# Water disruption in Shah Alam and Klang

**SHAH ALAM:** Water supply disruption in 31 areas around Shah Alam and Klang since early yesterday morning was due to a burst pipe near Dataran Automobil in Section 15.

Pengurusan Air Selangor's head of customer relations and communications Abdul Raof Ahmad said the incident, affecting a major 1,050mm water pipe, had caused a reduction of 70 million litres of water per day into the Lipat Kajang catchment pond.

"The unscheduled water supply disruption was found to have been caused by works done by a third party and has affected about 99,500 consumers.

"Restoration works are underway and we expect it to be completed within 24 hours," he said yesterday.

Among the areas affected were Ambang Botanik, Johan Setia, Taman Klang Jaya, Bayu Perdana, Kem Rimba and Persiaran Raja Muda Musa.

# Low water pressure in Klang

## More than 99,000 households expected to face supply cut caused by main pipe leakage

WATER supply to most homes in Klang were still flowing yesterday at noon despite a notice from Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Syabas) that consumers would experience an unscheduled water disruption due to leakage of a main pipe from Bukit Jelutong to Lipat Kajang reservoir.

However, at 4.30pm some residential areas in Klang were experiencing low water pressure.

Based on the media statement from Syabas, the damage to the pipe was caused by a third party.

Klang Consumer Association president Devadass Anjan said the association had called up several residents associations upon receiving the news but found that most of the housing areas in Syabas' list had water still.

Devadass said project contractors should refer to the authorities for the exact location of such pipes before carrying out earth works.

Taman Setia Residents Association former chairman M. Sivaguru said water supply was normal yesterday afternoon.

"As at 1.30pm, our neighbourhood has not experienced any water disruption," he said.

Taman Palm Grove Rukun Tetangga chairman G. Ganesh said water to the taps was still flowing.

Meanwhile, a check at the Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital found water supply was normal.

A spokesman said the hospital had sufficient water tanks and if

the water level in the tanks was low, the hospital would notify Syabas as it was on the priority list.

Businessman K.K. Devan said the area around Bandar Ambang Botanic had not experienced water disruption or low water pressure.

More than 100,000 people in Klang and Shah Alam were put on the alert of supply interruption yesterday after a project work by a third party damaged the main pipe.

Syabas, a member of Air Selangor Group, said third party works caused pipe leakage near Dataran Automobil, Persiaran Selangor, Section 15 in Shah Alam, since yesterday morning.

"Thirty-one areas and 99,454 households will be affected by the water supply interruption," said Air Selangor customer relations and communication department head Abdul Raof Ahmad.

"This incident resulted in a reduction of 70 million litres per day to the Kajang Lipat Reservoir."

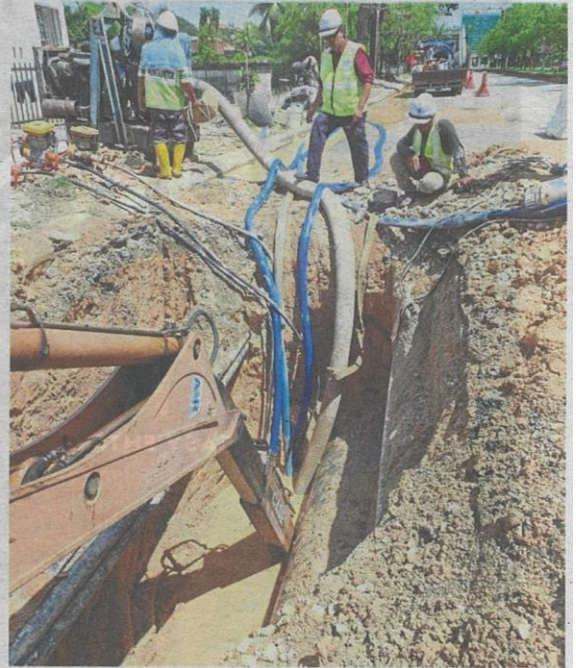
He said the ongoing repair works were expected to be completed within 24 hours.

Some of the areas experiencing low water pressure include Taman Bayu Perdana, Bandar Bukit Tinggi 1 and 2, Taman Klang Jaya, Pandamaran, Bandar Botanic, Persiaran Raja Muda Musa, Taman Selatan, Taman Chi Liung, Taman Sri Andalas, Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Klang, Teluk Gadong Besar and Kecil in Klang, as well as Kem Rimba and Taman Intan in Shah Alam.

"Customers can refer to the Air Selangor mobile app and [www.syabas.com.my](http://www.syabas.com.my) to get the latest information and status," said Abdul Raof.

Three Local Service Centres have also been mobilised to provide additional water supply to affected residents.

They are located at Taman Rakyat, Jalan Tun Dr Ismail, Taman Sri Andalas, (GPS: 3.021248,101.450512); Taman Rekreasi Bandar Parklands, Jalan Delima 8, (GPS: 2.968332,101.456393) and Kompleks Sukan Pandamaran (GPS: 3.016951,101.415709) in Klang.

## Mayor: No protection for MBPJ wrongdoers

“WE WILL not protect wrongdoers,” Petaling Jaya mayor Datuk Mohd Sayuthi Bakar affirms.

He made the declaration at the Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) fullboard meeting yesterday, in reference to the alleged bribery case involving MBPJ officers.

He said the case was still being investigated by Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC).

“In such cases, two parties are at fault, the one bribing and the one receiving.

“When issued a summons, shopowners can appeal their case at the council (instead of offering bribes).

“I urge people not to take the easy way out in such incidents, that is how you might be taken advantage of,” he said.

When asked by a journalist if the officers were suspended, he retort-

ed, “Who told you that? Do not believe in hearsay.”

It was previously reported that two MBPJ enforcement officers were alleged to have asked for bribes and are currently desk-bound during the MACC investigation.

The case made headlines when a video of what appeared to be an MBPJ enforcement officer receiving money from a shopkeeper in Kelana Jaya went viral on social media.

The shopowner was said to have been asked to pay between RM100 and RM300 to avoid being fined a higher amount by the council’s enforcement officers doing routine checks.

MBPJ councillor Terence Tan Teck Seng, who is in the council’s licensing committee, suggested that

the Licensing Department set up booths in shopping centres to allow business proprietors to easily apply for permits to place promotional materials outside their shop.

“The permits can be issued the same day.

“There is also a suggestion for the council’s 2017 Advertising by-law to be amended so that the permit fee is waived for shops within malls,” he added.

Mohd Sayuthi said the council would have a meeting with the state exco to discuss this issue soon.

Meanwhile, the city has recorded two deaths from dengue fever, one in SS21/2 and the other in PJS6/4E.

“We were just informed that the resident in SS21 was hospitalised in Kuala Terengganu and there were no prior dengue cases in SS21.

“PJS6/4E, however, is a dengue

hotspot,” said the council president.

There are 16 hotspots in Petaling Jaya.

In the 24th week, a total of 3,251 dengue cases were reported, making it a 301% increase from the same period last year, in which 1,077 cases were reported.

The fullboard meeting also announced that MBPJ had – up until May – checked 545 food premises, issued 658 compounds and ordered 84 premises to shut down under the MBPJ 2007 Food Establishment Bylaw.

It also conducted 344 checks on 24-hour restaurants, of which 76.5% were found to be complying with the council’s order for a two-hour mandatory closure for cleaning purposes.

There were 138 compound

notices issued for various offences.

MBPJ said it was extending its discount campaign, which was supposed to end on June 30, to Aug 31 in conjunction with National Day celebration.

The council is offering discounts for traffic and parking compounds.

Payment can be done over the counter at MBPJ’s headquarters and branch offices or via the app.

After the meeting, the council launched its “Plastic-Free and Ban on Polystyrene Campaign” in line with the Federal Government’s Roadmap Towards Zero Single-Use Plastics 2018-2030 that was introduced last October.

# Composting way to sustainability

Machine can support up to 100kg of food waste a day

A FOOD composting project is finally taking off at Block 3, Desa Mentari with the support from the Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ). The council provided a food composting machine to the community, which has been involved in several green initiatives, at an event launched by the Petaling Jaya mayor Datuk Mohd Sayuthi Bakar over the weekend. It was also attended by Petaling Jaya MP Maria Chin Abdullah, Seri Setia assemblyman Halimey Abu

Bakar and Subang MP Wong Chen. Sayuthi said the council wants to promote waste-to-energy types of initiatives among the community. Block 3, Desa Mentari was selected and provided with the anaerobic digestion composition machine as part of MBPJ's long-term goal to strive towards being a sustainable city by 2030 as well as creating a zero waste community. "The council has two other food composting machines located in SS2 and SS8. This is the first one in Desa Mentari, and is also sponsored by the council. "The council wants to emphasise

3R (reduce, reuse and recycle) and promote a circular economy (where the goal is to reduce waste and reuse manufactured goods). "Through this composting effort, the residents could even sell their liquid compost and biogas in the future," said the mayor who wants to reduce the money spent on discarding waste at the landfill. He added that the composting machine could support up to 100kg of food waste each day. On average, the council spends about RM77mil for waste management in Petaling Jaya. Some 700 tonnes of waste is discarded in the city each day and

20% of the council budget is spent on waste collection and the cleaning of public areas. Sayuthi said in Japan, the community would spearhead such green projects but over here, the council was trying to introduce the composting concept to the community. Petaling Jaya Solid Waste Management and Public Cleansing Department director Lee Lih Shyan said in 2016, the Block 3, Desa Mentari community came third at the state government organised river and beach cleanliness competition. They took second place in the

same competition in 2017. In April, the community was roped into the composting project and has since gathered some 800 litres of liquid compost. Sayuthi highlighted that 10 years ago, MBPJ first engaged with the Block 3 residents to rehabilitate the then polluted Sungai Way river that flows through their neighbourhood. He said with the help of the residents, the river water quality improved by leaps and bounds. The block residents took a step further with the help from Global Environment Centre and created a community garden along the river.

**S**HAH Alam, being Selangor's "golden triangle", offers big opportunities for companies and businesses to grow.

For I-Berhad, the company could go beyond the current RM10 billion gross development value (GDV) footprint for its i-City development in Seksyen 17, said executive chairman Tan Sri Lim Kim Hong.

Lim said the value of I-Berhad's investment properties would be enhanced by being located within the golden triangle.

There would also be spillover effects to the company's hospitality, retail and leisure businesses, he told NST Property.

Lim said it is quite possible that I-Berhad could achieve its targeted RM1 billion investment for property portfolio in less than five years from now.

According to its 2018 annual report, as at end-December last year, I-Berhad's property investment portfolio stood at RM641.1 million.

The company's growth strategy focuses on building up three core segments — property development, investment property and leisure.

I-Berhad plans to upgrade and relocate some of its theme park rides and attractions at i-City, in order to free up the land for property development which will include investment properties.

"There's a lot happening in i-City," said Lim, adding that for the rest of this year the company would be launching RM800 million worth of properties.

Just recently the RM850 million Central i-City was officially opened by Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah.

Next year will see the opening of the second convention centre and the DoubleTree by Hilton hotel at Central Walk @ i-city.

**MOST ICONIC SHOWPIECE IN I-CITY**

Lim said the most iconic element of the entire urban enclave would be the landmark and skyline-changing 68-storey office-cum-five-star hotel tower.

The tower is envisaged to be the tallest building in Shah Alam and possibly Selangor.

Rising an imposing 300 metres from ground to rooftop, the grand tower will see Grade A offices occupying Level 1 to 50, separated by a sky lobby and a sky pool before continuing on with a five-star hotel from Level 51 to 68.

The highest floor would be topped off by a breath-taking sky bar which would illuminate the skyline by night, Lim said.

The tower will be surrounded by a medical mall, commercial-based developments and residential properties catering to the international community.

He said the medical mall would feature three components — a medical office, a medical centre and a wellness centre providing healthcare-related services to residents, visitors and medical tourists.

**TECHNOLOGY-BASED GOLDEN TRIANGLE**

Lim hopes i-City would cement its place as the heart of Selangor's golden triangle and as a platform to help in the realisation of the Smart Selangor 2025 initiative.

"Considering that only half of the approved GFA (gross floor area) has been completed, there are ample opportunities for i-City to continue contributing to the economic development and prosperity of Selangor," he said.

As the No. 1 Technology City, I-Berhad has the track record to be a catalyst to help Selangor achieve its vision.

"From the onset of i-City's conceptualisation and development about 15 years ago, technology has always been the underlying motivation which sparks all manner of activity," said Lim.

Today, i-City is still the only urban centre in Shah Alam and is home to information and com-

munications technology (ICT)-centric businesses such as the Selangor Digital Creative Centre (an incubator and co-working centre of the state government), and the first Uptime Institute-certified data centre in the country.

"Uptime Institute is known to be the IT industry's

most trusted and adopted global standard for the proper design, build and operation of data centres," said Lim.

i-City was also the first connected community in the Southeast Asian region when it adopted the Cisco Smart + Connected Community platform, making it the first development in the country that provided not only fibre optic-based connectivity to the unit as a basic utility, but also high speed broadband when dial-up modems were still commonplace.

"i-City we see unfolding before our eyes today was founded on the determination to offer a fully-integrated lifestyle township with the infusion of cutting-edge technologies, characterised by a number of strategic alliances with some of the world's leading lights.

"When completed, the entire i-City landscape will be an intelligent and international city comprising a shopping mall, corporate office towers, cyber office suites, serviced residences, hotels, apartments, leisure attractions, medical and educational hubs, as well as a data and innovation centre," he said.

Lim said by the middle of the next decade — being likely home to 20,000 residents (of the 25,000 targeted) and 25,000 knowledge workers (of the 30,000 targeted) — the final phases of i-City's development would be embarked on.

"By such time, a total of 20 towers would already have indelibly and unmistakably marked the skyline of Shah Alam," he added.

"Hari ini kandungan air, sifat dan warnanya sudah berubah sama sekali sehingga mengeluarkan bau dan jika disentuh, badan akan berasa gatal-gatal.

"Saya harap pihak berkuasa dapat menjalankan pemantauan dan mengambil tindakan tegas terhadap individu yang sengaja mengotorkan sungai," katanya sambil menambah bahawa sungai sepatutnya dijadikan sebagai nadi kehidupan rakyat, bukan untuk dicemari.

**T**ABIAT jelik orang ramai yang mengambil jalan mudah dengan membuang sampah ke dalam sungai menjadi antara penyumbang utama terhadap masalah pencemaran sebatang anak sungai di Kampung Sungai Raya, Batu 9, Cheras di sini.

Penduduk mendakwa, selain dicituskan oleh faktor pembangunan, masalah itu juga berpunca daripada sikap segelintir penghuni dalam kalangan warga asing apabila menjadikan

kawasan sungai itu sebagai tong sampah besar bagi mereka.

Penduduk mendakwa, kedudukan rumah yang terletak kira-kira lima meter dari sungai berkenaan dipercayai menjadi punca sikap ambil mudah penghuni yang mengabaikan kemudahan tong sampah disediakan di setiap rumah oleh pihak berkuasa tempatan.

Tinjauan *Utusan Malaysia* di kawasan itu baru-baru ini mendapati dakwaan penduduk berasas apabila anak sungai yang mengalir di tengah-tengah penempatan didiami kira-kira 1,700 penduduk itu dipenuhi pelbagai jenis sampah-sarap. Ini termasuk plastik, bekas

makanan dan botol minuman yang boleh mempengaruhi kualiti airnya dan memberi kesan pada ekosistem Sungai Raya termasuk ikan sungai dan hakisan.

Turut mengejutkan sampah pukal seperti tilam, kusyen dan perabot juga dibuang ke dalam sungai sehingga menyekat aliran air.

Sementara itu, Ketua Kampung Sungai Raya, Norlisman Abu berkata, keadaan sungai itu tidak lagi seperti dahulu yang mana airnya boleh diminum, dijadikan tempat mandi-manda dan kawasan riadah penduduk sekitar.

Katanya, aktiviti pembuangan sampah ke dalam sungai masih berlaku meskipun be-

# Henti penularan politik jijik: Amirudin

**K**epemimpinan negara diminta mengambil tindakan tegas supaya dalang di sebalik penularan video palsu yang memfitnah seorang menteri kanan segera diheret ke muka pengadilan.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Amirudin Shari, berkata pihak berwajib juga perlu menyekat penularan video dan memberi amaran keras kepada pihak yang terus-menerus mensensasikan fitnah itu kepada khalayak awam.

### Fasa melampau

Beliau yang juga Pengerusi Majlis Pimpinan Negeri PKR Selangor menjelaskan perkembangan politik nasional sejak kebelakangan ini dijejaskan oleh mainan jelik dan keji, dengan penularan video palsu memfitnah menteri berkenaan memasuki suatu fasa yang melampau dan memualkan.

“Ketika rakyat dan seluruh negara mengharapkan politik yang memberi harapan untuk perubahan dan pembangunan, tetapi apa yang berlaku adalah

sebaliknya. Kini, politik menjadi medan fitnah, bukannya sebagai wasilah kepada kesejahteraan awam.

“Semalam satu lagi video fitnah disebar dan turut dimuat naik ke dalam laman pornografi. Amalan politik sebegini mencemarkan kesucian agama, tradisi dan budaya serta kemaslahatan rakyat khususnya umat Islam di negara ini,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan, di sini, semalam.

Amirudin berkata, pertembungan politik seharusnya berlaku dengan sihat serta menawarkan idea-idea yang mengangkat martabat rakyat dan negara, bukannya melalui cara terdesak yang kotor.

“Komplot politik jahat yang mengheret rakyat itu seharusnya tidak berlaku lagi di era Malaysia Baharu ini,” katanya.
