# Malaysia kekal pilihan pelabur

## Inisiatif Permit Pembinaan Ekspres bantu kurang karenah birokralis

**Kulim:** Malaysia dijangka akan menjadi destinasi utama pelabur asing berikutan usaha kerajaan mempercepatkan proses kelulusan melalui inisiatif E10 (Permit Pembinaan Ekspres), sekali gus membantu mengurangkan karenah birokralis.

Menteri Kanan Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali, berkata inisiatif diperkenal Lembaag Pembangunan Pelaburan Malaysia (MIDA) itu akan menjadikan penanda aras baharu dalam

memperkuuh keyakinan pelabur asing ke Malaysia.

Katanya, dasar dan agenda dibawa kerajaan di bawah Rancangan Malaysia Ke-12 (RMK-12) serta Aspirasi Pelaburan Nasional (NIA) turut memberi penekanan kepada elemen alam sekitar, sosial dan tadbir urus (ESG).

"Ini adalah elemen penting perlu diperkenal bagi menarik pelabur asing ke Malaysia. Negara berada pada kedudukan strategik kerana menjadi anggota penting dalam Perjanjian Perkongsian Ekonomi Komprehensif Serantau (RCEP) yang dapat menjamin pasaran baharu serantau serta kalangan negara anggota RCEP.

"Pelabur bukan melihat insentif diberi kerajaan saja, tetapi melihat secepat mana kita membuat keputusan dan apakah tenaga kerja boleh ditawarkan serta kemudahan mampu disediakan kepada pelabur," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika ditemui selepas merasmikan Majlis Pecah Tanah Kilang Per-

dustrian AT&S di Kulim Hi-Tech Park, di sini semalam. Yang turut hadir, Menteri Besar, Muhammad Sanusi Md Nor.

Mohamed Azmin berkata, mengambil contoh pelaburan dibuat AT&S, ia adalah suatu rekod kerana hanya mengambil masa 12 bulan hasil usaha inisiatif E10 yang berjaya mempercepatkan kelulusan di peringkat Persekutuan, negeri dan pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT).

"AT&S adalah peneraju global pembuatan papan litar bercetak (PCB) dan litar bersepadu (IC) berprestasi tinggi berpangkalan di Austria. Mereka memilih Kedah untuk kemudahan pengeluaran pertamanya di Asia Tenggara dengan pelaburan fasa pertama berjumlah RM8.5 bilion.

"Ia adalah pelaburan terbesar dalam sejarah syarikat ini, bakal mencipta 1,500 peluang pekerjaan dalam kalangan jurutera dan 4,500 pekerjaan dalam kalangan pekerja kolar biru selain 6,000 anak tempatan diambil bekerja," katanya.

# 54 kebun komuniti MPAJ rebut hadiah RM28,000

**Ampang Jaya:** Sebanyak 54 kebun komuniti di bawah pentadbiran Majlis Perbandaran Ampang Jaya (MPAJ) menyertai pertandingan kebun komuniti bagi rebut hadiah keseluruhan bernilai RM28,000.

Yang Dipertua MPAJ Mohd Fauzi Mohd Yatim berkata, pertandingan sebagai dorongan dan sokongan kepada pengusaha kebun komuniti dalam menuju ke arah bandar rendah karbon.

"Untuk makluman, terdapat 54 kebun komuniti dan kebun sekolah yang berdaftar di bawah program komuniti MPAJ.

"Pertandingan ini adalah kali kedua dianjurkan dan hadiah kemenangan diberikan hasil daripada caj beg plastik," katanya ketika di temui selepas melancarkan pertandingan kebun komuniti di Pangsapuri Cemara di sini, semalam.

Mohd Fauzi berkata, sehingga Oktober ini, pihaknya berjaya mengumpul

RM400,000 hasil daripada caj penggunaan beg plastik di kawasan pentadbiran MPAJ.

"Hasil daripada caj ini akan disalurkan kepada program alam sekitar dan aktiviti kemasyarakatan.

"Sebab itu saya sentiasa menggalakkan ahli majlis supaya meneruskan kempen alam sekitar di kawasan mereka," katanya.

Mengulas berhubung kebun komuniti, beliau berkata, pelaksanaan kebun komuniti pada peringkat awal adalah untuk mengindahkan kawasan tanah terbiar dan sebagai bekalan makanan kepada warga kebun.

"Bagaimanapun, terdapat kebun komuniti yang mengorak langkah dengan mengambil inisiatif menghasilkan produk mereka tersendiri.

"Kebun komuniti juga antara perancangan kejiranan hijau yang digariskan dalam garis panduan kejiranan hijau," katanya.

SELAYANG Municipal Council (MPS) has managed to collect assessment fees amounting to RM86.7mil (79.57%) from the projected RM109mil as at Sept 30.

The council collected RM6.1mil (74.91%) from the outstanding arrears of RM8.15mil, MPS president Mohd Yazid Sairi said during a full board meeting.

He said notices (in Form E) were issued on Sept 1 to property owners with assessment arrears.

"A warrant of RM100 will be issued, starting Oct 21, to ratepayers with arrears," he said.

He disclosed that 73,368 overdue notices expired on Oct 20.

"The public can check and make payments through the MyMPS portal," he added.

To encourage residents to pay up, MPS organised a campaign in villages and at low-cost housing areas.

"Property owners who make full payment will get a reduction in charges and the warrant against them will be cancelled.

"All information on eligibility for cancellation of warrants is available at the MPS assessment payment counter," said Mohd Yazid.

From Oct 25 to Dec 31, renewal of business licences can be done online.

Business owners are required to update their information and make payments at [lesendigital.mps.gov](http://lesendigital.mps.gov), then print out their business licence for display.

"The MyMPS initiative is to facilitate the licence renewal process so that people do not have to be physically present at the counter," Mohd Yazid highlighted.

"However, the payment process for licences for liquor, massage and reflexology parlours, cybercafes, hotels, visual or billboard licences including those from unauthorised factories, as well as scrap items and quarries, must be made through MyMPS and applicants must collect their licence from the Licensing Department.





"The setting up of MDIC will enable cooperation with various smart partners encompassing medical device producer ministry and government agencies, international innovation centres and university research institutes. It will also air enhance access to the medical device market and create a community of joint practices that manage and commerce new technologies," he said at the launch of MDIC in Kulim Hi-Tech Park here.

The launch of MDIC was officiated by Senior Minister and Minister of International Trade and Industry Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali. Sirim chairman Tan Sri Dr Ahmad Tajuddin Ali was also present at the event.

Ahmad Sabirin said MDIC was established following feedbacks obtained by Sirim from the medical device industry and related government agencies which among others raised issues and challenges faced by the industry.

The main challenges posed by all levels of the industry are limited resources in conducting product R&D due to lack of financial resources, infrastructure facilities, and highly skilled workers.

Meanwhile, multinational companies are facing difficulties in securing human resources with specific expertise to lead their technological direction.

There are about 50 major local companies and 120 small and medium enterprises which focus on latex-based products such as surgical gloves, disposable products, and furniture used by hospitals, according to the Sirim chief.

"The issue of market access is faced by all categories of the industry, especially the stringent rules of European and U.S. markets. All categories of the industry are worried about the lack of technical and local talent to fulfil their needs," he said.

Three major programmes will be implemented by MDIC involving advanced technological innovations for local SMEs, Industry 4.0 technologies adopted by large local companies, and major vendor projects to be joined by multinationals companies and local SMEs.

Sirim will strengthen the country's medical device ecosystem through testing, inspection, and certification as well as business strategy services in order to help local companies penetrate global markets, he said.

"MDIC will also implement manufacturing innovation incubator, open laboratory and 'teaching factory' which will engage network of public and private collaboration to be realised," he added.

Ahmad Sabirin said in view of the pandemic faced by the country, MDIC can be a platform for information and experience sharing to enhance the medical device industry through technology and innovation, apart from supporting its ecosystem via infrastructure facilities and services. — Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 29 — An allocation of RM2.1 billion for programmes and initiatives proposed in Budget 2022 responded to the immediate need to revive the country's economy and attract new high-quality, high-tech and green investments.

Senior Minister cum International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali said the government's efforts were in line with the 12th Malaysia Plan (12MP) and Malaysia's National Investment Aspirations (NIA) which placed environmental, social and governance (ESG) elements.

"Among the initiatives contained in Budget 2022 to attract foreign direct investment (FDI) and increase local capacity include the Special Strategic Investment Fund to attract strategic foreign investment among multinational companies."

"This is specifically what can complete the industry value chain and drive the creation of knowledge-based jobs and t development of local small and medium enterprises (SMEs) with the proposed RM2 billion allocation," he told a press conference after the tabling of Budget 2022 by Finance Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Zafirul Abdul Aziz today.

Azmin said other initiatives to attract FDI included the Trade and Investment Mission to explore high-impact investment and export markets with an allocation of RM25 million; PMKS Halal Product Digital Branding and PMKS Halal Product Marketability Enhancement programme (RM25 million); and Industry4WRD to encourage technological transformation towards the fourth industrial revolution among SMEs (RM45 million).

Meanwhile, Azmin said investment inflows to Malaysia have been more labour intensive and caused the country to be dependent on foreign workers.

"Today alone we have more than five million foreign workers while I am confident that local youths have the potential skills if they were given the opportunity to hone their talents and skills," he said.

Hence, he said the incentives provided to woo strategic investment to Malaysia would not only bring high-quality investment, but also create high-quality jobs for young people.

"For this year, Miti is expected to attract RM20 billion in investment and create about 114,000 jobs. Most of the FDI expected to come from the manufacturing sector, accounting for RM140 billion," he said.

He is confident that through the incentives proposed in Budget 2022, Miti will be able to attract investment for 2022 surpasses this year's performance. — Bernama

他说，小贩摊档往往非法搭建，有者在路边、转角处等，还有霸占道路和沟渠，工业区重型车辆穿梭，或停泊在路边光顾非法小贩，导致道路环境充满盲点、交通阻塞，处处暗藏杀机，非常危险。

“小贩也带来食物安全、卫生等问题，因此不得不正视。”

他说，非法小贩太多，也对缴付租金、执照费的合法小贩不公平，存在抢客问题，让合法小贩面临损失。

#### 存食物卫生問題

他指出，市议会其实有一项条例，即大型工厂必须内设员工食堂，惟多年来似乎没有严厉执行，导致员工光顾非法小贩，以致非法小贩问题越来越严重。

他说，市议会在日前的会议上，已议决严厉实行这项条例，未来所有新建工厂在，都必须设立员工食堂。

他指出，厂家过去没有遵守这项条例，主要是因为工业地价格昂贵，相信厂家都选择把土地建设在利益建筑之上，忽视设立食堂的条例。

他说，当地目前现有的12个摊档，只有2间有小贩租借。

他劝请非法小贩不要挑战法律，迁入合法摊档，避免遭到对付，市议会早前便已经拆除了多个非法摊档。



# 巴生市會邀約議員居協商處理固體廢料方案

这项圆桌会议活动于周五在巴生市议会韩沙礼堂举行，共获得155位人民代议士和居协民代表参与讨论，其中出席的州议员有巴生港口区州议员阿兹米占、班达马兰区州议员梁德志、圣淘沙区州议员古纳拉加和巴生中路区州议员莫哈末法克鲁兹。

阿末法兹里主持圆桌会议时说，巴生市议会需处理的固体废料分成好几个种类，包括住家固体废料、进口固体废料、商业固体废料、机构固体废料、建筑固体废料、工业固体废料以及公共固体废料。

“垃圾土埋场日趋饱和，这成了巴生或大马其他地区需处理的问题。不完善的收垃圾制度，也促使了垃圾土埋场的垃圾越来越多。”

### 忧土埋场不堪负荷

他直言，如果按这样的趋势下去，令人担忧现有的垃圾土埋场很快就会不堪负荷，寿命殆尽。

“垃圾承包商没有效率或按时处理固体废料，也是造成垃圾问题的原因之一。如果没按时清理

垃圾，就会衍生环境卫生问题，包括飘臭或引来蚊虫滋生，甚至传染疾病。”

他认为，法律途径是其中一个可以达到控管效果的措施，尤其地方政府持续性执法，能警惕各造更谨慎处理垃圾问题。

不过他也认为，除了法律途径，举办回收活动也有助于提高人民的醒觉意识，况且资源回收还能降低固体废料丢弃的问题。

班达马兰区州议员梁德志说，尽管达鲁益山清理承包商有提供前来处理大型垃圾的服务，但巴生许多民众并不知情，因此一些民众选择将大型垃圾丢弃在路旁或非法垃圾堆。

他建议垃圾承包商，不妨设一个固定时间，即可在每一区每月一次置放大型垃圾槽，以提供周边的民众丢弃大型垃圾，或许就能有效解决民众乱丢垃圾恶习。

另外，梁德志也建议市议会加强执法工作，取缔非法垃圾堆黑区，惟有揪出及严惩垃圾虫，才能“杀鸡儆猴”，杜绝其他人仿效。(BPK)
