Taman Seri Gombak.

It was activated on Sept 16 last year to distribute food aid to those affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, especially low-income households.

Broken road dividers pose danger to Klang motorists



Motorists want Klang Municipal Council to rebuild the damaged concrete dividers along Jalan Langat.

DAMAGED road dividers along Jalan Langat in Klang with no signs to indicate their presence have led to numerous accidents.

Unable to spot the dividers in time, cars and even two-wheelers have smashed into these structures.

Motorist N.P. Raman said while driving along Jalan Langat outside Bandar Bestari, he almost hit the concrete divider on the four-lane road.

"I was driving at a moderate speed when all of a sudden, the divider was in front of me.

"I managed to swerve in time as there were no other vehicles on my left then.

"Signage for the concrete divider is not visible.

"The luminous road paint has also faded," he said.

Ahmad Asri, 55, who rides a motorcycle, said the broken divider outside Bandar Bestari posed a serious danger and the authorities must urgently rebuild it.

"Such a raised structure on the road must have luminous material that will allow motorists to spot it from a distance.

"It would be better if the authorities instal raised reflectors for about 50m before the divider," said

the father of three.

Commercial advertiser Hanidah Mansor, 35, said damaged road dividers were a real danger.

"There is another divider on Jalan Langat — at the turn-off to Jalan Batu Unjur — which has also caused accidents," she said.

Klang Public Works Department (JKR) chief Zaizul Hisham, when informed of the matter, said currently, maintenance of Jalan Langat was under the LRT3 construction management.

"Klang JKR will inspect both areas with the broken dividers before informing the LRT3 construction management to carry out repairs," he added.

Selangor set to become Asean's digital hub through Sidec

Sidec also to realise Selangor becoming a liveable 'Smart State' in Asean by 2025

SELANGOR is set to emerge as Asean's leading digital hub by making the Selangor Information Technology and Digital Economy Corp (Sidec) the foundation for its digitalisation efforts.

Sidec CEO Yong Kai Ping said Sidec is also expected to realise the vision of Selangor becoming a liveable "Smart State" in Asean by 2025.

He noted that Sidec is an industry council represented by both government officials and key industry players, which was mandated to lead the digital transformation focusing on three key sectors of the digital economy — namely e-commerce, start-ups and SME (small and medium enterprise) digitalisation.

Established in January this year, Yong said the agency is determined to spearhead the digital transformation of Selangor as Asean's digital hub by nurturing the state's digital talents while narrowing the digital divide.

This includes accelerating Selangor start-ups to become regional tech icons, empowering the digitalisation of businesses and SMEs, as well as encouraging digital investment and emerging technologies in the state.

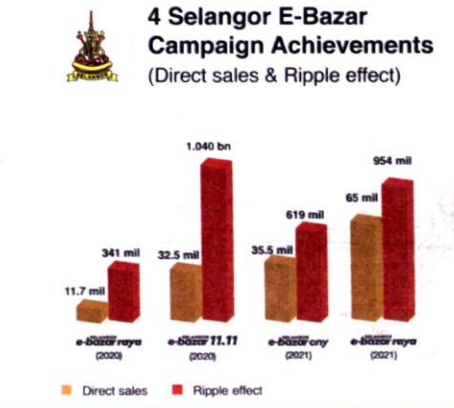
Selangor has always maintained its position as the top GDP contributor to the country's economy. The state also records about 22% of the digital economy's contribution to the national GDP.

Currently contributing about 24%, Yong believes Selangor will soon become the biggest contributor as the country's digital economy hub by 2025. This is in line with the target underlined by the MyDigital Blueprint of digitalising 873,000 SMEs located largely in Selangor by 30% and nurturing 5,000 start-ups.

"The digital economy has grown by leaps and bounds to contribute about 20% to the country's GDP, which almost matches the GDP contribution by Selangor. It is also a known fact that a major part of the digital economy is centred in Selangor," he told *The Malaysian Reserve* recently.

Yong added that due to these factors, it is of no surprise that foreign investors are very much inclined to invest in Selangor. At the same time, he said with the state's connectivity to other countries, most investors believe it is definitely worthwhile to invest in Selangor.

As the pandemic intensified digitalisation around the world, Yong noted that Selangor remains steadfast in building a digital economy and eco-



system, as well as keeping its position at the forefront of technology while attracting more investors.

As of April 2021, Selangor has recorded a foreign direct investment (FDI) of about RM9 billion, despite the more challenging economic situation now compared to a year ago.

The Malaysian Investment Development Authority (Mida) revealed that Selangor was the top investment destination in Malaysia for the third consecutive year with total investments of RM18.4 billion in 2020.

Embracing Digitalisation amid Pandemic

The global e-commerce and digital economy as a whole have grown by more than 50% due to lockdowns and work-from-home measures caused by the Covid-19 pandemic.

Selangor introduced a host of initiatives related to digitalisation, which has majorly helped its stakeholders and this was especially evident through the four rounds of the Selangor E-Bazar campaigns.

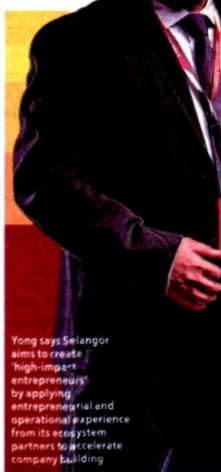
"The four E-Bazar campaigns managed to benefit almost 300,000 online merchants and nurtured 75,000 new online merchants, generating direct sales of RM145 million and creating a RM2.95 billion ripple effect to the economy of Selangor."

"The tremendous growth is a testament that e-commerce and digitalisation is booming in Selangor."

Yong emphasised that most sellers showed how their sales doubled and even tripled after joining the E-Bazar campaign.

For instance, Zaharah Aris of modest clothing brand Az-Zara Boutique only managed to make sales of RM2,000 before the Movement Control Order. However, since joining the inaugural Selangor E-Bazar Raya campaign last year, her income skyrocketed to RM50,000.

Meanwhile, Wan Shazrina Izlin Wan Mohd Zahid, whose company Marathon Baker produces home-

made energy bars, said she saw a 50% increase in sales compared to the month prior to participating in the Selangor E-Bazar 11.11 Campaign.

Another satisfied participant, Zarina Zahidan of Zarina Cakes, initially recorded sales between RM2,000 and RM3,000 after first utilising Shopee, but after participating in the E-Bazar CNY 2021 campaign and using vouchers disbursed by the state government, her sales reached RM12,000 to RM13,000.

To further empower businesses, Yong said the state government initiated the Selangor SME Digitalisation Matching Grant to assist SMEs to take the first step to digitalise their businesses. The initiative is expected to benefit 1,000 Selangor SMEs with an initial grant of RM5 million. For the first batch, the state government disbursed RM1.2 million to 280 SMEs out of 492 applicants.

Taking Digitalisation Agenda Abroad

In efforts to step up its digitalisation agenda, Yong said it is extremely important for Selangor and Malaysian businesses to engage their regional counterparts to gain overseas exposure.

He noted that the state will bring its Selangor Accelerator Programme (SAP) participants to Vietnam and Indonesia when the Covid-19 situation is under control. Additionally, he said the top five winners of SAP will be invited to join the Selangor International Pitch Showcase at the Dubai World Expo 2022.

Selangor will also be collaborating with the Taipei Computer Association and Foundation for Commerce and Culture Interchange to introduce the state's tech start-ups to Taiwan.

Yong said Sidec also plays a significant role in the Selangor International Business Summit (SIBS) 2021 through this year's 6th Selangor Smart City & Digital Economy Convention (SDEC). SDEC is an event gathering industry leaders, academics, SMEs and players from the public and private sectors to delve into the mechanics of existing and future smart city and digital economy frameworks and solutions.

Through the convention, Selangor aims to spearhead the dig-

ital transformation of Selangor as Asean's digital hub, to act as a platform for local industry players to engage and discuss on the new normal and emerging trends, and to strengthen and grow the Selangor digitalisation ecosystem for SMEs.

Sidec to Nurture SE Asia's Tech Icons

Moving forward, Yong said among the plans in store include the "Selangor Innovation Ecosystem Alliance", which is a new initiative consisting of experienced company builders, serial entrepreneurs and investors to create market-leading companies that will rise as South-East Asia's tech icons.

He said Selangor aims to create "high-impact entrepreneurs" by applying entrepreneurial and operational experience from its ecosystem partners to accelerate company building.

Yong said the formation of the alliance has been shelved for the time being due to the pandemic. However, he said its purpose to accelerate the growth of start-ups in Selangor through collaborations has been carried out through several partnerships between state government agencies and respective start-ups facilitated by Sidec.

He quoted Tourplus Technology Sdn Bhd as an example. The travel start-up secured a funding of RM4.1 million and recently signed a memorandum of understanding with Tourism Selangor to launch the Go Selangor App to digitalise tourism operators in the state to prepare post Covid-19 recovery plans.

Another initiative introduced was the "Selangor Agriculture Ecosystem Alliance" with the objective to strengthen the state's agrofood system, smart farming for agropreneurs, technology transfer and to address food security issues.

Yong said the initiative was also designed to enhance farmers' incomes, to create agricultural jobs and to raise agro-exports. He added that through the alliance, Selangor could become the most advanced agriculture powerhouse in the country.

As the starting points, two agritech start-ups, namely Havva and Kapitani, will be working together with Selangor Agricultural Development Corp (SADC) on several ventures.

Havva will be developing a 3,000 sq ft hydroponics farm at the SADC building in Shah Alam, while Kapitani — which provides simplified financial services such as booking services for farmers — will be onboarding traders and farmers at Pasar Borong Selangor.

被推举为负责人的陈瑞芬澄清，接下这个担子也是非常无奈，但是基于同业们需要复工，唯有在大家的推荐下接下重任，避免早市无法执行标准作业程序，因而不得不开。

她说，一切要追溯到去年7月，当时因3月实施的行动管制令，小贩们停工3个多月，当时小贩们希望可以尽快复业，因此与时任当地市议员黄智荣接洽，要求允许该早市复业。

聘警衛員買防疫品

“我们从7月1日开始讨论此事，最终于7月20日在市议会开会后，决定小贩必须自己负责聘请志愿警卫员和落实防疫措施，市议会便允许早市于21日复业重开。”

她说，当时在场的有约20多名小贩，大家一致推荐她担任负责人，她当时也拒绝，可惜最终没有其他人选，唯有硬着头皮接下担子，负责每天向开摊的小贩收取每个泊车格5令吉，没开摊的小贩则不需要缴费。

收费是苦差没人愿意扛

陈瑞芬指出，同业看到她每天忙于收费，有时连自己摊位都无暇看顾，还要协助购买防疫用品、与市议会接洽开会、每天记账、做账等，因此认为她应该得到津贴。

她说，由于是“苦差”，没人愿意扛下这个担子，因此有同业们提出给她津贴的建议。

“我从去年8月开始，每月获得600令吉津贴，这不是薪金，可能同业们教育水平不高，因此误解用语。”

她指出，当时同业们也在群里提出这项建议，同样没有人反对。

她强调，这一年多来，所有账目都是非常透明公开，她每周也会在群里，

她补充，当地每日固定摆摊的小贩约有10多摊，同时每周7天都有不同小贩入驻，每天有20多至30多名小贩开摊，一共约120名小贩，他们也对此特地成立了一个联系群组。

“大家都没有反对此事，原本以为两、三个月，疫情就好转，岂料一拖就1年多，加上疫情反复，早市也开开关关，为了持续落实防疫措施，避免违反作业程序而遭令关闭，我们一直维持收费到今天。”

她指出，小贩们已有共识，一旦不需要再聘请警卫员和防疫措施，就会停止收费，可能一些非固定小贩不理解，因此做出投诉。

无论如何，她希望同业们明白，疫情之下大家都辛苦，大家应该和气生财，否则早市关闭，大家就被迫又停工。

汇报购买收据和财务状况，该账户目前还有逾3000令吉盈余。

“一旦雨天没生意或盈余太多时，我们会暂停收费，例如下周开始，我们一连4周，即1个月暂停收费，使用盈余来落实防疫措施。”

她说，这其实是一项吃力不讨好的工作，出发点是为了大家好，但是没有料到会引发这么大的误解。

(蒲种3日讯) 梳邦再也市政厅拨款28万3000令吉, 提升蒲种宏愿花园(Taman Wawasan)公园防洪池湖泊, 工程从今年5月起动工, 预计本月尾竣工, 届时湖底将挖深1公尺, 以加强防洪效果及降低水灾风险。

金 奎区州议员黄思汉指出, 蒲种宏愿花园的公园防洪池是市政厅管辖区内最大的湖泊, 面积有22英亩, 具备美化公园及蓄水防洪的作用。

“在湖泊提升期间, 市政厅的承包商不仅挖深湖底, 也将进行清洁湖泊工作, 相信在工程竣工后, 湖泊的水质会变得更好。”

黄思汉今日与梳邦再也市政厅官员到场巡视该公园防洪池湖泊工程。这项工程因冠病疫情及行动管控令打乱计划, 导致延迟动工。出席者包括梳邦再也市议员叶国荣。

黄思汉指出, 从当初蒲种宏愿花园发展至今, 该公园防

洪池湖泊已历时30年未曾清理, 市政厅这项提升工程不只挖深湖底, 也负责清理湖泊, 再安装2部水车增加湖水含氧量, 工程竣工后会往湖泊释放鱼群。

“为方便施工的重型车辆出入公园, 市政厅将在公园的2个出入口铺设水泥新路段, 未来将用于湖泊维护工程的车辆出入使用。”

美化新路段

他指出, 日后任何重型车辆出入公园范围, 必须循着新路段行驶, 以避免对公园基建造成破坏。

叶国荣指出, 蒲种宏愿花园公园防洪池湖泊提升工程进



配合出入公园湖泊施工的重型车辆, 市政厅将从2个出入口的设水泥路面新路段, 以承担10吨重的罗里行驶。

度已达70%, 不只是主要湖泊挖深1公尺, 就连衔接主要湖泊的支流水道也同样挖深1公尺, 全面提升防洪作用。

“市政厅也会对新路段展开美化及点缀工作, 平常则禁止车辆通行, 但允许民众在此路段跑步。”

她指出，每逢下大雨时，雨水也会淹进商店内，损坏店内物品及给商家造成惨重损失。

她日前已安排与市议会官员和承包商到场巡视，设法解决有关大树所带来的问题。

“市议会也清理沟渠内的树根和落叶，确保沟渠排水能通畅无阻，我也要求市议会为沟渠加盖，避免树叶

掉落沟渠内，造成严重阻塞。”

她也会建议砍树后的地点，栽种不会影响居民生活作息的植物，同时保持该环境绿化目标，并也建议在菜场附近空地兴建停车场，以方便居民安全停放。

武吉哥文寧閃淹 溝渠障礙物致水災

(沙亚南3日讯)位于沙亚南的武吉哥文宁日前一场大雨后发生水灾，水位高达一尺。沙亚南市议员江世荣表示，有者在沟渠上违建“建筑”、摆放障碍物，加上大树根缠绕等因素，造成武吉哥文宁（Bukit Kemuning）一带闪电水灾。

沙亚南市议员江世荣与沙亚南市政厅官员及市议员党鞭峇峇莱都巡视水灾现场后受询指出，引发水灾的其中一个原因是，工厂和住家都在沟渠上违建“建筑”或摆放私人物品，令人排水系统受到影响，雨水无法正常排出。

他说，就有一家工厂直接排水沟上违建，所以市政厅执法小组已向业者开出警告信，下令对方必须在14天内，将违建物拆除。

影响排水系统

“还有一间民宅的屋主也霸占排水沟并违建，上方摆放各种狗笼饲养逾10只狗，所以执法人员除了下令对方将违建物拆除外，也要求屋主在下次执法员巡视时，出示养狗执照。”

他说，民宅和工厂区的排水系统也受大树根的影响，树根贯穿和缠绕在沟渠内，因此他已经通知市政厅的园艺小组尽早清理这些树根。

“由于在突击检查的过程中，一些工厂紧锁大门，所以执法组一旦得到搜查令后就会直接登门检查。”

他也希望居民和业者给予配合，勿非法霸占沟渠和违建，否则若排水系统受到影响，遭殃的还是居民和业者。
