175 NGO rayu Agong campur tangan

KUALA LUMPUR: Sebanyak 175 pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) Islam merayu campur tangan Yang di-Pertuan Agong dan Raja-raja Melayu menghentikan pertelungan kahan parti politik supaya kepentingan rakyat dapat diutamakan.

Rayuan itu dilakukan melalui satu penyerahan memorandum kepada Seri Paduka di Istana Negara semalam.

Pengerusi Gerakan Pembela Ummah, Mohd. Zai Mustafa berkata, sekiranya kerajaan pemerintah ketika ini terburar, maka tiada pihak lain memperoleh majoriti membentuk kerajaan.

"Pihak kami menyambut titah nasihat Sultan Selangor, Sultan Johor dan Pemangku Raja Pahang yang menitahkan agar pemimpin berhenti daripada perebutan kuasa dan mengutamakan kemaslahatan rakyat dan perpaduan ummah.

"Krisian dan kekecwaan yang dizahirkan oleh baginda raja-raja Melayu berkaitan dengan krisis politik yang tidak berkesudahan ini perlu ditangani oleh semua pihak," katanya ketika ditemui di sini.

Mohd. Zai berkata, seharusnya sekarang semua pihak berganding bahu dan berkongsi ikhtiar memastikan Covid-19 dibendung, program imuniti berkelompok dicapai dan ekonomi negara digerakkan semula.

"Jika semua itu dilakukan bersama dengan istiqamah, kami percaya negara ini akan kembali pulih seperti sediakala dalam tempoh sepatutnya. Malangnya pemimpin politik lebih mengutamakan ego masing-masing berteraskan kepentingan kepartian dan kelompok bukannya kesejahteraan rakyat.

"Mereka tidak menggunakan Parlimen sebagai tempat mencari kata separa bagi memerangi mu-suh bersama, sebaliknya merosakkan demokrasi dengan menyalahguna-kannya bagi kepentingan sendiri," jelasnya.

Shah Alam: Gugur kewajiban memandikan atau tayamum jenazah pesakit Covid-19 sekiranya dibimbangi boleh menyebarkan penyakit kepada pihak yang menguruskannya.

“Mufti Selangor Datuk Dr Anhar Opir berkata, perkara itu diputuskan dalam Mesyuarat Khas Jawatankuasa Fatwa Negeri Selangor Kali Pertama Tahun 2021 yang bersidang pada 7 Ogos setelah diperkenan Sultan Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin

Idris Shah Al-Haj pada 11 Ogos lalu.

“Hukum asal pengurusan jenazah Muslim termasuk jenazah pesakit Covid-19 hendaklah diurus dengan sempurna melalui kaedah pengurusan jenazah dengan dimandi, dikafan, disembahyang dan dikebumikan dalam tempoh masa seminimum mungkin mengikut prosedur operasi standard (SOP) ditetapkan.

Shah Alam: Mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Tetap Alam Sekitar Bagi Membingkangkan Penyelesaian Isu Pembakaran Terbuka Di Kawasan Revolusi Hijau, Johan Setia, Klang membuat beberapa ketetapan bagi mempertingkatkan tindakan pelbagai agensi dalam menangani masalah pembakaran itu.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Tetap Pelancongan, Alam Sekitar, Teknologi Hijau dan Hal Ehwal Orang Asli Selangor Hee Loy Sian berkata, beberapa insiden kebakaran belukar di kawasan itu menyebabkan berlakunya kererosotan kualiti udara dan jerebu setempat di ka-

wasan sekitar sejak 18 hingga 29 Julai lalu.

"Oleh itu, Mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Tetap Alam Sekitar sudah membuat ketetapan untuk melaksanakan tindakan-tindakan tambahan antaranya Pejabat Tanah dan Daerah (PTD) Klang akan melaksanakan program pemutihan melalui proses bincian yang telah dijalankan bagi membasi aktiviti pembakaran terbuka, pelupusan sampah haram dan penerokaan haram di tanah-tanah rizab kerajaan (talian rentis dan rizab simpanan jalan dan parit).

"Petani-petani ini akan dibantu untuk menda-

patkan lesen pendudukan sementara (LPS) daripada kerajaan negeri," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia.

"Polis Diraja Malaysia turut diminta membantu melaksanakan tangkapan dan rondaan di kawasan Johan Setia bagi menimbulkan perception of being caught (POBC) dalam kalangan petani supaya tidak melakukan pembakaran terbuka," katanya.

Menurut Hee, mengikut Seksyen 29(A), Akta Kualiti Alam Sekelling 1974, mereka yang disabitkan dengan kesalahan melakukan pembakaran terbuka boleh didenda hingga RM500,000 atau penjara hingga lima tahun atau kedua-duanya sekali.

LZS bantu 10 beradik yatim piatu

Pada awalnya kehilangan bapa, disusuli ibu mereka empat hari kemudian akibat Covid-19

Sepuluh adik-beradik yang tinggal di Program Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) Kota Damansara di sini menjadi yatim piatu dalam sekelip mata apabila ibu bapa mereka meninggal dunia akibat Covid-19.

Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) yang menziarahi keluarga itu memaklumkan, adik-beradik itu pada mulanya kehilangan bapa, kemudian disusuli ibu mereka empat hari kemudian.

"Sedih dapat khabar ini apatah lagi kedua-dua arwah ini meninggalkan anak angkat berusia dua dan tiga tahun yang masih kecil," katanya menerusi kenyataan dimuat naik di Facebook LZS pada Jumaat.

Menurut kenyataan itu, berdasarkan rekod LZS keluarga terbabit merupakan asnaf Zakat Selangor sejak tahun 2015.

"Kami melawat anak-anak ini dan cuba memberikan kata-kata semangat buat mereka sambil menyampaikan sumbangan pek bakul makanan.

"Mereka maklumkan, terdapat tunggakan sewa rumah, insya-ALLAH pihak LZS akan bantu selesaikan," katanya.

Menurut LZS, pihaknya juga telah meluluskan bantuan khairat kematian kedua-dua arwah ibu dan bapa keluarga berkenaan.

"Keluarga ini menerima bantuan khairat kematian keseluruhan berjumlah RM3,000

iaitu RM1,500 untuk ibu dan bapa mereka yang meninggal dunia," katanya.

"Duit mehang tidak boleh gantikan nyawa yang telah pergi,

tapi kami harap dengan bantuan zakat ini, sedikit sebanyak mampu membuatkan anak-anak ini untuk terus hidup biarpun berdepan ujian," katanya.

MAIS bantu rumah ibadah, pusat tafhib

SHAH ALAM - Majlis Agama Islam Selangor (MAIS) menyumbang sebanyak RM537,500 bagi keperluan masjid, surau dan pusat tafhib di seluruh negeri ini yang terjejas akibat pandemik Covid-19 berikutan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) Fasa 3.

Pengerusinya, Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof berkata, daripada jumlah itu, sebanyak RM337,500 diperuntukkan kepada 638 masjid dan surau.

“Jumlah ini merangkumi sebanyak 316 masjid dan 322 surau yang terpilih di negeri ini mengikut senarai Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS),” katanya pada majlis simbolik penyerahan replika cek MAIS di Bangunan Sultan Idris Shah di sini pada Jumaat.

Abdul Aziz memberitahu, setiap masjid terpilih itu menerima bantuan sebanyak RM500.

Sebanyak RM200,000 disumbangkan kepada Persatuhan Institusi Tahfiz Al-Quran Negeri Selangor (PITAS) membabitkan sebanyak 250 maahad tafhib yang terjejas bagi keperluan kos utiliti dan sewaan bangunan di samping penyediaan kemudahan pembelajaran serta kebajikan pelajar tafhib di negeri ini.

Kata beliau, sumbangan berbentuk wang tunai itu diberikan menerusi peruntukan Baitulmal MAIS.

“Pembayaran sumbangan akan dikredit dan akan dilaksanakan secara berperingkat kepada penerima.

“MAIS berharap bantuan yang disalurkan itu dapat meringankan beban terutama bagi keperluan masjid, surau dan pusat tafhib untuk menampung bayaran bil-bil utiliti serta lain-lain keperluan kecil sepanjang pelaksanaan PKP Fasa 3 sejak 25 Mei lalu,” katanya.

Exco Pelancongan, Alam Sekitar, Teknologi Hijau dan Hal Ehwal Orang Asal Selangor, Hee Loy Sian berkata, keputusan tersebut dibuat ketika Mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Tetap Alam Sekitar bagi membincangkan solusi isu dan tindakan agensi bagi menangani masalah pembakaran terbuka di kawasan tersebut.

Menurutnya, terdapat beberapa insiden kebakaran belukar di kawasan Revolusi Hijau, Johan Setia yang menyebabkan kemerosotan kualiti udara dan jerebu setempat di kawasan sekitar dari 18 hingga 29 Julai lalu.

ON WEEKENDS, litter louts gather at a small children's playground in Jalan Mohd Tahir 2B, Taman Angkasa off Jalan Sungai Jati in Klang, for drinking sessions.

The field is left in a mess thereafter, with beer bottles strewn all over the field.

The drinking session is said to start at 8pm and last until 3am.

Other than beer bottles, which can number up to 50 on average, the men also leave heaps of burnt rubbish in a corner of the park.

KDEB Waste Management employee Hussain Bakhti, 46, who cleans the park twice a month, said workers cleaning the area would find the litter of beer bottles and cans.

"We have to clean it all up and also remove the burnt rubbish, apart from carrying out regular duties such as raking up fallen leaves at the park," he said.

Another worker, Nisarali Khan, 28, said if they found broken bottles, the workers would make the effort to comb the field to remove the glass shards to protect children at the playground from

Residents say outsiders hold drinking sessions there, litter area accidentally getting cut.

A resident of neighbouring Taman Saujana, who wished to be known only as Ah Yap, urged Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Enforcement Department staff to patrol the area at night, especially on weekends, to put a stop to such activities.

He pointed out that Selangor government banned the consumption of alcohol, smoking and vaping at recreational parks and children's playgrounds under the local councils' parks by-law.

"Residents want MPK to take action against the groups that come here to drink alcohol and litter the playground," added the 56-year-old.

SELAYANG Municipal Council (MPS) has taken action against illegal traders and those flouting the law in two separate raids since Aug 9.

Equipment and goods were seized during both operations.

In the first raid, MPS Corporate Communication director Mohamad Zin Masoad said officers confiscated items from two business premises run illegally by foreigners in Taman Perindustrian KIP, Kepong in Kuala Lumpur.

The premises were used for selling groceries, storing unlicensed liquor and cooking.

Among other items seized were 88 boxes of alcoholic drinks of various brands, 11 tables, 35 chairs, two fans and 18 cooking gas cylinders.

"During the operation, the premises was found to be locked," said Mohamad Zin.

"The foreigners had run away and officers had to cut the front grille door to gain entry."

"The premises was also found to have been used to process dry foods.

"This had caused odour and hygiene problems that had become a nuisance to nearby residents," he added.

The operation involved 30 officers from the MPS Enforcement Department and two officers from the Licensing Department.

Action was taken under Section 3 of the Trade, Business and Industry Licensing By-law (MPS) 2007.

"A police report was also lodged for further action by the authorities against the foreigners' activities," he said.

In an earlier operation on Aug 9, MPS confiscated items from 16 hawkers at the Bandar Tasik Puteri Food Court in Rawang, Selangor, for causing obstruction.

Mohamad Zin said the hawkers were issued notices on Aug 6 to remove the items but none had heeded the warning.

"The hawkers had not managed their rubbish properly either."

"Six MPS enforcement officers and 30 personnel from the council's various departments were involved in the operation at the food court," he said, elaborating that action was taken under Section 46(1) of the Street, Drainage and Building Act 1974.

"I hope this move will serve as a reminder to all hawkers to abide by the rules and conditions set in their permits, especially regarding activities in public areas."

"We will not hesitate to take stern action against wrongdoers," he added.

Separately, in conjunction with the 64th National Day celebration on Aug 31, MPS wants building owners and property managers to raise the Jalur Gemilang at their premises until Sept 16.

"We hope government and private buildings, business premises,

staff quarters, schools and places of worship will be spruced up and decorated with flags and lights at night, throughout the period," said Mohamad Zin.

Selangor's National Day celebrations and raise-the-flag campaign kicked off on Aug 1 and would end on Sept 16.

Mohamad Zin also urged Malaysians to stand together in the fight against the Covid-19 pandemic and reminded ratepayers to follow the standard operating procedures under Phase One of the National Recovery Plan.

Fulfilling good deeds

BETWEEN 2017 and 2018, StarMetro embarked on a "Do Good, Grant A Wish" campaign to collect donations from readers and the public to help charities.

The campaign, which called on the public to donate much-needed items stated in the festive wish list of the selected homes, was a success, raising RM100,000 worth of donations and corporate support.

In view of the challenges faced by many charitable organisations amid the Covid-19 pandemic, StarMetro has decided to check on how they are faring currently.

To start off, the team revisited the three old folks homes that participated in the campaign in conjunction with Chinese New Year.

They are Canaan Caring Home in Shah Alam, Rumah Orang Tua Seri Kembangan and Rumah Caring in Sungai Petani, all of which are located in Selangor.

With two of them still there, one is in a quiet town and a land title issue.

Rumah Orang Tua Seri Kembangan

During the campaign, this home received a vacuum cleaner, electric kettle and a bread toaster, which were among items listed in its wish list.

Perbadanan Pengurusan Rumah Orang Tua Seri Kembangan committee secre-

tary Yeo Koh Sang said it also received a new fridge to replace an old one that was leaking, as well as five ceiling fans following the campaign.

Last year, the home also received a cash donation of RM10,000 from a generous donor, said Koh Sang.

The home stopped admitting new residents due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Together with four employees, it is now caring for 13 senior citizens.

It continued to receive a steady stream of donations until the pandemic struck, causing donations to drop by 80%.

However, Koh Sang said the

home was in dire need because a trust fund established by the committee was able to sustain the home's daily expenses.

The home originally dates back to the 1950s when it was established as a place to house former mining workers from nearby Klang.

Rumah Caring

A 14-seater van, flat-screen television and calmlets with doors were given to the home, which had on its wish list and received during the campaign.

During the team's recent visit to the home, the team was told that Rumah Caring had been established aged between 34 and 80.

Having established the centre in 2004, committee member Wendy Yap revealed that she had one more wish to fulfil.

She said although the kind landowner helped to build the home and allowed the committee to stay for free, the home could not renew its lease after the leasehold of the Department after it expired five years ago.

This is because Kajang Municipal Council (MPK) did not issue an operating permit.

From the official documents shown by Wendy, it was clear that the home was built under the Act 33 of the Street, Draining and Building Act 1972 and was constructed without planning permission from MPK.

A RM25,000 fine was issued in 2018 by MPK, which also informed that the home was illegal.

Wendy said the council was notified that they had the consent of other residents in the neighbourhood to build the home.

Another donor also wrote all the names of the landowners in the neighbourhood, the Fire and Rescue Services Department, Health Ministry and the police.

The home in Kajang is located on a plot of land that is still under the main title.

Though it has been divided into 22 stalls, the committee has yet to complete the plots.

A piece of land in Kajang

Sungai Petikan in Petaling Jaya was initially built in the 1960s but residents in that neighbourhood objected to this.

According to the National Welfare Department, not only will our welfare system be affected, but the title deed problem is not resolved.

Wendy said the home continues to receive help and funding from well-wishers, she fears they will not be able to sustain the home if the title deed problem is not resolved.

Local NGOs and community groups related partially on public donations.

Canaan Caring Home

In January 2018, this old folks home in Kajang, which sits on a corner lot, cared for 11 senior citizens.

From the official documents shown by Wendy, it was clear that the home was built under the Act 33 of the Street, Draining and Building Act 1972 and was constructed without planning permission from MPK.

A RM25,000 fine was issued in 2018 by MPK, which also informed that the home was illegal.

The home in Kajang is located on a plot of land that is still under the main title.

"One resident is staying here for free because he has no children or siblings," he said, adding that over 100 families in the original residents had passed away.

Ng said that despite the Covid-19 pandemic, the committee has continued to receive groceries and aid from well-wishers, churches and private establishments.

When we moved, I took all 11 residents with me in the van."

He said the van was his only mode of transport and he had to pay for fuel.

There was no moving cost as he was given the van by a friend.

Ng said that the van was purchased with the help of five volunteers.

"We are now caring for eight senior citizens who have next of kin to pay between RM700 and RM1,500 monthly for the residents,

churches and private establishments.

Bandar Sunway reaping benefits of well-thought-out master plan

Once a tin-mining wasteland, Bandar Sunway began its transformation in the mid-1980s. The first development at the 800-acre township by master developer Sunway Bhd was Sunway Lagoon Theme Park, which it began constructing in 1986. It is one of the earliest theme parks in the country. More buildings were subsequently built in Bandar Sunway, which falls under the ambit of Majlis Bandaraya Subang Jaya. They include the Egyptian-inspired Sunway Pyramid shopping centre with its eye-catching lion sculpture standing guard at the entrance, Sunway Medical Centre, Sunway Hotel & Resorts as well as Sunway University. All have since become landmarks in the township.

There are also other developers in Bandar Sunway, including Nadayu Properties Bhd and Cicet Asia Development Sdn Bhd.

Well-planned township

Today, Bandar Sunway is a self-sustaining mixed-use township with residential, commercial and industrial components. It has shopping malls, hotels, a medical centre, universities, offices, factories and a theme park.

The township is connected via public transport, namely Sunway Monorail and the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Sunway Line. It is also accessible via highways such as the New Pantai Expressway, Lebuhraya Damansara-Puchong and Lebuhraya Shah Alam.

"Bandar Sunway is one of the earliest and better [master-planned townships] in the country, where the developer brings in and runs its own businesses. Some of the properties have been injected into its REIT (real estate investment trust). This move plays a major role in making the township work, with its intention of creating value for the township in the long term," Reapfield Properties group chief operating officer Jonathan Lee says.

"[When Bandar Sunway was first developed], the clear intention was to create economic activity first to draw consumers to the place, and it did well with the theme park and the shopping mall. The remaining components, such as the office buildings, hospital and university, were then integrated together. These had been planned from the beginning, and are being executed stage by stage."

Residential rental

Laurelcap Sdn Bhd executive director Stanley Toh noted that the rental market in Bandar Sunway has always been strong. The high-rise residential market is especially stable as it is mainly driven by students from universities in the area.

"Bandar Sunway is known for Sunway University and Monash University Malaysia, thus the tenant profile is mainly students. There is also a huge young adult working-class population. They are attracted to the area because of the good infrastructure, facilities and amenities. The idea of walking down from your apartment or condo and taking the monorail or BRT to Sunway Pyramid appeals to the adult working class and students, while the highways provide easy access to many parts of the Klang Valley," he says.

"There is also another segment of tenants for the residential properties, which are from the B40 (bottom 40% of income earners) and foreign workers, in Sunway Mentari and Ridzuan Condominium. They are similarly attracted to the township's convenience and good transport network. These were the two main areas in Bandar Sunway with the best-yielding properties before Covid-19. The properties were [seldom] left vacant for too long as demand exceeded supply."

Lee concurs, adding that Bandar Sunway also attracted expatriates before the pandemic.

"There is also the expatriate market, especially in the South Quay area. The market is not huge, but it is significant enough. There are the international school

teachers, university lecturers as well as professionals from the medical centre. Sunway Group also has collaborations with foreign companies, which also bring in foreigners. It is a strategic place where kids can go to the international school there and the parents can work nearby. Everything is within walking distance and they like the environment," he says.

"Landed properties there are older and they are mostly for own use, while the rental market is mostly at the high-rise developments. Sunway Group did a good job on the supply-demand ratio, such that all units have been taken up as the gap between supply and demand is not big. They put a lot of thought in the planning. Properties at Bandar Sunway will have a better premium in terms of rental because of the integration and because the different components are well spread out."

Commercial and industrial rental
 Meanwhile, Toh has observed a change in the tenant profile in the industrial properties over the years. In the early days, the terraced factories adjacent to the university were mainly occupied by trading

companies that acted like warehouses, storing stock and supplies. He sees a major revamp there in terms of tenant profile, demand and supply.

"They have moved towards higher-yielding [uses] with high-performance auto workshops, showrooms, sports modification centres and premium auto accessory shops. There are also cafes and bakeries there," he explains.

The shopoffices next to Sunway Pyramid are more than 90% occupied, commanding premium rental rates due to the spillover effects from both [developments]. The vast majority of the tenants at the ground floor of the shopoffices are F&B outlets."

Future demand
 The entertainment, hospitality and leisure businesses have been badly affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. Many businesses have failed and shopoffice owners too have taken a hit when the businesses vacated their units.

Property consultants expect some changes in the rental market in the township post pandemic, due to new laws and evolving tenant demand.

Toh foresees a paradigm shift in future demand for the rental market there, following the Workers' Minimum Standards of Housing and Amenities (Amendment) Act 2019. To comply with the regulation, owners of nearby factories will need to seek adequate accommodation for their workers.

"Gone are the days where you could stuff 20 people in a small apartment. Now, with the Act, a minimum standard has to be observed. This latest regulation will have a positive impact on the surrounding residential property market as the increase in demand for accommodation fit for human habitation outstrips supply. The rental value of these properties will see a potential increase in the years to come," he says.

Lee, meanwhile, expects the rental market in Bandar Sunway to go through a period of correction. "There will be a time when we will have to neutralise the supply and demand to reach equilibrium. Residential units won't be impacted much as they fulfil a basic need, so it is about the pricing. Also, work-from-home is the new norm now, so the demand for space in residential properties will be different.

"The main issue will be the commercial properties — how they are going to reinvent themselves due to the work-from-home norm, especially for retail units near the office blocks."

"Covid-19 resets everything so we cannot predict future property value like we used to do. I believe that properties at Bandar Sunway will bounce back from the impact of the pandemic faster because of its location and amenities. Also, the developer is still there [to support it]."

PJD Link eyes submission of plan for mega PJ highway in 2Q2022

Private construction firm PJD Link (M) Sdn Bhd, which is proposing to revive a multi-billion-ringgit highway project across Petaling Jaya, Selangor, has yet to get the go-ahead from the Selangor state authorities for the proposed highway.

"Submission of official documents and applications to the Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) and Selangor state authorities are essential for regulatory approval and scheduled to be completed by the second quarter of 2022," its executive director Amrish Hari Narayanan said in a letter to Selve Sugumaran Perumal, the chairman of Section 14 Residents Association, dated Aug 7, 2021. A copy of the letter was obtained by *The Edge*.

Amrish was responding to talk that PJD Link (M) had received approval from MBPJ and the Selangor state government on the quiet and without due process. In January, Selangor Menteri Besar Amirudin Shari reportedly said it was "unfair" for critics of the proposed Petaling Jaya Dispersal Link (PJD Link) highway to equate the project with the previously scrapped Kinrara-Damansara Expressway (Kidex), a comment that PJD Link opponents see as a move in support of the proposed highway.

Calling the allegations "baseless" and "entirely false", Amrish said in the letter: "Not only do we need to

adhere to stringent regulatory approvals from MBPJ, the Selangor state and federal governments, but our banks will scrutinise every detail to ensure there is full compliance in every aspect."

Still, plans for the proposed highway have taken a major step forward. Amrish told *The Star Metro* on July 31 that the company had received approval from the Malaysian Highway Authority (MHA) and the Highway Planning Unit under the Works Ministry to proceed with the next stage of planning on its alignment.

In the letter, Amrish said PJD Link (M) is proposing toll alignment of the proposed highway to run along Jalan Penchala and Jalan Sultan (PJ Sentral), crossing the Federal Highway towards Jalan Professor Khoo Kay Kim (previously known as Jalan Semangat) and Jalan Harapan, and then turning west along the Sprint Highway towards the New Klang Valley Expressway Damansara toll plaza. Meanwhile, an earlier proposal to follow part of Sungai Penchala's alignment is no longer a favourable option.

"We now have a firm proposed alignment after having substantive discussions with MHA and other government departments. This represents a small milestone for us," he added.

Amrish said the alignment map and proposed exit/entry ramp locations would be released to the pub-

lic, but he did not disclose the date.

He conceded, however, that the Covid-19 pandemic had delayed its plans, including preparation of the traffic, social and environmental impact assessments, as well as engaging the public via townhall meetings.

'Private-sector initiative with no government subsidies'

When contacted by *The Edge*, Amrish says he is still unable to determine the cost of the project until the alignment is finalised. The cost of the previous controversial Kidex project, which was scrapped six years ago by then Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohammed Azmin Ali, was said to be RM2.4 billion.

PJD Link (M)'s proposal is to build a 34.3km four-lane elevated expressway with eight interchanges over three years. There will also be two toll plazas on the proposed highway — one at Jalan Harapan and another at Kinrara.

"This is an infrastructure project without any subsidies from the state or federal government, including the land acquisition cost. We are forking out every sen of our own plus borrowings from private banks," said Amrish in the letter. PJD Link is 70% controlled by businessman Tan Sri Hari Narayanan Govindasamy and his family via private vehicle Noblemax Resources Sdn Bhd. The remaining 30% is held by PJD Link Holdings Sdn Bhd, which is majority-owned

by Mansor Salleh @ Md Salleh.

PJD Link (M), as the project concessionaire, will be collecting tolls over a period of time to recoup its investment.

The proposed highway comes at a time when some existing highway concessionaires are not generating enough money to pay back bondholders. On Aug 2, local rating agency Malaysian Rating Corp Bhd had warned that toll-road concessionaire MEX II Sdn Bhd's RM1.3 billion sukuk and RM150 million junior bonds remained at risk for imminent default. "MEX II faces a looming repayment of RM68.7 million on Aug 27, followed by a further RM38.2 million on Oct 29. [However,] it had reported cash of just RM7.8 million in its finance service reserve account at end-May," it said.

In the letter, Amrish stated that PJD Link would help ease traffic flow in Section 13 and PJ Sentral, which are fast developing into a new city centre.

"PJD Link will remove many cars from the existing roads at ground/street level by putting them on the elevated highway, thus traffic will become more manageable at the street level.

"For residents living or working around Jalan Templer (Seksyen 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6), the new highway built along Jalan Penchala will divert peak-hour traffic away from the severely congested Jalan Templer.

For vehicles heading southbound to Puchong and Taman Medan, you no longer need to squeeze through the narrow Jalan Templer to gain access to the New Pantai Expressway," he said.

Maria Chin Abdullah, Member of Parliament for Petaling Jaya, says until the traffic, social and environmental impact assessments are completed, the proposed highway is still a no-go. "It has to go through a series of consultations from federal to state to council levels plus feedback from the residents," she tells *The Edge*.

"As far as I am concerned, we don't need elevated highways in PJ. We need a good public transport system that can take the elderly, the schoolchildren, the shoppers, the workers to the social and economic amenities such as hospitals, market schools and libraries.

"I won't deny that we need to resolve the traffic congestion, but there are other ways, for example, a thorough review of our public transport system to increase buses and walkways to connect buildings like those at Ampang Park. There is a serious need to reduce our carbon footprints and not create more to pollute the environment. Besides, when Pakatan Harapan came in as the government (from 2018 to February 2020), we did say we wanted to move towards reduction, if not to get rid, of tolls. Our promise to the people must be upheld." ■

(吉隆坡12日讯)雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁预测随著接种新冠肺炎疫苗加速，更多人完成2剂接种后，于8月尾，确诊后进入第三、第四或第五级病情，甚至于进入加护房的人数将会减少。

他说，截至目前，雪州已完成接种了576万1304剂新冠肺炎疫苗，完成两剂疫苗已达

44.14%。加上部分已在吉隆坡完成接种两剂疫苗的人数，相信已近50%已完成接种两剂疫苗。

他今日下午召开视讯记者会，公布雪州政府在接种疫苗的进展，以及各项推动的计划时，如是指出。

他说，有部分雪州人民是在吉隆坡区接种疫苗，分别是来自八打灵县、巴生县、鹅唛县等。

他说，在576万1304剂疫苗中，迄今共有366万5093人已接种首剂疫苗，大约是77.1%，209万6211人已接种两剂疫苗，即是

44.14%。他说，随著接种疫苗加速进行，及更多人已完成两剂疫苗的接种，相信到8月尾，确诊后进入第三、第四或第五级病情，甚至于进入加护房的人数将会减少。

44.14%接種兩劑疫苗

“通过Se1VAX接种疫苗计划，已接种了27万696剂疫苗，在此数字中，7万138人已完成两剂疫苗。”

大臣说，在Se1VAX工业接种疫苗计划中，已接种疫苗的共有12万8529人，其中接种首剂的是有7万3000多人，已完成接种两剂疫苗的则是有5万4000人。

他说，至于社区接种疫苗活动原定是在8月11日完成，如今可能延迟多两三天。

他指出，尚未接种疫苗的雪州人民，如今可在没有预约下，前往接种疫苗中心接种，已完成接种疫苗的雪州人民，对于防疫工作也不能掉以轻心，尤其是针对危险性高的Delta病毒。

9月派檢測試劑盒

雪州政府将在9月，通过56个州议会议服务中心或选区协调官，派发总数6万个免费居家检测试剂盒(free saliva test kits)给确诊者和高风险的家庭。

雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁说，雪州人民在接受筛检及鉴定确诊后，会获得免费的居家检测试剂盒。

他说，州政府在这之前总共拨出150万令吉，每位新冠肺炎死者家属将获得一次性的1000令吉援助。

他指出，在上述计划中，登记活动是到8月31日，截至目前已

有1500人已登记。他说，雪州政府如今将增加多100万令吉特别拨款，登记活动将展延到12月31日，计划中总共有1000个新冠肺炎死者的家属将会领取1000令吉援助金。

另外，雪州大臣说，在今年首季，沙白安南一带的稻农也面对虫害问题，以致在稻田收成蒙受严重的损失。

他说，雪州政府将拨出279万5085令吉予1万868位稻农，从稻谷、农药等，确保在疫情期间，稻米供应保持稳定。

做好準備應對第3劑疫苗

阿米鲁丁说，以雪州接下来的接种新冠肺炎疫苗率，以及之后将陆续运抵的疫苗，雪州将有足够的疫苗供人民接种第3剂疫苗，不过仍需视中央政府及卫生部，是否批准人民接种第3剂疫苗。

他说，欧美一些国家已为国民准备4剂疫苗，大马如今只是为国民准备两剂疫苗的接种。

他说，雪州如今已加速接种疫苗，如果有接种第3剂疫苗的需要，雪州是已做好准备应对。

在提及第三剂疫苗时，他也提及“售卖”字眼，不排除可能采取售卖方式执行。

“如果完成接种疫苗者已达80%，就可以着手准备接种三剂疫苗，但至于接种第三剂疫苗是否可行，最终也是要看中央政府及卫生部的决定。”

阿米鲁丁说，雪州政府接下来是为17岁、18

有需要將援助冠病死者後事

阿米鲁丁说，尽管雪州政府之前没有插手新冠肺炎死者后事被徵收过高费用的问题，但随著接获投诉后，州政府会提供援助给有需要，尤其是面对经济问题的家属。

他说，州政府之前接获一些穆斯林和非穆斯林家属的投诉，指冠病死者遗体，在安葬过程中被徵收太高费用。

阿米鲁丁指出，双溪毛糯医院、巴生医院、安邦医院、沙登医院、士拉央医院转为专治新冠肺炎病患医院后，已有足够能力应对新冠肺炎病人，而普通病症病已被转到私人院

他说，在穆斯林方面，将会过雪州宗教局等提供援助予面对经济能力的家属。

他指出，穆斯林死者的遗体通常都在24小时内处理，非穆斯林死者遗体大约是2至3天，其中涉及处理费用一事的延误。

他已与行政议员甘纳查迪劳、州秘书等讨论，供领援助给非穆斯林家属，尤其是一些

没有能力及有经济问题的家属，州政府提供安葬费用等的援助，减轻家属的负担。

“如果安葬费是需要2000令吉，雪州政府将提供1000令吉的援助，希望能减轻家属的负担。”

对于火化场，他说，如今雪邦、巴生、八打灵等的火化场运作的也比以前好，也加速处理遗体火化问题，避免医院堆积太多有待处理的遗体。

有能力應對冠病病人

他说，中央政府及卫生部在兴建医院，以及在政府医院增加医疗设备如病床、氧气等，让新冠肺炎病人可更快获得处理。

阿米鲁丁说，雪州政府接下来也将针对9月学校复课一事召开会议，并且也将会呈交建议给教育部。

珍惜前線奉獻，防疫不能鬆懈

最近一周內接二連三传来噩耗，雪州烏魯冷吉的新冠肺炎評估中心（CAC）主任阿華占莫哈末，8月8日因感染新冠肺炎的病情惡化而不治離世。阿華占生前隸屬烏魯冷吉衛生局，一直在前线积极工作，协助许多患者解决难题，对于他的离世，我深感惋惜。

我熟悉的希望青年团团长兼诚信党青年团团长长沙兹尼，于8月6日因冠病逝世，得年34岁；公正党柔州前任青年团团长纳兹里依纳斯迈于8月11日上午染疫病逝，得年47岁。这两位政治战友英年早逝，更让我痛心和感慨不已。

近期来疫情反覆，死亡病例高居不下，许多家庭不幸失去了至亲，年幼的孩子失去了父母，无数令人悲痛的案例一再提醒我和团队，必须加紧努力截断病毒感染链及全力加速推行接种疫苗计划。

我们更要牢记的是，如果没有医护战士、前线人员、政治工作者和义工们的努力和牺牲，政府无法展开漫长而艰辛的抗疫战争，也无法深入州内乡区与偏远角落为民众提供援助和进行接种等工作。

据卫生部的数据表示，第三波疫情期间，全国有超过1300名医疗前线人员感染冠病，来自雪兰莪州的病例最多，不幸中之大幸的是，由于医护人员已在全国疫苗接种计划第一阶段优先安排接种，大部分确诊者只是出现轻微症状。

鼓舞醫護員

雪州的医疗系统已有一段长时间处于紧绷状态，多间医院都出现爆满的情况，也让站在最前线的医护人员们身心疲累。雪州卫生局日前特地制作一个短片，向州内的3万名医护人员致敬和鼓舞大家的士气。我和掌管卫生事务的雪州行政议员西蒂玛丽雅受邀参与短片拍摄，为医护人员加油打气。

在这个名为《我们不会输的》（KitaTakkanMengalah）的短片中，来自各家医院或诊所、卫生局各部门、疫苗行动队伍、冠病评估中心等职员们，身穿防护装备并透过口罩坚定喊话：“我们不会输的！”，声声打动人心。

我衷心感谢每一位前线英雄的付出和贡献，他们在面对疫情的这段期间所表现出毅力和坚持，将点滴写入我国历史最重要篇章里。我也希望民众们一同为前线人员打气，并祈祷他们能每天平安健康地回到家人身边。

不過早放寬

随著冠病变种毒株的出现，尤其是传染力更高的Delta毒株入侵我国，我们更要慎防缺口，因此，雪州政府不认同中央政府过早实施“进场机制”和放宽管制，以免政府与人民在过去防疫努力功亏一篑。

首相慕尤丁日前宣布完成接种新冠疫苗（接种第二剂疫苗14天后）的民众，可享有隔离、行动和社交上的管制放宽，包括允许完成接种者堂食。不过，雪州政府将按部就班，胥视疫情和医疗体系压力获得舒解之后，才会建议中央政府让雪州进入国家复苏计划的下一阶段。

在这之前，我不鼓励雪州民众在现阶段跨县探亲、互访或旅游，也不允许食肆开放堂食，所有地方政府的执法单位受促持续监督，确保各造遵守相关条例。

大臣：感谢每一位前线英雄的付出和贡献。

我也要特别提醒家长或儿童监护人，不得带儿童前往人多的公众场合或室内场所，以免受到法律对付，况且18岁以下的孩童仍未接种疫苗，他们对新冠肺炎病毒毫无防护能力。

全民须继续努力迈向群体免疫的目标，珍惜前线人员“用生命守护生命”的奉献与牺牲，不能轻易松懈下来。

失業斷糧陷困境
外勞求助要物資

(吉隆坡12日讯)新冠肺炎疫情期间，各行各业都有业者因撑不住倒闭或暂停营业，导致许多本地人和外劳失业，不少外劳更陷入断粮的困境。

在新冠肺炎疫情期间，尤其是雪州在行动管制令下，有不少商店及工厂等无法面对漫长、不知何时可复业的情况，宣告倒闭和结束营业，除了本地人，有不少外劳也加入失业大军，没有收入，有部分已断粮。

根据各区州议员反映，在派发物资时，遇到外劳求助，大部分表明已失去工作数个月、没有收入、断粮、家里有孩子等。

不敢向使馆求援

他们说，求助的外劳是印尼、缅甸和孟加拉籍居多，也有非政府组织、本地居协和居民等会伸出援助协助陷入困境的外劳。“这些外劳主要是居住在组屋区、中价公寓或商店楼上，有部分是他们自己租货，有部分是雇主租下单位，与同乡同事住在一起。”

他们说，由于有部分外劳是非法逗留或准备逾期等，即使陷入困境，也不敢外出或向其大使馆求助。“有不少外劳是直接在当地食物银行领取物资，只要有需求，他们都会去领取。”

获许多要求物资援助的求助讯息，除了本地人，也有不少外劳。

有外劳会要求物资援助，一些外劳在见到我们在派发蔬菜时，竟哭泣说已很久没有吃过蔬菜、已断粮之类似。寻求帮助的外劳，包括印尼、孟加拉和缅甸等，有不少在外期间已失去工作，也没有收入等。

据了解，印尼大使馆之前也曾派发过物资给予国民，但相信可能有需要的人也太多，也可能让大使馆也无法一一照顾。

曾接获来自万宜国会选区一間制衣厂的外劳求助物资，人数大约有50多位，他们表明已没有工作，之后把有关个案移交给万宜国会议员的团队。

在派发物资时，遇过外劳寻求协助，申诉已有多少个月没有工作，家里有好几个孩子要养，已断粮等。

我们也曾遇过雇主要求协助其外劳，相信大部分雇主在疫情期间还是有照顾其外劳，可能部分外劳会面雇主置之不理的情况。

这些外劳都是居住在组屋区，但也有本地人提供消息，要求协助当地外劳，也有一些居协也为当地一些已陷入困境的外劳提供援助等。

除了向国州议员、非政府组织等寻求援助，有部分是到当地食物银行处寻求物资。

（蒲种13日讯）自行动管制令实施以来，商家及市民发挥“有能力者帮助有需要者”的精神，通过金銮服务中心派发粮食和物资给区内超过5000户人家。

这段期间，金銮服务中心平均每周“上门”派发粮食两三次，截至目前为止，共派出5000份食物篮、10吨的新鲜蔬菜和5吨鱼类。

此外，了解到一些家庭有好几个孩子，所以该服务中心也派发奶粉和尿布给200户家庭。

黃思漢：受惠家庭以B40为主

金銮州议员黄思汉指出，受惠的家庭除了以B40为主，也有不少M40群体，他们也是因为生活而逼于无奈接受援助。

“这段时间，不少B40群体上门服务中心领取物资，我们会提供米、面食、鸡蛋等。但也有一些驾驶名车、住洋房的居民前来要求援助，我们也一视同仁。希望提供粮食，至少能解决他们的温饱问题。”

他坦言，过去两三个月，不少家庭因行管令无法开工，以致收入减少甚至失业，陷入了经济困境。

“金銮州选区是全马选民最多的州选区，但当我们接到的求助申请，有很多是来自蒲种其他地区。”

逾70商民贊助物資

黃思汉指出，去年因为冠病疫情肆虐，其服务中心推行“关爱金銮”计划，以协助选区内贫困家庭；如今虽然疫情没有好转，但庆幸有关计划在获得善心人士或商家捐助物资下，能继续帮助有需要的人解燃眉之急。

他说，截至目前，有超过70名商家或个人出钱出力捐助物资，金銮服务中心庆幸得到他们的信任，以透过其义工团队分配给有贫困、单亲家庭或病患家庭等。

他说，其服务中心也无法严格去审核受惠者的需要和背景，抱着“一个不能少”的精神，希望尽可能帮助到有需要的人。

盼人人吃得饱

黄思汉也说，其选区目前设有金銮厨房1.0，于周日免费派发午餐；而金銮厨房2.0则于周五派发晚餐，惟自行管制令3.0起，前来领取午餐的人数逐步增加，目前每周平均可以免费派发500份。

他说，金銮厨房秉持没有人接锁的精神经营，所以没有限制领餐的数量，有时额外提供由赞助商赞助的面包或水果等，希望人人都吃得饱，也吃得健康。

“令人感动的是，有些个人或单位以‘无名氏’的身份捐赠，只想略尽绵力为社会献力。”

他指出，收到的食物和物资种类很多，除了基本的柴米油盐、口罩和洗手液，也有成人尿布、药物，以及新鲜的蔬菜和肉类等，都能实际帮助受惠者解决日常所需。

“义工团队也非常给力，平均每个星期出动

雪政府派6萬檢測試劑盒

黄思汉指出，联邦政府防疫政策未臻完善，以致确诊病例节节上升，昨日再创新高，达2万1668宗，雪州政府对此采取积极行动，包括免费派发6万个居家唾液检测试剂盒（SalivaTest Kits）给确诊者或高风险群。

“目前确诊者多以无症状为主，因此居家检测非常必要且方便使用，其准确度相当高，一旦检测呈阳性，可以马上采取隔离措施。”

他指出，在过去数个月里，雪州政府与卫生部携手加速疫苗接种，透过“全国冠病疫苗接种计划”（PICK），共接种了576万1304剂疫苗，其中有366万5093人已接种首剂，209万6211人完成两剂疫苗接种。

他说，雪州有信心在短期内能达到80%群体免疫之际，也着手为18岁以下的人士进行疫苗接种。同时已有计划为雪州人民进行第三剂疫苗接种。

他指出，疫苗是目前对抗疫情最好方法，还未得到任何预约者受促上门到特定疫苗中心进行疫苗接种。

(沙登13日讯)雪州的SELangkah应用程式与MySejahtera系统疫苗接种记录不协调问题仍存在。通过SELangkah登记并完成两剂疫苗接种者，时隔三周在MySejahtera上仍不见相关资料和疫苗接种电子证书，令人感到担忧。

黄俊昱：接超过20投诉

马华蒲种区会史里肯邦安投诉局主任黄俊昱和新嘉坡局主任孙文辉今日召开线上新闻发布会指出，他们目前接到超过20宗类似的投诉，即已通过SELangkah完成两剂疫苗接种者，不获得MySJ发出的疫苗接种电子证书。

黄俊昱表示，在众多投诉案中，有一对林姓姐弟致电向他叙述亲身经历，姐弟俩在接种第二剂疫苗后（7月25日），至今已经超过了3个星期了，但仍未获得MySJ的电子证书，引起他俩的忧愁。

他说，姐弟俩多次尝试询问雪州行政议员黄思汉办公室以解决问题，但被要求向SELangkah有关负责部门提出，而SELangkah负责人则让他们联系MySJ。

“最终事情没完没了，便到这对姐弟非常不满、烦燥和不安。他们质问SELangkah和MySJ为什么系统不能结合，资料不统一。”

姐弟為健康寧自費750接種

黄俊昱表示，当时这对姐弟为了自身健康安全着想，为了争取时间加快接种疫苗的速度，因此额外共750令吉的接种费用完成疫苗接种，尽管他们很清楚在国家疫苗计划中疫苗接种是免费的。

他补充，当时SELangkah负责人告知姐弟俩，通过SELangkah完成接种后，MySJ系统会在一周内更新资料，所以他们也就放心付费了，然而结果却让他们感觉失望，两个系统依旧不统一，且资料没有被更新。

SELangkah接种后 频获MySJ预约

他说，姐弟俩同样在通过SELangkah完成了第一剂的冠病疫苗接种后，收到MySJ传来的预约。

完成接種 未見MySJ疫苗證書

黄俊昱披露，姐弟俩这期间持续收到MySJ的预约通知，无奈迟迟不获电子证书，并有想过若情况持续下去，将会根据MySJ的预约时间赴约完成所谓第3和第4剂的疫苗，但他已经劝阻林姓姐弟不要冲动。

“如果这事成为事实，有可能第3和第4剂是不同技术制作的疫苗，会带来很多问题，是否会危害身体健康，都是未知数。”

没疫苗证书恐影响工作

他理解，由于他们居住在雪州，工作地点在吉隆坡，跨州跨县都需要该证书，其中在隆市某大型广场工作的姐姐更担心，若开放之时广场管理层只承认MySejahtera电子证书的情况下，会面对暂时失业的问题，而加重经济负担，所

通过雪州疫苗接种计划完成疫苗接种者，将获得纸质疫苗卡证明，惟因为种种的问题，让人质疑其可信度，担心不受承认。

孙文辉：雪疫苗計劃連串問題

孙文辉则表示，雪州疫苗接种计划下产生的一连串问题，已经带给人民相当多的不便。

他说，除了SELangkah发出的电子证书外，雪州政府更是发出纸质疫苗卡证明，惟近日有新闻报道指出有一些疫苗卡出现伪造的问题，这不免会让人质疑SELangkah系统和纸质卡的可信度，造成恐慌。

他认为雪州政府其实可以避免这些问题的发生，不必画蛇添足，使用统一的系统，而无需自行推出自家的应用程序。

接种者可要求同步更新新资料

马华蒲种区会认为接种者有绝对的权力要求有关单位在疫苗接种前后，即同步和更新MySJ的资料。

“政府决定解除某些层面的限制之后，MySJ电子证书将会是全国各地通用的唯一证件，无论办理任何事物。”

孙文辉举例，日不论是信徒前往宗教场所、公众在前往店铺购买日常用品或堂食时，都必须出示有关场所的认可的证件（MySJ电子证书）。

他也补充，新加坡政府于本月11日在当地报纸明确指出不会认可任何纸质证书，且目前我国卫生部也曾指出只承认MySJ的电子证书。

他说，雪州政府没有必要制造这么多种类的系统和证件，搅乱国家的疫苗接种登记系统，尤其在疫情肆虐期间，人民已经面对各种经济、生活、健康安全保障等问题，已经很是烦恼。

譴責雪為何不統一使用MySJ

黄俊昱谴责雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁没有严正看待此事，两个系统早已出现不协调的问题，为何不统一使用MySJ来处理疫苗接种的相关事务。

他希望阿米鲁丁立即向人民交代，并解释是否已经和其他州政府协调，承认和接受SELangkah电子报告和疫苗卡为跨州的合法证件。

孙文辉也要求雪州政府全额退还接种费用给已付费的接种者，包括个人和企业，以兑现希盟政府对人民的承诺。

“我们要提醒雪州希盟政府，记得他们对人民所许下的5大承诺，首要承诺即减轻人民生活负担。”

他说，雪州政府所推动的疫苗接种计划，从这些投诉者当中得知并没有提供良好的服务，况且这项付费的活动还带来了许多问题和矛盾，雪州政府的表现非常不专业，显得没能力，且缺乏沟通。
