JAIS tangguh akad nikah, sesi persekolahan

SHAH ALAM: Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS) menangguhkan semua temu janji majlis akad nikah yang dijadualkan di Pejabat Agama Islam (PAID) Klang berkuat kuasa semalam.

Semua sesi persekolahan di bawah kelolaan dan kawalan JAIS di daerah Petaling turut ditangguhkan.

Pengaruhnya, Mohd. Shahzihan Ahmad berkata, temu janji nikah itu melibatkan yang dibuat sebelum atau pada Rabu lalu kepada pasangan dari Zon Klang dan Zon Kapar.

“Ia berikutan penangguhan semua aktiviti di masjid dan surau oleh JAIS di seluruh daerah Klang yang dikuat kuasakan sejak Rabu lepas dan penguatkuasaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) pada Jumaat lalu.

“Sebarang temu janji akad nikah individu terlibat di PAID Klang akan dijadualkan semula,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan semalam.

Bagi persekolahan pula, Mohd. Shahzihan berkata, semua sesi di bawah kelolaan dan kawalan JAIS di daerah Petaling ditangguhkan sehingga 25 Oktober ini.

Menurutnya, penangguhan itu berdasarkan peningkatan popularan kes Covid-19 di daerah tersebut selain menjaga kemalahan para pelajar, guru, ibu bapa dan masyarakat umum.

SHAH ALAM: Kerajaan Selangor terkejut dengan pengumuman pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) di Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya termasuk Selangor selama dua minggu bermula tengah malam ini.

Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, pihaknya baharu sahaja selesai mengadakan mesyuarat Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) negeri bersama beberapa agensi termasuk Jabatan Kesihatan negeri, Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) dan Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM) berhubung situasi terkini Covid-19 di Selangor.

Menurutnya, keputusan mesyuarat menunjukkan hanya Klang, Gombak, Hulu Langat dan sebahagian Petaling yang mempunyai bilangan kes membimbangkan.

"Malah, secara konsensus kita melihat ada beberapa ca-

Amirudin berkata, kerajaan negeri berharap semua pihak bersedia dengan perubahan itu agar bersama-sama mengawal penularan Covid-19.

"Kerajaan negeri sangat menghargai komunikasi krisis yang lebih efektif dan konklusif melibatkan semua pihak.

KLANG – Kesusahan tiga beranak yang terpaksa tinggal di dalam bangsal berhampiran Stesen Keretapi Tanah Melayu (KTMB) di sini yang disiarkan Kosmo! semalam mendapat perhatian pelbagai pihak.

Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri Sungai Kandis, Mohd. Zawawi Ahmad Mughni, pihaknya sedang menyelaras bantuan terutama sebuah rumah agar S. Letchumi, 28, dan suaminya, M. Ngaraj, 38, dapat tinggal dengan selesa bersama enam anak mereka berusia enam hingga 15 tahun.

MPK: Motorists going against traffic flow on one-way Lorong Tingkat

MOTORISTS entering Lorong Tingkat's commercial area from Jalan Istana in Klang have been reminded that it is now a one-way street and not to drive against the flow of traffic.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) Engineering Department (Road and Bridges Section) engineer Azman Wahid said motorists should follow the new traffic direction to prevent accidents on the single carriage-way.

"Our department has put up one-way road signage and painted arrows on the road but some motorists are adamant and choose to drive against the flow of traffic."

"Motorists are going the opposite direction because they want a short cut," he said.

MPK turned Lorong Tingkat into a one-way 240m stretch, from its entrance at Jalan Istana until the Kriya Babaji Ashram.

At the Kriya Babaji Ashram, motorists can turn left to make a loop to return to Lorong Tingkat or turn right to exit into Jalan Tengku Kelana.

Azman carried out an assessment on the traffic movement at Lorong Tingkat and a discussion was held with Kuala Lumpur and Selangor Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry special task com-

mittee chairman NP Raman.

In the 45-minute feedback session, Raman said the council had put up a "no left turn" sign in front of Kriya Babaji Ashram.

"Motorists must be allowed to turn left to be able to make the loop into Jalan Istana and back into Lorong Tingkat.

"We must not inconvenience people coming into this tourist spot. Movement of traffic must be smooth," he said.

Raman added that a raised pedestrian walkway must be built at the exit point of Lorong Tingkat after the row of flower shops to prohibit vehicles from entering Lorong Tingkat from Jalan Tengku Kelana.

Azman and two assistant engineers, Shaharin Jamali and Azary Adnan, agreed with the proposal.

"Our workers will remove the 'no left turn' board and allow traffic to turn left and right."

"We will add more painted arrows on the road and use thermo-plastic road marking to paint the signs to improve visibility and make it safer at night," said Azman.

He said the reflective road markings were guide for drivers in what they could or could not do.

"Lorong Tingkat's one-way traffic movement will take effect from Oct 19 and council enforcement officers will monitor the situation," he said.

Mohd Zuki: Rotations, work-from-home to be used

PETALING JAYA: All government services will still be operational despite the conditional movement control order (MCO) which will come into effect 12.01am tomorrow, says Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Mohd Zuki Ali.

According to him, government services will function as usual with the civil service's adaption of the rotation system and by working from home on a case-by-case basis.

Mohd Zuki said every department head must abide by the Public Services Department circular dated May 2 with the reference code of JPA/SARAAN(S)256/6/31JLD.6(6).

"Department heads must also use their discretion and consideration wisely on this matter aside from ensuring all health and safety SOP are fully abided by, such as temper-

ature screening, social distancing, wearing a face mask and providing hand sanitisers.

"This implementation is also used in any areas where conditional MCO is enforced," he said in a statement issued yesterday.

Mohd Zuki also said the usage of online apps would be given a priority to minimise direct services such as counter services and meetings, which is in line with the social distancing practice.

"The National Security Council will issue detailed SOP at the soonest time possible," he added.

Following three-digit spikes in Covid-19 figures in recent days, the conditional MCO will be implemented in Sabah for 14 days beginning today till Oct 26.

Selangor, Putrajaya and Kuala Lumpur will also fall under the conditional MCO from 12.01am tomorrow to Oct 27.

The country has seen three-digit figures in daily Covid-19 infections since the Sabah state election concluded on Sept 26.

COASTAL areas in Selangor are on alert as authorities have been told to be ready to respond to floods that may occur due to the high tide phenomenon that has sea waves of 5.7m to 5.8m in the forecast from Oct 17 to 19.

Selangor infrastructure and public amenities, agriculture modernisation and agro-based industry committee chairman Izham Hashim said floods were possible if continuous rain coincided with high tide.

"Areas along Selangor's coast have been put on vigilant mode from Oct 17 when the forecast says tides will reach 5.7m at 6.11am, while on Oct 18, it is expected to hit 5.8m at 7.50am and on the final day, the tide will reach 5.7m at 7.27am," he said.

Izham added that five districts, namely Klang, Sepang, Kuala Langat, Kuala Selangor and Sabak Bernam, had been identified as high-risk areas for flooding if the phenomenon was accompanied by heavy rain and strong winds.

Port Klang assemblyman Azmizam Zaman Huri advised residents in high-risk areas to always follow the instructions from security authorities in the event of flash floods.

"In Kampung Telok Gong, Port Klang, the Drainage and Irrigation Department strengthened the bund that saw water rising above it in last month's high tide and some houses were inundated," he said.

Izham advised residents living close to the seaside and rivers to be vigilant and avoid boating activities, fishing trips and tours along the coastline.

On the high tide phenomenon expected to continue in November, the National Hydrographic Centre forecasts the tides on Nov 15 (at 5.44am) and Nov 16 (6.25am) to reach 5.6m.

"All district-level Fire and Rescue Department units, state Civil Defence Department and the Swift Action Taskforce (Pantas), which is a team that handles emergencies and disasters at local council level, will be on high alert," he said, adding that the Selangor government had raised the height of rock bunds and strengthened barriers at several locations.

Izham said that while the state government was confident that the bunds or embankments close to the sea and rivers would hold up, the authorities were on alert as certain low-lying areas were at risk of flooding.

He said high-risk areas in Klang, Sabak Bernam, Kuala Selangor, Kuala Langat and Sepang were on the Selangor Disaster Management Unit's high-risk flood list.

The areas on the list in Klang are Kampung Tok Muda, Kampung Sungai Pinang in Pulau Indah, Pandamaran, Taman Selatan

Damai, Port Klang, Kampung Sungai Serdang, Bund Sementa, Bund Sungai Keramat, Kampung Perepat, North Port, Telok Gong and Pulau Ketam.

In Sabak Bernam, the areas are Kampung Sungai Air Tawar, Bagan Sungai Besar, Tebuk Mendeleng, Pantai BNO, Sungai Lang, Pantai

In Sepang, the high risk flood areas are Persisir Pantai Bagan Lalang, Kampung Tanjung Rhu and Kampung Orang Asli Bagan Lalang.

Meanwhile, Fire and Rescue Department Sungai Pinang Station operations chief Bonny Martin Saging Mata said all 37 personnel with the station were on alert to face the high tide.

He said all stations in the district were well-equipped and prepared to handle any calamity.

"Our fire stations are equipped with boats, life jackets and utility vans, and are able to provide relief if flash floods occur," he said.

Bonny added that based on tide levels forecast, the water levels would be manageable and should not breach the bunds.

Meanwhile, Malaysian Red Crescent Klang District Emergency Respond Disaster chairman S. Thinesvaran said his team of 15 men were on standby to provide counselling therapy, psychological support and also to help in food preparation at evacuation centres if the need arose.

Exco: State govt still awaiting analysis results of water samples

SEREMBAN: The Negri Sembilan government is still awaiting the results of analyses of samples taken from the pollution source in Nilai, which had caused two Water Treatment Plants (WTP) in Selangor to suspend operations on Oct 4.

State Health, Environment, Cooperatives and Consumerism committee chairman S. Veerapan said to date the official results of

the analyses had not been received from the Chemistry Department.

"Usually, the results will be available within two weeks from the day the samples are sent to the Chemistry Department... but we, on the part of the State Department of Environment (DoE), have asked for the results to be released as soon as possible.

"Meanwhile, the DoE is still

conducting investigations around the premises at the illegal dumpsite," he told *Bernama* when asked about the results of analysis of water samples here, yesterday.

On Wednesday, Deputy Inspector-General of Police Datuk Seri Acryl Sani Abdullah Sani was quoted as saying that the police had arrested two men in their 30s and 40s, who were suspected of being involved in the pollution of Sungai Batang Benar, Nilai and Sungai Semenyih, Selangor, on Oct 6.

Acryl Sani said the two men were nabbed in Kota Baru, Kelantan while on their way back to Nilai.

On Oct 5, *Bernama* reported that the Environment and Water Ministry said waste and organic compounds found in the bushes on the fringe of the industrial area in Jalan Emas, Nilai Industrial Park were the source of pollution in Sungai Batang Benar.

The pollution caused two water treatment plants in Sungai Semenyih and Bukit Tampoi to halt

operations resulting in unscheduled water supply disruption to 309,687 consumer accounts in Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang.

On Friday, Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor)

chief executive officer Suhaimi Kamaraizamana was quoted as saying that water supply disruption in all 274 affected areas in Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat, Sepang and Putrajaya had been fully restored. *Bernama*

The heart of a new urban renewal concept

RETHINKING urban spaces can be the foundation of a new “common civics”. When I virtually met a designer and innovator, Weiee Ying, I was intrigued by his idea of “common civics”, a new approach to create healthier, happier and human-centric communities in Malaysia.

“Placemaking”, shares Weiee, “is the process of turning public spaces into community places. Instead of designing to only fulfil architecture needs and amenities, placemaking focuses on engaging with people who use the space to know how best to design for them — hence creating community life”.

We all know that Malaysia is heavily dependent on fossil-fuelled transportation where traditional cars instead of electric vehicles are predominant. People are used to lives dominated by an insane use of the cars. Their lives are literally driven by cars!

Over the last few months, I read articles and saw pictures of one of the unintended consequences of the pandemic-induced lockdown: the rethinking of urban spaces throughout the world.

Car-centric towns, like Milan

and Paris, have started rethinking their urban spaces, closing more and more roads to cars, creating more pedestrian spaces.

The same happened in metropolises, like New York City and Toronto, where new kilometres of new bicycle lines have been planned to respond to the Covid-19 emergency.

In Malaysia, such evolution and progress did not emerge strongly enough.

For example, Jeffrey Lim, a graphic designer, came up with the idea of creating a bicycle map of Kuala Lumpur and some parts of Petaling Jaya. The final product, completed in 2014, was the

result of a collaboration with people from different walks of lives.

It is true that some local councils made an effort to embrace a more bicycle-friendly vision, including the Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL), Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ), and in the past have shown an interest in creating the so-called “Cycleways” network but the commitment has been patchy at best and without long-term planning and a common vision.

To succeed, collaborations are essential. For example, Weiee recounts how Epic, a social innovation organisation, has been working in the past with the Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MP-SJ) to “create minimal interventions to test the validity of the park’s existence — and the finding was that the location was not at all suitable for a park since it is surrounded by main highways.”

The idea of “common civics” is about getting people to think about new urban solutions that could transform their lives for the better. It is not only about designing new prototypes on micromobility, a concept of which Weiee is very fond of. For example,

conceptualising new ways to improve the sidewalks’ experience or finding more healthy solutions to car movements.

At the foundation of this is a deep commitment to have people working together, most of the time donating their time, for a higher cause. It’s about dialogue and discussion and it’s also about partnerships. Transformational change will only happen if the government at all its levels is ready to be engaged and supports the process.

One of the cornerstones of design thinking that inspires much of this urban renewal work is the concept of prototyping, starting small and trying out a new solution that has been elaborated after cross-sector stakeholders’ discussions and deliberations.

Backing up financially such a working approach should not be an issue and some budget lines must be allocated nationally and locally to enable the best ideas to emerge through a “cross fertilisation-based” decision-making.

Ideas and best practices are certainly not lacking in Malaysia. For example, Think City, another citizens-led organisation, has the

mission of “making cities people-friendly and resilient by being a catalyst for change in the way cities are planned, curated, developed, and celebrated”. At its core is the idea of placemaking intended as a “way to improve the economic viability of a place and offer opportunities for building healthy, productive, resilient societies”.

Another example is Sedunia, a very interesting change making platform set up by Epic where new ideas and new actions emerge and are implemented collaboratively from urban regeneration to promotion of volunteerism.

The truth is that the underlying issues are very hard to tackle due to the incentives or a lack of that which are tied to their solutions, shares Weiee. We need political will and ability to execute transformative changes. Will the political class be up to the challenge?



CMCO for Selangor, KL, Putrajaya and Sabah

KUALA LUMPUR (Oct 13): More states have been placed under the Conditional Movement Control Order or CMCO, as new daily cases stubbornly remained above 300 since Oct 5.

The latest states and federal territories where CMCO will be imposed for two weeks are Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya and Selangor -- starting Oct 14 till Oct 27 -- and Sabah, from today till Oct 26.

Health Ministry director general Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah reported 563 new Covid-19 cases yesterday -- its second highest daily new cases recorded. This caused the number of active confirmed infections, which carry high transmission risks, to soar by 1,176 cases in four days to a new record high of 5,039 cases.

Senior Minister (Security Cluster) Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob said the decision to impose the CMCO on Selangor and KL was reached at a special National Security Council (MKN) meeting chaired by Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin yesterday, following advice from the Ministry of Health (MoH), amid rising infections in these states.

"More than 100 active districts will now be allowed. However, areas with more than five districts need to show a work pass or letter of approval by the employer," he said in a virtual media conference via the Ministry of Defence Facebook site, according to Bernama.

All schools, institutions of higher learning, kindergartens, nurseries, tafiz centres, police stations and residential centres will be closed and only two persons would be allowed from one household to go out to purchase necessities, he said.

Mosques, surau and non-Muslim houses of worship will also close, while all

sport, recreational, social and cultural activities as well as wedding and engagement ceremonies will not be allowed, the news agency reported. Entertainment centres and night clubs will also not be allowed, along with all forms of manufacturing activities in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya are still allowed to continue, said Ismail Sabri, adding that the list of further and detailed standard operating procedures (SOP) would be announced by MKN.

For the CMCO in Sabah, he was reportedly saying that wholesale and daily markets can only operate from 6am to 2pm; while stores selling necessities, convenience stores, sundry shops, restaurants, eateries, stalls can operate from 6am to 6pm and will be allowed to drive-through, delivery and takeaways.


Police stations, he said will also be allowed to operate from 6am to 6pm only, as will pharmacies and medicine stores, though government clinics and hospitals will be open for 24 hours. Taxi and e-hailing services, meanwhile, will be allowed to operate from 6am to 8pm, while express buses and public stage buses are not allowed to operate.

Fisheries, farming and agricultural sectors will remain to operate during the period, he said, while the business and manufacturing sectors, including the small and medium industries (SMIs), that plan to operate could seek approval from the Sabah State Disaster Management Committee.

On violations of defying the Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO), said police detained 617 individuals and from the total, 44 individuals were remanded while two were granted bail yesterday.

Among the highest offences reported are physical assault involving 239 individuals, not wearing face masks (178) and night club activities (105), Ismail Sabri added.

More CMCO as Covid-19 new cases remain high

KUALA Lumpur (KL), Selangor and Putrajaya will be placed under the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) for two weeks starting tomorrow.

Senior Minister (Security Cluster) Datuk Seri Ismail Yaakob said the decision was made upon the Ministry of Health's (MoH) advice following a spike in Covid-19 cases in several localities such as Klang, Petaling, Gombak and other districts.

"To curb the spread of the virus, the National Security Council (NSC) special meeting held yesterday has agreed to put Selangor, KL and Putrajaya under the CMCO effective midnight of Oct 14 until Oct 27," he said at a press conference yesterday.

However, Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari in a statement later yesterday described the announcement as "a shock" as only Klang, Gombak, Hulu Langat and some parts of Petaling had worrying numbers of cases.

"I had just chaired a meeting with the Selangor State Security Council, the Selangor Health Department, the police and other agencies on the implementation of the CMCO in Petaling.

"The state is of the opinion that areas in the green and yellow zones like Sabak Bernam and Kuala Selangor are still under control, therefore the state government will send some recommendations to the NSC immediately for them to reconsider."

Apart from Selangor and KL, the government has also decided to impose the CMCO on the entire state of Sabah from today until Oct 26.

Ismail Sabri said the CMCO throughout Sabah was recommended by the Sabah government representatives, besides MoH and NSC. Before this, only Tawau, Kunak, Semporna and some areas in Kota Kinabalu were put under the CMCO.

"However, the special NSC meeting chaired by Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin heard MoH's confirmation on the increasing positive cases in Sabah.

"Besides that, cross-district control has been implemented since Oct 3, in which only employees with an authorised employee card will be allowed to cross districts."

The senior minister also noted that those in the trade and manu-

faturing sectors, including small and medium industries must obtain permission from the Sabah Disaster Management Committee (SDMC) to operate.

The government also announced Felda Umus in Tawau will be placed under Enhanced MCO (EMCO) starting today until Oct 26, involving 800 households comprising 17,549 residents.

Under the EMCO, all residents will not be allowed to leave their houses and all entryways into the area will be closed.

For emergency cases, involving health or death, the residents may apply for approvals at nearby police stations.

The authorities will be conducting targeted screenings on all the residents, while the state govern-

ment will provide all necessities such as food and water.

Meanwhile, the police arrested 663 individuals on Oct 11 for violating the Recovery MCO (RMCO).

Ismail Sabri said the offences committed include not practicing physical distancing (239 cases), not wearing face masks (178), activities in entertainment centres (105) and premises failing to record customers' details (89).

Of the total arrests, 617 individuals were issued compounds, 44 remanded, while two others were granted bail.

The minister said the increase in the arrests and compounds showed that the police will no longer compromise with RMCO violators.

All govt services remain operational under CMCO

ALL government services will remain operational throughout the implementation of the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur (KL) and Putrajaya from Oct 14 to Oct 27, said Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Mohd Zuki Ali.

In a statement, Mohd Zuki said

civil servants will adapt to a rotation system and work from home, based on the requirement.

He said heads of departments are required to comply with the Public Service Department Circular "JPA. SARAN (S) 256/6 / 3JLD.6 (6)" dated May 2, 2020, for the purpose, and use their discretion and due consideration in the best interest of

their staff's health and welfare.

They should also ensure all safety and health standard operating procedures (SOPs) are fully complied with such as performing body temperature screening, practising physical distancing, and using face masks and sanitisers.

"This will also apply to any other areas declared as being

under the CMCO," he said.

Mohd Zuki said online applications should also be prioritised to minimise physical presence at offices or over-the-counter services.

He added that the National Security Council (NSC) would be issuing more detailed SOPs in the future.

Senior Minister (Security Clus-

ter) Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob yesterday said the Special NSC Meeting agreed to implement the CMCO in Selangor, KL and Putrajaya after receiving advice from the Ministry of Health and taking into account the increase in the number of Covid-19 cases in districts such as Klang, Petaling and Gombak. — Bernama

Health DG: CMCO a proactive move

AS COVID-19 infections in the Klang Valley can no longer be curbed with the current standard operating procedures, the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) is the way to go, Health DG Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdul-lah said.

In his Covid-19 briefing yesterday, he said the CMCO is a more proactive and effective action, especially in ensuring that the country's public health is taken care of.

"For Selangor, Kuala Lumpur (KL) and Putrajaya, although less than 100 cases are being recorded daily, they consistently record new cases every day. The cases are scattered in the Klang Valley and starting to spread in all districts except for Sabak Bernam.

"We can no longer just look and wait for the yellow zones to turn red to implement the CMCO. We

must understand that risk assessment depends on an area and is not only based on the number of daily positive cases, but also the pattern of transmission of the infection," he said.

He also reiterated that employers are encouraged to send their employees for screening from time to time, especially for sectors that involve interactions with the community such as shopping malls.

Meanwhile, Dr Noor Hisham said a total of 522 members of various categories and health workers have been sent to Tawau, Lahad Datu, Semporna and Kota Kinabalu, Sabah.

He added that in the future, the Health Ministry (MoH) will send 11 more medical experts, namely three clinicians and eight physicians.

"The ministry also calls on more health medical volunteers to assist the ministry in tackling the third wave of Covid-19.

"Coordination will be carried out by the Crisis Preparedness and Response Centre, and those who are interested and qualified can email to mobilasasi9@gmail.com or

cprc@moh.gov.my," he said.

On the topic of personal protective equipment (PPE) supply to accommodate frontliners in the country, the health DG noted that

preliminary planning has been made and that PPE stock is closely monitored at all levels.

Yesterday, MoH recorded 563 new positive cases, of which only one case was imported.

Sabah continued to record the highest cases at 291, mainly due to the large-scale health screening conducted in the targeted areas.

Penang came in the second spot with 141 cases — all from the Penang Remand prison — followed by Selangor with 69 cases and KL with 28.

Two more deaths were reported in Sabah, bringing the total tally to 159. However, 109 recoveries were recorded, bringing the total recovery cases to 11,022, or 67.95% of total Covid-19 cases in Malaysia, to date.

Six new clusters were identified, namely two in KL and one each in Sabah, Selangor, Johor and Putrajaya.

员，尤其是对中小型工商业者造成影响。

仁嘉隆华小今午接获雪州教育局发出指示，要求学校关闭7天，即从即日起关闭至本月18日，本月19日（周一）恢复上课。

万津州议员刘永山接受《东方日报》记者电话访问时指出，县卫生局今日已派出医护人员，协助师生进行新冠筛检；根据县卫生局提供的名单，共有80名师生，因曾直接接触过该名学生，而需要接受新冠检测。

「据我了解，相关的学生并没出现任何症状，在等待学生的筛检报告出炉之前，校方不敢掉以轻心；校方目前不仅已在全校进行消毒，县卫生局今日也为相关的师生进行新冠筛检。」据悉，仁嘉隆华小的确诊学生，已于10月7日送往双溪毛糯医院进行检测，检测报告于今日出炉。

与此同时，在雪州沙登二校，一名五年级的学生也确诊冠病，这名学生据悉是早前确诊的斯里肯邦安国中二年级的弟弟。

沙登二校在接获卫生局报告后已向全体学生家长发出通告，根据有关通告，该校的一名四年级学生的检测结果为阴性，不过另一名五年级学生的检测则是阳性。

随着有关五年级学生确诊，他在课后前往的史里肯邦安怡观园的学习中心同样遵守卫生部防疫程序，关闭中心进行消毒，并在等待卫生局进一步指示后才重开。
