Azmin kesal PKR-DAP bertembung di enam kerusi

SHAH ALAM 25 April - Timbalan Presiden Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali kesal berikutan parti itu akan bertembung dengan sekutunya, DAP di enam kerusi Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) termasuk di Batu Kitang, pada Pilihan Raya Negeri (PRN) Sarawak, 7 Mei ini.

Mohamed Azmin berkata, beliau tidak dimaklumkan mengenai perkara itu oleh DAP, sebaliknya hanya mengetahui menerusi laporan berita pagi tadi.

"Saya tidak tahu (DAP akan bertanding kerusi Batu Kitang)... saya mendapat tahu menerusi laporan berita pagi ini.

"Ketika saya bercakap dengan (Lim) Guan Eng (Setiausaha Agung DAP) melalui perbualan telefon 10 malam tadi, dia tidak beritahu salah seorang daripada (calon) kami perlu menarik diri...beliau mahu teruskan rundingan, maka ini suatu yang malang," katanya

kepada pemberita selepas merasmikan Program Jom Baca di Perpustakaan Tun Uda di sini, hari ini.

Beliau yang juga Menteri Besar Selangor berkata demikian ketika diminta mengulas mengenai pertembungan calon PKR dan DAP di enam kerusi tersebut pada PRN Sarawak ke-11.

Selain Batu Kitang pada penamaan calon hari ini, kerusi Mulu, Murum, Mambong, Simanggang dan Ngemah menyaksikan pertembungan antara calon DAP dan PKR.

Sebelum ini, menerusi perjanjian bertulis berhubung pengagihan kerusi yang ditandatangani antara PKR dan DAP pada 7 April lepas, kerusi Batu Kitang, Marudi, Machan, Layar dan Belaga telah diperuntukkan kepada PKR.

Sementara kerusi Senadin, Mulu, Tasik Biru, Simanggang, Mambong, Bukit Semuja, Ngemah dan Murum akan ditandingi DAP.


Bagaimanapun, PKR dilihat 'mencabuli' persetujuan pembahagian kerusi itu dengan bertanding menentang DAP di Mulu, Mambong, Ngemah, Simanggang dan Murum.

DAP pula membala dengan meletakkan calonnya menentang PKR di Batu Kitang.

Mengulas mengenai perjanjian bertulis berkenaan, Mohamed Azmin mengakui beliau telah memberikan kuasa kepada Pengurus PKR Sarawak, Baru Bian untuk menandatangani surat kebenaran bagi calon-calon PKR bertanding di lima kerusi yang menjadi perbahanan dengan DAP.

Azmin, bagaimanapun mendakwa beliau membuat keputusan itu berdasarkan mandat yang diberikan presiden parti, Datuk Seri Dr. Wan Azizah Wan Ismail kepadanya untuk menyelesaikan pertikaian kerusi tersebut. - BERNAMA

Calon-calon pembangkang bertembung sesama sendiri

DAP anggap ditipu PKR

■ KUCHING 25 APRIL

HARI pencalonan Pilihan Raya Negeri Sarawak Ke-11 (PRN-11) mendedahkan tembelang parti pembangkang yang tidak mampu berkompromi sehingga bertembung sesama sendiri di hampir 30 kawasan Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN).

Pertembungan itu berlaku bukan sahaja dalam kalangan parti yang membentuk pakatan seperti PKR dan DAP malah melibatkan Pas dan serpihannya, PAN serta parti pembangkang Sarawak iaitu Parti Reformasi Negeri Sarawak (STAR) dan Parti Bansya Dayak Baru (PBDSB).

PKR dan DAP yang digambarkan 'seiring sejalan' di Semenanjung umpamanya, bertembung sesama sendiri di enam kawasan DUN iaitu Batu Kitang, Mulu, Murum, Simanggang, Ngemah dan Mampong.

Pemimpin kanan DAP sehingga petang semalam merayu supaya PKR Sarawak berkompromi namun segalanya tidak dipedulikan.

Setiausaha Agung DAP yang belum disahkan jawatannya, Lim Guan Eng tidak dapat menyembunyikan kekecewaannya terhadap PKR yang enggan mengubah pendirian mereka.

Katanya, beliau boleh menerima jika pertembungan hanya berlaku di satu DUN namun jumlah lima DUN yang bertindih adalah terlalu banyak.

Menurutnya, PKR juga tidak ada komitmen untuk mematuhi perjanjian supaya mereka tidak bertembung antara satu sama lain.

Beliau yang ditemui di luar pusat penamaan calon DUN Senadin di Miri pagi ini secara terbuka berkata: "Kami rasa telah ditipu."

Pertembungan di lima kerusi itu berlaku apabila Timbalan Presiden PKR, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali memberi kuasa kepada PKR negeri untuk bertanding di kawasan yang bertindih.

Perkara itu diakui Mohamed Azmin dalam satu majlis di Shah Alam, Selangor hari ini.

Berikut itu, DAP secara dramatik membala dendam dengan mencalonkan calon Melayu, Abdul Aziz Isa di Batu Kitang sedangkan kawasan itu ditandingi calon PKR, Voon Shaik Ni.

Menurut sumber, pagi ini Abdul Aziz bersiap sedia di dalam keretanya di luar pusat penamaan calon dan apabila menerima berita PKR meletakkan calon di DUN

Mambong (bertindih dengan DAP), dia bertindak menyerahkan borang pencalonan kepada Suruhanjaya Pilihan Raya (SPR).

Sebuah lagi parti yang turut mengganggotai pakatan bersama DAP dan PKR iaitu PAN mengambil peluang untuk membala dendam kepada Pas dengan bertanding di Samarang, Muara Tuang, Sadong Jaya, Sebuyau dan Beting Maro.

Pertembungan itu ibarat dedalu yang menumpang pokok kerana semua kawasan berkenaan dirintis oleh Pas sejak beberapa siri PRN terutamanya di DUN Beting Maro yang mula menunjukkan hasil.

Pas juga bertembung dengan DAP di Pujut dan Samalaju selain turut bersaing dengan PKR di Kakus, Jepak dan Lambir.

Turut menyertai drama pertembungan dalam PRN-11 ialah STAR dan PBDSB yang bertanding di kawasan DAP serta PKR.

STAR bertembung dengan DAP di Padungan, Bukit Semuja, Dudong, Bawang Assan, Pelawan dan bertembung dengan PKR di Jepak, Nangka, Serembo dan Batu Lintang.

PBDSB pula bertembung dengan PKR di Opar dan Balai Ringin selain berentap dengan DAP di Senadin, Kedup dan Bukit Semuja.

Air empangan dipantau setiap jam

Usaha bagi pastikan bekalan air sentiasa cukup untuk seluruh penduduk Selangor

SHAH ALAM - Menteri Besar, Mohamed Azmin Ali berkata, kerajaan negeri memantau paras air di empangan dan sungai di Selangor hampir setiap jam.

Menurutnya, ia bagi memastikan bekalan air sentiasa cukup untuk seluruh penduduk Selangor.

"Kami telah adakan mesyuarat khas tentang perkara ini. Beberapa empangan dilaporkan berada pada tahap rendah tapi kami dah ambil langkah-langkah seperti pembinaan kolam tadahan air dan kolam di Bestari Jaya yang boleh pam air ke sungai di Selangor.

Beliau berkata, kerajaan negeri juga menjalankan operasi pemberian air untuk satu tempoh panjang.

Walaupun cuaca sangat panas, rakyat Selangor masih mampu mendapat hujan.

"Kami putuskan jika ada

keperluan untuk tingkatkan operasi pemberian awan, kami akan buat dengan teknologi terkini," katanya.

Azmin berkata, jika ada keperluan untuk menambah bilangan penerbangan untuk pemberian awan, pihaknya akan berbuat demikian.

"Kami juga ambil langkah proaktif termasuk pemberian awan yang dijalankan sejak beberapa bulan lepas. Jika ada keperluan, kami akan tambah penerbangan untuk pemberian awan," katanya selepas menyertai Program Terjah dan Musnah Aedes di Seksyen 28, di sini, semalam.

Sementara itu dalam satu majlis di Bangi, kelmarin, Azmin kesal dengan tindakan rakyat yang sewenang-wenangnya membasuh kereta dan menyiram pokok menggunakan bekalan air bersih.

Menurutnya, aktiviti itu sepatutnya menggunakan takungan air hujan yang disimpan.

"Penduduk kena ingat, kos rawat air cukup besar sebab itu kami ambil langkah pro aktif minta rakyat berjimat cermat dalam penggunaan air bersih," katanya.

Beliau turut meminta pihak berkuasa tempatan mengkaji semula reka bentuk rumah baharu dibina supaya pemaju menyediakan kemudahan takungan air hujan bagi aktiviti tersebut untuk penduduk.

Tegasnya, kerajaan negeri membelanjakan hampir RM162 juta setahun hanya untuk membekalkan air bersih kepada rakyat.

"Tapi saya dapati ramai yang guna air bersih sewenang-wenangnya untuk aktiviti yang sebenarnya boleh gunakan sumber air lain," katanya.

Selangor lega benteng ampuh

KUALA LUMPUR 25 April - Benteng Selangor yang kebal dalam dua perlawanan terakhir melegakan jurulatihnya, Zainal Abidin Hassan apabila menerima kunjungan pendahulu Kumpulan E, Ceres FC dalam saingan Piala AFC esok.

Namun, ketumpulan jentera serangan sedikit merebahkan juara Piala Malaysia itu kerana Red Giants perlu mencari gol bagi mendapatkan tiga mata dalam aksi di Stadium Majlis Pembandaran Selayang.

"Selepas kerap dibolosi dalam perlawanan-perlawanan sebelum ini, Selangor menekankan tumpuan kepada aspek pertahanan.

"Ia amat berkesan dalam dua perlawanan terakhir apabila kami tidak dibolosi (menang 1-0 ke atas Pulau Pinang dan seri 0-0 dengan PDRM).

"Namun bahagian serangan kurang menyertainya. Kegagalan mencipta gol akan memberi masalah kerana tanpa gol sukar untuk meraih kemenangan.

"Misi esok adalah menang atau bakal berdepan kesukaran untuk ke peringkat seterusnya," kata Zainal.

Red Giants kini menghuni tangga ketiga dengan tujuh mata hasil dua kemenangan, satu seri serta satu kekalahan.

Dalam pertemuan pertama dengan Ceres di Bacolod pada 23 Februari lalu, kedua-dua pasukan seri 2-2.

Sementara itu, jurulatih

Ceres, Frank Muescan berkata, biarpun menghormati Selangor, namun dia optimis mampu mengejutkan tuan rumah.

"Saingan Kumpulan E sangat sengit dan kami hanya dipisahkan dengan satu mata di depan Selangor serta Tampines (Singapura), jadi kami perlu menang esok."

DAP, PKR gagal sepakat

SHAH ALAM – Janji tinggal janji. Walaupun mengadakan rundingan untuk tidak bertanding di kawasan sama dalam Pilihan Raya Negeri (PRN) Sarawak kali ini, dua parti dari Pakatan Harapan iaitu PKR dan DAP akhirnya gagal mencapai kata sepakat.

Perjanjian antara Timbalan Presiden PKR Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali dan Setiausaha Agung DAP Lim Guan Eng yang ditandatangani pada 7 April lalu diabai begitu sahaja apabila kedua-dua parti menamakan calon masing-masing di enam kerusi, semalam.

Enam kawasan itu ialah Batu Kitang, Mulu, Murum, Simanggang, Ngemah dan Mampong.

Paling menarik perhatian tentunya pertembungan di Batu Kitang yang merupakan kerusi 'balas dendam' oleh DAP apabila PKR memungkiri janji untuk tidak bertanding di lima kerusi lain.

Kerusi bagi Dun berkenaan bakal menyaksikan pertembungan lima penjuru membabit-



kan calon BN, PKR, DAP dan dua calon bebas.

Walau pada awalnya Abdul Aziz Isa dikatakan akan bertanding di kerusi majoriti penduduk Melayu, Stakan namun selaku calon tunggal Melayu parti DAP, beliau dinamakan untuk menentang sekutunya dari PKR, Voon Shiak Ni.

BN pula mempertaruhkan Lo Khere Chiang (SUPP) sebagai calon manakala dua lagi calon bebas ialah bekas pegawai di Jabatan Tanah dan Ukur, Sulaiman Kadir dan seorang ahli perniagaan, Datuk Seri Othman Bojeng.

Pengerusi DAP Sarawak, Chong Chieng Jen berkata, menurut kaji selidik berbayar

yang dijalankan oleh Merdeka Center terhadap enam kerusi, DAP menerima penilaian yang lebih baik daripada PKR.

Dalam hasil kajian yang ditunjukkan kepada pemberita, DAP memperoleh rating 60 peratus menggalakkan di Batu Kitang berbanding PKR sebanyak lapan peratus namun kata Chieng Jen, PKR tidak mempedulikan kaji selidik itu.

"(Pengerusi PKR Sarawak) Baru Bian secara terbuka berkata beliau akan guna veto berkenaan perjanjian antara dua pihak. Dia tidak akan mengiktirafnya dan menyebut bahawa Azmin tidak mempunyai kuasa bagi parti di negeri ini."

"Dia berkata terdapat

pertindihan kerusi. Adakah petunjuk ini cukup bahawa dia akan melanggar perjanjian di antara Azmin dan Guan Eng. Bukankah sudah ada bukti mencukupi?" soalnya.

Ketika diminta mengulas jika Bian ditekan oleh pemimpin akar umbi PKR, Chieng Jen berkata, beliau tidak tahu keadaan politik dalam PKR tetapi katanya mereka adalah 'orang-orang yang membakar jambatan'.

Sementara itu, Bian dalam satu kenyataan semalam berkata, keputusan PKR menamakan calon dibuat secara kolektif di antara pimpinan negeri dan pusat.

Katanya, Pakatan Harapan telah melalui proses perbincangan bagi 95 peratus jumlah kerusi yang ditandingi, tetapi hanya lima peratus kerusi yang tidak dapat dicapai kata putus.

"Ini merupakan satu pencapaian yang baik memandangkan proses perbincangan bukanlah mudah. Malah ruang untuk berbincang dengan DAP tetap terbuka hingga hari terakhir sebelum penamaan calon," katanya.

Buntu cari duit rawatan anak

Anak hidap kanser, perlu RM30,000 jalani internal dosimetry 12 Mei ini

JERAM – Hati ibu mana tidak luluh melihat anak sulung menganggung kanser tiroid sejak kecil sehingga terpaksa dibedah tiga kali dan perlu menerima rawatan susulan berikutan sudah merebak ke paru-paru.

Salina Samington, 44, yang hanya menjual kuih sejuk bekut itu sebak mengenangkan nasib anak sulung dari empat beradik itu yang terpaksa berulang alik ke Hospital Besar Kuala Lumpur dan Institusi Kanser Negara (IKN) Putrajaya setiap bulan.

Menurutnya, walau pun sakit, namun anaknya, Mohd Khairul Halim, 19, masih 'kuat' menyambung pembelajaran dalam bidang kemahiran automatik di Yayasan Basmi Kemiskinan (YBK) Kuala Selangor untuk semester ketiga.

"Akak mula kesan anak Bengkak dekat leher masa umur empat tahun dan pernah rujuk dekat klinik tapi dimaklumkan tiada apa-apa se-

bab anak tak mengadu sakit yang teruk.

"Tapi bila tengok Bengkak makin lama makin besar dengan keadaannya selalu demam dan muntah-muntah, akak terus rujuk ke Hospital Tanjong Karang sebelum dipindahkan

ke Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah (HTAR) Klang.

"Masa tu baru tau anak disahkan kanser tiroid... memang terkejut sangat bila doktor cakap macam tu dan masa darjah dua, pertama kali anak kena bedah. Rawatan dari Klang kena pindah ke Hospital Besar Kuala Lumpur dan IKN (Institut Kanser Negara) Putrajaya," katanya.

Disebabkan kekangan kewangan, Salina bersama anaknya terpaksa menaiki bas se-

awal jam 5.30 pagi dari Kuala Selangor untuk ke Kuala Lumpur dan Putrajaya setiap kali rawatan susulan.

"Duit banyak habis untuk kos ulang alik dan kos perubat-


an lain... wang simpanan pun sudah susut dengan dua anak masih sekolah lagi," katanya.

Salina berkata, 12 Mei ini anaknya perlu menjalani rawatan susulan 'internal dosimetry' dengan kos yang dianggarkan lebih kurang RM30,000 berikutan kanser sudah merebak.

"Suami pun hanya kerja nelayan dan ikut nasib sebab kadang-kadang dapat ikan dan kadang-kadang pulang tangan kosong.

"Memang Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) ada bantu tapi wang simpanan tak mencukupi nak tanggung kos pergi balik dan rawatan susulan akan datang," katanya sebak.

Orang ramai yang ingin membantu keluarga ini boleh menyalurkan dana bantuan terus ke akaun Agrobank 2007291000105842 atau Bank Islam 12083020302420 atas nama Salina Samington.

Menurutnya, ia bagi memastikan bekalan air sentiasa cukup untuk seluruh penduduk Selangor.

"Kami juga ambil langkah proaktif termasuk pemberian awan yang dijalankan sejak beberapa bulan lepas. Jika ada keperluan, kami akan tambah penerbangan untuk pemberian awan," katanya selepas menyertai Program Terjah dan Musnah Aedes di Seksyen 28, di sini, semalam.

Sementara itu dalam satu majlis di Bangi, kelmarin, Azmin kesal dengan tindakan rakyat yang sewenang-wenangnya membasuh kereta dan menyiram pokok menggunakan bekalan air bersih.

Menurutnya, aktiviti itu sepatutnya menggunakan takungan air hujan yang disimpan.

"Penduduk kena ingat, kos rawat air cukup besar sebab itu kami ambil langkah pro aktif minta rakyat berjimat cermat dalam penggunaan air bersih," katanya.

"Tapi saya dapati ramai yang guna air bersih sewenang-wenangnya untuk aktiviti yang sebenarnya boleh gunakan sumber air lain," katanya.

57 pemilik papan iklan terima padah

MPSJ roboh iklan haram di lebuh raya, kos perobohan bakal ditanggung pemilik

SERDANG - Kedegilan 57 pemilik yang tidak mengendahkan notis dikeluarkan Majlis Perbandaran Subang Jaya (MPSJ) sebelum ini, menyebabkan struktur iklan didirikan mereka di sepanjang Lebuh raya Kuala Lumpur-Seremban, dirobohkan pihak berkuasa tempatan itu, semalam.

Pengarah Jabatan Perlesenan MPSJ, Azfarizal Abdul Rashid berkata, hasil pemantauan pihaknya mendapat terdapat 39 papan iklan dan 18 struktur iklan jenis 'unipole' didirikan secara haram di sepanjang lebuh raya berkenaan.

Menurutnya, pemilik iklan sudah diberi notis dan dikenakan kompaun sebelum ini, namun masing-masing tidak mematuhi arahan supaya iklan itu diturunkan.

Azfarizal berkata, pihaknya mengambil tindakan perobohan iklan terbabit di ba-

wah Undang-undang Kecil Iklan MPSJ 2007.

"Setiap iklan perlu dilesenkan, kami dapati sebanyak 57 iklan yang didirikan di sepanjang lebuh raya di sini, tidak mempunyai kebenaran daripada pihak majlis.

"Hari ini (semalam) pihak majlis menerusi kontraktor dilantik mengambil tindakan merobohkan 18 papan iklan gergasi, baki selebihnya akan dilakukan secara berperingkat," katanya kos perobohan akan ditanggung pemilik iklan.

Beliau berkata, papan iklan haram didirikan tidak mempunyai kelulusan dari aspek penempatan, struktur dan visual menyebabkan timbulnya keraguan terhadap keselamatan struktur.

Katanya, visual yang dipaparkan kepada orang ramai juga tidak mematuhi piawaian pihak MPSJ.

Azfarizal berkata, sejak awal tahun lalu, MPSJ mengeluarkan 185 kompaun dan 65 notis amaran.

Menurutnya, sebanyak tujuh papan iklan dirobohkan, manakala empat iklan diturunkan sehingga April lalu.

Katanya lagi, sebanyak 920 kompaun dan 327 notis amaran dikeluarkan sepanjang tahun 2015.

Dalam tempoh itu, beliau berkata, MPSJ melaksanakan tindakan perobohan terhadap 73 papan iklan dan turut menurunkan 20 unit iklan.

"Kawasan MPSJ terutama lokasi strategik bersebelahan lebuh raya ada nilai ekonomi yang tinggi bagi pemilik iklan. Ia menyebabkan ada antara mereka sanggup memasang iklan tanpa kebenaran," katanya.

Beliau berkata, sekiranya pemilik tidak dapat dienal pasti, kompaun akan dikenakan terhadap syarikat pengiklan.

Masih belum cergas

Kedua-dua individu ini berasas masing-masing, seorang kepunyaan memiliki rumah flat yang dibida menerusi lelongan sejak 2006, manakala seorang lagi berjuang untuk mempertahankan hak milik rumah kedainya selepas dibuka untuk lelongan pada hujung Januari lalu.

Kes mereka bukan kes yang terpencil, malah ribuan lagi rakyat Malaysia turut berdepan masalah sama berikutnya tiada akta atau undang-undang khusus yang jelas di peringkat Persekutuan untuk mengawal selia aktiviti pelelongan terutama membabitkan harta tanah pembeli rumah strata antara 1970 hingga 2015.

Bagi pemilik rumah yang berdepan dengan masalah kewangan, mereka berde-

pan risiko kediaman mereka dilelong dalam jangka masa singkat jika gagal menjelaskan tunggakan pinjaman tanpa melalui mahkamah atau Pejabat Tanah dan Galian (PTG).

Ini kerana jaminan harta tanah yang belum mendapat

pat hak milik strata atau geran adalah bergantung kepada Loan Agreement cum Assignment (LACA) iaitu berdasarkan satu kes mahkamah pada 2001 yang melihat sewa beli strata sebagai perjanjian perniagaan.

Mengikut LACA, kemungkinan pembayaran dalam tempoh maksimum tiga bulan membolehkan institusi kewangan melelongan kediaman berkenaan menyebabkan pembeli yang gagal menjelaskan tunggakan tidak mempunyai peluang 'bernafas'.

Lebih merumitkan lagi keadaan, lesen lelong dieluarkan secara individu oleh negeri dengan bersandarkan undang-undang yang wujud sejak zaman sebelum kemerdekaan tanpa sebarang pindaan dibuat.

Kerajaan negeri tidak boleh memindahkan undang-undang itu mengikut peredaran zaman berikutan aktiviti lelong disenaraikan di bawah Perkara Perlembagaan Persekutuan sekali gus menyebabkan mereka terpaksa mengikuti apa saja yang sudah ditetapkan peraturan lapuk itu.

Antaranya ialah Kelantan mempunyai Enakmen Jualan Lelong 1930, Selangor, Negeri Sembilan dan彭亨 (Peraturan Jualan Lelong 1926) manakala Pulau Pinang dan Melaka (Ordon Lesen Pelelong 1906).

Kalau ditakdirkan saya terpaksa hidup merempat, saya reda. Tapi saya tidak sanggup lihat anak berkongsi nasib sama," luah bapa kepada enam anak, Roslan Abdul Lama, 37, yang kini terdesak mendapatkan rumahnya semula selepas dilelong Januari lalu.

Dia yang bekerja sebagai buruh kasar di Damansara terkejut apabila menerima surat pemberitahuan daripada pihak bank bahawa bayaran rumahnya tertunggak selama empat bulan.

Perkara itu menyebabkan rumah kedai yang dibeli di Seri Kembangan tujuh tahun lalu dibuka untuk lelongan.

"Saya menyerahkan semua urusan pembayaran rumah setiap bulan kepada isteri kerana dia memegang gaji saya sejak berkahwin."

"Saya hanya ambil

wang belanja kira-kira RM100 ke RM200 dan selebihnya digunakan untuk bayaran rumah, bil dan keperluan anak berusia antara dua hingga 12 tahun," katanya ketika ditemui, di sini, baru-baru ini.

Menurutnya, dia perlu membayar sebanyak RM450 setiap bulan kepada bank dan harga rumah berkenaan bernilai RM70,000, namun dia tidak dimaklumkan oleh isteri mengenai kenáikan faedah sehingga menyebabkan terdapat tunggakan.

"Saya sibuk bekerja bermula

awal pagi sehingga lewat malam. Jadi segala urusan surat menyurat antara pihak bank dan saya semuanya diuruskan isteri.

"Memang saya akui, tiada masa untuk saya bertanyakan mengenai urusan pembayaran rumah dan lain-lain, namun saya percayakan isteri uruskan semua itu kerana dia berada di rumah sepanjang masa," katanya berasal dari Kunak, Sabah.

Lebih memburukkan keadaan, isteri Roslan sudah pun pulang ke kampung halaman di Sabah atas alasan kesihatan dan segala urusan mengenai rumah ditanggung dia bersendirian.

Katanya, jumlah bayaran tunggakan selama empat bulan mencecah RM4,000 dan tiada peluang kedua baginya untuk memiliki rumah pertamanya itu semula memandangkan sudah ada pembeli.

"Sekarang ini, saya fobia mendengar bunyi orang ketuk pintu kerana bimbang kami anak beranak akan dihalau pada bila-bila masa dan saya

tiada tempat berlindung lain.

"Kos untuk pulang ke kampung pula memakan belanja tinggi dan sukar untuk mendapatkan pekerjaan tetap dalam masa singkat," katanya yang berpendapatan RM2,400 sebulan.

Lebih malang, Roslan sudah pun membelanjakan RM2,000 untuk upah peguam bagi mendapatkan semula rumahnya itu, namun tiada sebarang tindakan atau berita baik.

"Peguam yang saya upah tidak memaklumkan apa pun mengenai usaha mendapatkan rumah semula, malah panggilan saya tidak dijawab sehingga kini.

"Saya mengeluarkan simpanan untuk membayar upah peguam dan tidak sangka macam ini pula yang terjadi. Saya tidak tidur malam memikirkan masalah ini," katanya.

Roslan berharap ada pihak yang sudi membantunya untuk menyelesaikan masalah ini biarpun terpaksa menghabiskan semua wang simpanannya untuk membayar wang tunggakan.

Saya fikir membeli rumah lelong se-nang tetapi sebaliknya. Sampai sekarang belum selesai," kata Zul, 38, seorang kakitangan swasta yang masih gagal memiliki sebuah rumah flat dibida menerusi lelongan sejak se-dekad lalu.

Menurutnya, dia bukan sa-ja gagal memiliki kediaman itu di ibu kota malah keru-gian hampir RM10,000.

Katanya, dia tertarik untuk membida sebuah flat yang dilelong pada harga RM40,000 dengan deposit perlu disediakan sebanyak li-ma peratus.

"Ketika itu saya baru dua tahun bekerja dan memang merancang memiliki rumah sendiri kerana merasakan kewangan kukuh.

"Saya terbaca iklan me-nenai rumah lelong pada harga RM40,000. Keinginan memiliki kediaman itu membuka-bukaan dan yakin menang bidaan," katanya.

Zul berkata, dia terus menghubungi ejen lelong dan tidak menyangka bidaan yang dilakukan di Pusat Da-gangan Putra Dunia (PWTC) menyebelahi dia.

Menurutnya, perasaan se-lepas menang bidaan tidak dapat digambarkan kerana hasrat memiliki kediaman sendiri semakin menjadi ke-nyataan.

"Tanpa berlengah saya me-lantik peguam untuk me-

nguruskan proses pertukaran nama.

"Bayaran lima peratus saya keluarkan daripada Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) bagi pembelian ru-mah pertama," katanya.

Zul berkata, beberapa hari kemudian, dia tergerak me-lihat rumah yang dibeli na-mun terkejut apabila mendapati kediaman masih ber-peñghuni.

"Pemilik rumah terkejut ketika kunjungan saya kera-na dia tidak menerima se-barang notis berkaitan rumah mereka dilelong. Mereka berkeras tidak mahu keluar dari rumah itu," katanya.

Katanya, beberapa kali juga pertemuan diadakan bersa-ma pemilik lama, namun mereka berdegil dan tidak mahu keluar dari rumah itu.

"Peguam tidak dapat ber-buat apa-apa, manakala pi-hak institusi kewangan pula seperti lepas tangan kerana tiada sebarang dokumen atau pengesahan dikeluarkan me-nyatakan rumah itu sudah menjadi hak saya.

"Jadi saya tidak dapat membuat laporan polis. Saya terpaksa menerima hakikat impian untuk memiliki ke-diaman sendiri terkubur," katanya.

Katanya, disebabkan ku-rang pengetahuan berhubung proses lelongan rumah, dia terpaksa lepas tangan dan menanggung kerugian.

"Saya nasihatkan orang ra-mai supaya siasat dulu ru-mah yang dilelong sebelum membida," katanya.

Mega facelift

The mixed development in Damansara Uptown will include a shopping centre, residences, office tower and a multi-storey carpark

TWO things often come to mind when Petaling Jaya's Damansara Uptown is mentioned – traffic congestion and unavailability of parking space.

It is understandable, however, why this commercial square in SS21 has been attracting big traffic volumes that are ever-increasing especially over the past decade.

This is thanks to the 13 banks in the hub, along with more than 100 eateries strategically located here.

Not forgetting the working population there, which has been estimated to be about 25,000 people occupying 232,000sq m of office space within the square.

What It Was

Thirty years ago, high-rise buildings and traffic crawls did not exist in Damansara Uptown.

Instead, it was filled with street hawkers and bicycle shops. It was also a popular watering hole for residents in the Klang Valley.

Nearby resident Datuk Thong Weng Hon reminisced, "I remember one of the early outlets here was a comic shop, it was very popular among students and I remember visiting it very frequently."

Thong, who grew up in SS20, said there were fewer vehicles in the area those days, not much landscaping and the area was also fairly dirty.

But it was safer back then, he said, and he would cycle to school in Damansara Jaya, cutting through Damansara Uptown.

"Those days the place was filled

with Chinese coffeeshops and hawkers that lined the street from the police station up to the end of the road.

"I remember the place was dirtier back then because of all these hawker stalls on the road and there were no proper shops unlike now," said Thong, who is in his 40s.

Thong, who has a law firm in Damansara Uptown now, is happy with how the area has grown and welcomes the new changes and developments.

Apart from bicycle shops and coffeeshops, another establishment that has become a landmark in Damansara Uptown is The Ship restaurant.

Having been there for as long as surrounding residents and regular visitors can remember, this restaurant which serves western cuisine is still enjoying good business.

"Though we have had some turbulence along the way over the years, we are now sailing smoothly" said restaurant manager Tammy Ma.

"We do see a lot of loyal customers and our concept is different from other restaurants around here, so I believe that is why we are still doing well," she said, adding that she had seen shops opened and closed within a short period of time in the years that she had been working there.

When asked if business was affected because of competition from new restaurants, Ma said it slowed down a little recently due to the poor economy but there was still a good crowd during weekends.

Damansara Utama Residents and Owners Association (Duroa) president Rajes Patel remembers the place to be dotted with pubs and car workshops.

"Back then the centre of attraction




said.

She, however, lamented that traffic got a lot heavier over the years but held out hope that it would get better once the parking bays in the new developments opened up.

"There were not many banks then. The bigger banks only came in later," he said, adding that he used to be able to get RM3 cendol here but not anymore.

Jane Wong, who used to study in this commercial square and later got a job there, said she would prefer the area to remain the way she remembered it as some eight years back.

She used to spend a lot of time in Damansara Uptown in the late 1990s when she studied at a college in this location. She later worked in an advertising agency based in the Uptown 5 building.

"I will always remember the very affordable and tasty *nasi lemak* and *chee cheong fun* there.

"But I try to avoid that area nowadays unless I have no choice, because when I hear the name Uptown, I think about how difficult it is to find parking.

"There is certainly a lot more development taking place now and a lot more traffic, making it constantly congested," she said.

The face of Damansara Uptown has evolved and transformed over the past three decades.

Apart from traffic, there was a time when crime rates in the area increased, along with development. "Crime has been an issue here in the past five years but the situation has improved a lot recently, largely thanks to the efforts of the developer See Hoy Chan Sdn Bhd," said

Yong Yit Ling, who works as a service delivery manager at a company in the square.

Now, apart from the police kiosks and installation of closed-circuit television cameras, auxiliary policemen can be seen patrolling the area.

"I am also glad they have painted the buildings and are doing some beautifying works around this commercial area," she

Poor response to Klang's free buses

Royal town's residents urge state govt to review route

IT HAS been nine months since the free bus service was introduced by the Selangor government in Klang but response has not been encouraging.

Only a handful of passengers are seen taking the Selangor Smart Bus on its 3km loop around the royal town.

Two red and yellow buses are being used to provide the service from 6am to 10pm.

It starts from Jalan Batu Tiga Lama near Wisma Hafiz and goes past Jambatan Musaeddin en route to Klang South.

The buses stop at the Komuter Station, Klang Magistrate's Court, SMK Sri Istana at Jalan Istana, SK and SMK Convent on Jalan Tengku Kelana, the Indian Muslim Mosque, Syabas and the Klang Municipal Council (MPK) office at Jalan Perbandaran.

It also stops at the Tabung Haji building, Goldcourse Hotel SJK (C) Pin Hua and Jalan Sireh.

Mohd Yusoff Ramlil, 61, who has taken the bus occasionally, blamed the poor response on the unsuitable route.

"It is a shame that not many people are benefitting from it," he said.

Klang resident Tony Chua, 55, said the buses were not meeting the needs of commuters.

"It plies such a short route that people think it is faster to walk to their destinations."

"The buses are supposed to have a 15-minute frequency," he said.

Klang Consumer Association president A. Devadass said the buses were not serving the needy and old folk.

He urged the state government to review the route so that residents would truly benefit from the service.

"There is no point wasting public funds if the service is not being fully utilised," he said, pointing out the buses did not go to hospitals and government clinics.

He said the residents wanted the Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital, Poliklinik Bandar Botanic and

Poliklinik Taman Rashnah to be included in the route.

"It has been nine months since the free service was introduced and the number of people commuting on the buses is not encouraging," he said.

The Selangor Smart Bus, formerly known as Selangorku Bus, began in Petaling Jaya in 2014 and has been expanded to Shah Alam and Subang Jaya.

State Public Transportation Committee chairman Datuk Teng Chang Khim said the free service was introduced to ease the burden of residents and reduce traffic congestion.



Most of the time, the free buses travel the 3km loop with no passengers.

Plans to upgrade Section 13

One-day workshop gathers feedback from stakeholders and residents

SECTION 13 has never had a set of urban design guidelines despite being designated a "special area" in the Petaling Jaya Local Plan.

The Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) organised a one-day workshop to gather feedback from stakeholders and residents to address this.

"One of the challenges for urban design is to create 'people space' from public spaces.

"This needs the creation of places such as public parks, urban sculptures and public transport," said Petaling Jaya mayor Mohd Azizi Mohd Zain at the workshop.

He said they wanted to solicit views and preliminary suggestions to make Section 13 more vibrant and safe.

Section 13, which began as an industrial zone, was designated a Special Area Plan

in 2010.

Bukit Gasing assemblyman Rajiv Rishyakaran said the design guidelines currently were very basic and could result in disjointed pedestrian connectivity.

Section 13 city councillor Lee Suet Sen said the main issues included asking landowners to surrender some land for infrastructure and pedestrian connections.

"We have to work out the connectivity from Section 13 all the way to Section 52, which means from the Asia Jaya LRT station to PJ Hilton," said Lee.

Otherwise, the council might have to go through land acquisition, which could push back the guidelines' publication and outlining of public spaces.

The discussion was moderated by urban planning consultancy IZM Consult's principal Ihsan Zainal Mokhtar.

For people working in Section 13 such as Lee Choo, who was representing her company at the workshop, seeking stakeholders' views was a good step.

"The main problem is traffic and connectivity," said Lee.

Currently, only 20% of Section 13 has been redesignated commercial, with the remainder still having industrial status.

"However, industrial activity there is so minimal it is almost non-existent, hence the need to redevelop," said MBPJ Urban Planning Development director Sharifah Marhaini Syed Ali.

Selangor must beat Ceres to progress in AFC Cup

KUALA LUMPUR: It's do or die for Selangor when they take on Ceres in their penultimate AFC Cup Group E match at the Selayang Municipal Council Stadium tonight.

The Red Giants are third in the group with seven points. Singapore's Tampines Rovers, also on seven points, are second but with a better head-to-head record. Ceres of the Philippines lead with eight while Dhanmondi of Bangladesh are pointless.

After Ceres, Selangor will play Tampines in their last-group fixture at the Singapore National Stadium on May 10.

The Red Giants desperately need a win tonight to keep their last-16 hopes alive and coach Zainal Abidin Hassan has demanded his foreign stars - Liberian striker Patrick Wleh, Argentine midfielder Mauro Olivi and Indonesian winger Andik Vermansyah - to deliver a win.

"Our attacking players are not performing up to the mark yet. We need to play consistently throughout the 90 minutes," said Zainal.

In their first meeting on Feb 23, Selangor held Ceres to a 2-2 draw at Bacolod City.

Striker Adrian Gallardo, who has scored five goals in four matches, is Ceres' danger-man and Selangor need to find a way to shackle the Spaniard.

Selangor, the record 33-time Malaysia Cup winners, will be without winger R. Gopinathan and defender Razman Roslan. Both are injured while midfielder Hafiz Kamal is out through suspension.

Zainal also warned his players to keep their temper in check.

Last week, Selangor were held to a 0-0 draw by Police in the Super League after midfielder Nazmi Faiz Mansor was red carded for elbowing Police's Andrezinho.

"A red card always puts a team in a difficult position."

"The players should know better. I don't want this to happen again," said Zainal.

Pakatan left in disarray

Clashes over six seats spell trouble for the Opposition

KUCHING: The clash between DAP and PKR in six seats spells trouble for the Pakatan Harapan alliance.

Their first outing as an Opposition team in the Sarawak election started off in a rocky manner when both parties failed to honour a deal over seat allocations agreed upon by their national leaders.

When PKR decided to contest in the five disputed seats, DAP retaliated by fielding a last-minute candidate to spoil its ally's chances in Batu Kitang.

Under the agreement signed some two weeks ago by PKR deputy president Datuk Seri Azmin Ali and DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng, the Chinese-majority seat of Batu Kitang would be given to PKR on condition that DAP be given the all clear to field its picks in five seats

- Mulu, Murum, Simanggang, Mampong and Ngemah.

Leaders of both parties spent the entire morning after nomination blaming one another for renegeing on their promise, with DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang describing the clashes as regrettable.

"In 50 years of politics, very few elections have made me this sad."

"But what is the challenge now? It's the May 7 polls," he said, adding that the public could express their disappointment with the Opposition via the ballot box.

Defending PKR's move, Azmin said the written agreement with DAP was never conclusive, adding that both parties were still in negotiations until the very end on the overlapping claims.

Sarawak PKR chief Baru Bian



maintained that the party respected the negotiation process with its allies, and only handed over letters of appointment to its 35 candidates three days before nomination.

"In fact, our window for negotiations with DAP was open until the day before nomination day, and we put forward the proposals to resolve our disputes."

"Unfortunately, we had not heard anything from DAP until midnight

(on Sunday)," he said.

The Opposition's aim to deny Barisan Nasional a two-third majority has suffered a setback following the squabble, which one analyst felt had filtered down to the people.

Prof Andrew Aeria of Universiti Malaysia Sarawak said the clashes in the six constituencies reflected poor leadership on both sides.

"The seat allocations should have been decided a year ago. The fact that they left it so late and then had these overlapping claims tells you that there is very weak leadership," he said.

Aeria said the "bad blood" between the state's PKR and DAP chapters could even spill over onto the national stage, depending on how its leaders in the peninsula deal with the issue post-May 7 polls.

DAP MP fires 'rocket' at PKR

PETALING JAYA: DAP's Tanjong MP Ng Wei Aik has fired a "rocket" at its partner over the allocation of seats in the Sarawak elections.

"Ask PKR to go to hell," Ng wrote on a Facebook post which carried a report quoting PKR deputy president Datuk Seri Azmin Ali.

Additionally, DAP's Batu Kitang candidate Abdul Aziz has said that PKR breached an agreement on seat allocation.

Azmin: DAP-PKR contest in disputed seats unfortunate

SHAH ALAM: It is truly unfortunate that both the DAP and PKR have not been able to resolve the dispute over several seats in the Sarawak elections, said PKR deputy president Datuk Seri Azmin Ali.

He had discussed the matter with DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng over the phone until late Sunday night while PKR vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar, who is Sarawak polls director, also had a similar discussion with DAP national publicity secretary Tony Pua.

He said he had authorised state PKR chief Baru Bian to sign the appointment letters for candidates contesting for the disputed seats, adding that Baru had only signed letters for the disputed seats while the appointment letters for all the other seats were signed by Dr Wan Azizah.

The seats contested by both DAP and PKR are Batu Kitang, Mulu,

Murum, Simanggang, Ngemah and Mambong.

When contacted, a Selangor PKR elected representative close to the party leadership confirmed that Dr Wan Azizah had put Azmin in charge of the Sarawak polls.

The elected representative, who declined to be named, also showed *The Star* a copy of an e-mail in which Wan Azizah instructs Azmin to do the necessary in Sarawak.

The party president also mentions the Mulu, Murum Mambong

constituencies with further instructions to take care of PKR's interests and that of the other Pakatan Harapan partners.

"We have no choice but to also contest in Mulu, Murum and Mambong as these are our seats.

Sitec received more than 70 entries for the competition, with 60 shortlisted to compete for the top prizes.

"We wish to set quality standards and increase competency," said Teng.

"We also want to reward good performance by industry players. This event celebrates that ideal as we are here to witness the success of homegrown Malaysian companies."

Taman Bukit Rawang residents want bus service to resume

THERE has been no bus service in Taman Bukit Rawang Jaya and its surrounding areas for over a year. Residents want the service restored.

Commuters say they have to fork out between RM8 and RM12 per trip by taxi if they wanted to get from Bukit Rawang Jaya to Rawang town or Taman Gasing Utama.

Mohanadass Velasamy, 58, who has been living in Taman Bukit Rawang Jaya for the last 20 years, said the bus service had stopped for more than a year.

About 3,000 people staying in Taman Bukit Rawang Jaya, Taman Bukit Rawang Jaya 2, Taman Rawang Perdana 1 and Taman Rawang Perdana 2 are affected when they stopped the bus service.

"At least about 200 people use the bus service here daily to get from the township to the Rawang town that is about 3km away."

"Some of the pupils are now forced to walk from Jalan Rawang to SK Bukit Rawang Jaya since the bus service was terminated last year. I have to send my grandchildren to school by car," said

Mohanadass, who operates a workshop in the area.

Govindarajoo Alagar, 73, a retiree, who works part-time in a restaurant, said that he had to walk about 2km daily from his home in Taman Bukit Rawang Jaya to the main road to get to his workplace.

"The weather now is very hot and it is difficult to walk so far. I do not have a driver's licence so I don't drive."

"Sometimes, I would take a taxi and it would cost me about RM10 each trip from my house to the town. There are also 'illegal' taxis that charge up to RM15 per trip to town."

"I earn about RM30 daily working at the restaurant and it is not enough to make ends meet if I have to use taxi daily to get to my workplace."

"I go to the government clinic in Rawang twice a month to get my medicine for diabetes. I hope the authorities will act quickly to reintroduce the bus service to this area," he said.

Umadevi Ghandi, 40, a single mother who has been living in Taman Rawang Perdana for eight years, said the lack of bus service from her area made it difficult to

send her two children to school.

"I sell nasi lemak in Kuala Gasing. I need to use public transport about four to five times daily and it costs me RM8 to RM10 to take a taxi from my house to town."

"I have a driver's licence but I do not own a car and thus rely on public transport to get to town," she said.

Selayang MCA Youth chief Chan Wun Hoong said he would organise a dialogue with the previous bus operator about resuming

the service.

"If the original bus operator is unable to service the route, the route should be offered to other operators to provide the service. Hopefully the problem can be resolved soon," he said.

Selayang MIC division chairman M.B. Raja said residents came to his office and complained about not having any bus service for a year.

"I will talk to bus operator and Land Public Transport Commission

(SPAD) to try and solve this matter as the residents there were suffering without public transport.

"Many commuters here are retired and from poor families. They depend heavily on public buses."

"The authorities must realise that when poor people are unable to go to the clinics to get their medicine due to the high transport charges," he said.

SPAD could not be reached for comment.

SEVERAL groups have submitted a joint memorandum to the state government against the degazettement of forests to make way for the Sungai Besi-Ulu Klang Expressway (Suke) project and Damansara Shah Alam Highway (DASH).

Representatives from Peka Malaysia, Sahabat Alam Malaysia (SAM), Malaysian Nature Society (MNS), Save Green Lungs, Say No To Suke (SNTS) and Say No To DASH (SNTD) gathered at the lobby of the Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah building in Shah Alam to present the memorandum to Sri Muda assemblyman Suhaimi Shafiei, who is also political secretary to Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azmin Ali.

Memorandum urges S'gor govt to stop degazettement of forests for highways

The memorandum, addressed to Azmin and Selangor Forestry Department director Mohd Puat Dahalan, stated that the degazettement of forest reserves should not be allowed as it went against the efforts of the Sultan of Selangor to promote environmental conservation.

It asked the state government for an immediate stop to any efforts to degazette forest reserves.

They said highways were not the first and only answer to traffic congestion in the state.

The forests that will be affected are Bukit Cherakah Forest Reserve

and the Sungai Buloh forest for the DASH project while the Bukit Sungai Puteh Forest may be degazetted for the Suke project.

Last week, the Save Green Lungs group submitted a petition containing 10,000 signatures to the state Forestry Department to protest the proposed degazettement of the Sungai Puteh Forest Reserve in Ampang to make way for Suke.

SNTS chairman Agos Hasan and SNTD spokesman K.W. Mak said they were disappointed the issue was not raised during the state assembly meeting.

"Why are our elected represent-

atives not talking about it?" Mak questioned.

Peka president Datuk Shariffa Sabrina Syed Akil said that they did not want any development that would destroy the environment.

SAM representative Azrul Faizal said the state government should preserve any forests left in Selangor.

MNS president Henry Goh said that people thought non-government organisations were against development.

"This is a misconception. We are not against it but we are calling for balance," he said.

Mada: Identify seafood exporters who used banned substance

THE MALAYSIA Aquaculture Development Association (Mada) wants the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to identify the Malaysian exporters whose shrimp and prawn were found to contain antibiotics residues so that action can be taken against the black sheep of the industry.

Mada president Khoo Heng Soon said shrimp and prawn, which are among Malaysia's seafood exports, are also favourite foods of many Malaysians.

If shrimp and prawn farmed in Malaysia contained nitrofurans and chloramphenicol as alleged, it would not only deal a blow to Malaysia's seafood exports but also cause Malaysians to shun these seafood as well, he said.

Khoo said this when asked by *China Press* to comment on reports by foreign media last week that the FDA had issued an import alert on shrimp and prawn from Peninsular Malaysia, saying some of them contained antibiotics unfit for human consumption.

Testing in 2015 found up to one-third of the Malaysian imports contained "residues of nitrofurans and chloramphenicol, which are banned in the US", reported UPI.

According to the report, the FDA also said it would detain any shipments of shrimp and prawn from Malaysia without inspection.

Khoo urged the Malaysian Fisheries Department to follow up on the issue and closely monitor the industry so that its development is not hampered by the action of a few errant operators.

He said Mada's 160 members had stopped using antibiotics to treat shrimp and prawn diseases ever since such drugs were banned by the ministry.

Any such practice is just "treating the symptoms and not the disease", he said.

He said instead the association had encouraged its members to improve the quality of water and environment of their prawn and shrimp farms to control disease.

'Don't rush into PTMP'

> Penang NGOs urge state govt to address issues first before signing transport master plan

BUTTERWORTH: A group of 15 Penang-based non-governmental organisations (NGOs) have urged the state government not to rush into signing the Penang Transport Master Plan (PTMP).

They said in a joint statement that transparency, accountability and genuine engagement with the public were needed before signing the agreement.

They said they supported the idea of a transport master plan and the need to prioritise public transport over the present private car-centred transport system, and they wished to commend the state government for the proactive move.

"However, there are very fundamental and critical issues that need to be addressed before the current proposals are accepted," it said.

The NGOs listed a total of nine issues which they said should be dealt with before

signing the agreement.

The main issue is whether the population projections warrant such a massive scheme at such tremendous costs.

As a government committed to "Competency, Accountability and Transparency (CAT)", there was a lack of clarity with regards to the financing of the entire scheme.

"What are the people of Penang being committed to? How will payment via reclamation work? Will SRS Consortium, which is the project delivery partner, implement roads first and public transport last? What happens if we run out of funds after the initial stages? Will the public be subjected to unaffordable fares, thereby making them return to their cars? No answers are provided in the PTMP," they said.

It was reported previously that the massive sea reclamation would start as early as 2018 under the PTMP.

The reclamation is to fund infrastructure

under the PTMP which feature an undersea tunnel linking the island and the mainland of the state, highways, LRT, monorail as well as extensive bus connectivity on both the island and the mainland.

The 15 NGOs are Penang Forum, Penang Heritage Trust, Aliran, Sahabat Alam Malaysia, Consumers Association of Penang (CAP), Malaysian Nature Society, Citizens for Public Transport Coalition (Cepat), Friends of Botanical Garden, Pesticide Action Network Asia & Pacific, Tanjung Bunga Residents Association, Women Centre for Change, Suara Rakyat Malaysia (Suaram), PBTUSM Alumni Northern region, Mama Bersih and Ombak Arts Studio.

Meanwhile, state Local Government, Traffic Management and Flood Mitigation exco Chow Kon Yeow told *theSun* that he had read the joint statement and would take note of the issues raised.

"The state government will take note of the requests and SRS Consortium will also study the matter."

"We will come out and address the questions after we study this," he said.

BRIEFS

HAZY CONDITION IMPROVES WITH RAIN

PETALING JAYA: The haze seems to be improving with the rain and so are the water levels at the dams in Selangor and Penang. The Air Pollutant Index (API) reading on the Department of Environment's (DoE) website yesterday showed most areas around the country to be either good or moderate. Good indicates low pollution without any bad effect on health while moderate means moderate pollution that does not pose any health problems. Meanwhile the water levels in the dams in Selangor and Penang look positive as it is now above the danger mark.

MBJB ENFORCEMENT GETS MORE POWER

JOHOR BARU: Johor Baru City Council (MBJB)'s enforcement officers are now empowered to take action against errant businessmen, and hawkers under the Trade, Business and Industries (MBJB) by-law 2016. MBJB mayor A. Rahim Nin said they had to make the amendment to the MBJB by-law 2004 so that more power can be given to the enforcement officers, especially senior officers to close shops, confiscate goods and to handle errant traders.

"Before we had to apply for a court order. Effective this month, we can use the amended by-law," he said after attending a City Hall session with businessmen at Jotic here yesterday.

10 JOHOR NGOS GIVEN DIRECT GRANTS

ISKANDAR PUTERI: Some 10 non-governmental organisations (NGOs) in Johor were yesterday awarded direct grants amounting to RM170,000 from the Mentri Besar's Office for their club activities and social programmes. State Health and Environment executive committee chairman Datuk Ayub Rahmat said this at the cheque presentation ceremony held at the Kota Iskandar state administration centre here. "This is part of the RM2 million annual grant from the state," he said. "I expect the government will increase the amount this year," he added.

Study needed before declaring Bukit Merah disaster area

IPOH: A thorough study should be done before declaring Bukit Merah, about 90km from here, a disaster area following the receding water level in Tasik Bukit Merah Dam due to the El Nino phenomenon.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Shahidan Kassim said normally, a location would be declared a disaster zone if it was hit by a disaster like flood or large-scale fire.

When such a declaration is made, the affected residents have the right to receive aid such as compassionate payment, he said when contacted yesterday.

He added if the dwindling water level in a dam adversely affected farmers, the Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Ministry would have to study the situation

and take follow-up action.

He will visit the affected areas at Bukit Merah soon to see the situation.

He was asked to comment on Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Zamby Abd Kadir's statement on Sunday that the state government would apply to the federal government to declare Bukit Merah a disaster zone, and hoped the National Security Council could assist farmers in the Kerian area assess the losses incurred due to the depleting water level in the Bukit Merah Dam.

However, council secretary Datuk Seri Alias Ahmad said it was no longer the agency responsible for assessing damage or losses incurred by any party in a disaster and they should refer to the National Disaster Management Agency instead. – Bernama

'No tiger on the prowl in Setiu'

KUALA TERENGGANU: The Terengganu Department of Wildlife and National Parks yesterday dismissed as untrue a viral report on social media of a tiger on the prowl in the recreational forest in Setiu.

Its director, Mohd Hasdi Husin, said the department had not received any report.

"I hope the people will not be easily influenced by the viral report as it will only trigger panic," he said.

The report carried a photo of a tiger by a river, allegedly in Bukit Keling, Sungai Tong.

Mohd Hasdi said the tiger in the viral report was definitely not in Setiu. – Bernama

Forest fires and open burning adding to air pollution

PETALING JAYA: Several places in Selangor, Terengganu and Pahang have become contributors to the air pollution due to forest fires and open burning.

Most of the open burning were in illegal dumpsites and plantations, said Selangor Fire and Rescue Department deputy director-general (Operations) Datuk Soiman Jahid.

"There are three cases in Selangor, one is a forest reserve in Kuala Langat, Tanjung Sepat while the other is an illegal dumpsite in Jalan Kuari Bukit Kapar.

The third case is in Bukit Kemandul, which

is a plantation. These cases are man-made problems because they have been clearing the vegetation," he said.

Soiman said the department has been conducting operations round the clock to control the situation.

He said the department was working with other agencies and departments such as the Geoscience and Mineral Department, local councils, Malaysian Civil Defence Department, Rela and the various state forestry departments.

Thus far, Soiman said, the situation was under control, however, open burning has been ongoing at an illegal dumpsite in Jalan Kuari since April 18.

Soiman said that in Pahang, Ladang Felcra Serambi and Nenasi have also contributed to the air pollution with land clearing in these two plantation areas.

In Terengganu, there have been cases of peat fires in four areas, namely at Kampung Alor Tempoyak, Dungun; Kampung Chabang, Kerteh; Teluk Kalong in Kemaman and Kampung Durian Guling.

There was also a forest fire recorded in Jalan Mersing Endau, Johor.

According to Soiman the cloudy weather and cloud seeding efforts have been helpful for the operations.

"The rain will not completely douse the fire but it is helping our officers by prevent-

ing them from getting heat stroke," he added.

Soiman advised people to stop open burning, adding that the El Nino phenomenon would cause the fire to spread.

The air pollutant index (API) as of 5pm yesterday showed good and moderate readings nationwide.

Meteorological Department director-general Datuk Che Gayah Ismail said the department was expecting more afternoon rain and thunderstorms during the inter-monsoon season, which was expected to last at least until mid May.

She said cloud seeding was still being carried out, especially in the peninsular.

Terengganu palace confirms revoking MB's titles

KUALA LUMPUR: The Sultan of Terengganu, Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin, has stripped Menteri Besar Ahmad Razif Abd Rahman (pix) of all state titles bestowed on him effective April 22.

This was announced in a statement issued yesterday by the Comptroller of the Royal Household, Office of His Royal Highness the Sultan of Terengganu.

The statement reads: "After consultation with the Terengganu Royal Council, it is hereby announced that His Royal Highness

the Sultan has stripped Ahmad Razif bin Abd Rahman of all Terengganu awards bestowed on him effective Friday April 22, 2016.

"This declaration has no connection with other developments in Terengganu."

Ahmad Razif was bestowed the Darjah Dato' Paduka Mahkota Terengganu Kehormat (DPMT), which carries the title "Datuk", in 2012 and the



Seri Setia Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin (SSMZ), which carries the title "Datuk Seri", in April 2015.

Ahmad Razif, who is the state assemblyman for Seberang Takir, was sworn in as the menteri besar on May 12, 2014, to replace Datuk Seri Ahmad Said.

Meanwhile, in Lundu, Sarawak, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak said yesterday he

would have an audience with Sultan Mizan on the issue.

He also called on all quarters not to speculate on the matter, saying the state government administration was functioning normally.

"I am scheduled to have an audience with the Sultan of Terengganu soon. I will issue a statement after that," he told reporters after accompanying Sarawak Chief Minister Tan Sri Adenan Satem to submit his nomination papers for the upcoming Sarawak polls. — Bernama

Najib: Opposition incapable of governing

> They can't even resolve their squabble over seats, says Najib

LUNDU: The Opposition's failure to reach a consensus over seats in the nth Sarawak state election proves they are in disarray and incapable of forming a stable

government, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak.

He said the disunity within the Opposition also indicates that they cannot work



as a team due to a lack of understanding and tolerance.

Najib said Barisan Nasional's (BN) uncontested win in two seats, Bukit Sari and Bukit Kota, was proof there are weaknesses in the Opposition's strategy and approach towards the election.

"They have already suffered an early blow. The people are happy and confident with the current government because we are always united in our pursuit.

"Voters should shun the Opposition because the present government can ensure a bright and prosperous future for Sarawak through rapid development," he told reporters after accompanying Sarawak Chief Minister Tan Sri Adenan Satem who filed his nomination for the Tanjung Datu seat at the Lundu community hall yesterday.

It was the first time in the history of the Sarawak election that the prime minister, who is also BN chairman, had accompanied the Sarawak chief minister, who is state BN head, to the nomination centre.

Najib, who was accompanied by his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, told the Sarawak BN election machinery to power full steam ahead to ensure a splendid victory for Adenan's team.

"We also want to increase the popularity of Sarawak BN under the leadership of Adenan to

ensure fair representation for all races. This is important because we have a bigger agenda for Sarawak to maintain the peace and harmony enjoyed by the people," he said.

Najib said the bigger agenda will be carried out within the next five years.

"The federal government will continue to support, work closely with and provide funds to Sarawak for it to progress on par with the mainland," he said.

He added the success of BN in Sarawak will be very important for the coalition in setting the momentum towards the next general election.

Najib, who is also the finance minister, said among plans to boost Sarawak's economy over the next five years are mega projects like the Pan Borneo Highway, building roads in rural areas and providing broadband services to keep the people connected.

Meanwhile, in Kapit, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Zahid Hamidi also hit out at the Opposition's failure to resolve its squabble over seats, which he said indicated they were incapable of good governance.

Speaking to reporters after visiting the nomination centres of Baleh, Pelagus and Bukit Goram to give moral support to BN candidates, he said: "There is really no reason for Sarawakians to support them. They come and go. They cannot deliver and can only offer lip service, criticise and propagate the politics of hatred and anger against the government." — Bernama

in five seats could not be overlooked.

"The contests between PKR and DAP would create confusion among voters, as both parties are supposed to be fighting on the same side," he said.

In Shah Alam, PKR deputy president Datuk Seri Azmin Ali said it was very unfortunate that his party would be going head to head with DAP in six seats.

He said the central PKR and DAP leaders had agreed that the matter be decided by the respective state leaders as, until the nth hour, the dispute had not been resolved.

"End of the day, we have to respect their autonomy," Azmin said, insisting he had not gone beyond his authority in allowing Sarawak PKR chief Baru Bian to authorise contests in seats the DAP was contesting.

Besides, he added, the previous agreements signed with Lim to prevent clashes between PKR and DAP had not been "conclusive".

With the these latest developments, there will now be a five-cornered fight for the Batu Kitang seat, with DAP's Abdul Aziz Isa facing off with PKR's Boon Shiak Ni, Lo Khere Chiang (BN) and Independents Othman Bojeng and Sulaiman Kadir.

Four seats will see four-cornered fights.

Mulu, a new constituency, will see a fight between Paul Anyie Raja (DAP), Paul Baya (PKR), BN direct candidate Datuk Gerawat Gala, and Independent Roland Dom Mattu.

In Ngemah, Richard Lias (DAP) and Thomas Laja Besi (PKR) will take on BN incumbent Alexander Vincent and Independent Joseph Jawa Kendawang.

Leon Jimat Donald (DAP), Norina Umoi Utot (PKR), BN's Datuk Francis Harden and Independent Ngu Piew Seng will challenge each other for the Simanggang seat.

Murum will see Matthew Silek (DAP) challenging Abun Sui (PKR), Chukpai Ugon (BN) and Independent Stanley Ajang.

A three-cornered fight for the Mambong seat will see Willie Mongin (PKR), Sanjan Daik (DAP) and BN direct candidate Datuk Jerip Susil in a face-off.

Due to unhappiness over the issue of BN direct candidates, BN parties SUPP, UPP, Teras and SPDP have fielded Independent candidates in seats traditionally theirs.

In Batu Kawah, former UPP branch chairman Liu Thian Leong is standing as an Independent against SUPP president Datuk Sim Kui Hian.

In Dudong, Benny Lee (formerly of SUPP) joins the fight as an Independent against Datuk Tiong Thai King (BN direct).

Election Commission (EC) chairman Datuk Seri Mohd Hashim Abdullah said two nominations out of a total of 230 nomination papers received had been disqualified.

Speaking at the EC office in Kuching, he said the two nominations involved the PKR candidate in Pantai Damai and an Independent in Kuala Rejang.

Of the total 230, 82 were from BN, 40 PKR, 31 DAP, 13 Parti Amanah Negara, 11 Pas, 11 Star, five PBDSB and 35 Independents.

满足知识需求 蓝海管理图书馆

莎阿南25日讯 | 雪兰莪州务大臣拿督斯里阿兹敏阿里建议，雪兰莪公共图书馆（PPAS）应运用「蓝海策略」，作为管理图书馆的创新措施之一。

「其实这项策略并不只是限制于全球企业和工业市场，我们也可以在教育，知识和公共图书馆方面运用这项策略。」

「我们需要开创蓝海学习，并走出结构主义，以思考图书馆的作用，并采取综合及长期的措施，加强图书馆满足社会的期望。」

他说，这项计划重要且与州政府实现精明雪兰莪的目标一致，持续于培育知识渊博的人力资本，以满足知识和渐进的经济需求。

阿兹敏阿里表示，雪州公共图书馆应备有可触发思想和参考的书籍资源，以便州议员在立法议会时，可以提出实质性的辩论，这也是为了实现民主所必须采取的路径。

重塑品牌提升图书馆

阿兹敏阿里今日出席由雪州政府举办的「走，一起阅读10分钟」阅读活动时，如是指出。其他出席者包括阿兹敏阿里夫人拿汀斯里珊西达、雪兰莪伊斯兰教理事会主席拿督莫哈末阿兹、公共图书馆机构总监玛斯杜拉及理事会成员哈丽玛。

哈丽玛表示，活动已持续举办多年，以鼓励成人和孩童的阅

读；虽然活动仅以10分钟阅读时间开始，但希望人们可持续，将阅读成为一种习惯，再促成社会的阅读风气。

她说，公共图书馆在2008至2010年仅吸引41万8802人到访、从2011至2013年有155万0435人，2014至2015年则有151万931人。

「截至2015年，雪州公共图书馆成功以重塑品牌（Rebranding）的概念，提升及建设21所图书馆，届时将成为其他州属仿效和参考的例子。」

「根据美国公司在2007至2009年所作出的调查报告显示，有76%受访者已减少花钱购买书籍、光碟及DVD影片，而75%的受访者倾向于从图书馆租借书籍、光碟和DVD影片，并使用图书馆的电脑和免费无线上网宽频服务。」（407）

隆芙大道旁拆60非法广告牌

沙登25日讯 | 车水马龙的隆芙大道旁，竖立起近60个非法巨型广告建筑结构，梳邦再也市议会将逐一展开拆除行动！

隶属梳邦再也市议会管辖范围内的一条道路，被侦查到有57个非法广告牌建筑结构，包括39个普通广告牌以及18个单脚大型广告牌（Unipole）；市议会如今已委任承包商，沿路展开拆除工程。

这些非法广告牌的建筑结构，都是建设在主要大道旁，因广告牌没有依照条例进行申请，抵触2007年地方政府广告（梳邦再也市议会）条例。

梳邦再也市议会执照组主任阿兹法斯札指出，所有竖立在路旁的广告牌或广告牌建筑结构，都必须事前向地方政府提出申请，否则一律违法。

业者承担拆除费用

他说，市议会发现，车流量极高的隆芙大道，成了设置非法广告牌的热门地区，除了展开拆除行动外，市议会也会开出每个广告牌1000令吉的罚单，给涉及设置非法广告牌的广告业者，并由后者来承担所有的拆除费用。

他表示，但若市议会无法鉴定广告业者的身份，市议会就会转为对付广告牌上的商家。

「根据统计，2015年市议会全年共拆除了73个非法广告牌的建筑结构，以及拆下20个非法广

告，总计发出920张罚单，以及327张警告信。

而今年截至4月为止，则总计共发出了185张罚单以及67张警告信。

而在今年首4个月，共有7个非法广告牌建筑结构被拆除，4个非法广告被卸下。」

阿兹法斯札今早连同市议会官员，一同在沙登喜来登后方工业区，视察非法广告牌的拆除工程后，如是表示。

由于被拆除的巨型广告牌，正巧打中并弄断路旁的电线，阿兹法斯札表示，他们会通知国能公司，而有关修复费用将由广告业者来承担。（401）

违例者禁更新广告执照

阿兹法斯札说，为了打击区内的非法广告牌问题，市议会将采取严厉的对付行动，绝不手软，包括不允许涉及抵触2007年地方政府广告（梳邦再也市议会）条例者，更新市议会的广告

执照。

他解释，市议会坚决对非法广告牌展开拆除行动，主要是因为这些广告牌的建筑结构，无法确定是否安全。

此外，他表示，市议会今日

计划共拆除18个非法广告牌，直至57个非法广告牌全数被拆除为止。

「任何广告业者要在路旁竖立巨型广告牌，首先需获得土地局的批准，之后再向市议会策划小组和建筑小组申请图测，批准后再向执照组提出申请。」

巴生疫苗针缺货 小贩办执照受阻

巴生25日讯 | 巴生市议会疫苗针缺货，熟食业小贩申请更新执照受阻！

雪隆贩公会联合会顾问陈秀溪指出，过去一周接连收到小贩业者投诉，指向市议会申办更新执照时，因当局疫苗针缺货，数次申办皆无功而返。

据他了解，市议会疫苗针缺货是上周开始，官员要小贩自行在外面诊所注射疫苗，然后才批准更新执照。

「但是，小贩也发现坊间多家诊所同样面对缺货困扰，市场上出现疫苗针短缺。」

从事饮食业者和小贩，聘请的帮手包括本地人或外劳，一律必须依据卫生准绳注射疫苗，才获市议会批发和更新执照。

他说，市议会注射疫苗费用介于30至35令吉，外面诊所则需80令吉，差距甚大。因此，大部分小贩皆选择到市议会注射，然后更新执照。

出席者包括雪贩公会会长陈联发、巴生滨海小贩商业公会理事潘国全、财政黄政树、会员陈来添。

陈联发说，雪隆地区饮食业主要80%都是外劳帮手，而其中逾

50%是非法外劳，业者受促尽快补办漂白程序，避免遭取缔。

6月起取缔非法外劳

他说，漂白非法外劳程序将于月底截止，政府将于6月1日起展开取缔非法外劳行动。

他也鼓励，业者雇用本地退休人士，取代外劳；如此一来，也让本地人有工作机会。

潘国全表示，饮食业者除了地方政府批发营业执照，还需申请中央政府的SSM商业注册，以及有报个人所得税，才获得漂白外劳。

「所以，业者需要补办以上程序，才能真正合法化外劳员工。」

他也建议，业者在申办漂白外劳员工的过渡期，先暂停外劳员工，改雇本地临时工，直到漂白成功才让外劳做工。

他不希望，业者冒险雇用非法外劳，否则被取缔时，将面对罚款最高1万令吉的刑罚。
