Prosedur tuntut sijil nikah masih kuno

SAUDARA PENGARANG,

SAYA dan pasangan bernikah pada Disember tahun lalu. Namun, sehingga kini masih belum menerima sijil atau kad nikah sebagai perakuan yang mengatakan kami adalah pasangan suami isteri yang sah di sisi agama Islam.

Isteri saya menghubungi Datuk Dr. Zulkifli Mohamad Al-Bakri melalui laman sosialnya semasa beliau masih lagi memegang portfolio Menteri di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (Hal Ehwal Agama) dan diberitahu Jabatan Agama Islam Hulu Langat di bawah kuasa naungan raja-raja bagi negeri-negeri. Bagi Jabatan Agama Islam Hulu Langat pula dibawahan Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS).

Apabila saya lihat, proses atau prosedur yang memerlukan suami dan isteri ke pejabat agama adalah sesuatu yang tidak masuk akal sedangkan seseorang yang berkahwin sudah pastinya akan tinggal bersama. Jadi, apa salahnya jika salah seorang sahaja yang ke Jabatan Agama untuk menuntut sijil perkahwinan?

Sudahlah pejabat tersebut tutup awal iaitu pukul 4 petang, agak sukar kami yang tinggal di Shah Alam untuk mengejar masa kerana terikat dengan tuntutan kerja di pejabat.

Dalam keadaan negara yang dilanda pandemik Covid-19, sepatutnya perkara ini diper mudahkan dan bukannya masih mengekalkan cara lama yang kuno. Jika setakat untuk menyemak butiran, saya pasti pasangan juga boleh melakukannya secara dalam talian dan

hanya ke pejabat agama untuk mengambil sijil. Jadi, tidak perlu kedua-duanya hadir bersama.

Saya percaya sebenarnya masih ramai lagi yang tidak menuntut sijil dan kad nikah. Diharap pihak berwajib dapat membantu pasangan-pasangan yang masih lagi tidak mengambil sijil nikah sebelum dan sejak penularan Covid-19 di negara ini dengan memudahkan cara.

Jika masih terus mengekalkan cara yang lama, ia akan menyukarkan pasangan baru berkahwin, lebih-lebih lagi jika mereka tidak tinggal di kawasan yang mereka memohon kebenaran perkahwinan kerana perlu mengikut suami.



KUALA LUMPUR - Sebanyak 63 peratus daripada 41 kawasan yang terlibat gangguan bekalan air tidak berjedual susulan insiden paip pecah berhampiran jejambat Ampang Point, Jalan Ampang di sini sudah menerima bekalan air setakat jam 10 pagi pada Ahad.

Bagaimanapun, Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor) menerusi kenyataan di Facebook memaklumkan, terdapat 15 kawasan yang masih belum menerima bekalan air antaranya Kampung Muhibah Ampang, Kampung Tasik Permai, Kampung Ampang Indah, Kampung Indah Permai dan Kampung Ampang Campuran.

ONE hundred and twelve compounds were issued to owners of vehicles parked illegally along Jalan Pipit 4 in Puchong Jaya, Selangor following complaints received by Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ).

The operation was carried out under the Road Transport Act 1987, MPSJ Road Transport (Parking Allocation) Order 2007 (amendment) 2011 and MPSJ Park By-Laws 2005 and Local Government Act 1976 for traffic obstruction offences committed by vehicle owners.

A statement from MBSJ noted that 82 compounds were issued to motorists for the offence of parking vehicles on a non-parking lot and for obstructing traffic.

Another 30 summonses were issued by the police.

Seven council enforcement officers, along with five officers from Serdang District Police Headquarters, carried out the

operation after receiving complaints of such vehicles along the road.

The operation, which took place from 10am on Sept 22, was led by MBSJ Enforcement Department senior assistant director Tarmidi Kadri and Serdang District Police Headquarters Traffic Investigation and Enforcement Section enforcement inspector Muhammad Norfarid Tan.

MBSJ added that the city council and the police would continue to monitor and prevent traffic obstructions by enforcing the laws as well as ensure that the roads were safe from obstructions that could endanger other road users.

Mixed reactions to tram project in Cyberjaya

Some stakeholders question need for service in area without congestion

A FULLY electric tram will be tested at an undisclosed location in Cyberjaya early next year by the Sepang Municipal Council (MPSepang).

This is part of the local council's initiative to create an efficient public transportation system in line with its goal to achieve smart low-carbon city status by 2025.

The tram will use the automated rapid transit (ART) system that is reported to be a hybrid between the electric bus and trackless tram.

MPSepang president Datuk Abd Hamid Hashim said the tram would navigate a virtual tramway on the road.

"The tram will be identified by road markings. It can be operated manually by a driver, or automatically."

"The tram will have three coaches, with the capacity to ferry 307 passengers at a time and move at a maximum speed of up to 70km per hour."

"There will be a charging station and an ART station to support the operation," he said.

He added that the pilot project was a collaboration between the council and Mobibus Sdn Bhd, which also conducted a pilot pro-

ject of the ART System at Iskandar Malaysia in Johor from April to August this year to demonstrate its capability and use of green technology in the mobility industry.

However, the tram idea for Cyberjaya is not new.

The government has been mulling the idea of introducing a tram-like option for better connectivity and a more efficient transportation system for a couple of years now.

On March 6, 2018, *The Star* reported Land Public Transport Commission (SPAD) chief executive officer Mohd Azharuddin Mat Sab as saying that the agency planned to introduce a tram in Cyberjaya, Petaling, Kajang and Bangi when presenting the 2017 SPAD report.

SPAD has since been dissolved and replaced with APAD)

Mohd Azharuddin had envisioned a 53km tramway network to be linked to the MRT 1 line in Kajang, the upcoming MRT 2 line and the High Speed Rail line.

He said the tram was viewed as a cost efficient and environmentally-friendly option to alleviate congestion in the four areas.

The government had also planned to include trams in the central business district of Kuala Lumpur a few years ago but the

plan was shelved. The proposal is expected to be revisited later.

What people think

Despite the benefits of having a tram network in Cyberjaya, stakeholders have reservations about the project.

Dr Jauhuddin Tengku Mahmud Shah, who is a Sepang councillor and Residents' Representative Committees (JPP) chairman for Cyberjaya, said the project would provide a great boost to the image of the city that is dubbed the "Silicon Valley of Malaysia".

He, however, has reservations about its success in the long term due to poor uptake of public transportation.

"Buses, taxis and trains are currently the modes of public transport in Cyberjaya."

"Buses are the most widely used. "A number of buses under Smart Selangor, the state's free bus service, ply these routes despite the low number of commuters," he said.

Tengku Jamaluddin added that despite running at a loss, especially during movement restrictions when there were very few passengers, the Smart Selangor service has not stopped because it is funded

by the state. "I am not sure if the car-centric culture will change to make the tram project profitable."

"The government may need to make some radical changes to limit the use of private vehicles to force people to shift to public transportation," he added.

If the project is to be viable, he foresees its success in providing good service only if it were to be run by the government.

"Public transportation should be a service to the people and not be motivated by profit."

"There are not many passengers even for the buses, so I am not sure how viable it is to be run by a private company."

"I do not know the details of the pilot project but I hope studies have been conducted to determine a profitable alignment for the tramway before construction because unlike buses, the route for trams is fixed," he pointed out.

James Wendy Kusuma, 22, a resident of Cyberjaya for the past four years, said the government should be more focused on improving bus services before embarking on other expensive projects such as a tram service.

He said he hardly saw buses in Cyberjaya.

"There used to be a transit bus

but I do not see it anymore. "Without proper bus service, it is very inconvenient and expensive to get around."

"There are also many roads ridged with potholes."

"It would be more worthwhile to spend the money allocated for the tram on maintenance and repairs instead," he added.

Another resident, who wanted to remain anonymous, questioned the need for trams in Cyberjaya as there was no traffic congestion there.

"Usually, trams are used in busy cities. In my opinion, Cyberjaya does not need a tram at the moment," he said.

On the other hand, lawyer Shahruhzad Ismail, 44, from Kajang looks forward to having trams operating in Cyberjaya.

Shahruhzad said he enjoyed using the tram service when he was in Melbourne, Australia and wished to see this mode of transport in Malaysia.

"I run my own legal firm in Putrajaya and travel to neighbouring Cyberjaya occasionally."

"The commercial centres are scattered and it is important to have a good public transport system in place for the convenience of the people," he added.

Renew permits and licences online, MBSJ urges businesses

THE Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) is encouraging business operators to renew and pay for their business permits and licences online to reduce physical contact amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

"This can be done through the Ezy MBSJ portal at <https://ezy.mbsj.gov.my/>," said MBSJ Corporate and Strategic Management

Department deputy director Azfarizal Abdul Rashid in a statement.

"The online renewal is only for licences not deemed high-risk (such as healthcare centres or massage parlours.)"

The steps to renew a licence with MBSJ are as follows:

> Visit <https://ezy.mbsj.gov.my>

> Look for the licence category

> Enter the licence/permit account number in the search field and press the search button

> Press select to pay button

> Check the amount to be paid and press the pay button on the cart

> Review and confirm payment details by clicking on the proceed button

> Complete payment through the selected payment medium

> Print and keep the licence certificate (using white paper or any suitable colour)

For renewal and payment of licences and permits under high-risk or temporary categories, Azfarizal said this could be done through the Ezy MBSJ portal only after the application documents were reviewed and updated by the city council's

Licensing Department.

Those facing problems with their applications, renewals or need to submit documentation are required to make an appointment via <https://bit.ly/3kmVuFB> before visiting the department's office at MBSJ's headquarters in USJ 5, Subang Jaya.



Meru residents dread heavy rain

Flash flood problem in eight areas not resolved for more than a decade, they say

HAVING to wade through knee-deep water every time there is heavy rain has become all too common for residents of eight areas in Meru, Klang.

Often, a 30-minute downpour will leave many of the houses in these areas flooded, with the last incident occurring on Sept 17.

The areas are Taman Daya Meru, Taman Daya Maju (Jalan Berus and Jalan Abadi), Taman Bayu, Taman Meru Utama A, Taman Meru Utama Daya B, Taman Meru Utama C and Kampung Meru Jalan Chempaka.

Each time she hears thunder, Shiesyilia Singal, 39, becomes anxious as her terrace house in Jalan Abadi 5, Taman Daya Meru, gets flooded and the water takes an estimated 12 to 14 hours to recede.

"When I moved into this neighbour-

hood in 2007 there were no flash floods, it only started happening in March 2010.

"Our furniture has been damaged a number of times and we gave up on getting new ones."

"The situation becomes worse during the monsoon season," she told *StarMetro*.

Despite building a 0.45m wall at the front of her house, water still enters.

Manja Mansor, 35, from the same neighbourhood, said that residents were fed up as it has been flooding there for years.

He said Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Engineering Department made several site visits in 2012 but nothing materialised.

"We feel MPK is not concerned about our plight. It is a nightmare as we do not have the financial resources to move out of this area," said Manja.

"When I moved into this neighbour-

hood in 2007 there were no flash floods, it only started happening in March 2010.

"Once water overflows from the monsoon drain, it enters residential drains."

"It reaches knee-height and takes at least 12 hours to recede," he said.

Taman Meru Utama A resident Maheswaran Kanniah, 52, said three mechanical pumps were installed 10 months ago at Jalan Sesendul to pump floodwaters out from the neighbourhood into a monsoon drain along the main road of Jalan Teratai.

He said a private firm paid for the pumps under its corporate social responsibility initiative.

"We hope MPK will provide us with a permanent solution as we

cannot put up with this situation any longer," he said.

Kampung Meru Jalan Chempaka resident M. Azhar, who is in his 50s, urged MPK to visit the eight areas plagued by flash floods and resolve the matter for the people's well-being.

"It is time MPK finds a solution and not make us suffer."

"MPK should not be focused on gaining city status especially if issues like this are not resolved," added Azhar.

Taman Daya Meru Residents Association chairperson Mohammad Daud Saidin, 65, said out of the 800

houses in the eight areas, some 300 were hit by flash floods.

"If it rains heavily, especially at night, people have to stay awake until the rain stops," he said, highlighting that it sometimes lasted overnight.

He said the flash flood were due to water backflow at the confluence of two monsoon drains outside Pahang Pharmacy at Jalan Teratai, Pekan Meru.

"Engineers need to find a way to direct the water flow from the monsoon drains until it empties out into Sungai Kapar Kecil, a few kilometres away," he added.

Temporary permits for 17 roadside traders in Selayang

HOUSEKEEPING supervisor Wan Suhaidi Wan Lawang, 47, was forced to quit his job last year and to make ends meet, set up a roadside stall selling apam.

"I was on unpaid leave for several months last year and had to take a 50% pay cut."

"It was becoming difficult for me to manage my finances."

"Although my wife is still working as an auditor, I have three children, a disabled brother and ailing mother to support."

"I started selling apam by the roadside since December last year and am in a better situation now," said Wan Suhaidi who eventually quit his job.

Wan Suhaidi was among the 17 traders issued temporary business permits, valid for three months, by the Selayang Municipal Council (MPS).

"I hope we will be given a business permit for longer because it may take awhile before we can get a job," he said when met.

Amirul Zamri, 27, who also received a temporary licence, hoped the government would support people keen to do business.

"The three-month permit costs RM290 and I think it is a fair amount."

"I welcome this effort to legalise our businesses," said Amirul who sells drinks.

The Selangor government is working with local councils to help small-time food sellers like Wan

Suhaidi and Amirul by providing them with temporary permits.

State local government and public transport committee chairman Ng Sze Han went on a walkabout at Kampung Selayang Indah and Taman Selayang Mutiara to present the temporary permits to traders.

"From August last year until early this month, 1,121 permits were issued by MPS to traders who have been operating without permits," said Ng, adding that 8,300 traders were issued business permits throughout Selangor since August last year.

"Selayang was among the first councils to identify street traders without permits and provided them with temporary business permits.

"We hope that moving forward, the application process for business permits will be shortened."

"The permits are valid for three months and we hope to extend the

duration in the future," said Ng.

The permits are aimed at helping those from the B40 and M40 group who suffered loss of income due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

“使用私家车营办的小贩最难捉。只要执法组抵达，他们可以直接盖掉后尾箱后开车离开。”

士拉央市议员余深恩指出，其实他们并非针对任何小贩，只是他们会特别针对某些民生课题，包括霸占泊车位等。

他指出，使用私家车营办的小贩最难辨别，交易过程也没收，只要执法组取缔就直接关掉后尾箱后开车离开。

他指出，上述服务却引来他人误会，误以为当局向非法小贩收取额外费用。“执法组前来取缔时，若有固本可直接出示。”

涉及餐车霸占泊车位事宜，他则指出，餐车执照不容易申请，且只能在一个指定地点营业。

他指出，根据了解，一辆餐车的成本很高，也必须有餐车等。他说，他们原本要安排餐车业者集中在同一个地点上时段营业，可是发出执照方面就会面对问题，因一些业者早上需在其他地点营业，而执照已列明。

葉國榮：流動小販氾濫

沈邦再也市议员叶国荣向《中国报》指出，目前收紧的是流动小贩，因为方便和容易设置摊位，有者仅需出动私家车或罗铺，尤其私家车小贩最难捉。

他指出，这些小贩属于打游击，即使执法组不停止展开取缔行动，可是就犹如猫捉老鼠一样，他们通常都是将车泊在泊车位，只要执法人员抵达就立刻关上后尾箱。

他强调，这些小贩大部分都是非法营业，停在泊车位后直接关掉后尾箱就可摆出物品开摊营业。

“执法单位一旦接到投诉就会前去取缔，通常都会先口头警告，可是遇到罔顾不畏和抗拒，点点不合作，执法组官员就会提供地点，让业者本身也可提供地点，让官员审核后再做出批准。”

他指出，餐车投资额较大，凡是投资一辆餐车需要8、9万令吉，因此很多餐车业者都不会贸然经营，加上餐车营业执照准证只能在指定的一个地区。

“我们明白小贩们都是为了维生，很多合法小贩都在路边营业，可是过于泛滥时会带来很多问题，包括人潮聚集和噪音等，SOP，执法单位除了地方政府的执法行动，卫生部和警察等都可采取执法行动。”

士拉央市议员李富豪指出，随着多次管制令和封城，许多领域都受到

(吉隆坡25日讯)相比餐饮车霸占泊车位营业，令雪州各地方政府执法组较头痛的是打游击，且直接升车牌摆卖物品的小贩，执法单位与小贩如“猫捉老鼠”，因此希望小贩们申请执照，安心安全合法营业！

他们指出，往往接到投诉的都是非法小贩，包括非法摆摊位和以私家车为摆出物品，尤其是避开执法人员的方法。

接投诉执法组必取缔

“我们是以辨别他们的身分，只要执法人员抵达前将车尾箱盖上，直接坐在车上或是呆坐暂时离开，都是避开执法人员的方法。”

他们指出，他们了解大家是为了维持生计，可是也必须考虑是否会带困扰，加上目前疫情当前，一切都必须以SOP为先。”

他们强调，若持续单到投诉，执法组必采取消公和发出罚单的取缔办法。“最好的控管就是他们申请执照，让我们可掌握资料和可采取适当的行动。”

影市议员陈狄源指出，无执照者点出无数州选区有数个黑区，有许多非法摆摊位和使用私家车摆出物品的小贩。他指出，很多小贩不愿意申领执照，会在商业区或人潮集中地方摆摊位或用私家车摆业。

他说，很多小贩选择出动私家车，直接将物品摆在车尾箱营业，只要找到停车位，就可以很快盖掉车尾箱，执法人员根本无法辨别他的身分。

他指出，在敦胡先翁的苏阿萨那路(Jalan Susanna)，非法摆摊位多达30摊，每天包括摆摊和使用私家车营业。

他说，陈明明和首都镇原本有五、六摊，目前已有一10摊左右，其实不难发现很多都是新面孔和打游击和使用私家车营业。

“既然大家都是流动性的小贩，我们鼓励他们申请执照，因一旦接到罚单却要求扣缴和提供援助，问题难以解决。”

他说，私家车相比餐车更难找到，毕竟很多餐车业者都持有执照不会贸然违法。

至于私家车都是打游击和属于兼营卖物的小贩，我们难以掌握实况情况和数据。

他指出，执法单位也是左右为难，所以对于首次违例的小贩都会给予劝说和警告，若是持续不遵守就会采取行动。

(巴生25日讯) 随著开放旅游业后，吉胆岛开始迎来游客，为免该岛已受控的疫情“破功”，该岛2个渔村在巴生市议会和巴生县卫生局撮合下，正式成立社区自我防疫小组，提高岛上防疫意识，减低交叉感染的风险！

正式成立的“巴生港口吉胆岛社区自我防疫小组”(ComSci20)，除了关注疫情管控，也把焦点放在防范骨痛热症上，因为后者同样足以夺命。

入島人流增加

当地巴生市议员李富豪今午为该小组主持推介礼后，向媒体披露，该岛2个渔村的疫情皆受控，其中五条港渔村，更是依然维持著零确诊本土病例。

目前，虽然还有传出零星病例，不过都是生活在岛外的村民，不是属于在岛内交叉感染的病例。”

不过，他说，随著管制逐步放松、旅游业开放后，入岛的人流也开始增加，因此如何加强岛民的防疫意识非常重要，确保外人不会带来交叉感染。

他说，该小组早在去年已成立，当时冠病疫情还不严重，所以主要是防范骨痛热症，不过随著疫情严重后，我们的防疫目标也扩大，双管齐下。

他说，今日市议会也派送20个礼袋，给吉胆岛乡管会、五条港乡管会、4间学校、诊所、警察局及多个社团组织等，礼袋内主要有防蚊工具，例如喷雾器、药水、蚊油、传单等。

9月1骨痛熱症病例

李富豪指出，冠病会夺命，骨痛热症也一样会夺命，因此大家必须像防疫一样，防范黑斑蚊。

他说，吉胆岛的骨痛热症病例目前受控，不过9月有1宗新增病例。

“骨痛热症也像冠病一样，只要发生一宗，就有机会大肆传染，只是冠病是通过人和人传染，骨痛热症则是通过黑斑蚊传染，一样都会致命。

在场的还有吉胆渔村乡村关了委员会主席蔡全智、五条港管委会主席陈水清、市议会卫生小组主任阿兹米、副主任哈斯诺、环境分组组长查卡利亚等。

黃思漢促民衆守SOP

黃思漢說，雪州疫情開始好轉，在進入第二階段後，許多經濟領域得以重開，公園設施也會全面開放。受詢及蒲種華山（Wawasan Hill）是否會開放登山，黃思漢指出，該山由森林局管理，而當局在复苏第二阶段仍是禁止任何登山活動。

“我要提醒公眾，雖然開放領域更多了，但公眾依然要遵守標準作業程序，這是非常重要的。”

他指出，冠病病毒仍在四周，人們必須時常警惕自己，不要違反標準作業程序群聚。

(吉隆坡24日讯)雪州行政议员许来贤指出，遮拉卡山森林保留地与莎阿南社区森林附近的发展计划所在位置，已在2006年解除宪报，不再是森林保留地。

早前数个非政府组织与民众，针对上述发展计划提出质疑。

许来贤指出，该发展计划所在地已在2006年被前朝政府，通过编号PW1443撤除宪报，更换土地拥有权，已非是森林保留地。

“由于涉及道路与房屋发展的地段已非森林保留地，雪州森林局没有权限介入当地的管理与发展。”

他说，无论如何，雪州希望政府会时刻确

保，当地所有发展活动遵守当前标准作业程序，即遵守2015年环境法令提呈环境评估报告，及按1976年城乡规划法令发出发展准证（KM）。

他指出，其他控制发展措施包括绿地维

持，考量有关野生动物的通行道，更有策略

确保雪州大自然与社会经济的永续性发展。

剩3208畝森林保留地

他说，遮拉卡山于1909年宪报为森林保留地，占地2万3826亩；于1976年起多次撤除宪报作发展用途，如高峰阿南城、Alam Budiman、UiTM 高峰阿南等，目前只剩3208亩森林保留地，由雪州森林局管理。

他指出，在2007年，遮拉卡山有2427.51亩地，重新颁布宪报为保留地，即如今的莎阿南植物园。

序。”

他说，前朝在解除保留地宪报时，并未寻找替代保留地，这也证明他们更关注及承担著不断增加保留地面积的责任。

森林保留地憲報未撤除
莎阿南社區森林協會反駁

(莎阿南25日讯)莎阿南社区森林协会反驳雪州行政议员许来贤指遮拉卡山森林保留地在2006年已被撤除宪报的解释，并促请雪州的能力、公信力和透明度特别遴选委员会（SELCAT）可处理这课题。

该协会发告指出，许来贤提出的并非证明遮拉卡山森林保留地宪报已被撤除的文件证据，而是针对这项宪报撤除的调查计划。

文告说，PW1443是在2006年9月7日，由雪州测量与图测局（JUPEM）局长签署，是关于撤除相关宪报的计划，而不是证实宪报已撤除的证据。

文告声明，该协会查证，遮拉卡山的森林保留地宪报在2006年并未撤除，虽已公布，但调查计划并未曾公布。

因此，该协会认为，许来贤的说辞带有误导性，在相关的宪报撤除未被公布前，该森林依然维持著保留地的状态。

此外，他们认为，政府针对相关宪报所作的公布，是象徵著民主的重要一环，因这能确保整个过程是透明且可信的，缩短整个程序的行为则是违反宪法的。

为此，该协会呼吁州政府，尊重遮拉卡山的森林保留地状态，停止一切破坏森林的举动，并让SELCAT处理。

2014年至今維持第2級別 峇東加里河水水質良好

(吉隆坡25日讯) 峇东加里河水水质，从2014年至今，都维持在第二级别，保持良好水质，且每年皆有改善。

雪州行政议员许来贤说，从2019年至今，峇东加里滤水站的取水口录得的水质指数，显示该河水质一直维持在良好的第二级别。

“水质指数在85至92.7之间属于2A级，意味只需常规地过滤，而76.5至85则属于可用作休闲用途的水质。”

他今日发文告针对有媒体指峇东加里河会因为附近的金凤鱼养殖活动，与周遭的

发展，导致该河成为“死河”的报导，作出回应。

他说，州政府属下机构对一切河流污染事故，皆会立即采取行动，确保水源获得保障。

定期采集河水样本

他说，至目前为止，州政府没有收到任何有关峇东加里河周遭工厂，污染河流的投诉。

“雪州水务管理机构也定时采集河水样本及监督工厂。”

此外，他指出，根据2019至2023乌雪县地方蓝图，

51.7%的土地属于森林，35.67为农业地。

“随著乌雪发展，出现畜牧、水产养殖业、挖沙洗沙、农业、房屋发展等活动，其中根据乌雪县议会2016年纪录，峇东加里河与双溪达姆周遭，有7间民宿或度假村。”

他说，根据水务机构初步调查，上述金凤鱼养殖场面积达0.41公顷，已向雪州渔业局登记，且取得水务机构的准证营运，而水务机构的准证会在今年尾届满。

他指出，该养殖场已经营运10年，拥有约29个池塘。

许来贤说，峇东加里河附近一切有关水源的活动，都获得水务机构在“污染物输入与排放”条例下取得许可证。

“水务机构也向当地两项挖沙及提升桥梁与河床的工程发出准证。”

他指出，当地有8个涉及抽取河水的活动，包括上述金凤鱼养殖场，也获得当局发出的准证。
