Projek sungai buatan RM300j dijangka bermula awal tahun depan

Kuala Terengganu: Projek pembinaan sungai buatan bernilai RM300 juta bagi mengurangkan risiko banjir, terutama di daerah Kemaman, dijangka mula dilaksanakan awal tahun depan.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Kebajikan, Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Perpaduan Nasional Terengganu, Hanafiah Mat, berkata projek sungai berjarak sembilan kilometer bagi mengurangkan banjir di beberapa kampung di bandar Chukai itu akan dilakukan selepas kerja pengambilan balik tanah penduduk selesai.

Katanya, projek bermula dari Kampung Paman ke Tasik Bungkus di Ibok, dijangka mengambil masa kira-kira enam tahun untuk disiapkan.

"Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) sudah memberi kelulusan laporan Penilaian Kesan Alam Sekitar (EIA) untuk kerja lebarkan sungai buatan sejauh 250 meter dengan ketinggian dua meter. Apabila siap, projek ini dijangka dapat meminimumkan pertembungan air sungai Air Putih dan Sungai Cerul di Hulu Kemaman," katanya ketika dihubungi semalam.

Hanafiah yang juga Ahli Dewan Undangan negeri (ADUN) Chukai berkata, banjir besar yang melanda Kemaman sehingga menenggelam dan merosakkan kediaman penduduk pada tahun lalu berpunca daripada pertembungan air, terutama apabila berlaku fenomena air pasang besar.

"Ia menyebabkan beberapa kawasan di sekitar Chukai seperti Bandar Baru Bukit Mentok, Kampung Pengkalan Pandan dan Kampung Tempurung tenggelam ketika banjir tahun lalu," katanya yang juga Timbalan Pengurus Jawatankuasa Bencana Negeri.

Katanya, Terengganu dijangka dilanda hujan lebat ketika musim Monsun Timur Laut mulai akhir bulan ini yang boleh menyebabkan banjir di kawasan rendah.

"Kita menjangkakan peningkatan taburan hujan sehingga 3,600 milimeter (mm) tahun ini berbanding hanya 3,000 (mm) tahun lalu. Jika taburan hujan antara 300 hingga 400mm sehari, banjir mungkin berlaku seperti di Gunung Jera, Kedah, iaitu disebabkan kepala air," katanya.

Sehingga kini, katanya, taburan hujan di negeri ini adalah sebanyak 2,000mm dengan kadar taburan dalam sehari sekira 80mm.

Kartel ulat jenazah Covid-19 sukar dibendung tanpa kerjasama waris

KLANG: Ahli keluarga waris jenazah meninggal dunia akibat Covid-19 yang merasakan mereka terpedaya dengan caj mahal oleh kartel diminta tampil membuat laporan kepada pihak berkuasa.

Mereka hanya perlu menge-mukakan bukti seperti resit kepada polis, Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM), Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) atau Kementerian Kesihatan.

Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Pelabuhan Klang, Azmizam Zaman Huri berkata, sikap waris yang reda dengan perbuatan kartel pengurusan jenazah menyebabkan kegiatan tersebut tidak dapat dibendung secara menyeluruh.

"Kegiatan tersebut telah terbukti apabila SPRM mengambil tindakan terhadap kakitangan hospital yang terlibat.

"Sepatutnya waris yang terpaksa membayar caj melampaui kepada kartel pengurusan jenazah melibatkan orang dalam ini tampil membuat laporan dan menjadi saksi," katanya ketika ditemui di sini semalam.

Baru-baru ini, akhbar ini melaporkan, lima kakitangan jabatan forensik sebuah hospital di negeri ini ditahan berhubung kes rasuah pengurusan jenazah selepas dipercaya mengaut keuntungan kira-kira RM22,000 dalam tempoh dua tahun sejak tahun 2019.

Satu sumber berkata, petugas kesihatan Gred 19 hingga Gred 29 itu menerima habuan antara RM300 hingga 400 bagi setiap jenazah daripada ejen mengikut

jenis-jenis kematian.

Mengulas lanjut, Azmizam berharap lebih ramai waris yang terpaksa membayar caj melampaui oleh kartel pengurusan jenazah di hospital tertentu memberi maklumat kepada SPRM agar kes tersebut dapat dibanteras.

"Saya difahamkan, waris-waris yang teraniaya hingga terpaksa membayar caj tayammun jenazah hingga empat angka mengambil sikap berdiam diri kerana mengambil prinsip tidak mahu memanjangkan perkara tersebut.

"Bagaimanapun saya menyru mangsa-mangsa yang terlibat tidak terus berdiam diri dan membiarkan saki-baki kartel pengurusan jenazah terus bermaharajela menganiayai waris pesakit Covid-19 dan lain-lain sebab kematian," katanya.

SEBAGAI inisiatif meningkatkan integriti, Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (LUAS) mengadakan program latihan bagi meningkatkan kefahaman Pengurusan Risiko Rasuah (CRM) dengan Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM).

LUAS dalam satu kenyataan memberitahu, kursus tersebut dianjurkan bersama Ketua Unit Pemeriksaan dan Perundangan SPRM, Azuan Adzhar.

Antara kejahilan mengenai adab memberi teguran yang dikhawatir makin berleluasa kini ialah membuat penjelasan tentang sesuatu kesilapan atau kesalahan dilakukan seseorang di media sosial tanpa individu terbabit mengetahui teguran disampaikan. Sedihnya, dia hanya tahu setelah video atau entri berkenaan ditonton atau dibaca oleh ribuan, malah puluhan ribu orang sedangkan maruahnya sudah pun jatuh dan tercelar. Adakah begini adab yang diajarkan Islam?

Nia yang ikhlas tidak memadai, jika cara digunakan hakikatnya hanya menjatuhkan, mengaibkan atau memburukkan peribadi seseorang. Sepatutnya hanya kesalahannya sahaja yang diceritakan tanpa menyebutkan namanya kerana demikianlah cara sunah yang sebenar. Rasulullah SAW apabila menegur seseorang baginda akan menyebut secara umum: "Ma ba' aqam.." (Apakah orang ini...) **Riwayat Abu Dawud**

Menyuruh kepada kebaikan dan mencegah daripada kemungkaran serta nasihat-menasihat, berpesan-pesan dan tegur-menegur amalan yang ditutup oleh agama. Nabi SAW bersabda: "Agama itu adalah nasihat". Kami bertanya: "Untuk siapa?" Baginda menjawab: "Untuk Allah, untuk kitab-Nya, untuk Rasul-Nya, untuk pemimpin golongan Muslimin dan seluruh umat Islam". **Riwayat Muslim**

Bagaimanapun, dalam memberi nasihat perlulah dipelihara matlamat dan adabnya apabila nasihat yang diberikan bertujuan supaya umat Islam sentiasa melaksanakan segala perintah Allah SWT dan menjauhi segala larangan-Nya, sentiasa membaca dan mengamalkan tuntutan al-Quran serta sentiasa mencintai serta mengikuti sunah Nabi SAW.

Nasihat untuk pemimpin boleh dibagikan kepada dua, sama ada pemimpin dunia mahupun pemimpin agama (ulama). Nasihat untuk pemimpin dunia adalah bertujuan supaya mereka bersikap adil, tidak berbuat zalm serta memperjuangkan kebenaran. Nasihat untuk ulama pula adalah bertujuan supaya mereka menyampaikan ilmu, menegakkan kebenaran dan menghapuskan kebatilan. Namun, cara menasihati

mereka hendak dengan lemah lembut, penuh adab, hormat serta menjaga lidah daripada mencaci mereka.

Diceritakan, Khalifah al-Ma'mun pernah meminta seorang zahid memberibolehnya nasihat, lalu dia bertanya: "Bolehkah aku bercakap lantang terhadapmu?" Jawab Khalifah: "Tidak, kerana sesungguhnya Allah telah mengutuskan Musa AS, sedangkan dia lebih baik daripadamu, kepada Firaun, sedangkan dia lebih buruk daripadaku. Namun firman-Nya: Kemudian hendaklah kamu berkata kepada dia yang lemah lembut."

Surah Taha: 44

Allah SWT turut berfirman: "Serulah ke jalan Tuhanmu (wahai Muhammadi) dengan hikmah (kebijaksanaan) dan nasihat pengajarannya yang baik." **Surah an-Nahl: 125**

Diriwayatkan, Hisyam bin Hakim RA pernah menegur seorang gabenor, iyadah bin Ghann RA dengan kata-kata kasar sehingga iyadah naik marah. Kemudian beliau membacakan kepada Hisyam hadis Nabi SAW: "Sesiai yang hendak menasihati sultan (pengguna) tentang sesuatu perkara maka janganlah dia melaksanakannya secara terang-terangan, tetapi hendaklah dia mengambil tangannya, lalu duduk bersyurian dengannya. Diriwayatkan, Hisyam bin Hakim RA pernah menegur seorang gabenor, iyadah bin Ghann RA dengan kata-kata kasar sehingga iyadah naik marah. Kemudian beliau membacakan kepada Hisyam hadis Nabi SAW: "Sesiai yang hendak menasihati sultan (pengguna) tentang sesuatu perkara maka janganlah dia melaksanakannya secara terang-terangan, tetapi hendaklah dia mengambil tangannya, lalu duduk bersyurian dengannya. Jika dia menerima nasihatnya maka itulah sememangnya dan jika tidak, dia telah pun menuai kewajipannya terhadapnya"

Riwayat Ahmad

Nasihat untuk seluruh umat Islam adalah bagi membimbing

memalukannya dan membuka aibnya."

Beliau turut berpesan: "Sampaikanlah nasihatmu kepada semua aksi bersendirian dan elakkanlah memberi nasihat kepada sekutu orang ramai. Sesungguhnya memberi nasihat di khayal ramai itu adalah salah satu bentuk celaan yang aku tidak reda mendengarnya. Sekiranya kamu menyalahilah dan mengingkar pesanku ini maka janganlah kamu terjeput jika nasihatmu itu tidak ditaati."

Seorang ahli hadis, Mis'ar bin Kidam ditanya: "Adakah kamu suka orang yang menghabarkanmu tentang keibaikanmu?" Lalu dijawabnya: "Sekiranya dia menasihatiku dalam keadaan hanya diriku dan dirinya maka jawabnya ya. Namun, sekiranya dia menegurku di khayal ramai, jawabnya tidak."

Imam al-Ghazali dalam Ihy' Ulumiddin mengulas: "Benar kata beliau kerana sesungguhnya teguran di khayal ramai itu hanyalah perbutan memalukannya."

Jelasnya, teguran secara *private* (tertutup) adalah cara yang paling afdal dan lebih menarik orang yang dinasihati untuk mendengar serta menerima dengan insaf. Seandainya umat Islam menghayati kefahaman sedemikian, nescaya permusuhan dan perpecahan yang berlaku dapat dieلالkan.

SHAH ALAM – Klang dan Kuala Lumpur merupakan dua kawasan yang masih belum pulih sepenuhnya daripada gangguan air yang berlaku sejak 13 Oktober lalu.

Dua kawasan itu telah mencapai kerja-kerja pemulihan melalui 90 peratus setakat pukul 6 pagi semalam.

Bagaimanapun, gangguan bekalan air di enam lagi wilayah seperti Hulu Selangor, Kuala Langat, Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Petaling dan Gombak telah pulih sepenuhnya.

Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) dalam satu kenyataan memaklumkan, keseluruhan pemulihan bekalan di 998 kawasan terjejas telah mencapai 98 peratus.

Bagaimanapun tambahnya, pemulihan di kawasan yang masih mengalami gangguan adalah bergantung kepada jarak lokasi premis pengguna dan tekanan air pada sistem pengagihan bekalan.

Terdahulu, Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari memaklumkan, Loji Rawatan Air Sungai Selangor Fasa 1 di Bukit Badong, Kuala Selangor perlu melalui proses penyelenggaraan dan

menyebabkan gangguan berjadual bermula 13 Oktober sehingga 9 malam tadi.

Kerja penyelenggaraan itu bagaimanapun dilaporkan siap lebih awal iaitu pukul 8.15 malam pada Rabu lalu berbanding jangkaan asal pukul 11 malam.

Penyelesaian itu membolehkan bekalan mula disalurkan ke tangki imbangan serta agihan sebelum diagihkan kepada peng-

guna di kawasan terjejas dan susulan itu Kuala Selangor dilapor menjadi wilayah pertama mula mendapat bekalan air.

Bagaimanapun, dalam tempoh berkenaan pengguna di kawasan terjejas masih boleh mendapatkan bekalan di Pili Awam serta Stesen Pengisian Air Komersial yang boleh disemak lokasinya di hentitugas.airselangor.com.

THE Education Ministry will work closely with relevant stakeholders to repair a four decade old school after its roof fell off — again.

Deputy Education Minister Datuk Dr Mah Hang Soon said the ministry is waiting for reports from the district education office (PPD) and the Malaysian Public Works Department (JKR) before deciding on the next course of action to fix SJK(T) Telok Panglima Garang.

"This school is 44 years old and upon visiting it, we noticed that the roof had fallen off. "We are still waiting for the reports to know what the issues are and what steps can be taken to repair the building soon.

"We will work closely with Kuala Langat MP Datuk Dr Xavier Jayakumar (on improving the building's condition)," he said after visiting the school in Banting with Dr Jayakumar last Thursday.

The school has a total of 478 pupils. No one was hurt when the roof fell off on Oct 12.

Kamalanathan Chellappan said this is not the first time the roof has fallen off.

"We have had this problem for many years, and each time, it just gets repaired.

"This time around when PPD and JKR Kuala Langat told us the same, we took a firm stand to say enough of repairing, give us a new roof.

"We suggested demolishing the building with the fallen roof, and replacing it with a

new structure; we have enough land," he said, urging the government to use its allocation wisely for the children's development.

"We hope Mah's visit will accelerate the process of improving our school," he said. — By SANDHYA MENON

HTAR consultant haematologist Dr Tan Swee Looi says: "When the influx of patients overwhelmed our facility, Southern Realty's donation of GeneXpert to the pathology department and digital portable X-ray machine to the radiology department had our backs covered."

As we transition into an endemic Covid-19 stage, booster vaccine doses are inevitable.

For example, on Sept 22, the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved a single Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine booster dose for three groups of people six months after they complete their primary vaccination series.

They are: those aged 65 years and above, those who are at high risk of severe Covid-19, and those with frequent exposure to Covid-19.

Following this, Health Minister Khairy Jamaluddin announced the rollout of booster doses in Malaysia from this month onwards for selected targeted groups.

However, the world continues to face shortages of Covid-19 vaccines.

Although vaccine shortages are worse in low-income countries, middle-income countries like Malaysia are not spared.

We have enough vaccines for approximately 110% of our population, but that number may be under-counting our actual population and boosters may deplete our supplies.

Therefore, it is crucial for Malaysia to implement an effective, nuanced and targeted booster strategy.

Here, we propose five ways to strengthen Malaysia's booster strategy and support public health outcomes.

Strengthen primary vaccination

Firstly, we need to strengthen our ongoing primary vaccination series.

The primary goal of vaccination is to confer immunity on the entire population.

Malaysia's own Real-World Evaluation of Covid-19 Vaccines under the Malaysia National Covid-19 Immunisation Program study has shown strong protection from the three main vaccines used (AstraZeneca/Oxford, Pfizer/BioNTech and Sinovac) against infection, symptomatic disease and ICU (intensive care unit) admission.

This shows that two doses of the Covid-19 vaccine are highly effective and protective against the SARS-CoV-2 virus, and likely sufficient for the general population.

Therefore, while we roll out booster doses to protect those who remain at risk, an equal focus should remain on our primary vaccination series, especially in states with low vaccination rates.

For example, on Oct 11, only 65% of the adult population of Sabah had been fully vaccinated, although the national average is now 90%.

Collect booster shot data

Secondly, we need to gather and publicise data on the need for boosters in high-risk groups.

Currently, there is limited data globally on Covid-19 vaccine booster doses, like who should receive them, when, how often and the safety profile.

Therefore, to increase public confidence in our ongoing primary vaccination series, we urge the Health Ministry to gather and publicise local data and evidence on the definition of high-risk groups

Strengthening our booster strategy

As Covid-19 booster shots appear increasingly necessary, here are five suggestions to consolidate our approach to them.

and their indications for booster doses.

This data will hopefully increase public understanding on issues such as the increasing infection rates in states with high vaccination rates, like Sarawak.

Following this, the promised targeted booster strategy should be publicised.

Some points to cover include transparent data on vaccine supply across states and regions, detailed definitions on high-risk groups, logistics of the administration of

booster doses, and whether these booster doses are necessary or may be opted out by targeted groups who have previously received two doses.

Continue public communication

Thirdly, we must educate and reassure the public that vaccines remain important and useful, even if we need a booster shot.

As in many aspects of health, adequate patient or public educa-

tion will create understanding and motivation, while reducing fake news.

In this education process, the differences between a third Covid-19 vaccine dose and booster doses should be clarified, as these two terms are currently used interchangeably.

Although this may now be a minute detail, it may generate public distrust in the two-dose Covid-19 vaccine regime or other vaccination initiatives.

Proper education on the differences between these two terms will increase public understanding of the reasons for booster or third Covid-19 vaccine doses, which will increase public confidence in our booster strategy.

Communication with the public needs to be simple and targeted to our unique Malaysian demographic, which includes using multiple languages, formats and media.

Making it routine

Fourthly, a booster strategy must be long-term and short-term at the same time.

We urge the government to begin laying down a sustainable foundation for an endemic Covid-19 strategy.

"Zero-Covid" strategies are slowly being abandoned worldwide because the inherent properties of the SARS-CoV-2 virus – such as high transmissibility and its capacity to evolve into new variants – make it impossible to be completely eradicated.

Instead, the world is now moving towards an endemic Covid-19 strategy, which will only be possi-

ble with widespread immunity achieved through vaccination.

Current data indicates decreased efficacy of Covid-19 vaccines over time, suggesting the need for repeated booster doses, and perhaps even a Covid-19 vaccine every 12-18 months for selected high-risk groups.

Therefore, our long-term strategy should include the embedding of regular booster doses into the National Immunisation Programme (NIP), unlike the current situation where boosters are being administered through the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme (PICK).

In other words, we need to shift the Covid-19 vaccination campaign from "campaign mode" to "routine mode".

Developing our own vaccines

Finally, we should utilise this opportunity to accelerate the development of a National Vaccine Development Strategy.

The procurement of Covid-19 vaccines for Malaysians has not been an easy feat.

Furthermore, repeated purchases can be costly.

Malaysia has long produced international award-winning scientists, suggesting that our country has the intellectual capacity to come up with our own vaccines.

We must now build the regulatory and manufacturing capacity to match our intellectual capacity.

This can be made possible by appropriately building and investing in the country's manufacturing facilities, by aligning with health policy areas of the 12th Malaysia Plan (MP12).

In addition to ensuring efficient and wise resource allocation of vaccine production, any advancement in manufacturing facilities will further strengthen Malaysia's public health and pandemic preparedness in facing future health crises.

However, the government must create the conditions for private sector investment in manufacturing, rather than act as the sole or biggest investor.

This will ensure a clear separation between government and business, increase the chances that capital will be allocated efficiently and reduce the risk of corruption.

One part of the whole

Although currently controversial, Covid-19 booster doses are being increasingly accepted as a necessity.

Nonetheless, there are still ways for us to strengthen the booster shot programme, as we have described in this column.

Above all else, we urge everyone to remember that boosters and vaccination programmes are crucial, but they are only one part of the entire universe of our public health and pandemic responses.

Water supply recovery at 98pc

+ KUALA LUMPUR: The restoration of water supply in 998 areas in Petaling, Klang, Shah Alam, Gombak, Kuala Lumpur, Hulu Selangor, Kuala Langat and Kuala Selangor reached 98 per cent up to 6am yesterday.

Air Selangor Sdn Bhd corporate communication head Elina Baseri said that based on the percentage breakdown of water supply recovery according to region, six districts — Hulu Selangor, Kuala Langat, Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Petaling and Gombak — had attained full recovery.

The recovery rate in Kuala Lumpur was at 95.5 per cent and Klang at 89.4 per cent.

"The duration of the disruption and restoration of water supply in

the affected areas differed depending on the distance of the consumer's premises and the water pressure of the distribution system," she said yesterday.

The disruption from Oct 13 due to the shutting down of the Sungai Selangor Water Treatment Plant Phase 1 for upgrading and maintenance work was scheduled to end by 9pm yesterday.

Air Selangor hoped consumers who received their water supply would use it prudently to allow the recovery in the other areas to run smoothly.

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 16 — Water supply in the Klang Valley have recovered by 98 per cent as at 6am today, according to Air Selangor.

Only two out of eight districts — Kuala Lumpur and Klang — are still affected by the scheduled water cuts that started on Wednesday, to enable much needed repairs and maintenance work to Isun Selangor Phase 1 Water Treatment Plant.

In Kuala Lumpur, eight areas may still experience cuts. They are Taman Flora Impian, Taman Prima Impian, Dutama, Taman Sri Bintang, Taman Bukit Sri Bintang, Taman Seri Bukit Segambut, Arjung Tara and Mont Kiara.

In Klang, 12 areas are still affected. They are Aman Perdana, Perindustrian Pulau Indah Fasa 2, Perekat, Kapar, Seme, Bukit Kapar, Bandar Baru Bukit Raja, Pulau Ketam, Kampung Telok Gon, Kampung Pulau Indah, Bukit Kerayong.

Air Selangor head of corporate communications, Elina Basri said water supply has been fully restored to the other districts, namely Hulu Selangor, Kuala Langat, Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Petaling and Gombak.

The upgrading and maintenance works for the water treatment plant were completed on October 14, but Air Selangor said the duration of the water supply disruption and recovery in the affected areas will vary depending on the distance from consumers' premises and the water pressure at the distribution system.

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 15 — Water supply in 998 areas in Petaling, Klang/Shah Alam, Gombak, Kuala Lumpur, Hulu Selangor Langat and Kuala Selangor has been restored by 68 per cent as at noon today.

Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) corporate communication head Elina Baseri, in a statement today, said water supply in Hulu Selangor has been fully restored, while in Kuala Selangor, it was 99.4 per cent and 94.2 per cent in Shah Alam

In Petaling, it was 89.8 per cent, Kuala Langat (85.7 per cent), Kuala Lumpur (38.6 per cent) and Klang (16.8 per cent).

*The duration of water supply disruption and restoration in the affected areas will vary depending on the location of consumer's premises and the water pressure on the water supply distribution system.

Air Selangor continues to mobilise alternative water supply assistance via tanker trucks to critical premises such as hospitals, dialysis centres, Covid-19 Quarantine and Treatment Centres (PKRC) and Vaccination Centres (PPV), as well as for use at funeral ceremony, she said.

Water supply was disrupted in the affected areas due to work to improve and maintain critical assets at the Sungai Selangor Water Treatment Plant Phase 1 (LRA SSP1) last Oct 13.

She advised consumers to let the taps flow for a while until the water turns clear before using the water and to use v prudently to ensure the recovery process in the affected area runs smoothly as scheduled.

The status of water supply restoration will be updated from time to time through Air Selangor's official communication channels including its website www.airselangor.com, Air Selangor application, Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 15 — The water supply recovery rate in Kuala Lumpur and Selangor stood at 28 per cent as of 6 today, according to Air Selangor.

The water utility company said it expects the ongoing scheduled disruption to all 998 areas to end by tomorrow.

As of now, Kuala Selangor has the highest recovery rate at 75.6 per cent, Hulu Selangor (60.7 per cent), Petaling (60.4 per cent), Shah Alam (40.4 per cent) and Klang (0.9 per cent).

Gombak, Kuala Lumpur and Kuala Langat are yet to receive any supply.

"Air Selangor hopes that consumers who have received water supply will use their water prudently to ensure that the recovery process in the other affected areas runs smoothly as scheduled," Air Selangor's head of corporate communications, Elina Baseri said.

Elina had yesterday said that the upgrading and maintenance works for critical assets on its Sungai Selangor Phase 1 Water Treatment Plant (SSP1 WTP) were completed at 5am yesterday.

The scheduled disruption is to enable upgrading and perform maintenance works on its critical assets at SSP1 WTP.

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 15 — The restoration of water supply in the affected areas in the Klang Valley has reached 85 per cent as of 6pm today, said Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor).
Water supply has been fully restored in three districts, namely Hulu Selangor, Kuala Langat and Shah Alam.

"The recovery rate in Kuala Selangor is at 99.4 per cent, Petaling (98.9 per cent), Gombak (85 per cent), Kuala Lumpur (per cent) and Klang (50.4 per cent)," Air Selangor said in a statement today.

According to Air Selangor, the duration of the disruption and restoration of water supply in the affected areas would differ depending on the distance of the consumer's premises and the water pressure of the distribution system.

Air Selangor hoped that consumers who have received their water supply would use water prudently to allow the recovery process in the other affected areas to run smoothly as scheduled.

Air Selangor had previously announced that a total of 998 areas in eight districts would be affected by scheduled water supply disruption from Oct 13 to 16 due to the shutting down of the Sungai Selangor Water Treatment Plant Phase 1 (SSP1 WTP) for upgrading and maintenance works. — Bernama

她说，工人在2006年签署授权书，委任Era Permai私人公司负责兴建房屋计划，随后，也签署了买卖合约。

“在109名工人签署了房屋拥有权后，雪州政府的责任已圆满结束，然而，发展商却无法在期限内完成计划，导致搁置。”

与地产局（LPHS）召开数次会议商讨问题，发展商二度提出调整房屋售价。

“原价3万5000令吉的21间廉价排屋在2019年8月和9月分别修改至8万令吉和10万令吉；33间中价排屋的价格则从6万5000令吉修改至20万，还有55间8万令吉的中价排屋修改至25万令吉。”

她说，州政府对修改房屋售价没有异

议，条件是发展商必须获得109名工人的同意，但截至最新，双方未能就房屋售价达成协议。

“州政府的建议是，发展商自动放弃当初签署的授权书，但有责任承担一切费用，又或者，工人们取消当初委任发展商的授权书。”

巴生新城区州议员拿督邓章钦特别助理严玉梅受访时指出，根据雪州水务管理公司的消息指出，截至早上6时为止，巴生还有12个地区仍未恢复供水，不过情况一直到中午时段也未

见改善。

她披露，这12个地区包括中路、富豪苑、英达岛第二期工业区、柏乐峇、加埔、士文达、武吉加埔、武吉拉惹、吉胆岛、甘榜直落昂、甘榜英达岛及武吉克拉涌绒。

“因为距离较远的问题，水源从滤水站输送到富豪苑和武吉拉惹，需要比较多的时间，所以迄今仍未恢复供水。”

她说，雪州水务管理公司昨日中午和傍晚时段，已轮流到受影响的地区派水，而相关工作今日也会延续，有些民众则到公共水喉取水。
