

# 9 lagi kematian

2,433 kes jangkitan dilaporkan, Selangor tertinggi

**K**es jangkitan baru Covid-19 terus menjejaskan empat angka apabila 2,433 kes dilaporkan semalam dengan sembilan kematian.

Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah berkata, jumlah keseluruhan kes positif Covid-19 di Malaysia meningkat kepada 135,992 kes dan

kebolehjangkitan pula 27,332 kes.

"Selangor melaporkan kesan baharu tertinggi iaitu 730 kes (30.0 peratus). Daripada jumlah itu, 510 kes daripada kluster dan sangan kontak rapat Covid-19 yang aktif dijalankan di lapangan.

"Ini diikuti Sabah 403 kes (16.6 peratus) dan Johor 321 kes (13.2 peratus).

"Sebanyak 86 kes (3.5 peratus) dilaporkan berkaitan kluster di lokap, depot tahanan imigresen dan penjara membabitkan Kluster Penjara Jalan Harapan (79

kes), Kluster Pagar Siput (3 kes), Kluster Penjara Seberang Perai (3 kes) dan Kluster Tembok Choh (1 kes)," katanya dalam satu kenyataan media, semalam.

Dr Noor Hisham berkata, Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) merekodkan bilangan kes sembuh Covid-19 1,277 kes menjadikan jumlah kumulatif kes pulih 108,109 kes.

Tambah beliau, terdapat 171 kes positif Covid-19 dirawat di Unit Rawatan Rapi (ICU) dengan 76 kes memerlukan bantuan pernafasan.

Selain itu, katanya, terdapat pertambahan sembilan kematian semalam menjadikan jumlah kumulatif kes kematian 551 kes.

"Lima kes dilaporkan di Selangor iaitu empat lelaki dan seorang wanita berusia 51 hingga 78 tahun.

"Tiga kematian dilaporkan di Kuala Lumpur membabitkan wanita berusia 94 tahun dan dua lelaki bukan warganegara berusia 37 serta 60 tahun. Manakala satu kematian di Sabah membabitkan wanita berusia 83 tahun," katanya.

**SHAH ALAM** – Pembuangan sisa industri terus berlaku pada malam minggu apabila yang terbaru, sebuah kilang pembuatan berasaskan bahan kimia dikesan berbuat demikian di daerah ini malam kelmarin.

Dalam kejadian kira-kira pukul 10.30 malam itu, perbuatan kilang yang telah beroperasi sejak enam tahun lalu itu terbongkar hasil pemeriksaan Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) Selangor.

Pengaruhnya, Nor Aziah Jaafar berkata, trend itu semakin menjadilah sebagai jalan mudah bagi membuat sisa industri tanpa rawatan sewajarnya.

Katanya, pihak JAS juga mendapat rekod jumlah aduan pencemaran yang diterima adalah lebih tinggi berlaku pada hari cuti dan hujung minggu.

"Siasatan mendapati, kilang terbabit melepaskan effluen secara pintasan ke longkang awam yang boleh mengalir sehingga ke Sungai Klang, seterusnya menceburkan sungai berkenaan.

Alam Sekeling. 1974 telah dikeluarkan bagi memastikan tindakan pembakaan diambil segera oleh pihak kilang," katanya ketika dihubungi semalam.

Beliau menambah, hasil siasatan mendapati kilang tersebut pernah dikesan melakukan pencemaran dua tahun lalu.

Nor Aziah berkata, fokus pemantauan dilakukan meliputi premis-premis kilang di beberapa kawasan perindustrian di Shah Alam, Bestari Jaya, Semenyih, Sepang dan Kuala Langat yang pernah diadu melakukan

pencemaran.

"Kita memberikan amaran tegas kepada pihak industri supaya tidak sewenang-wenangnya melepaskan sisa pencemaran bagi mengelakkan sebarang pencemaran alam sekitar," jelasnya.

Kosmo! pada 31 Disember lalu melaporkan tindakan sebuah kilang makanan mengambil kesempatan melepaskan sisa pemprosesan terus ke longkang awam ketika hujung minggu terbongkar selepas dikesan pihak berkuasa di sekitar daerah ini pada 27 Disember lalu.

THERE was an almost 40% drop in the number of dengue cases in 2020 compared to the previous year, says Selangor Health Department director Datuk Dr Sha'ari Ngadiman.

He said Selangor recorded 44,635 dengue cases last year compared to 72,543 in 2019.

"The districts with the highest number of cases were Petaling with 15,518 cases or 34.8% of the total, Hulu Langat with 9,842 (22%), Klang at 6,960 (15.6%), Gombak 6,642 (14.8%) and Sepang 2,400 (5.3%)."

"There were 37 dengue-related deaths last year compared to 56 cases in 2019," he said in a statement.

Despite the drop, Dr Sha'ari reminded the public not to be complacent and continue to take precautions.

"Ensure that your surroundings are clean so that Aedes mosquitoes cannot breed."

"Spend 10 minutes each week to ensure that there is no stagnant water and sprinkle Abate where needed," he said.

When contacted, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia's parasitology and entomology expert Assoc Prof Dr Hidayatul Fathi Othman said increased awareness of the dengue threat could be one of the factors contributing to the reduction.

"Cases have been steadily decreasing since the 32nd week of

Selangor also sees fewer deaths in 2020 compared to previous year

2020. After a spike between week 25 and 30, there were increased reminders and efforts made by related agencies to reach out to the people," she said.

Assoc Prof Hidayatul added that these efforts were helped by community-led initiatives to eradicate Aedes mosquitoes.

"The Combi teams (Communication for Behavioural Impact) were actively taking charge of the situation in their respective communities as they know that government agency staff are shorthanded," she said.

She added that managing dengue required a coordinated effort and that the search-and-destroy method against mosquito breeding grounds was still the main preventive action.

Despite the reduction in the number of cases, Selangor still topped the list compared to other states nationwide.

Based on Health Ministry data between Dec 27, 2019 and Jan 2, 2021, Malaysia recorded a total of 90,304 dengue cases, a decrease of 30.6% (39,797 cases) from the previous year.

There were 145 deaths in 2020, compared to 182 in 2019.

Johor is the state with the second

highest number with 11,622 cases and 43 deaths.

Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya recorded 10,631 cases, followed by Sabah (4,078), Kelantan (3,889), Pahang (3,220), Negeri Sembilan (2,891), Melaka (2,843), Perak (2,665), Sarawak (1,516), Penang (1,043), Kedah (780), Terengganu (404) and Perlis (80).

# Two ministers quarantined

Redzuan and Saifuddin self-isolating after sitting next to Tok Pa

**PETALING JAYA:** At least two ministers are now self-isolating after they sat next to Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, who tested positive for Covid-19, during a meeting in Putrajaya on Jan 6.

Also ordered to undergo testing are Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia leaders who attended a party meeting with Mustapa on the same day.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohd Redzuan Md Yusof and Communications and Multimedia Minister Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah confirmed they had been identified as close contacts and were now in isolation as a precautionary measure.

"Throughout the Cabinet meeting, there was no physical contact. We were not only physically distanced but there was also a screen between us. Also, we were all wearing masks."

"However, as an identified close contact, I will undergo a swab test as well as remain in isolation as directed," said Mohd Redzuan.

During the meeting, ministers said Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin was seated about

seven chairs away – about 7m – from Mustapa.

Saifuddin said while he had not experienced any symptoms, he was monitoring himself under home surveillance order (HSO).

He said he would also be undergoing a swab test and would remain in isolation until given full clearance by the Health Ministry during a second screening.

Mustapa, the Minister in the Prime Minister's Department, confirmed in a statement yesterday that he had tested positive for Covid-19 on Saturday.

He was tested as soon as he reached Kota Baru on the morning of the same day.

Mustapa, who had tested negative in an earlier screening on Jan 1,

is reported to be in stable condition at Hospital Raja Perempuan Zainab II in Kota Baru.

"All his close contacts from Jan 1 to 9 are advised to undergo screening as soon as possible. He has apologised for the inconvenience caused," said his office.

Religious Affairs Minister Datuk Seri Dr Zulkifli Mohamad Al-Bakri had in early October also tested positive for Covid-19 after travelling to Sabah.

This led to those in close contact with him, including Cabinet ministers and Muhyiddin, to undergo health screening and self-quarantine.

Meanwhile, Bersatu leaders, who attended its supreme leadership council meeting on Jan 6 with

Mustapa, were ordered to undergo Covid-19 tests immediately.

Its information chief Wan Saiful Wan Jan said Mustapa had attended the meeting, which was conducted according to SOP.

"However, as a preventive measure, all council members who attended the meeting have been ordered to take a Covid-19 test immediately," he said in a statement on the party's WhatsApp group yesterday.

Those involved would also have to adhere to the required SOP issued by the Health Ministry, he said.

Among those at the meeting were Wan Saiful, party vice-president Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee, supreme council members Datuk Seri Azmin Ali, Saifuddin and Redzuan.

Also present were Srikandi (Women) chief Datuk Seri Rina Mohd Harun, Armada (youth) chief Wan Ahmad Fayshal Wan Ahmad Kamal and Srikandi vice-chief Datuk Mas Erniecey Samsudin.

Azmin is the International Trade and Industries Minister while Rina is the Women, Family and Community Development Minister. Kiandee is the Agriculture and Food Industries Minister.

The meeting, which was chaired by Bersatu president Muhyiddin, was held in light of calls by several Umno divisions to withdraw support for Perikatan Nasional.

# 'WE NEED COVID-19 ADVISORY PANEL'

It can address new challenges that require multisectoral, transdisciplinary action, say experts

**M**ALAYSIA urgently needs to form an independent Covid-19 Advisory Committee to plug the gaps in virus detection, prevention and care, as the pandemic enters its second year with no signs of abating.

Health experts cautioned that this year could present new challenges and changes, which would require complex and coordinated multisectoral, transdisciplinary action to improve the country's Covid-19 response.

Drawing parallels with advisory committees established in the United States and New Zealand, the experts said such a panel of local experts was crucial to aid the authorities in coming up with

clear, holistic and effective mitigation measures.

Epidemiologist and biostatistician Associate Professor Dr Maolina Osman said setting up an advisory committee would be a positive development in pandemic management.

She said it could address blind spots of current strategies, provide specific advice in specific situations, empower the community, show transparency in the government's approach to tackling the virus, offer wider options of the relevant data analysis and improve the trust deficit.

"The committee can provide valuable information and feedback to enhance outbreak management, offer suggestions and allow the relevant data to be analysed timely."

"Proper and specific platforms for the discussion should be arranged with the specific objectives and related performance indicators," she told the *New Straits Times*.  
She said the committee should

be made up of strong-minded local public health experts from academia, ministries and/or former Health Ministry personnel.

She said those in the National Pharmaceutical Regulatory Agency, physicians and surgeons who

served as frontliners (including those in the private sector), occupational safety and health experts, infectious diseases researchers, mathematicians, statisticians and data modelling experts should be roped in.

"There is a need to have relevant stakeholders share their distinct views consistently and continuously in the country's battle against Covid-19."

"Currently, the Health Ministry, through specific platforms and meetings, invites experts to share their views, but sharing is limited to the discussion duration and is usually done ad hoc."

Universiti Selangor visiting professor of environmental health Professor Dr Jamal Hisham Hashim said more could be done in pan-

demic assessment and control.

"The main clusters are the Sri Petaling *tabligh*, Sabah election, prison and workplace clusters. Only the Sri Petaling cluster has been well resolved."

The other clusters from prisons and workplaces are still highly challenging.

"We have not come up with an effective strategy to prevent future outbreaks from similar clusters."

He said data gathered on the Covid-19 risk assessment, management and communication had shown that the two main contributors to the public's exposure to the virus were environment and behaviour, so these two aspects should be beefed up.

"There are some aspects of the pandemic control that are beyond the Health Ministry's scope. Two of these are prisons and workplaces, which come under the Prison Department and Human Resources Ministry, respectively."

"An advisory committee would help us put together a multi-pronged approach in assessing and strategising our targeted approach towards Covid-19 control."

Malaka Manipal Medical Col-

lege's Community and Occupational Medicine Professor Dr G. Jayakumar said the special committee should complement the Health Ministry, especially in addressing issues particular to different states.

"We need to recognise that the Health Ministry has been successful in handling the pandemic, but fatigue can set in and affect the medical officials, especially the frontliners."

"An independent committee will contribute to controlling the further spread of Covid-19 by understanding and working holistically with relevant agencies and ministries."

He said the committee would need leadership from and collaboration between national and state public health leaders, academics, public health physicians from professional bodies like the Malaysian Medical Association and Academy of Medicine Malaysia, as well as other experts.

Malaysian Public Health Physicians Association president Datuk Dr Zainal Ariffin Omar said the association was keen to be part of the advisory committee should the government agree to its formation.

(八打灵再也 10日讯) 雪兰莪州议员被指学历不够格，莎阿南市政厅更有市议员疑因“背景不合格”之故，造成明天宣誓仪式被展延！

本报探悉，莎阿南地方政府原定明天上午举办市议员宣誓仪式，惟，期间发现被委任的一些市议员并不符合要求资格，公关也在下午发信急证宣誓仪式，惟没有说明原因。

有关市议员被质疑资格的原因包括未取得大马教育文凭资格、背景有污点、种族分配不均等。

除此，昨天在巴生市议会面簿专页里，也出现一个署名为“民主行动党班达马兰北区联合会”(Gabungan Cawangan & Cawangan DAP Pandamaran Utara) 及班达马兰 N47C 区市议员 (Ahli Majlis Zon N47C Pandamaran) 的网友连名带姓称，班达马兰州议员梁德志所遴选的市议员洪建华没取得大马教育文凭的学历。

### 巴生马来市议员少引不满

此次更有人民公正党党员在面簿撰文不满心声，指巴生市议会的马来市议员人数少于华印裔，即只有7人，后者加起来合共有16人。

根据雪州政府提供市议员申请表格显示，申请者需填写学历资格，最低学历为大马教育文凭，国语成绩及其他学历等。

## 黄思汉：若有污点会刷下 不存在种族分配不均

掌管地方政府事务的行政议员黄思汉向本报指出，此次被遴选市议员皆通过背景调查、学历考证，相对，更不存在有关种族分配不均等问题。

他说，首先州政府确实有向警方、反贪会等核实遴选者的背景，但在等待回复期间，州政府还是须按本身调查机制进行，让符合条件者通关受委。

“若随后执法单位出炉报

告显示被遴选者确有污点，州

政府也有权将他们刷下，就如早前土团党跳崖，公正党员被开除党籍的市议员，都在任期间直接被取消市议员资格。”

他强调，希望委任市议员也不存在种族分配不均的问题，因为受委任者主要看其表现能力，并由各盟党按本身遴选机制选出。

“至于大马教育文凭学历也不足最主要遴选资格，没有读文凭者仍可获州政府安排参加考试通过，有关考试主要通

过实事、政策等课题来测试考试者的马来理解、阅读能力等。”

他指出，洪建华是其中一名参与考试者，并且也通过了有关测试，在数名参赛者当中，就只有2人不合格，而无法获选为市议员。

## 梁德志：虽没大马教育文凭 洪建华通过州政府考试

班达马兰州议员梁德志受访时坦承，洪建华确实没有大马教育文凭学历，不过，其已通过完成州政府安排的考试资格，因此仍是符合担任市议员资格的。

“有关指责不确实，而且，大马教育文凭也非担任市议员必备的资格，若相关人士没取得该学历，也可通过参与州政府安排的考试取代，洪建华就于去年11月参加了有关

考试，并取得合格的成绩。”

针对洪建华被攻击一事，梁德志表示，主要是小撮人表达不满心声，但本身也有委任市议员的要求和准则，尤其必须与本身配合协助解决州选区民生课题、能够建议地方政府制定政策、专注市议员工作等。

“一些人或有他们的专业和学历，不过，同时也忙于本身工作，以致无法全程参与市

议会会议、活动，甚至解决民生问题等，这可能就无法达到我的当选要求了。”

“我只能说，无法满足所有人的要求，最重要的是选区民生工作能够获得处理而已。”
