# Kes naik, MAEPS diaktifkan

**PUTRAJAYA:** Jumlah positif Covid-19 dijangka meningkat dalam tempoh empat minggu akan datang, kata Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Tan Sri Dr. Noor Hisham Abdullah.

Susulan itu, Pusat Kuaran tin dan Rawatan Covid-19 Berisiko Rendah di Taman Ekspo Pertanian Malaysia Serdang (PKRC MAEPS) 2.0 diaktifkan semula.

Menurutnya, peningkatan kes positif itu adalah berikutan perluasan saringan ke atas pekerja khususnya warga asing di kilang dan juga tapak binaan.

Katanya, kebanyakannya kes positif itu adalah daripada kategori 1 (iaitu individu yang tidak bergejala) dan kategori 2 (iaitu

pesakit yang bergejala ringan) di mana mereka dimasukkan ke Pusat Kuaran tin dan Rawatan Covid-19 Berisiko Rendah serta hospital.

“Selain itu, jumlah kes positif dijangkakan akan kekal tinggi susulan perluasan saringan atas pekerja warga asing yang juga dilancarkan oleh Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso) di enam negeri iaitu Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Pulau Pinang, Negeri Sembilan, Sabah dan Labuan.

“Atas jangkaan terbabit, Pusat Kesiapsiagaan dan Tindak Cepat Krisis Kebangsaan (CPRC) mengaktifkan semula PKRC MAEPS 2.0 sebagai langkah kesiapsagaan bagi menghadapi isu peningkatan kes susulan perluasan saringan dalam kalangan

pekerja warga asing dan juga peningkatan kes di Lembah Klang,” katanya pada sidang akhbar di sini semalam.

Mengulas lanjut mengenai PKRC MAEPS 2.0, Noor Hisham berkata, ia akan dibuka secara berfasa dengan kapasiti maksimum sebanyak 1,000 buah katil.

Katanya, fasa pertama bermulai hari ini, dengan kapasiti sebanyak 650 buah katil yang kemudian akan ditambah secara berperingkat.

“Ia akan menempatkan pesakit bukan warganegara yang sebelum ini diasingkan di Institut Latihan KKM (ILKKM) Sungai Buloh iaitu seramai 250 orang.

“Malah, kita jangkakan bilangan pesakit akan meningkat minggu ini di mana seramai 400

orang pesakit baharu kategori 1 akan ditempatkan di fasiliti terbabit,” katanya.

Noor Hisham menambah, pentadbiran PKRC MAEPS 2.0 ini akan diletakkan di bawah kawalan Ketua Komander Wilayah Tengah iaitu Pengarah Jabatan Kesihatan Selangor.

“Ia merupakan satu kolaborasi di antara Kementerian Kesihatan dengan pelbagai agensi Kerajaan yang lain termasuk Agensi Pengurusan Bencana Negara (Nadma), Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM), Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM), Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia, Angkatan Pertahanan Awam Malaysia (APM), Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM), Jabatan Kerja Raya (JKR) dan MAEPS sendiri,” katanya.

## Lot 850: Penduduk mahu saman

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Pertubuhan Bukit Antarabangsa Task Force (BATF) tidak teragak-agak untuk mengambil tindakan undang-undang terhadap Majlis Perbandaran Ampang Jaya (MPAJ) kerana meluluskan projek pembangunan mega Lot 850 di Bukit Antarabangsa.

Pengerusi BATF, Datuk Al Bakri Ali berkata, sehingga sekarang, MPAJ masih tidak memberikan jawapan mengapa kelulusan pembangunan diberikan kepada pemaju meskipun terdapat bantahan penduduk.

"Selepas kami meminta supaya MPAJ menunjukkan salinan kelulusan bersyarat yang dibuat dengan pemaju tempoh hari, kami menghantar satu surat peringatan kepada Yang Dipertua MPAJ, namun, masih tiada jawapan bertulis sehingga

hari ini.

"Sudah lima tahun kami memperjuangkan isu ini, tetapi jika masih tiada jawapan dari MPAJ, kita tidak teragak-agak

untuk bawa isu ini ke muka pengadilan," katanya kepada *Utusan Malaysia* di sini, semalam.

Pada masa sama, Al Bakri juga mempersoalkan sikap MPAJ yang seolah-olah mengeneppikan suara persatuan penduduk.

"Perbincangan status projek ini melibatkan pelbagai pihak tetapi malangnya NGO penduduk tidak dilibatkan bersama. Kami hanya memohon supaya MPAJ memberikan penjelasan dan jaminan dari kerajaan negeri bahawa tidak akan berlaku bencana alam," katanya.

Projek Lot 850 yang terletak di Batu 6 1/4, Jalan Ulu Klang, Mukim Ulu Klang, Daerah Gombak telah mendapat bantahan penduduk sejak 2015.

Projek itu akan membina dua blok kondominium di atas lapan hingga 12 ekar tanah

yang terletak di kawasan cerun, berselbelahan Lebuhraya Lingkaran Tengah 2 (MRR2) dan berhampiran dengan Highland Towers.

Projek tersebut dilaporkan tergantung sementara berdasarkan Mesyuarat Tindakan Ekonomi Selangor (MTES) pada 18 Ogos 2016 bagi meneliti bantahan penduduk.

Namun, penduduk dikejutkan dengan papan tanda pada Julai lalu yang menunjukkan bahawa pemaju sudah mendarat kelulusan pembangunan, dengan tarikh projek bermula 22 Jun 2020 dan akan tamat pada 5 Julai 2021.

MPAJ pada Oktober lalu berkata, permohonan cadangan pembangunan Lot 850 telah pun diluluskan pada 8 Januari 2019.

Sindiket nikah palsu dikesan mengenakan bayaran RM3,000 dan menggunakan logo Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) palsu pada dokumen pernikahan bagi proses menyatakan pasangan yang berdepan masalah untuk menikah secara sah. **M**emasukan logo Jais batas Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) pada dokumen pendaftaran nikah. Itu antara taktik 'kadi celup' yang dikesan menjadi ejen sindiket perkahwinan dan memperdaya ramai pasangan warga tempatan serta asing untuk menggunakan khidmat ditawarkan.

Kegiatan ejen sindiket perkahwinan itu mulai dikesan bergerak aktif sejak 2013 selain sudah menguruskans perkahwinan ribuan pasangan pengantin dengan bayaran RM3,000 bagi setiap pasangan.

Sumber berkata, siasatan Jais bagaimanapun hanya menemui rekod 402 pasangan yang diruruskan sindiket itu bermula 2017 hingga Disember 2020.

"Dari pada jumlah itu, 70 peratus atau 281 kes per-

kahwin ini berlaku di Selangor. Bakinya pulak adalah kes yang berlaku di negeri lain seperti Pulau Pinang, Perak, Wilayah Persekutuan,

Terengganu, Sabah dan Sarawak.

"Siasatan mendapati suspek berusia 50-an itu dipercaya menguruskan pernikahan bagi pasangan tempatan bermasalah membabit-

kan 'kahwin lari' atau berpoligami. Malah sindiket ini turut membantu menguruskan perkahwinan antara orang tempatan dengan pasangan dalam kalangan warga asing," katanya.

Kegiatan itu bagaimanapun dibongkar Jais susulan penahanan dalam utama warga tempatan terbabit di sebuah rumah di sini, jam 12.30 tengah hari, kelmarin.

"Hasil pemeriksaan itu, Jais menyita dokumen, rekod dan maklumat pasangan nikah sindiket. Turut dirampas adalah buku resit, komputer riba dan telefon bimbit yang disyaki mempunyai kaitan dengan aktiviti pernikahan sindiket diuruskan suspek.

"Berdasarkan dokumen itu, suspek dipercaya mengenakan bayaran tempahan majlis akad nikah sebanyak RM500. Bagi melengkapkan proses pernikahan itu, pelanggar (pasangan yang mahu bernikah) perlu membayar sejumlah RM3,000," katanya.

Menurutnya, berdasarkan barang kes disita, suspek juga didapati menghantar dokument nikah palsu dengan meletakkan logo Jais.

"Mungkin ini bertujuan meyakinkan pasangan yang berurusan dengan gannya. Malah lelaki itu turut dikesan menguruskan perkahwinan bagi pasangan yang mahu 'nikah lari' di negara jiran.

### Undang banyak masalah

**Shah Alam:** Tindakan pasangan bernikah menggunakan khidmat ejen atau sindiket perkahwinan hanya akan mengundang lebih banyak masalah kepada masa depan anak dilahirkan dan pasangan.

Ketua Hakim Syarie Jabatan Kehakiman Syariah Selangor, Datuk Mohammad Adib Husain (gambar) berkata, pernikahan yang tidak diliktif undang-undang ditetapkan di negara ini membabitkan isu antaranya keengganan pasangan mendapatkan kebenaran pejabat agama Islam negeri untuk bernikah ataupun berpoligami.

"Pasangan yang bernikah tanpa kebenaran ini akan memberikan kesukaran kepada mereka kelak untuk memperolehi dokumen penting seperti mendaftarkan kelahiran anak jika tiada sijil kelahiran maka ini akan memberikan kesan pula kepada masa depan mereka untuk bersekolah."

"Malah timbul lebih banyak masalah apabila ditakdirkan suami meninggal dunia dan pernikahan mereka belum diliktif oleh undang-undang. Justeru, ini boleh mendatangkan kesukaran kepada isteri untuk mendapatkan hak harta putus dan sebagainya," katanya.

Menurutnya, mahkamah akan melihat semula semua kaitan antara si isteri dan si mati berdasarkan dokumen yang sah.

ini mengikut Seksyen 134, Enakmen Undang-Undang Keluarga Islam (Negeri Selangor) 2002 - Percubaan & Subahat," katanya.

Sehubungan itu, katanya, orang ramai yang pernah berurusan dengan mana-mana ejen bagi apa-apa tujuan berkaitan urusan pernikahan tampil memberikan maklumat kepada Jais bagi membantu siasatan.

"Maklumat boleh disalurkan di talian 1-800-88-2424 Hotline Pengukuhan Jais atau berhubung terus dengan Unit Siasatan Jenayah, Bahagian Pengurusan Pengukuhan Jais," katanya.

Sementara itu Pengarah Jais, Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad ketika dihubungi wartawan mengesahkan berhubung penahanan suspek lelaki terbabit, namun enggan mengulas lanjut.

**K**erajaan mengakifikan Pasar Kuaran Dan Rawatan Covid-19 (PKRC) Taman Ekspo Pertama (Tep) dan Pusat Perdagangan (PKRC Maeps 2.0), semalam.

Menyatakan mengakifkan PKRC Maeps 2.0 akhirnya memperbaiki keadaan negara asing dalam kawasan kapal terbang. Apabila aspek keselamatan akan diperketatkan Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM) dan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) akan melaksanakan operasi rawatan berbanjir dan pelaksanaan program saringan kerja asing Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso).

Menurutnya, skop operasi kali ini adalah menghalau segori pesakit Covid-19 yang bergejala ringan yang membabitkan bukan warganegara.

"Memandangkan PKRC Maeps 2.0 akan memperbaiki keadaan negara asing dalam kawasan kapal terbang, maka aspek keselamatan akan diperketatkan Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM) dan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) akan melaksanakan operasi rawatan berbanjir dan pelaksanaan program saringan kerja asing Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso)."

# Enam negeri rekod rizab margin air terawat rendah

**Kuala Lumpur:** Enam negeri merekodkan rizab margin air terawat yang rendah berbanding kapasiti yang ditetapkan Majlis Air Negara (MAN) di bawah 15 peratus.

**Timbalan Menteri Alam Sekitar dan Air, Datuk Dr Ahmad Masrizal Mohamad** berkata, antara negeri itu ialah Johor sebanyak 11.3 peratus, Sabah (8.3 peratus), Perlis (7.1 peratus), Selangor (1.5 peratus), Kelantan (-0.2 peratus) dan Kedah (-2.3 peratus).

Menurutnya, bagi beberapa negeri lain seperti Selangor, Kelantan dan Kedah, rizab air terawat di negeri itu dijangka dapat ditingkatkan sebaik loji rawatan air baharu dibina untuk tempoh antara ta-

hun depan hingga 2023.

“Bagi konteks di Selangor, Loji Rawatan Air Langat 2 Fasa Satu yang dijangka siap dibina pada 2023 mampu meningkatkan kapasiti rizab air terawat sebanyak 10 peratus.

“Manakala pembinaan Loji Rawatan Air di Kampung Telok di Kelantan juga dijangka mampu meningkatkan rizab air terawat sebanyak empat peratus.

“Manakala di Kedah pula terdapat lima loji rawatan air yang sudah diluluskan pembinaannya dan mampu meningkatkan rizab air terawat sebanyak 21 peratus,” katanya pada Sesi Pertanyaan-Pertanyaan Bagi Jawab Lisan di Dewan Rakyat di sini, semalam.

# Pengamal perubatan Islam dipanggil

**KLANG** – Penduduk Pandamaran Jaya yang hidup dalam ketakutan tidak menolak kemungkinan untuk menggunakan khidmat pengamal perubatan Islam bagi menghentikan gangguan ketukan misteri di kawasan tersebut.

Ini berikutan, rondaan yang dilakukan penduduk tidak menemui sebarang petunjuk utama berhubung punca kejadian.

Ketua Kampung Pandamaran Jaya, Mohamad Zahiruddin Mohamad berkata, rata-rata penduduk menyatakan waktu tidur mereka kini tidak tenang apabila bimbang berlaku insiden buruk.

Beliau memberitahu, pihaknya tidak menolak akan menggunakan khidmat pengamal pengamal perubatan Islam sebagai langkah menghentikan gangguan berkenaan.

"Perbincangan masih dijalankan bersama pihak Masjid Kam-

pung Pandamaran Jaya di sini dalam mengesas sama ada kesemua misteri ini dikaitkan dengan perbuatan mistik.

"Dalam masa sama, kita juga akan menghantar surat permohonan kebenaran mengadakan solat hajat di masjid daripada Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) susulan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) yang masih dilaksanakan di Selangor," katanya kepada Kosmo!

Kosmol semalam melaporkan misteri ketukan dan gangguan makhluk berlari atas bumbung rumah bermula Ahad lalu menyebabkan penduduk Pandamaran Jaya hidup dalam serba ketakutan.

Katanya, setakat ini sebanyak 13 laporan daripada penduduk telah diterima pihaknya berhubung ketukan itu, manakala empat kes mengenai larian di atas bumbung.

"Setakat ini, rondaan dilaku-

kan bermula pukul 12 malam hingga 4 pagi tidak menemui pergerakan mana-mana individu terlibat," katanya.

Sementara itu, Ketua Polis Daerah Klang Selatan, Asisten Komisioner Shamsul Amar Ramli telah turun padang menemui penduduk bagi mengetahui punca sebenar kejadian berkenaan.

Malah, beliau turut memberi jaminan bahawa anggotanya akan menjalankan rondaan berkala + bagi memantau kejadian itu.

# Arsyad terlantar sakit ketumbuhan otak

**KLANG** – Harapan seorang ibu melihat anaknya kembali lincah hancur apabila disahkan menghidap ketumbuhan otak buat kali kedua tahun lalu.

Arsyad Ruzin, 16, yang merupakan pelajar tingkatan empat di Sekolah Menengah Sultan Abdul Samad di sini diagnosis ketumbuhan tersebut selepas kepalanya terhantuk tiang semasa bermain di kawasan rumah di Kampung Sungai Kandis di sini.







"We have always been the pioneer in setting new standards and regulations," said Ng. "We should be further discussed on how to implement this idea," he says.

# Three business premises near Sungai Rawang demolished

A CATTLE farm, a heavy machinery workshop and a recycling centre near Taman Garing Permai in Rawang were demolished in a joint operation by the Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) and Gombak Land and District Office (PTDG).

MPS president Shamsul Shahril Badiliza Mohd Noor said the three premises, which were located 10m from the banks of Sungai Rawang, had been issued a notice to vacate under Section 245 of the National Land Code as they were squatting on government land.

"The land was leased out to a cement plant operations company.

"The leaseholder rented out the lots to these business premises.

"However, the lease expired five years ago and the land has reverted to the government.

"The premises currently occupying the land are located on a river reserve and the government will not issue business licences to the operators," he added.

He said while the demolition exercise had gone well, the only trouble received was from the cattle farm owner, who was reluctant to remove his 20 animals and two chickens.

Asked why other heavy machinery and equipment workshops were spared the excavator's claw, Shamsul said these premises had

appealed to PTDG for time to remove their machinery to protect their investments.

"We will give them one or two days. If they do not comply, we will take action," he explained.

He added that it was best for the owners of these premises to demolish their structures and vacate the land instead of waiting for MPS to come after them.

"By taking initiative, they can ensure minimal damage to their equipment," he said.

At the time of the demolition, no pollution to the river was detected.

To ensure that the river reserve land would not be encroached by illegal businesses again, Shamsul said MPS would do constant patrols to monitor the area.

## MPS goes digital for faster access to land matters

MANUAL checks on land use will soon be a thing of the past as Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) has adopted the "MPS Local Plan Land Use" system.

Operational since August, this system allows officers inspecting a site to search for relevant information about the land on their mobile device.

Council president Shamsul Shahril Badliza Mohd Noor said this simplified data checks and site location.

"Our officers can search for related information on-site. Before this, they had to go to the office to access the same information.

"This system saves time and allows them to get data on zone types and land use fast," he said, adding that the system that cost RM20,000 took a month to develop.

Apart from the system, Shamsul said the council had also developed other online platforms to improve its services to ratepayers.

He said a new app called MyMPS would be launched this month to allow for online

payment of assessment.

Starting Jan 1, 2021, MPS will do away with sending bills via post and opt for electronic billing instead.

Shamsul said some 35,000 account owners had updated their contact details while the rest had been reminded to follow suit.

"They can update their details by visiting MPS' website or scan the quick response (QR) code on the bill for this year's second term."

"The assessment bill will be sent via SMS and e-mails starting next year," he said at the "Hari Inovasi dan Integriti 2020" launch at Menara MPS in Selayang.

The MPS president hoped the use of this digital platform would reduce bureaucracy and administrative cost.

"Among the platforms we have prepared are eAduan, eTaksiran, eBayaran, eLesen, eTender, dog licence system, ePayment and digitalising assessment," he said.

On the Covid-19 pandemic and standard operating procedure during the movement

control order period, he said the council was complying with the requirement for 30% staff to be at the office and this had minimal impact on productivity.

"The council still conducts meetings and decisions via digital apps such as GoToMeeting and Zoom.

"We have also conducted seminars and programmes via webinars and Facebook," he said.

Shamsul also urged employees to stay clear of abuse of power and corruption as stern action would be taken.

"The MPS integrity unit is constantly monitoring employees. Employees who want to take on part-time jobs to earn a side income or get involved in politics are advised to submit a formal application to this unit.

"Anyone found guilty of inappropriate conduct will face the consequences, including termination of service," he said.

Shamsul reminded that they should also avoid becoming the middlemen or runner

for any business related to MPS.

"The management has issued several warnings, yet complaints about this matter continues," he said.

Shamsul touched on asset declaration,

reminding staff to update details periodically.

"If there is a new purchase or disposal of property or asset, this must be updated in the system.

"This is to avoid negative perception among the public towards council employees whose asset value exceeds their monthly earnings," adding that an anti-bribery management system that was being developed to detect irregularities among employees would be implemented soon.

Shamsul reminded all employees to abide by the state government's directive to report for duty during the conditional MCO.

"This includes those who are working from home. Failure to do so will be considered an offence that warrants disciplinary action," he said. — By FARID WAHAB

# Stop-work order on Bukit Enggang road project

Action taken as developer not complying with terms and conditions, says MPKj

A PROJECT developer in Bukit Enggang, Bandar Sungai Long, Cheras has been slapped with a stop-work order for violating terms and conditions set out by the local authority.

Kajang Municipal Council (MPKj) public relations head Kamarul Izlan Sulaiman said the non-compliance came to light during a site visit by the Engineering Department on Nov 24.

"The initial approval for a road construction project was issued on July 15 and was subject to the developer complying with the

terms set.

"Now the developer is required to submit a new infrastructure plan for approval," he said.

Among the terms set by the council included building a drainage system equipped with silt traps to prevent pollution in waterways and maintaining the slopes at the site to prevent landslips.

The matter came to light when hikers to the hill complained about the development project there.

This was highlighted in a *StarMetro* report on Nov 11.

They feared the project that began last year would contaminate the natural lake and streams in the area.

They also said the project had shortened their hiking trail as they were no longer able to use the site which turned muddy when it rained.

The hill, known as Sungai Long Hike, is a popular spot for hiking and recreation among locals in the area and from nearby townships.

In the report, MPKj said the project was to develop the East Klang Valley Expressway and it was undertaken by Ahmad Zaki Resources Bhd (AZRB).

However, a spokesperson for AZRB had denied that the work site in question was under its purview.

Clearing the dispute, Kamarul said the



StarMetro's report on the project.

project was to construct a road for an upcoming development by a different developer.

He said, however, that MPKj had yet to receive any application for other developments at the site.

In response to whether hikers could use the site for exercise, Kamarul said this depended on the land ownership status.

"If it is privately owned either by a company or an individual, then doing so is considered trespassing," he said.

A local, who spoke on condition of anonymity, said that when she visited the site on Dec 9, works were still ongoing.

She questioned if the developer had obtained a permit from Hulu Langat Land and District Office to conduct earthworks. "The developer should also show proof that it was allowed to carry out the project," she said.

The land office had earlier said it was aware of the project but declined to comment further.

## Six states still have low treated water reserves

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Six states recorded a reserve margin of below 15% in treated water during the second quarter of the year, says Deputy Environment and Water Minister (KASA) Datuk Ahmad Masrizal Muhammad.

They are Johor (11.3%), Sabah (8.3%), Perlis (7.1%), Selangor (1.5%), Kelantan (-0.25) and Kedah (-2.3%).

"Through the National Water Services Commission (SPAN) which acts as the regulatory body of the national water services industry, KASA has set the key performance indicators of treated water margin reserves that need to be complied with and achieved by all state water operators at 10 to 15%," he told the Dewan Rakyat yesterday.

Ahmad Masrizal was responding to a question from Datuk Ahmad Nazlan Idris (BN-Jerantut) on the ministry's initiative to address the low treated water reserve margin in the country and plans to increase

water sources.

For Selangor, he said the completion of the Langat 2 Plant in 2023 would increase the treated water margin reserve to 10%.

For Kelantan, he said completion of the water treatment plant in Kg Teluk, scheduled next year, would increase the water margin reserve to 4%.

"For Kedah, five plants, for which tenders have been approved, are expected to be completed in 2023 and they will increase the water reserve margin to 21%," he said.

On the treated water margin reserve for the whole country, Ahmad Masrizal said: "It is at 11.5% or 1.943 million litres per day as of the second quarter of this year."

Apart from the construction of new water treatment plants and upgrading of existing treatment plants, the initiative to reduce non-revenue water (NRW), through replacement of old and damaged pipes, as well as repair of service

tanks, is carried out to increase the national treated water margin reserve.

In response to a question from Datuk Seri Tiong King Sing (GPS-Bintulu) on the approach to be taken to improve the drainage system, especially in urban areas that are prone to flash floods, Ahmad Masrizal said the Irrigation and Drainage Department (JPS) is working closely with the local authorities to address the problem.

"This can be done by further strengthening the mechanism for compliance with drainage reviews by JPS in the process of applying for planning permission for a development.

"The importance of working with local government authorities has been emphasised in several papers presented at the National Water Council and the Environmentally-Friendly Drainage Manual has also been approved for use by local authorities since 2000 through the

Local Government National Council," he said.

Malaysian Water Forum president Saral James Maniam said a good water reserve margin should be between 25% and 30%.

"With this margin, we will be able to accommodate all unstable water disruption. The water will be there for them to supply, though it takes 48 hours to restore the water," she said when contacted.

She pointed out that states such as Kelantan and Kedah do not have any reserves.

"The demand is higher than what they can produce, that is why there is a negative reading. They also have significant NRW, which means they can produce that much treated water but they lose it before it can be supplied to end users.

"The capacity is there, not to say it isn't there, but the water might be lost during the transfer. It is a serious problem to have a negative water margin," she said.

## Gombak voters' suit against Azmin will determine if MPs are our fiduciary

A COMPANY lawyer can tell us without difficulty the fiduciary duties of a member of the company's board of directors because it is clearly spelt out in the Companies Act and judicially explained at great length in a large body of case law.

The same thing cannot be said of the fiduciary duties of a member of parliament (MP), but that will perhaps soon change because of a case that had been filed at the Kuala Lumpur High Court last week.

As the case is now *sub judice*, we have to be extra careful to comment. The facts are as follows. The plaintiffs are 10 Gombak voters who had voted for the defendant (Datuk Seri Azmin Ali) as their MP in the 14th General Election (GE14).

The plaintiffs claimed that the defendant had made false representations and deceived them when campaigning, and he had subsequently breached his fiduciary duties to them after they had entrusted him to be their elected representative.

In the run-up to GE14, the defendant campaigned for the Gombak parliamentary seat as well as the Bukit Antarabangsa state seat.

In their statement of claim, the

plaintiffs gave examples of the defendant's representation in the GE14 campaign, that his party, Pakatan Harapan (PH), would replace Barisan Nasional (BN) as the federal government because of the latter's wrongdoings, and that he would (together with PH) ensure the wrongdoings were addressed.

The plaintiffs stated that the promised reforms under the PH rule came to nought because the defendant had "orchestrated" the fall of the PH government as result of the Sheraton move on Feb 23 this year.

The plaintiffs stated that the defendant had acted to further his own interests and had breached his duties as a trustee of the voters by acting against his representations (breaking his

promises) to the voters, including by "orchestrating the Sheraton move" and working with BN leaders to topple the PH government.

The plaintiffs seek various court orders, including a declaration that the defendant (as an MP for their constituency) owes a fiduciary duty or is a trustee due to his relationship with Gombak voters, and he has breached these duties.

They also seek a court order declaring that the defendant had committed the tort of deceit against them, and had also breached his constitutional oath. They also seek compensation to be paid.

The local media's initial comment on this pending litigation is that the plaintiffs had filed this lawsuit against the defendant

over his alleged deceitful role in the Sheraton Move plan, which caused the PH government to collapse in February ("10 Gombak residents file suit against Azmi Ali for deceiving constituents" — Dec 1).

According to Laith K. Nasrawi, professor of public law at the University of Jordan, legislators and ministers are in a fiduciary relationship with the voting public, based upon the trust granted them to act solely in the public's interest, and not in their own best interests.

Legislators are fiduciaries in terms of acting with honesty, integrity and the utmost good faith in the interest of the electors, the beneficiaries, who are vulnerable to the misuse of power. They owe an exclusive loyalty to their constituents to promote matters of concern to them in parliament and assemblies, and not to allow their personal financial interests to conflict with their public duties.

Nasrawi added that the fiduciary duty of elected members is to represent the interests of their constituents in parliament, which is truly at the heart of the mandate of an elected MP. Without constituents to advance their own matters of concern, there

would be no system of representative democracy to uphold, and there would be no role for political parties and their candidates to play in the system of parliamentary government.

A similar sentiment is expressed by Lindsay Aagaard. In her paper, *Fiduciary Duty and Members of Parliament* published in the *Canadian Parliament Review* (2008), she states that the obligation MPs have to represent the interests of their constituents is truly at the heart of the mandate of an MP.

Without constituents to represent, there would be no role for MPs to play in our system of government, no need for an oath of office, no system of representative democracy to uphold, no need for parties to effect change or safeguard the status quo. The obligations MPs have flow from the power they gain from the citizenry.

We will wait and see how our courts decide on this important constitutional issue on whether your MP is your fiduciary.


"We hope to see that our best practice is replicated nationwide, so we can together mitigate the pandemic without leaving anyone behind."

#### Water supply to Petaling, KL, Hulu Selangor, Kuala Selangor restored

KUALA LUMPUR: As at 6 pm today, water supply has been restored to 805 or 93.5 per cent of the 861 areas in seven localities in the Klang Valley that have experienced water cuts since yesterday.

Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) corporate communications head Elina Baseri said water supply in areas in Petaling, Kuala Lumpur, Hulu Selangor and Selangor had been fully restored, while in Klang/Shah Alam it was 91.6 per cent, Kuala Langat (90 per cent) and Gombak (85.6 per cent).

"Alternative water supply is still available at public taps and local service centres (PKS) for the convenience of consumers who are still affected," she said in a statement today.

Water supply disruption occurred when the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) in Rantau Panjang and the WTP in Sungai Selangor Phases 1, 2 and 3 stopped operations yesterday due to raw water pollution in Sungai Selangor.



KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 9 — Water supply resumed fully by noon today in four areas in the Klang Valley — Petaling, Kuala Lumpur, Hulu Selangor and Kuala Selangor — which faced disruption since early morning yesterday, according to Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd.

Air Selangor corporate communications head Elina Baseri said supply had been restored to most places in three other affected areas, namely Kuala Langat (80 per cent); Klang/Shah Alam (74.9 per cent) and Gombak (70 per cent).

"As at noon today, water supply was stable in 731 of the 861 affected areas. Air Selangor is striving to stabilise distribution of supply in the remaining 130 areas," she said in a statement.

Elina said alternative supply of water through public taps and local service centres is still available for the affected consumers.

Air Selangor advised consumers to comply with the conditional movement control order (CMCO) standard operating procedure when fetching water from tanker lorries, local service centres and public taps.

Water supply was disrupted yesterday after detection of pollution of the raw water in Sungai Selangor, which triggered the shutdown of the Rantau Panjang Water Treatment Plant and the Sungai Selangor water treatment plants Phase 1, 2 and 3. — Bernama

## Alarming water margins of below 15% in 6 states

THE volume of treated water reserve margin for six states were recorded at an alarming level of below 15%, Deputy Environment and Water Minister Senator Datuk Dr Ahmad Masrizal Muhammad said.


Ahmad Masrizal told the Dewan Rakyat yesterday that two out of the six states have a negative margin, recorded as of the second quarter of this year (2Q20).

He said the states are Johor (11.3%), Sabah (8.3%), Perlis (7.1%), Selangor (1.5%), Kelantan (-0.2%) and Kedah (-2.3%).

"Among the approaches that have been implemented to increase the rate of treated water reserves for these states are the construction of new water treatment plants and upgrading the existing plants so that the production capacity can be increased."

"We also implemented the non-revenue water programme involving the replacement of obsolete pipes and the repair of damaged and leaking service tanks," he said.

He was responding to a query

by Datuk Ahmad Nazlan Idris (Barisan Nasional-Jerantut) on the government's initiatives to overcome the issue of low treated water reserve margins and the long-term plan to increase water resources.

Ahmad Masrizal said a total of seven water treatment plants are being constructed in Selangor, Kelantan and Kedah to increase the reserve margin levels for the states. He said the development of the

The Kampung Teluk plant in Kelantan, which will have a capacity of 30 million litres per day (MLD), is expected to be completed next year and increase Kelantan's reserves by 4%," he said.

He added that five plants in Kedah are in the process of appointing contractors and will be completed in 2023, and the success of the project would increase the state's margin to 2%.

Ahmad Masrizal said Malaysia's treated water reserve margin was recorded at 11.5% or 1,943 MLD in 2Q20.

He said through the National Water Services Commission, the government has set the key performance indicator for Malaysia's margin reserves at 10% to 15%.

"Most water treatment plants in Malaysia use river water, or surface water, as the main raw water source.

"In line with climate change, the government has set a new policy for water exploration to increase the raw water resources through the off-river storage project known as TAPS, barrage and the horizontal collector well," he said.

如今经济低迷，市议会致力于减轻人民的经济负担，包括允许一些大企业和挂牌公司，以分期付款的方式缴付税务，也预料门票税收入会因此而放缓。

其实，市议会辖内许多酒

店和旅游业者受到的冲击超乎想象，包括一些挂牌公司、三井名牌城 (Mitsui Outlet) 的生意深受打击，连带影响市议会的税收。所以市议会尽量不加重人民与企业的经济负担，希望大家能一起共渡难关。

在开销方面，市议会也降低成本，许多发展项目都已延缓或暂时搁置，除了一些必须紧急处理的工程，至于用于防疫的拨款，多为市议员执行用个人援款，包括举办施赠老弱的活动，协助人民。

## 民衆延遲繳稅

◆黄亚详（沙白安南县议员）

受到新冠肺炎疫情影响，许多发展商减缓发展项目，估计县议会一些主要收入，如发展基金会随之下滑；此外，不少企业无法承受低迷经济而结业，执照的收入来源首当其冲。

在收入减少的同时，县议会的开销却不必往年少，包括在行政开销出现上涨趋势，许多执法人员必须加班履行职务，确保所有人民都遵从标准作业程序，而公务员的超时加班费，均由县议会所支付。

尽管如此，由于今年不少民众延迟缴付税务，县议会预料明年徵税率会出现反弹，税收入也会因而增加。但我个人认为，税收入不会如预期般理想，反而会与今年的徵税率，保持一样。

## 財政赤字增加

◆洪友亮（瓜拉冷岳市议员）

瓜市议会2021年财政预算案，是市议会今年升格后，首次提呈的财政预算案，财政赤字比2020年的500万令吉，增至900万令吉。

由于市议会辖内有不少新的屋业发展，预计收入将有所增加，至于其他税项方面，则已设下目标。但一切视明年的经济状况而定，必有部分面对经济

问题，而延迟缴交税款。

至于开销方面，发展开销与去年相比，并没有太大的差异。但行政开销则因升格后，所有市议员和官员皆已调整薪金至市议会的水平，故薪酬方面的支出，随之提升。

## 王友泰：料門牌稅收入增漲

打灵再也市议员王友

泰指出，灵市市政厅

因受到新冠肺炎疫情的冲

他说，非税收入涵盖执照、准证、罚单、停车费和租金等收入来源，其中，在新冠肺炎疫情的笼罩下，许多商家包括购物广场的商铺关店结业，导致执照费预估减少1.1%。

“其实，下跌幅度最高的是租金收入，如一些停

车格和活动场地没人租用，以致租金收入减少26%，而投资利润和营业额也下滑30%。

他说，虽然灵市市政厅近年皆提呈赤字财案，但今年的预算案明显受到疫情影响：在面对收入减少的

情况下，市政厅明年将谨慎开销，主要执行一些紧急与关键的工程项目。

## 防疫工作欠透明緩慢

# 職場成主要感染群

(吉隆坡8日訊) 職場成為新冠肺炎確診病例的主要來源，衛生部沒有透明化處理疫情，感染群有增無減，原有感染群已持續了數個月之久、無法切斷感染鏈、防疫工作緩慢、沒有出現新冠肺炎症狀的感染者隱藏在人群之中等，造成雪隆確診病例高居不下。

根據卫生部和雪州卫生局的新冠肺炎新增确诊病例，在踏入12月后，新增确诊病例还是高居不下，截至12月7日，单日新增确诊病例还是在3位数，即是426宗。

根据雪州卫生局数据，12月7日426宗新增确诊病例中，大部分是涉及职场和感染群，包括工厂、建筑工地、外劳和工人宿舍等。

根据雪州议员接受《中国报》记者电访时表示，担忧新冠肺炎病毒已在雪州扩散，尤其是目前许多确诊者是无症状。

他们重申，由于目前许多确诊者没有新冠肺炎症状，如果没有接受检测，是无法确认其确诊的情况，也成为了社区中的隐忧。

### 感染链無法切斷

有者也炮轰卫生部和中央政府，没透明化的处理新冠肺炎疫情，包括没有提供疫情资讯给雪州政府，造成雪州政府也无法在地方上提供更全面的援助。

他们说，在雪州感染群是持续增加，原有感染群也是持续了数个月之久，显示出感染链也无法切断，是引发确诊病例出现的根源。

他们指出，在雪州，确诊病例主要是发生在职场，其中包括建筑工地、工厂等，大部分都是涉及外劳。

他们说，相信是外劳宿舍的居住人数过于密集、没有遵守标准作业程序、厂商没有进行防疫工作等，形成高感染风险区。

“在公寓或组屋区是有一些确诊病例，主要是源自于职场，也延伸到密切接触者，但暂时没有出现社区感染群。”

## 州政府無從下手

卫生区目前还是红区，尤其是从过去两个月迄今，确诊的病例还是高居不下，而且是持续性出现。

据了解，目前确诊的病例主要是涉及职场，包括工厂、建筑工地等，约有70至80%是涉及到外劳。

工厂和工地主要都是涉及外劳宿舍，太过密集的居住人数和没有保持社交距离、厂商等没有防疫等，都是引发确诊病例的情况出现。

同时，多个感染群迄今是持续出现，包括吉隆吉斯感染群(Kluster Bah Manggis)、柏立基感染群(Kluster Perigi)、连花路感染群(Kluster Teratai)等，尤其是目前，一些筛检活动也还在进行中，相信还是会有确诊病例出现。

### 對衛生部失望

虽然卫生部是以避免引起恐慌为理由，拒绝透露实际的资讯，但也因缺乏透明化的资讯，造成感染链迄今还是无法被中断。

即使是雪州政府或者是国州议员等想从旁给予协助，也是无从下手，让我们对于卫生部和中央政府的防疫感到失望。

卫生部没有更加透明化的处理新冠肺炎疫情、无法切断感染链、防疫工作缓慢等，都是形成雪州的新冠肺炎疫情还是高居不下的主要原因。

由于卫生部或者是卫生局也没有提供消毒方面的援助，我们也接获一些有出现确诊病例的公寓管理委员会等的求助，提供消毒援助。

巴生港口苏丹苏莱曼镇组屋(Flat Bandar Sultan Sulaiman)的确诊病例已持续了两个月，居民常见到救护车的进出，但卫生部也没有采取进一步的行动。

## 免費檢測反應不佳

## 衛生當局沒聯繫事主

李富豪披露，除了上述7名确诊外劳似乎“被遗忘”。还有2名在巴生一家电子厂工作的华裔确诊者也面临同样遭遇，即在确诊冠病后，卫生当局都没有联系事主，更遑论说要安排把他们截走。

他说，其中一人因为必须与一名独居老人同住，所以更担心会把病毒传染给抵抗力较

弱的老人，只能被隔离在家忧心忡忡，不知如何是好。

“事主在上周四（3日）接受筛检，本周一（7日）被通知确诊，但直到今日都没人联系他。”

“我有一名朋友的妹妹住在巴生高阳苑一栋公寓，即也是在同一间电子厂工作的员工确诊迄今，也没被截走。”

“但以上9名确诊者似乎都被遗忘，不排除或是协调方面出了问题，我会再跟进。官员也答应会传达予负责的领导，以安排把确诊者截走。”
