AJL35 SOP ketat

Tukar lokasi, hadkan kru elak kejadian tidak diingini

Akur situasi semasa dengan semua pihak berusaha mengelakkan penularan pandemik COVID-19, Anugerah Juara Lagu (AJL) Ke-35 pada 7 Februari depan, dikenalkan dalam norma baharu.

Banyak perubahan dibuat mengikut prosedur operasi standard (SOP) antaraannya tiada penonton dan lokasi acara ditukar dari Axiatea Arena, Bukit Jalil ke Auditorium Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA), Selangor.

Premis baharu dipilih atas faktor kapasiti kru dan pihak yang terlibat dalam produksi AJL35 dikurangkan.

Sehubungan itu, Auditorium MBSA dipilih berikutan saiznya yang lebih kompak dan sangat sesuai dalam memenuhi SOP.

Mengulas lanjut perubahan lokasi itu, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Rangkaian Televisyen Media Prima dan Primeworks Studios, Datuk Khairul Anwar Salleh, berkata kerjasama antara MBSA dan TV3 meyakinkan TV3 mewujudkan AJL35 dari auditorium majlis bandar raya itu.

"Sepanjang pandemik COVID-19, kami banyak membuat kerja produksi dengan MBSA.

"Saya yakin dengan bantuan mereka dan Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) untuk mengawal selia SOP ditetapkan, AJL35 akan lancar," katanya pada sidang media virtual AJL35 kelmanarin.

Khairul Anwar menambah TV3 bertujuh dapat menggunakan Auditorium MBSA yang baru diubah suai.

"Kami akan memanfaatkan kelebihan itu dengan sebaik mungkin untuk menghasilkan persembahan menarik dan menghiburkan," katanya.

Sementara itu, Penerbit Eksekutif AJL35, Nurhul Huda Khalid berkata, bilaupun AJL35 berlalu ke lokasi kecil, pihaknya memberi jaminan acara pencarian Juara Lagu itu akan menyajikan hiburan terbaik kepada penonton.

"Berikutnya AJL35 dianjurkan tanpa penonton, kita putuskan mengubah lokasi dari Axiatea Arena, Bukit Jalil ke Auditorium MBSA.

"Lokasi baharu lebih kompak dan sesuai untuk acara yang tidak memerlukan had kapasiti ramai."

"Biarpun berubah tempat, ia tidak membataskan kami untuk menyajikan persembahan terbaik kepada penonton," katanya.

Selain itu, tambah Nurhul Huda, kali ini, pengaruh metapak syarat kepada setiap finalis agar tidak menonjolkan elemen yang boleh mencetuskan kontroversi dalam persembahan mereka.

Sehubungan itu, finalis perlu menandatangani akta janji bagi memastikan kontroversi aksi di pentas seperti tahun lalu, tidak berulang.

"Tahun ini, produksi mewajibkan setiap peserta menandatangi surat perjanjian sebagai langkah berjaga-jaga.

"Sebelumnya, kita ada menerapkan syarat elemen dibenarkan atau dilarang untuk ditonjolkan dalam elemen persembahan finalis.

"Cuma kali ini, kita mahu dibuat secara bertulis," katanya.

Nurhul Huda berkata, surat akta janji itu disediakan Jabatan Undang-Undang yang antara lain menetapkan syarat seperti tiada unsur politik, kegagasan hati sepihak dan menguris hati sepihak," katanya.

"Kita juga perlu pastikan maklumat dalam skrip yang menyentuh isu semasa seperti pandemik COVID-19, bencana banjir dan politik tidak menguris hati sepihak," katanya.

"Biasanya, apabila kami buat lawak, aura penonton akan memperoleh semangat. Tapi kali ini, suasana pasti berbeza.

"Mujur ketika mengendalikan program Separuh Akhir Muzik-Muzik (SFMM) Ke-35 tempoh hari, saya dapat pengalaman berharga."

"Ketika itu, saya menggunakan media sosial untuk mendapatkan maklumat balas segera penton.

"Peminat beritahu, saya kena lebih fokus dengan kamera kerana walaupun tiada penonton di studio. Kita tahu mereka ada di luar menyaksikan."

Lokasi baharu lebih kompak dan sesuai untuk acara yang tidak memerlukan had kapasiti ramai.

Selain itu, persembahan interlude AJL35 bertemakan Projek Band akan menampilkan Hujan, Hazama & The Penglipur Lara dan Akim & The Majistret. Semua band ini akan mempersembahkan aksi medley dan *mash up* lagu terbaik mereka sambil bergandingan dengan Misia Omar, Dayang Nurfaizah dan Ziana Zain.

BAWANGKANALAH studut kecil padang kacang yang subak kacang yang besar, cili padi, petis, kangkung, kailan, timun Jepun, tumis rambutan dan lain-lain.

Bukan sahaja "mencuci" batas perbatasan jalinan sayur-sayuran, malah ia dipergunakan untuk teruskan ikon air tawar turut terdiri daripada tanaman yang padang rekreasi awam seluruh negara.

Sofuan.

SHAH ALAM: Kumpulan peniaga di Seksyen U12 di sini kesal apabila dilabelkan sebagai kumpulan gerila pembunuh anjing disebabkan tindakan mereka mengadu kepada pihak berkuasa agar anjing-anjing liar di kawasan komersial tersebut ditangkap.

Wakil kumpulan tersebut, Muhammad Fathi Ismail berkata, isu tersebut timbul apabila seorang peniaga di sini telah diserang 20 ekor anjing liar hingga luka parah di kepala di kawasan itu semasa menuju ke keretanya.

Menurutnya, tindakan yang diambil kumpulan peniaga ialah menghalau anjing yang sedang menyerang mangsa sebelum membawanya ke hospital untuk menerima rawatan.

"Selepas kejadian tersebut, salah seorang peniaga di sini sekadar suka-suka menggelarkan kumpulan peniaga yang membantu mangsa tersebut dalam hantaran akaun Facebook beliau sebagai kumpulan gerila khas yang wujud untuk memastikan tiada anjing liar berada di kawasan tersebut.

"Namun, tindakan ini telah disalah tafsir dan menimbulkan persepsi negatif dalam kalangan netizen apabila gambar kami dalam *Animal News* tersebut dipaparkan bersama gambar lain termasuk beberapa ekor anjing yang rebah dan berbau mulutnya yang tidak diketahui sumbernya di dalam Facebook *Malaysia Dogs Deserve Better* (MDDB).

"Walhal, kesemua anjing liar tersebut telah ditangkap oleh Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) dengan kaedah sumpitan ubat pelali dan gambar anjing mati diracun yang dipaparkan tiada kaitan dengan peniaga," katanya dalam sidang akhbar di sini hari ini.

Selangor beli 5 juta dos vaksin Covid-19

Sungai Besar: Kerajaan Selangor bercadang membeli sebanyak tiga hingga lima juta dos vaksin Covid-19 bagi mengawal penularan, sekali gus memutuskan rangkaian jangkitan wabak terbabit di negeri ini.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, langkah itu bertujuan memastikan kesihatan rakyat di negeri ini terus terjamin selain memastikan bekalan vaksin Covid-19 mencukupi.

"Selangor perlu membeli (vaksin Covid-19) sebab keperluannya lebih kerana industri negeri memerlukan pekerja termasuk pekerja asing.

"Setakat ini, vaksin Covid-19 disediakan kepada warganegara namun mereka (pekerja asing) perlu membeli vaksin terbabit," katanya ketika ditemui di majlis perasmian Dataran Patriotik Pejabat Daerah dan Tanah Sabak Bernam di sini, semalam.

Menurutnya, pembelian vaksin itu juga akan dibincangkan dengan Kerajaan Persekutuan selain dibawa ke Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, Rabu ini.

Ditanya mengenai langkah diambil kerajaan negeri susulan Selangor mencatatkan bilangan kes Covid-19 harian tertinggi, beliau berkata, pihaknya sudah mengadakan mesyuarat bersama Majlis Keselamatan Negeri, minggu lalu.

Katanya, beberapa perancangan dan pelan tertentu masih dalam tindakan na-

'Kami bukan gerila pembunuh anjing'

SHAH ALAM – Para peniaga di Pusat Komersial di Seksyen U12 di sini kesal dilabelkan ahli gerila pembunuh anjing oleh satu kumpulan pencinta haiwan, menerusi laman rasmi Facebook mereka, baru-baru ini.

Kesemuanya bermula apabila seorang peniaga di kawasan berkenaan, Muhd. Zikri Muit, 48, parah di kepala akibat diserang sekumpulan 20 anjing liar.

Wakil peniaga, pusat komersial berkenaan, Muhammad Fathi Ismail berkata, susulan kejadian tersebut pihaknya telah membuat aduan kepada Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) berhubung ancaman anjing liar sebelum pihak berkuasa tempatan itu menangkap kesemua haiwan itu.

Katanya, seorang daripada peniaga kemudiannya sekadar bergurau mengelarkan kami gerila khas dalam memastikan tiada anjing liar di kawasan ini menerusi hantarnya di akaun Facebooknya.

"Perkara itu kemudiannya didapati dimanipulasi kumpulan pencinta haiwan itu dengan memaparkan suntingan gam-

Proposal to rent apartments to B40 group shot down

COUNCIL-owned apartments on Lintang Jelai 4 off Jalan Kim Chuan in Pandamaran, Klang, have been vacant for some years now, prompting calls to turn them into affordable housing.

One of the groups seeking better use of the apartments is Klang Hakka Association.

"We have received suggestions from residents urging Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Property Management Department to refurbish the 32 units and turn them into affordable housing for either council staff or the B40 group," said association vice-president Robin Chong Yook Tiam.

MPK: Vacant council-owned building to be privatised and used as document storage facility

The four-storey building, he said, had been left idle for sometime, thereby attracting vandals to the extent that electrical fittings had been stripped off the wall panels.

Lim Wai Kit, 34, who lives across the apartments, said it was high time the council refurbished the building and allowed those in the lower-income group to move in.

"Most of us who live in the neighbourhood want the apartments to be done up to stop bad hats from entering at night," he added.

Another resident, Lee Kim Peng, 58, said the last occupants of the apartments were college students.

"If the units are refurbished and tenanted with affordable rent, surely they will be snapped up."

"MPK should allow deserving families to rent the units and in turn, it can earn revenue from the apartments," he said, hoping MPK would make this a priority.

MPK Property Management Department director Helmy Mohamed Rashid said the council had discussed the issue of the vacant apartments at its management meeting.

"We have taken into consideration the views of the residents of Lintang Jelai 4 and Lintang Jelai 3 who live across the apartments.

"Our proposed plan is to privatise the use of the building, whereby a firm will refurbish it and use it as a document storage facility," he said.

Helmy added that the proposal to turn the premises into affordable housing was not suitable as it would lead to an increase in traffic on Lintang Jelai 4, which is a residential road.

The Women, Family and Community Development Minister was admitted to Hospital Sungai Buloh at 11am yesterday.

According to her office, the minister received the result of her test on Sunday night after undergoing screening at the Putrajaya Klinik Kesihatan earlier that day.

"The minister apologises if this incident has caused any inconven-

ience or anxiety," her office said in a statement, adding that the Ministry would continue its work as usual.

Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamad, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department, confirmed in a statement on Sunday that he tested positive for Covid-19 on Saturday.

Following which, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohd Redzuan Md Yusof and Communications and Multimedia Minister Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah confirmed they have been identified as close contacts to Mustapa and were self-isolating.

Rina attended a supreme council

meeting on Jan 6 with Mustapa.

The meeting was attended by Bersatu information chief Wan Saiful Wan Jan, party vice-president Datuk Seri Dr Ronald Kiandee, and supreme council members Datuk Seri Azmin Ali, Saifuddin and Redzuan.

Also present were Armada (youth) chief Wan Ahmad Faysal Wan Ahmad Kamal and Srikanth vice-chief Datuk Mas Ermeyati Samsudin.

Azmin is the International Trade and Industries Minister while Kiandee is the Agriculture and Food Industries Minister.

The meeting, which was chaired by Bersatu president Muhyiddin, was held in light of calls by several Umno divisions to withdraw support for Perikatan Nasional.

Religious Affairs Minister Datuk Seri Dr Zulkifli Mohamad Al-Bakri had in early October tested positive after travelling to Sabah.

In KOTA BARU, Galas assemblyman Mohd Syahbuddin Hashim became the latest in a growing list of politicians who have tested positive for Covid-19.

The Barisan Nasional state representative in Kelantan confirmed his status in a Facebook post yesterday.

"Abe Din and my wife tested positive for Covid-19. To all those who have had close contact with us, I apologise for the inconvenience. (I apologise to) those who are forced to be tested and might have been infected," he said in his post.

Mohd Syahbuddin, who often refers to himself as "Abe Din", advised everyone to be careful as Gua Musang has been declared a red zone for Covid-19 cases.

Make assessment billing digital in stages, MBPJ urged

Ratepayers say registration and download of app come with problems

PETALING JAYA City Council's (MBPJ) decision to make its assessment billing mandatory from Jan 1 this year has caught ratepayers off guard.

Last month, MBPJ issued a notice to all ratepayers that it would no longer accept payment via the physical platform that it would no longer provide. It also urged ratepayers to download and pay online bills via the e-Cukai MBPJ app.

There was also a warning that the city council would not entertain exceptions for late payments on payment by physical bill.

Ratepayers are upset and frustrated by the lack of forthcoming information on how to download and use the app, as well as the lack of payment options for non-tech-savvy users such as the elderly.

Some who attempted the digital method found themselves unable to log in or log out of the app after entering an account via the app or while navigating MBPJ's website.

"When I first received any notice or message from MBPJ about my assessment bill, I did not know how to download and use the app," said Wong Yew Chong, a Residential and Owners Association (ROA) member.

"We were only made aware when we received a letter from Duras' chat group after calling the council's helpline that we had to check with our area councilor for help."

He said he personally tried downloading the app but struggled to do so.

"It's unfair for MBPJ to penalise late payers when they have not even been much publicity on electronic assessment bills," he said.

"The city council can't just assume that everybody has access to pay online," he said, adding that it should have consulted with the elderly group representatives before implementing the new measure.

"It's fine if MBPJ wants to go paperless, but the transition should be done in stages."

For example, it can offer the option of allowing people to pay the

bill in cash and to go online for the second term."

MBPJ's assessment bills are typically split into two halves of the year, the first and second halves of the year.

The payment deadline for the first half is Aug 31 and the second half is Feb 28 and Aug 31 respectively.

Ratepayers will have to pay for two terms in advance.

MBPJ chairman Ronald Danker said assessments were only made aware of the move through a post on his assemblymanner posted by their assemblyman.

"As far as I'm concerned, we are making things easier with the move," he said, adding that the elderly are less likely to use digital devices.

People who are less mobile or have difficulties walking, so they get a neighbour to help them download the app or bring the assessment bill in person at the MBPJ headquarters after Aug 31.

"I had to make two trips, I was turned away when I first went because it was Aug 31, the day due to the crowd control measures.

And made sure I brought a copy of my identification card and my assessment bill, so they have been more difficult for the elderly to pay online," he said.

"I'm going to my records without it," he said.

Bukit Tinggi chairman Datuk Lamen Sayong said, "MBPJ should consider the elderly as well."

Pivotal forfeiture verdict on PKFZ case on Wednesday at Federal Court

PUTRAJAYA (Jan 11): A three-member Federal Court bench is scheduled to deliver its decision on the forfeiture of RM37.8 million from Bintulu member of Parliament Datuk Seri Tiong King Sing and his related companies involved in the construction of the Port Klang Free Zone (PKFZ) project.

This was announced by the apex court registrar office after the decision had been postponed twice since Sept 30 last year, due to implementation of the conditional movement control order (CMCO).

Originally, the apex court was to deliver its decision on Sept 30 but this was deferred to Oct 21, and this had been deferred again to this Wednesday.

An outcome in the PKFZ decision would have a bearing on other related forfeiture cases, especially those linked to 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB), as the prosecution seeks to impose pecuniary orders as stipulated under Section 59 of the Anti-Money Laundering, Anti-Terrorism Financing and Proceeds from Unlawful Activity 2001 (AMLATFPUAA) to impose penalty that can be imposed on suspected offenders if forfeiture fails.

Section 59 of AMLATFPUAA stipulates the court shall mete out a pecuniary penalty order against persons found to be involved in money laundering as it sees fit. In addition, the court may also assess the value of the benefits derived and order the persons to pay the federal government a penalty equivalent to that amount.

Besides naming Tiong, the prosecution named eight other respondents comprising Kuala Dimensi Sdn Bhd (KDSB), the main contractor of the PKFZ project, along with Transhipment Megahub Bhd, Coastal Skyline Sdn Bhd, Wijaya Baru Aviation Sdn Bhd, Wijaya Baru Sdn Bhd, Wijaya Baru Construction Sdn Bhd, Law Ka Hieng and Selangor Development Corporation (PKNS).

Tiong was formerly KDSB chief executive officer.

The government is seeking to forfeit movable and immovable property that includes cash of RM37.8 million, plus a land in Pulau Lumut, Klang, owned by Coastal Skyline, a land in Kota Kinabalu, Sabah, owned by Wijaya Baru Sdn Bhd and two plots of land in Section 13, Shah Alam, belonging to PKNS that was sold to KDSB.

The decision on the case involves KDSB — the turnkey developer of the controversial PKFZ, whose cost ballooned from an initial RM1.96 billion to a whopping RM7.45 billion.

As reported in August last year, many 1MDB forfeiture cases appeal, including the one against Umno's RM192.2 million, and others are awaiting the outcome of this apex court's verdict involving Tiong and KDSB.

This followed the High Court having mostly rejected the forfeiture of the 1MDB related cases as the money sought from alleged payment by former prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak are no longer there, and hence the pending appeal at the Court of Appeal.

With regards to Tiong's and KDSB's case, the prosecution had on June 30, 2020 told the apex court bench led by Federal Court's Justice Vernon Ong Lam Kiat that it should not look at the withdrawal of charges against former Port Klang Authority general manager Datuk OC Phang as a basis not to allow the forfeiture application by the prosecution as there are other means the court could consider, including the implementation of Section 59 of AMLATFPUAA.

The prosecution had failed in its case at the Shah Alam High Court on Nov 4, 2011 and again it failed in its appeal at the Court of Appeal resulting in its ensuing and final appeal at the Federal Court.


