Shah Alam: Selangor mensasarkan penurunan 50 peratus kadar jangkitan COVID-19 di tempat kerja khususnya di kawasan perindustrian dan perkilangan sekiranya program Pencegahan Penularan di Kawasan Titik Panas (POIS) dilaksanakan di seluruh negeri itu.

Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari, berkata pelaksanaan program itu dianggap perlu kerana 80 peratus kes di Selangor berpunca daripada tempat kerja.

"Sekarang pusat epik jangkitan di Selangor adalah kawasan perindustrian iaitu kira-kira 70 hingga 80 peratus. Maka, kalau kilang dapat ikut sistem ini, saya yakin kes di tempat kerja boleh dikurangkan.

Beliau berkata demikian selepas melancarkan program POIS di Kilang Perusahaan Nestle Malaysia Bhd dekat sini, semalam.

Amirudin berkata, program POIS itu memerlukan majikan dan tempat kerja menjalankan prosedur operasi standard (SOP) yang ketat bagi mengelakkan penularan COVID-19.

"Antaranya melakukan rutin tapisan pekerja di semua pintu masuk, menyemak sejarah perjalanan pekerja di samping pelaksanaan ujian saringan secara berkala," katanya. BERNAMA

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11 peniaga terbeban bayaran caj bulanan

Hulu Langat: Sebelas daripada 14 penjaja di Pekan Batu 18 di sini, memohon permit untuk menjaja secara sah tahun lalu namun kadar caj bulanan sebanyak RM150 yang dikenakan mengusarkan mereka.

Seorang daripadanya, Sarizan Ismail, 56, berkata, dia tidak mampu membayar caj itu kerana keuntungan bulanan diterima tidak seberapa, apatah lagi ketika Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) akibat pandemik Covid-19 ketika ini.

Lebih dikesalkan apabila

Majlis Perbandaran Kajang (MPKJ) didakwa tidak menjelaskan mengenai caj bulanan itu lebih awal iaitu sebelum mereka membuat permohonan permit.

"Sebelum ini, pihak MPKJ datang minta kami (peniaga) buat permit, jadi saya dan peniaga lain buat permohonan tanpa kami tahu mengenai bayaran bulanan.

"Saya terkejut diberitahu perlu bayar RM150 sebulan ketika mengambil permit di pejabat MPKJ. Rahu lalu, malah kami diminta membayar RM185 (ketika itu) untuk bayaran bulanan, permit dan lain-lain urusan berkaitan

permit," katanya ketika ditemui, semalam.

Dia yang sudah berniaga lebih 22 tahun di situ tidak berpuas hati dengan alasan diberi MPKJ berhubung caj terbabit kerana mendakwa tapak berkenaan bukan tanah di bawah seliaan pihak berkuasa tempatan itu.

"Sejujurnya, saya tidak mampu bayar yuran bulanan kerana kedai saya hanya dibuka hujung minggu dan ketika ini jumlah pembeli berkurangan kerana PKP.

"Anggaran keuntungan saya peroleh RM50 sehari selepas ditolak modal. Itu tidak lagi termasuk bil air dan

elektrik digunakan kedai ketika beroperasi," katanya.

Seorang lagi peniaga, Roziah Lutun, 47, mengangap caj itu sebagai membebankan mereka yang haraj mengaut keuntungan yang tidak seberapa.

"Saya berniaga di kawasan ini sejak tiga tahun lalu dan menyewa tapak kedai daripada pemilik pada harga RM100 sebulan. Jika ditambah lagi bayaran bulanan kepada MPKJ, pastinya ia menambah bebanan bagi saya," katanya yang berharap ada penyelesaian yang lebih baik daripada MPKJ.

Terdahulu, peniaga me-

nyerahkan memorandum bantahan bayaran caj bulanan kepada pihak MPKJ serta Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (Adun) Dusan Tua, Edry Faizal Eddy Yusof.

Sementara itu, Pegawai Perhubungan Awam MPKJ Kamarul Izlan Sulaiman berkata, pihaknya mengenakan fi penajaan RM150 terhadap penjaja bagi semua jenis perniagaan di dalam kawasan pentadbirannya.

"Semua jenis perniagaan dijalankan di dalam kawasan MPKJ perlu dlesenkan atau diperminkan sebelum dibenarkan beroperasi termasuk di kawasan berkenaan.

"Berdasarkan bincangan 25 November 2020, ada hampir 20 binaan tanpa kelulusan di atas tanah kerajaan dan aktiviti perniagaan tanpa kelulusan di lokasi itu.

"Disebabkan itu, kami ambil inisiatif membolehkan aktiviti penajaan di situ dengan pengenaan fi penajaan RM150 sebulan," katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

Menurutnya, MPKJ sedia maklum aduan penjaja terbabit dan akan mempertimbangkan cadangan serta melakukan penambahbaikan.

Pihaknya juga mempertimbangkan permohonan Permit Perniagaan Sementara Pasca Covid-19 kepada 11 peniaga dikenal pasti di kawasan itu.

Selangor terima vaksin dibeli paling lewat Jun depan

SHAH ALAM – Kerajaan negeri menjangkakan memperoleh dua hingga lima juta dos vaksin Covid-19 yang dibeli, selewat-lewatnya Jun depan.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, pembelian semua vaksin itu dianggap penting bagi membantu kelancaran Program Imunisasi Covid-19 Kebangsaan.

"Kita setakat ini belum menentukan jumlah sebenar vaksin berkenaan, namun ia melibatkan kuantiti besar dan kos yang tinggi.

"Jika semuanya berjalan lancar, kita jangka akan memperolehnya seawal Mei atau Jun depan. Pengumuman rasmi mengenai proses agihan vaksin akan dibuat kelak," katanya ketika ditemui selepas melancarkan program Pencegahan Penularan di Kawasan Titik Panas (POIS) di Kilang Perusahaan Nestle, Seksyen 15, di sini semalam.

Bulan lalu, Amirudin memaklumkan kerajaan negeri merancang membeli tiga hingga lima juta dos vaksin Covid-19 sebagai tindakan mengawal penularan virus di Selangor.

Ketika ditanya mengenai status bekalan dan agihan vaksin Pfizer-

BioNTech, Amirudin menegaskan akan bertemu Menteri Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi merangkap Menteri Penyelaras Program Imunisasi Covid-19 Kebangsaan, Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar.

"Saya akan jumpa beliau (Khairy) hari ini (semalam) dengan perbincangan memfokuskan jumlah pengagihan vaksin di seluruh Selangor," jelasnya.

PETALING JAYA – Pemilik motosikal yang didapati bersalah mengubah suai ekzos sehingga mengganggu ketenteraman awam boleh dipenjarakan enam bulan atau denda RM2,000.

Pengarah Jabatan Siasatan dan Penguatkuasaan Trafik (JSPT) Bukit Aman, Datuk Azisman Alias berkata, pemilik motosikal juga perlu memastikan ekzos tidak diubah suai sehingga menyebabkan bunyi bising.

"Pihak polis juga boleh menahan motosikal tersebut sehingga pemilik motosikal mengambil langkah-langkah bagi menjamin kesalahan sama tidak berulang.

"Penggunaan ekzos bising ini menjadi trend bagi golongan

muda kerana dikatakan dapat meningkatkan kelajuan motosikal selain mencantikkan fizikal motosikal tersebut," katanya dalam satu kenyataan di sini semalam.

Mengulas lanjut, polis diberi kuasa untuk menyita motosikal di bawah peruntukan Seksyen 64 Akta Pengangkutan Jalan 1987 dengan tujuan untuk mengelakkan kesalahan sama berulang.

"Mengikut Kaedah 103 Kaedah-Kaedah Kenderaan Bermotor (Pembinaan Dan Penggunaan) 1959 setiap ekzos (dengan penyenyap) yang dipasang pada kenderaan bermotor hendaklah diselenggarakan supaya berada dalam keadaan yang baik.

"Mana-mana individu yang

membuat pengubahsuaian sedemikian adalah melakukan satu kesalahan mengikut kaedah berkenaan," jelasnya.

Katanya, JSPT sentiasa mengadakan operasi bersepadu dengan kerjasama jabatan dan agensi yang lain termasuk Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS).

"Menerusi operasi tersebut, bunyi ekzos motosikal akan diukur mengikut paras yang dibenarkan dan sekiranya paras bunyi melebihi daripada yang ditetapkan, JAS akan mengeluarkan kompaun saman ke atas pemilik motosikal.

"Sebarang pengubahsuaian yang ingin dilakukan hendaklah mendapatkan kelulusan daripada pihak Jabatan Pengangkutan Jalan," katanya.

Dangerous stretch for motorists

Faded road markings on Jalan Sungai Bertih in Klang pose a risk to users

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MOTORISTS in Klang are troubled over faded road lines on Jalan Sungai Bertih as they pose a danger to road users.

The worn-out markings are meant to show that motorists must give way 80m from the intersection of Jalan Teluk Pulai and Jalan Sungai Bertih.

Most of the time, motorists are unaware that they have entered the lane meant for oncoming traffic.

Resident Meor Zukni Asarudin, 42, who works for an engineering firm, said the absence of clear delineated lanes not only confused motorists new to the area but also posed a danger to road users.

"Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Engineering Department has neglected to refresh the thermoplastic road line paint with different shaped lines, arrows and cau-

tion words," he pointed out.

"The road lines have faded since the past two years as hundreds of vehicles use the road each day."

Meor Zukni added that accidents and near misses occurred at the point where the lane switched directions, just a short distance after motorists turned into Jalan Sungai Bertih from Jalan Teluk Pulai.

"MPK has neglected the upkeep of the roads.

"In fact, the lines on other roads such as Jalan Teluk Pulai and Jalan Sungai Udang also need to be repainted.

"Motorists want the council to instal two different reflectors, yellow reflectors to guide motorists at night and red ones as a delineator to warn motorists that they should not enter the next lane," he said.

Fung Kok Loong, 47, who owns a motorcycle shop opposite Jalan Sungai Bertih, said from January to

February this year, there were at least three accidents involving cars and motorcycles as motorists were not aware of the lane switch because of the faded lines.

"It is extremely dangerous.

"MPK must use the allocated Malaysian Road Records Information System (Marris) Federal Government fund to repair the road quickly," he added.

Local trader, Razali Yacob, 55, said the faded road markings caused confusion among motorists.

"I agree that quality road reflectors must be installed for people's safety.

"The monies collected from assessment taxes must be used for these basic amenities.

"Do not let tragedy strike before action is initiated," he added.

MPK Engineering Department Zamri عثمان said the council had a schedule and would have the roads painted.

Monsoon drain upgrade in PJS1 ends decade-long flood issue

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A POORLY designed monsoon drain in Taman Kanagapuram, Petaling Jaya, has been upgraded after more than a decade of flooding woes.

Bukit Gasing assemblyman Rajiv Rishyakaran said he had raised this issue with the relevant authorities as early as 2013 and was glad the drain was upgraded at the end of last year.

"This drain flows from Petaling Jaya Old Town towards PJS1 and eventually into the Sungai Klang," explained Rajiv.

"The monsoon drain is built with concrete slabs but a 150m stretch of this drain at PJS1 narrows as it is not reinforced with concrete slabs.

"When there is a downpour, the drain overflows and floods Taman Kanagapuram.

"In the past, Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) would desludge the drain to enable better flow."

Last year, a contractor building a new Tamil primary school at PJS1 upgraded the monsoon drain,

which was right next to it, and since then, there had been no more flooding complaints from Taman Kanagapuram residents, he added.

He noted that the land was formerly occupied by Kampung Muniandy squatters, who vacated the land for the school to be built and enabled the drain upgrade works to be carried out properly.

He said under the Bukit Gasing constituency, there were eight

flood hotspots because of drainage issues, which were gradually being addressed.

The hotspots were Jalan Railway, Jalan Carey, Jalan 1/3, Jalan Templer, SJKT Vivekananda, Jalan 18/11, Taman Kanagapuram and Section 12.

"We have addressed the flooding issue in most of these areas with the help of MBPJ and the relevant authorities over the years," he said.

Air Selangor to source downstream

Storage ponds to serve as backup water supply in case of river pollution

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KLANG: Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd has initiated various efforts to counter the inconvenience of unscheduled water supply disruptions in the Klang Valley.

One of the initiatives implemented is sourcing water from the downstream flow of a river and storing it in ponds.

Air Selangor chief executive officer Suhaimi Kamaralzaman said these ponds act as river security because their water could be used if river pollution happens.

"If the river is polluted, we can shut the flow of the water into the ponds and draw water from there (the ponds) while the river is being cleaned up," Suhaimi said recently.

Currently, the Semenyih 2 and Labohan Dagang water treatment plants use this method and more plants are being built to take advantage of storage ponds.

Suhaimi explained that the old method of building treatment plants only tapped upstream water as opposed to downstream water as the latter was generally dirtier.

"The further downstream, the dirtier the water is typically, so these retaining ponds act as a pre-treatment process to ensure water that is let into the plants is clean," he said.

According to Suhaimi, the old method of building plants located them upstream near the mountains to facilitate water to be pumped from there.

"That was the more conventional

method of building water treatment plants in the 1980s and 1990s," said Suhaimi, adding that this started changing as technology improved.

He said that Air Selangor is one of the pioneers of the technology and was shortlisted for a Global Water Award.

"We were one of four public water companies that were shortlisted for the awards in Spain in April 2020 but we could not go because of the Covid-19 restrictions," said Suhaimi.

The other three shortlisted water companies were from India, Israel and Saudi Arabia.

He added that one of the criteria mentioned in Air Selangor's submission to the awards was the off-river water storage system.

"It impressed them (the awards organisers) a lot in terms of a newer way of approaching water treatment," he noted.

Suhaimi said Air Selangor would also be using the method to build the Rasau treatment plant downstream of the Klang River in the next four years.

"We are taking it downstream and putting the water in a series of eight ponds, and then drawing water from that.

"The new plant is timely as there is a huge demand for water in Klang and we are trying to meet it by bringing downstream water closer to where the demand is," said Suhaimi.

He added that while river pollution could not be completely stopped in the near future, the

turnaround time would be much faster with this method in the event of any water supply disruption.

Given that the Rasau water treatment plant is relying on relatively dirty downstream water, Air Selangor is putting in place measures to ensure the water is properly cleaned.

"We are working with our overseas partners to make sure sufficient technology is in place to cater for the treatment processing required," said Suhaimi.

One of the methods being looked at is pre-ozonation, which is technically using ozone to disinfect the water before it is drawn into the plant.

"The dirtier the water, the costlier the technology but if it needs to be done, we will do it," he added.

IT WAS all smiles and joy for 152 students from low-income families as they each received RM50 ahead of the school session that is set to resume next month.

A total of RM7,600 was distributed to students living in Kampung Baru Damansara Section 17A and Pangsapuri Damansara Bistari Section 19 in Petaling Jaya to ease the burden of low-income families.

Bukit Gasing assemblyman Rajiv Rishyakaran and Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPP) councillor for Zone 9 Loyis Uding, presented the vouchers to the primary and secondary schoolchildren during a symbolic handover ceremony at Kafe Integrasi Ar Rahmah Damansara Baru last weekend.

"We initially wanted to distribute the vouchers last year but it was delayed as I was undergoing a minor surgery as well as due to the movement control order in January," said Loyis.

Loyis said he and Rajiv had also supported other families preparing for back-to-school season in previous years.

"We contributed to the families at Pangsapuri Damansara Bistari last year. This time, we decided to include Kampung Baru Damansara," said Loyis.

Rajiv said: "The timing is quite good now as students will go back to school in March."

He said the RM50 voucher from Popular bookstore would give families the flexibility to choose the items they needed most while easing their financial burden when

their children return to school.

"I sympathise with parents who went through hardship to get a laptop for their children to learn online.

"For those in the lower-income group, especially those who have more than one child, getting them back to school will incur a lot of expenses.

"Each family may also have different needs, that is why we decided to do this instead of giving them items," added Rajiv.

Also present at the handover ceremony were Pangsapuri Damansara Bistari management committee representative Rosita Md Nor and Village Community Management Council (MPKK) representative Ang Siew Eng who received vouchers to be distributed to other students in the community.

S'gor targeting to halve Covid cases

➤ Special programme launched to prevent workplace clusters

SHAH ALAM: Under its Prevention of Outbreak at Ignition Site (POIS) programme, Selangor is targeting a 50% reduction in workplace Covid-19 infections, especially in industrial and manufacturing areas.

Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the implementation of the programme was considered necessary because 80% of cases in Selangor were from workplaces, reported Bernama.

"The epicentre of infections in Selangor is from the industrial area, representing about 70% to 80%. So if the factories can follow this programme, I am confident there will be a reduction in workplace cases," he said.

"This can be seen through the POIS programme, which was conducted at the Nestle Malaysia Bhd factory, where the infection rate there is less than 1%," he said during an event at the factory yesterday.

The event was also attended by Selangor Public Health, Unity, Women and Family Development committee chairman Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud and Nestle chief executive officer Juan Aranols.

Amirudin said that under the programme, employers must ensure that the standard operating procedures (SOP)

are strictly observed to prevent the spread of the Covid-19 virus.

The SOP include routine screening of workers at all entrances, reviewing the travel history of employees and conducting regular screening tests.

He said for now, the state government does not require employers to register for the programme but will look into its suitability in future.

"It involves a lot of things like licencing and operating permits.

"So for now, it is more of a voluntary process, and maybe we will try to work in line with what is available," he said.

On Jan 6, the Selangor Task Force for Covid-19 launched the POIS programme to prevent and reduce workplace clusters.

Registered employers need to set up committees, consisting several small groups with different functions, whose roles are to identify areas and activities at high risk.

The committees must formulate emergency action plans, reduce external contact and ensure that all SOP are complied with.

The POIS implementation initiative involves the cooperation of the state health department, Selgate Corporation Sdn Bhd, local authorities and the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers.

Selangor to reduce workplace Covid-19 cases with POIS

SELANGOR is targeting a 50% reduction in the rate of Covid-19 infection at workplaces, especially in industrial and manufacturing areas, if the Prevention of Outbreaks at Ignition Site (POIS) programme is implemented throughout the state.

Selangor Menteri Besar (MB) Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the implementation of the programme is necessary because 80% of cases in Selangor are from workplaces.

"Now, the epicentre of infection in Selangor is from the industrial area which is about 70% to 80%. So, if the factories can mainly follow this programme, I am confident that there will be a reduction in workplace cases.

"This can be seen through POIS which was conducted at Nestlé (M) Bhd factory, where the infection

rate there is less than 1%," he said when met by reporters after launching the POIS programme at Nestlé manufacturing factory. The event was also attended by Selangor Public Health, Unity, Women and Family Development committee chairman Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud and Nestlé CEO Juan Aranos.

Amirudin said the POIS programme requires employers to carry out strict standard operating procedures (SOPs) to prevent the spread of the Covid-19 infection, including conducting routine screening of workers at all entrances, reviewing the travel history of employees and conducting regular screening tests.

Amirudin said for now, the state government has not required all employers to register the system,

but will look into the suitability in the future.

"It involves a lot of things like licensing and operating permits. So, for now, it is more of a voluntary process and maybe, we will try to be in line with what is available," he said.

On Jan 6, the Selangor Task Force for Covid-19 launched the POIS programme to prevent and reduce workplace clusters.

Registered employers need to set up committees that formulate emergency action plans, reduce external contacts and ensure all SOPs are complied with.

The POIS implementation initiative involves cooperation of the State Health Department, Selgate Corp Sdn Bhd, local authorities and the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers. — *bernama*

大臣：防止火點爆發計劃 冀全面落實降50%感染率

(莎阿南22日讯)雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁指出，州政府目标透过全面落实“防止火点爆发”计划 (POIS)，将新冠肺炎感染群降低至50%，尤其是工业与制造业重镇地。

他指出，雪州共有80%确诊病例均源自职场，因此“防止火点爆发计划”势在必行。

“目前，雪州新冠肺炎确诊病例集中在工业地区，大约占70%至80%，因此，谈妥这些工厂都能参与并跟随这项计划，我相信职场感染的病例将会减少。”

他举例，自从在大马雀巢 (Nestle Malaysia) 工厂实施POIS计划后，该工厂的感染率即下降至少于1%。

他是今日为马来西亚雀巢制造厂的POIS计划进行推介仪式，并召开新闻发布会时，这么指出。

口处，向员工进行例行排查、审查员工的外出历史，以及进行定期筛检等。

“目前州政府并没强制要求所有雇主，必须注册并参与这项系统计划，但未来将探讨（强制）的适用性。”

他说，倘若强制所有雇主参与该项计划，将涉及许多思想，包括经营许可证，因此目前仅采取自愿性，让厂主或雇主参与，但日后或会尝试让所

有雇主保持一致。

雪州新冠肺炎行动小组是在今年1月6日，推介防止火点爆发计划 (POIS)，以预防减少职场感染群；所有注册的雇主必须成立由不同功能的小组而组成的委员会，鉴定任何高危地区与活动。

所有委员会成员必须制定紧急行动计划，减少与外部直接接触，同时确保遵守所有防疫标准作业程序。

（莎阿南22日讯）雪州政府今年将耗资600万令吉，延续疫情高风险社区的免费检测工作，放眼达至5万人的目标，让高风险的乐龄人士尤其是老人院的长者、肾病患者和大专生都受惠。

雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁指出，州政府会著重在人口稠密、低收入群体居住的地区进行，以减轻检测者的负担。

才拟定社区检测的地点，近期在各社区举办的检测活动，各站点的检测平均人数介于500人至700人。

他昨天也在面子书专页撰文指出，州政府提供的社区免费检测持续进行中，包括2月17日在莎阿南19区展开的检测，共获729人接受检测，19日巴生站有近400人接受检测，20日莎阿南第7区则有近600人检测。

(吉隆坡22日讯)巴生河流域东部大道特许经营公司否认巴生河流域东部大道(EKVE)工程导致巴生河水浑浊污染,并称正在进行的工程皆严格遵守土地侵蚀与沉积控制指南(ESCP),环境局及安邦再也市议会也经常巡视工地,以确保遵守ESCP。

该公司发言人在回应大道工程导致河流污染事件时说,该工程地点正在进行小型土地工程,位于安邦河靠近安邦滤水站取水口,距离巴生河有15公里。

“这对于该公司在安邦河工地的淤泥流(如果有)来说距离太远,无法影响巴生河的水质。”

该发言人说,当巴生河出现浑浊的水流时,安

邦滤水站取水口没有关闭,这说明在工程地点附近的安邦河只有极低的水浊度。

全长39.66公里的巴生河流域东部大道是双车道高架大道,介于双溪龙镇及优景柏兰岭(Ukay Perdana),预计今年7月竣工。

根据马新社于上周四报道,巴生河流域东部大道工程被鉴定为吉隆坡区巴生河水浑浊的导因,波及生命之河计划。

吉隆坡水利灌溉局在2月16日的调查结果显示,浑浊水流来自安邦休闲公园,因为不受控制的土地开发而导致,地点靠近安邦滤水站取水口,在流至巴生河之前。

根据雪州环境局,该工程从去年10月13日开始,仍处于停工令状态,该发展商被禁止进行土木工程及发展,直到另行通知为止。

发展商只允许进行河岸修复工作,包括稳定斜坡及关闭曝露的斜坡,修复土地水压导致安邦河附近坍塌的斜坡部分。(TSI)

(吉隆坡22日讯) 过去一周，士拉央比达拉花园组屋 (Flat Taman Bidara) 有4单位共10名居民确诊冠病，且全都被送院就医，而当地居民仍担心该组屋因此衍生新感染群。

士拉央市议员余深恩说，上述组屋共有A及B座，每座各有48户。

“截至本月21日，有4个单位的居民相继证实确诊冠病，当地居民更将医护人员形容为“太空人”，连续数次来到组屋将确诊居民送往医院，情况有点可怕。”

他披露，其中确诊的2个单位是属亲戚关系。

他说，他们接获当地居民的求助后，已联同另一名市议员张庆伟前往展开消毒工作，他们除了为确诊居民的单位消毒，也在楼梯和走廊处消毒。“确诊者全是本地人，当地居民也向我反映他们的担忧，毕竟确诊人数已有十人，他们担心当地因此出现感染群。”



他指出，比达拉花园组屋是他所领养的住宅区中的唯一一个组屋，组屋住有3大种族，其中，租户占了60至70%。

“由于该组屋并没有成立联合管理机构 (JMB)，所以环境糟糕，卫生欠佳。”

他说，他也会在行动管制令结束后在当地展开大扫除行动，并会派发口罩和搓手液。
