LZS sumbang makanan warga emas positif Covid-19

SHAH ALAM: Makan nasi dengan hanya berlaukan kicap dan telur sahaja demi meneruskan kelangsungan hidup.

Itulah keadaan pasangan warga emas bersama dua cucunya selama lebih seminggu akibat pandemik Covid-19 sebelum Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) hadir memberikan bantuan semalam.

Menceritakan nasib minimnya mereka sekeluarga, Jatimah Mahat, 58, berkata, tiga ahli keluarganya iaitu anak perempuannya, menantu dan cucunya berusia tujuh bulan dibawa menjalani pemeriksaan dan kuarantin Covid-19 di Hospital Sungai Buloh (HSB).

• Dia yang tinggal di Batu 13, Kampung Tengah, Puchong itu berkata, jangkitan tersebut diperoleh anak perempuannya di kilang tempat kerjanya di USJ, Subang Jaya.

“Susulan kejadian ini, kami sekeluarga yang merupakan kontak rapat terpaksa menjalani kuarantin di rumah sehingga

menyukarkan mendapatkan bekalan makanan. Malah, saya juga terpaksa menjaga suami yang berusia 83 tahun yang uzur akibat sakit tua selain dua cucunya berusia tujuh dan 11 tahun.

“Saya bekerja pengawal keselamatan di sebuah sekolah

dan tidak dibenarkan kerja oleh pihak majikan susulan merupakan kontak rapat.

“Oleh demikian, sepanjang tempoh seminggu lalu, kami hanya makan nasi dengan lauk kicap dan telur sahaja,” katanya ketika dihubungi di sini, semalam.

Terdahulu, tular kisah keluarga ini di laman sosial apabila LZS turun menyalurkan bantuan kepada keluarga tersebut.

Ber cerita lanjut, Jatimah berkata, dia sememangnya menerima bantuan dari LZS sebanyak RM400 sebulan dan sewa rumah RM750 juga ditanggung pihak berkenaan sejak 2010.

“Namun, saya bersyukur apabila kisah kami sekeluarga tular

Tolak adakan sidang khas Parlimen

Timbalan Speaker Dewan Rakyat tidak bersetuju dengan gesaan itu berhubung proklamasi darurat

Ahli Parlimen Pangrang, Datuk Seri Azalina Othman Said menolak permintaan Setiausaha Agung UMNO, Datuk Seri Ahmad Maslan yang meminta ahli Parlimen UMNO menyokong gesaan supaya sidang khas Parlimen diadakan berhubung proklamasi darurat.

Katanya, sebagai Timbalan Speaker Dewan Rakyat, beliau adalah individu yang berpegang teguh kepada demokrasi berparlimen.

“Ia wajar ditekankan bahawa Fasal 14(1) ordinan yang baru

saja dimasyurkan oleh Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah baru-baru ini memperuntukkan bahawa Parlimen hanya boleh dipanggil sebagai mana yang difikirkan sesuai oleh Yang di-Pertuan Agong.

“Oleh itu, pada hmat saya, kebarangkalian Yang di-Pertuan Agong memanggil satu persidangan Parlimen dalam masa terdekat ini ataupun membatalkan proklamasi dan ordinan tersebut sama sekali sangatlah tipis.

“Atas sebab-sebab yang di nyatakan di atas, maka dengan segala hormatnya saya menolak dan tidak bersetuju dengan per mohanan persetujuan ke atas isu tersebut seperti mana yang diminta oleh YB Pontian melalui surat 18 Januari 2021,” katanya dalam surat yang diantar kepada Ahmad pada Selasa.

Sementara itu, Azalina turut mencadangkan kepada Seri Pa-

duka Baginda supaya satu Majlis Khas Parlimen (bipartisan) serta memohon wakil UMNO dapat dilantik secepat mungkin ke dalam Jawatankuasa Khas Bebas Darurat yang bakal ditubuhkan nanti.

“Mencadangkan kepada Yang di-Pertuan Agong untuk menubuhkan satu Majlis Khas Parlimen (bipartisan) bagi mensiasati Seri Paduka Baginda berkenaan hasil pemantauan, penilaian dan perbincangan isu-isu berkaitan hak asasi dan kebebasan rakyat di bawah Perlembagaan Persekutuan.

“Majlis tersebut boleh terdiri daripada ahli-ahli Dewan Rak-

yat dan Dewan Negara daripada parti kerajaan dan pembangkang serta diberi kuasa untuk memanggil rakyat bagi memberikan pandangan, input dan cadangan.

“Semua ahli Dewan Rakyat dan Dewan Negara daripada UMNO yang merupakan ahli dalam Kumpulan Rentas Parti Parlimen Malaysia (KRPPM) dan juga Jawatankuasa Pilihan Khas (JPK) masih boleh pihaknya aktif supaya aktiviti-aktiviti KRPPM dan PJK masih terus giat dijalankan dan diteruskan.

“Ini memandangkan pada 12 Januari 2021, Yang di-Pertua Dewan Rakyat telah mengumumkan bahawa semua aktiviti kaukus, KRPPM atau PJK yang telah ditubuhkan masih boleh diteruskan,” katanya.

“Marilah kita jadikan Parlimen sebagai contoh untuk semua rakyat Malaysia, tanpa mengira kaum, agama, politik, mahupun kawasan, untuk bersatu demi usaha menyelamatkan Malaysia daripada wabak Covid-19,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

Lim Kit Siang menyambut baik gesaan supaya sidang khas Parlimen diadakan memandangkan situasi Covid-19 di negara ini semakin buruk.

Ahli Parlimen Iskandar Puteri itu berkata, ia selaras dengan Seksyen 14(1)(b) Ordinan Darurat pertama pada 14 Januari lalu.

“Atas sebab ini, saya menyokong seruan supaya sidang Parlimen khas mengenai Covid-19 dipanggil, yang selari dengan Seksyen 14(1)(b) Ordinan Darurat pertama pada 14 Januari 2021, yang menyatakan ‘Parlimen hendaklah dipanggil, diprorog dan dibubar kan pada suatu tarikh yang difikirkan sesuai oleh Yang di-Pertuan Agong.

“Marilah kita jadikan Parlimen sebagai contoh untuk semua rakyat Malaysia, tanpa mengira kaum, agama, politik, mahupun kawasan, untuk bersatu demi usaha menyelamatkan Malaysia daripada wabak Covid-19,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

Hospital Bersepadu 2.0 dijangka beroperasi sepenuhnya pada 24 Januari ini bagi merawat pesakit Co-

vid-19 kategori tiga, empat dan lima untuk distabilkan sebelum dibantarkan mendapatkan rawatan rapi di hospital.

Langkah itu bertujuan merawat pesakit Covid-19 kategori satu dan dua di PKRC MAEPS 2.0 yang tiba-tiba berubah kepada kategori tiga atau empat dan lima.

Hospital itu yang terletak di Dewan B menyediakan fasiliti yang sama dengan hospital lain, dilengkapi 30 katil bagi pesakit kategori tiga dan empat, selain sebuah khemah di luar dewan untuk kes transit unit rawatan rapi dengan 10 katil. - Bernama

Tiada wang, terputus makanaan ketika kuarantin

Kisah pasangan warga emas, dua cucu yang kehabisan wang dapat perhatian ramai pihak

“Sekarang saya langsung tiada wang di tangan. Semuanya habis digunakan bayar tambang Grab (e-hailing) untuk ulang-alik ke hospital sebelum ini,” kata Jatimah Mahat, 58, dari Kampung Tengah Batu 13 di sini.

Bagaikan sudah jatuh ditimpah tangga, menurut Jatimah, dia dan suaminya, Kastari Sirat, 83, bersama dua cucu terpaksa menjalani kuarantin di rumah kerana merupakan kontak rapat sebelum disahkan positif Covid-19.

Pada 7 Januari lalu, katanya, anak keduanya disahkan positif Covid-19 sebelum dimaklumkan mantan dan seorang cucunya yang berusia tujuh bulan turut positif virus berkenaan.

“Disebabkan menjadi kontak rapat kepada anak, saya, suami dan dua cucu membuat ujian saringan dan dipakaikan gelang pink serta diminta kuarantin di rumah.

“Keperitan bermula apabila empat anak saya dan menantu juga terpaksa kuarantin dan tiada siapa dapat membelikan makanan apabila kami terputus bekalan sejak seminggu lalu,” katanya kepada *Sinar Harian* pada Selasa.

Jatimah berkata, sepatutnya dia, suami dan dua cucu berusia tujuh dan 11 tahun ke hospital pada Isnin

untuk membuka gelang pink tersebut.

Bagaimanapun, katanya, dia terkejut apabila dimaklumkan mereka berempat positif Covid-19 dan perlu terus kuarantin di rumah.

“Saya teruja kerana doktor beritahu jika tak ada terima panggilan telefon daripada hospital pada Sabtu dan Ahad, bermakna sudah bebas daripada virus serta akan dibuka gelang pink semalam (Isnin).

“Rupanya kami masih positif virus itu dan perlu terus pakai gelang pink. Saya risau juga kerana sejak seminggu lalu demam dan kini hanya menunggu panggilan telefon daripada pihak hospital,” katanya.

Sementara itu, kisah Jatimah yang terputus bekalan makanaan mendapat perhatian pihak masjid dan penduduk berhampiran yang berkunjung ke rumahnya dengan membawa makanaan asas beberapa hari lalu.

“Ada orang masjid dan beberapa individu hantar makanaan, Al-

hamdulillah, cuma saya wang sekarang.

“Semua duit yang ada habis digunakan untuk tambang pengangkutan ulang-alik ke hospital sebelum ini. Saya pula sudah tidak bekerja sebagai pengawal keselamatan sejak mula kuarantin pada 7 Januari lalu,” katanya yang meruakan penerima bantuan asnf sebanyak RM400 dan bantuan sewa rumah sebanyak RM750 daripada Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS).

Sementara itu, LZS menerusi satu kenyataan memaklumkan Ketua Penolong Amil Kariah Masjid bersama Biro Kebajikan Masjid Nurul Iman, Kampung Tengah, Puchong sudah mengunjungi pasangan warga emas berkenaan bagi menyalurkan bantuan.

Katanya, bantuan itu diberikan sementara menunggu bantuan kewang bulanan diproses.

“Kami mendoakan agar mereka semua diberi kesembuhan dan bebas dari pandemik ini. Terima kasih kepada seluruh pembayar zakat,” katanya.

PM pays a visit to MAEPS 2.0 Integrated Hospital

KUALA LUMPUR: Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin visited the Malaysia Agro Exposition Park Serdang (MAEPS) 2.0 Integrated Hospital, near here, and spent some time meeting with patients recuperating there.

The Prime Minister, who arrived at 5.20pm yesterday, was accompanied by Health Minister, Datuk Seri Dr Adham Baba, to a closed-door briefing by Selangor Health director-cum-Central Region Covid-19 Unified Command Centre commander, Datuk Dr Sh'ari Ngadiman.

Also present were Selangor Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari and National Disaster Management Agency (Nadma) director-general, Datuk Dr Aminuddin Hassim.

After the briefing, the Prime Minister spent time visiting and meeting with patients at the Covid-19 Quarantine and Low-Risk Treatment Centre (PKRC) before touring the hospital.

The Integrated Hospital 2.0 will start operating on Jan 24 to treat Covid-19 patients in categories three, four and five to be stabilised before they are sent for intensive treatment there.

The move is aimed at treating Covid-19 patients from the PKRC MAEPS 2.0 in categories one and two who suddenly fall into categories three, four and five.

The hospital located in Hall B will provide the same facilities as in other hospitals and is equipped with 30 beds for patients in categories three and four while outside the hall, a tent for transit cases at the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) with 10 beds.

The PKRC MAEPS 2.0 will also receive Covid-19 patients in categories one and two who have recovered from categories three, four and five while being treated at hospitals, as well as patients from Johor, Melaka, Negeri Sembilan and the Klang Valley. — Bernama

Dark road makes driving dangerous

Sg Buloh residents say street light problem unresolved despite complaints over two years

THOSE living in and around Kampung Desa Aman, Sungai Buloh, have had to put up with pitch-dark roads for the past two years because of lack of proper street lights.

Sri Aman Heights residents said the complaints they had lodged with the authorities since 2018 seemed to have fallen on deaf ears.

StarMetro visited the area after 8pm and discovered that the particular stretch from Jalan Kuala Selangor to the railway bridge tunnel and up to the access road in Jalan Utama was dangerously dark. The situation was made worse by heavy rain.

Lorries ply Jalan Utama, which is a double-lane road near an industrial area. The street leads up to Sri Aman Heights.

Tan Hak Sieu, 67, said the authorities constantly passed the buck to one another since the first email was sent by Sri Aman Heights Residents Association (Sahra).

"We first sent a complaint to Selangor Municipal Council (MPS)



in 2018, because we thought that since the affected area was after the railway tunnel, it would be under MPS' jurisdiction.

"But the council took a while to get back to us, and when they did, they said it was under Petaling Jaya City Council's (MBPJ) jurisdiction.

"Then in 2019, MBPJ replied to

us saying that they had no budget to repair the street lights.

"MBPJ told us to lodge a complaint with the Public Works Department (JKR)," he told StarMetro.

In 2019, Tan's complaint was sent to the Selangor JKR office.

"An officer replied saying the

location fell under the Petaling district JKR office or the federal maintenance division and funds were needed to repair the lights.

"The officer also said the Selangor JKR electric division would apply for additional funds to repair the street lights. There was no follow-up after that.

"We even enquired with a contractor working on the MRT 2 project at the location, and they informed us that it was 'out of their work area' and we should go back to JKR."

"Until today, nothing has been done," said Tan.

The Sahra member said the road was most dangerous at night during rain when visibility was extremely poor.

"This is also a flood-prone area.

"Public safety is neglected.

"Someone has to be responsible for making sure the public is safe," he said.

Bukit Lanjan assemblyman Elizabeth Wong said she would look into the problem and find out which agency's jurisdiction it fell under.

"It is a service road, so it should fall under MPS.

"If that is the case, MPS has to apply to Tenaga Nasional Bhd to repair the lights.

"However, it often involves multi-agencies but it can be done.

"If we look at the map of the area, the jurisdiction of MPS, MBPJ and Shah Alam City Council intersects," she added.

New hawker centre welcomes relocated food operators

TWELVE hawkers have moved in as the first group of food operators at the newly opened Puchong Permai Hawker Centre in Puchong.

They comprise hawkers from the Puchong Permai roundabout, B40 individuals who are residents of apartments adopted by Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ), as well as Puchong residents.

The centre was built by MBSJ to relocate and house hawkers in the Puchong Permai vicinity in a systematic and centralised manner.

Selangor public health, unity, women empowerment and family committee chairman Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud presented the 12 hawkers with kiosks sponsored by MBSJ. One of them also received entrepreneur assistance worth RM4,800.

Present to witness the handover was Subang Jaya mayor Noraini Roslan.

"Construction of the Puchong Permai Hawker Centre started on July 1, 2020 and cost RM280,230."

said MBSJ Corporate and Strategic Management Department deputy director Azfarizal Abdul Rashid in a statement.

The hawker centre with a proper roof has 64 trading lots, each measuring 3m x 3m in size.

"MBSJ has also provided kiosks measuring 1.8m x 0.9m each as a facility for the hawkers.

"There is also ample parking space and a playground for children," said Azfarizal.

He also highlighted that the Puchong Permai Hawker Centre was strategically located along Persiaran Puchong Permai, a busy main road.

"The hawker centre is also located next to a popular weekly farmers market.

"The former Uptown Puchong site nearby will be developed as a food court and a football field this year.

"We hope the hawkers who are relocated here will benefit from the facilities offered.



The Puchong Permai Hawker Centre sited between the flats and playground is strategically located along the main road of Persiaran Puchong Permai.

"At the same time, we hope that there will be less complaints and traffic congestion at the Puchong Permai roundabout due to illegal hawker stalls there," he said.

He reminded hawkers to comply with the rules or face action.

A protest was held last month when MBSJ enforcement officers demolished five illegal

hawker stalls near the Puchong Permai roundabout.

There were 36 illegal stalls located along Jalan Tagwa in the township.

Of the total, 27 sold food and beverages, while others sold fruits, flowers and general goods.

MBSJ said the location was not suitable as a hawker site and that the hawkers breached their temporary permit conditions.

The hawker stalls were also located on road reserves and the stalls had permanent structures.

According to MBSJ, the hawkers continued to operate despite two notices issued by MBSJ for them to demolish the illegal structures themselves.

MBSJ said it had plans for an infrastructure upgrade at the affected road and roundabout and two briefings were held to update hawkers on the relocation exercise to the Puchong Permai Hawker Centre.

'Transforming expo park into a quarantine facility in 3 days no small feat'

KUALA LUMPUR

TAN Sri Muhyiddin Yassin visited the Malaysia Agro Exposition Park Serdang (MAEPS) 2.0 Integrated Hospital, near here, yesterday evening.

The prime minister, who arrived at 5.20pm, was accompanied by Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr Adham Baba. He was giv-

en a closed-door briefing by Selangor Health director-cum-Central Region Covid-19 Unified Command Centre commander Datuk Dr Sh'ari Ngadiman.

Present were Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Sharif and National Disaster Management Agency director-general Datuk Dr Aminuddin Hassim.

After the briefing, Muhyiddin spent time visiting and meeting

patients at the Covid-19 Quarantine and Low-Risk Treatment Centre (PKRC) before touring the hospital.

On his Facebook post, Muhyiddin said he was impressed by the efforts and commitment of all frontliners from the various agencies to ensure the PKRC could facilitate those seeking treatment and being quarantined there.

"What has been done by MAEPS to transform the expo park into a PKRC in three days, starting with just 3,100 beds, is not a small feat. It's extraordinary."

"Seven halls have been converted and they are equipped to accommodate a maximum of 10,000 beds with 9,200 of them filled to date."

"This facility is also being upgraded in phases. Once this is done, the facility can treat 30 high-risk Covid-19 patients, and 10 patients on ventilators, who need oxygen support."

Muhyiddin also said he had the chance to meet several of the frontliners at the PKRC.

"I'm proud of them as they are very responsible, committed and patient in executing their duties to look after the welfare of the patients and to ensure they have the best treatment."

He said he prayed that Covid-19 patients would stay strong while undergoing this trying time and for their speedy recovery.

"To all the frontliners, my prayers are with you. May you have the patience and strength in this fight against Covid-19."

The MAEPS 2.0 Integrated Hos-

pital will start operating on Jan 24 to treat Covid-19 patients, who are in categories three, four and five. They will be stabilised at the facility before being sent for intensive treatment at hospitals.

The move is aimed at treating Covid-19 patients from the PKRC MAEPS 2.0 in categories one and two who suddenly fall into categories three, four and five.

The hospital, located in Hall B, will provide the same facilities as other hospitals and is equipped with 30 beds for patients in categories three and four. Outside the hall, a tent has been erected to handle transit cases at the Intensive Care Unit. It can accommodate 10 beds.

The PKRC MAEPS 2.0 will also receive Covid-19 patients in categories one and two who have recovered from categories three, four and five after being treated in hospitals. It will also receive patients from Johor, Melaka, Negeri Sembilan and the Klang Valley. **Bernama**

Former Port Klang Authority GM OC Phang declared bankrupt in face of RM2.6b damages payment

KUALA LUMPUR (Jan 19): Former Port Klang Authority general manager (GM) Datin Paduka OC Phang, who was ordered to pay RM2.6 billion in damages by the Shah Alam High Court to the authority, has been declared a bankrupt.

The petition notice declaring her a bankrupt was made following a Kuala Lumpur High Court order dated April 11, 2019, that allowed PKA directors to recover the amount of damages that had been assessed.

The notice seeking the court to make the announcement was made by Datuk Yap Pian Hon, who was one of the directors.

This comes after the Shah Alam High Court had in 2018 found her liable for 11 of the 15 breaches listed by PKA in a suit filed against her following the Port Klang Free Zone (PKFZ) cost overruns, according to *Malaysiakini*.

Justice Datuk M Gunalan, who has since been elevated to the Court of Appeal, had agreed with PKA's claim that Phang owed her duties to PKA as its GM and given that it is a statutory body, she could not bypass the board of directors and rely solely on sanctions of the Transport Ministry, Finance Ministry and the Prime Minister to enter into agreements which were binding on PKA.

"It is erroneous for Phang to contend that the Treasury guidelines were not binding or applicable to her or that she had not known of the same. Phang cannot in principle rely solely on the protection of the Transport Ministry for her actions," he said.

The court ruled that Phang had breached her duties as PKA GM by entering into agreements without first consulting the PKA board of directors and in disregard of PKA's dire financial state, but which instead appeared to benefit the interests of a third party.

Phang had tried to bring 23 PKA directors as third party individuals into the claim as part of her defence but failed. Hence, she was ordered by the court to pay RM80,000 in costs, but was not able to come up with the amount.

It is not known where the former GM is currently, as her last known address is in Bukit Bandaraya, Bangsar.

The civil suit against Phang is the only successful court case brought against those

allegedly responsible for the overwhelming costs.

Meanwhile, the Federal Court had last Wednesday dismissed the prosecution's final appeal to forfeit RM37.8 million from Bintulu member of Parliament Datuk Seri Tiong King Sing, Kuala Dimensi Sdn Bhd (KDSB) and seven others in the PKFZ case.

Besides Tiong and KDSB, the main contractor of the PKFZ project, the prosecution had also named Transhipment Megahub Bhd, Coastal Skyline Sdn Bhd, Wijaya Baru Aviation Sdn Bhd, Wijaya Baru Sdn Bhd, Wijaya Baru Construction Sdn Bhd, Law Ka Hieng and the Selangor State Development Corp (PKNS) as respondents.

Lee: Prosecution and police sloppy

Former PKA chairman Datuk Lee Hwa Beng called the case by the police and prosecution sloppy at best, after the apex court last week found that the prosecution had failed to relate how Phang's three counts of breach of trust led to the money-laundering claims.

Speaking to *The Edge*, Lee — one of those who found something amiss in the project and helped reveal the purported mishandling and budget overruns — said if the prosecution would have read his book "PKFZ: A nation's trust betrayed", it may have performed better.

"I respect the Federal Court's decision with regards to the prosecution's final ap-

peal (to forfeit RM37.8 million worth of property and cash) from KDSB, Tiong and seven others.

"I noticed that the apex court judgement also alluded to the electrical infrastructure that was allegedly built but in actuality are falsely claimed as rightly pointed out, but no evidence or names of witnesses were referred to in the prosecution or police affidavit that resulted in the apex court to reject the appeal."

"Normally the Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) would oversee such infrastructure projects, and [I wonder] how come such evidence was not produced from the witnesses in the police and prosecution's affidavit," he said.

"It is as if the prosecution and the police [have been] doing the case half-heartedly since then attorney-general Tan Sri Abdul Gani Patail's time," he claimed further.

Lee also took the two-year-old Pakatan Harapan government to task for not working hard in seeing justice be done in this case.

So far, the PKFZ had not seen any successful prosecution, with criminal breach of trust charges against Phang withdrawn in 2016.

Three other individuals — two from KDSB: its project manager Law Jenn Dong and its chief operating officer Stephen Abok, and its appointed architect Bernard Tan Swee Seng of BTA Architect — were charged with cheating. They were acquitted by the Sessions Court in 2017.

The then government and Gani had also brought charges against two former transport ministers Tun Dr Ling Liang Sik and Tan Sri Chan Kong Choy for allegedly deceiving the then Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's and Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi's cabinets respectively when they were prime ministers.

Ling was acquitted by the High Court, and the prosecution did not file an appeal, while Chan's charges were later withdrawn.

他说，协助更多果农获得大马农业良好农业规范（myGAP）亦是公会为提升本地水果品质目标之一，因该认证是符合国际Gap的本土化食物安全认证系统，无论国人吃得安心，或出口海外也更容易。「此认证是鼓励农民耕种时不会有超标的农药使用，类似有效的品质控制标准作业程序（SOP）。」

他说，首要是让农民了解myGAP，再者执行官员会亲临果园，实地检测土壤、树叶，和果实中MRL（农药最大残留容许量）但不少欲申请认证果农都失利，因此公会将与当局寻求合作，给予申请者适当培训，以便能达标获得myGAP。「我们还计划到各大超市设摊，灌输民众myGAP认证概念，唯有终端顾客（end-user）接受此认证，才会促使更多果农申请。」
