Pemilik tanah bakar kebun sawit disiasat

PUTRAJAYA: Tindakan tidak bertanggungjawab pemilik tanah yang membakar kebun sawit di Sepang, Selangor mengundang padah apabila bakal disiasat Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS).

Menerusi kenyataan agensi itu, suspek dipercayai sengaja melakukan pembakaran terbuka di kawasan terbier berkenaan untuk dibersihkan bagi tanaman semula kelapa sawit baharu.

“Siasatan aduan insiden ini yang berlaku di Jalan Sijangkang Utama, Kebun Baru semalam dijalankan setelah menerima aduan kes daripada pihak bomba sendiri,” katanya.

Proses penyiasatan lanjut ke atas pemilik tanah kebun tersebut dilaksanakan JAS cawangan Sepang berdasarkan perintukan Seksyen 29 (A) Akta

Kualiti Alam Sekeliling 1974, jika disabitkan kesalahan boleh dihukum denda tidak lebih daripada RM500,000 atau penjara sehingga maksimum lima tahun atau kedua-duanya sekali.

Di samping itu, JAS memberi amaran tegas bahawa pelaku aktiviti pembakaran terbuka seumpamanya boleh dikenakan kompaun maksimum RM2,000 bagi setiap kesalahan dibuat.

Kenyataan itu menambah, pihak JAS berharap agar orang awam jika mendapati ada kes pencemaran tersebut segera melaporkan kepada agensi berkenaan untuk tindakan susulan melalui talian bebas tol 1-800-88-2727 atau e-mel terus kepada eaduan@doe.gov.my atau melaporkan kes pembakaran terbuka itu kepada bomba.

Kuala Lumpur: Skuad bawah 23 (B-23) tahun negara menghantar isyarat buat tiga pencabar lain dalam Kelayakan Kejuaraan Konfederasi Bolasepak Asia (AFC) B-23 di Mongolia hujung bulan ini apabila mencatat kemenangan kedua selepas membenam Kedah Darul Aman FC (KDA FC) 2-0 di Arena Majlis Bandaraya Subang Jaya (MBSJ), Subang Jaya, semalam.

Kejayaan menundukkan naib juara Liga Super itu

sememangnya mengejutkan apatah lagi ia kemenangan kedua berturut-turut skuad kendalian Brad Maloney dalam aksi persahabatan itu.

Sebelum ini, pemain negara berjaya meraih keputusan positif ke atas Penang FC dengan keputusan 2-1 pada Jumaat lalu.

Gol skuad muda negara dijaringkan tonggak pertahanan Ahmad Zikri Khalili pada minit ke-28 untuk mendahului lawan

dengan 1-0.

Anak buah Aidil Sharin Sahak cuba bangkit namun kekebalan benteng pertahanan negara cukup sukar untuk dibolosi, sekali gus keputusan itu kekal hingga tamat babak pertama. Bersambung separuh masa kedua, skuad negara yang diundi dalam Kumpulan J bersama Laos, Mongolia dan Thailand itu, diasak bertubi-tubi oleh jentera serangan Kedah untuk memburu gol

penyamaan.

Bagaimanapun, anak didik Maloney terus mengejutkan pasukan Liga Super itu apabila berjaya menambah gol kedua pada masa kecederaan hasil sentuhan Azfar Fikri Azhar.

Kemenangan itu cukup bermakna buat barisan pemain muda negara yang menyasarkan slot automatik ke pusingan akhir Kejuaraan AFC yang dijadual berlangsung di Uzbekistan tahun depan.

SHAH ALAM – Sultan Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah menzahirkan rasa sukacita apabila 85 peratus rakyat negeri itu sudah divaksin sepenuhnya.

Perasan itu dizahirkannya selepas berkenan menerima menghadap Menteri Kesihatan, Khairy Jamaluddin Abu Bakar di Istana Bukit Kayangan, di sini semalam.

Turut berangkat, Raja Muda Selangor, Tengku Amir Shah.

Menerusi kenyataan Facebook Selangor Royal Office, Sul-

tan Sharafuddin diberi taklimat mengenai perkembangan terkini penularan pandemik Covid-19 terutamanya di negeri ini.

“Baginda sukacita apabila dimaklumkan bawahan peratusan rakyat Selangor yang telah divaksin sepenuhnya kini mencapai 85 peratus.

“Pada pertemuan itu, YB (Yang Berhormat) Khairy Jamaluddin turut menyampaikan laporan terkini mengenai isu antivaksin dan tindakan yang sedang diamalkan pihak kementerian,” katanya.

Dalam pada itu, Sultan Sharafuddin dan Khairy turut membincangkan mengenai kepentingan penambahan fasiliti Geriatric di hospital bagi memampung peningkatan populasi warga emas.

“Baginda turut menyarankan agar tumpuan dan pelan jangka pendek diberikan kepada penyediaan perkhidmatan psikiatri dan kesihatan mental.

“Dua perkhidmatan itu perlu berkualiti dan lebih meluas khususnya di Selangor,” katanya.

PUTRAJAYA – Tindakan tidak bertanggungjawab pemilik tanah yang membakar kebun sawit di Sepang, Selangor mengundang padah apabila bakal disiasat Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS).

JAS menerusi kenyataan berkata, suspek dipercayai sengaja membuat pembakaran terbuka di kawasan terbiar itu untuk dibersihkan bagi tanaman semula kelapa sawit baharu.

“Siasatan aduan insiden ini yang berlaku di Jalan Sijangkang Utama, Kebun Baru semalam (kelmarin) dijalankan setelah menerima aduan kes daripada pihak bomba,” katanya semalam.

“Hubungi talian bebas tol **1-800-88-2727** atau e-mel kepada eaduan@doe.gov.my atau melaporkan kes pembakaran terbuka itu kepada bomba,” katanya.

Semalam, penguat kuasa JAS cawangan Sepang menjalankan rondaan di beberapa lokasi di daerah tersebut susulan bacaan Indeks Pencemaran Udara (IPU) yang berstatus sederhana termasuk kawasan Saujana Putra, Rimbayu, Kebun Baru, Telok

Panglima Garang, Batu 9, Telok Mengkuang, Sungai Manggis, Sijangkang, Dengkil, Kota Warisan dan Cyberjaya.

Kesemua stesen IPU di negeri itu merekodkan paras sederhana, namun stesen Johan Setia yang satu-satunya di negara ini berstatus tidak sihat, sudah kembali ke paras sederhana yang mencecah 159 dari pukul 10 pagi sehingga 8 malam kelmarin kemudian berjaya turun hingga bawah 100 menjelang 2 pagi semalam.

Tiada lagi istilah *The Sleeping Hollow*

Hulu Selangor kini ke arah perbandaran mampan untuk semua

Hulu Selangor merupakan daerah di utara negeri Selangor Darul Ehsan yang bersempadan dengan Kuala Selangor, Sabak Bernam dan Gombak.

Berdasarkan kedudukan, Hulu Selangor merupakan daerah yang strategik dan pintu masuk utama ke Selangor, turut dihubungkan ke negeri di Utara dan Pantai Timur melalui jalan darat dan rel.

Hulu Selangor dengan keluasan 175,630.11 hektar merupakan daerah terbesar daripada sembilan daerah di Selangor, menyamai keluasan negeri Melaka.

Dibahagikan kepada 13 mukim dan Pusat Pentadbiran Hulu Selangor terletak di Kuala Kubu Bharu, ditadbir oleh Majlis Daerah Hulu Selangor (MDHS) selaku Pihak Berkasara Tempatan (PBT) yang ditubuhkan sejak tahun 1975.

DAERAH KETINGGALAN

Walaupun Hulu Selangor adalah daerah terbesar namun 50 peratus daripada keluasannya merupakan Banjaran Tinggi dan Hutan Simpan Kekal.

Ia merupakan kawasan tадahan air utama yang membekalkan air bersih ke Lembah Klang dan faktor ini merupakan antara cabaran dalam merancangkan pembangunan di daerah ini.

The Sleeping Hollow adalah gelaran yang diberikan kerana daerah ini agak ketiadaan arus pembangunan. Namun, ia mula berubah sekitar awal 1990-an apabila terdapat ura-ura beberapa projek mega akan dibangunkan di sini.

la melanjutkan pemajuan di kawasan Hulu Selangor dengan pembukaan bandar-bandar baru seperti Bukit Beruntung, Bukit Sentosa, Sungai Buaya, Antara Gapi, Bandar Utama Batang Kali, Lembah Beringin dan Bernam Jaya iaitu antara pemajuan terancang dan lengkap dibangunkan bermula sekitar tahun 1992.

Daerah ini menjadi hab automotif apabila Perusahaan Automobil Kedua (Perodua) dan Tan Chong Motor Holding Berhad membuka kilang pemasangan kereta di Serendah.

KRISIS EKONOMI, ISU BROWNFIELD

Krisis Ekonomi Asia 1997 turut memberi kesan kepada pembangunan Hulu Selangor. Pembangunan yang sedang dijalankan terpaksa dirangka semula malah ada yang dihentikan antaraannya Sungai Buaya dan Lembah Beringin.

Bagi Projek Bandar Bukit Beruntung dan Bukit Sentosa, majoriti telah siap dibangunkan tetapi gagal dijalur. Lebih memburukkan keadaan apabila premis-premis pemasangan dan kilang tidak dapat disewakan atau dijual semula.

Keadaan ini mewujudkan suasana bandar tinggal atau dalam istilah lain *brownfield*. Ini memberi imej yang amat buruk kepada Bandar Bukit Beruntung ketika itu sehingga digelar "bandar tidak untung".

Isu ini turut memberi kesan dan cabaran kepada pihak MDHS terutama dalam aspek menyelesaikan masalah infrastruktur, isu rumah tinggal dan tunggakan cukai taksiran.

Kemuncak pada 2007, pihak MDHS dan Pejabat Daerah & Tanah Hulu Selangor diberi 'Anugerah Penyupu' oleh kerajaan negeri ketika itu kerana gagal mengutip cukai yang disarakkan.

LONJAKAN PERTAMA

Bagi menyelesaikan isu *brownfield* dan projek terbengkalai, MDHS selaku Pihak Berkasara Perancang Tempatan merangka strategi komprehensif melalui Rancangan Tempatan Daerah Hulu Selangor 2020.

MDHS turut bekerjasama dengan pihak Plan Malaysia menyediakan Pelan Tindakan Khas Kawasan Brownfield Bukit Beruntung dan Lembah Beringin.

Pembangunan di kawasan lain ditutup dengan menumpukan kawasan Bandar Bukit Beruntung dan Bukit Sentosa.

MDHS turut bekerjasama dengan kerajaan negeri dan Persekutuan bagi memajukan semula Bandar Bukit Beruntung untuk menarik pelabur dan orang ramai tinggal di sini.

Dari tahun 2010 hingga 2020, setelah berbincang dengan pelbagai agensi kerajaan, kemudahan pendidikan, rekreasi dan keselamatan berjaya dibina iaitu.

- SK Bukit Beruntung II
- SMK Bukit Sentosa II
- SJKC Bukit Tangga (Bukit Beruntung)
- SK Taman Bunga Raya II
- Bala Bomba Bukit Sentosa
- Masjid Saidina Ali
- Taman Awam Seruja
- Taman Awam Jenjarum

Melalui Invest Selangor, MDHS bekerjasama dengan kerajaan negeri dalam menarik pelabur ke Hulu Selangor.

Imej Hab Automotif diperkuatkannya dengan penjenamaan semula menjadi Hab Pembuatan Pengangkutan Negara.

Serendah juga dikenalpasti sebagai nukleus utama bagi hab ini dan tanah-tanah perindustrian sedia ad di Bandar Bukit Beruntung dan Bukit Sentosa dijadikan hab sokongan vendor.

Hasilnya, kawasan ini menerima pelaburan berimpak tinggi seperti pembukaan kilang pembuatan dan pemasangan kelongsong enjin kapal terbang oleh UMW Aerospace.

Kilang ini yang merupakan kilang Tier-1 bagi pengeluar komponen aeroangkasa sekali gus meletakkan Serendah di peringkat tertinggi dalam rangking dunia sebagai lokasi pengeluar komponen kapal terbang.

Hulu Selangor juga menjadi pilihan kepada syarikat lokomotif SMH Rail Sdn Bhd untuk membuka kilang pemasangan dan pembaikkan lokomotif.

Kilang di Kawasan Perindustrian Zurah, Rasa telah menjadi lokasi pemasangan gerak bagi MRT, selain bengkel pemasangan dan pembaikkan lokomotif tempatan dan antarabangsa.

Permain industri sedia ada seperti

- Penerapan konsep pembangunan pintar.
- Sistem perhubungan jalan raya dan infrastruktur yang efisien.
- Penawaran paket pelaburan yang menarik.
- Pembangunan modal insan yang efektif dan berdaya saing.

Empat teras ini dibentuk agar semua isu pembangunan ditangani:

1 Teras 1: Pembangunan dan peluang ekonomi yang saksama.

2 Teras 2: Pengurusan sumber asli yang mampan.

3 Teras 3: Pembangunan komuniti sejahtera.

4 Teras 4: Urus tadbir efektif dan efisien.

Semasa tempoh perancangan ini, isu ketidakseimbangan pembangunan antara bahagian selatan dan utara Hulu Selangor akan diberi perenakan.

Pembangunan berimpak tinggi dirancang di kawasan utara Hulu Selangor bagi menjadi pemangkin kepada pembangunan keseluruhan bahagian itu.

Penyelesaian isu *brownfield* juga diteruskan selain usaha membangunkan semula kawasan Bukit Beruntung/Bukit Sentosa termasuk Sungai Buaya dan Lembah Beringin.

Selain pembangunan, pengekalan semula jadi dan kawalan kepada kawasan tадahan air juga diberi perenakan. 15 tahun ke hadapan, Hulu Selangor perlu memilih jenis industri dan pembangunan yang sesuai beroperasi dan dijalankan bagi menerapkan konsep pembangunan mampan dan mesra alam.

Dengan pertambahan penduduk, kemudahan untuk kesihatan, rekreasi serta taraf keselamatan dan pendidikan akan dilakukan.

Bagi mencapai masa hadapan, MDHS telah merangka pelan pembangunan 15 tahun bermula 2020 sehingga 2035 yang berorientasikan *People-Centric* dengan menetapkan sasaran 500,000 penduduk pada 2035.

Segala perancangan dan halu tuju pembangunan perlu memenuhi keperluan penduduk dari aspek penyediaan kemudahan awam dan peluang pekerjaan.

Bagi mencapai sasaran berkenaan, emam tema pembangunan di tetapkan iaitu:

- Pembangunan sumber semula jadi dan warisan.
- Persekutuan komuniti lestari.

DULU MDHS KINI MPHHS

Bermula dengan daerah kecil dari segi pembangunan kemudian membangun dengan rancang sebelum terhenti akibat masalah ekonomi, Hulu Selangor mendepani masalah secara tenang dan berkesan.

Segala perancangan bagi pemuliharan sehingga 2020 telah dilaksanakan dan menampakkan hasil yang memberangsangkan.

Penerapan MDHS kepada Majlis Perbandaran Hulu Selangor (MPHS) pada 21 Oktober 2021 adalah satu usaha yang membuktikan Hulu Selangor kini membangun menuju ke alaf bandar pintar yang terancang.

Hulu Selangor kini bersedia untuk menjadi Perbandaran Mampan untuk semua!

HULU SELANGOR

Kerajaan negeri Selangor mengambil maklum berhubung aduan pencemaran di Sungai Remuk di sini.

Exco Pelancongan, Alam Sekitar, Teknologi Hijau dan Hal Ehwal Orang Asli Selangor, Hee Loy Sian berkata, Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (LUAS) sedang membuat semakan mengenai perkara tersebut.

THE field at Astaka Sports Complex in Petaling Jaya has always been a popular recreational and exercise site among residents in the city, especially those living nearby.

With the Covid-19 movement restrictions lifted and recreational activities allowed, locals have been visiting the field again for exercise, using the paved walkway for walking and jogging.

However, the side of the sports field that runs along the back of The Spastic Children's Association of Selangor and Federal Territories is marred by a huge tree uprooted during a thunderstorm in June. It has yet to be cleared.

The fallen tree has also damaged part of the walkway, with broken brick tiles strewn about and a big slab of cement blocking the path.

Unhappy residents are saying that this was dangerous as the spot was sunken and people could easily loose their footing and fall.

Lawyer Harbans Kaur, who lived nearby and goes for morning walks along the field, said the loose bricks along the walkway were dangerous, especially for elderly folk.

"We have many senior citizens walking here in the mornings and evenings. It is sad to see that the authorities have neglected to clear the uprooted tree for months now.

"If a person is not paying attention, he or she can easily trip and injure themselves because of the uneven walkway," she told *StarMetro*.

had paved the walkway earlier this year.

Businessman R. Ganesan, 59, who often walked around the field in the evenings, urged MBPJ to quickly clear the uprooted tree for the community's safety.

"I cannot understand why they are taking so long to do this. The tree is rotting already."

"We have to be extra alert now when using the walkway because sometimes the bricks near the damaged spot are loose and strewn haphazardly."

"Undergrowth is beginning to appear too and this should be cleared," he said.

Another frequent jogger in the area SL Tan, 62, feared snakes could emerge from the rotting tree and the undergrowth.

"It is the rainy season now and mosquitoes are abundant in this part of the field because there are



pockets of uneven spaces where water can stagnate.

"The walkway was nice and paved but unfortunately, the tree fell and damaged the ground."

"The authorities should look into this quickly and not delay it," he said.

When alerted by *StarMetro*, MBPJ Corporate Communications Department spokesperson said the matter would be handled by the relevant department.

KLANG, Kuala Langat, Sepang, Kuala Selangor and Sabak Bernam residents should be vigilant for another round of flash floods as their areas are expected to be affected by the high tide phenomenon on Nov 5, 6 and 7, with a higher risk if it coincides with heavy rain.

Klang District Fire and Rescue Department zone chief Hussin Ab Rahman said the National Hydrographic Centre in Port Klang forecasted high tide at 5.6m on Nov 5 at 6.02am and on Nov 6 at 6.40am, while on Nov 7, the tide will reach 5.5m at 7.18am.

"Stations in the district are prepared for any eventualities during

high tide.

"We have the manpower to tackle the possibility of flash floods expected in vulnerable areas," he added.

Hussin said all equipment needed for relief work were on standby, including boats and life jackets, while the Port Klang Fire and Rescue Station also had an amphibious boat that could be operated on land and water.

Klang district officer Mohd Zainal Mohd Nor said people living near rivers and coastal areas have been advised to be vigilant, especially during heavy rain.

"Based on the forecast, the level

of the high tide should not breach the bunds," he added.

Klang Municipal Council (MPK) president Ahmad Fadzli Ahmad Tajuddin said close-circuit television (CCTV) cameras used for traffic management in Klang would double up as an early warning tool to detect rising water levels in low areas during the high tide phenomena.

"Out of the 76 camera locations, we have five cameras in low-lying areas or flooding hotspots," he added.

"Our enforcement CCTV Unit staff will have real-time images from cameras at sites across

Tanjung Harapan, Pulau Ketam Jetty at Jalan Syahbandar (Jalan Foreshore), Jalan Jambatan Connaught, Jalan Tepi Sungai and Menara MPK," said Ahmad Fadzli, adding that the council's CCTV Unit staff would have dual tasks.

"Our enforcement staff will keep an eye out for traffic and monitor the occurrence of flash floods, if any," he added.

Ahmad Fadzli was glad that the CCTV Unit decided to turn a passive monitoring camera into a visual sensor that maximised the potential of the equipment.

Areas particularly vulnerable to

the high tide phenomenon in Klang are Taman Melawis, Kampung Delek, Sungai Udang, Pengkalan Tok Muda, Batu 4 at Jalan Kapar, Bund Sementa, Pelabuhan Klang, Jalan Pandamaran Banting and Taman Selat Damai in Pendamar, Port Klang.

For Kuala Langat, the areas are Pantai Kelanang and Persisir Pantai Tanjung Sepat while in Sepang, Persisir Pantai Bagan Lalang is vulnerable to the high tide phenomenon.

In Sabak Bernam, the areas are Tebuk Mendeling, Sungai Ayer Tawar and Sungai Panjang while in Kuala Selangor, the areas are Tanjung Karang, Kampung Kuantan, Pantai Remis and Pekan Sungai Buloh.

Stench from leaking sewerage upsetting residents of flats in Bandar Puncak Alam

RESIDENTS of several blocks of flats in Bandar Puncak Alam are feeling uneasy about a stench that is permeating the area.

They blame it on overflowed sewage from a drain near the parking lot.

Those residing in Flat Saujana Mawar believe the muck — which began appearing behind Block E eight months ago — is leaking from the underground sewerage system.

They urge the authorities to step in and resolve the problem, which has raised hygiene and health concerns in the neighbourhood.

Father-of-four Razali Zahidin, 60, said he had reported the matter to Kuala Selangor Municipal Council (MPKS) last month.

"The stench gets even worse after downpours," said the retiree, who bought his unit in 2010.

Another resident Mohd Arif Mat, 48, suspected objects in the sewerage pipes blocked the flow of sewage.

He said this has caused a backflow into the toilets inside the residents' units.

"As a result, some residents have installed a pipe to divert the waste from their toilet into the surrounding drainage system," he said.

This has caused another problem as the sewage now clogs up the drainage, causing the water to stagnate.

Razali said residents had no choice but to instal the additional pipes to prevent wastewater from gushing out of their toilets.

"Because of this, we have had to

go over to petrol stations or nearby supermarkets to use their toilets," he added.

Resident Mohd Shamsul Helmi, 38, said the walls in his units would sometimes become damp, perhaps due to the backflow.

A notice displayed in a common area by the joint management body (JMB) said six clean-ups of the sewerage system had been conducted since late 2017.

It warned residents not to throw items into the toilet bowl, adding that sanitary pads and undergarments were among items commonly found clogging the sewerage system.

MPKS Commissioner of Building Unit chief Muhammad Zulfiqah Omar, when contacted, said the maintenance of stratified buildings fell under the JMB.

He said the council had for-

warded the issue at the flats to its JMB, after receiving several complaints from residents.

"But the JMB does not have sufficient funds to service the sewerage, due to the poor collection of maintenance fees.

"There are also many empty units there that has further affected fee collection," he said, adding

that only 30% of residents have paid the maintenance fee.

The flats in Taman Alam Jaya comprised six blocks of five-storey buildings, each having between 60 and 70 units.

Residents also expressed concern about the overgrown grass in the area, fearing snakes among other creatures.

Helping unemployed to secure jobs

Selangor government's job fair to offer 25,000 opportunities

GROWING concerns over the 4.4% unemployment rate in Selangor has prompted the state government to continue with its *Jelajah Selangor Bekerja* job fair programme this year.

At a press conference to launch the event that will see 200 employers offering up to 25,000 job opportunities, Selangor youth generation, sports and human capital development committee chairman Mohd Khairuddin Othman said he hoped the platform would be of help to the 165,000 unemployed individuals, who were either fresh graduates or had lost their jobs due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

"If this platform is able to connect candidates to all the job opportunities offered by the participating companies, this will reduce the state's unemployment rate to 3.7%", said Khairuddin.

Quoting from English economist John Maynard Keynes, Khairuddin said an unemployment rate of high-

er than 4% was a sign of an unproductive economy.

In comparing the unemployment rate before the pandemic, he said in 2019, it was at 2.9% with 88,300 jobless.

"But by 2020, it had risen to 4.5% when the Covid-19 pandemic forced affected sectors to slow down or cease production altogether."

These figures were obtained from the Statistics Department and Social Security Organisation (Socso), he said, and that the number of layoffs were somewhat countered by an increase in self employment – in online businesses or e-hailing services.

Otherwise, the unemployment rate would have been higher, he added.

On the people's response to the job fair, Khairuddin said despite restrictions during the various movement control orders, last year's event recorded 15,000 online registrations.

"This year, we hope to see a rise in registration as employers and potential job candidates would be

able to meet face to face. In 2019, for example, the fair helped secure some 1,200 jobs within two days," he said.

Just as in the previous series, the *Jelajah Selangor Bekerja* programme will offer positions ranging from rank and file up to middle management in various sectors such as services, construction, IT, technical and aerospace, the last that was made possible through a collaboration with Invest Selangor Bhd.

On whether the current economic landscape was now an employer's market, Invest Selangor chief executive officer Datuk Hasan Azhari Idris said with the current freeze on the intake of foreign workers, it was hoped that locals would be able to take advantage of the void.

On whether fresh graduates and those new to an industry would have a chance of landing jobs, Hasan Azhari said with the training programmes available, it

boiled down to how a job applicant was able to impress his prospective employer during an interview.

Confidence and attitude were some of the important criteria employers look out for, he said.

The job fair will be held in Shah Alam, Kuala Selangor, Kuala Kubu Baru, Hulu Langat and Petaling from Oct 23 until the end of December.

German-based H&R to invest RM200m in speciality plant in Perak

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 18 – H&R GmbH & Co KGaA, a leading global sustainable refiner and marketer of speciality plasticisers, esterified oils, softeners and waxes headquartered in Hamburg, Germany, is investing RM200 million in a speciality manufacturing plant in Lumut, Perak.

The investment plan was announced during a meeting between H&R and the Trade and Investment Mission (TIM) to Germany delegation led by the Senior Minister and Minister of International Trade and Industry (MITI) Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali.

It said the construction of the facility is planned to kickstart by March 2022 followed by the commencement of production in early 2024.

"The project will tentatively be carried out in three phases, with a designed capacity of 150,000 tonnes per annum," it stated in a statement today.

"This investment is anticipated to create 70 new jobs in Malaysia," it said.

H&R said apart from H&R Chempharm Asia Sdn Bhd, it has two existing facilities in Malaysia, namely H&R Malaysia Sdn Bhd and H&R Malaysia Wax Sdn Bhd in Port Klang and Batu Caves, respectively.

It said these facilities have been in operations since 1990, producing wax speciality emulsions as well as undertaking marketing and distribution activities of various speciality oils and waxes.

Mohamed Azmin said H&R's investment announcement reflected foreign investors' confidence in Malaysia's business environment that remained conducive.

He said the company has indicated clear goals to reduce its dependency on fossil-based feedstock and move toward renewable or hybrid feedstock for more sustainable products and speciality applications to eventually reach carbon neutral operation by 2030.






