PKPB di Klang sebelum ini terbatal

Kuala Lumpur: Prosedur operasi standard (SOP) Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) yang diumumkan khusus untuk mukim Klang sebelum ini, terbatal.

Menteri Kanan (Keselamatan), Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, berkata SOP itu terbatal berikutan pelaksanaan PKPB di Selangor, bermula semalam.

"Disebabkan kerajaan sudah mengumumkan PKPB di seluruh Selangor, maka SOP yang diumumkan untuk mukim Klang terbatal," katanya semalam.

Mukim Klang dikenakan PKPB lebih awal, iaitu bermula 9 Oktober lalu, susulan peningkatan kes COVID-19 di daerah berkenaan.

Mengenai solat Jumaat dan solat jemaah di masjid serta surau di Selangor, Kuala Lumpur serta Putrajaya yang dikenakan PKPB, Ismail Sabri berkata, hal itu akan dimaklumkan pihak berkuasa agama dalam masa terdekat.

Sementara itu, beliau memak-

lumkan, sehingga semalam, sebanyak 273 kertas siasatan berhubung berita palsu berkaitan COVID-19 dibuka Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) dan Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia (SKMM).

Katanya, daripada jumlah itu, 136 kes masih dalam siasatan, 35



"Sebanyak 390 penafian dan penjelasan mengenai berita palsu diperjelas kepada orang ramai oleh Pasukan Respon Pantas (PRP), Kementerian Komunikasi dan Multimedia yang ditubuhkan bagi membantu membendung penyebaran berita palsu berkaitan COVID-19," katanya.

Ismail Sabri berkata, orang ramai mestи berhati-hati sebelum menyebarkan kandungan yang diragui kesahihannya dan sentiasa menyemak terlebih dahulu kesahihan berita daripada sumber yang rasmi atau boleh dipercaya.

"Perkara yang belum tentu sahih, jika kita turut sebarkan dan didapati tidak benar, anda juga boleh dikenakan tindakan."

"Jika ada berita yang diragui kesahihannya, anda boleh menyalurkan maklumat kepada PRP di talian 03-8911 5103 atau layari laman web www.sebenarnya.my untuk menyemak kesahihan berita itu," katanya.

Rakyat digesa elak pembelian panik



Kuala Lumpur: Rakyat diingatkan supaya mengelak pembelian panik, susulan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) di Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Putrajaya dan Sabah.

Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Hal Ehwal Pengguna, Datuk Seri Alexander Nanta Linggi, berkata bekalan barang terutama makana dan keperluan utama dijamin mencukupi pada harga stabil serta munasabah.

Katanya, bekalan makanan tidak terputus ketika Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) dilaksanakan di seluruh negara bermula pertengahan Mac lalu.

"Kita minta rakyat Malaysia bertenang dan tidak membuat pembelian panik. Kementerian mempunyai 2,269 anggota penguat kuasa di seluruh negara, yang sentiasa memantau dan memeriksa bagi memastikan bekalan makanan mencukupi.

"Semua pengilang, pengeluar, pemborong dan peruncit perlu memastikan stok bekalan mencukupi dalam menjamin permintaan pengguna. Atas dasar ini, beli apa yang perlu sahaja dan bukan didorong panik hingga menyimpan stok berlebihan," katanya dalam kenyataan di sini, semalam.

Jika pengguna mendapati ada peniaga yang tidak mematuhi undang-undang, mereka boleh menyalurkan aduan kepada KPDNHEP melalui portal e-aduan@kpdnhep.gov.my, menghubungi call centre di talian 1800 886 800 atau e-mel kepada e-aduan@kpdnhep.gov.my, katanya.

Aduan juga boleh disalurkan melalui aplikasi telefon pintar Ez ADU, dengan menghubungi enforcement command centre (ECC) di talian telefon 03-8882 6245 / 6088 atau talian telefon Malaysia Government Call Centre (MYGCC) di nombor 03-8000 8000 atau WhatsApp ke 019- 279 4317.

Sementara itu, Presiden Persatuan Penggunting Rambut Bumiputeria Malaysia (MBBA), TN Win-

da Mohd Tahir, meminta penjelasan daripada kerajaan sama kedai gunting di kawasan PKPB Selangor, Putrajaya, Kuala Lumpur dan Sabah dibenarkan operasi atau sebaliknya.

Beliau berkata, pihaknya masih tidak mendapat maklumat tepat sama ada boleh beroperasi atau tidak sepanjang PKPB itu.

"Kita ada menghubungi Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) dan dimaklumkan perlu mendapatkan kebenaran pihak berkusa tempatan (PBT).

Sebelah ini, kami tidak perlu mendapatkan kebenaran daripada PBT dan maklumat MKN menyatakan semua perniagaan dan kegiatan ekonomi dibenarkan.

"Melalui maklumat melalui sidang media Menteri Kanan (Keselamatan), Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakub hanya dinyatakan aktiviti sosial dan perniagaan seperti bar dan kelab malam serta taman tema tidak dibenarkan beroperasi tidak termasuk kedai gunting rambut dan salun. Justeru, kami mahukan penjelasan lanjut mengenai kerana ramai ahli kita masih kabur dan keliru dengan perkara ini," katanya kepada BH, semalam.

Sementara itu, Pengarah Jabatan Agama Islam Selangor (JAIS), Mohd Shahzihan Ahmad, berkata pihaknya menangguhkan solat Jumaat solat lima waktu berjemaah dan aktiviti keagamaan lain di seluruh masjid serta surau di Selangor sepanjang tempoh PKPB di Selangor, mulai semalam hingga 27 Oktober ini.

"Penangguhan ini akan membabitkan 425 masjid, 278 surau kebenaran solat Jumaat dan 1,747 surau. Tindakan penangguhan ini diatur selaras dengan penguatkuasaan PKPB di Selangor bagi mengekang penularan kes COVID-19 yang membimbangkan daripada tarus menukar dalam kalangan manusia di Selangor.

"Keputusan ini selari hasrat JAIS dalam memastikan pentadbiran masjid dan surau di Selangor dapat

Mohd Shahzihan berkata, pentadbiran masjid dan surau seluruh Selangor juga diminta memastikan solat Jumaat tidak dilaksanakan sepanjang penangguhan ini, sebaliknya digantikan dengan solat Zuhur di kediaman masing-masing, manakala solat fardhu berjemaah lima waktu hendaklah dilaksanakan dengan had bilangan jemaah tidak melebihi tiga orang sahaja, manakala azan hendaklah diumandangkan pada setiap waktu.

"Aktiviti pengimaranan seperti kuliah Magrib, kuliah Subuh dan kuliah Duha serta aktiviti agama lain juga hendaklah ditangguhkan buat sementara, berkuat kuasa pada waktu Subuh hari ini (semalam)," katanya.

LUAS berjaya sekat tumpahan minyak

Kuala Selangor: Sebuah lori konkrit terbabas sebelum memasuki parit yang mengalir ke Sungai Selangor di Jalan Kolam KL-Larut, Bestari Jaya, semalam.

Kemalangan kira-kira jam 10 pagi itu, turut menyebabkan berlaku tumpahan minyak dari kenderaan berat terbabit.

Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (LUAS) berkata, pihaknya bertindak pantas dengan meletakkan lapan 'oil boom' dan 10 'absorbent pad' di aliran air di lokasi kemalangan hingga minyak berjaya diperangkap.

"Tindakan itu bagi menghalang tumpahan (minyak) dari

lori mengalir ke Sungai Selangor.

"Kerja pembersihan dan pengalihan dilakukan syarikat lori konkrit terbabit," katanya menerusi pengumuman di Facebook, semalam.

Menurut LUAS, pihaknya melakukan persampelan di lokasi kemalangan dan selepas lokasi kemalangan.

Katanya, Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn Bhd (Air Selangor), Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) Selangor dan Majlis Daerah Kuala Selangor (MDKS) turut membantu menjalankan pemantauan dan siasatan bagi menangani insiden berkenaan agar tiada

berlaku pencemaran sungai.

"LUAS akan meneruskan pemantauan dari masa ke semasa sehingga kerja pembersihan dan kerja menyedut minyak selesai di alur air itu.

"Sehingga jam 3.40 petang, kerja-kerja pengalihan lori se-

lesai dan kerja-kerja (pembersihan dan menyedut minyak) masih diteruskan" katanya.

Katanya, tindakan itu terbaik berjaya mengelak daripada henti tugas Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) dan gangguan bekalan air kepada pengguna.

Batalkan penyahwartaan hutan simpan

SAUDARA PENGARANG.

CADANGAN kerajaan negeri Selangor untuk melakukan penyahwartaan Hutan Simpan Kuala Langat Utara (HSKLU) akan membebaskan 5.5 juta tan karbon dioksida yang menyumbang kepada krisis iklim.


Ketika ini, HSKLU bertindak sebagai penapis untuk udara tercemar yang ditiup angin barat daya (Mei-September) setiap tahun dari pusat perindustrian di barat HSKLU ke arah Lembah Klang. Tanpa HSKLU, udara tercemar akan sampai kepada penduduk Lembah Klang dan meningkatkan masalah kesihatan.

Kebanyakan rakyat Selangor yang tidak mampu ke hospital swasta akan berpusu-pusu ke hospital kerajaan. Dalam jangka masa pendek, ini akan memberikan tekanan terhadap infrastruktur kesihatan awam serta menurunkan produktiviti negeri.

Dalam pada itu, terdapat kemusyikilan cadangan kerajaan Selangor mengenai lokasi di Sabak Bernam yang bertujuan menggantikan hutan simpan berkenaan.

Ini berikutan Kementerian Tenaga, Sains, Teknologi, Alam Sekitar dan Perubahan Iklim sebelum ini mengeluarkan surat kebenaran pada 11 Disember 2019 yang membenarkan pembukaan ladang kelapa sawit di kawasan sama.

Selain itu, tidak wujud keperluan pembangunan bercampur di tapak HSKLU kerana berdasarkan Pusat Maklumat Harta Tanah Negara (NAPIC), Selangor dan Kuala Lumpur memiliki 30 peratus daripada jumlah

rumah yang tidak terjual di Malaysia pada 2019.

Sementara itu, ruang pejabat tanpa penghuni ialah 23.5 peratus pada tahun sama. Kadar ini dijangka meningkat dengan budaya kerja dari rumah dan pembinaan bangunan pencakar langit baharu di Kuala Lumpur.

Berdasarkan statistik Jabatan Perangkaan, kadar pertumbuhan penduduk di Selangor pada 2019 hanya kira-kira 0.8 peratus. Oleh itu, kerajaan negeri perlu membatalkan pembangunan bercampur di tapak HSKLU dan mewartakannya sebagai hutan adat Orang Asli Temuan.

Pelaburan langsung asing (FDI) berjumlah sekurang-kurangnya RM8 bilion yang dijangka direkodkan negeri Selangor pada tahun ini masih baik meskipun ia mungkin susut sehingga separuh berbanding angka 2019.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Tetap Pelaburan, Industri & Perdagangan dan Perusahaan Kecil & Sederhana (PKS) Selangor, Datuk Teng Chang Khim berkata, berdasarkan laporan Lembaga Pembangunan Pelaburan Malaysia (Mida) yang diperolehnya dua hari lalu, sejumlah RM3.3 bilion nilai pelaburan sudah diluluskan untuk negeri itu setakat 30 Jun lalu bagi tahun ini.

"Pada 2018 kita (Selangor) merekodkan FDI bernilai RM18.9 bilion, angka tertinggi dicatatkan dalam tempoh lima tahun diikuti tahun lalu kedua tertinggi iaitu RM17 bilion.

"Untuk tahun ini, kita mempunyai kira-kira RM5

billion lagi pelaburan yang masih dalam proses mendapatkan kelulusan dan tentunya kita percaya kesemuanya akan diluluskan menjelang akhir tahun ini.

"Jika ini berlaku, sekurang-kurangnya RM8 bilion nilai FDI akan direkodkan di Selangor di mana saya fikir sudah cukup bertuah untuk kami mencatatkan jumlah ini apabila melihat bagaimana Covid-19 dan pelaksanaan PKP memberi impak kepada ekonomi seluruh dunia sejak awal tahun ini," katanya pada sidang media yang diadakan secara maya

sempena pelancaran Selangor International Business Summit, semalam.

Mengulas mengenai Belanjawan 2021 untuk pemuliharaan ekonomi, Teng berpendapat perlunya ditambah baik susulan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) di Kuala Lumpur, Selangor dan Putrajaya bermula semalam.

KUALA LUMPUR - Susulan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB) di seluruh negeri Selangor berkuat kuasa semalam, prosedur operasi standard (SOP) PKPB di mukim Klang yang diumumkan sebelum ini adalah terbatal.

Menteri Kanan (Keselamatan), Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob berkata, oleh kerana kerajaan telah mengumumkan PKPB seluruh Selangor dan Klang termasuk dalam Selangor, maka SOP yang diumumkan untuk mukim Klang secara automatik adalah terbatal.

“Oleh itu, SOP PKPB seluruh Selangor terpakai juga bagi mukim Klang,” katanya pada sidang akhbar secara maya menerusi Facebook Kementerian Pertahanan semalam.

Mengenai penyebaran berita palsu berkaitan Covid-19, beliau berkata, setakat semalam, sebanyak 273 kertas siasatan telah dibuka oleh Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) serta Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (MCMC).

Beliau berkata, sebanyak 136 kes masih dalam siasatan, 35 kes telah didakwa di mahkamah, 21 didapati bersalah, 13 dalam proses perbicaraan dan 12 diberikan notis amaran.

KUALA SELANGOR - Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (LUAS) mengambil tindakan pantas memasang *oil-boom* dan *absorben* pada bagi menghalang tumpahan minyak dari mengalir ke Sungai Selangor berikutan kejadian lori konkrit terbantas memasuki kawasan alur Kolam KL-Larut di Bestari Jaya di sini pagi semalam.

LUAS yang memuat naik kenyataan di Facebook memaklumkan, aduan mengenai kejadian itu diterima pada jam 10 pagi dan kerja-kerja

pembersihan serta pengalihan lori telah dilakukan oleh syarikat lori terbabit.

"LUAS akan meneruskan pemantauan dari masa ke masa sehingga kerja-kerja pembersihan di alur air tersebut selesai.

"Setakat jam 3.40 petang tadi (semalam), kerja-kerja pengalihan lori konkrit tersebut telah selesai namun kerja-kerja pembersihan dan proses menyedut minyak masih dijalankan," kata kenyataan itu.

Clarity on travel restrictions needed

Many commuters still confused on where they can and cannot go

PETALING JAYA: Inter-district and interstate travel restrictions announced for the conditional movement control order (MCO) in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya have left many people with questions.

Commuters asked whether they were allowed to travel within the conditional MCO zones, and on the status of interstate passengers travelling in and out of the affected areas.

The National Safety Council (MKN) stated that travelling inter-district and interstate would be allowed for work purposes only.

They would have to show proof with their employers' authorisation letter and work pass.

Police permit is required for interstate travel only for the purpose of medical emergencies, death and flying out of the three airports in the Klang Valley, namely Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), KLIA2 and the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport in Subang.

Prasarana Malaysia Bhd media affairs head Azhar Ghazali said there had yet to be specific instructions to check passengers for employers' letters when using RapidKL services to travel within the zones.

"The start of the conditional MCO did not affect the use of our services that much."

"Our service and frequency of rides are running as per normal," he said.

On travel within the conditional MCO zones, Azhar said it was permitted for work and there was no need for police consent to do so.

"For example, if you live in Banting but work in Putrajaya, there is no need to get

police consent.

"Inter-district travel is allowed," he added.

Pan Malaysia Bus Operators Association president Datuk Mohamad Ashfar Ali said although express and stage buses were free to operate, they and their passengers were bound by standard operating procedures.

"For example, passengers on interstate express buses leaving, coming into or passing through the said zones must apply for permission from the police before travelling," he said yesterday.

As for stage buses within the affected conditional MCO zones, he said passengers only

need to show a letter from their employers.

On Monday, Transport Minister Datuk Seri Dr Wee Ka Siong said all land (including buses, city buses, taxi and e-hailing services), air and sea (except for cruise ships/holiday cruise ships) public transportation services were allowed to operate as usual provided they strictly complied with the SOP set by MKN.

Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya have been placed under conditional MCO for 14 days from Oct 14 to Oct 27 following a recent spike in Covid-19 cases.

A spokesman from Keretapi Tanah Melayu



Berhad (KTMB) said passengers were allowed to travel by train both inter-district and interstate subject to the conditions announced by the authorities.

"If they are travelling from one district to another under the conditional MCO for work, then they will have to get a letter from their employer.

"Those travelling interstate to and from the affected districts must get police consent," he said.

He said displays had been put up at KTMB stations to remind passengers of this.

However, he added that KTMB did not have the power to check passengers for the required documents to travel.

"Passengers will have to produce their letters if the police come aboard to check," the spokesperson added.

PLUS Malaysia Bhd Corporate, Community and Public Engagement head Syed Mohamed Idid said there was no spike in traffic volume along the highways following the enforcement of the conditional MCO.

"Traffic is calm and there was no exodus from the districts under the order," he said.

He added that police had set up roadblocks at nine critical toll plazas on PLUS highways namely Jalan Duta, Setia Alam, Shah Alam, Putra Mahkota, Sungai Buaya, Bukit Tagar, Bukit Beruntung, Lembah Beringin and Seafield.

MPK to use wooden piles in reinforcing drains behind houses

WOODEN piles can be used as temporary reinforcement behind 18 houses at Lintang Besi in Taman Melawis, Klang where an eroded earth drain caused cracks to house walls and water seepage. Klang Municipal Council (MPK) Engineering Department (road and bridges section) engineer Azman Wahid said it was a practical solution as an immediate short-term remedial measure while the council waited for the required approval and budget to build a concrete U-drain.

"Verification of the status of the strip of land behind the houses will take weeks while the project approval and budget will take months," he said.

Azman added that if there were no hitches in the land status, the project could be slated for middle of next year.

On Oct 5, *StarMetro* reported

that homeowners urged the council to upgrade the earth drain to a concrete U-drain, to overcome erosion behind their houses.

Complaints of erosion were lodged with MPK numerous times since the mid-1980s as homeowners had noticed that the original one-metre width of the earth drain had widened to 1.5m.

In 2004, residents in the area brought up the issue to MPK as the earth drain widened to a width of 3.5m.

The technical team installed a double stack of old motorcycle tyres to have the soil retained on-site and address the erosion but it was unsuccessful.

On Wednesday, Azman and two council assistant engineers Shaharin Jamali and Azary Adnan visited the site to get a first-hand understanding of the eroded earth drain.

Resident Ungku Aris Abdul Masjid, 73, said the gradual erosion of the earth drain affected the

houses, with cracks that allowed water to seep into the back portion of their properties during floods.

"Our houses were built in 1969 with a scupper drain at the back, but it is now broken while some stretches are covered with earth.

"Surface run-off and water from the houses flow into the

earth drain.

"It has been like this for decades," he said.

Another resident, Darshan Kaur, 60, said the gradual erosion had caused cracks in her car porch.

"Worse still, water seeps into the living room through cracks along the wall's skirting during rain.

"I have topped up the soil on the

side of my house many times but water still rises up to the ankles along the outer wall," she said.

Resident Hazril Abdul Rahman, 50, said MPK's suggestion to use wooden piles was practical to lessen the ongoing erosion to some extent as it would take time for the concrete U-drain project to start.

Enforce targeted enhanced MCO here like in Sabah, says academy

PETALING JAYA: The Academy of Medicine of Malaysia (AMM) has urged the government to enforce a targeted enhanced movement control order (MCO) in Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya and Selangor rather than a statewide conditional MCO.

As of Oct 12, two of the nine districts in Selangor were green zones, with six of them being yellow zones. Within those six yellow zone districts, 26 out of 41 subdistricts do not have any active Covid-19 cases.

"We recognise that as the economic centre of the country, the Klang Valley is densely populated, which makes it difficult to draw boundaries for enforcing a targeted enhanced MCO but the government must not jeopardise the livelihoods of Malaysians in Selangor's green zones," said AMM in a statement.

AMM, a registered body representing medical specialists in Malaysia, said the government should issue guidelines that were consistent.

"Certain red zones in Sabah have been under targeted enhanced MCO since Sept 28, while the same was enacted in Klang, Selangor on Oct 9.

"That same day, it was announced that weddings would be allowed in these areas on the condition that they comply with the standard operating procedure (SOP).

"This is counterproductive to the targeted enhanced MCO's aim of containing the spread of the virus.

"However, as of the Oct 12

announcement of a statewide conditional MCO, weddings are no longer allowed," said AMM.

"These guidelines must also be communicated clearly and in detail to the public to minimise confusion and ensure maximum compliance," said AMM, which also argued that all future MCOs must not prevent the public from enjoying outdoor activities.

"Outdoor activities are important for maintaining both mental and physical health during the pandemic. A global survey on Covid-19's impact on people's behaviour found that 44% of Malaysians felt their mental wellness declined, while 56% of Malaysians reported having done less physical activity during

the MCO period.

"The outdoors are relatively low-risk settings for virus spread and studies have found that natural environments are beneficial for one's mental health. Moreover, we must strike a balance between battling Covid-19 and non-communicable diseases, such as diabetes and hypertension, which are also prevalent in our population.

"Team sports can be put on hold but Malaysians must be given flexibility to maintain their mental and physical health by going outdoors," said AMM.

AMM, while acknowledging that the government has been trying to balance livelihoods with fighting a pandemic since businesses and

public life reopened in June, noted that the national unemployment rate reached a record high of 5.3% in May following the first MCO on March 18.

"This number went down to 4.9% the following month as the country transitioned into recovery MCO. This progress must not be undone with the reintroduction of the conditional MCO in the entire Klang Valley and Sabah.

"Despite the government's efforts to minimise economic impact by allowing many businesses to remain open, it is SMEs, low-income and vulnerable groups who have yet to recover from the first MCO that will likely be most affected," it said.

Klang to follow SOP applied in Selangor

PUTRAJAYA: The subdistrict of Klang will now observe the standard operating procedure applied for the entire state of Selangor, which has also come under conditional movement control order (MCO) effective yesterday.

Senior Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob said the earlier SOP for the subdistrict, which was placed under the conditional (MCO) on Oct 9, had been cancelled.

"The SOP for Selangor is now applied to those in the Klang subdistrict," he said.

Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya are under the conditional MCO until Oct 27.

Following that, the government provided a list of dos and don'ts for those residing in the three areas.

Ismail Sabri also said three individuals were arrested for refusing to be tested for Covid-19, adding that they were among 284 people detained on Tuesday for various violations of the recovery MCO.

"The majority of the offenders – 134 people – were booked for not

masking up while in crowded public areas.

"The police also arrested a driver for ferrying passengers above the permitted number," he said.

Ismail Sabri added that the task force monitoring SOP compliance would continue to check on businesses.

On another matter, he said 12,877 illegals had been arrested in Sabah since January and slightly less than half of them were still in various detention centres.

Presenting a report by the

enforcement authorities on undocumented foreigners in Sabah, Ismail Sabri said 5,204 who were currently being held in detention centres included 4,456 Philippine nationals, 618 Indonesians and 130 foreigners from other countries.

"We have sent 7,673 back to their respective countries," he said.

Food operators in PJ follow SOP strictly during conditional MCO

FOOD operators in SS2 in Petaling Jay are ready to serve customers in a safe manner during the conditional movement control order (MCO).

This includes adhering to the standard operating procedures (SOP) during the two-week period, until Oct 27.

"Until noon on Tuesday, we were unsure if we could operate," said Beer Factory restaurant general manager Wong Yuen Heng.

"When it was announced that dining in was allowed, it was a big relief."

"Many food operators here checked with the local authorities as well following the announcement by Senior Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob that restaurants, food stalls, food trucks, kiosks, food courts, roadside hawkers, convenience and grocery stores can open for business from 6am to 10pm during the conditional MCO.

"We decided to stay open only after the local council and police

gave us the green light," said Yuen Heng.

Checks showed that food outlets had rearranged the layout in their premises to adhere to the SOP when allowing customers in.

At the SS2 Selera Malam food court, western food hawker Wong Kok Wai said he and other hawkers had marked some 100 tables here.

"We have identified seats and tables that can be occupied by customers.

"We have placed an 'X' using tape across tables and chairs to make it clear that no one can sit here," said Kok Wai.

Over at Medan Selera MBPJ, mixed rice stall operator Roslan Baharun said he had made sure there were enough tables and chairs set out for his lunchtime

customers.

"I do not have to put markings as my customers know what to do. The SOP is not new to them.

"When I reopened in May after the initial conditional MCO, it was already stipulated that physical distancing was a must and my regulars followed this strictly," said Roslan.

Durian seller Cheong Yaw Chay said for customers' comfort, tables to accommodate groups of four people in addition to tables for two had been set up.

"I have placed extra tables in between these, marked with an X.

"This way, although a group of friends or family is seated at different tables, they are still close

enough to chat with each other," said Cheong.

SS2 resident Jack Neo, who was having lunch with two friends at the food court, said the food operators had taken efforts to ensure the safety of customers.

"The seating arrangements limit and distance diners and this is a must during this period," said Neo.

SELANGOR TRIMS 2020 FDI TARGET TO RM8.5B

State awaiting Mida approval for another RM5b worth of investments by year end

SELANGOR has lowered its foreign direct investment (FDI) target to RM8.5 billion for this year due to the weaker global sentiment brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic.

State executive councillor Datuk Teng Chang Khim said approved investments in Selangor stood at RM3.3 billion as at June 30.

Selangor had previously set an FDI target of RM12 billion in five main sectors, including electrical and electronics (E&E), food and beverages (F&B) and machinery.

“However, we have about RM5 billion worth of investments that we hope will be approved by the Malaysian Investment Development Authority (Mida) by year end,” he said at a virtual press

conference after officiating the Selangor International Business Summit 2020 yesterday.

Teng, who is also chairman of standing committees for investment, industry and commerce and small and medium enterprises, said the state government would be satisfied with FDI of RM8.5 billion this year.

“With the three months of Movement Control Order (MCO) in March and the Conditional MCO for the whole of Selangor now, we do not know what lies beyond for now. We have also not set our investment target for next year,” he said.

Selangor had recorded the

highest FDI in 2018 at RM18.9 billion, and RM17 billion last year.

On the reinstatement of CMCO in Kuala Lumpur, Selangor and Putrajaya from now to Oct 27, he said Malaysia’s gross domestic product might shrink to -4.4 per cent growth this year.

“Fortunately, all businesses and economic activities are still allowed under the CMCO. I hope this will minimise the impact on the economy.”

Teng said Selangor would focus on the E&E, transport equipment, F&B, life sciences and machinery and equipment segments this year.

Meanwhile, it expects to organise the International Aviation Show next year to promote the aerospace sector in the state.

“We believe the sector will pick up once all international borders are reopened.”

SIBS could see RM60m transactions by going digital

➤ Selangor International Business Summit expected to draw 284 exhibitors from 12 countries to inaugural virtual event this year, despite pandemic

PETALING JAYA: Selangor International Business Summit (SIBS) inaugural virtual edition is expected to see approximately RM60 million in transaction value this year, according to Selangor Investment, Industry, Commerce and Small and Medium Enterprises senior executive councilor Datuk Teng Chang Khim.

However, he outlined that this is not a hard target for the summit, given the uncertainties that have swamped the global economy due to the pandemic which resulted in a transition from a physical to a virtual exhibition.

In its previous iterations, SIBS has

seen the transactional value gathering strength from RM82 million in its first edition in 2015 to RM247.3 million recorded in the previous year.

"Given that we only had three months to pivot to a virtual summit, which is uncharted territory, there are no hard targets for this year's edition though it is estimated to achieve roughly RM60 million, a third of the amount raised last year given that there was only a third of the time to prepare," Teng explained to the media at a virtual press conference.

This year, SIBS has attracted 284 exhibitors from 12 countries to its virtual summit compared to over 500 exhibitors it attracted in the previous year but it also sees a larger buyer turnout of 70 from 24 different countries.

He stated these numbers are an achievement with the change in format especially with the increase in the number of buyers.

"Our target is to promote this platform as a platform for international trade for Selangor, in which the state has targeted to be the global trading hub," said the state exco member.

On the investment front, the state has felt a pinch due to the weaker global sentiment as foreign direct investment stood RM3.3 billion as of end-June 2020, a far cry from the RM17 billion reported last year.

For the full year, Teng estimates the figures to improve to RM8.5 billion, as there are an estimated RM5 billion investments into the state awaiting the approval from Malaysian Investment Development Authority.

For 2021, he stated that Selangor has not set any investments target due to the economic uncertainties.

Meanwhile, the state exco member acknowledged that the imposition of the conditional movement control order will certainly have an impact on the state's economic performance.

He cited a report that estimated a 4.4% adjustment to Malaysia's GDP attributed to the containment measures imposed today in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Sabah but remain a prediction at this juncture.

"Of course in terms of economic activity the measures have affected our business which is unavoidable but we have to think about the long term. Although, the economic activities are still allowed to be carried out which I hope will minimise the impact on the economic development."

In regards to the state's aerospace ambitions, Teng is confident that the sector will take off once again after the international borders are open.

"We have to be very patient as this is an important and strategic industry for the world and Selangor is giving a lot of focus on the industry."

Towards this goal, he revealed that the state government is planning to organise an international aviation show next year to demonstrate its commitment and efforts towards the aerospace industry.

KUALA LUMPUR (Oct 14): The Ministry of Health (MoH) has detected a new Covid-19 cluster with 17 infections.

MoH director-general Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah said the new cluster is called Kencana.

The Kencana cluster of infections was identified in several areas including Hulu Langat, Petaling, Klang and Gombak in Selangor, Cheras in Kuala Lumpur, and Johor Bahru, Batu Pahat and Pontian in Johor.

"The index case (case no. 13,805) tested positive for the virus on Oct 7 through symptomatic screening and has been admitted to Sungai Buloh Hospital.

"Up until noon today, some 23 individuals have been screened, of whom four were negative and two more are waiting for results," said Noor Hisham at a virtual press conference.

MoH reported 660 new Covid-19 cases today, which lifted the number of active cases in the country to a new high of 5,768.

Sabah continues to report the highest number of cases, according to the MoH.

Of the 660 new confirmed infections, 429 cases are in Sabah, 113 cases are in Kedah with 109 infections related to the Tembok cluster, while 17 cases in Penang

are linked to Remand Prison cluster and Seberang Perai Prison cluster.

In Klang Valley, there are 68 new confirmed cases in Selangor, seven in Kuala Lumpur and one in Putrajaya.

Four new deaths were reported in Sabah, involving two men and two women, which brings the country's death toll to 167.

Noor Hisham noted that due to a spike in new Covid-19 cases as well as the rising number of clusters in Peninsular Malaysia, 52 health districts have turned into yellow zones, while 19 health districts have turned into red zones.

According to the ministry, red zones are health districts which have at least 41 active cases, while yellow zones have one to 40 cases.

KUALA LUMPUR (Oct 14): Selangor's investment arm, Invest Selangor Bhd, is now only expecting about RM8.5 billion worth of investments in the state for this year due to the Covid-19 pandemic, said state executive councillor Datuk Teng Chang Kim.

He noted that this would be much lower than Invest Selangor's initial target of RM12 billion announced earlier in the year.

Teng, who chairs Selangor's standing committees for investment, industry and commerce and small and medium enterprises (SMEs), said that as of June 30, the state managed to obtain RM3.3 billion worth of investments.

On top of that, Teng updated that there are RM5 billion worth of investments at hand for which the approval is still pending.

"So we believe that by the end of this year, there will be at least another RM5 billion of investments that will be approved, which means we expect to have about RM8.5 billion of investments approved for Selangor.

"If that is the case, I would say that we are quite fortunate, although it is much lower than last year.

"We should be satisfied [with this projection] in view of the [Covid-19] pan-

demic," he told a virtual press conference following the launch of the Selangor International Business Summit 2020 (SIBS 2020) today.

Last year, Selangor recorded total approved investments of RM17 billion. Meanwhile, in 2018, the state achieved its highest investment record in 25 years at RM18.9 billion.

Teng said Invest Selangor will continue to focus on its five targeted clusters of sectors, as outlined in the Selangor Industrial Master Plan, which are machinery, transportation, food and beverages (F&B),

life sciences, and electric and electronics (E&E).

SIBS 2020, launched by Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari, runs from today until Saturday (Oct 17). The business summit, which is being held virtually, brings together global brands and industry players from around the world to help businessmen reset and reboot while providing valuable knowledge sharing, networking and business matching for all trade visitors.

SIBS 2020 will continue to have three main components, which are the Selangor International Expo, Selangor Asean Business Conference and Selangor Smart City and Digital Economy Convention.

The four-day online sessions include two virtual expositions, webinars, live conferences, online networking and business matching opportunities.

Amirudin said: "Over the years, this administration has braved strong winds, and risen to the challenges to make Selangor the preferred destination to invest and do business in the region.

"Hence, the Covid-19 pandemic is just another challenge that we have to go through along the way and, God willing, we will be able to make it, with strong support from everyone," he said.

Selangor cuts investment target to RM8.5b

Only RM3.3b investments approved in 1H20 as Covid-19 wreaks havoc on sentiments worldwide

SELANGOR is expected to rake in only RM8.5 billion of foreign direct investment (FDIs) this year for its manufacturing sector, half of the RM17 billion achieved last year, in the wake of the weak global sentiment caused by the Covid-19 outbreak.

The main contributor to the country's GDP on an annual basis at 24%, Selangor had set to achieve RM12 billion of investments for 2020.

However, according to Selangor executive councillor Datuk Teng Chang Khim, only RM3.3 billion of investments were approved as of the first half of this year (1H20) based on the latest data from Malaysian Investment Development Authority (Mida).

"We have about RM5 billion pending investments that will be approved by Mida towards the end of the year.

+ "As such, the state government

would be satisfied with the investment of RM8.5 billion this year, despite the ongoing pandemic and a series of Movement Control Orders (MCOs) that may be ongoing for the next few months," Teng said at a virtual press conference after the virtual launch of the Selangor International Business Summit (SIBS) 2020.

In June, the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development forecasted that FDI flows are expected to plunge about 40% this year from the US\$1.54 trillion (RM6.55 trillion) registered in 2019. In Asia, FDIs are forecasted to fall

between 30% and 45% year-on-year.

Previously, Selangor set a target of RM12 billion FDI in five main sectors including electrical and electronics (E&E), food and beverages (F&B), and machinery.

"With the previous three months' MCO in place, and now the Conditional MCO (CMCO) for the whole state of Selangor, we do not know what lies beyond.

"We have not set our investment target for next year due to economic uncertainties," Teng added.

In 2018, Selangor recorded its highest FDI of RM18.9 billion.

Teng said due to the reinforcement of the CMCO in the Klang Valley — comprising Kuala Lumpur, Selangor and Putrajaya — from Oct 14 to 27, Malaysia's GDP might shrink by another 4.4% this year.

"Fortunately, this CMCO focuses on restrictions for activities rather than movement, where all business and economic activities can still be carried out.

"I hope this will minimise the impact on economic development."

Moving forward, Selangor will continue to focus on E&E, transport equipment, F&B, life sciences and machinery and equipment segments.

Next year, Teng said the government is expected to organise an international aviation show to promote the state's aerospace industry — which falls under the state transport equipment investment cluster.

The move, he said, is pertinent to ensure that Selangor is prepared to be part of the multibillion industry, which is now heavily affected by the pandemic.

"(About) 80% of aircraft are still grounded and this adversely affects the aerospace sector, but we believe it will pick up again when all international borders are open."

"Selangor is focused on the industry and hopefully, it will improve our results in enticing foreign investors," Teng said.

Selangor is home to about 65% of the total 230 aerospace players in Malaysia, from manufacturing to aircraft services.

The four-day SIBS 2020 has been shifted to a fully virtual platform in response to public health and travel safety concerns relating to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Last year, SIBS raked in RM447 million in business transaction value, including the RM200 million garnered from the Malaysia-China Entrepreneur Conference.

黄思汉说，雪州政府允许早市巴刹营业，但必须聘请志愿警卫人员驻守和维持秩序。

他说，国家安全理会所宣布的标准作业程序中，没有包括早市巴刹在内。

他指出，夜市一样可以营业，营业时间从下午4时至10时，但必须聘请志愿警卫人员驻守。

他说，在雪州的路边摊小贩可营业，但必须遵守标准作业程序。

此外，有不少网友非常关心在管制令期间，理发店是否可营业。黄思汉回应说，理发店可理发，但必须遵守标准作业程序，如果要理发最好是住在社区的理发店，越区若遇到警方路障，必须给予理由。

鼓勵改居家做業

他说，各行业营业时间则视什么行业而定，虽然大部分可营业至晚上10时，但相信很少会开这么夜。

对于是否可以40多个人在一间公司内上班，他说，国家安全理事会没说明这一点。

黄思汉强调，雪州各区食肆和餐馆等都可堂食，10人位的大桌子可坐5人。

黄思汉对对梳邦再也市议会作出食肆和餐馆等禁止堂食，解释说那只是项错误，梳邦再也市议会已做出纠正且允许食肆、餐馆等堂食。

他说，雪州允许堂食，但每张桌子只允许坐2人。

“所谓的2人只是小桌子，如果一般的10人可坐的大桌子可坐5人，但必须确保人与人之间必须保持距离。”

针对是否可跨县或跨州时，他说，如果是在雪州、吉隆坡和布城内工作，不需要向警方提呈申请，只需出示公司信函等证件。

他说，如果因为工作必

须到其他县或州则没问题，同样要出示公司信件，目前只是不允许没理由的跨州。

他说，如果有紧急事件或其他事件必须跨州或跨区，必须向要向警方取得特别准证。

“如其中一位网友在其他的大学念书，要回到雪州住家，就必须向警方申请准证。”

他说，如果是从蒲种去吉隆坡国际机场也被允许，但必须出示机票等证件。

他指出，由於目前是管制令期间，他不敢送飞机的活动，应尽量留在家，减少外出。

他说，保险代理也只需出示证明是公司保险代理证件，一样可去医院为顾客处理事务，或接见顾客等。



巴生36地區 商業運作須按新SOP

(巴生14日讯)巴生市议会主席阿末法兹里证实，巴生市议会辖下所有地区的商业运作，包括早前被列入巴生副县有条件行管令的36个地区，都以国家安全理事会最新公布的防疫标准作业程序(SOP)为准。

国安全会昨午公布的雪隆布城防疫SOP，包括各食肆允许每桌只限两人一桌的堂食、早夜市能够正常营业，惟需有更严格的防疫措施。

在上周五落实至本月22日的巴生副县有条件行管令，受影响的36个地区概括几乎所有巴生南区(巴生港口和绿林镇除外)的食肆都不能提供堂食，只能打



包和外送，早夜市也禁止营业。

国安全会宣布，雪兰莪、吉隆坡及布城从14日午夜12时起，进入为期14天的有条件行管令直到27日。

大臣公布防疫SOP

巴生社会工作者叶金发受访时指出，巴生南区一带的食肆业者，昨日获知国安全会的最新防疫指南后，在同业口耳相传下，武吉丁宜和圣淘沙一带的食肆业者，都自动自发跟随，今早都有提供每桌只限两人的堂食。

叶金发透露，昨日接获巴生市议会辖

下的所有早夜市都能运作，惟基于情况不明朗，许多早夜市暂时不运作，包括武吉丁宜早市、永安镇早市及池龙花园周三夜市等。

另一方面，雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁今日公布了州政府3项防疫SOP细节，分别是露天早市获准营业，其SOP与露天夜市相同；游乐场所设施和公园运动设施一律不准使用；非穆斯林可以注册结婚，惟参与者不能超过6人。

“雪州政府也决定巴生副县同步从本月14日至27日落实有条件行管令，取消较早前的有条件行管令。”(TTE)
