5,295 mangsa masih di PPS

Kemaman jadi daerah paling teruk terjejas

Kuala Lumpur: Jumlah mangsa banjir di Pantai Timur menurun apabila seramai 5,295 mangsa banjir ditempatkan di pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS) di Kelantan dan Terengganu sehingga petang semalam, berbanding 8,658 mangsa kelmarin, manakala semua 38 mangsa banjir di Pahang sudah dibenarkan pulang ke rumah masing-masing.

Di Terengganu, seramai 4,139 mangsa daripada 991 keluarga masih ditempatkan di 27 PPS di daerah Kemaman dan Dungun, manakala keadaan banjir di Hulu Terengganu dan Setiu pulih sepenuhnya apabila semua 97 mangsa daripada 23 keluarga yang ditempatkan di tiga

PPS dibenarkan pulang ke kediaman masing-masing, petang semalam.


Ketua Sekretariat Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Bencana Terengganu, Letfenon Kolonel (PA) Che Adam A Rahman, berkata Kemaman masih menjadi daerah yang paling teruk terjejas apabila seramai 3,625 mangsa daripada 846 keluarga ditempatkan di 14 PPS.

Katanya, jumlah mangsa di Dungun menunjukkan penurunan apabila hanya 514 mangsa daripada 145 keluarga di 13 PPS.

Beliau berkata, pihaknya menjangkakan lebih ramai penduduk akan dibenarkan pulang ke rumah masing-masing susulan keadaan cuaca semakin baik.

Di Kelantan, jumlah mangsa banjir yang dipindahkan menuju kepada 1,156 mangsa membebaskan 418 keluarga sehingga petang semalam, susulan cuaca semakin baik.

Semua mangsa banjir ditempatkan di 15 PPS di tiga daerah iaitu Kuala Krai, Tanah Merah dan Pasir Mas.

Berdasarkan Info Bencana Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM), Pasir Mas kekal menjejaskan mangsa paling ramai iaitu 1,010 orang daripada 377 keluarga, manakala Tanah Merah 79 mangsa daripada 23 keluarga dan 67 orang daripada 67 keluarga dipindahkan di Kuala Krai.

Portal ebanjir Kelantan mendapati, hanya satu sungai melepas parus bahaya iaitu Sungai Golok di Rantau Panjang yang mencatatkan bacaan 10.35 meter.

Pada masa sama, sebanyak 14 laluan ditutup membabitkan daerah Kuala Krai, Pasir Mas, Tanah Merah dan Tumpat berikutan dinaiki air.

Di Pahang, dua PPS di Kuantan dan Jerantut yang mempertahankan 38 mangsa daripada enam keluarga, ditutup mulai semalam.

Portal Info Bencana JKM melaporkan PPS Dewan Orang Ramai Sungai Ular ditutup pada jam 11.30 pagi selepas 25 mangsa daripada empat keluarga kembali

ke rumah masing-masing, manakala PPS Sekolah Kebangsaan Kuala Teh, Jerantut yang mempertahankan 13 mangsa daripada dua keluarga ditamatkan operasi pada jam 2.30 petang.

Bagaimanapun, Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS) melalui portal <http://infobanjir.water.gov.my> melaporkan Sungai Pangah di Lubuk Paku, Maran berada di paras waspada, manakala Sungai Yap, di Jerantut dan Sungai Lepar, di sini di paras amaran.

MB-MKN bincang isu Covid-19 di Selangor

SHAH ALAM: Kerajaan negeri akan berbincang dengan Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) dalam masa terdekat bagi membincangkan situasi di Selangor yang berterusan mencatat angka tertinggi jangkitan Covid-19.

Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, perbincangan ini termasuk berkaitan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Diperketatkan Secara Bersasar (Temco) di daerah Klang.

“Bagaimanapun, semua keputusan bergantung kepada situasi terkini kes Covid-19.

“Kita sememangnya perlu melihat terlebih dahulu keadaan kes sama ada masih terkawal atau sebaliknya.

“Oleh demikian, kita perlu mengadakan pertemuan dengan MKN,” kata beliau ketika ditemui pada majlis penyerahan sumbangan kebajikan sempena Sambutan Hari Krismas di Bangunan Setiausaha Kerajaan Negeri (SUK) di sini semalam.

Turut hadir, Pengurus Jawatankuasa Tetap Pelancongan, Alam Sekitar dan Teknologi Hijau serta Hal Ehwal Orang Asli negeri, Hee Loy Sian.

Semalam, Pengarah Kesihatan Selangor, Datuk Dr. Sha’ari Ngadiman memaklumkan enam individu termasuk kakitangan dan pesakit di Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah (HTAR) Klang dan Hospital Serdang disahkan positif Covid-19.

HTAR pula merekodkan empat kes positif melibatkan dua kakitangan dan dua pesakit sekali gus menjadikan jumlah

keseluruhan seramai 143 individu dijangkiti Covid-19.

Dalam pada itu, Amirudin berkata, kerajaan negeri bercadang melaksanakan ujian sarigan Covid-19 ke atas semua petugas dan kakitangan HTAR susulan peningkatan kes di hospital itu.

Katanya, perkara itu akan dibincangkan dengan Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Selangor (JKNS) dalam tempoh terdekat.

“Kerajaan negeri mahu mengetahui pasti langkah susulan yang perlu dilakukan termasuk menyaring semua petugas.

“Namun, kawasan hospital padat dan kita akan membincangkan mekanisme terbaik. “Bagaimanapun, ujian sarigan perlu dilakukan segera berikutkan petugas dan kakitangan hospital berdepan risiko tinggi jangkitan,” ujarnya.

Bilangan kes baharu positif Covid-19 semalam mencatatkan peningkatan iaitu 2,018 kes menjadikan jumlah keseluruhan penularan wabak itu kepada 95,327 kes dengan jumlah kes aktif sebanyak 16,496 kes.

Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Tan Sri Dr Noor Hisham Abdullah berkata, daripada jumlah kes baharu direkodkan itu, tujuh kes import dilaporkan manakala 2,011 kes lagi membabitkan penularan tempatan.

"Selangor kekal melaporkan kes harian baharu tertinggi iaitu sebanyak 1,204 kes diikuti Johor (278) dan Sabah (247).

"Sebanyak 243 kes dilaporkan adalah berkaitan kluster-kluster di penjara dan depot tahanan imigrasi membabitkan Kluster Tembok Gajah (234), Kluster

Penjara Jalan Harapan (6) dan Kluster Tembok (3)," katanya pada sidang media perkembangan Covid-19 di Putrajaya, semalam.

Dr Noor Hisham berkata, terdapat 109 kes positif Covid-19 sedang dirawat di unit rawatan rapi (ICU) dengan 55 kes memerlukan

bantuan pernafasan.

"Sebanyak 1,084 kes dilaporkan pulih hari ini (semalam) menjadikan jumlah kumulatif kes pulih sepuhnya adalah 78,393 kes atau 82.2 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan kes.

"Terdapat satu kes kematian dilaporkan membabitkan seorang lelaki bukan warganegara berusia 50 tahun yang tidak mempunyai latar belakang penyakit kronik di Tuaran, Sabah.

"Kes berkenaan menjadi jumlah kumulatif kematian sebanyak 438 kes atau 0.46 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan kes," katanya.

SHAH ALAM — Semua petugas dan kakitangan Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah (HTAR), Klang dicadangkan menjalani ujian saringan Covid-19 susulan peningkatan kes positif di hospital itu.

Menteri Besar Selangor, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, cadangan mengenainya akan dibincangkan bersama Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Selangor (JKNS) dalam tempoh terdekat.

"Kita akan membantu proses saringan itu dan JKNS dilihat tiada halangan untuk turut melaksanakannya.

"Namun, kawasan hospital itu agak padat dan kita akan membingkangi mekanisme terbaik bagi pelaksanaan tersebut kelak," katanya ketika ditemui pembeberapa selepas menyerahkan sum-



banggan kebajikan sempena Hari Krisman di Bangunan Setiausaha Kerajaan Negeri (SUK), di sini semalam.

Kosmol semalam melaporkan enam individu termasuk kakitangan dan pesakit di HTAR dan Hospital Serdang disahkan positif Covid-19.

HTAR merekodkan empat kes positif melibatkan dua kakitangan dan dua pesakit sekali gus menjadikan jumlah keseluruhan seramai 143 individu dijangkiti pandemik itu setakat kelmarin.

Amirudin menegaskan, ujian saringan itu perlu segera dilaku-

kan berikut petugas dan kakitangan hospital berdepan risiko tinggi jangkitan.

Ketika ditanya mengenai keruelan mengusulkan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan Diperketatkan Secara Bersasar (Temco) di daerah Klang, Amirudin memaklumkan perkara itu bergantung kepada situasi terkininya Co-vid-19.

"Kita akan menemui Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN) dalam masa terdekat bagi membincangkan situasi pandemik di negeri ini," katanya.

Dalam perkembangan sama, beliau menjelaskan Pasukan Petugas Pencegahan Covid-19 Selangor (STFC) sedang merangka beberapa langkah terbaru bagi menekang penularan pandemik sebelum mengumumkannya secara rasmi kelak.

15 NOVEMBER 2018

Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor diadakan menerima rasuah RM2 juta daripada Tan Sri Chai Kin Kong melalui cek milik Syarikat Aset Kayanas Sdn Bhd (AKSB) yang depositos ke dalam akaun CIMB Bank, Tadmansori Holdings Sdn Bhd.

12 DISEMBER 2018

Phak pendakwaan memanggil 23 saksi untuk memberi keterangan termasuk dua bekas Datuk Bandar Kuala Lumpur, Tan Sri Ahmad Phesut Talib dan Tan Sri Mohd Amin Nordin Abdul Aziz serta Pengarah AKSB, Kin Kong.

2 JULAI 2019

Mahkamah Tinggi memerintahkan Tengku Adnan membela diri selepas mendapat pihak pendakwaan berjaya membuktikan prima facie dalam kes tersebut.

- Didapati atau disyifarkan tidak sempurna akal atau Seorang bankrap belum lepas; atau

- Tidak menyerahkan apa-apa pernyataan perbelanjaan pilihan raya yang dikehendaki oleh undang-undang dalam masa dan mengikut yang dikehendaki sedemikian; atau

Hill of concern

Residents surrounding proposed development worry over effects if project given the green light

A PROPOSED development on a hillside in Ampang Jaya, Selangor has residents in the immediate surrounding areas worried.

Those staying at Kemensah Villa, Desa Ria 2, Kemensah Heights, Kemensah South and Pesona Villa fear for their safety if the proposed project is given the green light.

Kemensah Residents Committee (KRC) chairman Mohd Faizil Abdillah said the project should not be approved as they doubted the stability of the slope.

Faizil, who has stayed in the area for over 20 years, said the land was originally earmarked for

development 10 years ago.

"It was the same developer and we object to it now because we were told there would be no more development in the area when we moved here," he said.

"To make matters worse, we learnt that the density was increased from 60 units per acre to 80 units per acre," said Faizil.

The planned development is expected to have 1,300 maximum units and 55 affordable units under Bumipah Selangorku.

It is located in one of the residential areas in the vicinity in opposing the project.

"The moment this project stopped, "Faizil said in a phone interview.

The residents held a press conference on the anniversary of the Babi Anambangan landslide to underline their concerns.

Resident from the five most affected residential areas in Kemensah Heights also lodged a memorandum with the police station on Dec 8.

Orang Besar Marshall, Ahmad Teh, who was a pioneer in the development of Kemensah Heights, said the proposed development should be allowed in the area.

"The land here can only accommodate eight units per acre, not 80 units."

"We expect the new project will result in having additional 1,300

not suitable for high-density buildings," he said.

"That is why the residents would approach Housing and Local Government Ministry to review the plan," he said.

"Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) should verify the information provided by the developer's consultants."

He said a proposed road will compromise the stability of the slope.

Residents are also concerned that a rise in the number of people and vehicles will strain existing infrastructure.

"The land here can only accommodate eight units per acre, not 80 units."

"We have already seen cracks appearing on the hillside. We fear there was a sewage project, so every time it rains, the water will flow down. What will happen if heavy construction takes place on the hill?"

Residents were also unhappy that the proposed development would exceed the perimeter of the area, which was agreed upon by the developer before giving out the area, but did not contract any surveyor to do so.

"However, when residents were investigating the area, they found that the same rectangle with dimensions were different," he said.

When contacted, a spokesperson of the MPAJ said the developer did not wish to comment.


Electrical shop manager Nyew Hui King, 36, hoped the campaign would be a success.

Tapping into export through FTAs

KUALA LUMPUR: Companies, including small and medium enterprises, should leverage free trade agreements such as the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) to export to countries in the Asia Pacific region, according to speakers at the first Export Excellence Awards (EEA) 2021 webinar.

RCEP, ASEAN's biggest free trade agreement (FTA) to date, comprises all 10 ASEAN member states and five of ASEAN's existing FTA partners to cover a market of 2.2 billion people with a combined size of approximately US\$25tril (US\$101.21tril), which is about 29% of the world's gross domestic product.

Its primary purpose is to serve as an overarching mechanism to facilitate free trade between the 15 countries with a single set of rules and procedures for accessing preferential tariffs.

During his welcome speech, Star Media Group chairman Datuk Fu Ah Klow highlighted the importance of RCEP as a significant development that will bring about change to the overall business environment and reignite economic growth in the region.

"As we all know, Southeast Asia – including Malaysia – will benefit significantly from RCEP as this could mean access to China's Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) funds, as well as enhanced gains from market access via transport, energy and communications links."

"And RCEP's favorable rules of origin will also attract foreign investments into Malaysia and other member countries."

"This trade agreement is expected to make the ASEAN economies more efficient, linking their strengths in technology, manufacturing, agriculture and natural resources," he said.

Titled "Shaping The Future: Broadening Economic Networks and Opportunities", the webinar

saw keynote speaker International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Azmin Ali sharing insights into RCEP and its potential for Malaysian businesses.

"It will also open doors of opportunity to access a broader spectrum of new markets. With RCEP, import duties will be eliminated and reduced. There is no better time to consider exporting as barriers to entry and supply chains have been simplified. This will bode well with manufacturers who are seeking to make a mark in the international arena."

The scope of RCEP includes reducing tariffs on trade in goods, as well as creating higher-quality rules for trade in services, including market access provisions for service sector suppliers from other RCEP countries.

The RCEP agreement will also reduce non-tariff barriers to trade among member nations, such as customs and quarantine procedures as well as technical standards," he explained.

Standard Chartered Malaysia managing director and chief executive officer Abrar A. Anwar added that RCEP's recent signing brings a ray of light and hope amidst the clouds of the Covid-19 pandemic.

All hospital staff urged to undergo tests following rise in number of cases reported, says MB

THE Selangor government will conduct Covid-19 screening tests on Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital (HTAR) staff soon, following the rise in cases among them.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said a meeting would be held with the state Health Department before the screening begins.

"We will examine the best mechanism before conducting the screening, and I suggest that all HTAR staff undergo the tests.

"The state government is ready to help in carrying out the screening and I think the state Health Department has no problems with it," he told reporters after a charity contribution handing-over ceremony in conjunction with Selangor's Christmas celebration at the Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah Building here, yesterday.

On whether Klang will be

placed under an Enhanced Movement Control Order following the rise in number of cases, including in HTAR, Amirudin said the decision would be up to the National Security Council (NSC).

He said the increase in number of Covid-19 cases in the state, especially in Klang, was due to the screenings carried out by companies and factories that employed foreign workers.

Amirudin said that the Covid-19 screening test on foreign workers was made compulsory by the government to curb the spread of the virus after drawing a lesson from the Teratai cluster in Meru.

"I will also propose some new strategies to contain the spread of the virus at the meeting with the

NSC this week," he said.

Up to yesterday, a total of 143 Covid-19 cases were recorded at HTAR involving 63 hospital staff and 81 patients.

Yesterday, Selangor also recorded 441 new Covid-19 cases, with Klang continuing to record the highest number of cases at

121. It was followed by Hulu Langat with 118 cases; Petaling (90); Kuala Selangor (35); Gombak (31); Kuala Langat (22); Sepang (14); Sabak Bernam (6) and Hulu Selangor (4).

All staff at Klang hospital to be tested for virus

SHAH ALAM: Screening will be conducted on all staff at the Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital in Klang following a spike in Covid cases there.

Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said the state health department is looking into the best mechanism to implement, apart from targeted screening to reduce the risk of transmission at the hospital.

"I am in talks with the Selangor health department on the testing method to be used. We will screen all employees because they are considered high-risk," he said yesterday.

As of Sunday, there were 143 positive cases involving 62 health workers 81 patients at the hospital, while the Serdang Hospital had 65 cases involving 37 staff and 28 patients.

In another development, Amirudin said any enforcement of the movement control order to curb the rise in Covid-19 cases in Selangor would be decided by the National Security Council.

He said the Klang district recorded high daily numbers of Covid cases following the government's decision to make it mandatory to screen factory workers, especially foreign workers in the red zone.

"Although the number of cases has increased, the situation is still under control as we have made it a ruling that the workers must undergo screening and the cost to be borne by the factory management. - Bernama

守卫警员受指示, 凡进入检测范围者必须在完成检测后, 出示报告结果才可离开。结果, 今早前往现场执行采访工作的媒体, 进入检

测范围时没有被告知相关规定。

因此, 媒体代表在离开时, 纷纷被要求出示检测报告, 否则皆不得离开, 这一度让媒体代表们进退两难, 最终只好遵守当局的指示, 检测及等报告出炉才离开现场。

蔬果批發公司隱瞞員工確診 公衆斥草菅人命

(士拉央21日讯)士拉央市议员余深恩引述消息称，士拉央有一家蔬果批发公司，疑因担心遭卫生部下令关闭14天，竟隐瞒公司员工确诊的消息，更下达封口令要求员工不得对外宣扬。目前获悉，该公司疑有3名本地员工确诊。

他发表文告说，他接获公众投诉，指上述蔬果批发公司草菅人命，隐瞒员工确诊的事实，还指示确诊员工不得向卫生部透露工作的地点。

他透露，该公司在出现第一位员工确诊病例后，仅选择性安排员工进行冠病检测，全公司共有约20至30名本地及外籍员工，但只挑数人前往检测，结果其中两人就呈阳性反应。

指示不得透露工作地点

据悉，该公司至今已有3名本地员工确诊，其中一名员工的两名家属也证实确诊，目前已在双溪毛糯医院治疗。

“尽管如此，该公司依然指示员工必需如常上班，并封嘴不得将员工确诊的消息向外透露，这样的举措让其他还在工作的员工感忐忑不安，担心自己及家人的安全。”

余深恩强调，投诉者希望该公司如实呈报卫生部，包括告知过去14天与该公司确诊员工来往的顾客，同时安排其他员工进行检测，保障每个人的安全。

他提到，一般上，若一家公司出现员工确诊后，卫生部在追踪病毒来源时会上门并第一时间给予指示及判断同室员工是否应带上手环隔离，而隔离的天数也依照标准作业程序而定，所有指示皆会以白纸黑字通知。

他说，他将要求鹅麦县卫生部及警方调查该投诉的真伪，并建议该公司员工主动进行拭子测试，保障自身的安全，同时挺身而出照事实向卫生部通报。

他在沙亚南州政府大厦银禧纪念堂主持配合圣诞节，颁发24万令吉非伊斯兰宗教拨款给州内3个教会团体后，如是表示。

针对州政府会否建议把近来疫情暴增的巴生县，颁布为针对性加强行管令地区（TEMCO）时，他则表明，这要胥视当地疫情数据和状况；若疫情剧增，我们需采取行动；若情况受控，则可采取适当行动。

“颁布一个地区为针对性加强行管令、加强行管令、有条件行管令、复苏式行管令和行管令等措施，都是由国安会决定和宣布的。”

阿米鲁丁解释，雪州疫情暴增，很大原因是国安会强制所有厂工，尤其是外劳需进行检测所致，检测费则由雇主承担。

认同强制厂工主动检测措施

他认同，国安会强制厂工主动进行检测的措施，这好过政府完全无从掌握疫情，导致病毒在社区传开。

他不讳言，虽然雪州疫情上升但仍处控制阶段，我们则从莲花路的感染群中学到教训，即在制造业和工厂领域的工人，面对很高冠病风险，因此要求私人界承担费用方式，为他们进行筛检。（TKM）

將篩檢醫院職員及醫護員

随着巴生中央医院和沙登医院截至昨日累积208宗冠病确诊病例，阿米鲁丁强调，雪州政府将采取积极措施和州卫生局配合，近期为医院职员及医护人员展开筛检。

他提醒，民众遵守防疫标准作业程序和加倍关注，这期间卫生局和院方已限制到院的访客人数。但医院发生疫情并非首次，相信可获解决。

他说，为解决医院收治冠病确诊者的负担，作为“方舱医院”安顿低风险与低传染冠病确诊者的沙登农业博览馆（Maeps），有很大部分由州政府负责管理，约有五六成的医护人员是来自雪州政府的旗下。（TKM）

(巴生21日讯)为更有效控制巴生地区的疫情，成冠病疫情新爆发区的巴生中路大巴刹展开大筛检，估计有逾千人接受检测。

雪州发展机构（PKNS）便在商店旁的中路轻快铁第三路线（LRT3）高架铁轨下的空地，搭起毗连的帐篷展开筛检，预料检测工作会一路到晚上才结束。

今早上午9时开始，当局便为周遭外劳、工人和业者进行自愿性冠病快速检测，前来响应的人潮踊跃，估计超过千人，有者更是携家带眷一同进行检测，以求安心。

巴生县长兼县灾难管理委员会主席莫哈末再纳受询时证实，今天接受筛检者，确认有人结果呈阳

性，不过，他没披露确诊人数。

截至昨日，大巴刹早前主动进行筛检的100名商贩中已有42人确诊；另有15名外劳确诊，但不包括在首度筛检呈阳、次轮筛检却呈阴性的两名外劳。

快速检测25分钟测出结果

负责大巴刹管区的巴生市议员严玉梅受询表示，大规模筛检是采用自愿和免费检测模式，鼓励住在大巴刹附近和在大巴刹工作的外劳、员工及业者前来，并使用可在25分钟内测出检测结果的快速检测（rapid test）。

她披露，检测者本身会接获通知，若结果呈阳性（确诊），则会马上被送往合适地点进行隔离。

她解释，今早的大筛检是始于当局在前日开会所下的决定：据知，雪州政府与雪州防疫特工队上周六召开会议，特安排大巴刹外劳今日进行大范围筛检。

大巴刹是在本月7日传出确诊，一名鱼贩被指高烧不退，随著身边亲友确诊后，才去进行检测，结果证实染疫。（TKM）
