Selangor jamin pusat pemindahan mangsa banjir patuh SOP

Shah Alam: Kerajaan Selangor memberi jaminan bahawa pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS) disediakan untuk mangsa banjir susulan fenomena air laut pasang besar dijangka berlaku hujung minggu ini, akan mematuhi prosedur operasi standard (SOP) Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Bersyarat (PKPB).

Pegawai Operasi Unit Pengurusan Bencana Negeri (UPBN) Selangor, Muhammad Izzat Haziq Mohd Nazir, berkata aspek penjarakan fizikal, kebersihan dan susun atur khemah di pusat berkenaan akan turut dititikberatkan bagi mengekang penularan COVID-19.

"Contohnya jika sebelum ini, kira-kira 20 keluarga boleh di tempatkan di dalam sebuah dewan, mungkin kita akan mengurangkan jumlah itu untuk mewujudkan penjarakan fizikal dan susun atur khemah.

"Sebagai persediaan, jika ada lokasi yang jumlah mangsa banjirnya besar, Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) akan membuatkan pusat pemindahan lain berdekatan dengan dewan bagi mematuhi SOP penjarakan fizikal," katanya ketika dihubungi *BERNAMA*, semalam.

Muhammad Izzat Haziq berkata, UPBN Selangor mengenal pasti 21 pusat pemindahan di lima daerah untuk digunakan jika fenomena air pasang besar mengakibatkan banjir di kawasan berpenduduk di Klang, Kuala Langat, Sepang, Kuala Selangor dan Sabak Bernam.

Dalam pada itu, beliau berkata, ban dan benteng pantai yang terhakis akibat fenomena air laut pasang besar pada 19 serta 20 September lalu, sudah dibaik pulih oleh Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS).

Malah, katanya, beberapa benteng tambahan turut dibina, terutama di sekitar kawasan pantai di Kuala Selangor.

Beliau berkata, anggota UPBN Selangor sentiasa meninjau secara berkala di beberapa lokasi yang diramal dilanda fenomena air laut pasang besar, selain melakukan pemantauan menggunakan dron.

Orang ramai sekali gus dinasihati menjauhi kawasan pantai, bermula semalam, bagi mengelakkan kejadian tidak dingini.

Fenomena air pasang besar dengan ketinggian air laut boleh mencapai sehingga 5.8 meter, diramal melanda pesisir pantai di lima daerah di Selangor pada Sabtu hingga Isnin ini, serta 15 dan 16 November depan.



PENDUDUK sekitar Keramat beratur untuk mendapatkan bekalan air daripada pili yang disediakan oleh Pengurusan Air Selangor Sdn. Bhd. (Air Selangor) selepas LRA terpaksa dihentikan operasi, baru-baru ini.

SEPUT sahaja Selangor, teringat gangguan bekalan air melibatkan kira-kira dua juta pemegang akaun di sekitar Lembah Klang, baru-baru ini.

Itu bukan pertama kali berlaku. Sejak Jun 2019 sehingga September lalu, sebanyak sembilan insiden pencemaran direkodkan sehingga menyebabkan Loji Rawatan Air (LRA) terpaksa dihenti tugas. Antara puncanya, pembuangan sisa proses kilang minyak masak, premis tidak menguruskan pelarut minyak enjin terpakai dengan baik, aktiviti pengilangan besi, kolam ikan keli haram dan terbaru, kilang penyelegaraan jentera.

Bukan itu sahaja, pada 4 Oktober lalu, 309,687 akaun pengguna melibatkan 274 kawasan mengalami gangguan bekalan air berikutan aktiviti pembersihan sebuah ladang angsa yang terletak di Sungai Pajam, Negeri Sembilan sehingga henti tugas LRA Sungai Semenyih dan Bukit Tampoi.

Rata-rata pengguna mengeluh dan ada peniaga terpaksa mengeluarkan belanja tinggi berikutan gangguan bekalan air tidak berjadual.

Kerajaan negeri Selangor seharusnya sudah boleh bertindak lebih agresif dan tidak lagi sekadar mengesahkan pelaku-pelaku yang bertanggungjawab. Sebaliknya, bertindaklah dengan merobohkan rumah atau kilang haram berhampiran tebing sungai yang berpotensi melakukan

Sehingga kini, tiada maklumat daripada kerajaan negeri tentang kilang haram yang dirobohkan walaupun Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah

pernah menitahkan perkara tersebut dan menzahirkan rasa dukacita berhubung masalah gangguan bekalan air menerusi surat kepada Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari.

Sudah tiba masanya juga kerajaan negeri menyegerakan penggunaan meter khas bagi mengetahui jumlah pembuangan sisa-sisa kumbahan yang boleh menjasakan alam sekitar seperti dicadangkan oleh Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (LUAS).

Kaedah baru ini akan memudahkan pengesanan pihak yang terlibat dalam mencemaran sungai selain boleh mengetahui kuantiti pembuangan sisa dan setiap jumlah yang dilepaskan perlu dibayar oleh pemilik kilang.

Bak kata lirik lagu, *'Sudah Cukup Sudah yang dinyanyikan Nirwana Band - 'Sudah cukup, cukup sudah, cukup sampai di sini saja.'* Rakyat sudah muak dengan gangguan bekalan air apakah lagi pihak tidak bertanggungjawab bebas melakukannya dengan beroperasi sewenang-wenangnya walaupun tiada lesen.

KEPUTUSAN FATWA

Berdasarkan warta fatwa pada 17 September 2015, kerajaan negeri Selangor memutuskan bahawa ajaran Millah Abraham di negeri ini boleh dikenakan tindakan undang-undang.

- 1** Fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham adalah menyelwend dan bertentangan dengan ajaran Islam kerana mengandungi elemen berikut:
- Membawa ajaran dan kerajaan baru (Millah Abraham).
 - Mendakwah ada rasul selepas Nabi Muhammad SAW.
 - Mensyurik golongan yang tidak mengikuti ajaran Millah Abraham.
 - Menggabungkan tiga ajaran agama iaitu Islam, Kristian dan Yahudi.
 - Menyalahertikan maksud kiamat.
 - Memahami al-Quran mengikut tafsiran sendiri.
 - Tidak melaksanakan solat lima waktu dan solat Jumaat.
 - Taasub kepada ajaran sehingga sanggup memutuskan hubungan keluarga dan suami isteri.

2 Mana-mana orang Islam diharamkan berpegang kepada fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham termasuklah:

- Menjadi pengikut ajaran Millah Abraham atau apa-apa fahaman dan ajaran yang mempunyai persamaan dengan ajaran itu.
- Mengajar, mengajur, mengadakan membantu menjayakan apa-apa perayaan, sambutan kerian atau majlis yang boleh dikaitkan dengan fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham.
- Isytihar diri sebagai orang yang berpegang dengan fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham atau yang ada persamaan dengannya melalui pengakuan bersumpah atau apa juga kaedah.
- Berselindung di sebalik apa-apa aktiviti ekonomi, pemilagan, pendidikan, kesenian dan sebagainya melalui pertubuhan, persatuan atau syarikat yang mempunyai unsur persamaan

dengan ajaran, pegangan dan fahaman Millah Abraham.

- Cuba hidupkan kembali, mengamal dan menyebarkan fahaman serta ajaran Millah Abraham di Selangor.
- Memiliki, menyimpan, mencetak, menjual atau mengedarkan filem, rakaman, audio, risalah, buku majalah atau apa-apa terbitan sajai lambang, rajah atau tanda yang boleh mengalihkan fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham.
- Telah berbalah (taat setia) dengan fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham.

3 Mana-mana orang Islam yang telah berbalah atau mengamalkan fahaman dan ajaran Millah Abraham hendaklah segera bertaubat kepada ALLAH SWT.

4 Apa-apa variasi, versi, bentuk atau cabang mana-mana ajaran pegangan atau fahaman yang ada persamaan dengan Millah Abraham adalah beranggah dengan ajaran Islam yang sebenar.

5 Apa-apa bahan publisiti dan sebaran yang menonjolkan ajaran, pegangan atau fahaman Millah Abraham sama ada dalam bentuk penerbitan, cetakan atau siaran di laman web, blog, Facebook, Twitter atau media sosial lain adalah diharangkan.

6 Mana-mana orang Islam yang melakukan perkara di atas boleh diambil tindakan undang-undang yang berkua kuasa di negeri Selangor.

Umat Islam di Malaysia khususnya di Selangor perlulah berpegang dengan ajaran Ahl Sunah Wal Jamaah dan jauh dari terlibat dengan sebarang aktiviti yang disebutkan di atas.

Segera laporan segala aktiviti dan perlaku yang merugikan kepada pihak berkua agama bagi membendung penularan ajaran yang boleh merosakkan akidah, sariat serta akhlak umat Islam.

SUITED up in protective gear and strapped with a mist blower full of disinfectant, Klang Municipal Council's (MPK) Vector and Communicable Disease Control Unit workers are going all out to disinfect Covid-19 hotspots to stem the spread of the disease.

MPK's Health Department director Azmi Muji said an aggressive exercise to sanitise hotspots, especially walk-up residential units, schools, government facilities and even public transportation areas was being carried out daily.

"Selangor Health Department, with coordinated guidance from District Health Department, has sanitised 14 locations categorised as Covid-19 hotspots.

"Our men have sanitised the areas of Vista Indah Apartment, Jalan Batu Unjur, SMK Pendamaran Jaya, Pandamaran police station, Jalan Batu Nilam 15 flats, Jalan Gelang 8 in Bandar Puteri, Klang Jaya Apartment, SK Taman Sri Andalas, SJK(T) Ladang

Batu Ampat, Kampong Jawa, North Klang police headquarters, SRA Sementa, Lorong Seri Tanjung 4D, 4C and 4A, Lengkungan Seri Sedili, SMK Tinggi Klang and SK Bukit Kuda," he said.

Azmi added that the council's Vector and Communicable Disease Control Unit carried out intensive effort in public areas such as bus stops, commuter stations and five-foot-ways of shops selling groceries.

"Our focus is on where there are one or two cases in a single locality.

"We are taking extra precautionary measures in those areas.

"While sanitisation work is carried out on frequently touched points, we also advise people to thoroughly wash their hands," he said.

Yesterday, Azmi and MPK environmental health officer Zakaria Ismail coordinated sanitisation

works at Flat Block A to D in Taman Suria Pendamar, Jalan Selat Selatan 17, Port Klang, where council workers spent some three hours sanitising public areas of the 240 units of walk-up flats.

"We also get the help of Klang Fire and Rescue Department when we are overwhelmed.

"It is a time-consuming effort as most of the work is labour-intensive.

"We will continue to evaluate our efforts and get guidance from District Health Department," he said.

Azmi also warned people to stop spitting in public places as it could lead to the spread of infectious diseases.

"We notice people spitting in public places. We want this bad habit to stop.

"Some people spit along common walk paths around the flats, on public roads and in lifts," he said.

Virtual festive fair set for Klang and PJ

KLANG'S Little India Deepavali Bazaar, an annual event that attracts shoppers in droves from other states, has been cancelled following the increase in Covid-19 cases.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) president Dr Ahmad Fadzli Ahmad Tajuddin said it was a difficult but necessary decision to cancel the bazaar in light of the rise in the number of infections.

Annually, 143 lots are given out to traders to do business at Lorong Tingkat, Lorong Rembau and the inner lanes.

Fadzli said it was a challenging time but the way people responded to it could make a difference.

"We must keep our spirits up and continue to do business via

online platforms," he added.

MPK, he said, had business platform Klang i-Plaza and during Ramadan, it allowed Muslim traders to sell traditional Malay cakes, daily foodstuff to break fast and even clothes online.

Klang i-Plaza was popular and gained traction with hundreds of local entrepreneurs.

"We hope Indian traders will follow suit and sell their traditional muruku, decorative items, salwar kameez, kurtas and sarees online," he said.

Fadzli said MPK's Information Technology Department had made it easy for new small business owners and entrepreneurs to trade via the platform, which offered free registration.

"The platform is designed to link business people, be it small or big entities, and like-minded people can share resources, develop plans, introduce products and

grow a business," he added.

The business platform at klangiplaza.my features a product checklist, tools and resources to

enable businesses to link up.

Nor Hasyimah added that the Companies Commission of Malaysia was a hybrid partner for Klang i-Plaza, where it allowed users to register their business online with ease.

Similarly in Petaling Jaya, the Deepavali Bazaar set to take place in two locations has been moved online, through the council's website.

Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) licensing director Sharinaz Samsudin said the city council would not proceed with the on-site bazaar as Petaling district had become a Covid-19 red zone.

The bazaar was initially planned to be held at Jalan SS9A/13, Sungai Way and Pasar Jalan Othman, with 18 stalls in each location.

MBPJ would also meet with the traders to encourage them to list their businesses on the council's

SME urged to go online to keep up

SHAH ALAM: The Selangor government has urged small and medium enterprises (SME), especially those in the retail business, to go online rather than depend on the traditional ways of doing business.

Selangor senior executive councillor and chairman of the Standing Committees for Investment, Industry and Commerce and Small and Medium Enterprises, Datuk Teng Chang Khim, said by going online, SME would be able to generate sales and income even during the movement control order (MCO) and conditional MCO (CMCO).

"During Ramadan this year, the state government sponsored RM1 million in discount vouchers for SME, which went

online by registering with e-commerce platform Shopee for E-Bazar Raya. Before this programme, we had 2,000 SME registered with Shopee but during this programme, the figure jumped to 6,400.

"The result is overwhelming. We managed to record RM11.7 million in revenue from the programme, 11 times more than what we invested," he said during a virtual press conference after officiating the fifth Selangor Smart City and Digital Economy Conference yesterday.

To make the E-Bazar Raya a success, he said the state government will organise an online shopping festival with the cooperation of two e-commerce platforms, Shopee and

Lazada.

"The 11.11 programme will be launched very soon by Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari, and he will provide all the details about this programme in a few days."

During his opening speech, Teng said that as a result of the MCO and CMCO to curb the spread of Covid-19, SME have been forced to go online.

He said SME have to embrace digitalisation to cope with office closures, restricted movement and supply interruption.

He added that the digitalisation of businesses is not a one-off piecemeal project but rather a comprehensive journey.

S'gor faces Covid-19 challenges with hybrid summit

SIBS will be held virtually with the state's aim to engage businesses and stakeholders for the next 12 months via the SBH initiative

THE world is showing no signs of recovering from the coronavirus any time soon.

After 10 months since its outbreak, more than one million people have died from the virus, while nearly 40 million people have been infected, leading to the closure of international borders to help curb the spread.

Any cross-border movement including ferrying of items and goods must also adhere to strict health guidelines.

In June, the United Nations (UN) announced that the global foreign direct investment (FDI) flows are expected to drop 40% this year, citing the pandemic as the principle factor.

The UN Conference on Trade and Development said the FDI will shrink from its 2019 value of US\$1.54 trillion (RM6.23 trillion) to less than US\$1 trillion for the first time since 2005.

Malaysia, which recorded RM82.38 billion of approved FDI last year, is expected to land only half of the figure before December.

The country's most developed state, Selangor, would need to make adjustments in hosting its annual international summit — the Selangor International Business Summit (SIBS).

For the first time, SIBS will be held virtually with the state's aim to engage businesses and stakeholders for the next 12 months via the Selangor Business

Hub (SBH) initiative.

SBH comprises Invest Selangor Bhd's promotional programmes, Selangor Information Technology and E-Commerce Council meetings and SIBS which started on Wednesday.

Through SBH, Selangor targets to woo more than 3,000 small and medium enterprises (SMEs) on the online platform — a virtual place where they can market their products until SIBS 2021 takes place, said Selangor state executive councillor Datuk Teng Chang Khim.

Teng said if the situation improves within the next year, Selangor will be prepared to welcome merchants, participants and exhibitors for physical events.

"This makes the initiative hybrid in nature, which we can adjust according to the new norm," Teng told *The Malaysian Reserve* in an interview recently.

The Investment, Industry and Commerce, and SME committee chairman said it is still tricky for the host, Invest Selangor, to gauge the final number of participants for SIBS this year.

"It is challenging but yet exciting because we had never held such an event before. Previously, we only did physical events but now we can do both — physical and virtual.

"We are still unable to estimate how many participants would take part. Without physical interaction, it will be an interesting event which also gives us opportunities to explore more," Teng added.

Last year's SIBS exhibition raked in RM47 million in business transaction value, surpassing the targeted business transaction value of RM250 million, which also included RM200 million garnered from the Malaysia-China Entrepreneur Conference.

SIBS 2019 attracted over 34,000 visitors, exceeding the initial expectation of 30,000 visitors.

Teng had earlier aimed at least 35,000 walk-in visitors this year.

"We had also projected better sales this year, unfortunately due to this pandemic, we have to postpone the event to next year.

"Meanwhile, we are still engaging participants through the virtual SIBS and this will give us better preparation towards any possibility next year," he added.

Happening until tomorrow, the four-day virtual summit comprises an exhibition, conference and webinar series featuring Selangor International Expo (SIE), Selangor Asean Business Conference (SABC) and Selangor Smart City and Digital Economy Convention (SDEC).

Teng said SIE focuses on the food and beverage (F&B) industry and aims to attract manufacturers, traders, policymakers and trade buyers to visit the event. So far, more than 300 companies have already signed up to participate in SIE.

Meanwhile, the SABC conference provides another networking event for regional think tanks, government officials and business communities to engage and discuss ways to move forward as a region.

SDEC focuses on creating networking opportunities for start-ups and tech companies in the region.

Besides focusing on F&B, which is one of the main contributors to SIBS for the last five years, Teng said Invest Selangor also does not want to miss out on promoting the growing healthcare sector.

"Healthcare will be one of our next focuses, not only in terms of medical, pharmaceutical and supplements but also Health Tourism.

"Invest Selangor and Tourism

Selangor are working on it, and we need a comprehensive plan to develop this because Selangor has the infrastructure in place.

"It has the biggest number of private and public hospitals compared to other states, and a big pool of staff in the medical and healthcare sectors, so we must utilise these," Teng said.

Moving forward, the Klang assemblyman said SIBS will continuously look into ways and innovative mechanisms to ensure the programme benefits all six million residents in Selangor.

"When we started with Selangor International Expo in 2015, we discovered the state had already been a gateway in Asean.

"Since then, we have aimed to become a global trading hub and are looking at a larger map — which is a global map instead of only Malaysia and Asean.

"Then we looked into the business-to-business platform, but since the trend now is online-to-online platform, we adjust accordingly. This helps with the state's vision," Teng said, acknowledging that the state would need to do more adjustments according to the current pandemic situation.

This, he said is pertinent so SIBS remaining relevant not only for the government, but more importantly for its people.

"Although SIBS does not involve micro SMEs directly now, positioning Selangor as the global trading hub will definitely benefit local supply chains in the long term as more products can reach the market at a greater scale," Teng explained.

"Despite the disruption, it is also a blessing in disguise for Selangor to explore more and do better," Teng said.

Selangor optimistic despite global health crisis

Using modern smart technology will ensure that the state keeps up with the regional market

FOR the past five years, Selangor has created more than 80,000 job opportunities from the manufacturing sector.

It is a pivotal segment for the richest and busiest state in Malaysia. Selangor is home to some six million people, of which half are in the job market.

Invest Selangor Bhd CEO Datuk Hasan Azhari Idris said since 2015, the total investment contributed from manufacturing has passed RM57 billion.

While taking this as an exceptional milestone for the state, Hasan Azhari said there is more that can be done by the state promotional agency, particularly to ramp up on the IR4.0.

He said with the automation of traditional manufacturing and industrial practices, by using modern smart technology, will ensure that the state keeps up with the regional market, particularly in the manufacturing sector.

"In 2015, Selangor paved the way to be acknowledged as a smart state by enhancing the use of technology as the key enabler for economic and socio activities.

"That is why we are targeting more on the high-tech and knowledge-based industries which require companies to embrace IR4.0.

"As such, we are also preparing on talent pools towards such features," Hasan Azhari told *The Malaysian Reserve* in an interview recently.

Selangor reported its highest direct investment in 2018, with RM18.9 billion of investment recorded, a 238% surge from RM5.59 billion recorded in the preceding year.

Last year, the state recorded RM17 billion of capital investment, with its five core clusters notching an impressive RM10.4 billion of investment.

The core clusters are electric and electronics, food and beverages, transport equipment, life sciences, machinery and equipment.

One exciting cluster is transported equipment, which comprises aerospace supply chains from manufacturing to services, located at the state's three aerospace parks — Serendah, Subang and Sepang.

Hasan Azhari said the five clus-

Overall, he said the campaign generated over RM300 million in a ripple effect to the merchants.

These include economic, socio-economic and branding effects that have created positive impacts towards the merchants, including their offline operations, job creation, online customer traffic, publicity, social media hype and more.

The Selangor E-Bazar Raya Campaign was an exclusive collaboration between the Selangor government and Shopee, which lasted two months from May 4 to July 4, with the state government channelling RM1 million in the form of voucher benefits to Selangor merchants on this platform.

"We envision to be the trend-setter for other promotional agencies in the country."

"It is important for us to continuously engage various parties and launch various initiatives, so SMEs can flourish in the state," Hasan Azhari said.

According to the SME Corp Malaysia's statistics, Selangor remains the leading state with 19.8% of the total 907,065 SMEs in Malaysia residing in Selangor, followed by Kuala Lumpur with 14.7%.

Hasan Azhari believed that the growth of small start-ups will play a major role in the state's economic sustainability.

He added that the agency has been provided hand-holding services to these investors, making sure that their project implementation takes off smoothly.

"Coordination meetings are held monthly to facilitate and track the progress, ensuring those projects meet their schedules and are on track."


"These are the factors why they choose to invest in Selangor," Hasan Azhari said.

As small and medium enterprises (SMEs) contribute to more than 98.5% of the economic activities, Hasan Azhari said Invest Selangor will continue to be innovative in assisting entrepreneurs to develop their businesses during the tough period.

"As an example, in May, during the Ramadan period, we launched the E-Bazar Raya to help SMEs market their products on Shopee when the Movement Control Order was first introduced."

"We only targeted 5,000 SMEs to get on board the Shopee platform with a RM8 million sales target."

"However, the response was overwhelming with 8,400 entrepreneurs joining this initiative, bringing direct revenue of RM11.7 million," Hasan Azhari said.

ters will remain as the anchor investment for Selangor, which aims to rack RM12 billion of investment this year despite the economic downturn due to the coronavirus impact.

"Selangor is seen as an excellent

network because it is an entry point to the country, either through the ports or airports located here."

"Additionally, the talent ability or talent pool produced by institutions in Selangor is abundant com-

"Looking at the current trend which includes our virtual engagements with companies around the world, we can still be optimistic and on the right track to achieve this target," he said.

However, he said the situation will highly depend on how fast the project can be materialised.

"Some of them are already in the pipeline and waiting for the federal government's approval."

"Therefore, at the moment, we have not reduced the target yet, as the aim is also lower than what we have achieved last year," Hasan Azhari said.

"It could be approved according to the timeline. But if it is not, then maybe, we will record a slightly lower than the RM12 billion investment target."

“可继续开业的早夜市，商贩和民众都务必要遵守标准作业程序，才能确保冠病疫情不会扩散。”

嚴玉梅：31早夜市11月1重開



巴生市议会执照、巴刹管理及小贩发展委员会兼巴生市议员严玉梅则表示，对于尚未开业的31个早夜市，市议会已决议将在11月1日(星期日)批准重开，惟一样需要严格遵守标准作业程序。

她说，负责巴刹管理及小贩执照组主任阿兹哈于昨日与财务小组开会后，准许市议会承担旗下负责早夜市聘请志愿警卫的费用。

还需聘37志愿警卫

她披露，根据国安会的标准作业程序，每个早夜市都得准备2到4名的志愿警卫，胥视多少个进出口而定。

“由于市议会管辖的早夜市也面对人手不足问题，所以也需要聘请志愿警卫的协助。”

她补充，市议会目前负责看守的早夜市有14个，预计还需要聘请37名志愿警卫。

沙林：確保各夜市遵守SOP

余深恩巡视士拉央再也更换水管工程，希望该区在更换新水管后能一劳永逸解决爆水管及制水问题。

(士拉央15日讯)士拉央再也24路展开更换新水管工程，以一劳永逸地解决因爆水管导致的制水问题。

据了解，雪州水务管理公司(Air Selangor)于上个月与当地居民汇报工程相关详情及进展，并于今日正式展开工作。

士拉央市议员余深恩今日特别前往巡视工程，同时召开新闻发布会指出，承包商已于今日进行标记工作，接下来将会进行挖掘及安装水管工作。

余深恩：需時5個月 涉480公尺長

余深恩说，雪州水务管理公司早前已向士拉央第12区的居民进行汇报，同时也获得士拉央市议会批准进行挖掘工作。

他说，该区的更换水管工程需时5个月，涉及范围共480公尺长；施工时间为每天早上8时至下午5时。

分阶段进行 避免居民交通受影响

他也说，由于更换水管的施工地点为住家前，为了确保居民及当地交通不受影响，工程将会分阶段进行。

“每一节水管约6公尺长，承包商将以每6公尺的范围进行挖掘、更换水管再铺好受影响的路段。”

此外，他透露，原有的水管将不会拆除，水供公司则会在新水管安装完成后，需时一两个小时重新连结水供，并将会在凌晨时间进行，因此整个更换水管过程将不会对当地水供造成影响。

士拉央再也制水多因爆水管

余深恩，雪州政府是于2019年通过这项更换水管计划，为州内共40个爆水管黑区更换新水喉，其中

就包括士拉央再也。

“鹅唛县一共有19地区将获更换新水管，其中在士拉央第12区内除了士拉央再也24路之外，也包括美乐蒂花园1路、5路及7路。”

他说，这些地方都是爆水管的黑区，其中以士拉央再也来说，自3月开始一直面对不定时制水的问题，其中大部分原因都是因为爆水管所致。

他解释，雪州过去所使用的水管为石棉水泥材质，会随着使用时间越来越薄，寿命仅有20年。

“水管越来越薄加上水压而导致爆水管问题，也代表是时候更换新水管。以士拉央再也24路来说，因为多车进出所带来的振动，更容易造成爆水管的发生。”

新水管寿命可达100年

他说，新的水管为球墨铸铁管，使用寿命可达100年。

另一方面，余深恩也透露，美乐蒂花园的更换水管工程则会在近期内动工，而水供公司早前也已与当地居民进行汇报。

“工程将会在该花园的1路、5路及7路展开，涉及的范围分别是230公尺、170公尺及100公尺。”

烏達瑪涉外染來群者

（八打灵再也15日讯）行动党万达镇州议员嘉玛莉亚指出，乌达玛感染群（Kluster Utama）指的不仅是在万达购物广场（One Utama）工作的员工及身处在该购物广场的人，且该感染群也可以涉及外来者，即从与来自万达购物广场确诊病例接触并受感染的人士。

嘉玛莉亚今日在脸书贴文说，乌达玛感染群指的是源自万达购物广场地区的感染群。

“举例来说，当进行接触追踪时，若一名来自万达购物广场的员工确诊冠病，并曾与不在万达购物广场工作的人士有着密切接触，而后者在确诊患上冠病后，将归纳进乌达玛感染群，即便后者不在万达购物广场工作，或与万达购物广场管理层没有关联。”

她提及，近日不少公众及居民对乌达玛感染群出现105宗冠病病例一事感到混淆，而万达购物广场管理层也发出声明，对一项报告指涉及63宗病例一事作出反驳。

她表示，对此，其办公室已向有关当局作出查核，并尽所能地及准确地回答相关问题。

她建议那些对此依然困惑的人士联系卫生部，因该部是全国最有信誉掌握相关资讯的来源。

同时，嘉玛莉亚希望今后起卫生部、县卫生局、管理层及任何相关当局在发布媒体声明前，可作出统一，此举能避免公众混淆及避免引起不必要的恐慌。

国安会拒豁免瓜雪沙白

肢体接触场所关闭

也是金銮州议员的黄思汉续指出，实施有条件行动管控令期间，雪州内的按摩中心、推拿中心、健身中心、网咖及酒廊等都不允许营业。

“基本上，雪州政府是使用国家安全理事会宣布的标准作业程序，只是其中有些变动。”

众可照样到社区公园，或住宅区的道路跑步，带孩子到公园、骑脚车和做运动、钓鱼等，也可以打太极，条件是所有群体运动或活动，都不能超过10人及不能有肢体接触。

他表示，由于有肢体接触，推拿及按摩活动等不能进行，相关中心也不能营业；设在公寓的健身室或一般的健身中心等也不能营业。

“托儿所、补习中心及音乐学校等同样需关闭，也没有托儿和安亲班服务，除非是送往私人保姆照顾。”

他指出，公园及儿童游乐场等仍继续开放，惟公园内运动设施及儿童游乐设施将被“封”。

“在公园跑步及溜狗等也被允许，但鼓励大家最好各自跑步，不要整群人，更不要超过10人。”
