'MBSA will cooperate with MACC'

Shah Alam mayor says city council will not protect officers who committed offences

SHAH Alam City Council (MBSA) will extend is full cooperation to the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) in its inves-tigations following the release of viral videos alleging their officers were on the take. Shah Alam mayor Datuk Haris Kasim said

they would not protect officers if they were found to have committed any wrongdoing.

"We will also conduct our own internal investigation after MACC completes its probe," he said at a traders legalisation pro-gramme organised by MBSA in Dewan Meranti, Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh, Shah

He was commenting on the remand of MBSA's enforcement department director and several enforcement officers in the probe into claims of corruption involving syndicate providing protection for illegal

Ten people, comprising nine MBSA officers and a foreign trader, have been arrested so far by MACC as the graft agency investigates claims that certain enforcement authorities were on the take and protecting illegal businesses in Sungai Buloh.

The arrests came about following videos on alleged illegal gambling and the sale of contraband cigarettes by Hot Burger Malaysia founder Mohd Asri Hamid, also

known as Asri Janggut.
Also present at the event's opening were Selangor youth generation development, sports and human capital development com-mittee chairman Mohd Khairuddin Othman, state local government, public transport and new village development committee chair-man Ng Sze Han, Sungai Buloh MP R. Sivarasa and Petaling district officer Johary

Khairuddin, who is also Paya Jaras assemblyman, said the engagement programme was part of MBSA's ongoing efforts to assist and legalise traders.

"It is not being held because of the viral

videos. The focus is on educating traders who are worried about approaching MBSA to apply for the necessary permits and for them to get accurate information for their

He said MBSA would also identify suitable

He said MBSA would also identify suitable locations to relocate traders.

"MBSA has proposed several locations, but will need to discuss their suitability with traders and residents associations.

"For now, MBSA will issue temporary permits to Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh traders to allow them to continue their business, while locking for epitties to section to section the section of the section o looking for solutions to restructure and relo-cate the traders," said Khairuddin, adding that priority would be given to those residing in Sungai Buloh.

He said one solution was for the construc-

tion of a business arcade at the present Paya

Jaras night market site.
"It will be a multi-level building to house between 200 and 300 traders. The suggestion was mooted in 2015 but the issue now is that the site needs to be gazetted," said

"In an earlier dialogue I had with Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh traders, they disagreed with the action taken by Mohd Asri and felt

what was said was his personal opinion.
"At the same dialogue session, I advised those present to form a traders association. It would serve as a unifying body to monitor and manage their issues and members."

Khairuddin also reminded traders that only Malaysians were allowed to run businesses in Selangor; foreigners were not allowed to trade and could not be hired as assistants. The traders legalisation pro-gramme was held over the weekend to edu-cate them on the do's and don'ts of conduct-

The two-day programme, which ended

yesterday, included briefings on the applica-tions and procedures required for temporary trading permits, additional structures such as awnings and partitions, planning permis-sion for existing structures as well as health and food safety.

The event was attended by affected traders as well as those from other areas under MBSA's administration who wanted to seek clarification to legalise their businesses.
"It's a good effort and convenient," said Mohamad Shaipudin Basir, one of the trad-

ers who attended. He has been selling pyja-mas along Jalan 1A/1, Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh for almost 10 years. "While not all of us brought the right doc-

uments this morning, we can return in the afternoon or following day to submit our

afternoon or following day to submit our applications.

"All of us hope to be able to get permits and proper trading space. While we understand we will be relocated, we hope the space has good footfall."

Mohamad Shaipudin is also pro-tem deputy chairman of Bandar Baru Sungai Buloh

Traders' Association, which was formed to represent some 80 traders in the area.

Plonxbox owner Naeem Zaidi was upset with MBSA for demolishing his shop's temporary structure during a joint raid with several government agencies, less than 24 hours after the council issued a removal notice.

"We started running a food business six years ago, after our printing business of over 30 years wasn't doing well. While the food business is licensed, we were unsuccessful in our application for temporary structures such as awnings and cabins.

"We had already booked vehicles and equipment to relocate our cabins after receiving MBSA's removal notice.

"But MBSA demolished the structures despire our pleas for more time," he said. Naeem said it was unfair that some traders were given less than 24 hours' notice, while others were given up to 14 days to submit an application plan for the council's approval or demolished the structures themselves.

Hulu Langat: Kekurangan tanah perkuburan di sekitar Sungai Long di sini, menyebabkan penduduk beragama Islam terpaksa melakukan urusan pengebumian di luar kawasan.

Bagaimanapun, mereka menarik nafas lega semalam, susulan pembukaan Tanah Perkuburan Islam Bandar Sungai Long di sini.

Pengerusi Badan Khairat Taman Rakan, Sungai Long, Mohd Zamzuri Abu Othman berkata, sebelum ini penduduk di kawasan berkenaan terpaksa menguruskan pengebumian jenazah ahli keluarga mereka di luar kawasan seperti di Cheras Perdana, Sungai Kantan dan Sungai Sekamat, Kajang.

"Ketiadaan tapak tanah perkuburan Islam di kawasan ini menyukarkan penduduk (Muslim) untuk menguruskan urusan pengebumian jenazah ahli keluarga.

"Disebabkan itu, Jawatankuasa Biro Tanah Kubur Masjid Taman Rakan diwujudkan pada pertengahan 2014 untuk mengesan tapak sesuai dijadikan sebagai tanah perkuburan di kawasan ini," katanya pada majlis perasmian tapak perkuburan berkenaan, semalam.

Mohd Zamzuri berkata, hasil usaha jawatankuasa itu, Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (Jais) mewartakan tanah seluas 7.256 ekar sebagai tanah perkuburan Islam pada 2 Mac 2017 sebelum kerja pembersihan serta penyediaan kemudahan dilakukan.
