53 lot niaga kaut untung 'atas angin'

PKPS kenal pasti tapak disewakan lebih tinggi kepada pihak ketiga

Serdang: Perbadanan Kemajuan Pertanian Selangor (PKPS) mengenal pasti 53 lot niaga di Pasar Borong Selangor, di sini, disewakan kepada pihak ketiga terutama warga asing untuk menguntungkan.

Penolong Pengurus Operasi PKPS, Jamaluddin Mohamed Subari, berkata maklumat diterima pihaknya mendapati ada lot niaga di situ disewakan lebih tinggi, berbanding kadar ditetapkan PKPS dan mampu meraih untung mudah antara RM500 hingga RM1,000 sebulan.

Katanya, biasanya kadar ditetapkan PKPS bagi lot niaga sayur-sayuran ialah RM1,320 sebulan, manakala lot barang basah seperti daging, ikan dan ayam pada kadar RM1,658 sebulan tetapi pihaknya menerima maklumat ada sesetengah pemilik lot menyewakan pula lot niaga mereka pada kadar lebih tinggi sehingga mencapai RM3,000 sebulan.

"Semua ini kita pantau dan akan ambil tindakan tegas. Ka-

lau terbukti salah, kita akan tarik balik lot itu dan memberikannya kepada individu lain yang berminat. Pemilihan penyewa akan dibuat menerusi sesi temu duga," katanya kepada BH, semalam.

Jamaluddin berkata, PKPS selaku pemilik pasar borong terabit ketika ini berada pada fasa akhir untuk mengambil tindakan tegas termasuk menarik balik lot perniagaan itu daripada pemilik warga tempatan.

Bagaimanapun, katanya, pihak perbadanan masih memberi peluang kepada pemilik lot niaga untuk membuat rayuan dan memberi penjelasan sebelum tindakan selanjutnya diambil dalam masa terdekat.

Mengenal kebanjiran etnik Rohingya di Pasar Borong Selangor, Jamaluddin berkata, kira-

kira 300 etnik terabit bekerja di pasar berkenaan daripada keseluruhan lebih 600 warga asing yang dikesan.

"Secara keseluruhan, lebih 600 warga asing yang bekerja di sini, termasuk dari Indonesia dan Bangladesh. Kebanyakan mereka sebagai pendatang asing tanpa izin (PATI).

Katanya, sepanjang tahun lalu, Jabatan Imigresen sudah mengadakan 22 operasi pengatuan bagi membantarkan PATI dan 37 operasi di Pasar Borong Selangor.

Semalam, BH mendedahkan kehadiran terlalu ramai warga asing, khususnya etnik Rohingya di Pasar Borong Selangor sejak tahun lalu, sama ada sebagai pekerja atau pemilik perniagaan di situ, mencetuskan kebimbangan pengguna tempatan untuk berbelanja.

Mereka dilihat menguasai hampir keseluruhan lot niaga barang basah seperti ikan, ayam, daging dan sayur-sayuran dalam pasar borong terbabit.

Berdasarkan syarat PKPS, Pasar Borong Selangor yang mempunyai 260 lot niaga hanya boleh dikendalikan warga tempatan, namun tinjauan BH pada

rah Imigresen, Datuk Khairul Dzamee Daud, berkata etnik Rohingya yang memegang kad UNHCR dibenarkan bekerja bagi menyara kehidupan mereka di negara ini, tetapi tidak diberi hak berniaga kerana status mereka sebagai pendatang asing tanpa izin (PATI).

Beberapa pengunjung pasar terbabit yang dijumpai BH, mendakwa pernah diugut dan dimaki hamun sewenang-wenangnya pekerja dan peniaga warga asing di situ apabila tidak jadi membayar selepas bertanyak harga barang jualan mereka.

Mereka juga percaya ramai kalangan etnik Rohingya itu berasal dari kawasan sekitar Pasar Borong Kuala Lumpur di Selangor yang berpindah ke situ susulan langkah Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) melarang pekerja warga asing di sana.

Sehubungan itu, pengunjung menuntut kerajaan negeri 'membersihkan' pasar berkenaan daripada warga asing, sama seperti dilakukan DBKL terhadap Pasar Borong Kuala Lumpur yang mengambil langkah drastik melarang kehadiran warga asing, sama ada sebagai pekerja atau peniaga, selain memastikan hanya pemilik sah menguruskan perniagaan di situ.

Peniaga tempatan disyaki upah warga asing

Serdang: Polis tidak menolak kemungkinan ada dalam kalanng peniaga tempatan di Pasar Borong Selangor di Seri Kembanagan, di sini, menggajiikan warga asing sehingga jumlah mereka di lokasi perniagaan itu semakin ramai kebelakangan ini.

Ketua Polis Daerah Serdang, Asisten Komisioner Razali Abu Samah, berkata keadaan itu juga didakwa menimbulkan rasa kurang senang pengunjung kerana harga barang dijual pekerja asing terbatik dikatakan lebih tinggi berbanding harga pasaran.

Beliau mengakui, pihaknya mendapati kebanyakkan isu yang tercusut di pasar borong itu disebabkan rasa tidak puas hati pe-

ngunjung dengan pekerja asing yang disyaki diupah oleh pemilik lot niaga di pasar berkenaan.

Sehubungan itu, katanya, Perbadanan Kemajuan Pertanian Selangor (PKPS) selaku pemilik pasar berkenaan boleh mengambil tindakan mengusir atau menyenaraikan hitam pemilik lot jualan yang melakukan kesalahan termasuk meletakkan harga sesuka hati.

"Polis akan bertindak jika ada unsur ancaman keselamatan ditimbulkan pihak yang mungkin tidak berpuas hati ketika PKPS melaksanakan pemutihan peniaga di pasar itu bagi mengesahkan mereka melakukan kesalahan.

"Kami tidak akan berkom-

promi terhadap sebarang unsur yang mengancam keselamatan dan unsur jenayah, sama ada terhadap pengunjung, kakitangan PKPS atau mana-mana pihak,"

katanya ketika dihubungi BH.

Razali memberi jaminan, pihaknya akan bekerjasama dengan PKPS melakukan operasi bersepadu dalam masa terdekat bersama agensi penguatkuasaan lain termasuk Majlis Bandaraya Subang Jaya (MBSJ).

Katanya, bantuan itu bagi 'membersihkan' Pasar Borong Selangor daripada warga asing yang dilaporkan mula mengalih tumpuan ke lokasi berkenaan dari Pasar Borong Kuala Lumpur.

Razali berkata, pemantauan dan pemeriksaan di sekitar kawasan Pasar Borong Selangor kerap dilakukan Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Serdang dan setakat ini pihaknya tidak me-

nerima maklumat atau aduan orang awam berhubung sebarang kejadian mengancam keselamatan masyarakat setempat di kawasan terbabit.

"Meskipun tiada kejadian jenayah dilaporkan, rondaan dan pemantauan sentiasa dilakukan secara harian oleh pegawai dan anggota dari Balai Polis Seri Kembanagan serta IPD (Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah) Serdang sendiri.

"Berdasarkan risikan Cawangan Khas IPD Serdang, sehingga hujung tahun lalu, tiada sebarang elemen, khususnya warga asing pelarian Rohingya cuba menguasai aktiviti jualan dan perniagaan di pasar borong berkenaan," katanya.

3,306 positif semalam

Kuala Lumpur: Sebanyak 3,306 kes baharu positif Covid-19 direkodkan semalam menjadikan jumlah keseluruhan penularan wabak itu bertambah kepada 161,740 kes dengan kebolehjangkitan 38,791 kes.

Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah berkata, daripada jumlah itu, tujuh kes import dilaporkan manakala 3,299 kes lagi membabitkan penularan tempatan.

“Selangor kekal melaporkan kes harian baharu tertinggi iaitu sebanyak 1,213 kes diikuti Sabah (432 kes) dan Johor (329 kes).

“Sebanyak 107 kes dilaporkan adalah berkaitan kluster-kluster di penjara dan depot tahanan imigresen membabitkan Kluster Penjara Jalan Harapan (65 kes), Kluster Tembok Mempaga (35 kes), Kluster Tembok Nanas (4 kes), Kluster Damai Pelangi (2 kes) dan Kluster Pagar Siput (1 kes),”

katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Dr Noor Hisham berkata, ada 226 kes positif Covid-19 dirawat di unit rawatan rapi (ICU) dengan 94 kes memerlukan bantuan pernafasan.

Dalam pada itu, beliau berkata, sebanyak 2,293 kes dilaporkan pulih semalam menjadikan jumlah kumulatif kes pulih sepenuhnya 122,344 kes atau 75.6 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan kes.

“Terdapat empat kes kematian dilaporkan hari ini (semalam) membabitkan tiga lelaki serta seorang wanita tempatan berusia antara 59 hingga 91 tahun yang mempunyai latar belakang penyakit kronik di Selangor, Sabah dan Terengganu.

“Kes itu menjadikan jumlah kumulatif kematian sebanyak 605 kes atau 0.37 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan kes,” katanya.

Baca jampi ubati koronavirus

Dua warga Bangladesh ditipu lelaki dakwa mampu rawat penyakit Covid-19 secara maya

Dakwaan seorang lelaki yang memiliki kemampuan untuk menyembuhkan individu dijangkiti Covid-19 dengan membaca jampi secara maya, sekali

gus mengubati ribuan orang hanya pembobongan.

Presiden Persatuan Pengguna Melayu Malaysia (PPMM) Leftenan Kolonel (Kehormat) Che Hassan Che Johan berkata, perkara ini diketahui selepas pihaknya menerima aduan daripada dua warga Bangladesh yang menjadi mangsa baru-baru ini.

Menurutnya, lelaki berke-

naan turut menawarkan khidmat untuk merawat semua pekerja sebuah kilang di Selangor yang disahkan positif wabak itu, baru-baru ini dengan paket harga berpatutan.

"Dia juga mendakwa boleh merawat penyakit mengikut keadaan dan sejak dari awal lagi kita kesan ia satu pembobongan kerana menjalankan rawatan secara maya

dan mengenakan bayaran tertentu.

"Dengan hanya satu panggilan dalam masa beberapa minit, dia boleh mengetahui jenis penyakit, tahapnya dan kesesuaian pesakit sedangkan ia tidak berlaku pun," katanya kepada Harian Metro.

Menurutnya, PPMM akan membawa isu ini perpuaskan rawatan berkenaan kepada ja-

batan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (JAKIM) dan polis bagi tindakan lanjut bagi memastikan tiada mangsa lain terperdaya.

Katanya, pihaknya juga meminta masyarakat agar lebih berhati-hati dengan sebarang tawaran merugikan, sebaliknya merujuk kepada klinik atau hospital jika berdepan masalah khususnya gejala Covid-19. Semen-

tara itu, Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) Datuk Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad berkata, pihaknya akan meneliti kes terbatib terlebih dahulu sebelum sebarang tindakan diambil.

"Jais akan teliti faktanya dan akan dibawa kejawatkuasa pengawalan akidah untuk penelitian lanjut dan status berkeraan," katanya.

Caj RM100, nasihat elak makan kuning telur

Kuala Lumpur: Guna teknik imbas secara maya dan mampu mengetahui sama ada seseorang individu dijangkiti virus Covid-19 dalam tempoh hanya tiga minit.

Itu tawaran seorang lelaki yang mendakwa mampu mengubati pelbagai penyakit termasuk Covid-19 dengan mengerakkan caj RM100 bagi setiap pesakit.

Mengiklankan perkhidmatannya di media sosial, kegiatan itu terbongkar baru-baru ini apabila dua pekerja warga Bangladesh cuba mendapatkan rawatan dan menyedari auta lelaki itu.

Mereka yang mengesyaki ada sesuatu tidak kena kemudian merujuk kes itu kepada Presiden Persatuan Pengguna Melayu Malaysia (PPMM) Leftenan Kolonel (Kehormat) Che Has-

san Che Johan untuk tindakan lanjut.

Mangsa yang mahu dikenali sebagai Nurul Islam, 27, berkata dia menghubungi lelaki itu untuk mendapatkan rawatan selepas mengalamai demam, batu-batu ini.

"Ketika itu saya bimbang mungkin ia gejala Covid-19 dan mengambil langkah awal untuk mengelak daripada dijangkiti."

"Saya bersama seorang lagi rakan menghubungi lelaki yang kami panggil ustaz itu dan dia meminta wang RM100 setiap seorang untuk memulakan rawatan tanpa perlu berjumlah," katanya ketika diinterview.

Mereka yang mengesyaki ada

Suspek mengiklankan perkhidmatannya di media sosial

kata dia dimaklumkan mengalami penyakit seakan-akan Covid-19 sejak tiga tahun lalu.

Katanya, selepas bayaran dibuat, lelaki berkenaan memaklumkan dia sudah membuat rawatan khusus untuk virus Covid-19 dan sudah dibuang daripada badannya serta-merta.

"Saya terkejut bagaimana dalam tempoh yang begitu cepat, dia boleh membuang virus Covid-19 dan perlu dirawat segera menerusi ustadz jampi secara maya bagi melaksanakan keadaan semakin parah."

"Yang saya tahu, hanya tidak ada penyakit Covid-19, tetapi ustaz itu meminta bayaran RM100 untuk tujuan rawatan."

"Selepas bayaran dibuat, dia menelefon saya dan membaca ayat-ayat tertentu dengan laju yang saya tidak berapa faham," katanya.

Mida, AmBank salur dana buat PKS, MTC bantu proses automasi, digitalisasi

AmBank dengan kerjasama Lembaga Pembangunan Pelaburan Malaysia (Mida) menawarkan geran sehingga RM1 juta kepada syarikat perusahaan kecil dan sederhana (PKS) serta syarikat tahap pertengahan (MTC) menerusi Geran Automasi Pintar Mida (SAG).

Geran itu disalurkan kepada PKS dan MTC layak berdasarkan asas padanan atau 50 peratus daripada keseluruhan jumlah perbelanjaan.

Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Mida, Datuk Azman Mahmud berkata, kerjasama antara dua entiti itu membantu syarikat berkaitan ke arah automasi dan digitalisasi dalam operasi dan proses pengeluaran.

"SAG bukan hanya dapat meningkatkan tahap daya saing dan keupayaan industri Malaysia, malah dapat mengurangkan kebergantungan kepada pekerja asing berkemahiran rendah selain mewujudkan peluang pekerjaan dalam sektor bernilai tambah tinggi."

"Inisiatif SAG adalah sebahagian daripada dana bernilai RM100 juta diperuntukkan di bawah Pelan Jana Semula Ekonomi Negara (Penjana) yang dilancarkan Menteri Kanan dan Menteri Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri (MITI), Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali pada 2 Disember lalu," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Terdahulu, AmBank memeterai perjanjian persefahaman (MoU) dengan Mida untuk menawarkan PKS dan MTC peluang menjadi sebahagian daripada SAG.

Kerjasama antara AmBank dan Mida adalah un-

tuk membantu memperbaiki pengetahuan PKS dan MTC dalam perkara berkaitan automasi dan digitalisasi.

Sementara itu, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Kumpulan AmBank, Datuk Sulaiman Mohd Tahir berkata, syarikat perbankan itu menjadi institusi kewangan pertama bekerjasama dengan Mida untuk menawarkan PKS dan MTC bantuan dalam persekitaran perniagaan yang mencabar ketika ini.

"Menerusi kerjasama ini, kami mampu berkongsi kepakaran dan sumber dengan syarikat berkenaan bagi membantu perniagaan masa depan mereka."

"Inisiatif ini menjadi sebahagian daripada program AmBank BizRACE untuk membangunkan pelanggan dalam beberapa aspek utama Revolusi Industri 4.0 (IR 4.0), digitalisasi dan industri halal selaras dengan

agenda kelestarian AmBank," katanya.

Bagi membolehkan PKS dan MTC memohon SAG, syarikat berkenaan perlu terbabit aktiviti pengeluaran atau perkhidmatan sejak 12 bulan lalu sebelum dipertimbangkan memperoleh geran berkenaan.

Untuk memenuhi syarat mendapatkan insentif itu, mesin automatik, peralatan atau perisian dibeli melalui SAG mesti digunakan secara langsung dalam rantai nilai syarikat bagi meningkatkan produktiviti dan kecekapan.

Penambahbaikan dinilai berdasarkan pelbagai kriteria seperti pengurangan pekerja tidak mahir, jam kerja, kadar kecacatan dan peningkatan jumlah pengeleuaran.

Beyond surface solutions

Klang stakeholders are fed up with poor road conditions, many of which are caused by private contractors involved in major infrastructure projects. Last year alone, the municipal council responded to 1,854 complaints of potholes on 429 roads. >2&3

UNEVEN surfaces due to crumbling asphalt, sudden potholes caused by heavy construction vehicles or sinkholes from water infiltration are among Klang's unerving for motorists. And those who drive on them are increasingly turning to their motorcycles as they could cause less damage to vehicles than the road. The problem seems to be worse now with more drivers opting to use two-wheeled vehicles for convenience.

Local roads surfaces are especially prone to damage as they have to withstand the weight of heavy vehicles from brick kilns on the one hand and heavy machinery from construction projects on the other. In fact, in a survey involving heavy construction vehicles, Klang Municipal Council Works Department (JKR) said it is likely that the responsibility of maintaining roads in Klang lies on the private contractor who carried out the project or that is the reason the condition of roads on these stretches is not good.

Most motorists and the public have agreed that the condition of roads in Klang is far from ideal as the uneven surfaces often causes vehicles to skid when going down traffic灯 to karters, says Edward Alijendra.

"We asked that construction companies that have secured tendering of the roads from JKR to build them in accordance with international standards and conditions are to prove that the roads will be able to withstand heavy traffic灯 to karters," he says.

"I understand that construction companies spouse the bid for the con-

Member CV Wong said construction companies that have secured tenders are proactive in maintaining the roads but they are not always consistent, he added.

"Local contractors in Klang and surrounding areas, I have seen that thousands of taxpayers' money is spent on roads and it was their right to have good roads," he said.

Residential roads affected

Social activist Mohamed Husain Hussain said the poor surfaces still paper restorative work on the roads.

He wants to spend more on maintenance work on residential roads and it was a financial burden, he said.

People have to spend more on vehicles to drive carefully because there were many potholes and holes and it was a financial burden,

"If the road owners under the jurisdiction of JKR and MPK do not maintain the roads and the drivers are not careful, the accidents will happen due to bad maintenance," he said.

"While the same drivers, all they want is smooth roads and if they get hole, others can sustain severe injuries," he said.

"Motorists are having to cope with bad roads and they are not happy with the condition of roads," he said.

Wong reiterates that the condition of residential roads is not good.

It is the road names under the jurisdiction of JKR and MPK that the authorities are failing to maintain properly, he said, adding that taxpayers' want roads to be in good condition.

Selangor MCA deputy youth chief Haris Sabri said the poor condition of roads in Klang was due to lack of maintenance as well as the negligence of contractors.

"Several potholes as well as a road that has been declared as a dead end were still paper restorative work," he said.

"There are traffic light poles and signage that are not functioning," he said.

He urges MPK to take action to maintain the roads soon.

"Klang residents are asking for better roads," he said.

He wants to improve the condition of roads in Klang.

Council's unsung heroes patch up potholes night and day

POTHOLE Ranger Misron Kasim has been repairing bad roads for more than 35 years.

Misron, 56, works at Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Engineering Department's maintenance team.

The father of six, who is MPK pothole ranger team's unit leader, job scope involves keeping signboards updated, removing shrubs, which can cause obstructions as well as road maintenance.

The Kapar-born Misron derives satisfaction knowing he is keeping the roads safe for motorists.

He is assisted by road miller M. Ravi Kumar, 37, and flagman Kumaran Vengumany, 38.

"The three of us go out to fix small potholes. We use cold mix asphalt, the most basic of asphalt that does not require heating.

"It is used to repair uneven road surfaces, cracks and potholes," he said.

Ravi said heavy rain was one of the reasons for road damage.

MPK Engineering Department director Zamri Othman said the pothole rangers often repaired and

resurfaced roads in the wee hours of the morning.

"Our men work hard on the graveyard shift and people often do not see them but they help keep the municipality roads safe and contribute to smooth traffic movement."

Zamri said MPK was working

round the clock to patch up potholes while private construction firms and Klang JKR would be told to begin road repairs too.

Klang JKR district engineer Syaharidanisman Mohd Johanis said the department's Road Unit would conduct an immediate survey and follow up with prioritised repairs based on the severity and danger posed.

"Our men will work to repair all roads that are damaged," he added.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) Engineering Department (road and bridges section) engineer Azman Wahid said the council had spent RM1.65mil in 2019 for road repairs and RM1.63mil last year to fix potholes and resurfacing.

"In 2020, our workmen had to respond to 1,854 pothole complaints involving 429 roads.

It was challenging as October, November and December saw continuous rain that damaged roads.

"Utility companies often dig up the road and fail to repave according to the required standard, leading to uneven surfaces," he added.

SELANGOR government and mobile navigation app Waze are in collaboration to identify potholes in the state so repairs can be done immediately.

State local government, public transport and new village development committee chairman Ng Sze Han is encouraging motorists who use the app to report potholes they see during their journey.

"Roads dotted with potholes are unacceptable. I urge the people to lodge a report through Waze. Other approaches would be to inform the respective local council, area councillor and even the state assemblyman."

"Bad roads are unacceptable. People must raise the matter with their local councils and it must be acted on swiftly. I advise all road users to be alert on the road," he said.

Ng also asked that all local authorities monitor council roads.

"If the roads come under the jurisdiction of the district Public Works Department (JKR) or private construction companies who are in the process of building a structure, the council must inform them and ensure the roads are repaired for people's safety," he said.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) Engineering Department (road and bridges section) engineer Azman Wahid said Waze was an effective way to report potholes.

Azman said while potholes were a bane, reporting them swiftly was key.

In November last year, Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari

informed the state assembly that Selangor documented 52,295 reports by road users on potholes through Waze between January 2019 and September last year.

Amirudin said 37,130 reports were on potholes on roads maintained by local councils and 10,219 were federal roads maintained by JKR.

Another 4,553 reports were on Selangor JKR roads and 393 on roads under the district land office.

Ampang businesses, worksites penalised for violating SOP

A JOINT operation to check on compliance of Covid-19 standard operating procedures during the movement control order period saw stern action taken against several businesses in Ampang.

The operation, led by Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ), involved officers from the Gombak and Hulu Langat district health offices, police and the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB).

MPAJ president Mohd Fauzi Mohd Yatim said CIDB officers issued stop-work orders for two worksites for failing to provide adequate accommodation for workers, among other offences under the CIDB Act 1994 (Act 520).

He added that four compounds were issued for various offences after checking eight premises comprising factories and building sites.

"Several operators failed to enforce physical distancing, wearing of face masks as well as failing to take the temperature of workers," he said.

Fauzi said such checks were vital to send the message that the authorities were serious in breaking the chain of Covid-19 infections.

"There are premises that take the easy way out by not observing the SOPs, but overall most do,"

he said.

Fauzi added that as cases were increasing in Ampang as well as in the whole of Selangor, residents and business operators must realise the importance of such protocols.

"They should be consistent in carrying out sanitisation or disinfection at their premises, especially high-risk touchpoints such as door handles, lifts and escalator railings."

MPAJ's Covid-19 task force has

disinfected 1,331 locations around the municipality as well as checked SOP compliance since the start of the MCO.

High touchpoint areas such as playgrounds, bus stops, commercial areas and markets have been undergoing frequent inspections and cleaning.

Checks by MPAJ at 1,879 premises between April 1 and Nov 30 found only 36.8% of businesses fully complied with the National Security Council's SOP.

Guidelines for businesses allowed to operate during MCO

LOCAL councils have been posting notices on their social media platforms to alert the public on what they can and cannot do since the latest movement control order was announced.

There are also notices on revised business hours, guidelines and procedures for online transactions as well as ways to lodge complaints.

Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) posted a graphic on its social media platforms to notify the public on the type of businesses in Selangor that were allowed to operate during MCO as well as the permitted operating hours.

However, the graphic was removed to allow for amendments due to several changes.

Senior Minister (Security

Cluster) Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob later announced that self-service launderettes and optical shops were allowed to operate.

These businesses listed as essential services were given the green light to operate by the National Security Council (MKN), International Trade and Industry Ministry (Miti) and Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry.

Companies involved in the retail, wholesale and distribution aspects of businesses that are allowed to operate during the MCO will need to apply for a registration confirmation letter from Miti's Covid-19 Intelligent Management System portal via <https://notification.miti.gov.my>.

Most businesses are allowed to operate from 6am to 8pm.

There are just too many in the queue and lab technicians are tired too

PETALING JAYA: Some Malaysians are facing challenges in getting tested for Covid-19, especially as more people – concerned over the rising daily figures of those infected – go for screening.

Hazlin Aminudin is one such person. She said she tried calling the Health Ministry hotline for several days after she started developing symptoms for Covid-19, but found it busy.

"It started with a sore throat and fever, and then a runny nose," said the mother of one.

"Knowing that this could possibly be a symptom of Covid-19, I called the ministry to know what my next step should be."

"I tried calling the hotline for three days, but no one picked up. So I called the Sungai Buloh hospital but was told that it was best to contact the ministry first," said the 35-year-old.

"Now, my son also has a fever and is coughing," she said.

"And I am feeling extra anxious," Hazlin said, adding that her family previously visited her mother-in-

law in Sungai Petani after being apart for five months.

Hazlin, who is in the media industry, said going to a private clinic for a test was beyond what she could afford.

"For now, my family and I are under quarantine at home as our symptoms are mild."

According to the Health Ministry, a person who is deemed a suspected Covid-19 case is someone who meets the clinical criteria (displays symptoms) and epidemiological criteria (a close contact or has a travel history to red zones).

The ministry also recently issued a circular which stated that all close contacts would have to undergo home quarantine, while only close contacts with symptoms would need to go for screening.

A man who only wants to be known as Chong said he was also anxious to get tested after a family member, who lives in the same household, tested positive for Covid-19.

"I needed to know my results so that my close contacts, such as my colleagues, would know what to do. Their families will be affected by my results."

"I tried to make an appointment with a private lab but according to the rules, if I am a close contact of a confirmed Covid-19 patient, I cannot be tested (at a private clinic)."

"I couldn't proceed with the test and the lab told me I have to go home and wait for the ministry's call," said the 40-year-old who works in an administrative position.

Chong then went to the private hospital where his family member was tested positive, and tried to make an appointment there.

"My request was rejected because it was fully booked. The person in-charge said that close contacts are meant to wait at home for the Health Ministry's instructions."

"However, after coaxing her, she agreed. Thankfully, I was tested negative," he said.

Chong said the call from the ministry did come eventually.

"The person on the other line told us to undergo home quarantine for 10 days."

"After the 10 days, we will need to go to the nearby district health department to get a release letter," he said, adding that there was no mention of a quarantine wristband.

Ahmad Munir, 58, found out that he could possibly be Covid-19 positive when a friend became infected.

"Just to be sure, I arranged for a test. I went to a government hospital but was told to go to the district health department instead."

"However, I decided to go to a private hospital."

"The Health Ministry didn't call me up or said I had to go through contact tracing. If my friend hadn't called me, I wouldn't have known I could be a suspected Covid-19 case."

Association of Private Hospitals of Malaysia (APHM) president Datuk Dr Kuljit Singh said private hospitals' labs were getting overwhelmed with requests for Covid-19 tests.

"We are becoming busier. We can still cope, but the waiting time to get the results may vary."

"At one point, you are able to get your result within 24 hours, but now it may go beyond that."

"However, I don't think it's a situation where a person cannot get a test in any private hospital for a whole week. Screenings are still available because almost every pri-

vate hospital offers the test," he added.

Malaysian Public Health Physicians Association president Datuk Dr Zainal Arifin Omar said it might be more challenging for Malaysians to book Covid-19 tests at this point in time.

"There are too many people asking to be tested. Moreover, some may be turned away by public health facilities because they may not fulfil the criteria by the Health Ministry to be tested," he said.

"They could be only casual contacts of confirmed cases."

A frontliner, who declined to be named, said that personnel who conduct the tests were "suffering".

"I am not sure if every hospital in the country is overwhelmed with people asking to be tested, but those in the red zones are," he said.

"We never expected the numbers to be this high."

Labs, he said, were doubling up on manpower and working round the clock.

"The frontliners aren't the only ones working hard," he said.

"The backliners (lab technicians) are pushing hard to get test results out as fast as they can, too."

THE Selangor government intends to purchase five million doses of Covid-19 vaccine for the people in the state, an effort most welcomed by the federal government and the Ministry of Health (MoH).

Mentri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the state government's intention would reduce the federal government's burden in purchasing the vaccine for the people.

"During the National Security Council (Emergency) meeting, Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin was made aware of Selangor's intention, which was also welcomed by the federal government as their burden (to purchase the vaccine) will be alleviated.

"So far, only the Selangor and Sarawak governments intend to buy the vaccine for the people in their respective states," he told a virtual press conference yesterday.

Amirudin said he would make a further announcement on the matter once they received the endorsement from the MoH.

He said the state government would collaborate with the federal government through the National Immunisation Plan to prevent overlapping in the efforts to address Covid-19.

The state government would also ensure all target groups would receive the vaccine as they have important roles to play in reviving the state's economy, he added. — Bernama

Lower FDIs in Selangor amid travel restrictions

The state was targeted to achieve RM12b of investments in 2020, without including the impact of the pandemic

FOREIGN direct investments (FDIs) in Selangor is expected to drop this year due to all the restrictions in place since the enforcement of the various Movement Control Orders (MCOs) which has hindered business meetings and discussions among potential partners.

Selangor's investment, industry and commerce, and small and medium enterprises (SMEs) state executive councillor Datuk Teng Chang Khim said global uncertainties due to the Covid-19 pandemic will also continue to hamper foreign investors' appetite in choosing the state as its base.

Teng said as of September last year, RM8 billion of FDIs in the state were approved — all from the manufacturing sector, while the data on services sectors are still being processed.

"But for 2021, the challenges will be greater compared to last year because the results of 2020 were dependent on our efforts in 2019. In 2020, nothing much could be done as we did not have a single mission to attract foreign investors last year, except one that was held before the first MCO in March."

"So, we predict the FDI for 2021 would not be so encouraging," Teng said in a virtual media confe-

rence after announcing the success of E-Bazar 11.11 Mega Sales Campaign yesterday.

In October, Teng announced that the state would only raise in RM8.5 billion of FDIs in 2020, which is half of the RM17 billion achieved in 2019.

Selangor was earlier targeted to achieve RM12 billion of investments in 2020, without including the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

"But, that does not mean Selangor took a back seat during the last MCO. We have shifted all the phy-

sical programmes online, including the discussion with investors.

"This included all the elements in the Selangor International Business Summit, which utilised digitisation throughout the programmes," he added.

Due to the Covid-19 outbreak that became prevalent last March, the federal government implemented the MCO, closing the national borders which halted major economic activities.

Even though the government eased many regulations and restrictions in May and June,

which allowed many to go back to work, the borders remain closed until now.

Some countries including Singapore and Hong Kong have tried to implement a bubble travel which allowed citizens to travel between cities that were deemed green zones.

However, the plan was cancelled due to the subsequent wave of the coronavirus at the respective green zones.

In Malaysia, another round of MCO was reinforced last week due to the spike in Covid-19 cases,

with a new record high of more than 4,000 infections reported in a day.

"For this year, we really cannot predict what the numbers of FDIs would look like, as we cannot even move now," Teng said.

Nevertheless, he said one of the state's biggest expo this year — the Selangor Aviation Show — which will showcase aviation related activities, is still on schedule to take place on April 2.

"But again, this will solely depend on the current MCO enforcement. We will still monitor the situation and see if the event will be continued or postponed to end of the year."

Meanwhile, Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari announced that Selangor has gained RM1.04 billion in ripple effect to its economy through the two-month E-Bazar 11.11 Mega Sales Campaign conducted from Oct 26 to Dec 15 last year.

He said the amount includes a total of RM32.1 million of direct sales generated through the RM2 million in vouchers channelled by the state to e-commerce merchants, involving 73,791 players.

Amirudin said the state government would not initiate any policies to tax merchants, as the priority remains in digitalisation growth among the SMEs.

"It's too early to tax them. But we will let this grow first. Maybe in the future we will discuss with certain organisations or tax agencies so the state will also benefit and get an income from it," he said.

部分巴生港池花园早市的小贩，今早在巴生市区流动小贩公会主席叶金发号召下，响应不满心声和围堵。他们称，市议会对重开早市的“U转再U转”政策，让小贩吃了许多苦和大亏；尤其是许多趁年关将近，进了许多货想要摆卖的小贩损失惨重，亏足本。一名菜贩形容，她向金马仑企业部汇报：值逾萬蔬菜如何賣掉？

吉隆坡士拉央批发公市的批发商拿了价值逾1万令吉的蔬菜，如今市议会一声令下早市又不能复业，她的这批菜被迫留在冷藏房内，且保质期只剩多只有三四天，她不知有何管道能把这批菜卖出，损失惨重。

也有水果小贩向记者出示收藏在冰箱的大批火龙果照片，形容早市在短期内不能开业，这批火龙果只好任由烂掉丢弃。

葉金發：巴生早市说开又不能开，令许多进了货的小贩损失惨重。

巴生市议会卫生小组委员李富豪向《南洋商报》记者披露，卫生部做此决定，说明了医疗体系已无法负荷目前庞大求医需求。

用者只需进入手机应用程序的“Helpdesk”，接着点击“Start”，寻找“ I am Covid-19 positive and waiting a call from MOH”，接下来便可填写个人资料及联系方式，便完成通报工作。

他也呼吁卫生部切勿放弃全面检测密切接触者，因为无症状者或形成下一个“无头公案”新感染群，巴生县社区传播快速便是例证。

无症状接触者投诉不获检测

李富豪也提到，无症状密切接触者因没有卫生部证明，导致需承担昂贵检测费、无法享有隔离假期等。

他曾亲自接到投诉案例，

他说，卫生部放弃全面检测密切接触者的举措或有 2 个原因，即（一）医疗体系严重崩溃，无法应对庞大需求，以及（二）资金不足，以致没有足够资源担起检测负担。

一名菜贩形容，她向

金马仑菜农和吉隆坡士拉央批发公市的批发商，拿了价值逾1万令吉的蔬菜等，如今市议会一声令下早市又不能复业。

过保鲜期难卖损失大

“我的这批菜被迫囤在冷藏房内，且保鲜期至多只有三四天，我不知有何管道能把这批菜销出，损失重大。”

也有水果小贩在记者会展示收藏在冰箱的大量龙珠果照片，形容早市在短期内不能开业，这批龙珠果只好任由烂掉丢弃。

巴生市议会从本月13日至26日的行管令一开始，鉴于巴生县疫情严重，因此把露天早市和国安会宣布不能营业的夜市归类为同一性质，结果引起业者批评，要求让早市小贩能开市谋生计。

一些市议员也为民请命极力争取，加上掌管地方政府事务的雪州行政议员黄思汉，于13日晚间在个人脸书专页宣布，雪州境内的早市都可营业，前提是在防疫措施方面需到位和控管人流，把一切交由地方政府以早市地点和防疫管控为定夺。

巴生市议会进而探讨，让旗下9座早市分阶段从本周复市的做法，其中4座原定先于今日复市；不料昨晚临时喊停，让许多准备在今明复市的小贩无所适从。
