MUKADIMAH

MAJLIS Perbandaran Ampang Jaya (MPAJ) antara pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) di Selangor yang giat mempromosikan pemansuhan penggunaan beg plastik dan bekas makanan polistirena secara berperingkat mulai tahun ini.



ABD. HAMID

Pendekatan itu diambil bagi membendung masalah pencemaran, sekali gus membantu menjaga kelestarian alam sekitar.

Berikutan pemansuhan itu MPAJ mengambil pendekatan awal untuk mendidik dan memberi kesedaran kepada peniaga dan orang ramai terhadap isu alam sekitar secara berperingkat menerusi kempen Bazar Juadah Mampam bermula tahun ini. Pelaksanaan ini dilakukan untuk memberi pendedahan kepada peniaga dan pelanggan untuk bersama menjaga kebersihan dan kesejahteraan sekitar kawasan sekali gus memelihara alam sekitar pada masa akan datang.

Wartawan Utusan Malaysia, ZULFADLI SHARIFUDIN menemu bual Yang Dipertua MPAJ, ABD. HAMID HUSSAIN bagi berkongsi mengenai kempen tersebut secara terperinci.

UTUSAN: Boleh terangkan secara terperinci mengenai kempen Bazar Juadah Mampam 2016?

ABD. HAMID: Program itu bertujuan meningkatkan kesedaran pengguna mengenai kepentingan beberapa perkara seperti mengurangkan penggunaan beg plastik dan polistirena, kesedaran mengenai kitar semula dan minyak masak terpakai.

Selain itu berkaitan penyampaian maklumat mengenai hal ehwal pengunaan dan kesedaran berhubung keselamatan makanan serta mengelakkan pembaziran.

MPAJ akan memastikan semua perkara itu direalisasikan dan akan dilaksanakan secara berperingkat.

Apa yang membezakan kempen bazar mampam anjuran MPAJ berbanding PBT lain di Selangor?

Pada tahun ini, semua lokasi dan tapak bazar di Ampang Jaya diisytiharkan sebagai zon bebas polistirena. Peniaga tidak dibenarkan menggunakan polistirena dari ini menjadi syarat lesen yang perlu dipatuhi setiap peniaga.

Tindakan yang diambil MPAJ terhadap peniaga sekiranya mendapati peraturan itu tidak dipatuhi?

MPAJ akan merampas bekas polistirena milik peniaga sekiranya mereka masih menggunakannya di bazar Ramadan. Bagi kesalahan menggunakan khidmat warga asing, lesen peniaga akan ditatit.

Sejauh mana MPAJ serius dalam memastikan aspek kebersihan dipatuhi setiap peniaga di bazar Ramadan.

Semua peniaga diwajibkan menghadiri taklimat kebersihan sebelum mengemukakan permohonan permit bazar Ramadan.

Selain itu Bahagian Keselamatan Persekitaran MPAJ bersama Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah akan menjalankan pemeriksaan kebersihan pengendalian makanan sepanjang bazar beroperasi.

Jumlah petak dan senarai lokasi bazar Ramadan di bawah kendalian MPAJ pada tahun ini.

Sebanyak 1,614 buah petak disediakan melibatkan 22 buah lokasi di bawah kendalian MPAJ.

Antaranya, bazar Ramadan Pandan Indah, Pandan Perdana, Pandan Jaya dan Taman Tasik Tambahan.

Setakat ini apakah aduan paling kerap diterima melibatkan bazar Ramadan kendalian pihak majlis?

Selain isu kesesakan lalu lintas, peniaga menggunakan warga asing sebagai pembantu gerai paling banyak diterima.

Bagaimanapun, bagi melancarkan operasi bazar, anggota penguatkuasa MPAJ ditempatkan di setiap bazar.

Harapan kepada peniaga dan pengunjung bazar Ramadan.

Program bazar juadah mampam tidak akan berjaya tanpa kerjasama semua pihak.

Bukan sahaja peniaga, saya juga berharap pengunjung bazar sama-sama menyahut kempen bebas polistirena ini.

PAN, DAP 'tak boleh diharap' – Abdul Hadi

SABAK BERNAM 13 Jun - Presiden Pas, **Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang** menegaskan, parti serpihannya, PAN serta bekas sekutunya, DAP 'tidak boleh diharap' untuk membawa perubahan kepada negara dan rakyat termasuklah dalam memartabatkan Islam sebagai agama rasmi Persekutuan.

Ketika berceramah di Restoran Kuala Kurau, Pekan Sungai Besar di sini malam tadi, Abdul Hadi berkata, kedua-dua parti itu dilihat berbuat apa sahaja bagi menolak sebarang usaha untuk memperkasakan Islam menerusi usul persendirian Rang Undang-Undang Mahkamah Syariah (Bidang Kuasa Jenayah)(Pindaan) 2016 di Dewan Rakyat.

"Kita (Pas) nak buat perubahan...bukan PAN, DAP. DAP memerintah Pulau Pinang dah macam-macam kita dengar," katanya.

Mengulas lanjut mengenai rang undang-undang tersebut, beliau berkata, ia perlu diberi perhatian bagi memperkasakan bidang kuasa Mahkamah Syariah di negara ini selaras dengan kedudukan Islam sebagai agama rasmi Persekutuan.

"Islam sebagai agama rasmi Persekutuan. Tetapi Mahkamah Syariah dari segi bidang kuasa adalah rendah termasuklah dalam soal hukuman yang lebih rendah daripada orang hisap rokok," ujarnya.

Sementara itu, Naib Presiden Pas, **Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad** berkata, Pas mampu bergerak bersendirian dan tidak perlu menagih simpati daripada PKR serta DAP untuk meneruskan kelangsungan politiknya.

Selain itu, tegas beliau, Pas tidak terhegeh-hegeh mendambakan sokongan kedua-dua parti terbabit untuk mentadbir kerajaan negeri.

"Kalau kita bergantung kepada PKR dan DAP, kita tidak lawan (tanding pilihan raya). Kita duduk luar saja," katanya di sini hari ini.

Iskandar mengulas dakwaan bekas Perdana Menteri, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad kononnya Pas mengharapkan sokongan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak bagi memenuhi impian menjadi parti Islam yang kuat.

Menurut Mahathir, disebabkan itu, Pas kini tidak lagi menyerang kepemimpinan Najib.

Ditanya sama ada tindakan Dr. Mahathir turun padang membantu calon PAN dalam Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK) Parlimen Sungai Besar dan Parlimen Kuala Kangsar memberi kesan kepada kempen Pas, Iskandar memberitahu, ia tidak langsung menjejaskan partinya.

"Semasa Dr. Mahathir menjadi Perdana Menteri pun kita lawan dia, apatah lagi dia bukan Perdana Menteri, lagi kita lawan," ujarnya.

Musa: Anak tempatan tidak akan 'lari'

SABAK BERNAM 13 Jun - Rakyat di Parlimen Sungai Besar mungkin berdepan masalah untuk berjumpa wakil rakyat mereka sekiranya calon PAN atau Pas memenangi kerusi kawasan itu dalam Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK), 18 Jun ini.

Hal demikian ini kerana calon PAN, Azhar Ab. Shukur berjanji untuk menjenguk kawasan sekurang-kurangnya dua bulan sekali manakala calon Pas, Dr. Abd. Rani Osman, seminggu sekali.

Ketua Menteri Sabah, Datuk Seri Musa Aman berkata, berdasarkan janji-janji pembang-

kang sebelum ini, banyak yang tidak dikotakan dan perkara sama tidak mustahil berlaku jika calon mereka memenangi kerusi Parlimen Sungai Besar.

"Kita tengok dua calon lawan yang lain. Mereka tidak tinggal menetap di kawasan ini. Mereka hanya muncul semasa pilihan raya.

"Kenapa BN memilih anak tempatan? Kerana kita tahu anak tempatan tidak akan lari dari tempat asalnya.

"Anak tempatan akan berkhidmat sepenuh jiwa raga untuk bumi kelahirannya," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian se-

masa berucap dalam majlis beramah mesra bersama pengundi di Parit 1 Timur di sini, semalam.

Musa sebelum itu menziarah pengundi yang uzur dan menyampaikan bantuan berupa barangan keperluan harian kepada penduduk sekitar.

Kelmarin, Abdul Rani berjanji akan turun padang seminggu sekali jika menang kerusi Parlimen Sungai Besar dalam PRK kawasan itu 18 Jun ini.

Sebelum itu, Azhar dalam ceramahnya berjanji akan turun ke kawasannya dua bulan sekali jika memenangi kerusi sama.

286 orang mengundi awal hari ini

SABAK BERNAM 13 Jun - Seramai 286 pengundi awal bakal menunaikan tanggungjawab dalam Pilihan Raya Kecil (PRK) Parlimen Sungai Besar di sini esok.

Pengerusi Suruhanjaya Pilihan Raya (SPR), Datuk Seri Hashim Abdullah berkata, mereka terdiri daripada anggota polis dan Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) serta pasangan masing-masing.

Menurutnya, pengundian awal bagi saluran Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) Sungai Panjang dan DUN Sekinchan dalam Parlimen Sungai Besar akan diadakan di Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Sabak Bernam.

Pengundian untuk DUN Sungai Panjang akan di Bilik Cawangan Latihan/ Sukan IPPD manakala DUN Sekinchan di Bilik Cawangan Latihan/ Sukan IPPD 1.

“Proses pengundian awal itu akan disaksikan oleh ejen-ejen calon yang bertanding di pilihan raya itu.

“Di samping itu, pemerhati tempatan daripada pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) yang dilantik SPR juga boleh memerhati proses pengundian awal,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

Hashim berkata, pusat pengundian yang dibuka dari pukul 8 pagi akan ditutup sepenuhnya pada pukul 5 petang.

Kertas-kertas undi itu hanya akan dikira pada 18 Jun ini.

PAN memang dukungan DAP

BEBERAPA peristiwa yang berlaku semasa kempen pilihan raya kecil (PRK) di Sungai Besar dan Kuala Kangsar sifatnya provokatif dan sensitif sekali. Isu pemasangan papan iklan yang dikatakan diakui dilakukan oleh pihak DAP adalah sesuatu yang serius. Penulis tidak fikir PAN bersetuju dengan strategi sebegitu kerana ia rasis dan boleh menggugat keselamatan negara.

PAN sebuah parti yang didukung oleh bekas kepimpinan Pas dan juga bekas ahli gerakan Islam tentu peka terhadap isu ini kerana perjuangan Islam tidak sifatnya perkauman.

Tetapi mengapakah PAN membisu tanpa reaksi yang jelas mengenainya? Seolah-olah strategi DAP dalam memenangi hati pengundi dengan cara yang provokatif dan sensitif itu dipersetujui PAN atau ia pandai-pandai DAP sahaja kerana DAP mendukung PAN.

Suatu lagi isu sensitif dilakukan oleh ADUN Sekinchan, Ng Swee Lim yang menyatakan sekiranya PAN mengatasi undi Pas, mereka akan merayakan dengan jamuan arak. Apakah ADUN DAP itu tidak merasa sensitif? Sewajarnya dia menghormati calon PAN di Sabak Bernam yang adalah orang Islam dan penyokongnya yang ramai terdiri dalam kalangan pemimpin gerakan Islam.

Walaupun itu isu peribadi, katanya, ia tidak mencerminkan rasa hormat kepada orang Islam di bulan Ramadan atau itulah cerminan DAP yang gemar menyinggung hal-hal berkaitan Islam.

Nampak jelas pemimpin-pemimpin DAP melakukan sesuatu yang sifatnya provokatif dan sensitif.

Pertentangan PAN dan Pas di kedua-dua kawasan Parlimen itu ternyata tampil tanpa segan-silu lagi. Semacam DAP sengaja mengaturnya berlaku. Kalau PAN berjaya mengatasi undi Pas di kedua-dua tempat bermakna PAN boleh dijadikan regu terbaik menghadapi Pas dalam Pilihan Raya Umum Ke-14 (PRU-14) nanti.

Pas sudah mempunyai pengalaman yang banyak dengan DAP pada masa lalu. Sehingga Presiden Pas, Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang membuat kenyataan bahawa

DAP anti Islam. Hairannya, PAN serpihan daripada Pas dan didukung oleh bekas tokoh-tokoh gerakan Islam semacam tidak faham dengan pengalaman Abdul Hadi bersama DAP.

Apakah mungkin PAN suatu hari nanti bakal mengalami nasib seperti Pas kerana DAP mempunyai rancangan jangka panjang untuk menentang UMNO dan Barisan Nasional dengan melibatkan kelompok Melayu-Islam ini dan ingin menguasai Putrajaya?

DAP tahu berlakunya perpecahan dalam kalangan kelompok politik dan individu Melayu Islam adalah baik bagi strategi mereka. Penyertaan Lim Kit Siang dengan Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad dalam Deklarasi Rakyat untuk menjatuhkan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak yang tidak disetujui oleh Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim adalah juga strategi DAP melemahkan kepimpinan politik Melayu-Islam.

Nampaknya PAN sedang mempersiapkan diri untuk menggantikan Pas dalam Pakatan Harapan walaupun mengetahui PKR sedang menghadapi krisis dalaman yang tidak mudah selesai dan boleh menyentuh hubungan Pas-PKR di Selangor nanti. Ini berlaku kerana PKR mengambil sikap membantu PAN di Sabak Bernam dan Kuala Kangsar.

DAP ingin melihat prestasi PAN di kedua-dua tempat ini. Sekiranya PAN tidak mampu mengatasi undi yang diterima Pas, ini bermakna pengaruh akar umbi Pas masih kuat dan menjadi ukuran kepada DAP bahawa pengaruh PAN tidak sama seperti pengaruh Pas sewaktu dalam pakatan pembangkang dulu.

DAP dan PAN menyerang Pas dan UMNO/BN habis-habisan kononnya ada semacam strategi dan persefahaman antara mereka ke arah kerjasama. Benar atau tidak dakwaan itu ini menguntungkan UMNO/BN kerana pertindihan calon yang berlaku seperti di Sarawak tidak memberi natijah baik untuk pembangkang. Takdirnya dakwaan PAN/DAP itu menjadi kenyataan, ini baik bagi politik umat Melayu sebagai tenaga pengimbang yang baik bagi politik Malaysia.

Parti Amanah Negara tidak layak tabur janji: PAS

Sungai Besar: Parti Amanah Negara tidak layak untuk menabur janji kepada pengundi di Parlimen Sungai Besar kerana wakil mereka tiada dalam barisan EXCO kerajaan Selangor.

Naib Presiden PAS, Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad turut menyindir parti serpihan PAS itu dengan mengatakan jawatan paling tinggi disandang oleh ahlinya hanyalah ahli majlis pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT), yang tidak mempunyai kuasa untuk menentukan dasar serta hala tuju pentadbiran kerajaan negeri.

“Sebab itu PAS pelik apabila dalam setiap kempen, mereka janji itu dan ini kepada pengundi. Mereka bercakap seolah-olah berada dalam pentadbiran kerajaan negeri.

“Ingin saya beritahu bahawa PAS berada dalam pentadbiran kera-

jaan negeri sejak 2008 sehinggalah sekarang. Wakil PAS ada dalam barisan EXCO, macam-macam kita sudah buat dan ada antaranya menjadi contoh kepada Kerajaan Persekutuan.

“Parti itu pula baharu sahaja ditubuh dan fungsi parti ini pula amat terhad,” katanya pada sidang media di sini, semalam.

Iskandar yang juga Pesuruhjaya PAS Selangor merangkap EXCO Perumahan, Pengurusan Bangunan dan Kehidupan Bandar Selangor turut mengingatkan pengundi supaya tidak terpedaya dengan kempen parti serpihan itu.

Banyak lakukan perubahan

“Sekali lagi saya tegaskan parti itu tiada hak bercakap mengenai kerajaan negeri. PAS lebih tahu perjalanan pentadbiran dan semua

EXCO PAS sudah banyak melakukan perubahan,” katanya.

Sementara itu, Pengarah Komunikasi parti serpihan PAS itu, Khalid Samad, berkata mereka layak berbuat demikian kerana mewakili pakatan harapan (PH), selain mendapat sokongan Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali dan EXCO PKR serta DAP.

“Saya cukup hairan mengapa perkara ini diungkit oleh (Naib Presiden PAS) Datuk Iskandar kerana jika dakwaan kita tidak tepat, maka sudah tentu ia akan disanggah oleh Menteri Besar, EXCO PKR dan DAP.

“PAS hanya ada 13 ADUN, kerajaan Selangor dipimpin oleh pakatan yang mendominasi dari segi jumlah dengan 29 ADUN. Jelaslah 29 lebih besar daripada 13, jadi kita berhak untuk bercakap bagi pihak kerajaan negeri,” katanya.

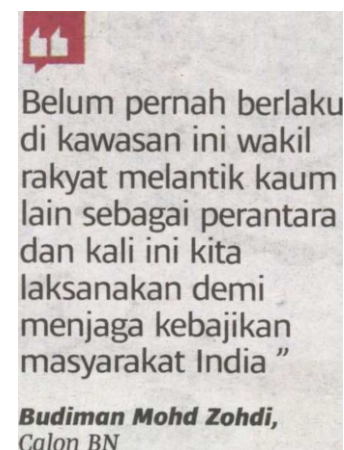

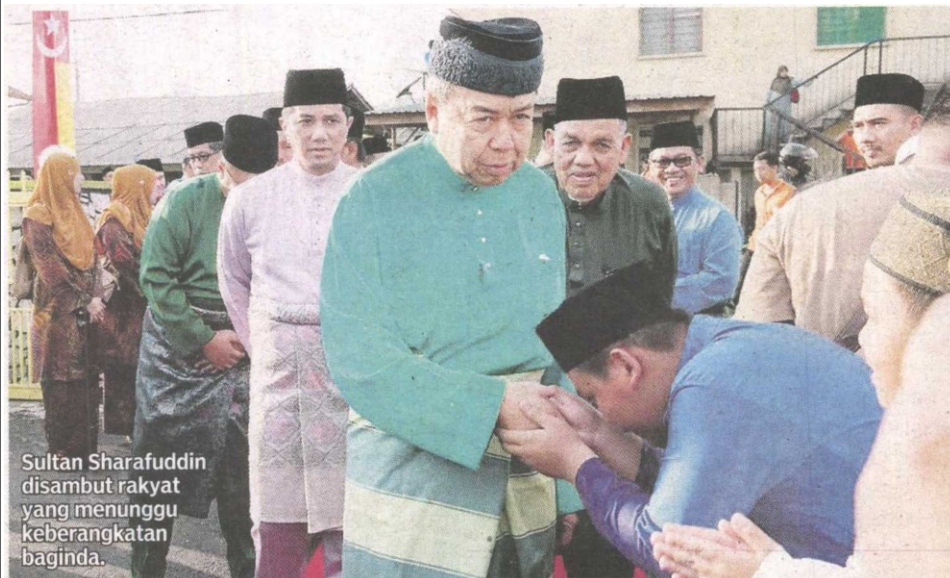

Pengerusinya, Mohd Yusof Anani, 55, berkata, seramai 20 pemandu teksi yang berpangkalan di hentian teksi Pekan Sekinchan didakwa terjejas teruk kerana perkhidmatan bas berkenaan.

"Mereka boleh bayar sewa sebuah bas dengan RM800 se-

hari, takkan mereka tak boleh bayar kami RM1,000 sebulan," katanya selepas demonstrasi aman membantah perkhidmatan Bas Selangorku, di sini, semalam.

Menurutnya, bas percuma berkenaan yang beroperasi dari jam 6 pagi sehingga 10 malam menyebabkan mereka tidak boleh cari makan.

"Kami cuma menunggu di sini dari pagi sampai petang sahaja tanpa pelanggan."

"Masalahnya kami juga perlu bayar air, api, GST, makan, minum dan tang- gung anak-anak malah kami

juga perlu menanggung penyelenggaraan kereta," katanya.

Sebelum ini Mohd Yusof berkata, mereka boleh mendapat sekitar RM1,500 hingga RM1,600 sebulan.

"Tapi sekarang ini berbeza sebab dalam sehari, kami cuma mampu raih sekitar RM10 sahaja dan pendapatan tersebut biasanya datang daripada pelanggan tetap," katanya.

Menurutnya, kerajaan negeri diminta mengkaji semula perkhidmatan Bas Selangorku itu.

"Duit rakyat yang di- belanjakan lebih membantu syarikat bas yang disewa se- dangkan penduduk yang naik bas berkenaan cuma dua tiga orang sahaja, selebihnya pula pendatang asing."

"Jadi kami minta kerajaan negeri kaji balik pemberi- an bas percuma jika mereka memahami masalah rakyat Selangor," katanya kepada *Sinar Harian*.

Tambahnya, pemandu kereta sewa tidak menghalang Bas Selangorku sekiranya tambang turut dikenakan ke atas perkhidmatannya.

'Amanah not part of Selangor government'

AMANAH cannot claim that it is part of the Selangor state government as the party did not exist when Pakatan Rakyat took over the administration from Barisan Nasional in 2008.

Call to abolish early voting

THE Pakatan Harapan alliance has questioned the credibility of the postal and early voting system head of the Sungai Besar and Kuala Kangsar by-elections that will be held on Saturday.

Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar said that as long as this system exists, the ruling Barisan Nasional (BN) government will always have several seats that will serve as “fixed deposits” for them.

“In the 2013 General Election, BN won a total 133 out of 222 parliamentary seats. However, the victory for 30 of those seats was secured only through the votes cast by the postal and early voters,” she said at a press conference at Parti Amanah Negara’s headquarters in Sungai Besar yesterday.

Nurul Izzah added that had it not been for those 30 seats won by postal and early votes, the opposition would have obtained a

majority of 119 seats to form the government.

Early voters mainly comprise the police and military personnel and there have been alleged reports that these votes are allocated to the constituency where their current military bases are located, as opposed to being sent back to their hometowns.

“To ensure the fairness of our elections, we call for the counting of early votes to be conducted on the same day that the votes were cast,” she said.

Early voting and postal voting will begin today in both Kuala Kangsar and Sungai Besar.

“We must urge extra vigilance in providing Malaysians with a free and fair electoral platform. The Election Commission must ensure transparency by making sure that watchful eyes are kept on the ballot boxes that carry the votes of our people,” Nurul Izzah said.

Not a pleasant drive in Petaling Jaya anymore

MANY Petaling Jaya denizens have to endure over the past six months deep frustration since the local council decided to toy with the much regrettable idea of changing the road system linking several main routes within this city.

Residents and business proprietors are very concerned as the originally planned changes, after a trial implementation did not yield the expected smooth flow of traffic, have now been turned into a jigsaw puzzle that no one knows how to solve!

What was once a pleasant short drive to our favourite shopping centre (Amcorp Mall) and fast-food joint (A&W), had now turned into a draggy and meandering affair.

These two places were previously just 200m or a two-minute drive from where I live across the road, but now I need to spend 15 min-

utes and drive nearly 3km to get there.

Residents voice out against proposed highway at meeting with MP

TEMPERS flared amid growing concerns of deforestation in Selangor to build the many proposed highways.

As residents protested the proposed Damansara-Shah Alam Highway (DASH), Shah Alam-Ulu Kelang Expressway (Suke) and East Klang Valley Expressway (EKVE) for various reasons, they stood in solidarity against the felling of trees in forest reserves to make way for development of highways.

Save Green Lungs representative Jessy Phuah protested against the degazettement of Bukit Sungai Putih Utara and Selatan Forest Reserves for the development

of Suke.

"We demand that Selangor Government put an emphasis on protecting our forest reserves and stop issuing notices to degazette our forest reserves," she said.

The group collected an estimated 15,000 signatures in objection to the degazettement of forest reserves.

The petition was handed over to Pandan MP Rafizi Ramli.

Rafizi reaffirmed his stance on highway concessions and said the highway concession model was no longer an economically viable option.

"It is time to eliminate the concession model in this country and

find more palatable transport models," he said, citing the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system as an option.

He said he would bring the discussion on highway concessions to Parliament.

Say No To Kidex (Kinrara-Damansara Elevated Expressway) group member Mak Khuin Weng said the Selangor government had not replied to any of the group's letters objecting to the highways.

"We never got a black-and-white about the cancellation of Kidex," he added.

Say No To Suke spokesman Agos Hassan-Ashari also highlighted several concerns of residents and

businesses in the areas affected by Suke.

Say No To DASH spokesman Alvin Chin said the group was not against the highway project but was asking for realignment as the proposed route cut through a densely populated Damansara Perdana.

"The DASH project has been approved to start work in August according to Bukit Lanjan assemblyman Elizabeth Wong, despite our objections against it.

"We highlighted to the Menteri Besar that there are flaws; they have breached local laws and regulations, and the Town and Country Planning Act," he said.

Council hopes use of reusable containers continues after Ramadan

AMPANG Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) has joined other local councils to discourage the use of polystyrene and plastics, by launching its Sustainable Bazaar Programme 2016.

Selangor Housing Committee chairman Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad said the state government was looking at implementing a ban on polystyrene and plastics in favour of reusable and biodegradable containers.

"When we carry out *gotong-*

royong, we see plastic and polystyrene containers clogging up drains.

"It is a cause of flash floods and also becomes breeding ground for mosquitoes.

"That is why the council is encouraging the use of biodegradable containers instead; the state is still in its educational campaigning stage.

"Other states such as Malacca have banned the use of polystyrene, and Selangor may go in that direction but we will first research the effects of such a move," he said at the programme held at the Pandan Indah Ramadan bazaar.

Five traders at the bazaar were given an incentive for their efforts in keeping their stalls clean, in a bid to motivate others at the market.

In addition to the programme,

Iskandar also plans to promote the use of reusable containers at night markets by distributing such containers to market-goers starting this week.

"The use of reusable containers should continue beyond Ramadan," he added.

MPAJ assistant secretary Johari Atli said the council had prepared 1,614 lots for traders in 22 locations in Ampang Jaya.

"So far, 1,417 lots are occupied by food traders and 28 taken up by drinks and coconut sellers.

"The selection of lots is on a first-come-first-served basis, and traders are limited to two lots each.

Johari also emphasised the importance of recycling in general, including processing used cooking oil.

"The programme is in line with

MPAJ's mission to make Ampang Jaya a sustainable city.

"It is aimed at strengthening awareness among traders and the general public on the importance of hygiene, encouraging the use of biodegradable containers, and raising the awareness of recycling solid waste as well as cooking oil.

"In total, the council has collected 2,149 litres of used cooking oil since the beginning of the year up to May," he said.

Used oil collection schedule for Ramadan markets is 3pm to 5pm weekly at Muhibbah Complex on Mondays, Bandar Baru Ampang on Tuesdays, Taman Melawati and Keramat Permai on Wednesdays, Bukit Indah on Thursdays, and Pandan Indah as well as Taman Melor on Saturdays.

Pas V-P: Dr M's diminished clout will not help PAN

SUNGAI BESAR: Efforts made to bolster Parti Amanah Negara's (PAN) campaign through the involvement of Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad are considered futile.

Pas vice-president Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad said Dr Mahathir's clout had diminished as he was ostracised by his former comrades in Barisan Nasional (BN) following attacks on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

Pas and PAN continue to bicker over campaigning

SUNGAI BESAR: Pas and Parti Amanah Negara (PAN) continue to lock horns when the latter was told that it has no business making electoral promises, or representing the Selangor government.

Pas vice-president Datuk Iskandar Abdul Samad said PAN was not part of the now-defunct Pakatan opposition pact, which cooperated to win Selangor in 2008, and later, retained it for a second term.

“Everybody can make claims but PAN was only established last year and all of the state government’s accomplishments can only be attributed to executive councillors from Pas, DAP and PKR.

“PAN has never been part of the state government from 2008 to last year. Their involvement is only limited to their capacity as local council members,” he said here yesterday.

Iskandar, who is also a Selangor state executive councillor, said PAN had never taken part in drawing up the state government’s policies.

In response, PAN said it had the right to speak on behalf of the Selangor government as it was part of the new opposition pact, Pakatan Harapan.

PAN communications director Khalid Samad said PKR, DAP and PAN altogether had 29 state assemblymen compared with Pas’ 13 representatives.

“PAN is supported by the Selangor menteri besar and there are more PKR and DAP state executive councillors than Pas’.

“I am baffled by why Iskandar brought this up because if what PAN has been saying is incorrect, for sure it will be rebutted by the menteri besar, DAP and PKR. So, it is clear that we are supported by PKR and DAP,” Khalid said here yesterday.

Khalid said the participation of Pas in the Sungai Besar and Kuala Kangsar parliamentary by-elections was irrelevant “because the fight is between Pakatan Harapan and BN”.

However, Khalid admitted that the campaign for parties under the opposition pact had weakened following the break-up of Pakatan.

Only small crowds at Dr M's events

KUALA KANGSAR: Fresh from campaigning for Parti Amanah Negara's (PAN) candidate for Sungai Besar on Saturday, Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad came here yesterday to campaign for the party's candidate for Kuala Kangsar, Dr Ahmad Termizi Ramli.

The former prime minister spoke at two functions in the morning and noon. He spent about an hour at the first event, which was a colloquium on "Selamatkan Malaysia", and another two hours at the second event, a forum on the Mahathir-Kit Siang declaration.

However, both events failed to attract the crowd, as only some 300 people were at the first function and a slightly larger crowd attended the second one.

Opposition leaders who joined Dr Mahathir at the first event included DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang, PAN president Mohamad Sabu and former Pas vice-president Datuk Husam Musa.

However, conspicuously missing at both functions were allies of the declaration, including former deputy prime minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and Dr Mahathir's son, Datuk Seri Mukhriz Mahathir.

Speaking at the forum at Chandan Puteri here, Dr Mahathir called on voters to reject the ruling coalition.

"We need to ensure Najib loses in both by-elections.

"If possible, make BN candidates lose their deposits as it will show how much the rakyat detest Najib.

"Vote for our candidate (Termizi)

and do not waste your vote on BN," he said, adding that candidates who supported the declaration should be supported.

Calling for Najib's removal, Dr Mahathir said Malaysia would become a developed nation only if the prime minister steps down.

As he was leaving the forum, Dr Mahathir told an impromptu press conference that he would consider returning to Umno if Najib was removed from the party.

"Overthrow Najib, return to the original Umno, then I will consider returning to the party."

Earlier, when attending the colloquium, Dr Mahathir said he had met Pas president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang to reveal Najib's alleged wrongdoings.

"He (Hadi) admitted to me that there was truth to what I said.

"But in the end, I think he is alone.

"Pas has no friends as his party had split to PAN and he hates PAN.

"That is why he is standing by Najib's side.

"Pas is now helping Najib," he added.

On statement by Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi that Umno would accept Dr Mahathir back if he was sincere, he said: "I have been tolerant towards Zahid. When he was the Youth chief, he said that I gave contracts to cronies, which was later found to be unfounded, but I did not sack him.

"Now, if anyone advises the party leadership, he will be sacked."

Addressing the crowd at the colloquium, Dr Mahathir said the Kuala Kangsar and Sungai Besar by-elections were not about changing the government.

"Pas said they wanted to come up with all sorts of laws when they become the government but the fact of the matter is Pas cannot form a Federal Government."

He added if Pas could not form a Federal Government, then it should not talk about making laws.

REPLY: He should watch what he says, says Zahid

KUALA KANGSAR

TUN Dr Mahathir Mohamad should "watch what he says" before people start accusing him of being senile, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said.

"I think he should watch what he says, or people will think that he is senile. That is all I want to say," he

said at the police tactical centre here yesterday.

Present were Menteri Besar and Perak Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abd Kadir and state police chief Datuk Seri Abdul Rahim Hanafi.

Zahid was commenting on Dr Mahathir's statement here early yesterday that the deputy prime minister should focus on business instead of getting involved in politics.

On PKR secretary-general Rafizi Ramli's continuous attacks on the prime minister's wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, here, Zahid said it would not affect the BN campaign.

He said Rafizi had apologised to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak for making baseless accusations, and that reflected the truth of his statements.

Zahid, who is also home minister, said the Kuala Kangsar and Sungai Besar parliamentary by-elections were the most peaceful in history.

He said only 11 police reports had been lodged in Kuala Kangsar, and five investigation papers had been opened.

"The peaceful environment is mainly because of political maturity," he said, adding that the election machineries of the contesting parties had not provoked each other.



'Dr M's campaign shows political disarray'

SUNGAI BESAR: Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's campaign for Parti Amanah Negara (PAN) in the Sungai Besar and Kuala Kangsar by-elections shows that the opposition is in political disarray.

Umno Supreme Council member Datuk Seri Ahmad Shabery Cheek said by working with Dr Mahathir, it appeared that the opposition had agreed with his stand and previous action against opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

"It appears that they have accepted all the things he had said and done against opposition leaders, including Anwar," said Shabery at the district fishermen association's jetty here yesterday.

Vice-versa, Shabery said Dr Mahathir's pact with his new allies appeared as if he had substantiated all of their allegations hurled at him.

He said for example, PAN was led by Pas deputy president Mohamad Sabu, who was known for his harsh remarks against Dr Mahathir when the latter was prime minister.

"It appears the disarray in the opposition has worsened.

"They had seen the formation of PAN following an internal conflict (in Pas).

"PAN is now led by a former Pas deputy president, who used to not only issue strong criticism against Dr Mahathir, but had uttered all sorts of harsh remarks against him.

"So, now with Dr Mahathir openly campaigning for PAN, it is as if he agrees with all the accusations hurled against him (by Mat Sabu)."

In **Johor Baru**, Umno Supreme Council member Datuk Nur Jazlan Mohamed said the former premier's action in campaigning for the opposition in the two by-elections was a betrayal to all Umno members.

"We can't deny that the progress we are enjoying today is partly because of what Dr Mahathir did in his 22 years as prime minister.

"However, this betrayal has also become part of his legacy."

Hisham criticises Dr M's backing of PAN

SUNGAI BESAR: Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein said the move by former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad to campaign for PAN was inconsistent with his political stand.

"For me, PAN is DAP... and throughout my political career, I have never heard of Dr Mahathir supporting DAP.

"But yesterday, he went on stage to support PAN, sharing the same stage with DAP.

"I see this as an inconsistency. If we want to assure the people of what we are fighting for, we must be con-

sistent," he said after meeting the Barisan Nasional (BN) election machinery and voters at Kampung Baru Kian Sit (Site A) in Sekinchan here yesterday. Present were MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Liow Tiong Lai and BN Malacca chairman Datuk Seri Idris Haron.

Hishammuddin said although the Kuala Kangsar and Sungai Besar by-elections were held to ensure the welfare of the constituents, Dr Mahathir chose to use the platform to attack Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

Idris said Dr Mahathir had gone

against his own principles by supporting the opposition.

"In his 22 years as BN chairman, Dr Mahathir had always reminded party members and voters to obey the leaders.

"But now, he has turned around and asked us to do the exact opposite. I would like to remind Dr Mahathir to stop destroying BN, enough is enough."

Meanwhile, Liow said he was confident that there would be a swing in Chinese votes to BN. He said the Chinese community here had lost confidence in the opposition.

哈迪：慎选候选人 否则遭天谴

致命缺点未解决 国阵领跑上半程

大港13日讯 | 结束半程赛事的大港补选，目前依旧由赛前热门-巫统候选人布迪曼领跑，诚信党候选人阿扎哈苏谷与伊斯兰党候选人阿都拉尼紧追其后，惟三方各有其致命缺点未解决，或许将成为下半程赛事翻盘的关键！

跨过巨头领袖助阵的「超级黄金周末」，大港补选仅剩5天竞选期，各候选人也因斋戒月期间开始显露疲态。

而过去一星期的主要课题，包括了前首相敦马哈迪为诚信党助阵、行动党树立的广告板课题、公正党副主席拉菲兹爆出的「首相夫人包机事件」等，似乎无助炒热大港选情，仅成为口水战话题。

布迪曼每日跑10场

尽管从赛前预测到如今仍属于热门候选人，惟布迪曼却不敢松懈，每日活动几乎超过10场，早上通常在马华领袖的陪同下，勤跑行动党强区-适耕庄，从茶餐室到巴刹都已走遍，神庙及教堂也拜访过，中午后进入马来甘榜，下午至晚上则集中在投票站行动室与清真寺，期望取得每一

张选票。

即使国阵巨头领袖包括首相拿督斯里纳吉与副首相拿督斯里阿末扎希先后站台，稳扎稳打的布迪曼却未显露未战先胜的傲气，长期保持低调回应作风，包括马哈迪为诚信党站台、行动党指责盗窃广告板事件等，他依然温文儒雅地应对，也让对手只能把打击目标转移至巫统、纳吉甚至大港区部主席嘉玛。

虽然亲民的布迪曼到处接触选民，并承诺中选后会实现各种诺言，惟并未回应反对党提出的各种国家课题，包括经济日渐衰退、实施消费税对人民的冲击、一马发展公司与纳吉的26亿令吉政治献金等，无法拉回不满国阵政策的支持者。

身为诚信党首位西马候选人的阿扎哈苏谷，除了获得希望联盟巨头领袖的支持，更有超级助选员马哈迪的助阵，在政治明星

亮度上堪称无与伦比，即使诚信党基层与动员能力稍弱，惟从选战开始就获得行动党大力扶持，积极走入适耕庄保住华裔选票。加上终于动起来的公正党协助开拓大港选区，深入双溪班让马来甘榜会见选民，尝试动摇伊党与巫统两大票仓。

选民对诚信党陌生

惟选民依旧对刚成立不满一年的诚信党感到陌生，甚至不少人以为诚信党是伊党的分支，也成为阿扎哈苏谷的致命伤，加上嘉玛的「华人吃猪肉论」广告板虽然再度激起华裔对巫统的不满，却在巫裔选区产生反效应，加深巫统长期灌输「诚信党为行动党手下」的印象，因此接下来如何摆脱刻板印象，加深选民对诚信党的认识，还有很长的一段路要走。

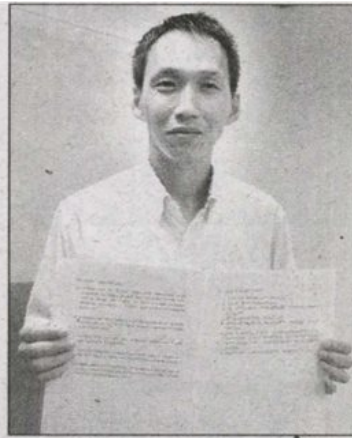

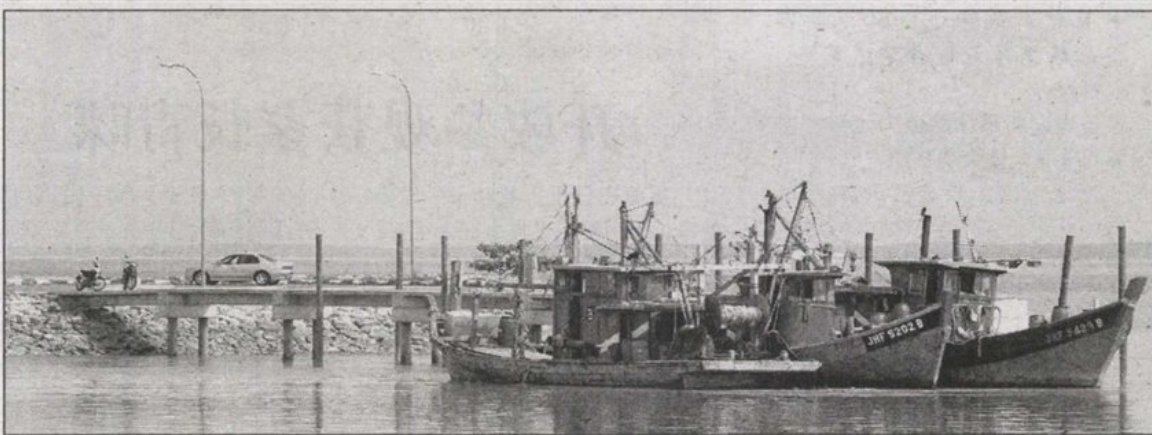

马上处理问题。

潘国全指出，前2年发生烧车、档主打鬥纠纷时，警方在接获投报后，原可在10分钟内赶抵现场，却因封路、交通阻塞，迟至超过半小时仍无法进入市集范围。

他说，市议会去年斋戒月市集出租逾200个摊位，就已招致诸多纠纷及引起交通大阻塞，今年还增至475个摊位，担心在封路后，加剧交通阻塞情况。

脑死奇迹苏醒 两老为儿筹医费

巴生13日讯 | 农历新年正月十五日遭遇严重车祸，一度脑死的男青年在家人不放弃治疗下奇迹生还，惟双亲已耗尽积蓄，不堪负担每月6000令吉的高额医疗费，冀望社会人士伸出援手、出钱出力捐献解决燃眉之急！

奇迹生还的郑业椽（26岁），经家人不放弃治疗下，通过每周六天定期的针灸，从被判定脑死生还几率微乎其微，好转至目前四肢瘫痪、一眼盲，惟仍有意识。

自他出院后，不能像一般正常人进食，必须饮用进口奶粉，冲泡后从腹部开洞插入胃部的塑喉倒入充饥，维持生命。

这几个月来，其双亲竭尽所能医治，已耗尽积蓄7万令吉，单靠父亲的汽车维修店收入，不堪负担每月约计6000令吉的医疗费用，入不敷出，经济陷入困境。

住在武吉丁宜Parklands廉价组屋的郑氏夫妇，郑炳金（58岁）与潘秀琼（56岁）周一通过行动党巴生国会联委会主席吴国民召开记者会，希望社会人士发挥爱心，慷慨解囊以助解决燃眉之急。

美门义务载送

郑炳金指出，汽车维修店原是儿子经营，自儿子出事后，他则代为打理店务，妻子则专心照料儿子。

他说，儿子充饥的奶粉钱平均每月1500令吉（每隔2天饮一罐，每罐100令吉）、补脑药每月300令吉、益菌药120令吉、成人

「我们会在取得市议会的批准信后，再向居民征收费用，作为聘请保安公司巡逻及站岗的费用，届时希望所有的村民都能够踊跃响应。」

「根据目前拟定的计划，村委会将聘请4位保安人员，每日从晚上7时至隔天早上7时巡逻社区和驻守保安亭，估计每月开销约6800令吉。」

白永福透露，有关社区围篱计划早在2年前就曾经讨论过，但一直没有落实。唯近期村内接二连三发生不愉快的事件后，村委们意识到必须作出一些改变。

另一方面，他表示，为了加强巡逻队伍的阵容，村委会也向社区志愿警卫队寻求合作，也获得对方答应每星期两天，派6名团员加入保安阵营。
