Kuala Lumpur: Kedai makan dan kedai serbaneka dalam kawasan selaria Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) dibenarkan beroperasi sehingga jam 2 pagi, mulai hari ini.

Menteri Wilayah Persekutuan, Tan Sri Annuar Musa, berkata ia selari dengan pengumuman Menteri Kanan (Keselamatan), Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, Kamis lalu.

"Saya sudah berbincang mengenai perkara ini dengan Datuk Bandar Kuala Lumpur, Datuk Nor Hisham A Dahlan.

"Eloklah beri peluang kepada peniaga yang sudah lama terjejas sejak Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) untuk tambah pendapatan mereka," katanya pada sidang media Program Pengindahan Taman Awam Bukit Kiara di sini, semalam.

Keputusan itu menyusul sehari selepas DBKL memaklumkan semua operasi premis perniagaan di Kuala Lumpur masih dikalkan sehingga jam 12 tengah

malam, sepanjang tempoh PKP Pemuliharan (PKPP).

Khamis lalu, Ismail Sabri dilaporkan berkata, kedai makan, restoran, dan kedai serbaneka 24 jam dibenarkan beroperasi sehingga jam 2 pagi.

Di Shah Alam, Selangor turut membuat keputusan yang sama untuk membenarkan semua restoran dan kedai serbaneka di negeri itu beroperasi sehingga 2 pagi, seiring keputusan Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN).

Ng Sze Han, berkata keputusan itu dibuat selepas mengambil kira penularan kes COVID-19 di Selangor terkawal sepanjang pelaksanaan PKPP.

"Kes COVID-19 di Selangor terkawal sepanjang PKPP, kini tiba masa untuk menangani dan memulihkan ekonomi," katanya dalam kenyataan.

Bagaimanapun, Sze Han meningkatkan pengunjung dan pengusaha restoran supaya sentiasa mematuhi prosedur sperasi standard (SOP) ditetapkan MKN dan mengamalkan penjarakan fizikal.

Tangani liberalisme, fahaman bercanggah dengan ilmu

Fahaman liberalisme, pluralisme, pragmatisme dan apa juga 'ism' atau cara fikir yang berlawanan prinsip al-Quran, sunnah dan qudwah Nabi Muhammad SAW adalah ditolak Islam.

Berhukum dalam menerima atau menolak dan mengetepikan cara fikir, hendaklah berdasarkan ketetapan bersifat mutlak dan relatif ditetapkan Islam.

Rujukan kepada nas al-Quran atau matan sesuatu hadis tertentu hendaklah dibuat mengikut disiplin ilmu yang ditetapkan.

Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS), Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad, berkata tidak boleh disimpulkan untuk dipegang sebagai nemanfaati satu-satu cara fikir hanya semata-mata merujuk zahir ayat nas al-Quran atau matan hadis atau terjemahan semata-mata.

Beliau berkata, kebenaran sesuatu bentuk dan kebenaran aliran berfikir atau cara fikir perlu merujuk ketetapan apa yang dirumus dan dihurai ulama terhadap nas al-Quran, begitu juga kaedah pengambilan hukum daripada hadis.

"Di sinilah timbulnya pembelajaran berkaitan ayat ahkam dan hadis ahkam (ayat dan hadis yang membawa kesan hukum), sehingga dalam perbahasan itu lahir kesimpulan dan rumus berhukum melalui kaedah fiqh," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian mengulas pendirian tegas Majlis Agama Islam Selangor (MAIS) yang memandang serius dan mengutamakan isu berkaitan

akidah umat Islam termasuk ancaman gerakan liberal di Selangor.

Antara 2014 hingga 2019, JAIS melaksanakan 582 aktiviti membabitkan sesi penjelasan, seminar, konvensyen dan pemantauan bagi memastikan fahaman liberalisme termasuk ajaran setiap datangani ke peringkat akar umbi.

Dalam mendepani faham ism atau cara fikir yang bercanggah dengan Islam, Mohd Shahzihan berkata, tiada cara lain melainkan menerima kehadirannya sebagai cabaran baharu ummah.

Katanya, ia bukanlah faham dan cara fikir yang bertunjang kuat, melainkan suatu pola pemikiran yang membimbulkan krisis pertentangan antara hal dan batil dalam melihat serta memberi makna kehidupan semasa.

"Ini mencakupi tradisi dan prinsip ketuhanan, perundungan, kemasyarakatan, keduduan lainnya dan soal berkaitan hubungan secara langsung atau tidak dengan kehidupan dan pasca kematian.

"Bagi mempercepatkan penzahiran, umat Islam perlu mendepani isu ini dengan ketumbukan besar masyarakat yang bersatu hati dan fikrah, berpegang kepada sistem dan disiplin keilmuan yang benar agar aliran arus jernih dan laju dapat meneutralkan sebuah lumpur, kotar dan sampah daripada ism songsang di tengah dan di pinggiran," katanya.

Beliau menegaskan, kedudukan Islam dalam perlumbaan dan kuasa negeri dalam hal ehwal agama Islam adalah faktor utama yang sentiasa membuka jalan kepada aliran arus yang akan menjernihkan lumpur dan kotoran ism ini.

Bagaimanapun, katanya pelaksanaannya memerlukan hasrat, cita-cita dan harapan kepemimpinan Islam di pelbagai hierarki serta tindakan radikal pentadbir hal ehwal Islam dan masyarakat Islam secara keseluruhan.

"Selama mana ilmu Islam hanya di bilik darjah, ia akan hanya terhenti sebagai satu falsafah bukannya pegangan dan amalan spontan masyarakat Islam.

"Selagi masjid dan surau gagal menjadi pusat keilmuan Islam yang membina keimanan dan kekuatan beramal masyarakat sekitar, sebaliknya menjadikan gelanggang perpecahan, air yang jernih tidak akan bertakung untuk melimpah menjadi ibu air yang mengalir deras membawa, membuang dan menolak bersekali bersamanya kekorban dan sampah sarap ke hulu sungai," katanya.

Beliau berkata, dalam soal hak asasi diperjuangkan, ia hanya suatu cara pemegang ism ini merasionalisasikannya agar merantas semua permasalahan

dan membentuk logik adil yang menyggagi prinsip serta bentuk keadilan ditetapkan Islam.

"Kesimpulannya, ism songsang nyata dan jelas salah apabila dilihat dan dinilai daripada sudut prinsip Islam, kaca mata sarwa jagat dan fitrah manusia.

"Tiada jalan lain menghadapi ism semasa ini, melainkan menjadikan kebatilan sebagai batu sempadan. Perlu-lah terus memegang dan memacu kebenaran ilmu Islam sebagai izzah dalam persekitaran tersendiri dan terhor mat di mata dan pandangan Allah SWT.

"Ini bermakna ilmu adalah sangat perlu bagi menilai dan memisahkan kebatilan dan ia berlaku bukan secara berpikir panjang, sebaliknya secara spontan dan tanpa rasa serba salah atau goyang dan berbelah bagi.

"Berpeganglah secara bijak kepada apa yang disabdarkan Rasulullah SAW yang memperingatkan bahwa sesiapa yang mahukan dunia hendaklah dengan ilmu, jika mereka mahukan akhirat hendaklah juga dengan ilmu dan jika mahukan kedua-duanya (dunia dan akhirat) hendaklah juga dengan memiliki ilmu pengetahuan," katanya.

Pada masa sama, katanya umat Islam hendaklah beradaptasi dengan bijak kepada perkembangan semasa, ancaman serta kepesatan teknologi maklumat dan komunikasi.

"Mungkin tidak ramai mampu beradaptasi dengan cara fikir baru ini dan dapat menguruskannya dengan baik, namun itulah hakikat kemenangan hasil kepahaman, kegetiran dan kesakitan memegang agama bagi megang bara api yang panas," katanya.

KUALA LUMPUR: Selepas aksi Terengganu menentang Johor Darul Ta'zim (JDT), mutu pengadilan sekali lagi tercemar, kali ini melibatkan perlawanan PJ City dan Sabah dalam saingan Liga Super, kelmarin.

Ibu tersebut timbul selepas penjaga gol Sabah, Rozaimie Rohim dilihat sudah terkeluar dari garisan gol sebelum sepakan penalti dibuat oleh penyerang PJ City, Washington Brandao pada masa kecederaan masa penuh.

Meskipun Rozaimie berjaya menangkis tendangan tersebut, namun pengambilan penalti tidak dilakukan semula meskipun jelas penjaga gol telah keluar dari garisan gol sebelum bola itu disepak.

Keputusan tersebut menyaksikan PJ City sekadar berkongsi satu mata selepas terikat 1-1 menerusi jaringan Elizue Araujo dan Rodoljub Paunovic.

"Bukan isu besar apabila Washington gagal menyempurnakan sepakan penalti sebab kami tahu dia memang hebat.

"Cuma ada harinya ia tidak menemui jaringan, itu perkara biasa dalam bola sepak," kata pengendali PJ City, K. Devan yang enggan mengulas isu kualiti pengadilan perlawanan.

Md. Dali Wahid akan memberikan kenyataan berhubung isu mutu pengadilan selepas bermesyuarat hari ini.

"Salam, esok (hari ini) pukul 3 petang saya ada mesyuarat. Selepas itu baharu saya buat kenyataan. Maaf, terima kasih," kata Dali kepada *Utusan Malaysia*, semalam.

Kelmarin, pemilik JDT, Tunku Ismail Sultan Ibrahim

secara lantang mengkritik pengadilan Wan Mohamad Tarmizi Wan Ibrahim dalam saingan Liga Super di antara skuad Harimau Selatan menentang Terengganu.

Tunku Ismail menyifatkan pengadilan amat teruk kerana ada beberapa sepakan penalti dan kad merah sepatutnya dilayangkan akibat kekasaran pemain tetapi tidak mendapat perhatian pengadil.

Bukan isu besar apabila Washington gagal menyempurnakan sepakan penalti sebab kami tahu dia memang hebat."

KUTIPAN zakat di Selangor merekodkan penurunan ketara sehingga 31 peratus berpunca daripada faktor kekangan kewangan yang dihadapi pembayar zakat susulan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) bagi membendung penularan pandemik Covid-19 sejak Mac lalu.

Ketua Divisyen Operasi Agihan Asnaf Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS), Abdul Basith Hamid berkata, kutipan zakat bagi bulan Mac tahun ini di negeri itu adalah sebanyak RM44.9 juta berbanding RM65.7 juta dalam tempoh sama tahun lalu.

Penstrukturkan semula agihan zakat akan dilakukan bagi penuhi keperluan asnaf

SHAH ALAM – Kutipan zakat di Selangor menunjukkan penurunan ketara sehingga 31 peratus yang berpunca daripada kekangan kewangan dihadapi para pembayar zakat akibat pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) sejak Mac lalu.

Berdasarkan rekod Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) pada bulan Mac, agensi itu merekodkan penurunan ketara sehingga mencecah RM20 juta sebulan.

Ketua Divisyen Operasi Agihan Asnaf LZS, Abdul Basith Hamid berkata, kutipan zakat bagi bulan Mac tahun ini adalah RM44.9 juta, iaitu penurunan lebih 31 peratus berbanding RM65.7 juta dalam tempoh yang sama tahun lalu.

Katanya, bagi bulan April, LZS berjaya mengutip RM71.9 juta, iaitu hanya pengurangan RM2 juta berbanding RM73.9 juta tahun lalu.

"Punca penurunan berkenaan mungkin disebabkan faktor kekangan kewangan yang dihadapi oleh para pembayar zakat susulan pelaksanaan PKP.

"Situasi ini menyebabkan LZS membuat unjuran atau sasaran kutipan RM800 juta berbanding RM900 juta semasa awal pelaksanaan PKP oleh pihak kerajaan," katanya ketika ditemui Kosmo di sini baru-baru ini.

Bagaimanapun, ujar beliau, secara realitinya LZS dapat melihat proses pergerakan semasa ekonomi negara yang bermula sejak Mei adalah lebih pantas berbanding negara-negara lain.

"Trend kutipan zakat didapati

mula menekat pada Mei lalu dengan mencatatkan RM135.9 juta termasuk zakat fitrah berbanding tahun sebelumnya sebanyak RM113.5 juta selepas Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) dilaksanakan kerajaan," tambahnya.

Mengulas lanjut, Abdul Basith menjelaskan, LZS berkemungkinan terpaksa menstruktur semula pengagihan zakat agar dapat memenuhi keperluan lebih

60,000 keluarga asnaf sekiranya sasaran kutipan RM800 juta itu tidak dapat dicapai.

Jelasnya, orang ramai harus menyedari bahawa LZS secara hakikatnya sama seperti institusi zakat yang lain di negara ini yang bertindak menstruktur semula pengagihan zakat bergantung kepada jumlah kutipan zakat yang dapat dikutip daripada para pembayarannya.

"Ia penting bagi memastikan

kutipan tersebut mampu menampung keperluan agihan zakat.

"Secara umum, pelaksanaan agihan zakat di Selangor adalah berdasarkan Maqasid Syariah melibatkan tiga kategori utama iaitu bantuan berbentuk Daruriyat (asasi), Hajiyat (keperluan) dan Tahsiniyat (pelengkap).

"Justeru, terdapat beberapa jenis bantuan zakat terutama dalam kategori Tahsiniyat akan

dihentikan terlebih dahulu berbanding dua kategori lain bagi memastikan kelangsungan asnaf yang disifatkan begitu terdesak demi kelangsungan hidup mereka," katanya.

Beliau berkata, kesedaran orang ramai terhadap pembayaran zakat tetap menunjukkan peningkatan iaitu seramai 42,264 pembayar zakat baharu pada tahun 2019 berbanding 37,442 orang pada tahun sebelumnya.

KUALA LUMPUR — Jumlah eluan bulanan yang diberikan kepada ahli jawatan kuasa masjid di seluruh negeri Selangor oleh Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS) terpaksa dikurangkan bagi memberi keutamaan kepada golongan asnaf yang lebih memerlukan di negeri itu.

Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS), Mohd. Shahzihan Ahmad berkata, surat makluman berhubung perkara itu telah dikeluarkan pada 10 September lalu melalui Bahagian Pengurusan Masjid JAIS.

"Arahan dikeluarkan kepada semua Pegawai Tadbir Agama Daerah memandangkan bayaran kepada individu terlibat dibuat oleh Pejabat Agama Daerah masing-masing.

"Arahan juga dibuat secara dalaman kepada semua Pegawai Tadbir Agama Daerah supaya bayaran dilakukan mengikut jadual baru yang telah ditetapkan susulan penstrukturkan semula peruntukan oleh pihak LZS," kata-

Menurut Mohd. Shahzihan, Pegawai Tadbir Agama turut diarahkan untuk memaklumkan kadar baharu itu selaras dengan kesedaran semua pihak termasuk pegawai yang layak menerima bayaran bawahan pandemik Covid-19 memberi kesan kewangan dan ekonomi kepada banyak pihak.

"Bayaran tersebut bukanlah secara bulanan, namun dibayar secara empat bulan sekali dan bayaran bagi Januari hingga April telah dibuat mengikut kadar asal sebelum penstrukturkan semula dibuat.



Lest we forget the hardworking 'water men'

WATER trickling along the street, gushing out of a burst pipe. This is what I saw recently in my Petaling Jaya neighbourhood. Why? Because pressure was unstable in the water distribution network as supply was restored to the 1.2 million people affected by the Sungai Selangor pollution mishap, I was told ("Sg Selangor pollution causes water cut in seven Klang Valley districts", *The Star*, Sept 3; online at bit.ly/star_river).

Some 50m from my gate, a pipe had burst. A Syabas (Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd) team arrived and began work in the early afternoon. Then the rain came. They continued to work, soaked by the downpour, trying to solve the problem of water gushing out of the burst 200mm pipe 1.5m below.

Two of the men stood in waist-deep water. They initially poured out buckets of water from the deep trench that had to be dug out by a backhoe to get to the burst pipe. Then other team members arrived with a mini generator to help get the job done. There were no breaks for rest.

The burst pipe was then sawed – it was real hard work! I stood and watched, feeling for each of them and thinking how easily the rest of us complain and demand an immediate solution to our water woes. What is taking them so long? Why have they not arrived yet? Questions I hear often.

Here's one answer: The past few days have been hard on everyone, as pipes burst in the Klang Valley with the returning water supply.

The backhoe driver told me he hadn't slept in the last 36 hours. When they are fixing burst pipes, there isn't even time to answer nature's call, much less take a break for food and sleep.

But the job on my street is an easy one compared to what they did yesterday, he said: They had to replace a burst pipe running under a bridge over a river; he showed me the photo. I asked how they managed. "Oh, we have people with all sorts of different expertise within Syabas – it is all a matter of teamwork."

They finally left at 9pm, the job done. Hopefully it was their last call.

Think for the long term

Help nature to heal

NOT too long after various countries went on lockdown due to the Covid-19 pandemic, we started getting reports of wild animals “taking over” towns and marine life, such as whales and dolphins, being seen in what used to be busy, polluted waterways. It took a while, especially for the latter as the waterways had to be “cleansed” first before these marine animals could survive in them. But cleansed they were as humankind was forced to stay indoors, which resulted in less pollution everywhere. What this proved was that nature could heal itself as long as it was left alone to do so. It may take time but eventually, nature reclaims its very own. And so it is, too, with Sungai Ichat in Kuala Terla, Cameron Highlands. This time, though, it took a little bit of help from mankind. Sungai Ichat is one of the sources for the Kuala Terla water treatment plant. Plagued by pollution problems, it degenerated to a Class 4 river, meaning its water was classified as “moderate”.

Two years ago, the Pahang government decided that enough was enough and implemented severe enforcement action to tackle encroachment and illegal land clearing for farming near the river. This saw Sungai Ichat returning to such a pristine level that it is now considered a Class 1 river where minimum

treatment is needed for the water to be safe for consumption. Yes, nature does heal itself. But if we want it to heal faster, it needs help from the people and governments. And through this reasoning, it tells that the troubles in other rivers can also be solved. A case in point is the recent pollution at Sungai Gong, Selangor. The water from Sungai Gong leads eventually to Sungai Selangor. And Sungai Selangor is a major source of treated water for the Klang Valley. Selangor is not the only state with water pollution problems. As we pointed out before, there are many dead rivers in Malaysia. There are many more which are not quite dead but will be soon if nothing is done. Now, imagine if these rivers are clean. We will have readily available sources of water. We would not have to face unscheduled water cuts — unless the treatment plants somehow malfunction — and fishermen and anglers would have an abundance of river fish and prawns to fill their pockets and bellies.

The restoration of rivers like Sungai Ichat via rehabilitation work and strict enforcement may be the solution, but there will still be a struggle. That struggle is to balance the needs of the people like farmers versus the long-term demands of sustainability. The key is to think for the long term. Naturally, there will be challenges — businesses and the people may suffer, farmers and fishermen may lose some income. But here is where the authorities can step in to help. It may prove difficult, politically, to move factories and other structures from riverine areas, but if we can muster the will to do it, think of the gains we will make in the future. Think, above all, of the life our children will be forced to lead if we do not.

New water entity for FT won't solve problems, says association president

KUALA LUMPUR: The formation of a new entity to prevent water supply issues specifically for the Federal Territories will not solve the perennial water supply pollution and contamination.

The Association of Water and Energy Research Malaysia (Awer) president S. Piarapakaran said, instead, raw water pollution must be addressed for all.

"The recurring water resource pollution, causing water cuts in the Klang Valley, seems to be a perennial problem. A new entity will not solve the problem. What we need to do is work together to address the issue holistically."

Piarapakaran was commenting on the proposal to set up a water authority body specifically for the Federal Territories.

On Saturday, Federal Territories Minister Tan Sri Annuar Musa tweeted that the frequent water

supply disruptions in the federal capital was worrisome and required long-term solutions.

He said among the long-term solutions required included the establishment of a water authority body specifically for the Federal Territories, along with a back-up plan or an alternative supply.

The Ketereng MP also said that there was a need to amend existing laws by imposing harsher punishment on quarters that cause a water crisis.

Piarapakaran said rather than forming a new entity, Annuar as a minister could push the cabinet to increase the penalty for those who

polluted water resources as this affected millions of consumers.

"A new entity in terms of cost is not going to be a good number, and the company that is operating right now (Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd) already put so much cost on the system.

"We cannot blame Air Selangor for the water pollution because they have no power to go after the polluters, as they are just the company that is treating and supplying water to the consumers."

He said many good suggestions had been put forward to the government to prevent the recurrence of water pollution in the long term, including from Awer.

He added that Awer had proposed that local council officers be trained by the Environmental Department.

"These officers are not environmental officers. They need to be trained so that they will be able to identify pollution and the culprits.

"If it is rubbish pollution, you can see it. (But) the actual pollution problem is liquid pollution going into the water."

Commenting on the recent incident, Piarapakaran said the company that polluted raw water in Sungai Selangor had caused chaos.

"They should be treated as terrorists and not normal criminals, as the factory had been fined RM60,000 for a similar offence in March.

"They know what they did was wrong, yet they did it again. Only

people with a terrorist mindset would do that. That river supplies almost 60 per cent of Klang Valley's raw water and yet you put so many people in danger."

Piarapakaran said the situation was going to repeat itself until a strong change was made in laws and policies, along with beefing up enforcement.

"The root cause of the problem goes back to enforcement and how officers and ministers want to take action."

He said it was unfortunate that enforcement only sprung into action when there was a problem.

"If only we realise the seriousness of the problem, just like how we took action to curb the spread of Covid-19, a similar incident will not happen anytime soon."

"We need the same energy as we did for Covid-19 to control the pollution."

KL food premises allowed to stay open until 2am

PETALING JAYA: The Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) has agreed to allow food premises and convenience stores in Kuala Lumpur to operate up to 2am from today.

Federal Territories Minister Tan Sri Annuar Musa said the extension is in line with the decision made by the National Security Council (MKN) which was announced by Senior Minister (Security) Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob on Thursday.

"I have discussed with Kuala Lumpur Mayor Datuk Nor Hisham A Dahlia a while ago because MKN has given the relaxation.

"Traders have been making huge losses, if they (businessmen) do not threaten security which has been evaluated by MKN, I agree that City Hall allow opening to 2am.

"But the standard operating procedures (SOP) should be fully complied with," he told a media conference after attending the Bukit

Kiara Public Park Beautification Programme yesterday.

DBKL had on Saturday announced the operation hours of business premises in Kuala Lumpur would still be up to 12am during the recovery movement control order (RMCO).

Malaysian Muslim Restaurant Owners Association (Presma) president Datuk Jawahar Ali said around seven per cent of restaurants under Presma are facing business closure and more will be affected after the loan moratorium ends this month.

"This additional two hours would help the restaurant owners to do cleaning and rearranging tables to prepare for opening the next day" he said.

Malaysian Indian Restaurant Owners Association (Primas) president T. Muthusamy agreed that the two-hour will help restaurants to earn a bit more.

"Many business owners will be delighted and customers will get to spend more time

with their friends and family," he said.

"Most Malaysians have been following the SOP during the RMCO.

"It will also make it easier for staff to clean the restaurant before closing."

He pointed out that the Selangor government has also allowed restaurants and stores to operate until 2am.

Selangor's Local Government, Public Transport and New Village Development Committee chairman Ng Sze Han said yesterday that restaurants and convenience stores in the state can continue to operating until 2 am following the announcement made by MKN.

"Covid-19 cases in Selangor remained under control throughout the RMCO period, and it is timely to work on economic recovery.

"However, the prevention of the spread of the virus is still the state government's priority. Therefore, visitors and store operators are reminded to fully adhere to the SOP issued by MKN," he said in a statement.

Selangor Business Hub aims 3,000 firms on online platform

INVEST Selangor Bhd is calling for small and medium enterprises (SMEs) to leverage its inaugural virtual Selangor Business Hub (SBH) initiative amid Covid-19 challenges for the business community.

Selangor state executive councilor Datuk Teng Chang Khim said the state is eyeing for more than 3,000 companies to register on the online platform within the next 12 months.

Currently, 300 merchants have registered to participate in the virtual Selangor International Expo (SIE), one of the components of SBH, scheduled to begin next month.

"The numbers are still growing,

So far, there are participants from over 10 countries in this programme.

"It is tough, but we will try to increase the participation to 3,000 merchants over the next one year because we have already reduced the price of booths from RM6,000 to RM500 for this summit," Teng said at the launch of SBH in Kuala Lumpur recently.

SBH, an alternative for businesses to communicate, engage and do networking with stakeholders, comprises three key components.

They are Invest Selangor promotional programmes, virtual Selangor International Business Summit, as well as the Selangor Information Technology and E-Commerce Council (SITEC).

The virtual Selangor International Business Summit is an online format of the annual Selangor International Business Summit (SIBS).

It consists of Selangor Asean Business Conference and Selangor Smart City and Digital Economy Convention, as well as SIE.

SITEC is an information hub for webinar programmes held by the council to expand and reach an international audience.

Teng explained that historically, there were up to 20% to 30% of foreign participants in the SIBS physical expo held last year. Invest Selangor aims to achieve the same composition for the virtual series this year.

"This is the only way that we

can work within the constraints of the close borders," he said, adding that Selangor is ready to adjust the format accordingly, including offer physical summit to businesses when the travel restrictions end.

Teng also said Selangor would focus on its Halal Business Hub programme and the aerospace industry development for SIBS this year.

On the state direct investments projection, Teng said it is still early to review its target this year as Selangor is already facing economic challenges due to the pandemic.

"Selangor has been ranked No 4 in terms of investment in the manufacturing sector with total investment worth RM1.5 billion

(for manufacturing) in the first quarter 2020 (IQ20) and we are waiting for 2Q results.

"It is still too early to give the forecast for this year as we have seen that Covid-19 has affected the investment flow in the state.

"I would say we don't have to be so pessimistic to look at those figures," he said.

Teng said Selangor will be more prudent in drafting its 2021 budget, to be tabled by year-end.

"In line with that, the provision may also be lower than what was provided last year.

"However, as long as the budget for development is sufficient to generate the economic growth in 2021, we will be satisfied with that," he said.

Punish, not reward wrongdoers

The Selangor govt decides to give one final chance to unlicensed factories and landowners to legalise their operations by the end of this year

LEGALISING unlicensed and errant factories and landowners would only lead to unresolved issues.

Referring to the recent state-wide water woes, lawyer Datuk Mohd Haaziq Pillay Abdullah said the Selangor government must punish the wrongdoers instead of rewarding them.

"By legalising them, the state government is letting them to legally carry out their wrongdoings. This is absurd. Why has no action been taken against the board of directors?

"Open investigation papers against the directors, who are behind the water pollution and collecting the profit. The directors should take responsibility," he told *The Malaysian Reserve* (TMR).

Mohd Haaziq said the factory should have already been closed as the last ordeal was not the first caused by the same company.

He stressed that water is a basic necessity and over 1.3 million residents had suffered, having to carry gallons of water.

"Not everyone has the privilege to stay in a hotel during the water crisis.

"Why do we allow some to abuse

and underestimate the rule of law. In the future, other factories will do the same," he added.

The Selangor government last week decided to give one final chance to unlicensed factories and landowners to legalise their operations by the end of this year.

Failure to do so, Mentri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the state government would not hesitate to demolish the

building structures.

"We have been offering them to carry out the legalisation process since 2008.

"The decision of the last State Executive Council in 2018 was to extend the action until 2020. After 2020, we will demolish," he said in a press conference after the declaration of Kuala Langat Municipal Council as consented by the Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, last Wednesday.

Bernama reported that the factory suspected of the Sungai Gong water pollution was found to have operated without a licence since 2014.

According to Selayang Municipal Council corporate department director Mohamad Zin Masood, data also showed that the factory had never applied for a licence since it started operating six years ago.

The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) reportedly has begun investigations into the issue of pollution of Sungai Gong, Rawang.

Universiti Putra Malaysia political scientist Prof Dr Jayum Anak Jawan echoed similar concerns and said this reflects the government's failure.

"This will only encourage people to do things illegally in the future, because they know that they will be given ample time to legalise their operations.

"This discourages good and law abiding citizens," he told TMR.

Jayum said the state's lackadaisical attitude only encourages deviant and disrespect for law + and order.
