# Pegawai tadbir MBSA hadapi 4 tuduhan rasuah

Mengaku tidak bersalah terima RM36,000 babit tender khidmat pembersihan awam

**Shah Alam:** Seorang pegawai tadbir Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam, atas empat pertuduhan menerima suapan berjumlah RM36,000 pada 2014.

Azlan Dolah, 45, bagaimanapun mengaku tidak bersalah selepas semua pertuduhan dibacak terhadapnya di hadapan Hakim Rozilah Salleh.

Mengikut kertas pertuduhan, Azlan sebagai pegawai tadbir Gred N44 didakwa menerima suapan berjumlah RM36,000 daripada seorang individu menerusi empat cek pada Jun dan Julai 2014.

Tertuduh didakwa menerima suapan berkaitan tender Perkhidmatan Pembersihan Awam di Zon SA25 (A) Seksyen 32, Shah Alam, untuk MBSA.

Justeru, tertuduh didakwa melakukan kesalahan yang boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 165 Kanun Kesejahteraan (Akta 574).

Jika sabit kesalahan, tertuduh boleh dihukum penjara hingga

dua tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Su ruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM), Fadhliz Ab Wahab.

Pihak pendakwaan menawarkan jaminan RM20,000 dengan seorang penjamin warganegara berserta syarat tambahan perlu menyerahkan pasport bagi simpanan mahkamah dan melaporkan diri di Pejabat SPRM Selangor pada minggu pertama setiap bulan.

Peguam, Azizzul Shariman

Mat Yusoff yang mewakili tertuduh pula meminta mahkamah mengurangkan jaminan kerana tertuduh digantung tugas hingga kes selesai dan hanya akan menerima separuh gaji bulanan.

Beliau berkata, tertuduh juga perlu menyara tiga anak dan isteri, selain menanggung ibu menghidap penyakit kencing manis serta strok, dan bapa yang juga pesakit kanser.

Mahkamah kemudian menetapkan ikat jamin RM13,000 dengan syarat tambahan, dan tarikh sebutan semula kes pada 25 Ogos ini.

# Selangor komited sedia kemudahan bantu PKS

**Selangor** akan terus menyediakan kemudahan bagi menyokong perusahaan kecil dan sederhana (PKS) serta syarikat pemula nia- ga mendepani cabaran dalam perniagaan dengan beralih ke arah digital.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Tapak Pelaburan, Industri dan Perdagangan, Perusahaan Kecil dan Sederhana, Datuk Teng Chang Khim, berkata pandemik yang melanda menjelaskan syarikat tradisional, akibat Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) yang berlanjut.

Beliau bagaimanapun berkata, masih terdapat perniagaan berkaitan teknologi pertanian, teknologi perbankan, teknologi hijau, e-dagang dan perbandaran pintar menunjukkan peningkatan memberangskan.

"Penyelesaian e-dagang, teknologi perbankan dan perbandaran pintar sangat relevan pada ketika ini bagi memastikan perniagaan masih dapat diteruskan walaupun dalam keadaan masih menjaga keselamatan."

"Ini adalah fokus utama kerajaan Selangor untuk memulihkan ekonomi melalui digitalisasi, penggunaan teknologi dalam operasi perniagaan dan menjamin keselamatan makanan," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika melancarkan siri keempat Selangor Accelerator Programme

(SAP) 2021, inisiatif di bawah Selangor Information Technology and Digital Economy Corporation (SIDEK) secara maya, semalam.

Mengulas lanjut, Chang Khim berkata, Selangor melancarkan pelbagai siri program pendigitalan seperti empat pusingan kempen Selangor e-Bazar dengan jumlah pembentukan sebanyak RM7 juta.

Beliau berkata, kempen e-Bazar itu memberi manfaat kepada hampir 300,000 peniaga dalam talian termasuk 75,000 peniaga baharu, menjana jualan langsung sebanyak RM145 juta, sekali gus memberi impak RM2.95 bilion kepada ekonomi Selangor.

Kerajaan Selangor juga, katanya, terus memberi sokongan kepada PKS melalui Geran Padanan Digitalisasi PKS Selangor yang bertujuan untuk membantu PKS mengambil langkah pertama untuk mendigitalisasikan perniagaan.

Inisiatif itu, tegasnya, diharap dapat memberi manfaat kepada 1,000 PKS Selangor dengan geran keseluruhan bernilai RM5 juta.

"Untuk kumpulan pertama, kami mengagihkan RM1.2 juta kepada 280 PKS daripada 492 permohonan. PKS boleh mula mendaftar untuk kumpulan kedua geran ini mulai 1 Ogos sehingga 31 Oktober 2021," katanya.

# 'Saya risau JDT bukan Selangor'

**Mora ambil sikap waspada bertandang ke laman Red Giants**

**Johor Bahru:** Johor Darul Ta'zim (JDT) mengambil pendekatan berwaspada apabila turun menentang Selangor FC pada aksi Liga Super di Stadium Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya (MBPJ), malam ini.

Pengendali pasukan, Benjamin Mora mengakui tugas rumit bakal menanti mereka berdepan skuad kendalian Karsten Neitzel, namun sudah bersedia meneruskan momentum kemenangan.

"Sudah tentu saya inginkan kemenangan bertemu Selangor FC. Bermain dengan corak per-

mainan yang lebih konsisten selain pemain diturunkan nanti tampil dengan lebih agresif dan mengikut taktikal dirancang.

"Pemain perlu fokus apabila beraksi di padang dan ia penting untuk tampil dengan prestasi lebih baik dan itu yang yang saya harapkan. Dari situ baru saya dapat nilai kerana saya tidak bimbang dengan prestasi Selangor FC."

"Saya tidak terlalu risaukan Selangor FC, saya risau akan JDT. Saya risaukan permainan JDT, sebabnya jika JDT melakukan tugasnya secara 100 peratus, ia akan menjadi sangat sukar untuk pasukan lawan mendapatkan peluang tapi jika kami tidak fokus dan memberikan peluang, mereka akan hukum kami," katanya.

Pada pertembungan pusingan pertama di Stadium Sultan Ibrahim pada 17 Mac lalu, JDT terikat 1-1 dengan skuad The Red Giants dan aksi kedua dilihat menarik taktala JDT mahu terus melebaran rekod kemenangan untuk kelalai tangga teratas.

Tegas Mora lagi, aksi 90 minit

perlawanan pasti menarik kerana bukan sahaja JDT mahukan kemenangan malah Selangor FC juga berazam untuk bangkit selepas mencatat keputusan seri 1-1 ketika menentang KL City FC.

Katanya, JDT tidak boleh ambil sikap mudah kerana Selangor FC adalah pasukan yang bagus walaupun ia berada di tangga kelima tapi menunjukkan semangat untuk melawan bagi merebut kejuaraan liga.

Katanya, saingan pada musim ini jelas sengit berikutan Terengganu FC, Kedah Darul Aman FC dan Penang FC sudah mula mempamerkan aksi mantap sekali gus memaksa JDT tidak boleh silap percaturan dan keciciran mata.

# Kerajaan negeri siasat dakwaan

**SHAH ALAM:** Siasatan dan pengesahan sempadan hutan simpan perlu dilakukan terlebih dahulu bagi mengesahkan aktiviti pertanian yang didakwa melibatkan penanaman pokok durian di satu kawasan di Hutan Simpan Bukit Cerakah di Sungai Buloh benar-benar menceroboh.

Hal itu dijelaskan Exco Pelancongan dan Alam Sekitar, Hee Loy Sian yang memaklumkan pihaknya akan menyiasat dan mendapatkan maklumat terperinci berhubung dakwaan terbabit.

Bagaimanapun, Exco itu mengakui setakat ini beliau tiada maklumat berhubung perkara itu dan menegaskan tindakan akan diambil jika benar aktiviti pertanian itu menceroboh.

“Kita kena siasat dahulu sama ada tanah itu benar-benar di bawah hutan simpan ataupun tidak, kalau sah, kita kena ambil tindakan. Setakat ini yang saya tahu, pencerobohan hutan simpan di Selangor untuk penanaman durian tidak ada, tetapi pokok kelapa sawit banyak.

“Aduan boleh dibuat melalui Jabatan Perhutanan ataupun kepada saya,” katanya ketika dihubungi semalam.

Sementara itu, Timbalan Pengarah (Operasi Hutan) Norddin Noor pula menjelaskan, pihaknya juga perlu melakukan siasatan bagi memastikan status tanah kawasan hutan yang ditebang.

“Kita siasat dan buat pengesahan sempadan, ia atau tidak (berlaku pencerobohan). Kita hendak mengesahkan sempadan untuk menentukan sama ada kawasan yang mereka buat aduan itu hutan simpan ataupun bukan.

“Selepas itu, kalau betul hutan simpan, kita kena ambil tindakan menggunakan akta kita (Akta Perhutanan Negara 1984). Kalau bukan hutan simpan, kita tidak akan ambil tindakan,” kata beliau.

# Pegawai tadbir MBSA nafi terima RM36,000

**SHAH ALAM:** Seorang pegawai tadbir Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) mengaku tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, hari ini atas empat pertuduhan menerima suapan berjumlah RM36,000, tujuh tahun lalu.

Tertuduh, Azlan Dolah, 45, membuat pengakuan itu selepas keempat-empat pertuduhan dibacakan di hadapan Hakim Rozilah Salleh.

Berdasarkan pertuduhan, Azlan yang bertugas di MBSA Cawangan Kota Kemuning dituduh telah menerima wang tunai berjumlah RM36,000 daripada Mohamad Shaharom Alias melalui empat cek Hong Leong Bank Berhad tanpa sebarang balasan yang diketahui ianya ada kaitan dengan tugas rasmi berkenaan dengan tender Perkhidmatan Pembersihan Awam di Zon SA25(A) Seksyen 32, Shah Alam.

Pegawai Tadbir Gred N44 itu didakwa melakukan kesalahan terbabit di cawangan bank di Seksyen 15, di sini masing-ma-

sing pada 13 Jun dan 9 Julai 2014.

Bapa kepada tiga orang cahaya mata dengan pendapatan bulanan sebanyak RM6,000 itu didakwa telah melakukan kesalahan yang boleh dihukum di bawah Seksyen 165 Kanun Keseksaan (Akta 574) dan jika sabit 'kesalahan, dia boleh dipenjara sehingga dua tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya sekali.

Timbalan Pendakwa Raya daripada Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM), Fadhli Ab. Wahab menawarkan jaminan RM20,000 bagi kesemua pertuduhan dengan syarat tambahan melapor diri di pejabat SPM terdekat pada setiap minggu pertama setiap bulan selain menyerahkan pasport antarabangsa milik tertuduh kepada mahkamah.

Mahkamah menetapkan jaminan RM13,000 dengan seorang penjamin warganegara. Kes disebut semula pada 25 Ogos ini.

# 'Kami kini asnaf sementara'

**Kuala Lumpur:** Ini semua Allah yang atur. Dia nak bagi rezeki macam ini," kata isteri Man Kidal, Norlaila Yusof berkenaan kehadiran pegawai Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) ke rumah mereka di Damansara, Petaling Jaya, Jumaat lalu untuk menghulurkan bantuan barang keperluan asas.

Norlaila ketika dihubungi berkata, pada saat mereka mengalami kesempitan hidup akibat suaminya hilang mata pencarian sejak pularan Covid-19, bantuan ini amat berharga.

"Alhamdulillah, ada orang nak bagi. Kita dah dua tahun tak kerja. Ada orang bersimpati, kita nak tolak pun tak boleh. Saya tak min-ta apa-apa, tapi terkejut melihat mereka datang.

"Saya juga diminta isi barang bagi mendapatkan bantuan pada masa depan. Namun, nama Abang Man diletakkan asnaf dalam ku-rungan dan saya mulanya terkejut.

"Namun, saya fikir balik, apa nak malu. Orang nak cakap apa-apa terpulanglah. Kalau tak tolong tak apa, tapi janganlah kecam. Se-baliknya doakan yang baik-baik," katanya.

Menerusi bantuan ini, Man Kidal, 57, yang turut positif Covid-19 baru-baru ini, diletakkan dalam kategori asnaf sementara sehingga dapat bangkit semula.

"Gitar itu Abang Man guna 40 tahun untuk bagi keluarga makan. Saya sangat meng-hargainya. Dia pun pesan kalau dia tiada nanti jangan bagi orang lain," katanya.



**PARLIMENTER** Ahli Parlimen Kuala Selangor Dr Dzulfiyati Ahmad membentur Menteri Sains dan Teknologi Bala berkata, kerajaan tidak memberikan maklumat tentang perkongsian data Covid-19 dalam masa yang terlambat 10 bulan memandangkan jumlah keselamatan jangkaan itu Covid-19 sudah mewabah sejak.

Sistem Gitihsa yang boleh diakses oleh orang ramai menyediakan maklumat berkenaan penularan wabak Covid-19 di Malaysia.

Diseujukan minggu lalu, untuk menyediakan maklumat antara lainnya, ulasan dan pengiktirafan, kerusakan hasil tanaman, kiraan ECI dan jumlah diri basuk menerusi aplikasi MySejahtera.

"Saya (sejauh) belum temui teks asas (data yang dimasukkan dalam) Gitihsa ini cumanya 10 months lalu (terlambat 10 bulan), katanya yang juga bekas menteri kesihatan di Dewan Rakyat.

Bagaimanapun Ahli menjelaskan, "Tak apa, sekurang-kurangnya ada tuh dengan jemuan tuh, Dzulfiyati Ahmad tuh dengan peranan dia dalam menurunkan entri faktor yang menyumbang kepada peningkatan jangkaran adalah keberangkatan KKM berkongsi data secara terperinci dengan kerajaan Selangor."

Untuk rekod, Selangor telah menjadi negeri yang mencatatkan jumlah kes harian Covid-19 yang tertinggi di Malaysia.

Namun, Ahli membantah bahawa jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Selangor (JKNS) ada taksu Tax Fon Covid-19 Selangor yang diberikan oleh Dzulfiyati.

Bagaimanapun Dzulfiyati kemaslahat menduduki ADS tidak berasarkan berlogori data yang kengang Selangor.

**Adham:** Yang berkohesi (Dzulfiyati) menginggirkan Dewan.

**Dzulfiyati:** Dia yang menggilang Dewan? (Dia) sleeping on the job (anda tidak kuat kepal) tu tontongngek anda.

Tidak peduli dengan seorang Dzulfiyati Adham merenungkan penginggiran dengan menyentuh isu ejan saringan Covid-19 secara besar-besaran.

Bagaimanapun, Ahli salah loging oleh Dzulfiyati yang merendahka dia berbongkah bekerja sijil senring secara besar-besaran telah diadak di setiap negeri.

Adham berkata terdapat 15 sijil yang saringan yang dibuat untuk membenarkan penularan Covid-19.

"Inti merupakan instansi yang buat sebenarnya yang dipalakkan oleh KKM dan setiap negeri sajapandemik berisikan."

"KKM telah menerakan ujian bersarang teratas mesej dan juga-juga mesej di kawasan PDRM perihal kawasan pengarakan diperketatkan," kata Adham merenungkan ucapan penginggiran.

# Govt is all for making workplaces safer for employees

**PETALING JAYA:** All efforts will be made to assist employers who only allow vaccinated employees on site as long as the intent is to make workplaces safer and better, says International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mohd Azmin Ali.

"Non-vaccinated staff may (cause) a spike that would lead to operations closing down, loss of income, and workers being laid off."

"As much as possible, the International Trade and Industry Ministry wants to work with private employers not just to preserve existing employment, but also to create new jobs," said the Senior Minister.

"Employees are the backbone of the economy and must be protected at all costs."

Azmin said that the government introduced the Public-Private Partnership Covid-19 Industry Immunisation Programme (Pikas) because it realised that many companies need to operate but were wary of Covid-19.

"Employees have no choice but to be exposed at the workplace during the movement control order because essential goods and services sectors (under manufacturing) need to operate to minimise the disruption of supply to the rakyat."

"However, because the current government policy on vaccination is voluntary, there is an urgent need to speed up the process so that more economic sectors can open up."

"Hence, the government and private employers have come together under Pikas to safeguard their employees by getting them

348,852 (first dose at least). Of these, 35,790 have received their second dose," he added.

Azmin said many private companies had been very supportive of Pikas.

"Pikas has been very successful with full support and cooperation from companies. We urge more to come on board as I believe they want their employees to be protected against infections in the workplace," he added.

Separately, the Human Resources Ministry said that it was not against labour laws to have a company policy demanding all staff present in the workplace be fully vaccinated.

The ministry's Labour Department chief Asri Ab Rahman said that as long as the effort was to make the workplace safer and better for employees, such rulings are permissible but must be done

through the right procedure.

"Companies that want to make it a ruling that only staff who are vaccinated can be present at the workplace should make it a company policy to ensure that this is applicable across the board, among all employees."

"For those companies where workers are part of a union, we advise them to work with the unions with such a ruling so as to ensure a better and safer workplace for all."

"What is important in applying such policies in the workplace is that there must be sufficient notice and information before enforcing the ruling."

"On the part of the Human Resources Ministry, we welcome all efforts by employers who strive to make their workplaces better and safer for their employees," said Asri when contacted.

## More revenue needed for Klang city aspirations

Proposed assessment tax hike not sitting well with residents and businesses

THE Klang Municipal Council (MPK) has plans to increase assessment tax rates on all properties by up to 25% over five years, starting from January.

This would see residential and commercial property owners paying more in taxes regardless of the type or category of building possessed, a source in MPK said.

"Properties are valued in their original structure or renovated, will we a like in assessment rates?"

MPK has the power to impose the assessment tax under the Local Government Act 1996 and its decision to propose an increase in the rates is largely unpopular with Klang residents and property owners as many of them have been promised a moratorium until the Covid-19 pandemic is over.

The source said the council had planned to propose the hike after it decided to postpone its annual budget meeting as the government enhanced movement control order was imposed earlier on July 16.

"The Economic Affairs Department had noted in its meeting earlier this year that the assessment tax on all property was outdated as the evaluation was done in the year 1994 and this had impacted to collection," said the source.

The assessment tax increase is needed to meet the financial needs of the council to expand and maintain the city.

"MPK needs additional funds to improve its public facilities such as roads, drains, street lights, bus stops, children's play areas, business, factories, parks, etc. We also need more funds as well as other public places."

The current pandemic has taken a toll on the economy and people have lost jobs, forcing them to move to smaller houses and even flats to make ends meet.

Such difficulties are common among the middle-class and lower-income groups.

Local resident and Kampung Sungai Kerenggong Residents Association president A. S. Nathan, 57, said

"I was not the one to propose the assessment tax as people were not asked for their opinion on what they thought about the hike in rates."

"We have difficulties paying their bills and there is no money left for other expenses," he said.

Such rate hikes in stable economic areas or those that are not strong enough for the ordinary man but still have to pay the same assessment rates as those who have seen prices of food items rise sharply during the pandemic.

"It will be better for MPK to increase the assessment rates on the Tebuk Gedung Indah Residents Association area," said A. S. Nathan, 52, who said that people were shocked when they heard about

the hike in rates.

"Our ageing population might not have the financial resources to pay the assessment rates especially after being impacted by the pandemic," he said.

"MPK's assessment increase can affect the middle-class and lower-income groups who do not enjoy the services provided by the council," he said.

Meanwhile, Kuala Lumpur and Selangor Businessmen and Industrialists Association president Ng See Hock, 52, said

"We are going through economic and social challenges and people risk falling into extreme poverty again. We are seeing many people with low income are trying to get mental health services and this is becoming more difficult now," he said.

"I hope that MPK will not drop the idea."

"Recordings of past meetings should be uploaded on the council's website so that they can be accessed by the public anytime," he said.

Derek said Sharipah agreed to the request and said the live link for the proceeding would be available online next month.

The meeting also heard that MBPJ has uncollected assessment tax amounting to RM177.638mil

from ratepayers.

It urged the public to settle outstanding tax before Aug 31 to avoid a penalty.

The city council has 266,111

payees in its assessment roll.

MBPJ also collaborated with the police for 155 operations.

# **Seven caught dumping rubbish in market area**

SEVEN individuals in Selayang were fined RM1,000 each after they were caught on camera throwing rubbish at an undesignated area in Taman Sri Gombak.

Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) Corporate Communications director Mohamad Zin Masoad said in a statement that its officers tracked down the offenders who threw domestic waste at a rubbish disposal area meant for traders of Pasar Taman Sri Gombak.

“The issue of garbage overflow in this market has dragged on for almost two years as the disposal area built for the use of market traders are used by irresponsible individuals to dispose of their rubbish, causing hygiene issues in the surrounding area.

“On July 23, compound notices were sent to the offenders’ resi-

dences by checking the vehicle registration number in the i-Sikap application that was obtained from closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras installed in the area,” said Mohamad Zin.

He added that since January, 34 compounds were issued to offenders for dumping rubbish illegally based on CCTV monitoring at several hotspot areas within the municipality.

“MPS would like to remind residents to dispose of their domestic waste in their residential rubbish bins and be aware of garbage collection schedules in their neighbourhoods.

## Special committee to hear objections to Selayang draft plan

OBJECTIONS to Selayang Municipal Council's (MPS) Draft Local Plan (Replacement) 2030 will be tabled before a special committee in September, says its new council president Mohd Yazid Sairi.

He said MPS received 166 objections to proposed developments in the draft plan after going through a public inspection process for two months.

"Each objection submitted will be discussed and taken into account in the Local Investigation and Hearing Committee before the draft plan is finalised," he said during the council's full board meeting yesterday.

The new local plan will replace the existing MPS Local Plan 2020, which was gazetted in January 2011 and expired at the end of last year.

The plan will be the main reference point in terms of development within a local area, to avoid conflict in land usage.

Due to the lockdown, MPS extended public inspection of the draft plan from May to the end of June to get feedback from stakeholders.

On another matter, Mohd Yazid said MPS continued to take necessary steps to eradicate illegal and unlicensed factories within the municipality.

"Following a census, only 30% of 1,513 factories in Selayang submit-

ted feedback as part of the local council's factory legalising programme that started last year.

"A consultant will be appointed to carry out another census to determine if there are more such factories in areas not yet covered.

"We estimate about 500 factories remain unlicensed," he said.

Part of the programme was to clear river reserve areas of factories that could potentially cause water pollution and the shutdown of the state's water treatment plants.

In December last year, *StarMetro* reported on MPS demolishing eight business premises to clear the banks of Sungai Rawang and Sungai Gong of illegal factories.

Prior to yesterday's meeting,

Mohd Yazid was sworn in as the new MPS president.

He clocked in on July 19 after former president Shamsul Shahril Badiza Mohd Noor was promoted to a Federal Government post in May.

Mohd Yazid was most recently deputy director (management) of Selangor Islamic Religious Department (JAIS) and was Sepang district officer prior to being appointed MPS president.

He pledged to continue the vision to lead MPS towards upgrading to a city council by 2030.

He also aimed to upgrade and develop the municipality as an eco-tourism destination.

"About 33% of the area under our jurisdiction is made up of for-

est reserves and recreational sites. Places like Taman Rimba Bukit Lagong, Hutan Lipur Sungai Tua, Taman Ekstrem Gua Damai and Selayang Hot Springs have potential to generate returns on any investment," he added.

As expected, the Opposition MPs were chafing at the bit after waiting so long to be able to gather in the Dewan Rakyat. For them, it was a chance to slam the Perikatan Nasional government's handling of the Covid-19 pandemic.

From the outset, they tried very hard to get the Speaker to change the "special sitting" – as it was termed – to a full-blown parliamentary meeting where elected representatives of the people had the right to question the government of the day on what it has done to fight the pandemic, especially in its use of emergency powers granted by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, and to debate the National Recovery Plan.

From their standpoint, this was what the King's decree was about and not for the government to fudge around with a special meeting that it could control as a briefing session.

But Speaker Datuk Azhar Azizan Harun would have none of it and maintained that the July 26-Aug 2 dates were indeed a special meeting with the agenda set by the government as listed on the order paper, which were "explanations by ministers" for all five days (there is no meeting on Friday).

Azhar was mauled by Pakatan Harapan MPs for sticking to his guns – he got called a government lapdog – and when he had enough, he

snailed back to shut his critics up.

The meeting is a prime example of the power and advantage of incumbency and the Perikatan government used it to the hilt. During a heated exchange when Opposition MPs kept insisting they wanted to debate the emergency ordinances, de facto Law Minister Datuk Seri Takiyuddin Hassan suddenly announced that the government had decided to revoke all emergency ordinances promulgated during the proclamation of emergency in January. What's more, he added the government would not advise the King to extend the emergency beyond Aug 1.

Takiyuddin acted like everyone should know this, which was, of course, ridiculous since there was no announcement of that decision made during last week's Cabinet meeting.

It was a Machiavellian move that knocked the wind out of the Opposition's sails but it leaves the whole nation rather confused. What exactly does this revocation mean? No more summons and fines for violating SOP, even though many places are under restricted move-

ment and enhanced MCOs? Under what powers will enforcement of restrictions be made?

As expected, Constitutional law experts are giving their learned opinions on the legality, implications and consequences. All the public can do is wait and see. Does anyone want to test the waters by venturing out without a mask, having five people in a car and inviting friends over for dinner?

Although watching the House proceedings online had its shortcomings, like low resolution quality, it did allow public participation through the posting of immediate comments.

This, to me, was a good indication of public sentiments, which were mostly angry and resentful. This is, of course, not a situation unique to our country. Australians, Italians, Greeks and the French are so furious that thousands of them are protesting their governments' handling of the pandemic.

Knowing how immensely unpopular a couple of ministers are, the Opposition couldn't resist gunning for them in the House. Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr Adham Baba's two-week old "Spanish fly" gaffe was still fresh meat for sly jokes thrown at him and the attack on International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali was quite relentless.

When he tried to defend his ministry's position and actions on factories and workplaces during the lockdowns, they mercilessly mocked the posters with economic charts and statistics he had brought along to show them.

There were moments of wry humour like when veteran Arau MP

Datuk Seri Shahidan Kassim complained to the Speaker that the Opposition had repeatedly heckled and interrupted his speech. Vexed, he likened them to unschooled children. Seizing the moment, a witty but unknown MP intoned, "Sekolah tutup" (schools are closed).

Much as I was irritated and frustrated with the time-wasting shouting and mud-slinging that went back and forth, I was glad to see signs of boisterous life back in our Dewan Rakyat.

What's more, I was impressed with some of the MPs who did manage to speak sense and show they were really in touch with what's happening on the ground.

Among them were MP for Permatang Pauh Nurul Izzah Anwar who urged caution against depending on mass vaccinations to save the economy. She cited Iceland's example of opening up their country to vaccinated tourists after 85% of its citizens were fully vaccinated, only to reimpose restrictions after infections spiked again with the Delta variant.

Among other points they raised, Muar MP Syed Saddiq Syed Abdul Rahman and Bukit Mertajam MP Steven Sim made an appeal for the new loan repayment moratorium to be automatic, without conditions and interest. This I fully agree with because it's unfair for banks to recover the unpaid interest during the Covid-19 years by increasing the instalments from their affected clients once the moratorium is over.

In contrast, so many other businesses are struggling to survive and if they can reopen, they will never make back what they lost. So why should the government be so kind

to banks that are famous for providing an umbrella that they take away when it rains?

Jelebu MP Datuk Jalaluddin Alias was a surprise in his strong criticism of the government's failure to resolve the contract doctors' issue which led to their strike on Monday. He said he raised the issue in November and that the Health Minister had promised to look into it. He also pointed out that more private hospitals in the country should share the burden with government hospitals of taking in Covid-19 patients. He added that according to a July 6 Health Ministry report, only about 50%, or 112, private hospitals were doing their part.

I also support his call to get insurance companies to change their policy requiring Covid-19 patients to "pay and claim" as it is another hardship on them.

Listening to these people gave me some hope that there are intelligent elected representatives who do have the smarts, compassion and interest to serve the nation and not just themselves. I would like to think there are more of them in both Opposition and among government backbenchers.

The Perikatan government may think it has headed the Opposition off at the pass by setting up a special meeting and revoking the emergency ordinances. But whether Perikatan ministers like it or not, Pakatan Harapan and other Opposition MPs will definitely counterattack in the days to come. So on with the show, parliamentarians!

"Aside from that, lunch and dinner also came late. Lunch was served between 1.30pm and 2pm while dinner was served between 8.30pm and 9pm. Yesterday's dinner was only a packet of char kuey teow.

"Imagine how physically and mentally stressed they are due to the situation... they can only eat in the late afternoon. Covid-19 patients need sufficient food and nutrition to fight the virus," he said in a statement today.

He said such an incident should not have happened, especially at a hospital.

"The complainant is very concerned about the condition of her family members who are in the hospital and not getting good care. Hospital services are declining. This is due to the lack of capacity and staff."

"The federal government's failure to plan a long-term strategy to handle the Covid-19 outbreak has caused hospitals in the Klang Valley to operate beyond capacity thus affecting the efficiency and quality of treatment."



## 李富豪：不戴隔离手环恐失控

戴上隔离手环已难以管控，若确诊也不须戴隔离手环会不会更失控而加剧社区“流动病毒”的出现？巴生市议会卫生小组委员李富豪市议员认为，大家要有心理准备迎接更糟的局面。

李富豪向媒体指出，卫生部日前宣布，无症状或轻微症者不需要再到冠病评估中心进行评估和领取隔离手环，而无症状密切接触者也无需进行检测，他认为，这将是另一个

灾难性的措施，或进一步把疫情推向失控发展的地步。

就过去的案例可见，一些戴隔离手环者仍继续在外趴趴走，包括没获卫生部信函而被迫继续上班、外出采购等，不自律态度叫人傻眼，如今卫生部却允许确诊者不戴手环，也就等同于‘放任自由’，让病毒更无所不在地出现在社区内。”

他说，尽管目前社区感染已非常普及，但仍未到最糟情

况，不过，上述措施落实后，大家需有心理准备。

“我在今年2、3月期间已提醒，社区感染最大问题是没做好居家隔离措施，或是无法揪出隐藏确诊者而扩大感染群。”

他补充，一个无症状者的感染者，或者无碍本身健康状况，但是却难保不会把冠病传染给其他人，甚至导致其他人产生重症，因而成为危害社区安全的隐忧。

“早前，密切接触者在一些疫情严峻的县署里一早就无需接受检测，如今卫生部直接宣布无需检测了，这无形中让人担忧将有更多无症状患者在社区内走动，以致扩大病毒感染之余，也让目前确诊数据无法反映我国真实染疫情况了。”

他说，谁能确保密切接触者不会是下一个感染者呢？再说，如今病毒越来越“凶狠”，放任病患和密切接触者居家隔离也容易因住家环境隔离措施不佳，最终导致全家被感染，甚至蔓延至社区。

之谈，反倒是前往人多的疫苗接种中心后，更应该回家洗澡和换衣服。”

他补充，早前他曾提及落跑的确诊印尼妇案例，曾收留她的友人那户人家，7人当中有3、4人确诊，该住家的屋主是其邻居，也疑收租时被感染，包括前往收租的屋主70岁姐姐和逾百岁妈妈中招，姐姐目前还在加护病房。

到修车厂修车时，就算与员工保持距离抽上一根烟，结果也遭感染。

# 涉清潔服務招標收賄 市廳官員控4罪

(沙亚南27日讯)一名沙亚南市政厅行政人员因涉嫌在公共区域清域服务招标事宜上，收贿总值3万6000令吉，今天在沙亚南地庭面对4项控状，惟他不认罪。

这名被告是45岁的阿兹兰多拉(44级公务员)，是沙亚南市政厅哥打哥文宁分局官员。

他是被控于2014年6月13日

和2014年7月9日，在沙亚南15区一家银行向同一个人收取4张支票。

首控状指他于在公务上没报备的情况下，涉嫌在沙亚南第32区的SA25(A)公共区域清洁服务招标事宜上，收取莫哈末沙哈伦阿里亚斯2000令吉的支票。至于

第二、三及四项控状，被告在同一个目的下，各别向同一人接收1万令吉、1万7000令吉及7000令吉的支票，因此被告触犯刑事法典第165条文(574条文)。

根据有关条文阐明，一旦罪成，最高可被判监禁2年或罚款，或两者兼施。

由于被告否认有罪，审理此案的法官为罗兹拉莎烈最终让被告以1万3000令吉

和1名担保人，保释外出，同时需要呈交护照给法庭，并每个月到雪州反贪会报到一次。负责此案的副检察司是法迪，而被告的代表律师则是阿兹祖。(TSI)
