'Tiada hospital, klinik swasta lewat maklum kes'

Kuala Lumpur: Hospital atau klinik swasta yang menjalankan ujian saringan COVID-19 tidak melambatkan pelaporan kes, sekali gus melanggar peraturan menterapan kes penyakit berjangkit dilaporkan serta-merta.

Presiden Persatuan Hospital Swasta Malaysia (APHM), Datuk Dr Kuljit Singh, berkata pihaknya tiada menerima laporan atau mengenal pasti pengamal swasta yang melengahkan proses pelaporan ditetapkan.

"Kami perlu meneliti dan mengesahkan jika ada hospital atau klinik swasta melambatkan pelaporan kerana kebiasaananya apabila keputusan keluar, ia terus diantar serta-merta.

"Bagaimanapun, kadang-kadang kita mendapat laporan agak lambat dari makmal."

"Pihak makmal juga terlalu sibuk memproses ujian saringan COVID-19 yang terus meningkat," katanya ketika dibubungi BH semalam.

Kelmanin, Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah, memaklumkan peningkatan kes harian COVID-19 secara mendadak sejak beberapa hari lalu antaranya berpunca daripada kelewatan pelaporan menggunakan Sistem Makmal Kesihatan Awam (SIMKA) oleh fasiliti swasta.

Dr Kuljit berkata, hospital dan klinik swasta sudah melakukan

yang terbaik mengikut kemampuan dan kapasiti semasa bagi mengurangkan beban hospital kerajaan.

Katanya, menyataan Dr Noor Hisham menyebut kelewatan pelaporan itu berlaku di pihak kementerian.

"Apabila terlalu banyak data dihantar dari seluruh negara, prosesnya akan sedikit lambat," katanya.

Beliau turut mengulas ke-nyataan Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari, yang akan mengenakan tindakan kompaun melalui Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Selangor (JKNS) kepada klinik atau hospital swasta yang tidak melapor-

kan kes positif secara terus pada hari yang sama melalui SIMKA.

"Ugutan sedemikian tidak wajar, sebaiknya berbincang dan beri amaran jika benar ada pengamal swasta melakukan tindakan sedemikian," katanya.

Dr Kuljit memaklumkan, hospital swasta sudah mula menerima dan merawat pesakit COVID-19 mengikut kemampuan pusat perubatan masing-masing.

Katanya, inisiatif itu dimulakan sejak lebih sebulan lalu tetapi bezanya dahulu pesakit COVID-19 boleh dihantar ke hospital kerajaan.

"Sekarang ini disebabkan tiada katil, kita teruskan rawatan menyeluruh di hospital swasta.

"Hospital swasta yang ada fasiliti seperti katil di unit rawatan rapi (ICU) boleh menerima pesakit COVID-19 termasuk yang kritis dan berada di tahap lima," katanya.

Beliau menambah, jumlah pesakit yang dikendalikan hospital swasta agak kecil memandangkan mereka tidak mempunyai tenaga pakar dan kemudahan sebagaimana dimiliki hospital kerajaan.

Mengikut data Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM), setakat ini 96 hospital swasta bersetuju menyediakan rawatan COVID-19 dengan kemudahan 1,252 katil, 65 katil ICU dan 54 mesin ventilator.

Tidak sorok pesakit Covid-19

SHAH ALAM: Klinik swasta yang mengendalikan ujian saringan tidak menyembunyikan keputusan pesakit yang menunjukkan positif Covid-19.

Ketua Pegawai Operasi Kumpulan Megaklinik Zahran, Mohd. Nafidz Abdul Razak berkata, pihaknya sentiasa mengemas kini keputusan positif Covid-19 menerusi Unit Notifikasi Khas Covid-19 yang ditubuhkan sejak tahun lalu.

Katanya, unit khas itu ditubuhkan untuk mengendalikan pesakit positif dengan memaklumkan keputusan semasa kepada Pejabat kesihatan Daerah (PKD) dan di dalam Sistem Informasi Makmal Kesihatan

Awam (SIMKA).

"Seramai 10 individu ditugaskan dalam unit khas tersebut kerana setiap keputusan diperoleh dua kali iaitu pagi dan petang. Apabila keputusan diperoleh dan menunjukkan positif, kita terus memaklumkan kepada Kementerian Kesihatan.

"Setakat ini, kira-kira 500 individu melakukan ujian saringan setiap hari dengan melalui dua kaedah sama ada menggunakan Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) dan kit ujian Rapid Antigen (RTK-Ag). Keputusan setiap hari ujian saringan menunjukkan kira-kira sepuluh peratus atau 20 hingga 50 individu yang melakukan ujian saringan didapati positif Covid-19m," katanya ketika dihubungi *Utusan Ma-*

laysia di sini, semalam.

Semalam, Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari memaklumkan tindakan klinik dan hospital swasta yang tidak melaporkan secara terus kes Covid-19 adalah salah satu faktor penyumbang peningkatan virus itu direkodkan di Selangor.

Malah, peningkatan kes Covid-19 di negeri ini disebabkan kes kumulatif daripada saringan pekerja kilang dan di penjara yang dapat dikesan kes yang berlaku 10 hari yang lalu.

Mohd. Nafidz menegaskan, tiada isu menyorokkan keputusan semasa Covid-19 dan terus memberi kerjasama kepada kerajaan dalam usaha memutuskan rantaian virus.

Dalam pada itu, beliau memaklumkan, pihaknya tidak

mempunyai kuasa mutlak untuk mengambil tindakan lanjut terhadap pesakit kecuali menasihatkan mereka supaya kekal berada di rumah agar dapat memutuskan rantaian Covid-19.

"Kita mencadangkan supaya kerajaan membaiki sistem dengan memberi kuasa kepada klinik dan hospital swasta untuk mengendalikan kes pesakit Covid-19 agar dapat bertindak pantas.

"Mungkin mereka boleh memberikan kuasa kepada klinik dan hospital swasta untuk memberikan gelang pink kepada pesakit. Apabila keputusan diperoleh positif, kita boleh terus ke rumah pesakit untuk memakaikan gelang pink," ujarnya yang mempunyai 11 cawangan.

Meskipun negara menjalani Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) namun masyarakat Cina tetap bersentanggat membuat persediaan untuk menyambut perayaan itu mengikut SOP ditetapkan.

Sambut Tahun Baru Cina dalam talian

Shah Alam: Selangor akan mengajurkan sambutan Tahun Baru Cina peringkat negeri secara dalam talian iaitu menerusi platform media sosial buat julung kalinya pada 12 Februari ini.

Exco Pelaburan, Perindustrian dan Perdagangan dan Industri Kecil dan Sederhana negeri, Datuk Teng Chang Khim berkata, sambutan yang bertemakan Tahun Baru Harapan Baru itu akan disiarkan di laman Facebook Menteri Besar Selangor dan media dalam talian pada hari pertama Tahun Baru Cina bermula 9 malam.

"Sambutan perayaan ini menerusi platform media sosial adalah susulan ke-

daan semasa pandemik Covid-19 yang tidak membenarkan pengajuran acara besar dan perhimpunan orang ramai.

"Ia juga dapat memberikan impak positif kepada masyarakat berbilang kaum, terutamanya di Selangor, apabila masyarakat Melayu, India dan lain-lain juga dapat menonton persembahan yang disediakan sepanjang program itu berlangsung," katanya.

Menurut beliau, kaedah pemberian program istimewa secara maya itu dilihat sebagai

alternatif terbaik yang bersesuaian dengan norma barbaru untuk masyarakat Cina menikmati suasana perayaan di kedianman masing-masing.

Katanya, sebanyak 12 persembahan nyanyian, tarian dan kebudayaan akan disiaran untuk program yang menelan kos pengajuran RM414,000 antaranya melibatkan kumpulan tarian kebudayaan Cina bertaraf antarabangsa.

Mengulas tema Tahun Baru, Harapan Baru, Teng berkata pemilihannya

dibuat bagi memberi semangat kepada masyarakat yang telah hampir setahun dilanda pandemik Covid-19.

"Sejak Covid-19 melanda, ramai kehilangan kerja, perniagaan dan kehidupan terjejas tidak boleh ke sekolah, serta ditangguh peperiksaan. Disebabkan itu, Tahun Baru Cina ini adalah perayaan penting bagi masyarakat Tiong Hua untuk kita perbaharui azam dan mahu bebas daripada belenggu penyakit," katanya.

Teng turut menasihati masyarakat Cina supaya kekal mematuhi prosedur operasi standard (SOP) semasa menyambut perayaan Tahun Baru Cina minggu depan.

Siasatan berhubung agama baharu dikenali sebagai 'Agama Melayu' yang menolak ajaran Islam, kini berada di peringkat akhir dan dijangka selesai dalam masa terdekat.

Timbalan Menteri di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (Hal Ehwal Agama), Datuk Ahmad Marzuk Shaaify (**gambar**) berkata, sebaik siasatan selesai, pihaknya akan membuat pengumuman.

Katanya, kes berkenaan diserahkan kepada Jabatan Agama Islam Negeri Selangor (Jais) untuk menyiasat memandangkan kes berkenaan di Selangor.

"Sekiranya siasatan mendapati wujud penyelewengan ajaran sesat, Jais akan mengambil tindakan lanjut termasuk proses pendakwaan di mahkamah.

"Bagaimanapun, saya menasihatkan orang ramai supaya tidak cepat untuk menghukum seorang individu berdasarkan vi-

deo yang tular.

"Sebaliknya perkara itu perlu diserahkan kepada pihak berkuasa agama untuk menyiasat. Ini kerana soal penyelewangan aqidah hanya boleh dinilai pihak tertentu, bukan semua orang boleh tentukan," katanya pada sidang media selepas menyerahkan bantuan Tabung Musaadah Covid-19 Jakim-Yayasan Waqaf Malaysia (YWM) di sini, semalam.

Media sebelum ini melaporkan pihak berkuasa agama menyiasat dan menilai tindakan sewajarnya berhubung isu agama baharu dikenali sebagai 'Agama Melayu' yang menolak ajaran Islam.

Yang Dipertua Yayasan Dakwah Islamiah Malaysia (Yadim), Nasrudin Hassan berkata, sebagai agensi dakwah, pihaknya sentiasa bersedia untuk memberi kefaamanan, pemurnian aqidah dan fikrah.

Mengulas lanjut, Ahmad Marzuk berkata, pihaknya menerima laporan berkaitan perkara berkenaan minggu lalu selepas tular sebuah video sebelum Jais membuat siasatan.

Selepas memberi amaran kepada kerajaan Malaysia minggu lalu, kumpulan penggodam Cyberpunk Team melakukan serangan di beberapa laman sesawang milik kerajaan, kerajaan negeri dan pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) tengah malam kelmarin.

Perkara itu dimaklumkan kumpulan berkenaan merentasi status yang dimuat naik di laman Facebook *Anonymous Malaysia* dan mendakwa mula menyergap beberapa portal kerajaan sejak malam kelmarin.

Antara yang menjadi sasaran kumpulan itu termasuk

'Maaf...jangan cari kami'

Cyberpunk Team serang beberapa portal kerajaan sejak malam kelmarin

suk portal kerajaan negeri Sabah, Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia, Lembaga Pembangunan Industri Pembinaan Malaysia dan Majlis Perbandaran Selangor.

"Kumpulan penggodam itu turut menggodam portal perak.my, bagaimanapun tidak dapat dipastikan sama ada ia laman sesawang yang ada kaitan dengan kerajaan negeri Perak.

Semakan Harian Metro mendapati kumpulan terabit meninggalkan pesanan di laman sesawang yang digodam dan meminta

pentadbir laman sesawang menjaga keselamatan portal mereka.

"Kepada pentadbir laman web (sesawang), kami menemui laman web anda terdedah dengan ancaman penggodaman, sila pastikan laman web anda selamat.

"Kami memohon maaf kerana menggodam laman web anda, jangan cuba mencari kami kerana kami hanya ingin memastikan laman web anda tidak la-

gi terdedah," kata kumpulan penggodam itu dalam portal yang digodam mereka.

Kumpulan itu turut meninggalkan e-mel untuk berhubung dengan mereka dalam laman sesawang yang digodam. Bagaimanapun semua laman sesawang yang digodam berkenaan pulih seperti sedia kala, semalam.

Minggu lalu, Cyberpunk Team melalui laman Facebook *Anonymous Malaysia* kembali muncul menghantui laman sesawang dan aset dalam talian negara ini selepas lima tahun berdiam diri.

Kemunculan kembali kumpulan itu dibuktikan menerusi satu video berdurasi 2.29 minit yang dikongsikan di laman sosial Facebooknya.

Menerusi mesej video itu, kumpulan berkenaan berjanji untuk mengadakan serangan siber terhadap laman web kerajaan dan aset atau talian dikenali sebagai #OpsWakeUp21.

Malis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) melalui Agensi

Keselamatan Siber Negara (Nacs) memandang serius ancaman pihak tertentu mahu menggodam laman sesawang kerajaan menerusi penularan satu video yang dikeluarkan *Anonymous Malaysia* di platform media sosial baru-baru ini.

MKN dalam satu kenyataan dilaporkan berkata, sehubungan itu, Nacs sudah mengeluarkan satu notis amaran kepada semua agensi kerajaan untuk mengambil langkah perlu bagi mencegah dan meminimumkan impak ancaman tersebut.

Penggodam Anonymous Malaysia serang portal kerajaan dan agensinya

Laman web kastam, CIDB digodam

PETALING JAYA – Penggodam laman sesawang bergelar Anonymous Malaysia mula membuat serangan siber ke atas portal-portal milik kerajaan dan agensinya dengan menjadikan Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) dan Majlis Perbandaran Selangor (MPS) antara mangsa pertama.

Selain dua portal itu, mereka turut menggodam laman web Kerajaan Negeri Sabah, Perak.my dan Lembaga Pembangunan Industri Pembinaan Malaysia (CIDB) dengan meninggalkan logo cyberpunk di situ.

Serangan tersebut dimaklumkan mereka pada awal pagi semalam di laman Facebook Anonymous Malaysia dengan kata-kata *cyberpunk team has + started the party* (kumpulan cyberpunk telah memulakan parti).

Kumpulan itu mengotakkan janji mereka untuk melakukan serangan siber selepas memberi ugutan kedua kepada kerajaan pada minggu lalu.

Minggu lalu, Anonymous Malaysia kembali muncul menghantui laman web dan aset dalam talian selepas lima tahun berdiam diri.

Menerusi mesej video dimuat

naik kumpulan itu, mereka berjanji untuk mengadakan serangan siber terhadap laman web kerajaan dan aset atas talian

dikenali sebagai #OpsWakeUp21.

Sementara itu, Ketua Aktivis Persatuan Pengguna Siber Malaysia, Dr. Mohd. Fazli Azran berkata, Serangan Alih Muka Web (Defacement) boleh menjadi lebih besar sekiranya tiada tindakan segera daripada kerajaan.

"Ketika ini, beberapa agensi seperti JKDM dan CIDB telah digodam dan tidak mustahil agensi lebih besar akan berdepan nasib sama jika tiada tindakan tegas kerajaan.

"Modus operandi juga lebih

bersifat misteri kerana tidak memberikan pautan URL dan memerlukan pengendali sistem mencari sendiri kesilapan," ujarnya.

Menurut Kosmo! di laman sesawang milik Kerajaan Negeri Sa-

lah dan MPS turut menunjukkan berlakunya penggodaman dengan menunjukkan paparan logo 'cyberpunk' di laman itu.

Sementara itu, pihak MPS dan CIDB ketika dihubungi enggan memberi sebarang ulasan.

TUMPAT – Siasatan menyeluruh berhubung ajaran sesat 'Agama Melayu' yang didedahkan Yayasan Dakwah Islamiah Malaysia (Yadim) dijangka hampir selesai.

Timbalan Menteri Di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (Hal Ehwal Agama), Datuk Ahmad Marzuk Shaary berkata, siasatan mengejai ajaran itu sedang dijalankan oleh Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) dan akan didedahkan selesaikannya selesa tidak lama lagi.

Menurut beliau, buat masa ini, pihak kementerian menerusi Jabatan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (Jakim) memberi kerjasama penuh dan percaya akan kredibiliti JAIS dalam melakukan siasatan kes tersebut.

"Jakim menerima laporan berhubung kes ini pada minggu lalu selepas satu video upacara ritual berkaitan ajaran itu tular di media sosial," katanya.

Yang Dipertua Yadim, Nasrudin Hassan berkata, pihak berkuaasa agama sedang menyiasat perkara itu selain memberi kefahaman aqidah dan fikrah.

Mengulas lanjut, Ahmad Marzuk memberitahu, pihaknya pernah menerima laporan berhubung berkait satu ajaran sesat

Jelas beliau, Jakim akan memanjangkan perkara itu kepada Jawatankuasa Muzakarah Kebangsaan Hal Ehwal Islam pada

16 Februari ini untuk diteliti kandungan ajaran tersebut sekiranya bertentangan dengan Islam.

"Saya ingin menasihatkan orang ramai agar tidak cepat

menghukum sesuatu perkara berkait dengan ajaran sesat."

"Kita serah kepada yang pakar untuk membuat keputusan," kata beliau.

Timbalan Menteri di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (Hal Ehwal Agama), Datuk Ahmad Marzuk Shaary berkata, kes itu diserahkan kepada JAIS kerana ia di bawah bidang kuasa agama negeri.

Beliau berkata, kelahiran agama baharu yang dikenali sebagai Agama Melayu itu menolak ajaran Islam yang dianggap sebagai Islam Arab serta mengaku membawa ajaran Islam Melayu.

Sementara itu, Ahmad Marzuk turut menasihatkan orang ramai supaya jangan cepat percaya sesuatu hanya berdasarkan video yang tular, sebaliknya menyerasikan kepada pihak berkuasa yang lebih pakar untuk menjalankan siasatan.

Setiap negara mempunyai bangunan bersejarah yang memiliki keunikan tersendiri.

Bangunan atau monumen bersejarah selain pembacaan kisah tokoh sejarah baik politik, ekonomi dan sosial disifatkan antara elemen penting dalam pembentukan semangat patriotisme dalam kalangan rakyat terutama generasi muda.

Monumen bersejarah ini penting untuk dikenalkan sebagai rujukan kerana ia adalah bukti kukuh kepada sesuatu peristiwa atau era yang pernah berlaku dahulu.

Secara psikologinya monumen ini dapat menjadi pengisian dalam pembentukan jati diri generasi muda tidak hanya mengenai pengorbanan generasi terdahulu dalam memperjuangkan kemerdekaan negara sebelum ini tetapi juga pembinaan ketamadunan bangsa Malaysia.

Menurut *Kamus Dewan Bahasa Edisi Keempat* - Monumen merujuk kepada bangunan yang dibina untuk memperingati seseorang atau peristiwa penting.

Malaysia memiliki banyak monumen mengikut era yang mempunyai tidak hanya mempunyai nilai komersial memacu industri perlancongan tetapi juga menyuntik semangat patriotisme.

Dari utara, Stesen Keretapi Padang Besar (Perlis); Masjid Zahir, Lembah Bujang (Kedah); Kota Cor-

nwallis, Penang Free School, Rumah P. Ramlee, Muzium Perang (Pulau Pinang); Istana Iskandariah, Istana Kellie's, Menara Jam Condong Teluk Intan (Perak).

Di tengah pula, Bukit Malawati, Jambatan Kota, Masjid Sultan Salahudin Abdul Aziz Shah, Istana Alam Shah manakala ibu kota Kuala Lumpur pula dengan bangunan Abdul Samad, Stadium Merdeka, Stesen Keretapi Kuala Lumpur, Carcosa Seri Negara, Tugu Negara.

Rantauan selatan pula tidak kurang hebat dengan Istana Lama Seri Menanti, Teratak Za'aba, Muzium Tentera Darat (Negeri Sembilan); Kota A Famosa, bangunan Stadh Yus, Gereja St Paul (Melaka); Masjid Sultan Abu Bakar, bangunan Sultan Ibrahim, Muzium Sultan Abu Bakar dan Balai Polis Bukit Kepong (Johor).

Jajaran pantai timur pula ada Jambatan Gantung Sungai Lembing (Pahang); Pintu Kota Istana Balai Besar (Kelantan); Masjid Abidin (Masjid Putih), Batu Bersurat Padang Tara (Terengganu).

Untuk generasi gajet terus mengikuti kisah sejarah monumen tidak menjadi sebarang masalah dengan kecanggihan teknologi telekomunikasi pada masa kini melalui platform WhatsApp, Telegram, Tik Tok dan sebagainya.

Namun, cabaran sebenar adalah untuk mengekalkan monumen ini untuk terus menjadi tatapan generasi masa depan.

Antaranya cabaran kewangan yang menyaksikan beberapa kawasan bersejarah berada dalam wilayah segitiga ekonomi yang mempunyai pasaran harta tanah tinggi.

Selain itu, kurangnya tenaga pakar dalam kalangan rakyat tempat-

an bidang pemuliharaan baik bangunan bersejarah ini juga secara tidak langsung menjadikan sesuatu kerja pemberian mengambil tempoh masa yang panjang.

Faktor kurangnya kesedaran dalam kalangan segelintir anggota masyarakat khasnya terhadap nilai sentimental sesebuah monumen juga mengundang kepada perlakunya vandalism terhadap produk sejarah lalu ini.

Pulihara

Pada Ahad, Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah bertitah menerusi Facebook rasmi Selangor Royal Office supaya semua pihak bertanggungjawab memperhebatkan usaha berkaitan pemuliharaan dan pemeliharaan monumen bersejarah berkaitan negeri itu terutamanya di Kuala Lumpur.

Sultan Sharafuddin bimbang sekiranya bangunan bersejarah itu tidak dipulihara segera serta terbitar berkemungkinan monumen itu akan runtuh atau rosak sehingga tidak boleh diselamatkan lagi.

Kesimpulannya, usaha pemuliharaan dan pemeliharaan monumen bersejarah ini memerlukan sokongan padu secara konsisten tidak hanya dalam kalangan rakyat, pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) tetapi juga komitmen sektor korporat dan kerajaan negara ini.

Paling penting cara berfikir setiap anggota masyarakat juga perlu berubah dengan tidak menganggap monumen lama sebagai barang lama sebaliknya sebagai sesuatu yang tak lapuk dek hujan, tak lekang dek panas.

Penduduk di Projek Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) Lembah Subang 1 di sini kesal dan kecewa dengan pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) serta pihak pengurusan kerana tidaknya mengendahkan aduan mereka mengenai persekitaran tidak selesa akibat longgokan sampah termasuk kerosakan kemudahan di bangunan itu.

Tinjauan *Sinar Harian* pada Isnin mendapati keadaan di PPR sangat kotor dengan timbunan sampah di antara blok-blok kediaman yang mengeluarkan bau busuk di kawasan sekitarnya.

Selain itu, tinjauan juga mendapati kemudahan lain seperti tangga, kamera litar tertutup (CCTV) dan taman permainan rosak akibat tiada penyelenggaraan baik daripada

pihak pengurusan di sini.

Salah seorang penduduk di sini yang mahu dikenali sebagai Niza, 43, berkata, kehadiran orang tempatan dan warga asing yang menceroboh dan tinggal secara haram di sini menyusahkan kehidupannya.

Menurut ibu tunggal itu, dia pernah bergelap selama beberapa hari kerana bekalan elektrik di rumahnya terputus akibat wayar penyambung elektrik di rumah dicuri penginap haram itu.

"Mereka (penceroboh) juga pernah buang sampah di depan rumah saya sehingga kawasan

depan rumah saya berbau busuk kerana berendam dengan saya tanpa sebab yang munasabah.

"Sudah banyak kali saya adukan kepada PBT dan pihak Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya (MBPJ), tapi mereka langsung tak peduli dengan kami di sini," katanya yang telah tinggal di kawasan itu sejak 16 tahun lalu.

Seorang peniaga air tebu yang mahu dikenali sebagai Abu, 36, pula berkata, pihaknya pernah terkesan dengan sikap penceroboh haram yang selalu mencampakkan sampah dari tingkat atas ke aras bawah.

Ujar Abu, dia dan rakan-

rakan pernah bekerjasama untuk membersihkan kawasan di bloknya dengan upah sebanyak RM10 setiap rumah, namun golongan tersebut tidak mahu memberi kerjasama.

"Kita tidak tahu siapa buang sampah kerana kamera CCTV di sini pun selalu rosak.

"Jadi, saya ambil inisiatif untuk membayar tukang cuci untuk bersihkan kawasan rumah dengan upah RM10 setiap rumah. Itu pun mereka (penceroboh) tidak beri kerjasama," katanya kepada *Sinar Harian* pada Isnin.

Dalam pada itu, seorang

penduduk yang mahu dikenali sebagai Lina, 48, berkata, dia berasi kurang selesa dan tidak selamat apabila mengetahui ramai penceroboh terutama daripada golongan warga asing yang tinggal di sini secara haram.

Dakwanya, pihak PBT tidak pernah datang untuk memeriksakan kawasan PPR itu untuk memastikan penduduknya tinggal secara sah.

"Sepanjang lebih lima tahun tinggal di sini, saya tidak pernah nampak PBT buat pemeriksaan untuk banteras warga asing yang tinggal di PPR ini secara haram," katanya.

IT WAS a good weekend for night markets in the Klang Valley, as they reopened under the new movement control order (MCO) last week after more than two weeks of the sector being closed due to the pandemic. They received the go-ahead from the National SOP Council, which was allowing them to reopen on Friday but said that it must be done in line with Kuala Lumpur's own guidelines and operating procedures (SOP).

There were up to two visitors per stall at night markets in the city, with the same SOPs applied by traders as well. The SOPs were first issued for districts like Ipoh.

This seemingly comes from footfall numbers rather than health representations, as night markets which led to infections earlier have been closed for disinfection.

The two parties to adhere to the SOP at all times, as the public has been told to take appropriate measures to anyone breaching the procedures.

On Jan 29, DBKL issued a statement that night markets in Kuala Lumpur were allowed to open again on Friday and Saturday, while associations in Selangor only got the green light on Saturday.

On the same day, the National Security Council (NSC) said that night markets were allowed to operate under certain conditions outside the SOP guidelines but this information was not widely known.

A few news portals had picked up the story, but not many.

Some night market traders in Selangor and Kuala Lumpur have capitalised on MBSN's announcement to encourage people to "Come and buy the Chinese New Year lantern before we are

Double standards

For traders who rely solely on night markets to make a living, things are getting increasingly tough.

Who sells bread and pastries, found it difficult to sustain his revenue as most consumers move from trading at the night market to the supermarket or online.

"This adds up to about RM2,000 monthly for me," he said.

"Traders are excited to be selling again after a long time."

"There were about 1,000 visitors and the market was packed tightly throughout the night," he said.

"The market is filled with a crowd of two visitors to a stall also gets a lot more sales," he said.

"For example, if we have 100 stalls and each sells RM20 worth of bread at one time, a capital of 200," he said.

Sultan's call to preserve heritage buildings resonates with the rakyat

KLANG: The call by the Sultan of Selangor to protect and preserve heritage buildings in Kuala Lumpur, especially those that are linked to Selangor, has been welcomed by many people.

Selangor Council of Justice of Peace president Datuk Loke Fay said the call by Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (pic) was timely.

"There is a need to preserve and save these iconic buildings as they have historical and architectural value," he said yesterday.

Loke said it was also important to preserve these buildings for the younger generation as many were not aware that Kuala Lumpur was part of Selangor prior to being designated a Federal Territory (in 1974).

He also urged Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin to allocate resources to preserve these buildings to be conserved.

Sultan Sharafuddin had in conjunction with Federal Territory Day called for Kuala Lumpur's heritage buildings to be protected.

In the statement issued by Istana Alam Shah here, the Ruler said he wanted historical buildings such as Carnosa Seri Negara, the Sultan Abdul Samad Building, Masjid Jamek, St Mary's Cathedral, the Kuala Lumpur railway station, the Keretapi Tanah Melayu Bhd headquarters, the old Istana Negara and Stadium Merdeka to be protected.

He added that many of these buildings, such as the Sultan Abdul Samad Building, had strong links with the state when Kuala Lumpur was Selangor's administrative capital before 1974.

The building also holds a lot of memories for senior lawyers given the courts were located there until the mid-1990s.

Shearn Delamore & Co partner and consultant S. Radhakrishnan, 80, said Sultan Sharafuddin's call to preserve the buildings was very

appropriate as they hold a lot of history.

"The High Courts, Supreme Court and later the Appeals Court were located in this block of buildings.

"Many landmark legal decisions were made here," said Radhakrishnan who has retired from legal practice.

"Another building I vividly remember is the Central Market when it was a wet market."

"I used to see the late Toh Puan Bunny Suffian, who was the wife of the then Lord President Tun Suffian's (Tun Mohamed Suffian Mohamed Hashim), buying poultry and fish there by herself," he added.

Malaysian football icon Datuk Soh Chin Aun said he was happy that Sultan Sharafuddin mentioned Stadium Merdeka in the list.

"We had played so many Merdeka tournaments there as well as against many foreign visiting teams. Football legend Diego Maradona had also played in Stadium Merdeka," said Soh, 71.

He said if Stadium Merdeka was not preserved, part of the nation's sporting history would also vanish together with the iconic venue.

Veteran designer Datuk Johan Ariff, who is in his 80s, said that many of the iconic buildings had fallen into disrepair.

"It is indeed timely for Tuanku to have made the call," said Johan, who has designed many of the well-known buildings around

Kuala Lumpur.

Heritage expert Datuk Hajeedar Abdul Majid said that there was still time for the authorities to act in conserving the nation's tangible heritage sites.

He said that unless urgent action was taken to sustain and preserve these buildings, they could be gone.

"It was heartening to hear about the Sultan's concern about these iconic heritage buildings and I hope it would prompt immediate conservation efforts," he added.

Hajeedar, who is past president of the International Council on Monuments and Sites Malaysia, added that the buildings were in a sorry state and quickly deteriorating.

"If left abandoned for too long, as some of the buildings have been, rot would set in and this could cause

exponential deterioration.

"We need to find new uses for old buildings, but also in keeping with its history as it signifies the progress of the country," he added.

Hajeedar said that the sites were gazetted as national heritage under the National Heritage Act 2005, as such, the owners were obligated to conserve and maintain the buildings.

Kuala Lumpur Tourist Guides Association chairman Edmond Chan urged authorities not only to conserve iconic heritage buildings in Kuala Lumpur, but also old villages and historical sites.

"There are still a lot of places in the capital city that have significant history and values in the formation of Kuala Lumpur into what it is now.

"This includes old villages in Kampung Baru and Brickfields as

well as Chinese new villages in Kuala Lumpur.

"Some tourists would go for the history and cultures of the city, which can be seen in these historical areas," he said.

While Chan applauded some owners along Jalan Sultan for restoring pre-war buildings into more modern, touristy landmarks, the authorities should channel more efforts into conserving stretches of historical buildings and turn them into cultural villages.

"For example, most of the houses in Kampung Baru are privately-owned, but there are no specific buildings there to educate visitors on its history and the formation of the Malay enclave.

"The government should also allocate more funds to the conservation of historical buildings and sites," he added.

'Don't handle the produce'

CUSTOMERS shopping at the 14 morning markets in Klang are not allowed to dig into the boxes of vegetables and fruits or touch any other items being sold.

They are required to point out the items they want to buy, and the traders will pack the items for the customers.

Four of the markets — Pasar Pagi Eng Ann, Pasar Pagi Lorong Sungai Puloh 13 in Klang Utama, Pasar Pagi Lorong Sepat in Teluk Pulai and Pasar Pagi Jalan Batu Nilam 27 in Bandar Bukit Tinggi — reopened for business yesterday.

Another three — in Jalan Papan, Taman Chi Liung and at Flat Taman Chi Liung — will reopen tomorrow.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) Licensing and Hawkers Department director Azhar Samsudin said the council decided to allow these daily markets to open from 6am to 11am under strict conditions, where every stall must have a QR code and customers were made to follow the 3S of the standard operating procedure (SOP) — sanitise, screen (body temperature) and scan (QR codes).

Meanwhile, three weekly morning markets will reopen on selected dates — Pasar Pagi Lintang Dato' Tahir will open today, Pasar Pagi Jalan Khoo Kek Kheng on Feb 6 and Jalan Sri Sarawak 18 in Taman Sri Andalas will open on Feb 7.

The reopening of the remaining two daily markets and two weekly markets in the municipality, said

MPK, would depend on the SOP compliance rate at the operational markets and the number of Covid-19 cases.

All of the morning markets had been ordered to shut at the start of the second movement control order.

"Morning markets are essential businesses as people get their fresh produce here. This is to support small local businesses and empower the economic engine in an area," said Azhar.

A trader, Yip Peng Peng, 55, who sells traditional Chinese cakes, said open-air wet markets allowed for greater physical distancing, while temporary makeshift stalls enabled flexibility and enhanced cleaning at the end of the business day.

StarMetro visited three of the markets that opened yesterday and found the majority of people complied with the SOP. However, at cer-

tain points, it was difficult for customers to practise physical distancing due to the number of people in a given space.

Several customers did not wear the mask properly, either by wearing it under their chin or covering only their mouth and leaving their nose exposed.

There were also customers who insisted on touching and holding the produce while making their selection.

Traders were also seen reminding customers to keep the minimum one-metre distance from each other and wait in line to maintain safe distance.

Azhar said it was hard for people to keep their distance while shopping but it must be done.

"We are in a pandemic mode, but there is a need for people to shop for basic necessities and get goods for Chinese New Year," he added.

MBSA provides bins for bulk waste from CNY spring cleaning

SHAH Alam City Council (MBSA) is providing roll-on roll-off (Roro) bins for residents who are spring-cleaning their homes and want to get rid of bulk waste ahead of the Chinese New Year festival.

"A total of 275 three-tonne Roro bins will be placed, in stages from now until Feb 14, at selected locations in Sections 1 to 36 and Sections U1 to U20 in Shah Alam,"

said MBSA Corporate and Public Relations Division head Shahrin Ahmad in a statement.

"This service is aimed at providing residents the convenience of disposing bulk waste and selected recyclable materials after their spring clean.

"It is also to educate Shah Alam folk about proper bulk waste management."

MBSA has an assigned schedule

for the bin placements.

The Roro bins will be left at a predetermined location for seven days for residents to dispose of their bulk waste but will be removed earlier if they are full.

According to MBSA, the Roro bins are for:

> Bulk waste: table, chair, sofa, cupboard, mattress, bed and other furniture;

> Metal-based items: bicycle,

baby cradle, barbecue equipment and metal drum;

> Glass-based items: aquarium, vase, decorative lamp and chandelier (to be properly wrapped before disposal so that they do not break easily and injure the waste disposal workers); and

> Electrical or electronic items: fridge, radio, television, battery charger and mobile phone..

"We hope residents will cooper-

ate by placing their bulk rubbish in the provided bins to facilitate the waste collection and ensure the surrounding area is clean," said Shahrin.

RM2mil in discount vouchers disbursed under Selangor govt CNY e-bazaar initiative

A TOTAL of RM2mil in the form of discount vouchers will be disbursed to small and medium enterprises (SMEs) as well as micro businesses in Selangor under the state government's e-bazaar Chinese New Year campaign.

The campaign is targeting 25,000 small and mid-size enterprises as well as micro businesses, including 12,500 new e-merchants to participate in efforts to soften the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic on businesses.

The vouchers, which will be passed on to consumers by participating merchants, will be divided between the two largest online marketplace platforms in Malaysia, namely Lazada and Shopee.

State investment, industry and commerce, and small and medium enterprises committee chairman Datuk Teng Chang Khim announced that the campaign would run until March 7.

"Like previous rounds of the Selangor E-Bazar campaign, it is to assist SMEs and micro businesses in Selangor in embracing digitalisation to survive in the challenging business environment caused

by the Covid-19 pandemic.

"With the current reimposition of the movement control order, going digital has never been this urgent for businesses to ensure continuous cash flow," he pointed out.

The campaign is jointly organised by Selangor Information Technology and Digital Economy Corporation Sdn Bhd and Invest Selangor.

Teng said the campaign would only be for businesses registered in Selangor and urged them to take advantage of it.

"The Selangor E-Bazar CNY campaign provides a safe marketplace for people to discover popular festive goods and food, including mandarin oranges, biscuits and hampers."

Teng said the campaign would hopefully help to ensure Chinese New Year can still be celebrated in the right spirit, albeit in a different way.

"We may not be able to go back to our hometowns this year but buying gifts through the E-Bazar platform shows that our affection for our parents, family and friends will never be disrupted, even by the pandemic," he added.

Teng also said the state government remained committed to the digitalisation agenda in assisting

SMEs, micro-SMEs and merchants to go digital.

"According to recent research by e-Economy SEA, which was launched by Google and Temasek, Malaysia's digital economic growth saw a 6% increase in 2020 with US\$11.4bil (RM46.08bil) compared to US\$10.7bil (RM43.25bil) in 2019.

"The gross merchandise value (GMV) of Malaysia's digital economy is expected to grow to US\$30bil (RM121.27bil) by 2025.

"Local businesses should make full use of this so that they can increase their income further while increasing our GMV," said Teng.

Following the two rounds of Selangor E-Bazar campaigns in 2020, SMEs generated a total of RM1.39bil in ripple effect to the economy through direct sales worth RM43.76mil from the total of RM3mil in vouchers channelled by the state government.

Ways to silence the noisy revs of errant motorbike riders

I REFER to the letter "Menace of motorcycle noise" (*The Star*, Jan 29), which highlighted the issue of noise pollution caused by errant motorcyclists on highways located near housing areas.

I think majority of the public, myself included, would totally agree with the writer's views about this noise being a menace to society.

However, most just suffer in silence and accept it as "part of life" because they think there is nothing they can do about it.

The source of the problem, of course, is the crowds of mat rempit who do not care about the well-being of others as they rev up their motorcycle engines to unbearable noise levels while taking part in illegal street racing or showing off stunts on their machines.

Residents at Puncak Damansara Condo and the surrounding areas in Kayu Ara, Petaling Jaya are also affected by this menace.

I have noticed that there are at least five motorcycle workshops at the single row of shops outside Puncak Damansara Condo and another two or three nearby.

Why are so many motorcycle workshops allowed to operate in this area? Workshops that just repair motorcycles are fine, but two or three of these premises are outlets selling accessories/kits for bike modification.

These shops will indirectly contribute to the menace of motorcycle noise pollution as they provide the means for the mat rempit to modify their machine's exhaust pipes to achieve the revs required for the thrill factor.

I strongly suggest that the authorities (police and local authorities, in this case the Petaling Jaya City Council) take proactive measures to tackle the problem and bring some peace to residents of all the areas affected by this noise pollution. This can be done by, among others:

- 1) Restricting the number of shops selling motorcycle modification kits in residential areas. These shops should actually be located in other commercial areas such as shopping malls;

- 2) Enforcing the relevant laws strictly and acting immediately upon receiving complaints from the public. Impose a jail term or a stiff fine on repeat offenders; and

- 3) Educating and rehabilitating the offenders.

The police and local authorities must carry out frequent patrols on highways that are popular race tracks for the mat rempit, especially areas with low- to medium-cost flats where the population density is higher.

I sincerely hope the authorities will not sit back while the silent majority is suffering.

SADDENED by the inability to gather physically for Chinese New Year celebration, the Selangor government has decided to hold its annual open house virtually this year.

State executive council (exco) member Datuk Teng Chang Khim said the virtual celebration would take place on Feb 12 at 9pm, which is the first day of the Chinese New Year.

"Traditionally, the Chinese New Year celebration is one of the biggest festivities around the world, including in our country, together with Aidilfitri, Deepavali and Christmas celebrations.

"We believe by celebrating virtually this year, it will have its own advantages because everybody, regardless of race and religion, can join the celebration. They can watch the live performances from the comfort of their homes," Teng told the press yesterday.

the Investment Standing Committee, Industry and Commerce and Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) portfolio.

He said preparations for the virtual celebration cost about RM414,000.

He said the state government had come up with the celebration's theme of a "New Year, New Hope".

"After looking back at what we have gone through together last year, with having to face Covid-19, and staying at home for almost a year... we believe this is the best theme that represents it as with a new year, comes new hope."

He urged for Selangor folk to strictly comply with the standard operating procedures (SOP) at all times.

"It is worrying to see the number of cases spike in the last two weeks, as well as the number of people fined for not following the rules. Please take care of yourself and your families."

He said the state government had launched an online campaign called "Chinese New Year Wish and Win", which aimed to pick the three best Chinese New Year wishes.

"This is the first time that the state government is holding a

mass virtual festivity celebration and we want to make the most of it. The online campaign will run from Jan 24 until Feb 3. We have been receiving hundreds of entries.

"Three winners will be picked and each are entitled to win RM168 worth of ang pao. The amount was chosen because of its significant meaning (in the Mandarin language), which means 'leading a prosperous life'."

The virtual celebration will showcase 12 entertainment performances, with 68 minutes of live broadcast on the Facebook platform.

Selangor govt goes online for CNY celebration

The virtual celebration is the best alternative for the Chinese community to celebrate the new year, says state exco

THE Selangor state government's Chinese New Year (CNY) celebration this year will be held online due to the resurgence in Covid-19 infections in the country, replacing physical celebrations that were usually held previously.

Selangor state executive councilor (exco) for investment, industry and commerce, and small and medium enterprises (SMEs) Datuk Teng Chang Khim said the virtual celebration, which will take place on Feb 12, 2021, is the best alternative for the Chinese community to celebrate the new year amid the new normal.

"We have had physical open houses, but this year we have prepared a special virtual programme as the Covid-19 pandemic does not allow us to hold huge ceremonies in the country," he said in a virtual press briefing yesterday.

The special programme can be streamed via Selangor Menteri

Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari's Facebook page, as well as several other media organisations' pages who have partnered Invest Selangor to showcase the hour-long programme.

It will begin at 9pm and consists of 12 performances, including lion

dance, horse dance, puppet and opera show.

Teng said the total cost for the celebration stands at RM414,000.

In conjunction with the celebration, the state government also holds a competition for creative CNY wishes which will end on Thursday.

everyone will comply with the standard operating procedures (SOPs) even if a small gathering is allowed.

"We have to follow the SOPs to help curb the spread of Covid-19 infections. A lot of people are still not complying with the SOPs, which is reflected by the amount of fines issued daily to those who have breached the restrictions," said Teng.

Meanwhile, SMEs and micro-businesses are now able to register on both Shopee and Lazada platforms for the Selangor E-Bazar CNY Campaign, which will end on March 7, 2021.

The programme — which aims to assist small businesses to embrace digitalisation during the pandemic — enables SMEs to enjoy discounts worth RM2 million allocated by the Selangor state government.

A total of 25,000 SMEs are expected to participate in the bazaar, including 12,500 new sellers.

SMEs previously generated RM1.39 billion in ripple effect to the economy through direct sales worth RM43.76 million from the total of RM3 million in vouchers + channelled by the state government + from two e-Bazar campaigns last year.

的营业时间为早上6时至中午12时，每逢周一关闭消毒。

此外，巫统雪州联委会主席丹斯里诺奥马和大马中小型企业家联盟组织（IKHLAS）主席莫哈末里祖安也前往该早市巡视，并对早市小贩无须搬迁获准在原处营业的结果认同。

诺奥马提到，该早市的搬迁风波越演越烈，已影响小贩生计，相关单位不应在有别的组织或党派介入，及小贩居民激烈表达强烈不满后，才有此结论。

莫哈末里祖安则声称，有部分小贩对此结果心存怀疑；因此，他希望这项结果不会在不久的将来出现变卦。


