Pinda akta tambah denda kes cemar air

AKAS 1974 akan dibentang di Parlimen tahun depan

Kuala Lumpur: Sebagai langkah meningkatkan kadar denda maksimum bagi kes pencemaran air di samping memastikan pendekatan itu bersifat pencegahan, Akta Kualiti Alam Sekeliling 1974 (AKAS 1974) akan dibentang untuk dipinda di Parlimen tahun depan.

Timbalan Menteri Alam Sekitar dan Air, Senator Datuk Dr

Ahmad Masrizal Muhammad, berkata jumlah denda masih belum dimuktamadkan dengan mengambil kira pandangan pelbagai pemegang taruh dan pakar alam sekitar.

“Di bawah AKAS 1974, bagi kesalahan berkaitan pencemaran air, denda maksimum boleh dikenakan RM100,000 atau penjara tidak melebihi lima tahun atau kedua-duanya sekali,” katanya ketika menggulung perbahasan usul menjunjung kasih titah Yang di-Pertuan Agong, di Dewan Negara di sini, semalam.

Sementara itu, Ahmad Masrizal berkata, pembangunan premis yang beroperasi berhampiran

sungai perlu diberi perhatian serius bagi mencegah berlaku pencemaran yang boleh menjaskan bekalan air bersih kepada rakyat.

Katanya, aspek penguatkuasaan melalui Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) akan terus dipertingkatkan dengan memeriksa punca pencemar termasuk kilang, loji kumbahan, bengkel dan lain-lain terutama yang terletak di hulu loji rawatan air.

“Operasi secara besar-besaran dengan kerjasama daripada pelbagai agensi penguat kuasa mengikut bidang kuasa masing-masing akan terus dilaksanakan bagi meningkatkan lagi keberkesanan pemeriksaan punca pencemar,” katanya. **BERNAMA**

Malaysia komited jadi destinasi pelaburan terbaik

MELAKA: Kerajaan komited mewujudkan persekitaran pelaburan sihat dalam negara untuk menjadi destinasi pelaburan terbaik di Asia Tenggara.

Perdana Menteri, Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin berkata, keyakinan itu penting bagi menggalakkan pelabur menambah pelaburan mereka.

Menurutnya, sektor perkilangan juga direkodkan menyumbang sebanyak 22.3 peratus kepada kadar pertumbuhan ekonomi negara pada tahun lepas.

"Daripada jumlah itu, industri elektronik merupakan penyumbang utama dalam sektor perkilangan berdasarkan jumlah pelaburan daripada syarikat-syarikat antarabangsa," katanya dalam satu kenyataan yang dikeluarkan Pejabat Perdana Menteri semalam.

Terdahulu, Muhyiddin melawat kilang Infineon Technologies di Batu Berendam selepas hadir mesyuarat Majlis Tindakan Ekonomi (EAC).

Turut serta ialah Ketua Menteri, Datuk Seri Sulaiman Md. Ali dan Menteri Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri, Da-

tuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali.

Perdana Menteri turut mengumumkan komitmen Infineon untuk melabur sejumlah RM3.25 bilion dalam jangka masa 10 tahun sehingga 2029.

Melalui pelaburan itu, Infineon telah membuka jalan untuk merancakkan nilai rantaian sektor semi konduktor ke arah proses berkeuntungan tinggi seperti *Packaged Integrated Circuit*.

"Pelaburan ini menjadi mer-

cu tanda dalam hubungan kerjasama pelbagai bidang antara Malaysia-Jerman dan juga simbol tahap keyakinan tinggi oleh pelabur asing terhadap kestabilan dan daya tarikan Malaysia.

"Dengan pengalaman selama 40 tahun dalam bidang semi konduktor automotif, Infineon membuktikan keupayaan mereka untuk terus memacu industri elektronik maju ke hadapan," katanya.

Malaysia adalah satu-satu-

nya negara di luar Jerman yang menyaksikan Infineon mempunyai kemudahan proses ujian dan pengumpulan *Wafer Fabrication* untuk kilang berkenaan.

Semasa lawatan itu, Perdana Menteri telah diberi taklimat berhubung operasi kilang tersebut yang memiliki seramai 9,000 pekerja dan mendengar pandangan serta cabaran yang dihadapi oleh pihak pengurusan dan pekerja Infineon susulan pasca Covid-19.

Pencemaran Sungai Gong: Tindakan di bawah SOSMA

PUTRAJAYA: Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) sedang menunggu keputusan daripada Jabatan Peguam Negara (AGC) mengenai tindakan untuk menyiasat dan melakukan pendakwaan terhadap individu yang terlibat dalam jenayah terancang membabitkan pencemaran alam sekitar mengikut Akta Kesalaman Keselamatan (Langkah-Langkah Khas) 2012 (SOSMA).

Timbalan Pengarah (Siasa-

tan/Perundungan) Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah PDRM, Deputi Komisioner Mior Faridalathrash Wahid berkata, pihaknya akan melakukan kajian dalam membantu Kementerian Alam Sekitar berhubung aspek pengukuasaan berdasarkan kekuatan anggota yang dimiliki sekarang. Jelasnya, walaupun berdepan dengan isu kekurangan anggota polis seperti dilaporkan media baru-baru ini, namun isu mem-

babitkan jenayah alam sekitar perlu diberikan perhatian serius dan keutamaan pihaknya.

"Kita sudah merujuk AGC sama ada boleh atau tidak diam-bil tindakan di bawah SOSMA secara keseluruhannya membabitkan isu jenayah alam sekitar. Bagi peringkat permulaan, kita akan melihat kepada isu pence-maran yang berlaku di Sungai Gong.

"Contohnya, kejadian di Su-

ngai Gong kita bantu dengan menggunakan unit forensik bagi mendapatkan keterangan untuk mendakwa pesalah di mahkamah," katanya dalam si-dang media di sini semalam.

Beliau mengulas penggunaan Menteri Alam Sekitar dan Air, Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man mengenai penubuhan Unit Cegah Jenayah Alam Sekitar (UCIAS) antara kemen-teriannya dengan kerjasama

strategik Kementerian Dalam Negeri (KDN) bagi menangani sindiket jenayah terancang berkaitan alam sekitar di negara ini.

Pasukan khas itu akan melibatkan kekuatan anggota daripada Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS), Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN), Jabatan Biokese-lamatan (JBK) serta PDRM yang dijangka dapat beroperasi pada awal bulan depan.

BARU-BARU ini, penduduk di tujuh wilayah di Kuala Lumpur dan Selangor menderita kerana mengalami gangguan bekalan air bersih selepas operasi empat loji rawatan air (LRA) dihentikan berikutan air sungai tercemar. Hampir 1.2 juta pengguna terkesar dengan mala petaka itu. Puncak pencemaran sungai dipercayai dari sebuah kilang menyelenggara mesin dan jentera di Rawang.

Menurut Pengurus Jawatankuasa Tetap Alam Sekitar Selangor, Hee Loy Sian, siasatan awal Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (LUAS) mendapat kilang itu gagal melakukan penyimpanan sisa minyak buangannya mengikut syarat-syarat ditetapkan. Kilang tersebut sebelum ini pernah dikompaun RM60,000 atas kesalahan sama. Kenyataan Loy Sian menunjukkan kompaun sahaja belum mampu membetulkan keadaan.

Hukuman lebih berat dan setimpal perlu diwujudkan, misalnya tempoh penjara yang lama, kilang dirobohkan, jentera dan peralatan disita dan dimusnahkan. Selain dendanya tinggi, pesalah diwajibkan membayar pampasan untuk menampung kos kerajaan menjalankan kerja pembersihan sungai dan pemuliharaan alam sekitar yang tercemar.

Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah pula bertitah, mana-mana bangunan di kilang yang didirikan di tepi sungai dan menjadi puncak pencemaran sungai hendaklah dirobohkan. Baginda bertitah agar kerajaan negeri bertindak lebih tegar. Baginda juga tidak mahu ada campur tangan ahli-ahli politik dalam perkara itu.

Pada 2016, pencemaran sungai menyebabkan LRA Semenyih ditutup selama empat kali, mengakibatkan beberapa kawasan di Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat, Sepang dan Petaling mengalami gangguan bekalan air. Pada masa itu, Ahli Parlimen Kuala Selangor, Datuk Seri Dr. Irmoizam Ibrahim mencadangkan denda maksimum dinaikkan sehingga RM1 juta dan pemilik kilang dikenari sehingga 10 tahun.

Kita ada undang-undang alam sekitar yang sudah lapuk, tidak mampu menangani masalah pencemaran sungai.”

Dalam insiden terbaru ini, polis menahan empat pelaku yang merupakan pemilik kilang kerana disyaki memencemarkan Sungai Gong, Rawang. Pada 6 September lalu, polis mendapatkan perintah reman selama enam hari dari Mahkamah Sesyen Kuala Lumpur.

PEMUTIHAN

Mengikut laporan media, kerajaan negeri telah memberi peluang lagi kepada pemilik tanah dan kilang haram untuk membuat proses pemutihan sehingga hujung tahun ini. Kenyataan ini menyebabkan pihak tertentu bertanya: “Sudah 12 tahun pemilik kilang haram diberi masa, kenapa beri muka lagi kepada

mereka?”

Pada hemat saya, selesa ini kerajaan perlu melaksanakan *polluter pays principle*, iaitu mewajibkan pencemar membayar sejumlah wang kepada pihak berkuastra untuk menjalankan kerja memuliharkan kembali keadaan alam sekitar yang sudah tercemar kepada keadaan asalnya.

Australia bertindak sedemikian dengan menubuhkan Pihak Berkuastra Perlindungan Alam Sekitar (EPA). Kesatuan Eropah juga bertindak sama pada 2004. Perancis melaksanakannya dalam Artikel 4 Piagam Alam Sekitar negara itu, manakala Ghana mula menguatkuasakannya pada 2011. England dan Wales melaksanakannya di bawah *Environmental Damage (Prevention and Remediation) Regulations 2009*, manakala Amerika Syarikat melaksanakannya di bawah *Clean Water Act 1972*. Di bawah *Environmental Management Act 2002* Zimbabwe, mana-mana orang yang disabit melakukan pencemaran alam sekitar boleh diperintahkan membayar kos untuk membersihkan semula alam sekitar yang telah dicemar olehnya (*cost of decontaminating the polluted*

environment).

Pada asalnya, prinsip ini disebutkan sebagai Prinsip 16 Deklarasi Rio Mengenai Alam Sekitar dan Pembangunan 1992 yang mana Malaysia sejak awal lagi menyertainya. Malangnya selepas tiga dekad, kita masih lagi gagal melakukan sesuatu yang konkret dan bermakna.

LEMAH

Pada 2017, Menteri Sumber Asli dan Alam Sekitar (ketika itu), Datuk Seri Dr. Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar ada menyatakan, kerajaan akan memperkenalkan Akta Perlindungan Alam Sekitar untuk memberi kuasa kepada jabatan Persekutuan bertindak ke atas industri yang menyebabkan pencemaran sungai. Akta itu nanti akan memberi kuasa kepada jabatan Persekutuan memaksa kilang haram dipindahkan atau diroboh. Beliau menambah, dalam kes pencemaran Sungai Semenyih disebabkan oleh kilang haram, agensi di bawah kementeriannya tidak boleh bertindak kerana perkara itu di bawah bidang kuasa pihak Persekutuan (PBT).

Pada Mei 2019, apabila kes pencemaran Sungai Kim Kim di Pasir Gudang berlaku di mana hampir 6,000 orang penduduk daerah itu

terkesan, Menteri Tenaga, Sains, Teknologi dan Alam Sekitar (ketika itu) Yeo Bee Yin berkata, kerajaan bercadang menggantikan undang-undang alam sekitar sedang ada dengan satu akta baharu untuk memberi kuasa yang lebih sempurna dan mewujudkan hukum lebih berat kepada penjenayah alam sekitar.

Soalnya, apa sudah jadi dengan undang-undang alam sekitar baharu yang dijanjikan oleh beberapa menteri pada masa itu?

Kesimpulannya, kita ada undang-undang alam sekitar yang sudah lapuk, tidak mampu menangani masalah pencemaran sungai. Kita ada PBT tetapi nampaknya masih lemah melaksanakan penguatkuasaan ke tahap yang rakyat mahu.

Kita berdepan dengan pendirian kerajaan negeri yang terus berlembut dan memberi muka kepada pemilik kilang haram. Akhir sekali, kita berdepan dengan realiti jabatan atau agensi Persekutuan tidak boleh bertindak kerana tidak ada kuasa berbuat demikian.

Selangor Royal Office dalam hantaran di Facebook resmi semalam memberitahu, Kasut Emas tersebut dibeli pada satu nilai yang dipersetujui oleh kedua-dua pihak.

Penyerahan kasut tersebut diadakan dalam satu majlis ringkas di Istana Alam Shah,

Klang semalam.

Kasut Emas yang dimenangi Khalid pada 2002 itu juga akan diletakkan di Muzium Galeri Bola Sepak Selangor yang terletak di pekarangan Istana Alam Shah.

Khalid, 43, yang dianggap legenda bola sepak Perak dan pernah menyarung jersi Selangor dari 2005 hingga 2006 sebelum ini mencuri tumpuan apabila melolong beberapa koleksi peribadi seperti pingat, jersi dan poster.

Dia bagaimanapun menegas-

kan, tindakan itu bukan bermiat meriah simpati orang ramai, sebaliknya untuk meneruskan kelangsungan hidup.

Khalid ketika dihubungi *Utusan Malaysia* enggan mengulas mengenai perkara itu, sebaliknya hanya akan mengeluarkan kenyataan rasmi dalam masa dua atau tiga hari.

Media sebelum ini melaporkan, Kasut Emas penjaring terbanyak Liga Perdana 2002 itu dijual pada harga RM99,999.

PENCEMARAN SUNGAI GONG

Empat pengarah, pengurus kilang didakwa hari ini

Kuala Lumpur: Empat lembaga pengarah dan seorang pengurus kilang akan didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen Selayang, hari ini berhubung kes pencemaran bau di Sungai Gong, Rawang, Selangor pada 3 September lalu.

Ketua Jabatan Siasatan Je-
nayah (JSJ) Selangor, Datuk Fadzil Ahmat berkata, kertas siasatan kes berkenaan sudah dirujuk ke Pejabat Pe-
guam Negara.

"Pertuduhan pertama terhadap lima tangkapan itu dibuat mengikut Seksyen 430 Kanun Keseksaan yang dibacakan bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan. Selain Kasut Emas, Khalid juga melelong pelbagai barang peribadi termasuk poster, jersi serta medal yang dimenangi sepanjang kariernya.

Sementara itu, Khalid ketika dihubungi enggan mengulas lanjut mengenai urus niaga berkenaan.



Deluge of human indifference

THE floodwaters may have subsided and the cleaning of mud and rubble has begun in Sepang. However, in Sepang, worries of important flood issues still haunt residents.

It is the sheer volume of refuse they expect the council to clear again.

Septech, which saw 12 locations affected, was the second district with the most flood damage after Hulu Langat.

Abdul Zalani, chairman of Amal Relief Malaysia Sepang (Arif), an independent relief organisation funded by Amasah, said areas like Sungai Langat, Sungai Salak and Kampung Lubuk Laut had experienced flooding three times already this year.

On how long the recent flood passed before the new debris appeared, Abdul Zalani said Arif volunteers had struggled to clean up debris after the flooding cleared up exercises since 2009.

"The debris would accumulate more acute over time," he noted.

"We have been cleaning up more than RM500 per minute," he said. "In 2011, after the flooding, the estates started coming up in the surrounding areas. We were picking up debris."

"In the latest July floods, especially in the northern districts, including Sungai Petali, came up to about RM10,000 per minute."

He said that previously only a few houses in the area would be affected during a flood.

"Now, more than 100 houses are flooded, many properties down from their ancestors, had no more than five houses," he said.

But when the housing estates developed, more houses in the area would be affected at a time, said Abdul Zalani.

He said it was common knowledge that the new houses were built on the site where the new housing estate was now being set up on flood-prone areas.

"Sepang Municipal Council should have done the land surveying, drainage and environmental surveys before approving these houses," he said.

At Dergah, Abdul Zalani Tahl, secretary of the Sepang People's Association, a non-governmental organisation that aids flood victims, said damage victims, said damage was compounded by the fact that those who had to bear the cost of flood damages repudiated them.

"These victims are carried out on damaged parts of the river bank but the banks are always broken by the force of upstream

He added that residents had suggested marking possible vulnerable areas along the boundary of the riverbank and carrying out regular maintenance or upgrading operations had taken place.

In a state government news portal, Selangor Irrigation Department and Public Works Department director general chairman Idris Hashim was quoted as saying that the state government had approved upgrading work for the Sungai Langat river bend upgrade in August.

On the input in the river bend development, Idris Hashim said the state would be able to solve the issue and bring back the river to its original state before and not after a flood when the water level goes down.

Floods caused them huge losses, especially in the northern districts like Sungai Langat river bend upgrade in Tamu Permaisuri Dergah in August.

"We are happy that the state government will take action to solve the issue and bring back the river to its original state before and not after a flood when the water level goes down," he said.

In a state government news portal, Selangor Irrigation Department and Public Works Department director general chairman Idris Hashim was quoted as saying that the state government had approved upgrading work for the Sungai Langat river bend as part of its solution to address the fire.

Upgrading works for the Sungai Langat river bend will start early next year and is expected to be completed in 2022.

Idris Hashim said the state government also gave assurance that the council would monitor cleaning and maintenance works for the Sungai Langat river bend in the long run.



Environmental criminals beware

Dedicated task force targeting polluters set to swing into action

PUTRAJAYA: Efforts to investigate and solve environmental-related crimes will be given a boost with the formation of a dedicated task force to target environmental perpetrators who pollute the environment.

The task force will be in operation from next month and the government shows its seriousness to act against environmental perpetrators.

All four law enforcement agencies will give the authority to take immediate action towards environmental transgressions.

In announcing the setting up of the task force, Environment and Water Resources Minister Dato' Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man

said the unit would boast speed and effectiveness in the action by the relevant authorities against the various commercial crimes against the environment.

Setting up of the task force will help with enforcement against environmental offenders.

"This, along with amendments to the Water Services Industry Act and Water Services Industry Act 2010, will give the police more power to ensure that those who commit such acts will pay dearly," he told a press conference at the setting up of the special task force.

The task force will comprise officers from the Environment and Water Services Industry (DKE), Water Services Commission (SPAN), Environment Department and police.

In announcing the setting up of the task force, Environment and Water Resources Minister Dato' Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man

said the unit would boast speed and effectiveness in the action by the relevant authorities against the various commercial crimes against the environment.

Tuan Ibrahim said police and other enforcement agencies would discuss with the Public Prosecutor's Office on the setting up of the task force.

He said that amendments to the Water Services Industry Act and Water Services Industry Act 2010 will give the police more power to ensure that those who commit such acts will pay dearly.

"The task force will comprise officers from the Environment and Water Services Industry (DKE), Water Services Commission (SPAN), Environment Department and police."

He pointed to the Sungai Gong incident in Rawang where the pollution affects environmental sustainability and the health and well-being of the people.

"Globally, crime against the environment is the fourth highest organised crime after drug, money laundering and terrorism and internet crimes, so we have to increase our enforcement,"

Tuan Ibrahim said the ministry would discuss with the Public Prosecutor's Office on the setting up of the task force.

He also said that amendments to the Water Services Industry Act which will see stiffer penalties for environmental offenders would be tabled at the next Parliament sitting.

"We are seeking higher compensation and fines for those who pollute the environment and those who bear the cost," he said.

Tuan Ibrahim declined to reveal the proposed amount of compensation to be imposed on the polluters.

On the recent Sungai Gong water

pollution incident in Rawang, the minister said that investigation papers had been submitted to the Attorney General's Chambers.

"The investigation papers by the Environment and Water Services Commission will be submitted to the Attorney General's Chambers,"

Tuan Ibrahim said that under the proposed Water Services Industry Quality Act, action could be taken against companies that pollute the environment.

"We can also charge and take action against the company director, chief executive officer, managing director and other officers if necessary,"

Groups laud setting up of environmental unit

PETALING JAYA: Environmental groups and small businesses have lauded the government's move to set up the environmental crimes unit.

However, they want the unit's powers to be expanded to ensure effective action can be carried out.

Sahabat Alam Malaysia (SAM) president Meenakshi Raman said the move to introduce the unit was timely given the recent pollution incident at Sungai Gong in Selangor.

"With the involvement of the police and the setting up of the unit, we hope that the gravity of environmental offences are viewed much more seriously as they impact a much larger number of people in society, often with long-term effects," she said yesterday.

She suggested that prosecutors should also press for stiffer punishments such as custodial sentences on the directors of the companies

responsible for environmental crimes.

"It is indeed regrettable that thus far, only fines are normally meted out, which are easily payable by the offenders, often with repeat offences," she added.

She said that personnel under the unit must be of integrity and not be tempted by bribes because some companies might resort to corruption to escape punishment.

Meenakshi noted that environmental crimes involving wildlife trade, deforestation, sand-mining and hill-cutting were not within the scope of the collaboration.

"We urge the Natural Resources Ministry to also come within the purview of the unit, so that violations involving wildlife, forests and our natural resources are similarly viewed as environmental crimes," she added.

SME Association president Datuk Michael Kang also said the unit should not be confined to investigating water pollution cases.

"We hope attention will also be given other forms of pollution and not only industrial waste pollution of water ways. The unit should also look at household pollution, air pollution due to release of toxic materials or carbon dioxide," he said.

Kang suggested the unit should also organise education programmes for small and medium enterprises (SMEs) to educate them on environmental laws and regulations.

"There are laws and regulations but many SMEs are not unaware of them. The unit should come out with proper guidelines to educate SMEs," added Kang.

Malaysian Water Forum (MWF) president Saral James Maniam took an opposing view, saying there were sufficient authorities to handle investigations.

"The police act as action takers and enforcers but what we lack are regulators to supervise."

"Investigations should be done by agencies such as the Department of Environment (DOE) and National

Water Services Commission (SPAN) since they are the experts," she said.

Rather than set up a new unit, she suggested better collaboration between the agencies to handle investigations, citing the recent Sungai Gong incident where the DOE and SPAN had carried out investigations.

"We have so many units whose job responsibilities overlap and we may end up spending more rather than being more productive," she added.

Organisation for the Preservation of National Heritage Malaysia (Peka) president Puan Sri Shariffa Sabrina Syed Akil welcomed the move, but said the focus should also be given on solving the root causes of environmental issues.

"While the setting up of this unit may serve as a temporary solution, a long-term strategy must be put into place to ensure that the root causes of the problem are addressed towards ensuring national security," she said.

Selangor CID chief Senior Asst Comm Datuk Fadzil Ahmat said the five suspects would be charged under Section 430 of the Penal Code and Section 25 of the Environmental Quality Act 1974.

He added that four other suspects were released and would be called in as witnesses.

“The five will be charged at 8am at the Selayang Sessions Court.”

Following oil pollution which came from the factory, four Sungai Selangor water treatment plants had to suspend operations, resulting in the water supply disruption.

tiring from the game.

He intends to use the money from the sale of the items to help him and his family get by financially.

Many interested parties had come forward, with one buyer offering RM50,000 and another RM99,999 for the Golden Boot.

The Selangor Royal Office posted six photographs on its Facebook account of the former national player handing over the Golden Boot to the Selangor ruler at the Selangor Football Museum Gallery in Istana Alam Shah.

Khalid started playing in 1993 and grew with the sport, making a name for himself in the local and international arenas.

In 2002 he went on trial with

Environmental Crime Prevention Unit will come down hard on polluters, says minister

THE new Environmental Crime Prevention Unit, or 'Unit Cegah Jenayah Alam Sekitar', is set to start operations next month.

Environment and Water Minister Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man said the elite unit would comprise personnel from the Department of Environment, National Water Services Commission, Department of Biosafety and the police.

"The ministry views the issue of pollution seriously. This needs to be addressed in a holistic and proactive approach.

"This follows rampant pollution cases, with the latest incident at Sungai Gong, Selangor, which have a huge impact on the nation's environmental sustainability, economy as well as the health and wellbeing of the people," he told a press conference here yesterday.

While the respective agencies have been carrying out monitoring and enforcement of existing laws, they faced limitations, he said.

Thus, he said, the ministry needed support in terms of logistics, forensic and intelligence expertise, enforcement as well as enhancement of relevant laws.

He said the ministry would soon discuss the appointment of personnel in the unit with the Public Service Department and Finance Ministry.

He said the police would also be empowered to take action against environmental criminals under the Environmental Quality Act and Water Services Industry Act 2006. The force has received the delegation of authority to enforce the Biosafety Act 2007.

"I would like to thank the home minister (Datuk Seri Hamzah Zainudin) for this cooperation that enabled the establishment of the unit.

"With the formation of the unit, we hope to prevent, curb and solve environmental crimes in Malaysia more effectively."

Tuan Ibrahim said the ministry welcomed suggestions and assistance from all parties, including non-governmental organisations, in addressing pollution issues.

He gave an assurance that the new unit would come down hard on polluters.

He said at the global level, environmental crime was the fourth largest organised crime after drugs, money laundering and human trafficking, which saw international trades valued at about US\$258 billion in 2016.

"According to the United Nations, the figure increases between five and seven per cent every year. Environmental crime does not only pose a threat to the country's sustainability and the people's health, but also to national security."

Tuan Ibrahim said the ministry was looking into amending the relevant laws to increase the penalty against polluters, among others.

"We hope to table the amendments to the law at the next Dewan Rakyat sitting this year."

Meanwhile, Federal Police Criminal Investigation Department's prosecution and law division deputy director SAC Mior Farid alathrash Wahid, who attended the meeting on the newly formed unit, said the cooperation

would see police extending assistance, including forensic expertise, like how it did in the Sungai Gong case.

He, however, said the selection criteria of policemen for the unit had yet to be determined.

On a separate matter, Tuan Ibrahim said the investigation paper into the recent Sungai Gong pollution, which led to millions in the Klang Valley without water supply recently, had been submitted to the Attorney-General's Chambers last week.

"The investigation paper was submitted by the ministry and SPAN.

"The director, chief executive and other officers of the company responsible for the pollution could be charged under Section 43 of the Environmental Quality Act 1974.

"We will not compromise with any parties involved in polluting our water resources and wish to send a clear message to all that we are serious in dealing with environmental pollution," Tuan Ibrahim said.

The incident on Sept 3 forced Air Selangor to halt operations at the Sungai Selangor Water Treatment Plant Phases 1, 2 and 3 and the Rantau Panjang Water Treatment Plant.

It caused a massive disruption to water supply to some 1.2 million account holders in 1,292 areas in the Klang Valley.

RESIDENTS in the Klang Valley once again endured water disruption for several days recently. It appears that this is a recurrent incident.

The question is, why should the public suffer inconvenience due to the irresponsible acts of some individuals with regard to water pollution?

While the laws to curb such actions are in place, what is lacking is vigorous enforcement. While it is possible to amend the laws to impose stiffer punishment, what is more important is enforcement.

The authorities must monitor the operations of factories located near the rivers to ensure that they strictly comply with the regulations. There should be no compromise with violators of the laws.

Not only should the offenders be prosecuted and punished if found guilty, their business licences must

be revoked and assets confiscated. This will serve as a lesson to the offenders not to flout the laws.

Some quarters may argue that the revoking of licences and confiscation of assets are unfair as this will affect the livelihood of workers in the company.

This argument may be rebutted with the contention that the workers have a duty to expose the wrongdoings of the management.

If, despite the disclosure, no action is forthcoming, they should alert the authorities under the Whistleblower Protection Act 2010. Their move will be lauded as they are not serving their self-interest but the larger interests of the company and the public.

5 to be charged for dumping effluents

PETALING JAYA: Four company directors and a factory manager, who were held for investigations into the dumping of effluents into Sungai Gong in Rawang are expected to face multiple charges of alleged pollution to the environment today.

Selangor police CID chief SAC Datuk Fadzil Ahmat said yesterday that the Attorney-General's Chambers ordered the five suspects to be jointly charged for "discharging or depositing scheduled waste into the environment leading to pollution" under Section 25 of the Environment Quality Act and "mischief by injury to works of irrigation" under Section 430 of the Penal Code.

He said the directors and manager will be charged at the Selayang sessions court at 8am today.

Fadzil said four others who were arrested in connection with the case were freed on bail.

The four directors of the family-run Yip Chee Seng & Sons Sdn Bhd in Batu Arang, Rawang were arrested on Sept 4 and have spent the past 10 days in remand to facilitate investigations into the case.

The brothers, who are aged between 50 and 60, were held after large quantities of effluents suspected to have originated from their company were found dumped in Sungai Gong. – by **Charles Ramendran**

Environmental crime prevention unit created

PUTRAJAYA: An Environmental Crime Prevention Unit has been set up to curb environmental pollution in the country, said Environment and Water Minister Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man (*pix*).

The unit is expected to begin operations early in October. It involves agencies under the ministry, namely the Department of Environment, National Water Services Commission, Biosafety Department as well as the police.

The ministry's enforcement agencies will support them in terms of logistic resources, forensic and intelligence expertise, manpower and the consolidation of laws and jurisdiction.

"It is hoped that the setting up of the unit will help prevent, curb and solve planned environmental crimes in Malaysia more effectively," Ibrahim said.

According to him, the United Nations classifies planned environmental crimes as the fourth biggest planned crime after drugs, money laundering and human trafficking, which cost US\$258 billion (RM1.06 trillion) in 2016.

He said it was agreed the police would take immediate action against



environmental criminals as enforcement power under the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and the Water Services Industry Act 2006 would be handed to them while the Biosafety Act 2017 enforcement power was already under them.

Meanwhile, the Attorney-General's Chambers has ordered five suspects to be charged for "discharging or depositing scheduled waste into the environment leading to pollution" in the recent Sungai Gong case. - Bernama

Special task force formed to tackle environmental crimes

Amendments of environmental laws will see harsher punishments imposed on offenders, says minister

A SPECIAL task force has been established to look into environmental crimes committed in the country and to set out justifiable punishments for the culprits.

Environment and Water Minister Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man said the environmental crimes unit, which is a collaboration between the Home Affairs Ministry (KDN), Department of Environment, National Water Services Commission, Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM) and Department of Biosafety, is expected to commence enforcement next month.

The task force permits PDRM to take immediate action on environmental criminals as it has been granted the power to arrest under the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and the Water Services Industry Act 2006. Previously, PDRM only had the power to enforce the Biosafety Act 2007 against polluters.

"The complexity in environmental enforcement requires structural changes within the govern-

ment as the agencies need logistic and forensics support, adequate enforcement officers and tighter laws.

"From the meeting between KDN and the Environment and Water Ministry (yesterday), an environmental crimes unit was set up which involves several agencies under the ministry," Tuan Ibrahim said at a press conference in Putrajaya yesterday.

He said additional funds will be requested from the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service Department to increase the

number of enforcement officers, based on the urgency of the cases reported and investigated by the task force.

Tuan Ibrahim said the amendments of Malaysia's environmental laws will see harsher punishments imposed on the offenders.

Among the proposed amendments are higher compound rates, stern action in suspending the culprits' business licences and putting the cost of the cleaning process for river pollution on the offenders.

"We will raise the amount of

compound issued to the culprits as the rate that we have right now is too low.

"The ministry will also make sure that the cost of the cleaning process for river pollution is at the expense of the factories responsible for waste dumping."

He said the process of amending the Environment Quality Act 1974 and the Water Services Industry Act 2006 is currently underway and that the amendments are expected to be brought to the Parliament during the next session.

The Sungai Gong pollution early this month was the latest fiasco after discharged effluent was found in the river, causing disruption in water supply to 1.2 million people.

Four managers of a factory in Rawang, suspected to be involved in the industrial waste dumping at the river, have been remanded.

PDRM submitted its investigation papers on the incident to the Attorney General's Chambers last week.

Tuan Ibrahim said the offenders of the Sungai Gong pollution could be charged under Section 43 of the Environment Quality Act 1974.

"Under the Act, we could take action against the company's CEO, managers, directors or officers who are involved in the crime."
