## **GOVT TO OPEN** TWO MORE MAKESHIF HOSPITALS

KLH maternity ward and former leprosy hospital in Sungai Buloh to quarantine and treat migrants

HE government has ramped up efforts to tackle the spiralling number of Covid-19 cases among undocumented immi-grants in detention with a slew of measures, including opening up two more hospitals for the group.

Defence Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob said the government had identified two more facilities for conversion in-to makeshift hospitals to treat

and quarantine immigrants.
"We were concerned that there would not be enough hospitals to treat them. The MAEPS (Malaysia Agro Exposition Park Serdang) makeshift hospital can support about 600 patients, so we decided to add more makeshift facilities to

treat the (migrant) workers. "We will use the Kuala Lumpur Hospital maternity ward building and the former leprosy hospital in

Sungai Buloh for this purpose," he told a press conference yesterday. He said for now, all the treat-ment facilities, including MAEPS, could support up to 1,430 patients.

"We are confident that these facilities can support their treat-ment if there is a spike in cases among the (migrant) community.

Malaysia's Covid-19 cases saw a sharp increase in the last two days, mostly involving immi-grants held in detention in three Immigration Department depots, namely the Kuala Lumpur Inter-national Airport, Bukit Jalil and

Semenyih depots. Ismail Sabri said Malaysia would deport all undocumented workers who tested negative for Covid-19 to their home countries. He said the decision was made at a special inter-ministerial meeting on the management of undocumented workers that he

chaired yesterday.

"We also agreed that all undocumented migrants in depots that have Covid-19-positive detainees have to be screened. Those who test positive will be sent to MAEPS for treatment.

'As soon as they test negative following their quarantine, tests and treatment at MAEPS, they must be sent back to their home countries.

He said Wisma Putra had been asked to engage its counterparts in the countries involved and foreign missions in Malaysia so that Malaysia could help them in the repatriation exercise.
Ismail Sabri said the workers

would be screened before they

were deported. He said the government made the decision after Malaysia recorded a staggering rise of 172 Covid-19 cases on Monday, breaking the 21-day streak of only double-digit in-creases. Of the total, only eight cases involved Malaysians, with the rest being foreigners, mostly undocumented workers held in the Immigration depots. Ismail Sabri said all officers and

support staff, such as food suppliers, in depots nationwide would undergo mandatory screenings. He said anyone linked to the

three detention depots would have to undergo a swab test, adding that all officers tested so far had come out negative.

On Monday, the Health Ministry said 227 cases were linked to the three detention depots involving undocumented migrants, with those from Bangladesh recording the highest number at 53 cases.

The rest of the cases involved migrants from India (41), Indonesia (38), Myanmar (37), Pakistan (28), China (17), Cambodia (four), Nepal (three), Sri Lanka (two) and one each from the Philippines, Libya, Egypt and Syria.

Ismail Sabri said the govern-ment would not bow to critics

who slammed it for rounding up

undocumented workers.
"Firstly, they were caught because under the law, they cannot be in our country without valid papers. Secondly, they should be grateful because if the workers are not caught they would be spreading it (Covid-19) to our innocent citizens.

"If they meet you (detractors), won't they give you Covid-19? We need to look after the needs of the majority of Malaysians who are complying with the Movement Control Order. We can't allow them to stay here by using human rights and freedom as an excuse.

"Our actions are to safeguard the interests and safety of our people.

Human rights groups had slammed the government for stepping up enforcement during the pandemic, saying that the move was counterproductive and



would force undocumented mi-grants into hiding, which could worsen the spread of Covid-19. Ismail Sabri also addressed the issue of cramped foreign workers' quarters being a hotbed for Covid-19 infection. 19 infection.

He said the Human Resources Ministry was expected to an-nounce amendments to the Work-ers' Minimum Standards of Housing and Amenities Act 1990 on

foreign workers' housing.

He said the amendment was made in 2019, but had yet to be implemented.

"It calculates floor space against the number of workers living there. I was made to understand that tomorrow (today), the human resources minister will announce

the amendments.
"We have discussed this with
the cabinet committee that I
chaired and it has been approved during a special meeting. We have tabled a lot of policies regarding foreign workers and if the cabinet approves them, I will make more announcements." make more announcements.

#### 187 new virus cases comprise mostly migrants

new Covid-19 cases hit three dig-

new Covid-19 cases hit three dig-its again yesterday, with 187 new cases, a majority of whom in-volved migrant workers. Health director-general Datuk Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah said cramped living conditions and poor hygiene were the main caus-es of infection among foreign workers. workers.

Speaking at his daily press con-ference yesterday, he said of the 187 cases, 10 were imported cases involving seven Malaysians and three permanent residents and

spouses of Malaysians.
The other 177 cases involved lo-cal transmissions, including 173 foreigners. Of these, 155 were de-tected at the Bukit Jalil Immigration Department detention cen-tre, while 13 were from the Cheras security guard cluster.

The number of active cases now

stood at 1,448, with all patients isolated and treated.

Dr Noor Hisham said eight pa-tients were being treated in the Intensive Care Unit, with five re-quiring breathing assistance.

He said 88 cases were detected at three construction site clusters involving foreign workers, as well as one Malaysian. He said out of 488 samples taken

from a Kuala Lumpur construc-tion site cluster, 31 tested positive, involving 29 Bangladeshis and two Indonesian workers.

For the Setia Alam construction site cluster, 91 samples were tak-en and 13 tested positive, all Bangladeshi workers. For the Kuala Lumpur 2 construction site cluster, 350 samples were taken and 44 tested positive, involving 34 Bangladeshis, nine Indone-sians and one Malaysian. Dr Noor Hisham said the three

the mandatory Covid-19 screening for foreign construction workers in red zones in Selangor and Kuala Lumpur as required by the Na-tional Security Council during the Movement Control Order (MCO),

He said 27,383 construction workers had been screened by their respective employers so far.

"The Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya Health Departments ordered the closure of the Kuala Lumpur 2 construction site and its *kongsi.*" He said sanitisation and disin-

out.
He said employers should be responsible and educate their workers on hygienic practices and ensure that standard oper-ating procedures (SOPs) were practised at the workplace and at workers' accommodations to

He urged employers to ensure that beds were Im to 2m apart, avoid food preparation and con-sumption in large groups, avoid crowding in leisure spaces and ensure that the accommodation,

"Our efforts to fight Covid-19 will be in vain unless there is compliance with SOPs at the workplace and accommodation. Efforts to resolve the issue of the living conditions of foreign workers need the cooperation of all ers need the cooperation of all parties and must be done holis-tically and comprehensively. #### **FAIR DEAL SOUGHT**

Landlords urged to grant deferment of rental as many businesses are facing a drop in income due to Covid-19 >2

BUSINESSES may go bust unless something is done to reduce their overheads.

One of the largest bills they still have to foot is rental even though many are still unable to open due to the movement control order (MCO).

StarMetro interviewed a few business owners who said they were struggling to cope and may have to close shop for good unless they receive some form of assis-tance. All names below have been changed to protect their identities

#### Struggling to survive

Jay owns and operates a children's play space in a neighbourhood mall in Selangor. His business had been greatly affected from as early as February because of the Covid-19 outbreak. He claimed to have emailed the mall management twice seeking to reduce his monthly rental of RM22,000.

Jay said he never received a response but when he highlighted

Jay said he never received a response but when he highlighted his plight on social media, he claimed to have been targeted by the mall's management.

"I provided a livelihood to about 20 workers during my four years at the mall but business took a dip because of Covid-19.

"Instead of reducing the rent, the mall continued to send me rental invoices, including late payment charges."

charges."

Jay claimed that the mall management had been selective over who deserved a rental discount.

He has not been able to secure

He has not been able to secure any government assistance and may have to file for bankruptcy, "I was told to pay until my tenancy agreement ends in 2021," said Jay, adding that small and medium enterprises were in need of a ballout to pay their rental. Emanual, who operated from a shoplot in Petaling Jaya, had not paid rent for two months. "I received a legal notice asking me to vacate during the MCO. I had always paid my rental on time over the last five years. "The MCO has put tenants like me in a difficult position," said

me in a difficult position," said Emanual, adding that he had since moved out and relocated to a place with cheaper rental.

#### Feeling squeezed from both sides

Tenants of commercial premises seek rental waiver but landlords say they too have costs to bear

"Many businesses will have to close down or relocate to survive," he said.

Wong, who operates a tuition centre in Segambut, said he had to "threaten" to move out before the landlord would even consider reducing the rent during McO. "I have been here for almost 18 years. I pay RM600 monthly for my unit.

"But because of the MCO, the centre was closed. The landlord

Meanwhile, Ruby, was shocked

Meanwhile, Ruby, was shocked to receive a letter from the building management that her company would have to pay the full rental for April even though none of the offices in her building were allowed to operate.

"We were also asked to pay 50% of the parking fees. I am paying RM1,800 per month for rent and RM180 for parking," said Ruby, adding that the management should have been more understanding.

shopping centre in Kuala Lumpur, felt it was unfair for the management ask them to pay the service charge in full during the MCO. Keneth, who operates a F&B outlet, said while shops that were closed during the first phase of MCO were exempted from paying rent and service charge, this changed during the conditional changed during the conditional

"For April, the rental was waived but we were still charged the full service charge even though most of the mall was closed."

"Since May 4, when the condi-tional MCO kicked in, we received a 30% reduction but still had to pay the full service charge, which is not fair," he said.

#### Sympathetic landlords

However, some landlords like Sunway Malls have been proactive in helping out struggling tenants. Sunway Malls & Theme Parks chief executive officer HC Chan said during phase one of the MCO, Sunway Malls gave a full waiver on rent to non-essential as well as on rent to non-essential as well as

F&B operators.
"Only essential services were

"We have extended the option of flexi-hours to non-essential as well as F&B operators post-MCO.
"They can choose to operate at a minimum eight hours per day compared to 12 or her they can

minimum eight hours per day compared to 12 so that they can manage their wages and utilities better," he said. A representative from Wisma MCIS in Petaling Jaya, said although no discount was given on rent, tenants were allowed to defer their payment for April, May and June.

"We still have to pay salaries for 10 building staff, and ensure that we do not neglect payments to con-tractors and cleaning services," he explained.

## Challenges of motherhood

PETALING JAYA: Having a baby has always been perceived as a happy occasion. Hence, the phrase "bundle of joy" when there is a new addition to the family.

However, it may not always be so for some mothers. More often than not, she ends up being solely responsible for attending to the baby's needs.

For new mothers, it is a learning process which can be a challenge that is overwhelming. Very quickly, the reality that it is not all cooing and toothless smiles sinks in - mood swings and anxiety caused by lack of sleep kicks in, bringing with them a sense of guilt. But many do not know how to seek help.

who Mothers experience symptoms that are more intense and longer lasting may have a condition known as post-partum depression (PPD), according to consultant psychologist at SOLS Health, Dr Leoniek Kroneman.

SOLS Health is a communitybased mental health centre that connects children, adults, families and communities to accessible and affordable mental health services with an emphasis on combating the stigma of mental health.

PPD is a depressive state that

One out of every seven women suffers from post-partem depression and many cases go undetected and untreated: Expert

MATERNAL mental health issues affect one in 10 women during pregnancy and one in eight women after childbirth, according to the World Health Organisation statistics. May 2020 has been declared the Global Maternal Mental Health Month to raise awareness on the prevalence of pre and post-natal mental health issues around the world.

SOLS Health, in collaboration with Institut Wanita Berdaya (IWB) Selangor, is studying post-partum depression among women in Selangor and invites all women in the state and of child-bearing age to complete a survey on their thoughts about maternal mental health at the following links. happens in the first few weeks to six months after childbirth," Kroneman told *theSun*.

"It is also alarmingly common one in seven women in Malaysia suffers from it but most go undetected and untreated."

Researcher Lim Su Lin, who assists Kroneman in a research study on detection and treatment of PPD in Selangor, said with timely

intervention in the form of therapy, there is a good chance of recovery

"The main aim is to provide the Selangor government actionable and female-centric recommendations on how to enhance the detection process and to link them with appropriate mental healthcare services," Lim told

"Our study involves interviews

with women patients and focus group discussions. We hope to enable these women to share their experience and insights and to get them to participate in efforts to improve the healthcare system," she added.

Kroneman said the factors that cause PPD are biological, social or psychological.

"PPD occurs because of a drop in reproductive hormones. Research shows some women are more susceptible than others. Other causes include lack of support from family and social isolation with the

baby," she said. Common symptoms of PPD are insomnia, irritability, anxiety and lack of appetite.

Another part of the SOLS Health research seeks to understand the mothers' knowledge about PPD and to spread awareness about maternal and mental health.

"We want to empower mothers to address their problems and seek help rather than avoid it out of guilt or shame. With professional help, PPD can be treated," Lim said.

She hopes the results from the study would spur state legislators and healthcare policy-makers to address the issue on multiple levels, and improve awareness of the condition and accessibility to remedial services.


