**N**EGARA mencapai kemerdekaan pada 31 Ogos 1957. Sungguhpun demikian, keadaan tanah air tidak selamat sepenuhnya khususnya di kawasan hutan dan pergunungan sehingga tahun 1989. Ini kerana Parti Komunis Malaysia melancarkan cubaan kedua mereka dalam hasrat memiliki sebuah negara komunis.

Tempoh ini disebut sebagai Darurat Kedua atau *Second Emergency* yang berlaku mulai tahun 1960 hingga 1989. Maka dalam tempoh itu dan sehingga Disember 1989, kawasan hutan dan pergunungan hanya berani dikunjungi oleh pasukan keselamatan iaitu Angkatan Tentera Malaysia bagi memburu pengganas komunis.


Situasi ini berlariar sehingga tahun 1992 iaitu selepas jerangkap samar yang ditanam oleh penganas komunis di dalam hutan negara dibersihkan.

Berdasarkan rekod, sehingga tahun 1992, belum ada lagi aktiviti *hiking* di dalam hutan dan pergunungan Negara secara bebas kerana keadaan yang tidak selamat sepenuhnya. Apa yang ada hanyalah aktiviti berburu dan mencari hasil hutan oleh penduduk tempatan atau orang asli. Jika ada, hanyalah melibat kawasan riadah atau *trail* yang dilasarkan oleh British semasa negara berada di bawah pentadbiran British.

Antaranya ialah *trail* di kawasan pergunungan Bukit Fraser, Bukit Maxwell, G. Kinabalu, dan Cameron Highland. Selebihnya ialah aktiviti bersukan di kawasan berbukit yang ada di sekitar kampung ataupun Bandar yang cerah dan disahkan selamat.

Aktiviti mendaki mula menjadi popular sekitar

awal tahun 1993, apabila ada bekas pesara tentera yang menjalankan perlindungan membawa pelancang melawat kem penganas komunis dan usaha pihak Muizum Tentera Darat menjelak lokasi pertempuran penting dan menggali semula jenazah-jenazah perjurut yang ditanam di dalam hutan seperti yang berlaku dalam peristiwa serang hendap Gua Musang.

Kini aktiviti mendaki bukit atau gunung telah menjadi satu aktiviti rekreasi paling popular atau 'goreng pisang panas' dalam kalangan anak muda. Hampir semua lokasi tanah tinggi yang ada di dalam setiap negeri menjadi lokasi tumpuan anak-anak muda bagi menawannya. Setiap negeri mempunyai lokasi pendakian popular masing-masing. Malah lokasi-lokasi pendakian ini turut menarik minat pendakian dari luar negara yang

mengagumi keaslian hutan hujan dan kecantikan gunung dan perburukan dalam negara.

Sungguhpun demikian, adalah di dapat kegiatan anak-anak muda dengan aktiviti mendaki tidak diasuh dengan baik yang mana kebanyakannya mereka melakukan aktiviti mendaki tanpa persediaan yang mencukupi, menyebabkan hampir saban minggu ada sahaja kemalangan sewaktu mendaki dilaporkan berlaku.

Sesetengah hilang, jatuh atau tergelincir, kesejukan gunung, gigitan serangga berbisa, lemas atau hanyut dibawa arus kepala air.

Kadang kala jenis kemalangan juga sangat memerlukan kerana ia berlaku di kawasan pendakian yang selamat dan mudah dilakukan. Inilah yang menjadi satu fenomena kepada kemalangan pendaki.

Berdasarkan kajian pendaki

tegar atau profesional iaitu Brigedier Jeneral Datuk Dr. Mohd. Radzi Abdul Hamid, yang berpengalaman lebih 35 tahun dalam pendakian; beliau mendapat kebanyakan kemalangan pendaki yang berlaku dalam negara yang akan dihadapi ketika mendaki.

Dalam masa yang sama, beliau tidak menolak faktor malang tidak berbau. Tetapi berdasarkan pemerhatian beliau, kemalangan pendaki yang berlaku adalah disebabkan oleh kurangnya pengetahuan asas berkaitan aktiviti dan cabaran yang akan dihadapi ketika mendaki.

Bagi membantu anak-anak muda tanah air ke arah memiliki pengetahuan asas pendakian beliau menulis sebuah buku panduan pendakian *Kitab Pendaki Gunung*. Ia ditulis berdasarkan pengalaman lebih 35 tahun bergelumung dengan hutan dan pergunungan semasa operasi memburu penganas komunis.

Buku setebal 419 muka surat ini mempunyai 25 bab yang menjelaskan pelbagai maklumat berkaitan pendakian antaranya memilih peralatan mendaki yang sesuai lagi tepat, tahap skala cabaran pendakian dan tatacara pendakian.

*Kitab Mendaki Gunung* turut memuatkan panduan perancangan aktiviti pendakian, panduan dan tindakan kepada kemalangan pendaki, tindakan mencari

pendaki sesat, tindakan berhadapan dengan binatang buas serta panduan memilih tumbuhan dan binatang atau serangga yang boleh dimakan atau ikhtiar hidup ketika sesat.

Ia memparapkan satu bab khas bagi panduan pendaki wanita. Dalam bab ini dijelaskan berkaitan panduan persiapan alatan dan diri pendaki wanita dan tip-tip pendakian dan ketika bermalam di *campsite*. Lebih menarik buku ini turut menyediakan panduan solat dan doa keselamatan ketika mendaki dan senarai bukit dan gunung dalam negara yang popular untuk didaki.

Penulis turut ber Kongsi pengalaman mendaki gunung tertinggi di Asia Tenggara iaitu Gunung Kinabalu untuk dikongsi bersama pembaca.

Ketika ditanya harapan beliau kepada hasil penulisan ini, Mohd. Radzi atau lebih dikenali dalam kalangan panggilan 'Pena Celoreng', mengharapkan anak-anak muda atau sesiaapa sahaja yang ingin berjimak-jinak dengan aktiviti pendakian melakukan persediaan terlebih dahulu sebelum memulakan aktiviti pendakian.

Persediaan adalah kunci utama kepada satu ekspedisi yang sistematis, selamat dan menghiburkan. *Kitab Pendaki Gunung* diilangarkan Raja Muda Selangor Tengku Amir Shah Ibni Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, di Gunung Nuang sempena pembukaan semula trail Gunung Nuang yang lebih satu tahun ditutup.

Dalam pelancaran ini Tengku Amir Shah turut meluangkan masa mendaki Gunung Nuang bersama beberapa orang kerabat di Raja Selangor dan mahasiswa MSU, Shah Alam dan anggota tentera dari 11 Briged Infantry Malaysia.

**PETALING JAYA:** UEM Edgenta Berhad (UEM Edgenta) telah menandatangani Memorandum Eksplorasi Perniagaan (MoBE) dengan Asma Advance Solutions LLC (Asma Advanced) bagi mengenal pasti strategi untuk memperluaskan pasaran perkhidmatan sokongan penjagaan kesihatan dan pasaran pengurusan fasiliti bersepadu di Arab Saudi.

## ISU BEKALAN AIR 3 BLOK PA

# DBKL dah bayar tunggakan

Kuala Lumpur

Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) sedang menjalankan semakan dan siasan mengenai jumlah bayaran bil air tertunggak membabitkan tiga blok Perumahan Awam (PA) Sri Kelantan, Sentul di sini, yang mengalami isu pemotongan bekalan air oleh Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd sejak Selasa lalu.

DBKL dalam satu kenyataan, semalam memaklumkan tiga blok perumahan PA terbabit diuruskan secara berasingan oleh Badan Pengurusan Bersama (JMB) dan DBKL yang berkongsi meter air pukal.

“Beginitupun, DBKL mengambil tindakan segera dengan menyelesaikan bayaran kepada pihak syarikat Air Selangor bagi memastikan penduduk di PA ini terus mendapat be-

kalan air.

“Satu mesyuarat berkaitan jumlah bayaran bil air tertunggak akan dilaksanakan dalam masa terdekat dengan pihak-pihak terbabit,” menurut kenyataan itu.

DBKL juga sedang mengkaji kemungkinan untuk melaksanakan pemecahan meter secara individu supaya dapat menyelesaikan isu tunggakan sedia ada memandangkan ketiga-tiga blok PA terbabit menggunakan meter pukal.

Kelmarin, media melaporkan penduduk di tiga blok PA itu didakwa kerap berdepan gangguan bekalan air akibat tunggakan mencecah RM97,000 membabitkan satu blok dan perkara itu disifatkan tidak adil kerana turut memberi kesan kepada penduduk di dua blok lagi di kawasan perumahan berkenaan.

PEJAM celik, pejam celik sudah ham-pir tiga bulan usahawan kosmetik, Nur Sajat atau nama sebenarnya, Muham-mad Sajjad Kamaruzzaman hilang da-ri pada pandangan umum.

Ada yang kata, Sajat kini bersembu-nyi di Thailand. Ada pula yang mendak-wa pernah terlihat kelihai penyanyi lagu *Bobo Di Mana* itu di Johor serta Kelantan.

Sajat di mana? Di mana pun keber-adaannya, Merak Jalanan berharap pe-muda berusia 36 tahun itu keluar dari

tempat persembunyian dalam kadar segera, lebih-lebih lagi raya sudah nak dekat.

Seorang teman Merak Jalanan ber-kata, Sajat perlu *gentlemen* dalam ber-hadapan dengan kes yang dihadapinya.

"Jat ni, aku peliklah. Kenapa mahu menyorok sedangkan dia tak berhadap-an sebarang pertuduhan atau hukuman yang berat di mahkamah.

"Sampai bila dia mahu bersem-bu-nyi? Raya dah nak dekat ni. Aku risau dia kemurungan bila dengar lagu raya,"

kata seorang rakan lagi.

Merak Jalanan mahu ingatkan Sajat, sambutan 1 Syawal di "perantauan" tidak semeriah sambutan di negara sendiri bila pun ketika ini kita berdepan pan-demik Covid-19.

Bagi yang malas membaca dan tiada klu kenapa Sajat menghilangkan diri, biar Merak Jalanan jelaskan kenapa dia diburu pihak berkuasa.

Pertama, pada 23 Februari lalu, Mahkamah tinggi Syariah Shah Alam mengeluarkan tangkap terhadap Sajat

kerana gagal menghadirkan diri pada sebutan semula kesnya berhubung menghina Islam tanpa sebarang sebab.

Kedua, Sajat bersembunyi sebaik waran tangkap dikeluarkan mahkamah dalam usaha mengelak dikesan pihak Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS).

Apa pun, jika benar Sajat bersem-bunyi di luar negara, Merak Jalanan berharap dia tidak mengalami sebarang kesukaran untuk menjalani ibadah pu-asan dan mudah mendapat makanan ha-lal untuk berbuka dan bersaruh.

# Covid-19: MB Selangor panggil sidang khas

**SHAH ALAM** - Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari akan memanggil sidang khas Jawatankuasa Kerja Keselamatan Negara (Negeri Selangor) pada Jumaat (hari ini) susulan peningkatan kes Covid-19 di negeri ini.

Menerusi ciapan di laman Twitter pada Khamis, Amirudin memaklumkan, sidang khas itu bertujuan meneliti semula pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) di seluruh negeri ini.

Beliau berkata, mesyuarat akan membincangkan syor-syor pelaksanaan

PKPB di Selangor kepada Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) untuk pertimbangan kerajaan Persekutuan.

"Hari ini hari ketiga berturut-turut kes baru Covid-19 kembali mencecah empat angka, esok pagi (Jumaat) saya memanggil sidang khas bagi meneliti semula pelaksanaan PKPB di seluruh Selangor," katanya.

Berdasarkan pecahan kes Covid-19 pada Khamis, Selangor merekodkan jumlah tertinggi dengan 1,083 kes diikuti Sarawak (522) dan Kelantan (401).

KUALA LUMPUR City Hall (DBKL) has been urged to continue holding public objections hearings on proposed developments under the Act 1982 – for all proposed developments in 2020 and subsequently. Rule 5 was not amended in 2018.

Then Federal Territories minister Khalid Abu Bakar had said that the public could object to such developments through the planning committee on the plan.

Under the provisions of law that requires the mayor to refer to the registered owners of land or buildings for their comments on a development, through advertisements in newspapers and notices displayed at the site, the public could object to the proposed developments. It was part of the Planning Development Committee's role.

Without the practice of Rule 5, property owners could not object to a proposed development project in their surroundings until a decision was made on the project.

Some Kuala Lumpur (Selangor), a non-governmental organisation, has been pushing for bringing back Rule 5 as it did before the government removed it in 2018.

It was reported that the gazetted plan was adopted without the public's input, which went through a different engagement route.

Local entrepreneur Dennis M. Ali said the 1980s had reflected in the granite and that the public should be allowed to object to developments.

Even if the current KLDP 2020 was in place, he said Rule 5 must continue to be conducted as it was in the 1980s. "People do not have time or the place at one drafting stage

## Holding the helm

Skipper Norma Nordin aims to help build character and good values in the youth that she trains through the sea scouts programme.

THEY may only be "kids" but they're out in front with the big boys. That holds true for skipper Norma Nordin, who is one of the few agrees between the ages of 14 to 17. Norma is also a skipper and a member of the crew, and the first Malaysian female skipper to have participated in the Raja Muda Selangor Passage Race. She is the only skipper to have done so with an entire crew of teens.

"We had to sail for 24 hours to reach each destination and there is a good amount of responsibility given to the class with," says Norma, explaining that the route took them from Port Dickson to Port Klang to Penang, Penang to Langkawi. They sail 420m in total, with a break of 10 hours before continuing around the islands of Penang and Langkawi. As skipper, she says, she has a full crew, nobody really saw them as big competitors.

But, they won third place overall. They also won first place class five in the sailing competition, which involved a race from Port Dickson to Port Klang to Port Klang to Penang to Langkawi. They sail 420m in total, with a break of 10 hours before continuing around the islands of Penang and Langkawi. As skipper, she says, she has a full crew, nobody really saw them as big competitors.

"It is, naturally, something she is proud of. "Sailing is a great way to teach children about the environment, their sea acoustics, etc. They learn about safety and good sailing in storms with very low visibility because they have to rely on their instruments (which can't be seen in the storm) and they have to follow sailing instructions, practise what they've learnt in sea acoustics, and do some mathematical calculations on directions, speed, timing," she explains.

**An interest in the sea**

Norma has been sailing since she was 10, became a scout when she was 13 and received her King's Scout award in 2017. Her late father Nordin Baharuddin, was a sailor and he would take the family out on his yacht and used to take the family out on his boat. Norma's mother, a teacher, did not share his interest in sailing started from him, even though he didn't exactly appreciate her love of the sea.

But her mother did encourage her to pursue sailing.

"When I'm out sailing on a boat at sea, I feel like I'm flying. It's a feeling that easily impacts life lessons for me to apply when I'm back on land."

"I love sailing because it connects me to nature, makes me age and, and it's a great way to meet new people and board a boat," she adds.

Her passion for the world of sea scouting began when she joined the Eric Kho Hoon Yew Sea Scouts, which was founded by the World Scout Committee and elected into the World Scout Committee, now known as the World Organization of the Scouting Movement (WOSM).

She is now a volunteer consultant there, and is also a volunteer consultant for the troop which started in 1938.

As a skipper, she says, there are also sea scouts and air scouts.

As skipper, she says, the art of building good character through the outdoors, whether it's through the outdoors or emergency services are usually the first to step up to help, explains Norma.

She says that the sea scouts programme is unique because they manage, communicate, plan and then work together as a team.

**Passing on her knowledge**

Norma is passionate about imparting her knowledge to the younger generation as she feels she is passing along skills the young scouts will use for the rest of their lives.

She runs a monthly during the boat club, which is a monthly session for sea scouts to train in radio communications.

"When we heard the distress signal, we were trained to send a message via their WhatsApp group to one of the parents (on land) who is an operator, and then we were required for an ambulance which was ready and waiting for us to come to the rescue," she says.

"Unfortunately, the person didn't make it, but the parents were very grateful when they acted promptly and did what they could for the victim," she says.

The regatta is a good experience for the scouts because they get to plan, manage, communicate, plan and then work together as a team.

"The skipper is trained in radio communications. So when we heard the distress signal, we were trained to send a message wherever they can give half-day because they must be available whenever they are taken," she says.

"The skipper is trained on what to do in case of an emergency situation where they all get an opportunity to rotate in their roles, whether it's navigating, looking after operations, or safety and to relate to the skipper," she says.

You have to be able to find problems or mistakes so that they can be resolved, and you have to be a leader or editor. 

# MBSA: Illegal stalls in Setia Alam seized due to complaints

SHAH Alam City Council (MBSA) had defended the actions of its enforcement officers who seized several stalls set up by illegal traders in Setia Alam earlier this month after a video of the operation went viral.

The video uploaded online on April 20, believed to be taken by one of the traders whose stall was seized by the council, garnered more than 100,000 views, with some claiming the action as being high-handed.

MBSA corporate and public relations head Shahrin Ahmad, in a statement, said the council acted on the illegal traders operating at Jalan Setia Gemilang BG U13/BG, Section U13, Shah Alam following complaints by Ramadan bazaar traders along Jalan Setia Perdana BB U13/BB, Setia Alam.

“The council had allocated space along Jalan Setia Perdana BB U13/BB for the Ramadan bazaar traders.

“However, there are a handful of illegal traders operating just outside the bazaar area.

“Ramadan bazaar traders felt it was unfair to them as they had to pay for the permit while the illegal traders did not.

“Having all the bazaar traders in specific locations is also to ensure strict compliance with Covid-19 standard operating procedures,” he said.

Shahrin added that MBSA had also offered incentives to Ramadan bazaar traders who registered with the council this year.

“For example, an RM50 subsidy was given to traders who had successfully applied for a permit to do business at the Ramadan bazaar.

“We had also given a two-month exemption on the night market and morning market licence fee at the start of the movement control order,” he explained.

To date, 1,476 Ramadan bazaar permits have been given to traders operating under MBSA’s jurisdiction. — **JAROD LIM**

## Obscure info hinders revival of Sg Buloh flats project

OBSCURE details surrounding the status of the site in Kampung Masjid, Sungai Buloh, that was earmarked for the development of low-cost flats, is proving an obstacle to the resumption of the now stalled project.

Adding to this difficulty is the unknown whereabouts of the developer, despite various attempts by the Selangor Housing and Property Board (LPHS) to get their feedback on the matter.

Selangor housing, urban well-being and entrepreneur development committee chairman Rodziah Ismail said the site in question was transferred by the developer to an individual on July 23, 2012, before being transferred to a company on March 28, 2016.

Rodziah, who is also Batu Tiga assemblyman, said the stalled project could not be resumed until the site was transferred back to the developer.

She said a meeting involving LPHS, Shah Alam City Council and Petaling District Office chaired by then state housing and urban well-being executive council member Haniza Mohamed Talha on Oct 22, 2019, had proposed several things.

"Among them was the resumption of the project after resolution of the site ownership issue and refunding the buyers."

"The developer should also replace the construction of the project on another land that it owned," she said in a statement in response to a *StarMetro* report on April 21.

The report highlighted the woes of some 70 families who vacated the site in 2005

to make way for the construction of an 11-storey flats that would replace their old homes.

This was part of the then state government's efforts to eradicate squatter settlements.

Rodziah said a court had on Aug 11, 2009 ordered the developer to wind up and a liquidator was appointed to handle the matter.

She did not clarify if the developer still existed.

In a record found on the state government's website, Paya Jaras assemblyman Mohd Khairuddin Othman — at the state assembly in April 2014 — had questioned how the ownership could be transferred without the liquidator's approval.


He had also asked if the state government would employ the National Land Code 1965 to cancel the transfer.

The written response to him stated that the transfer was done in accordance with the National Land Code.

It added that "Section 340 of the National Land Code protects all registered owners of real estate, in which the registration cannot be denied, with the exceptions of cases of fraud, forgery or where the title was acquired unlawfully."

"However, in reference to this transfer (of site ownership), such elements were not present and this section therefore does not apply."

But in the same sitting, Mohd Khairuddin had also been informed that the state government would try using the Land Acquisition Act 1960 to resolve the issue and safeguard buyers' interest.

# 'Get early input from stakeholders'

MPAJ's Local Plan 2035 should include our suggestions before public viewing, say residents

AMPANG Jaya residents are urging the local council to incorporate stakeholders' input into the draft Ampang Jaya Municipal Council Local Plan 2035 (RT MPAJ) before it is presented to the public.

They said this would allow for a more holistic and engaging approach in determining future development within the municipality.

Traditionally, the local plan is open for public viewing once the draft is prepared and only then are stakeholders invited to give their input and objections.

Taman Melawati Residents Association chairman Azhari Abd Taharin said there should be a focus group discussion with residents to determine what is needed in their respective areas.

"It would make better sense to get our input now so MPAJ can then incorporate our suggestions before the draft plan is done.

"Usually, only little changes can be made once the plan is ready and we can only voice our objections," said Azhari.

He added that a survey for the draft plan prepared by MPAJ earlier

this month was not detailed enough.

"The survey was only open for a week, which was not enough time to get the word out."

"We commend MPAJ for having asked for early input, but this should be done properly with participation from a majority of the population," he said.

Noina Baharuddin, one of the coordinators of the community grouping called Ampang Jaya (AJ) Rimba Collective, said a recent campaign to empower residents to participate in the ongoing process for

the RT MPAJ 2035 was successful.

The campaign aimed to bring awareness about the plan itself, which would determine the type of developments that are being proposed in Ampang Jaya for the next 15 years.

"We made it easier for residents to highlight and suggest specific issues and concerns they had on our website (ajrimba.org) and send directly to MPAJ.

"As a first venture, we saw an encouraging 600 respondents within a two-month period," she said.

Most of the respondents showed concern towards issues such as slope management, development and infrastructure as well as preserving green areas and rivers.

Noina added that an analysis of the respondents' input was provided to MPAJ in the hopes that it would be incorporated into the drafting of the plan.

Some of the neighbourhoods that are part of the collective include Ukay Heights, Bukit Antarabangsa, Ukay Perdana, Taman Melawati and Kemensah.

However, residents from all over the municipality took part in the campaign.

MPAJ Zone 23 councillor Mohamad Samat said it was a continuous effort to gather feedback for RT MPAJ 2035.

"We need input from people of all levels of socio-economic backgrounds, because only then would it be a comprehensive plan," he said.

In June last year, MPAJ announced it would start a study on a new local plan and residents were invited to give their feedback.

The new RT MPAJ 2035 would replace RT MPAJ 2020, which was gazetted in 2011 and went through two amendments (in 2013 and 2016).

A sum of RM700,000 is being allocated to hire consultants and finance the cost of producing the plan, which will touch on land use, infrastructure, transportation, environmental conservation and tourism.

Some of the proposed changes include increasing the density from 60 to 80 people per 0.4ha for residential projects similar to Rumah Selangorku, as well as redevelopment projects.

Other proposals being looked into include rezoning residential lots in traditional villages into commercial lots in areas such as Kampung Baru Ampang, Kampung Pandan Dalam and Kampung Tasek Permai.

MPAJ hopes to have the plan ready by July 2021 and publish a draft to get the public's input.

However, MPAJ press relations officer Norhayati Ahmad said this had been pushed back to the end of this year because of the Covid-19 pandemic.

"Relevant public input that has been submitted to MPAJ will be taken into consideration during the preparation of the draft plan.

"After the draft plan is ready, the public still has a chance to scrutinise and give their views before it is gazetted," she said.

KUALA LUMPUR, April 29 — The Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) is conducting an investigation into the outstanding water bills involving three blocks of the Sri Kelantan Public Housing (PA) in Sentul here, causing the residents to face water supply cut since Tuesday.

The City Hall in a statement today said the three housing blocks which were separately managed by a joint Management Body (JMB) and DBKL, were using bulk water meters.

"However, DBKL has taken immediate action by settling the payment to Air Selangor to ensure that the residents in this PA continue to have water supply," read the statement, adding that a meeting would be held with relevant parties to discuss the matter further.

DBKL is also looking into the possibility of implementing individual water metres to resolve the issue of arrears in the water bills, it added.

Yesterday, the media reported that the residents in the public housing allegedly face frequent water supply disruptions due to the outstanding water bill involving one of the blocks amounting to RM97,000, which was deemed unfair as the disruptions also affected residents in the other two blocks. — Bernama

### S'gor MB calls for special meeting of state National Security Task Force to address recent spike in Covid-19 cases

PETALING JAYA: Following the recent spike in Covid-19 cases in the state, Menteri Besar Dato' Sri Amirudin Sharif has called the National Security Task Force (Selangor) to hold a special meeting on Friday (April 30).

Amirudin, in a tweet on Thursday (April 29), said the special meeting will review the implementation of the conditional movement control order in Selangor.

"This is the third day in a row where new Covid-19 cases have reached the four-digit mark. On Friday morning, I will call a special meeting of the state National Security Task Force to deliberate on the conditional MCO for Selangor."

The Friday meeting will also table proposals for the conditional MCO in Selangor to be brought to the National Security Council (NSC) for Government's consideration, he said in his tweet.

On Thursday (April 29), Malaysia recorded 3,332 new cases, of which Selangor recorded the highest number of cases at 1,083, followed by Sarawak (522) and Kelantan (401).

The first time the number of daily Covid-19 cases breached the 3,000 mark was on Jan 7 when 3,072 cases were registered.

The number of cases remained high early in the year, with over 3,000 Covid-19 cases for eight days in a row beginning Jan 14, and hitting a record of 5,725 cases on Jan 29.

On March 29, the number of daily Covid-19 cases dipped below 1,000 with 942 cases, but it has since shown a steady increase in the following weeks.

# 巴生市議會常月會議 市會主席：著手解決技術問題 4屋業計劃重啓興建

(巴生28日讯) 巴生市议会主席阿末法兹里指出，为确保巴生人民，尤其是面对工程搁置的购屋者居者有其屋，市议会已着手协助4项屋业发展计划解决技术问题，以便重启兴建工程。

他说，巴生区内共49项搁置发展计划中，当中21项涉及非法兴建，另28项则为合法兴建，绝大部分对搁置计划皆为民宅发展项目，商业发展计划仅占10%，即3至4个项目。

### 延誤施工近20年

“市议会早前成立了‘重组搁置屋业发展项目小组委员会’，旨在探讨和复兴废置屋业发展项目，目前，委员会已召见4项屋业发展计划的发展商及承包商，协助解决他们所面对的技术性问题，好让有关项目取得入住证。”

他今日结束常月会议结束后，向媒体如是指出。陪同出席者包括巴生市议会副主席艾丽雅。

他说，获得处理的发展项目，分别是2项来自中路丽雅花园和哥本路天猛公第35路。碍于发展计划面对技术性问题，导致工程延误施工近20年。

“尽管如此，一些屋主已在6、7年前已入伙，因此市议会希望协助解决后续问题，好让屋主能安居乐业。”

他补充，搁置工程也衍生各种民生问题，对购屋者和附近居民造成各种困扰，其中，一些发展项目先斩后奏，未提呈发展图测便开始施工，最终导致巴生区内，出现高达21项非法兴建项目。

### 巴生南區遮迪草場 易名“巴生市議會廣場”

巴生南区古迹区遮迪草场 (Padang Chetty) 即将易名为“巴生市议会广场”，引发民众争议。为此，阿末法兹里称命名的问题不大，将为此进行讨论并再作决定。

民主行动党巴生市议员党鞭纳仁在常月会议上指出，许多市民普遍认为，遮迪草场具有历史价值和意义，不应随意改名，更对市议会易名的做法提出疑问。

“市议会从未在任何的小组或会议上，谈论（操场）易名一事，希望市议会能做出解释，好让我们可向社区市民交代。”

阿末法兹里较后接受媒体询问时说，有关草场耗资230万令吉推行，目前已进入最后阶段，预计5月8日全面竣工，至于草场命名一事，他认为问题不大，并会为此进行讨论和决定。

另一方面，她提及，由于巴生武吉拉惹镇会展中心计划，因屋顶部分的建筑工程受到延误，才导致计划工程比预期延迟17%；无论如何，她相信工程将在今年杪竣工，日后将成为各项活动的举办场地，成为巴生市区的新地标。

### 罰單折扣優惠至9日

## 刘天球：执意公开发声 连接纪委会3“情书”


