

15 kes positif virus dikesan di Bangunan Selangor Mansion, Malayan Mansion

**Kuala Lumpur:** Selepas Simpang Renggam, Johor; Sungai Lui di Hulu Langat, Selangor serta Menara City One di ibu negara dikenakan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Di-perketakatan (PKPD), dua blok bangunan flat dan kedai di Jalan Masjid India, di sini menjadi lokasi terbaru diletakkan di bawah perintah sama.

PKPD ke atas Bangunan Selangor Mansion dan Malayan Mansion di tengah-tengah pusat bandar ini yang berkuat kuasa semalam, diumumkan Menteri Kanan (Keselamatan), Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaacob pada sidang media disiarkan secara langsung, semalam.

Katanya, tindakan itu diambil atas nasihat Menteri Kesihatan (KKM) berikutan 15 kes positif jangkitan COVID-19 dikesan dalam kalangan penghuni 365 unit kediaman dan premis perniagaan di lokasi berkenaan.

"PKPD di dua bangunan ini membabitkan 5,000 hingga 6,000 penghuni berkuat kuasa hari ini (semalam) sehingga proses pengecualian kes dari unit ke unit (premis) selesai. Saringan kesihatan wajib ke atas setiap penghuni yang menetap di sini yang mesti berada di unit masing-masing sepanjang tempoh PKPD ini," katanya.

Tiga PKPD sebelum ini mem-

babitkan Menara Plaza City One di Jalan Munshi Abdullah mulai 31 Mac hingga 13 April, diikuti tujuh kampung dari Batu 21 hingga Batu 24 di Sungai Lui yang bermula 30 Mac hingga 13 April, selain Kampung Dato' Ibrahim Majid dan Bandar Baharu Dato' Ibrahim Majid di Simpang Renggam, Kluang, mulai 27 Mac hingga 9 April.

Serentak perintah itu, Ismail Sabri berkata, larangan dikenakan ke atas buat penghuni dan pelawat yang tidak dibenarkan masuk ke kawasan terbabit sepanjang tempoh PKPD dan semua aktiviti perniagaan dihentikan kecuali premis menjual barang keperluan.

"Orang ramai yang ada saudara mara atau rakan di situ tidak boleh mengunjungi kawasan berkenaan. Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM), Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM), Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL), Jabatan Sukarelawan Malaysia (RELA) dan Angkatan Pertahanan Awam Malaysia (APM) akan mengawal."

"Penghuni boleh membuat pesanan makanan yang boleh diantar dan diambil di tempat yang ditetapkan, manakala pangkalan perubatan dibuka di kawasan itu. Semua laluar keluar masuk ke kawasan PKPD ditutup," katanya.

Beliau meminta semua penghuni bertemang dan memberi kerjasama sepenuhnya kepada petugas-petugas dari Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) serta mematuhi semua arahan pihak berkewaspada.

Terdahulu, tinjauan BH sebelum pengumuman PKPD berkenaan dibuat, mendapat anggota PDRM dan ATM mempersiapkan kawalan ke atas dua blok bangunan lapan tingkat itu yang menempatkan flat kediaman serta premis perniagaan di bahagian bawah.

Yang turut hadir di lokasi terletak dalam lingkungan 500 meter dari lokasi Plaza City One itu adalah kakitangan KKM dan Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL), termasuk lengkap menggunakan peralatan perlindungan peribadi (PPE).

Difahamkan, sebahagian besar penghuni di kedua-dua blok kediaman yang sudah dimaklumkan lebih awal mengenai PKPD itu adalah warganegara asing yang bekerja dalam pelbagai sektor di premis perniagaan berhampiran, terutama di Jalan Masjid India dan Jalan Tunku Abdul Rahman.



"Oleh itu, selepas pelaksanaan PKPD dikuatkuasakan di kawasan ini, kami perlu mengatur gerak menerusi Jawatankuasa Keselamatan Kementerian Wilayah untuk menyelaraskan segala perkara berkaitan PKPD di sini," katanya.

# MSU bantu pelajar terjejas

Edarkan makanan melalui program *Meals On Me* bantu pelajar semasa PKP

## Pandang arahan PKP dari sudut positif



# Joint operation to sanitise public areas in Shah Alam

# Electricity demand to slow

But analysts say impact on power companies muted

**PETALING JAYA:** Demand for electricity is expected to ease in the second quarter of the year with the implementation of the movement control order (MCO) and the sluggish economic activities foreseen thereafter due to the Covid-19 outbreak.

However, analysts said the impact on power companies is "expected to be less severe, given their resilient earnings profile."

"Yes, there will be a near-term drag in demand for electricity because of the temporary closure of the industrial and commercial establishments that are not deemed essential. If the MCO is extended beyond April 14, it will compound the negative impact further. But the impact is likely to be mild on the sector," an analyst said when contacted.

This is because the sector is not restricted under the MCO for its "essential services" status. Additionally, the uptick in the usage of electricity by households will neutralise some of the expected decline in industrial usage, he said.

Analysts said the risk for Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) is covered under the imbalance cost pass-through mechanism, while for independent power producers (IPPs), their returns are governed by long-term power purchase

An analyst

agreements (PPAs) regardless of short-term demand fluctuations.

MIDF Research noted that the bulk of TNB's regulated earnings were on a revenue-cap basis. In other words, it is "technically compensated for any shortfall in demand - relative to the regulatory period 2018-2020's (RP2) projected demand growth of 1.8%-2% per year."

Vice versa, any excess demand relative to the RP2 projections is returned to consumers.

"For the most part of the RP2 so far, demand has exceeded the projected growth and TNB has been returning the excess revenue to consumers," the research firm said in a report.

Notably, the reserve margin, which is a measure of available capacity over and above the capacity needed to meet normal peak demand levels, is estimated to rise to 38% in 2020 from the estimated 35% at end-2019. In 2019, the 2,000MW Jimah East Power coal plant was commissioned, while the increase this year is expected to be driven by the commissioning of Southern Power Generation's 1,440MW combined-cycle power plant in July.

"Beyond the already announced plant-up plans, we foresee a dearth of major new plants coming on-stream, given the already

high reserve margin in the system. The next round of plant-ups is expected to occur around 2025-2026 onwards, when the reserve margin is expected to dip closer to the 20% minimum reserve margin benchmark," the research firm said, noting that sector opportunities could tilt heavily towards renewable energy project awards.

In the fourth quarter of financial year 2019 (4Q19), TNB reported a core net profit of RM477mil, bringing its FY19 core earnings to RM4.7bil. Revenue for 4Q19 came in 3% lower year-on-year (y-o-y) to RM12.17bil, owing to lower sales of electricity (-4%) and other regulatory adjustments of RM271.6mil. Total units sold for the peninsula in 4Q19 grew 1% y-o-y, with the commercial and domestic sector growing at 2.4% and 4.4%, respectively. This, however, was partially offset by lower demand from the industrial sector (-2.1%), mainly from the iron and steel, electric and electronic, and cement product industries.

For IPPs going forward, Kenanga Research said main concerns were "old issues such as unplanned outages" such as Kapar Energy Ventures Sdn Bhd losses for Malakoff Corp Bhd.

# Tough brake

TIMES are hard, not worth it.

This is the sentiment of most taxi and e-hailing drivers in the Klang Valley since the start of the movement control order (MCO) last month.

Finding it so hard to make ends meet, the drivers are unsure what to do.

Some are staying at home and spending sparingly, while some keep waiting for passengers at designated stops each day hoping for Lady Luck to shine on them.

*StarMetro* speaks to some of the hard-hit drivers to see how they are coping.

#### Temporarily quitting

E-hailing driver Rasamany Vettivelu, 73, has not been working since the MCO took effect on March 18.

It has been over two weeks since she was able to make any extra money to buy groceries and provide her husband with RM500 pocket money.

She was earning around RM2,000 a month as an e-hailing driver.

These days, meals at home have been downgraded to just one vegetable, one curry and papadom.

"I am not exaggerating, but merely being honest. I do get a monthly pension, but that goes towards paying the utility bills and other expenses," said the retired Inland Revenue Board officer.

Rasamany was forced to take on another job a few years ago after she lost a huge chunk of her savings, and that of her 82-year-old husband's to a gold investment company.

"The driving job was a way for me to pay my husband back each month and pay for petrol," she said.

Also staying at home for the plain reason of not wanting to be infected with Covid-19 is 55-year-old taxi driver V. Jambulingam.

# Taxi, e-hailing drivers at a loss

While many are next to calling it quits, associations are looking into their interest and asking them to be patient for a while longer

The Klang Taman Sentosa Taxi and Hired Car Drivers Welfare Association president said people began to avoid getting into taxis from the third day of the MCO.

"Awareness of Covid-19 height-

ened on the third day and people knew the need for social distancing.

"Our regular passengers politely told us that it would be better to walk or cycle to get groceries.

"Many did not mind walking a distance to get their basic necessities.

"I could not even earn RM10 after the MCO was declared. I used to earn RM80 to RM100 daily. Now, I would wait for eight hours and there would be no passengers," he said, adding that it was wiser to stay at home despite the bills.

The father of four, who has been a taxi driver for 35 years, added that his association members also felt it was not worth it as their daily income had dropped and at the same time, it was a health risk to stay outside.

Jambulingam's two working children are lending him a hand now.

"I pray for a cure to the disease quickly as it is wrecking our livelihood," he said.

Jerry Jayabalan, 53, who used to earn RM100 daily, stopped driving the taxi when his income dropped to only RM32.

He hopes application to the government's economic stimulus package will be a simple process and that the money will be chan-

#### Some still hopeful

Taxi driver Badrol Hisham Ahmad, 60, sits alone in front of the entrance of Pavilion Mall, Kuala Lumpur waiting from 9am to noon for passengers, but no one comes.

"No point going home, the wife is already angry seeing my face."

"If before e-hailing drivers stole our income, now it's this virus," said Badrol.

Over at KL Sentral, the taxi counter is still operating, but drivers say they have to wait hours for customers.

"I waited seven hours for one customer; it's better than going home and having to answer to my family," said Ismail Sikin from Kampung Baru.

"I feel restless staying at home doing nothing, so here I wait," he added.

Both Ismail and Badrol are not exaggerating.

A check at taxi hotspots in the city and areas like the KL Sentral, Bukit Bintang, Mid Valley, and the TBS station at Bandar Tasik Selatan have showed images of a ghost town.

While the government's one-off payment for taxi drivers (RM600) and e-hailing drivers (RM500) under the stimulus package can be seen as a relief, the drivers worry for the long term.

"It's nice that they are giving us the money, but I ask you, is RM600

enough," Badrol asked.

"The most I can do with that is to pay for groceries for one month," he said, adding that food was also very expensive now.

#### Cabbies, hang in there

Federal Territory and Selangor Taxi Operator Association president Datuk Aslah Abdullah said the Covid-19 pandemic has affected everyone and not just taxi drivers.

"Taxi drivers will complain all the time, it is their nature. We have helped by supplying food to the drivers at KL Sentral."

"The government said their services are essential, so they must wait, even though there are fewer customers now," he said.

"The KL Sentral management has been kind enough to waive the rental fees for the counter for the next six months, so we are very appreciative of that," he said.

Aslah's company Puncak Holdings manages the taxi counter at KL Sentral.

Gabungan Pertubuhan Teksi, Kereta Sewa, Limosin dan Teksi Lapangan Terbang SeMalaysia (GTSM) needs the government's support in the current dire situation.

Its head Kamarudin Mohd Hussain said without the government's support and strategic partnership, GTSM could not move for-

## KL 'mansions' under EMCO

6,000 near Masjid India affected after 15 new cases found there

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The Selangor Mansion and Malayan Mansion flats along Jalan Masjid India here are the two latest locations to be placed under enhanced movement control order (MCO). It involves around 6,000 residents.

Defence Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob announced that there were 15 positive cases of Covid-19 at both buildings.

"Given the number of cases, the government, as advised by the Health Minister, has decided to execute the fourth enhanced MCO directive.

"This order involves around 6,000 residents in 365 residential and commercial units in the buildings.

"It takes effect from April 7, 2020, until all residents are screened," he said in a statement yesterday.

Prior to this, the enhanced MCO has been enforced in three areas - Kampung Datuk Ibrahim Majid and Bandar Baru Datuk Ibrahim Majid in Simpang Renggam, Johor; Sungai Lui village in Hulu Langat, Selangor; and Menara City One in Jalan Munshi Abdullah here.

Under the enhanced MCO, all non-residents and visitors are prohibited from entering the area, and residents are allowed to order food deliveries that must be sent to and picked up from designated areas.

All business activities are to be closed, except for shops selling essential items in the buildings.

Ismail Sabri said a medical base would be set up in the area.

"To ensure compliance to the enhanced MCO, the police, Armed Forces, Civil Defence Force and

Jabatan Sukarelawan Malaysia (Rela) will administer the area.

"For the smooth execution of the enhanced MCO, all residents are advised to remain calm and give their full cooperation to Health Ministry officials and to comply with instructions.

"Residents who require assistance or have any enquiries can call the designated DBKL MCO operation centre hotline at 03-4026 7222 or 016-296 2982," he said.

Foreigners make up most of the residents in the two blocks of eight-storey flats which also comprise shoplots, located near Jalan Tuanku Abdul Rahman here.

When *The Star* visited the location at about 1.30pm yesterday, security personnel were installing barricades, including barbed wire fences around the area.

Health Ministry officials were also on hand to perform screenings.

Meanwhile, Tan Sri Annuar Musa said the Federal Territories Ministry will cooperate with foreign missions in connection with the enhanced MCO imposed on the two buildings.

Noting that most of the residents are from Pakistan, India and Bangladesh, the minister said his ministry will liaise with the respective High Commissions on the matter.

"We will also include representatives of the High Commissions in the ministry's security committee meetings," he told reporters after visiting the affected area yesterday.

Information on the enhanced MCO will be broadcast via loud hailers to the residents in the languages of the three nationalities as well, he added.

"All the residents are deemed 'Person Under Investigation' (PUI) for Covid-19," he said.

To date, 90 people there had been tested, with 300 more undergoing tests yesterday, he added.

Annuar said the ministry's security committee will also work out logistics, including the sending of food and essentials for the residents of both flats.

On the possibility that residents will be relocated due to overcrowding, the minister said it will depend on if cases here spike and the Health Ministry's recommendation.

"We have information that there are 20 or more people living in a single unit. Those who work the day shift will go out while night-shift workers return home but during the enhanced MCO, all will be home."

"The ministry will consider the possibility of relocating the residents to a quarantine area if the overcrowding contributes to increased cases and the Health Ministry recommends it," he said.

# Klang council sees increase in garden waste, too

FAMILIES who have been keeping their house compound clean by cutting grass and pruning trees since the movement control order (MCO) took effect, are contributing to an increase in garden waste.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) is providing some dos and don'ts to ease the burden of rubbish collection workers who are already dealing with the increase in domestic waste during this period.

Its environmental services director Zaireezal Ahmad Zainuddin said private contractors engaged by the council noted that a number of landed residential properties were discarding tree branches

and bags of cut grass.

"The council would like people to cut the tree branches into shorter lengths and have them tied up in bundles.

"Grass and leaves should be packed in rubbish bags to make it easier for the workers to collect," he said.

Last month, Zaireezal said, 19.1 tonnes of rubbish were collected in Klang, including garden waste.

"Since the MCO began on March 18, our statistics on domestic waste does not give a full picture of the increase in rubbish.

"Based on observation, we found that one large rubbish bag is now full compared to the half or three quarter-filled bags collected before the MCO," he said.

Zaireezal advised people not to discard vegetable, fruit peels, tea bags, coffee grounds, and even dried leaves into rubbish bins but instead use them for composting.

"I hope people will pick up composting as an alternative to reduce waste in landfills.

"If kitchen waste goes towards composting, it will be an added bonus for the council in seeing less

waste transported to the Jeram landfill in Kuala Selangor," he said.

Zaireezal assured ratepayers that collection of domestic and bulk waste would continue as usual.

He believed that the increase in domestic waste was more evident at the end of the month when people would throw out more empty cans, bottles, food wrappings and cardboard boxes.

**CHANGE FOR THE BETTER**  
Polluted rivers looking cleaner  
during MCO >8

MOTHER Nature can heal if given a chance.

And she is healing quite well at the moment, following the government-ordered restriction measures.

It seems the movement control order (MCO) enforced to stop the spread of Covid-19 has a positively surprising side effect in stemming pollution of rivers.

Global Environmental Centre (GEC) river care programme manager Dr K. Kalithasan noted the current conditions of some of the rivers in Klang Valley were much better now, after Day 16 of the MCO.

"We are getting reports from our contacts everywhere that there is generally a significant improvement in the river's health."

"Of course, we cannot confirm this unless we do a quality check, but that is not possible under current circumstances," he said.

"A proper turbidity test will be able to tell us just how clean the water is but right now I can safely say that with the general outlook from the videos and pictures that we are receiving from our green partners, it is looking good," he said. According to Kalithasan, there have been reports of more wildlife like birds and butterflies returning to the riverbanks at some rivers.

He showed StarMetro photographs of Sungai Gombak, Sungai Way and Sungai Kemunsing that were shared by communities who were happy with the rivers' improved conditions.

"Take Sungai Way for instance. This is a typical urban river running through commercial, industrial and residential areas; it was polluted with rubbish and the community had previously carried out cleaning activities in an attempt to keep it rubbish-free.

"No one has gone out there to clean it since the MCO started. Despite that, on Day Six, there was no rubbish to be seen and the river was clear; it was a very good feeling," he said.

Kalithasan said the Rukun Tetangga of Seri Terengganu in Kuala Lumpur also took before and after photographs of Sungai Gombak that they could see from their flats, and the proof was remarkable.

"From the photographs taken on March 19 and April 2, you can clearly see the physical improvements of the water quality," he said.

"The same was reported on Kampung Chubadak's Sungai Kemunsing from March 24 to April 2. The river flowing there showed a reduction of solid waste."

"Residents have reported clearer water and increased birds and fish sightings in some parts."

"This clearly shows that nature can heal itself when given time."

"But mankind must make transformative changes by reducing, reusing and recycling," he emphasised.

Water quality expert Dr Zaki Zainudin said he was not surprised at all to hear of the increased sightings of biodiversity and clearer rivers.

"Yes, I have been getting feedback from various non-governmental organisations that the overall sentiment was that the rivers are looking better each day, but

these are sporadic cases," he said.

"The (pollution) density and demographic vary in different river basins."

"There are many types of pollution sources; there is industrial, sewage, silage, domestic and waste from wet markets."

"The composition (waste) depends on the area, some areas may have more industrial waste while others have more domestic waste," he explained.

"During the MCO, there is less of industrial waste because operations of factories have ceased during the restriction order," he said, adding that even the areas with logs booms had reported less garbage.

On the flip side, Zaki said that in some places, unscrupulous individuals were taking the opportunity

during the restriction period to dispose waste into rivers.

He said a few cases of pollution had been detected by water authorities during the MCO – one was the diesel pollution in Sungai Selangor while another case

occurred in Johor where black effluent was found in Sungai Johor, which resulted in Environment Department suspending the licence of a factory near the river.

"Selangor Maritime found significant amount of rubbish trapped along several log booms along Sungai Kelang in the Selangor side, consisting of face masks, mini hand sanitiser bottles and disposable gloves in addition to plastic food containers."

"This shows that while there have been improvements in water

quality and river conditions in certain areas, other rivers remain unchanged," Zaki pointed out.

"It would appear the effects of MCO vary from basin to basin and river to river, depending on the demography and distribution of pollution sources."

"Some rivers may improve, some may not, while some irresponsible parties may even take advantage of the situation," he added.

When contacted, Environment and Water Ministry secretary-general Datuk Seri Zaini Ujang agreed that rivers were looking cleaner now, but said it was only because there was less human interference.

"There is less grey water from both residential and commercial development, and industrial waste has also reduced. So I am not surprised the rivers look cleaner," he added.

Drainage and Irrigation Department deputy director-general (specialist sector) Nishad Mohamed Shaffy shared the same sentiment, adding that there was

no construction work currently which contributed to the rivers being murky.

"The rivers are experiencing less movement, less land clearing, fewer people eating out and less washing, basically less human interference."

"We hope it stays that way after MCO ends," said Nishad.

GEC director Faizal Parish agreed that there was a significant reduction in emissions from transport and industrial activities as well as improvements in river water quality in the Klang Valley, with less industrial and food wastes entering waterways.

However, he cautioned that the current absence of pollution might only be temporary if there was no proper enforcement and policy or environmental-friendly incentives.

"We hope that after the Covid-19 pandemic is over, we will maintain these steps to reduce our carbon footprint," he said.

## Help needed to make face shields

Items to be donated to frontliners in Ipoh and other hospitals in Selangor



WITH the shortage of personal protective equipment for medical frontliners, numerous organisations and individuals have stepped up to volunteer their time to make the items.

One of the much-needed equipment is the face shield.

In Selangor, a group of over 100 volunteers has made 1,000 face shields and donated them to Serdang Hospital.

The DIY face shield project was initiated by Kinrara assemblyman Ng Sze Han with the help of Kinrara and Balakong Action units members.

The volunteers worked tirelessly to produce those 1,000 face shields within a day.

Ng is appealing to the public to donate materials for face shields for frontline medical staff.

"With the increase of Covid-19 cases, medical personnel are facing a shortage of face shields and masks. So, we want to do our bit to help."

"Aided by the two groups, we were able to get more than 100 volunteers to lend a hand, from purchasing materials and making the face shields to delivering them to the hospital," he said.

He explained that among the materials needed were A4 plastic sheets, elastic bands, sponges, double-sided tape, label stickers and staples.

"These items are usually easy to get but during the movement control order (MCO), stationery shops are closed so that makes it difficult to obtain."

"Hence we sourced the materials from businesses that we know of but they were only enough for the first batch of face shields," he added.

Ng, who is also the Selangor Local Government, Public Transportation and New Village Development state executive councilor, said they hope to make 15,000 face shields for distribution to hospitals in Selangor.

"We have received requests from other hospitals, hence we hope people are able to donate the materials to enable us to produce more face shields."

"The 100-plus volunteers are able to make 2,000 face shields in a day," he said.

Kinrara Action Unit head Yap Chee Ming, who is also Serdang Hospital Board of Visitors member, said the project proceeded after getting the hospital's green light and volunteers followed a video guide from the hospital to make the face shields.

"At first, we only managed to find a few businesses to provide the materials, but after word spread, we began receiving more materials and volunteers."

"Since the Covid-19 outbreak, people have been staying at home in compliance with the MCO but they want to contribute," added Yap.

Head of Balakong Action Unit, Lee Khai Ming said only a few people went out to get the materials for all the other volunteers who stayed home to make the shields.

"The volunteers who had to go out took the necessary safety precautions. They distributed the materials to the three section leaders who then passed them to the volunteers, to minimise contact."

He said the face shields were only for sin-

gle use. As more people learned of the project, many came forth to volunteer and more public hospitals requested for the equipment. "We received overwhelming support as many want to play a role for the country."

"If there are more requests from hospitals for the face shields, we will continue to help," said Lee.

The volunteer teams are in need of PVC in A4 size (210mm x 297mm thickness 0.2mm rigid sheet), elastic tape (12-20mm width), sponge (25mm thick), foam double-sided tape of 20mm width, sticker label and A3 paper. For details, contact William Phang (012-209 5959) or Nicole Ng (012-213 0012).

Meanwhile over in Ipoh, NGO Ipoh City Watch (ICW) also made about 1,000 face shields and distributed them to medical frontliners in the city.

ICW president Dr Richard Ng said he and several others made the face shields over three days and delivered them to the Kinta Health Department and Raja Permaisuri Bainun Hospital as a token of appreciation to those fighting the pandemic daily.

Ng said members from ICW, Lions Club of Perak and several Good Samaritans contributed cash and materials needed to make the item.

"Some helped us to buy the materials and

cut the plastic sheets."

"I made a video clip and shared it with those who wanted to contribute and help make the shields."

"It is not easy sitting idle at home as many people may become restless and their anxiety level will surely increase," he said.

He explained that he was inspired to make the face shields after doing some research on coronavirus and learned to make the protective equipment from a video on YouTube.

"There have been many cases of medical frontliners getting infected with Covid-19. They need protective gear, otherwise they risk getting infected."

"The shield protects the wearer's face from spray of droplets, fluid and chemicals in a medical facility or laboratory," he said.

"We will make more face shields if the need arises, provided that we get the financial support and materials," he added.

Ng also hopes that more NGOs in Perak can help to make the face shields, as the number of new Covid-19 cases in the state was increasing.

"The cases are rising at an average rate of between 6% and 15%."

"Two districts in Perak, which are Kinta and Hilir Perak, have already been declared as red zone areas," he added.

## 71-year-old man latest casualty of Covid-19, bringing death toll to 63

**PETALING JAYA:** Another person has died from Covid-19, bringing the death toll in the country to 63 while the number of infected climbed by 170 to 3,963.

Health Director-General Datuk Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah said the 71-year-old man who died at the Enche' Besar Hajjah Khalsom Hospital in Klang had attended a religious gathering in Sulawesi, Indonesia.

He said the man from Perlis was admitted on Sunday and died at 11pm on Monday.

Noor Hisham said 80 people were discharged, bringing the total number of people allowed to return home to 1,321.

"There are 92 people being treated in the Intensive Care Unit, with 50 requiring ventilators to help them breath," he said yesterday.

Noor Hisham said 69 of the 170 new cases have no clear source of

infection and were unrelated to any of the major clusters.

He said the number of cases were small compared with the total number of cases reported.

Some of the cases that previously appeared to be sporadic infections were later traced to established clusters, but investigators were unable to resolve these 69 cases, he added.

The government has added two more locations to the enhanced movement control order list – the Selangor Mansion and the Malayan Mansion buildings in Jalan Masjid India, Kuala Lumpur.

The other areas on the list are Simpang Renggam (Kluang, Johor), Hulu Langat (Selangor) and Menara City One on Jalan Munshi Abdullah.

On Malaysian workers in Singapore, Noor Hisham said the government was discussing the matter with the Singaporean authorities to get employers to allow their workers to stay on for 14 days.

## 軟著陸讓民衆適應未來新常態

**截**至4月7日早上6点，根据各国通报的数字，全球累计感染新冠肺炎的总人数达到了133万人。死亡高达7万3000人。

在举世大疫冲击下，世界各国损失惨重。马来西亚自然不例外，实施将近二十多天的行动管制令看来已经把每日确诊人数组控制在100到200人之间，但是这个数目一直没有下降至100人以下。这让许多商民担忧，如果每日确诊人数没有显示下滑现象，行动管制令或者是松绑了的管制措施可能还有必要延续一段时间。

在我的万津州选区，行动管制令实行初期，许多贩商还是可以咬紧牙关熬过去，可是进入第三个星期，许多人已经开始担忧，因为大家开始面对收入减少，现金流动不

足的现象。

这就是为何我在上周要求联邦政府不能忽略中小型企业，尤其是小贩商的需求。如果连他们也无法撑下去，我无法想像接下来会引发有多庞大的失业潮。另外，面对疫情迟迟没有消退的情况，各级行政单位不能忽略各政府部门因行动管制令而发生的沟通和协调问题。

昨天国防部长的记者会，联邦政府推翻雪州政府的指令。原因是雪州政府和瓜冷市议会（也是笔者本身选区的地方政府）允许部分商店，如农业肥料与农药、五金、动物饲料和汽车零件在一个星期两天，即星期一和星期四限时营业。

雪州政府的指令也允许修车厂营业，但是在这个指令实行不到一天，就被联邦政府推翻。到底中间发生什么问题，相信许多人都不得而知，但是限时营业以及业者本来

就必须遵守一定程度的卫生作业，相信这是管制令接触以后大家必须面对的新常态（norm）。既然这样，早一点让大家习惯不是更好吗？

### 寬鬆版管制措施

我本身支持州政府的决定，不是因为政治原因。难道管制令期间，获准营业的厂家、商家和小贩以及政府机构如医院、警方等等就不需要使用交通工具吗？如有交通意外发生、汽车罗里抛锚，需要修理或更换零件，请问要找谁来帮忙和供应？这些都是实实在在的问题。

我认为，政府在管制令期间也必须和各级政府机关保持沟通。不管管制令会否延长，我们的重点是软著陆，即慢慢让商民适应管制令结束后的宽松版管制措施。

例如，管制令结束后，可能我们

可以考虑实行政车流限制。我们也可能必须限制商店人流、强制要求每一个顾客戴口罩、测量体温、保持社交距离等等、商店亦有可能限时营运、夜店活动可能还得暂时休业，之前已经搬上网路运作的行业，或许还会继续在家通过网络运作。至于学校，恢复上课后要采取怎样的防范措施？

我无法在这边每一个都写出来，但是现在还在家中作业和拟定政策的公务员，必须开始思考这些问题，而不是在管制令结束后才来思考。

虽然这是联邦政府的权限，但是地方政府的在地经验是非常宝贵的，因此我认为地方政府的领导如果有任何建议，应该大胆直说。

好的政策不一定是从上而下，很多时候都是由下至上，再由高级领导拍板定案。

## 藍藍的天 空氣真好

（巴生7日讯）行动管制令，营造出一片“蓝”天！  
 雪隆一带的空气污染指数，在没有烟霾来袭的情况下，一般处于“青色区”，即51点至100点的中等水平，但是行动管制令第二阶段开跑后，雪隆地区除了工业与运输重镇的巴生外，其余地区全部都罕见的全天候进入蓝色区，即0点至50点的良好水平。

即使是巴生，也在54点上下徘徊，与蓝区只差区4点，一些地区的空气污染指数，更是创下接近20点的低度，让雪隆一带的居民，享受到数十年来难得一闻的清新空气。

根据《中国报》记者所了解，在行动管制令第一阶段一路上车辆减少、工厂暂停运作后，雪隆地区空气指数已经开始好转，介于50点上

尤其是吉隆坡，一个车水马龙的大都市，如今也难得变成了“无蚊”大都市。

以今早10点为例，空气素质依次为万律录得32点、莎阿南36点、瓜雪37点、蕉賴39点、八打灵再也39点、峇都慕达45点、祖汉斯迪亚45点及巴生53点。

在过去24小时，巴生是唯一青区，其它地区，包括空气“黑区”祖汉斯迪亚，也难得一见晋入蓝色区。

其中，瓜拉雪兰莪空气素质最佳，虽然今早突破30点，但是之前的管制期几乎都没超过30点，最低也录得22点，是全国指数最低的城市之一。

## 丹绒馬林空污指數最低

值得一提的是，与雪州毗邻的霹雳州丹绒马林，是全国空气污染指数最低的地区，录得15点的罕见新低。

该区在过去24小时内，最高也只有22点，但是从凌晨12时开始至早上10时，便一直维持在15点。

另外，过去24小时内，曾突破20点以下的地区，还有砂拉越州的泗里奎18点、加帛19点及西连16点。

同时，在早上11点，全国68个探测空污地点中，约80%一片蓝天，只有13个地点是青区，而青区最高也只有57点，即吉兰丹州的丹那美拉和哥打基魯。距离蓝区也只差7点指数。

## 林立迎：警示要保護大自然


