

This worsened traffic congestion along Jalan Universiti during the evening rush hour.

"However, two cars broke down and the owners, who looked very distressed, could not move their vehicles out of the way. "This forced other motorists to drive through the flooded side of the road. I could only hope that my car would not be trapped in the floodwater.

"We did not have much choice because of the heavy rain and if we did not move, traffic would have come to a standstill," he said, adding that the issue had been highlighted repeatedly by the media.
"This problem has been going on for several years and there seems to be no concrete solution to the matter.

"The authorities must not take this matter lightly," said Chick, who was caught in the congestion for over 30 minutes. He added that widening the flyo-ver could help address the issue. MBPJ councillor Thayalan Krishnasamy, when contacted, said he had been urging the city council to address the matter for several vears.

He said the council had agreed to call for a tender, so repair works could start by June.

As for the cause of the flooding, Thayalan said the road premix on the flyover had a recess before the drainage manhole, which was confirmed based on a survey by MBPJ. "The council intends to resurface the road to eliminate the recess and allow excess water to

"I understand there is an urgent need to repair the road as it can be dangerous for vehicles that are trapped in the flood. "In the worst-case scenario, the vehicles trapped at the flyover

watch on this matter," he said.
The flyover was built to ease traffic during rush hour and opened in 2007.

GUAN Di Temple in Bandar Sunway, Petaling Jaya, hopes to expand its premises and facilities following the gazettement of a plot of land next to it for non-Islamic

of land next to it for non-islamic religious purposes. "The extra space will allow us to accommodate the growing number of devotees who come to the tem-ple for activities and celebrations," said Persatuan Pengurusan Rumah Berhala Guan Di chairman Koay

said Persatuan Pengurusan Rumah Berhala Guan Di chairman Koay Teng Koon.

"We hope to merge the new plot of land with the existing site, then raise funds to build a two-storey temple that we estimate will cost RM3mil. "For now, it will be used for storage and parking." According to the association, Guan Di Temple has a history of over 40 years in Bandar Sunway. The current temple site occupies 462sq metres.

The additional land, marked as Lot 37559, also measures 462sq m and was previously occupied by a kindergarten. "Our temple engaged a legal firm to assist in the application for the relevant lot in September 2014. "The application was rejected at that time because that lot was allocated for educational purposes,"

May 2016, which was verbally
rejected, and again in March 2017.

"Before the Covid-19 pandemic, our temple would have over 2,000 visitors for major events.

"We have not organised any celebrations since the pandemic, but the temple remains open for daily prayers with a maximum of 30 people allowed inside the prayer hall at any one time," he said.





BRITISH High Commissioner Charles Hay had s work cut out for him when he began his sting to Malaysia on a high note in March

He made elaborate preparations, even tak-ig up Bahasa Malaysia lessons to better iteract with Malaysians.

interact with Malaysians.

Hay's promising start was affected by the Covid-19 pandemic last year, but the father of two daughters who was a Captain in the British Army before joining the Foreign and Commonwealth Office in 1993 used his vas experience to make his presence count.

He focused his efforts on helping British the focused his efforts on helping British

businesses navigate the movement control order (MCO) restrictions imposed by the

businesses navigate the movement control order (MCO) restrictions imposed by the Malaysian government.

"During the first part of the MCO, we had to make a lot of representations on behalf of British businesses that were caught in an inability to manufacture. I met the International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Serl Azmin Ali and we were able to quite quickly resolve most of the problems," he said.

He cited the example of Synthomer, a British manufacturer of nitrile latex which is used in the production of rubber gloves in Malaysia. "There were some technical issues on whether they were able to continue with their production. Initially, the ministry didn't realise that what they were producing was essential for the rubber glove industry.

"That's an example of where we were able to help. It was quite a lot of what we did during the first half of the pandemic with British businesses," he added in a wide-ranging interview with StarBiz at his residence recently.

Can you tell us about the UK's recent-

Can you tell us about the UK's recently-unveiled foreign policy, and its impact on relations with Malaysia?

It's called the Integrated Review, a really groundbreaking piece of work. For the first time, in a very long time, certainly since the Cold War, we have taken a holistic look at all of our overseas activities of foreign policy, defence policy, national crime policy, cyber policy. It's all in the mix.

It's very interesting how it has come out, it's very good for this part of the world. There are strong references to the so-called tilt to the Indo Pacific and references on how this part of the world is extremely important for the UK because of the fast growing economy and opportunities.

opportunities.

The UK having left the European Union wants to be much more active in other parts of the world. And we saw this a year ago when Foreign Secretary Dominic Raab came here. He's very keen to come back. He has forged a good relationship with minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein, they've been speaking to each other. I very much hope that we will see some ministerial visits once things start to ease up with the vaccine. start to ease up with the vaccine

The Malaysian government's priorities lie in easing cashflow, catalysing people-centric economic growth and promoting quality investment in its bid to regenerate the economy post-Covid. We funded a study to ascertain how local businesses mitigate their risks will help policy-makers make better informed decisions on where to focus their economic stimulus planning strategy.

The project will run till April 2022. And two projects under the UK's International Programme Fund — with Ideas to promote SMEs economic resilience in Malaysia's Covid-19 Recovery Strategy.

The other was with Westminster Foundation for Democracy (WFD) to promote a more gender-sensitive policy and legislative responses in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic. On accines, Malaysia is part of the purchases of AstraZeneca, which is a private company based in the UK with strong technical and innovative links with the UK government.

There are a large number of Malaysians studying and working in the UK. How many of them have been vaccinated so far?
All the vaccinations are being done by GPs so I'm not even sure they collect data by nationality of people vaccinated. It is difficult to check by nationality. But all Malaysians in the UK who fall into this category are entitled to the vaccine.

to the vaccine.

About 32 million people including Malaysians living in the UK have been vaccine. Manaysians living in the OK have been vaccinated so far based on their age group. But students are unlikely to have had any vaccine, yet because they tend to be younger, unless they have got underlying health conditions which will push them up the vaccine chart. Education remains a key pillar in our ties. How are Malaysian students doing in the UK? We used to have at least 20,000

the UK? We used to have at least 20,000 there.

It's down a bit. The latest figure is about 14,000. I guess that's what you'd expect given the Covid-19 pandemic. And given the fact that almost all universities at the moment are operating offline, virtually, to a greater or lesser extent. And the universities have been doing their best trying to make life as good as it can be for the students.

From organising some physical events where possible to finding innovative ways of working online and using tech, they have done what they can to mitigate it. There are some innovative examples of high-quality online learning being delivered by institutions across the UK.

Some universities have created virtual ward rounds with virtual patients to mimic clinical decision making for their medical students, while others have developed new ways for students to conduct fieldwork, using hi-res photos, Google Earth and drone-scans.

On travel restrictions to the UK, when do

On travel restrictions to the UK, when do you think normality will return?

PM Boris Johnson has set out an outline plan for opening up the UK and he has given some indicative dates, and I think the indicative date he gave for the possibility of overseas travel was the middle of May – May 17. It's not confirmed yet, but I'm hoping that if all goes to plan, then come May the possibilities of travel in and out of the UK will open up again.

What will the criteria be, in terms of the

What will the criteria be, in terms of the approved country list?

That will depend on an assessment done by health experts in the UK government, they're constantly crunching the data that they are getting from different countries. And depending on the situation and on the appearance of new variants. Of course, we've had the South African variant, which was particularly worrisome.

Countries will go on and come off the so-called red list. For example recently, there were some new countries put on the red list, cluding Qatar. That means

including Qatar.

That means that some people travelling from Malaysia to UK, if they've gone by Qatar, they will have to go into enforced quarantine.

We are still in a situation where people travelling from Malaysia to the UK have to

quarantine, but they can do it in a hotel or in eir own home.

Or if you're renting a house or if staying with friends, you can do it there. But only if you are not coming from one of the red coun-tries. Malaysia is classified as green, so standard precautions are planned

On the impact on bilateral trade, how are our businesses coping with the pan-

demic?
All things considered, bilateral trade was affected but the numbers are not too bad. Total trade in goods and services (exports plus imports) between the UK and Malaysia was £4.7bil in the four quarters to the end of Q3 of 2020, a decrease of 5.2% or £253mil from the four quarters to the end of Q3 of 2019.

What does the future hold for trade and oreign investment between the UK and falaysia?

foreign investment between the UK and Malaysia?

It will focus largely on keeping supply chains open and removing barriers to trade and investment. The Joint Committee on Bilateral Trade & Investment Cooperation will provide a framework for the UK and Malaysia to work together at the government level to create the right conditions for our companies to trade with each other.

From my own engagement with business, I understand that despite the unprecedented challenges they have faced during the pandemic, they are taking a long-term view and pressing ahead with their plans.

As British companies act on lessons learned from Covid-19 and diversify their supply chains, I expect to see more of them considering Malaysia as a destination for manufacturing or regional hub operations, particularly those that support digitisation of the country's economy.

In the reverse direction, I know that the Malaysia External Trade Development Corp is working hard to help Malaysian exporters access new opportunities post-Covid. And in the same way that British companies operating in Malaysia take the long term view, Malaysian companies continue to seek new investment opportunities in the UK, citing the underlying strength of our economy and a favourable business environment as the reasons behind their decision.



ECRL route set to accelerate property value

PRICES for property near the East Coast Rail Link (ECRL) Northern Alignment route are expected to increase rapidly with the booming demand for transportation infrastructure and better connectivity.

Centre for Market Education fellow and Bait Al Amanah economist Fariq Sazuki said with the latest ECRL realignment, industrial towns like Serendah and Kapar in Selangor may see a rapid increase in

property value.

He said owners of logistics and industrial property such as warehouses and factory buildings will benefit from this project.

Fariq added that residential property in Selangor will also see a fast rise in value as a by-product of the infrastructure project.
"The areas nearby ECRL stations, namely Kapar, Puncak Alam, Gombak (in Selangor) and even Bentong (in Pahang) may blossom to become highly demanded residential regions for those working in Port Klang and

industrial areas in Selangor.

"It should be noted that property values in Selangor may rise even without the ECRL, but since it will cater to cargo freights, property values in industrial regions are expected to rise dramatically," he told *The* Malausian Reserve (TMR)

Additionally, Fariq said the ECRL may steer away demand for housing from the Klang Valley towards other areas along the route, such as Kuantan and Temerloh in Pahang, because of the better connection

to Selangor. He said due to higher costs of living in the Klang Valley, a "living in Kuantan, working in Kuala Lumpur (KL)" pheno-

menon is possible in the future.

Therefore, Fariq said demand for rental houses in areas nearby ECRL stations will rise as well.

However, in terms of development for investment, Fariq concurred with Selangor Mentri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari's opinion that the Southern Alignment could have created new high-value regions, such as in Jelebu and Kuala Kelawang, Negri Sembilan.

ECRL route set to accelerate property value

"The ECRL could have increased the property prices significantly in those areas, while attracting developers.

"Hence, property owners on the Southern Alignment are losing from the recent ECRL update. Although their property prices are still rising, it is at a much slower pace,"

Apart from the property sector, Fariq said regardless of which alignment is said regardless of which alignment is agreed upon, among the biggest beneficia-ries of the ECRL development are the logis-tics and transportation sectors due to its port connectivity.

Meahwhile, in terms of passenger trans-portation, he noted that the ECRL will be an important medium for people traversing the Klang Valley, Pahang, Terengganu and Kelantan, as it will be an alternative to the increase in traffic between the Klang Valley and the East Coast, limited highway access (especially for Kelantan) and low number of flights available (especially for Terengganu).

On a larger picture, Fariq said China is expected to be a main hopoficiative of its content of the content of t

expected to be a main beneficiary, as it

aims to pursue the Belt and Road Initiative through ECRL, bypassing Singapore in the

The ECRL development will also create a huge spillover effect, benefitting other indus-tries related to the project, for example, the construction sector due to rising property markets nearby the ECRL stations and paths.

"Higher demand for housing and higher property values will attract developers to build residential buildings," he added. Overall, Fariq said Selangor will benefit the most from the latest realignment because there is better connectivity within the cite.

there is better connectivity within the state.

He also noted that a dense state like Selangor will always have a demand for transportation due to a rapid growth of the manufacturing and services sectors.

Besides that, he said the state can decentralise the over-concentrated economic centre by moving developments away into areas like Puncak Alam and Kapar.

Meanwhile, CCO & Associates (KL) Sdn Bhd director Chan Wai Seen also agreed that the ECRL will benefit property owners around the stations, as there is currently no train connectivity along the Northern Alignment.

He said naturally, increases in demand and

roperty prices are expected. "However, I personally think that the sustainability of the prices will depend greatly on the efficiency of the ECRL after

completion.

"When you look at the impact of KTM ETS (Keretapi Tanah Melayu electric train service) services, it does not really create a significant impact on the local property market," he told TMR.

Chan added that it has been envisaged that ECRL would cater mainly to cargo movement as opposed to travellers due to its connectivity to ports like Kuantan Port

and Port Klang.

He suggested for the government to focus on creating more industrial developments around ECRL while ensuring the stations are well equipped to support industrial developments.

"Industrial developments will encourage population growth, increase income of the local residents and eventually stimulate the demand for local property," he said.





Selangor to step up digital adoption with Amazon, TM partnership

TM and SSDU agree to upgrade the speed connectivity up to 3Gbps linked to the state data centre

SELANGOR is leveraging the disruption caused by Covid-19 crisis to accelerate digitalisation agenda amid the high demand of online operations since January last year.

Smart Selangor Delivery Unit (SSDU) MD Dr Fahmi Ngah said as a start, Selangor has already invested and cooperated with Telekom Malaysia Bhd (TM) to provide the state government with a higher Internet speed connectivity for the state agencies.

state agencies.

Known as Smart Selangor Gigabit Network (SeGNet), TM and SSDU have agreed to upgrade the speed connectivity up to 3Gbps, which will enable public sectors in Selangor to have seamless data processes connected to the state data

The initiative, named Smart Digital Infrastructure (SDI), has four of 12 local councils subscribed to the facility so far.

Besides faster connectivity, TM will also facilitate a localised Smart Selangor Hybrid Cloud Data Centre (SSDC) with Tier-4 ready data storage facility for the state, Fahmi unveiled in his presentation about SDI last Friday.

"This is in line with the MyDigital (Malaysia Digital Economy Blueprint) plan agenda by the



To achieve the smart state agenda, Amirudin says the state govt is expected to disburse all of RM369m allocation from Smart Selangor programmes earlier than scheduled

federal government which targets 80% of cloud computing services in government agencies by 2022.

"If there is one state which is

"If there is one state which is ready to achieve this, it will be Selangor," Fahmi added. The MyDigital initiative,

The MyDigital initiative, announced in February, is also aiming for the digital economy to contribute 22.6% to GDP and provide 500,000 jobs in the related market.

Fahmi said the agency will still have to convince other local councils, as well as other agencies to invest in the initiative.

SSDU was tasked to make Selangor the smart state in the region by 2025, per blueprint that was set in 2016.

He also said some adjustment

was made to the master plan to make sure the "smart" term used by the state will always reflect the needs of the citizens.

From a total of 12 domains in the earlier plan, he said SSDU has shifted its focus to only four domains — Smart Government, Smart Economy, Smart Community and SDI.

Among others, SSDU plans to open as much collected data as possible in the state for its residence by 2025, to prove the level of reliability and transparency of the system that can be enjoyed by the citizens through the Internet of Things.

For instance, the waste management data daily collected and managed by the SSDU command centre will be useful information to check and keep tab the service levels provided by the waste collector.

As of now, all garbage trucks in the state are being monitored by the command centre via live GPS installed in the lorry collector. Selangor Mentri Besar Datuk

Selangor Mentri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said once the data sharing plan becomes live, it will make Selangor a smart state in Asean and empower its people, businesses and the public sector via the optimisation of digital technologies.

technologies.

He said this justifies the need of SDI initiative which ensures good infrastructure, applications and systems are in place to reach the 2025 goals.

"The application of these SDI infrastructures into government operations can ensure faster delivery of citizen services, operations and also realise more possibilities of technology co-development between SSDU and technology giants both local and international," he said in his keynote address when launching the SDI infrastructure in Shah Alam, Selangor last Fridav.

Besides the fast Internet speed through SeGNet and the SSDC cloud data centre provided by TM, Selangor also hired global cloud computing tech provider Amazon Web Services Malaysia Sdn Bhd (AWS) to manage the SSDC facility via AWS outposts — a fully managed services platform by Amazon. com Inc.

Fortune 500 firm based in Cali; fornia, NetApp Inc, will provide a peering technology on the AWS Outposts in Malaysia to enable state entities to relocate their servers into SSDC and have full access to the cloud computing services run locally on AWS Outposts.

Amirudin also said the state will continue to explore all aspects of digital features provided by global firms in the world, including to leverage the growing interest of cryptocurrency and its underlying technology, blockchain.

technology, blockchain.

"That is the future, some of our initiatives like Selangor Advance try to understand and get the framework of the cryptocurrency and (its systems) in some of our features like Citizen E-Payment and e-wallets.

"We have to move forward in blockchain technology, that is the future. There is a need for that, so that we get fast results and transparent management and governance. We will explore but not necessarily now (for implementation), but of course we need to explore to fulfil the whole ecosystem of the smart state." he said.

To achieve the smart state agenda, Amirudin said the state government is expected to disburse all of RM369 million allocation from Smart Selangor programmes earlier than scheduled.

The state had earlier committed to make the sum investment only by 2025.

by 2025.
"We saw the need after the disruption caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, so the state decided to accelerate the digitalisation agenda earlier than scheduled," he added.



他说,建校工程至今近95%完成,预计于明年2022年1月1日开始招生授课。









商業單位防疫措施做得較好

上生市议员兼卫生小组委员李富豪指出,10间被勒令关闭的工厂,都是在1988年传染病预防及控制法令(第342条文)下被对付,分别于1月关闭6间、2月3间及3月1间。

他说,无论是商业单位或工厂都得做好防疫工作,否则只要出现纰漏,就会被执法单位开出警告信,尤其工厂。

"工厂内最常发生的就是员工没保持人身距离、没扫描二维码或在登记簿 签到、员工宿舍防疫差和员工未接受冠 病筛检等。"

他说,比起工厂情况,商业单位防疫措施比较让人满意,只有9%单位无法达标,其中7间被勒令关闭、1间被开罚单、131间被充公物品,以及122间被发出警告信。



灵市圣淘沙17/27路巴刹自我国于2020年落实 行管令以来, 一直都有遵照国家安全理事会及卫生部 发布的防疫标准作业程序去执行,小贩及民众也都有 乖乖遵守, 让该巴刹不曾传出冠病确诊病例。

虽然如此,部分民众认为,大部分公共场所, 包括灵市圣淘沙17/27路巴刹都只是出入口有严格执 行防疫标准作业程序, 但走入里面却发现许多人没有 保持人身距离。

随着政府早前逐步放宽防疫标准作业程序,在 过去数周,国内陆续爆发感染群,近日的确诊数据也 在飙升,尤其近来国内许多大大小小的斋戒月市集也 出现大量人潮, 让许多人担心会加剧疫情, 呼吁政府 重新检讨收紧标准作业程序。

民衆已習慣遵守SOP



查80厂防疫无一合格

(巴生 17 日讯) 巴生 80 家工厂防疫检查, 竟然没有一家合格!

生工业区防疫工作仍 无法达至令人满意程 度,在80家被突击检查的工厂中竟无一过关,除了10家 直接被勒令关闭之外,其余 70家也因各种防疫纰漏而接 警告信。

相比之下,商业建筑的防疫措施做得较为完善,在1459家被突击检查单位中,有91%符合当局的防疫要求的。

巴生市议会卫生小组委员李富豪向媒体指出,市议会在防疫工作上毫不松懈,从今年1月1日起至3月31日,共检查了80家工厂及1459间商业单位。

"如上统计所见,工厂区 仍无法全面达至防疫规定要求,在短短三个月的检查中, 就有10家工厂在1988年传 染病预防及控制法令(第342 条文)下被勒令关闭,当中1 月期间最为严重,共有6家被

勒令关闭,2月和3月则分别有3家和1家。"

他说,厂商在防疫措施上 仍有待改善,因为他们就算没 有被勒令关闭,也会因为各种 细节而遭当局开出警告信。

多没做好身距安排

"当中,厂商最常见错误 是工厂没有做好人身距离安排、员工宿舍存在防疫疏漏、 没有做好出入登记,以及尚未 给员工检测冠病等。"

他也指出,相对,商业建筑的防疫措施较令人满意,从1月至3月期间,在1459间被检查商业建筑中,只有9%业者无法达标,当中7间被勒令关闭、1间被开出罚单、131间被充公物品,以及122间接警告信。

李富豪:三方合作阻断传播链

李富豪指出,为了阻断工业区的冠病传播链,雪州政府已指示地方政府采取预防和早期发现热点的爆发措施(简称POIS),检查工厂及商业建筑。

他说,有关措施由雪州冠 病专案小组提出,建议通过三 方合作,分别是政府 底 雇主和 非政府组织的配合,在焦点地 区为工厂及雇员检测,巴生市 议会将与巴生县卫生局携手推 行上述检查工作,阻断冠病传播链。

"根据检查,执法人员也 将着重各项风险评估,比如职 场与宿舍的冠病传播风险、环 境与人的现象、员工自我控制 的实践能力、公司面对员工感 染所采取的应对程序等。"

他指出,为了有效推行上述措施,市议会也在本身的管辖区内,为厂商业者提供了3次的说明会。
