CAC di Dewan MBSJ pindah ke Shah Alam tampung peningkatan kes

Shah Alam: Stadium Malawati di Seksyen 13, di sini, akan dijadikan Pusat Penilaian COVID-19 (CAC) bagi Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah (PKD) Petaling mulai hari ini.

Pengarah Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Selangor, Datuk Dr Shafiq Ngadiman, berkata stadium itu akan menggantikan CAC PKD Petaling terletak di Dewan Majlis Bandaraya Subang Jaya (MBSJ), SS15 sebelum ini.

Beliau berkata, Stadium Malawati dianggarkan boleh memuatkan antara 1,000 hingga 1,500 pesakit.

"CAC di Dewan MBSJ sebelum ini hanya boleh memuatkan maksimum hanya 500 pesakit.

"Susulan peningkatan kes yang semakin tinggi di daerah Petaling

kita memerlukan tempat yang lebih besar.

"Jadi, kita akan memindahkan CAC PKD Petaling di Subang ke Shah Alam," katanya ketika dihubungi semalam.

CAC Stadium Malawati akan beroperasi dari Isnin hingga Jumaat bermula jam 8 pagi hingga 4 petang, manakala Sabtu jam 8

pagi hingga 12 tengah hari dan tidak beroperasi pada hari Ahad.

Selangor mempunyai 19 CAC di sembilan daerah, masing-masing satu di Petaling, Gombak, Hulu Selangor, Klang, Kuala Langat dan Sepang, manakala dua di Hulu Langat, Kuala Selangor (tiga) dan Sabak Bernam (sembilan).

Terdahulu, satu pesanan menerusi WhatsApp tular dalam kalangan penduduk sekitar Shah Alam yang memaklumkan PKD Petaling akan melakukan pengambilan Stadium Malawati untuk dijadikan CAC.

Orang awam dinasihat tidak ke kawasan berkenaan, selain untuk urusan berkaitan saja.

Tekad besarkan anak sakit tulang rapuh

KUALA SELANGOR: Sepasang suami isteri tekad membesar-kan anak mereka yang disahkan menghidap '*osteogenesis imperfecta*' atau tulang rapuh biarpun tidak mengetahui sampai bila jangka hayatnya.

Bagi Nur Rhoshida Rosli, 34, dan suaminya Mohd. Nazri Mohd. Anuar, 36, mereka berdua perlu cekal menjaga anak bongsu mereka, Muhammad Adam Mikail (Adam) berusia setahun, yang hanya mampu terbaring dan bergantung sepenuhnya kepada alat bantuan pernafasan.

Nur Rhoshida berkata, dia pasrah apabila hasil imbasan yang dilakukan di sebuah hospital mendapati beberapa tulang bayi dikandungnya itu patah pada pertengahan 2019.

"Selepas sebulan melahir-kannya di Hospital Sungai Buloh pada hujung tahun sama, doktor mengesahkan anak keempat saya menghidap pe-

nyakit tulang rapuh.

"Keadaan ini turut menyebabkan Adam ditempatkan di unit rawatan rapi bayi (NICU) selama empat bulan sebelum dibenarkan pulang," katanya ketika ditemui di rumahnya di Taman Senohong, Jeram di sini semalam.

Sementara itu, Mohd. Nazri berkata, dia reda dengan ketentuan Allah dan memohon orang ramai supaya mendoakan kesejahteraan anaknya.

"Saya bersyukur kerana menerima bantuan Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) terutama keperluan susu, lampin pakai buang dan kos sewa rumah," katanya yang berpendapatan RM1,000 sebulan sebagai pembantu kedai.

"K alau mahkamah syariah mendapati pernikahan itu sah, pasangan terhakti perlu mendatarkan perkahwinan dan membayar denda jika tidak sah, perkahwinan itu terhalang," kata Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) Datuk Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad.

Beliau berkata demikian bagi mengulas mengenai pernikahan menggunakan

jururilah tanpu tudiah yang dibongkar Bahagian Pengurusan Pengsaktaaan Jais apabila menuduh seorang bekas kakitangan awam di sebuah premis di Puncak Alam

Shah Alam, Khamis lalu. Mohd Shahzihan berkata, lebih 100 pasangan dinikah sejak mengemaskinakan khidmat jururilah tidak bertauliah itu sejak lebih sebulan lalu diminta tampil segera ke Jais untuk membaik siasatan berkara itu.

Menurutnya, pihaknya perlu menjalankan siasatan terhadap semua pasangan itu dan mengambil keterangan mereka yang

terhabit lagi menentukan sama ada pernikahan diajalankan sah dari segi syarak atau pun sebaliknya.

Katanya, sekiranya didapati pernikahan mereka tidak sah, mereka perlu melaksanakan proses selanjutnya sama ada ber nikah semula atau perlu mengambil tindakan lain.

Beliau berkata, buat masa ini pihaknya memerlukan

"Jais melihat kepada dua elemen iaitu peradaongan dan juga penerapan hukum.

"Ini yang kita perlukan mereka tampil. Kita perlu siasat dengan teliti kerana ia membabitkan hukum, bukan boleh main-main," katanya ketika dihubungi semalam.

Beliau berkata, buat masa ini pihaknya memerlukan

kerjasama segera daripada semua yang terlibat untuk meneruskan siasatan.

"Nikah sindiket seperti ini macam yang kita ketahui tidak sama seperti juremikah bertauliah, ada kemungkinan maksum diberi tidak tepat misalnya pernah berkahwin satu, dia atan lebih."

"Kita tak saka pernikahan itu tidak sah dari segi hukum, tetapi mereka perlu tampil untuk disiasat," katanya.

Metro Ahad, semalam melaporkan lelaki yang menawarkan khidmat sebagai jururilah tidak bertauliah itu mengenang caj RM5,000 untuk setiap pernikahan dengan alasan ia bersifat khas kepada penyediaan dokumen.

Dilaporkan, lelaki berkenaan yang turut meletakkan legastri itu bersama isteri dan anaknya pernah ditahan Jais sebelum ini.

Boleh muat 1,500 pesakit Covid-19

Shah Alam: Stadium Malawati di sini beroperasi sebagai Pusat Penilaian Covid-19 sebelum menempatkan mereka di hospital, Pusat Kuaran dan Rawatan Covid-19 (PKRC) di Serdang atau diarah menjalani kuarantine di rumah, katanya.

Pengarah Kesihatan Selangor Datuk Dr Shamsi Ngadiman berkata, CAC itu menggantikan CAC Dewan Majlis Perbandaran Sungai Besar (MPSB) di SS15 berikutan kapasiti yang boleh menampung lebih ramai pesakit Covid-19.

"CAC di Dewan MPSB boleh memuatkan 500 pesakit sehari berbanding CAC di Stadium Malawati yang boleh menampung 1,500 pesakit. Keputusan ini dibuat berdasarkan jumlah kes baharu di daerah Petaling yang meningkat," katanya semalam.

Beliau berkata CAC itu beroperasi dari Isnin hingga Sabtu dan ditutup pada Ahad.

"CAC itu memainkan peranan menilai pesakit Covid-19 sebelum menempatkan mereka di hospital, Pusat Kuaran dan Rawatan Covid-19 (PKRC) di Serdang atau diarah menjalani kuarantine di rumah," katanya.

Beliau berkata, selain Stadium Malawati, CAC turut beroperasi di lapan daerah lain seperti di Klang, Kuala Selangor, Sabak Bernam, Gombak, Hulu Selangor, Hulu Langat, Sepang dan Kuala Langat.

Sementara itu, tinjauan di Stadium Malawati mendapati petugas Pejabat Kesihatan Daerah Petaling, Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam dan Jabatan Pertubuhan Awam sibuk membuat persiapan bagi memastikan operasi CAC berkenaan berjalan lancar. - Bernama

3,731 kes harian, 3,369 pesakit sembuh serta 15 kematian direkodkan

Tujuh kluster baharu dilaporkan

PUTRAJAYA – Kluster melibatkan majlis pergebuian serta perhimpunan keagamaan antara tujuh kluster baharu dikenal pasti semalam, yang antara lain penyumbang kepada 3,731 kes harian Covid-19.

Tujuh kluster baharu yang dilaporkan itu membabitkan tiga kluster berkaitan tempat kerja, dua kluster komuniti serta masing-masing satu kluster keagamaan dan kluster melibatkan kumpulan berisiko tinggi.

Selangor kekal mencatatkan kes baharu tertinggi iaitu sebanyak 1,608 kes dengan 1,025 kes daripada kluster-kluster dan sarungan kontak rapat yang aktif di lapangan, diikuti Johor (499 kes) dan Kuala Lumpur (372 kes).

Terdapat 15 kematian dilaporkan di Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Sabah, Sarawak, Putrajaya, Kedah dan Johor melibatkan lapan lelaki dan tujuh wanita berusia 18 hingga 94 tahun.

Tan Sri Dr. Noor Hisham Abdulrahman berkata, sebanyak 81 kluster melaporkan pertambahan, dengan kes tertinggi memahatkan Kluster Industri Seriam (246 kes), Kluster Gudang Salak Tinggi (127 kes) dan Kluster Tapak Bina Lembah Selatan (99 kes).

Menurutnya, kluster baharu yang dilaporkan ialah Kluster Seri Iskandar di Beluran dan Miri, Sarawak dengan 59 kes iaitu kes indeks bergejala serta melibatkan satu majlis pergebuian.

Kluster Lorong Mawar di Hilir Perak, Perak dengan 14 kes iaitu

kes indeks bergejala serta melibatkan satu perhimpunan keagamaan di Teluk Intan.

"Kluster Ampang Campuran di Cheras, Kuala Lumpur dan Hulu Langat, Selangor dengan 14 kes iaitu kes indeks bergejala serta melibatkan pengham dan pekerja sebuah pusat jagam di Lorong Ikan Jelawat, Kampung Ampang Campuran, Ampang" katanya dalam satu kenyataan akhir di sini semalam.

Beliau berkata, Kluster Tapak Bina Lembah Selatan pula di Sepang melibatkan 222 kes hasil saringan bersasar sebuah tapak binaan di Bandar Baru Lembah Selatan, Dengkil, Sepang.

"Kluster Jalan Bagin dikenal pasti di Sahak Bernam dan Klang dengan 32 kes iaitu kes indeks bergejala, mungkin kluster ini melibatkan sebuah pusat pengajian di Jalan Bagin Terap, Kampong Baru 38, Sahak Bernam.

"Selain itu, Kluster Jalan Gangsa Dua di Johor Bahru, Johor dengan 30 kes iaitu hasil saringan bersasar sebuah kilang di Jalan

SHAH ALAM – Stadium Malawati yang terletak di Seksyen 13 di sini akan beroperasi sebagai Pusat Penilaian Covid-19 (CAC) bermula hari ini.

Pengarah Kesihatan Selangor, Datuk Dr. Sha'ari Ngadiman berkata, CAC berkenaan akan menggantikan CAC Dewan Majlis Perbandaran Subang Jaya (MPSJ) di SS15, Subang Jaya bagi daerah Petaling.

Katanya, pengoperasian itu susulan kapasiti stadium itu yang boleh menampung lebih ramai pesakit Covid-19.

"CAC Stadium Malawati boleh menempatkan sehingga 1,500 pesakit berbanding Dewan MPSJ yang hanya mempunyai kapasiti seramai 500 pesakit sehari.

"Keputusan ini dibuat berikutan jumlah kes baharu di daerah Petaling yang meningkat," katanya ketika dihubungi di sini semalam.

Setakat kelmarin, jumlah kumulatif kes di Petaling mencecah 19,609 merangkumi mukim Bukit Raja, Damansara, Petaling, Sungai Buloh dan penjara.

Kata beliau, CAC berkenaan akan beroperasi dari Isnin hing-

ga Sabtu sahaja dan berperanan menilai pesakit Covid-19 sebelum menempatkan mereka di hospital, Pusat Kuaran dan Rawatan Covid-19 (PKRC) di Serdang atau hanya diarahkan menjalani kuaran di kediaman masing-masing.

"Selain itu, CAC akan menjalankan penilaian dan pelepasan kepada kes positif yang telah melebihi 10 hari.

"CAC juga turut beroperasi di lapan daerah lain seperti di Klang, Kuala Selangor, Sabak Bernam, Gombak, Hulu Selangor, Hulu Langat, Sepang dan Kuala Langat," jelasnya.

Setia ke hujung nyawa

KUALA LANGAT — Kasih sa yang seorang isteri tidak berbelah bahagi apabila setia menjaga suaminya yang mempunyai penyakit tiga serangkal lebih lima tahun lalu di Kampung Kebun Bharu Batu 10 di sini.

Rosni Mohd. Kassim, 61, dan suaminya, Sajeri Liwon, 65, yang berkahwin sejak 36 tahun itu tidak dikurniakan zuriat.

Mereka sebelum ini bekerja di sebuah rangkaian pasar raya besar di Kuala Lumpur.

"Suami saya menghidap kencing manis kronik, darah tinggi dan jantung yang menyukarkan pergerakannya dan lebih banyak terbaring di katil.

"Pergerakan saya juga terbatas dan memakai tongkat akibat terjatuh beberapa kali sewaktu bekerja di pasar raya berkenaan 10 tahun lalu.

"Kehidupan memang susah kerana wang simpanan yang ada sudah habis digunakan dan

kini hanya bergantung kepada keprihatinan jiran yang menghulurkan barang keperluah," katanya semalam.

Rosni berkata, mereka juga bergantung hidup kepada bantuan bulanan RM250 daripada Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS).

Katanya, keadaan kesihatan yang tidak memberangsangkan menyebabkan mereka lebih berada di rumah.

"Ini dugaan hidup kami, saya akan terus menjaga suami sehingga hujung nyawa," ujarnya.

Sementara itu, Pengurus Pertubuhan Peladang Kawasan Kuala Langat, Dr. Abdul Razak Khasbullah yang melawat pasangan itu telah menyumbangkan katil dan barang keperluan harian kepada mereka.

Stadium turned into Covid-19 testing centre

SHAH ALAM: The Malawati Stadium here has begun operating as a Covid-19 Assessment Centre (CAC) for the Petaling district.

Selangor Health director Datuk Dr Sha'ari Ngadiman said the CAC, which can accommodate more patients, would replace the one at Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MPSJ) Hall in SS15, Subang Jaya.

"The CAC at MPSJ Hall only has a capacity of 500 patients a day, while Malawati Stadium can accommodate up to 1,500 patients.

"The decision was made due to the rising number of cases in the Petaling district," he said yesterday.

Dr Sha'ari said the CAC at Malawati Stadium would operate from today to Saturday.

At the CAC, Covid-19 patients will be assessed before they are sent to hospital, Covid-19 Quarantine and Treatment Centre in Serdang or told to undergo quarantine at home.

Besides Malawati Stadium, there are also CACs operating in eight other districts. — Bernama

Smoothing over pothole problem

DBKL has set up a task force and hotline dedicated to handling complaints on poor road conditions in Kuala Lumpur. Meanwhile, in Selangor, the government is working with JKR to identify structurally damaged roads to fix them quickly. >283

SOME 60% of roads in Selangor are "expired" and many are structurally damaged, causing issues such as potholes and cracks to be a common sight.

State infrastructure and public works minister Datuk Seri Dr. Zambry bin Ali said up to 80% of industry roads outside urban areas like Petaling Jaya and Shah Alam are between 10 and 40 years old and past their life span for an upgrade.

"We usually replace industry roads between 25 to 30 years depending on usage."

Under this permit, upgrading works have to be done, particularly to the inadequate and old road junctions.

He revealed that before this was done, temporary measures like road closures or detours may help postpone road closures.

He noted that another task committee, comprising the state government, several local agencies, vehicle owners, state regulators, damage assessors and contractors, has been set up.

Ministers added that the main problem lies compounded to the fact that there are more than 100,000 vehicles in the state of Selangor, which could cause delays in resolving road issues.

In Selangor, there are five authority bodies responsible for roads: Federal Land Development Authority (FLDA), Selangor (SLB) – state roads, local councils – in Kuala Lumpur, Petaling Jaya, Shah Alam and Kepong, and Transport – agricultural roads.

"Selangor is the second largest jurisdiction of the Malaysian Highway Authority and project concessionaires," he said.

"Because there are many agencies involved, there are such budgetary issues and lack of communication between different road stakeholders."

"Local councils and Selangor (SLB) roads under Muaras Datukpanjang Road Research Institute (MDDRRI) fund, whereas there is no extra money for federal roads," he said.

He added that regular cuts were

difficult to measure as it would depend on the size of the road.

According to Selangor's road life span, to renew, repair or upgrade old 60-year-old roads, Selangor state drivers pay toll fees being considered as additional revenue.

"Older roadbeds could be reconstructed, especially those owned by industry and development companies," he said.

"In 2008, 60% of the state's local roads had to be let to contractors, dependent on the cost of daily work," he said.

To prevent roads from being dug up, Selangor's chief minister Dato' Sri Dr. Ahmad Zahid Hamidi began to introduce the Selangor Traffic Order 2018, where toll rates such as toll fees for heavy vehicles (HVs) and heavy vehicles with trailers will be set at a constant underground toll by 2020.

"The new law will be possible to use areas and developments," he said.

"It is also proposed to consider a road toll for vehicles under 2.5 tonnes, in toll tube collectors either as distance theory and space to finance the road," he said.

"In the meantime, the state has plans to introduce new methods of road safety and maintenance," he added.

He explained, "jet and thermal methods are being considered as well as being considered to fit potholes and cracks."

"In particular, jet can remove existing of dirt road, instead, it coats the pothole with a foamed bitumen, which is durable and long-lasting," he said.

"A chemical patch uses a liquid metal paste to within existing fissures and cracks, which can then be used to fill the hole."

One novel method being considered is the use of artificial intelligence (AI) in driverless vehicles to automatically monitor and detect potholes.

"The AI system will pick out potholes and other road surface irregularities and provide a better way to use conventional roads," he said.

"We are currently testing the new technology to determine its effectiveness and viability," he said.

Routine checks conducted on KL traders

LOCAL authorities are continuing enforcement operations to ensure businesses abide by Covid-19 standard operating procedures during the second movement control order.

In Kuala Lumpur, enforcement officers routinely carry out checks so that roadside traders under the Federal Territories Ministry's Free Trade Area initiative adhere to guidelines.

"During an operation by Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) at Jalan Desa Rejang 1 in Setiawangsa, officers found that 11 out of 87 traders did not have a valid licence to operate.

"Those traders were issued compounds for operating without proper permits under Section 3(1) of the Traders Licensing (WPKL) 2016 bylaws," DBKL said in a statement.

A further five traders were found to be in the process of applying for a licence from DBKL.

Officers also rearranged traders' tents to ensure physical distancing, installed safety tapes and placed water barriers to ensure traffic safety.

Under the initiative, anyone can apply for a temporary six-month licence to set up a stall.

It is meant to help those who

have lost their source of income amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

Meanwhile, Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) took action against businesses illegally run by foreigners.

"Monitoring and enforcement is carried out every day, while larger scale operations are based on the situation," an MPS spokesperson said.

In an operation, MPS enforcement officers raided an unregistered storage facility outside

Selayang Wholesale Market.

Some 18 boxes of seafood and vegetables were confiscated from the facility, which were used by foreign traders to sell illegally.

Workers from KDEB Waste Management helped to clean up the area as well as dispose of accumulated debris.

Action was taken under Section 3 of the Trade, Business and Industrial Licensing By-law (MPS) 2007. — **By SHALINI RAVINDRAN**

Seeking chance to earn some income

Clothes, shoe traders in Ampang night market want MPAJ to allow them to sell other items

NIGHT market traders in Ampang who sell clothes and shoes and are prohibited from operating during the movement control order period, want Ampang Jaya Municipal Council to allow them to sell products other than what is stated in their licence.

MPAJ Zone 23 councillor Mohamad Samat said about 10 clothes traders from the Taman Melur night market had reached out to him to ask for the council's permission to sell other items, such as food.

"Currently, clothes, accessories and shoe traders are not allowed to operate at night markets under MPAJ's jurisdiction.

"This also includes watches and spectacles as it involves visitors trying on the products.

Battling Covid-19

"This means that throughout the MCO, those traders do not have any income."

"So, some of them asked if they could sell food at the night market temporarily during this MCO."

"I think it is a good idea, so that they can earn some income," he said.

Mohamad said he had written to MPAJ president Mohd Fauzi Mohd Yatim on Saturday to seek his permission to allow these traders to sell products that were allowed under the night market standard operating procedures (SOP).

"It is a small matter and their trading licence will remain."

"I hope MPAJ can give the permission for the traders to temporarily sell other products such as food and face masks, instead of the products described in their licence."

The clothes and shoes traders do not have another way of earning an income," he said.

According to National Security Council guidelines dated Feb 4, night markets are allowed to open from 4pm to 10pm with strict SOP compliance and under the supervision of Rela volunteers or local councils.

However, it does not specify which product categories are not allowed to be sold at night markets.

Different local authorities in the Klang Valley, however, interpret the SOP differently.

Clothes traders in Setia Alam night market are open for business, but shoppers are not allowed to try out the items.

For example, night markets under Shah Alam City Council currently allow all traders to operate, while Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) has prohibited clothing and shoe traders from operating.

A trader, who declined to be named, said this grey area meant that some clothes traders at night markets in Petaling Jaya were operating but with strict SOP in place, such as not allowing shoppers to try on the clothes.

Meanwhile, Kuala Lumpur Night Market Association secretary Charles James Roy, who had been championing the welfare of night market traders, urged DBKL to specify products that were allowed to be sold at night markets.

"We only received text messages from DBKL that clothes and shoes are not allowed to be sold at night markets during the MCO," he said, adding that there should be greater clarity on the matter.

KLANG: It is important for both the Perikatan Nasional government and the state government to work together in fighting the Covid-19 pandemic, says Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari.

The Menteri Besar said he was open to the synchronisation and sharing of data between the Federal Government's MySejahtera and the state government's Selangkah appli-

cations. Both applications were developed to monitor the Covid-19 pandemic.

"In my first meeting with the Health Minister (Datuk Seri) Dr Adham (Baba), we highlighted about synchronisation of the data.

"Recently, when we met up with the Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Khairy (Jamaluddin), it was raised again to combine data and analysis," he said in a dialogue with Star Media Group adviser Datuk Seri Wong Chun Wai,

Karangkraf Group chairman Datuk Dr Hussamuddin Yaacub and former Utusan Melayu group chief editor Tan Sri Johan Jaafar.

The discussion, which is in collaboration with the Asia News Network, was conducted in Wong's Facebook Timeline and titled "Covid-19 Fight: Red Zone Selangor".

Amirudin, who was answering Hussamuddin's question if the data from both the applications would be synchronised, said there was a positive outcome in his latest meet-

ing with Dr Adham on the synchronisation of data.

He also said Dr Adham had agreed for the state's officer to go to the MySejahtera command centre in line with the synchronisation plan.

"With accurate data, there could be better analysis and projection as to the path and location of the pandemic," he said, citing how the state government was able to predict an outbreak in Jalan Othman market based on the analysis of data.

Stadium to be Covid assessment centre

SHAH ALAM: The Malawati Stadium here will operate as a Covid Assessment Centre (CAC) for the Petaling district beginning today.

Selangor Health director Datuk Dr Sha'ari Ngadiman said the CAC at the stadium, which will be able to accommodate more patients, would replace the one at the Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MPSJ) Hall in SS15.

"The CAC at MPSJ Hall only has a capacity of 500 patients a day, while the Malawati Stadium can accommodate up to 1,500 patients. The decision was made due to the increasing number of new cases in the district," he said yesterday.

The CAC will operate from Monday to Saturday. It will be closed on Sunday. Covid-19 patients will be assessed at the CAC before they are sent to hospitals, the Covid-19 Quarantine and Treatment Centre in Serdang or ordered to undergo home quarantine.

Besides Malawati Stadium, there are also CACs operating in eight other districts, namely Klang, Kuala Selangor, Sabak Bernam, Gombak, Hulu Selangor, Hulu Langat, Sepang and Kuala Langat. — Bernama
