# Malaysia, Singapura setuju perluas inisiatif VTL-Darat

**Singapura:** Malaysia dan Singapura semalam bersetuju memperluaskan inisiatif Laluan Perjalanan Lengkap Vaksin (VTL-Darat) dengan memasukkan semua kategori perjalanan membabitkan penduduk kedua-dua negara.

Bagaimanapun, kebenaran itu tertakluk kepada syarat keperluan kesihatan kedua-dua negara.

Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, berkata belum berbincang dengan rakan sejawatannya dari Singapura,

Lee Hsien Loong mengenai langkah tambahan yang akan dilakukan oleh kedua-dua negara berhubung perjalanan rentas sempadan antara Malaysia dan Singapura.

Ketika ini inisiatif Laluan Perjalanan Lengkap Vaksin (VTL-Darat) hanya membenarkan warga Malaysia, Singapura, dan pemastautin serta pemilik Pas Jangka Panjang Singapura atau Singapura.

## Rakyat dua negara manfaat pembukaan semula sempadan

"Mereka (Singapura) juga bersetuju untuk memperluaskan VTL-Darat dengan memasukkan laluan perkhidmatan bas tambahan melalui Link Kedua, kereta api yang dikendalikan oleh Keretapi Tanah Melayu (KTM) dan secara berperingkat membabitkan kenderaan peribadi seperti motosikal dan kereta."

"Kami mengakui bahawa pembukaan semula sempadan adalah penting untuk mengaktifkan semula aktiviti sosial dan ekonomi rentas sempadan yang akan memberi manfaat kepada rakyat kedua-dua negara."

"Kami berharap dengan berbuat demikian, ia akan memberi peluang kepada lebih ramai penduduk di kedua-dua belah tanah yang telah berjauhan dengan keluarga akibat pandemik COVID-19 dapat bersatu semula dengan orang tersayang," kata Perdana Menteri.

Ismail Sabri berada di sini dalam rangka lawatan rasmi sehingga Singapura atas jemputan Lee.

Ini adalah lawatan rasmi pertama beliau ke republik Singapura sebagai Perdana Menteri dan lawatan kedua ke negara jiran sejak mengangkat sumpah sebagai Perdana Menteri Malaysia kesembilan pada 21 Ogos lalu.

Kedua-dua pemimpin turut membincangkan pergerakan/perjalanan rentas sempadan antara Singapura dan destinasi seperti Pulau Pinang, Langkawi, Kuching dan Kota Kinabalu di Malaysia.

"Kami berdua memutuskan agar pegawai dari kedua-dua negara harus mula merangka langkah-langkah bagi tujuan ini," katanya.

Pagi semalam, Ismail Sabri melakukan perjalanan bersejarah dengan melintasi Tambak Johor dan disambut oleh Perdana Menteri Singapura di Woodlands Checkpoint.

Beliau bersama Hsien Loong kemudian melancarkan Laluan Perjalanan Vaksinasi (VTL) melalui udara dan sempadan darat antara Malaysia dan Singapura di Woodlands Checkpoint.

"Ini dengan sendirinya sangat penting kerana pada masa sama, kami turut melancarkan VTL-Udara. Ia adalah sebahagian daripada pembukaan semula sempadan negara secara beransur-ansur untuk memudahkan perjalanan antara kedua-dua negara," kata beliau.

Pada sebelah tengah hari, Ismail Sabri dan Hsien Loong telah mengadakan pertemuan empat mata di Istana.

Perdana Menteri turut diberi penghormatan apabila satu spesies hibrid angkerik baharu dinamakan sempena namanya, dan beliau kemudian membuat kunjungan hormat ke atas Presiden Singapura Halimah Yacob.

Turut serta dalam lawatan itu ialah Menteri Kanan Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali; Menteri Pengangkutan, Datuk Seri Dr Wee Ka Siong dan Menteri Luar, Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah.

Bercakap kepada wartawan Malaysia di akhir lawatan, Ismail Sabri berkata beliau berharap perbincangan dapat dilakukan dengan Thailand.

Beliau juga berharap untuk

mewujudkan lebih banyak laluan seperti 'green travel bubble' dengan Australia, New Zealand, Jepun, Korea Selatan dan sebahagian provinsi di China.

Sementara itu, Ismail Sabri berkata kedua-dua mereka ber-setuju mengenai keperluan untuk terus membincangkan mekanisme dua hala sedia ada antara mereka.

"Ini termasuk Pemukiman Pemimpin Tahunan ke-10, yang tidak dapat diadakan sejak dua tahun lalu akibat pandemik COVID-19. Insya-Allah, kami akan mengadakan Pemukiman Pemimpin pada suku pertama tahun depan dan berharap dapat kembali semula ke Singapura," kata beliau.

Dalam pertemuan itu, kedua-dua pemimpin turut menyentuh situasi di Myanmar.

"Kami bersetuju adalah penting bagi ASEAN untuk terus memainkan peranan yang positif dan membina dalam memudahkan penyelesaian kukuh dan aman demi kepentingan Myanmar serta Komuniti ASEAN," katanya.

## Eksport Malaysia cecah RM1 trillion

Nilai kukuh bagi 10 bulan 2021 sejajar pemulihan ekonomi global

**Nilai eksport** Malaysia melepas paras RM1 trillion dalam tempoh 10 bulan kepada RM1.004 trillion, meningkat 25 peratus daripada RM803.3 billion yang dicatatkan tempoh sama tahun lalu.

Menteri Kanan Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali, berkata angka eksport negara untuk tempoh dikaji juga melebihi jumlah keseluruhan eksport tahun lalu RM983.8 billion.

"Eksport turut mengatasi nilai tahunan tertinggi setakat ini yang dicatatkan pada 2018. Import berkembang 21.8 peratus kepada RM801.17 billion dan lebihan dagangan melonjak 39.2 peratus kepada RM202.58 billion.

"Perdagangan, eksport, import dan lebihan dagangan mencatatkan nilai tertinggi bagi perdagangan, eksport, import

tempoh ini," katanya.

Bagi tempoh Januari hingga Oktober 2021, hampir semua barang merekodkan pertumbuhan eksport dengan barang perikilangan meningkat 25 peratus kepada RM866.48 billion berbanding tempoh sama 2020, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan eksport barang elektrik dan elektronik (E&E), keluaran petroleum, keluaran getah, barang perikilangan logam serta kimia dan bahan kimia.

Eksport keluaran pertanian naik 33.5 peratus kepada RM77.04 billion berikutan pertambahan eksport minyak sawit serta keluaran pertanian berdasarkan minyak sawit dan getah asli.

Bagi eksport hasil galian pula, ia berkembang 15.3 peratus kepada RM56.43 billion didorong oleh peningkatan eksport gas asli cecair (LNG), bijih logam dan serpihan logam serta petroleum mentah.

Menurut Kementerian Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri (MITI), perdagangan Malaysia terus merekodkan prestasi memberangsangkan pada Oktober 2021 apabila sekali lagi mencatatkan rekod nilai bulanan tertinggi masing-masing bagi perdagangan, eksport, import

dan lebihan dagangan.

Perdagangan berkembang 26.5 peratus kepada RM202.61 billion berbanding Oktober 2020, melepas paras RM200 billion buat kali pertama dan menjadi pertumbuhan dua angka yang kesemua bulan berturut-turut sejak Februari 2021.

"Eksport naik 25.5 peratus kepada RM114.43 billion, pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun ke-14 bulan berturut-turut sejak September 2020.

"Import meningkat 27.9 peratus kepada RM88.18 billion dan lebihan dagangan berkembang 17.9 peratus kepada RM26.25 billion.

"Pertumbuhan eksport disumbangkan terutama oleh ke-nakan eksport keluaran petro-

leum, barang perikilangan logam, barang E&E, kimia dan bahan kimia serta minyak sawit dan keluaran pertanian berdasarkan minyak sawit," katanya.

MITI menambah, eksport barang perikilangan logam dan barang E&E mencatatkan nilai bulanan tertinggi setakat ini.

"Sementara itu, eksport ke pasaran utama khasnya ASEAN, China, Amerika Syarikat (AS), Kesatuan Eropah (EU) dan Jepun merekodkan pertumbuhan dua angka. Eksport ke ASEAN mencatatkan nilai bulanan tertinggi," katanya.

Ketua Perangkawan, Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, dalam kenyataan berasangan ber-

kata, pencapaian dicatatkan itu adalah tempoh terpanas nilai eksport mencecah RM1 trillion pernah direkodkan.

"Nilai eksport yang kukuh bagi 10 bulan 2021 adalah sejajar dengan pemulihan ekonomi global. Pembukaan aktiviti ekonomi di lebih banyak negara memandakan permintaan luar yang lebih baik," katanya.

Sementara itu, Ketua Ahli Ekonomi Bank Islam Malaysia Bhd, Dr Mohd Afzanizam Abdul Rashid, berkata pertumbuhan Keluaran Dalam Negara Kasar (KDNK) pada suku keempat bakal mencatat pertumbuhan yang positif jika perkembangan positif dalam perdagangan berterusan.

"Seharusnya pencapaian itu boleh menjadi pemicung kepada pertumbuhan dalam sektor pembuatan dan perkhidmatan berikutnya. Malaysia adalah negara pedang."

"Sudah tentu industri yang menyokong perdagangan antarabangsa seperti sektor logistik, kewangan dan insurans, teknologi maklumat dan komunikasi (ICT) juga akan mendapat manfaat secara langsung terhadap perkembangan positif perdagangan antarabangsa," katanya.

**K**es keganasan rumah tangga di Selangor meningkat tahun ini, dengan 1,519 kes direkodkan mulai Januari hingga Oktober lalu berbanding 1,349 kes pada 2020.

**Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Tetap Kesihatan Awam, Perpaduan dan Pembangunan Wanita dan Keluarga negeri, Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud** berkata, pada 2018, sebanyak 951 kes direkodkan dan ia meningkat kepada 1,159 kes pada 2019.

“Berikutnya peningkatan kes ini, kerajaan negeri mengambil inisiatif dengan menyediakan Talian SELamat sebagai talian khas untuk masyarakat membuat aduan mengenai keganasan rumah tangga yang berlaku khususnya di Selangor.

“Inisiatif ini sudah beroperasi sejak 1 November lalu dan sehingga 24 November, talian SELamat menerima 14 panggilan yang tujuh daripadanya adalah berkaitan keganasan rumah tangga membabitkan psikologi, fizikal dan ekonomi,” katanya pada Sidang Dewan Negeri Selangor (DNS) di sini, semalam.

Beliau menjawab pertanyaan **Juwairiya Zulkifli (PH-Bukit Melawati)** berkenaan keganasan rumah tangga di Selangor.

Mengulas lanjut, Dr Siti Mariah berkata, semua kes yang diterima bukan kecemasan dan panggilan bertujuan mendapatkan khidmat kaunseling bagi membantu mereka daripada segi pengurusan emosi.

“Talian SELamat memberikan pilihan kepada pemanggil untuk mendapatkan sesi kaunseling atau intervensi selanjutnya di badan bukan kerajaan (NGO) serta kaunselor Talian Sahabat di bawah Pusat Kaunseling Pejabat Setiausaha

Kerajaan Negeri Selangor yang mempunyai kaunselor bertauliah secara bersempena atau secara dalam talian,” katanya.

Beliau berkata, talian SELamat beroperasi 24 jam menerusi talian 03-64195027 di bawah kendalian Wanita Berdaya Selangor (WBS).

Katanya, WBS akan turut berkongsi maklumat mengenai Talian SELamat di laman sosial WBS (Facebook dan Instagram), Pusat Wanita Berdaya (PWB) di 56 kawasan Dewan Undangan Negeri (Dun) serta di pejabat rakan usaha sama sebagai langkah menyebarkan kesedaran dan advokasi berkenaan KRT.


Operasi bermula pukul 6.30 pagi sehingga 9 malam kelmarin melibatkan 10 orang penembak.

# 1,519 kes keganasan rumah tangga tahun ini

Selangor catat 4,978 kes dalam tempoh tiga tahun sejak 2018

**S**elangor mencatatkan sebanyak 4,978 kes keganasan rumah tangga dalam tempoh bermula tahun 2018 sehingga Oktober lalu.

Menyatakan perkataan Amirudin Shari berkata, perincian kes mengikut tahun adalah 951 kes (2018), 1,159 kes (2019), 1,349 kes (2020) dan 1,519 kes dalam tempoh Januari sehingga Oktober 2021.

"Berdasarkan statistik Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM), jumlah kes ke-

ganasan rumah tangga dilaporkan di Selangor mulai 2018 sehingga Oktober 2021 mencatatkan jumlah keseluruhan sebanyak 4,978 kes," katanya ketika sesi Mesyuarat Kedua Persidangan Penggal Keempat Dewan Negeri Selangor ke-14 di sini pada Isnin.

Amirudin berkata demikian bagi menjawab pertanyaan **Juwairiya Zulkifli (PKR-Bukit Melawati)** mengenai jumlah kes keganasan rumah tangga yang dicatatkan di Selangor sejak tahun 2018 sehingga kini.

Dalam pada itu, Amirudin berkata, kerajaan negeri mengambil inisiatif menyediakan Talian SELamat sebagai talian khas untuk masyarakat membuat aduan tentang keganasan

rumah tangga yang berlaku khususnya di Selangor.

"WBS turut berkongsi maklumat dan informasi mengenai Talian SELamat di laman sosial WBS (Facebook dan Instagram), Pusat Wanita Berdaya (PWB) di 56 kawasan DUN serta di pejabat rakan usaha sama," katanya.

## Pengurusan Skim Smart Sewa Selangor terdapat kelemahan - LKAN

**SHAH ALAM** - Laporan Ketua Audit Negara (LKAN) Mengenai Aktiviti Agensi dan Pengurusan Syarikat Kerajaan Selangor 2019 Siri 2 yang dibentangkan di Dewan Negeri Selangor pada Isnin mendapati beberapa kelemahan dikenal pasti dalam aspek pengurusan Skim Smart Sewa di Lembaga Perumahan dan Hartanah Selangor.

Ketua Audit Negara, Datuk Nik Azman Nik Abdul Majid berkata, antara kelemahan tersebut seperti kontrak tidak ditandatangani, surat tawaran lewat dikeluaran kepada penyewa, tiada surat pembaharuan sewaan antara Hartanah Selangor serta Perumahan dan Hartanah Selangor Sdn Bhd (PHSSB) dan penyewa serta pengurusan sewa yang kurang cekap.

“Secara keseluruhannya skim tersebut dapat membantu rakyat Selangor yang masih tidak memiliki kediaman dan gagal mendapatkan pinjaman perumahan supaya dapat menyewa kediaman yang disediakan oleh kerajaan negeri dengan kadar sewa yang berpatutan,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan pada Isnin.

Namun katanya, pembelian unit kediaman skim itu tidak mencapai sasaran yang ditetapkan dan penilaian keberhasilan belum pernah disediakan oleh Lembaga Perumahan dan Hartanah Selangor serta PHSSB bagi mengukur keberkesanan program tersebut.

Bagi pengurusan syarikat kerajaan negeri, Nik Azman berkata, objektif penubuhan Worldwide Holdings Bhd

(WHB) secara keseluruhannya telah tercapai dalam projek pembangunan kediaman untuk rakyat Selangor dan perkhidmatan pengurusan alam sekitar.

“Bagaimanapun, projek Amber dan Azalea yang dipilih sebagai sampel audit mengalami kelewatan penyiapan iaitu melebihi tempoh munasabah penyiapan projek mengikut standard Jabatan Kerja Raya,” katanya.

Menurut beliau, projek Amber hanya dapat disiapkan dalam masa 48 bulan manakala projek Azalea siap dalam masa 44 bulan dari tempoh yang ditetapkan dalam kontrak dan wujud kelemahan dalam pengurusan penjualan projek kediaman seperti pemberian diskain yang tidak teratur dan kadar harga jualan rumah yang melebihi nilai Jabatan Penilaian dan Perkhidmatan Harta.

“Tapak Pelupusan Sisa Pepejal Secara Sanitari juga kurang cekap dalam menguruskan perjanjian pengoperasian iaitu kontrak pelupusan sisa pepejal lewat atau tidak ditandatangani dengan pihak berkuasa tempatan terlibat,” katanya.

Katanya, bagi aspek tadbir urus syarikat itu adalah baik namun perlu penambahbaikan dalam aspek pengerusi, lembaga pengarah, setiausaha syarikat, prosedur operasi standard, jawatankuasa audit, jawatankuasa pencalonan dan jawatankuasa imbuhan.

“Kewangan WHB masih kukuh dengan mencatatkan lebihan keuntungan sebelum cukai,” katanya. - Bernama

## 87.8% of adult population have received Covid jabs

SOME 87.8% of the adult population in Selangor have had at least their first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine.

State public health, welfare, women empowerment and family committee chairman Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud said this meant that about 275,237 of those aged above 18 had yet to be vaccinated.

"A small percentage of those yet to be vaccinated are those who are

unable to get the vaccine or will have contraindications to the vaccine, while the rest have rejected the vaccine.

"The health districts' public outreach teams are reaching out to those who are unable to get to PPVs," she said.

Siti Mariah added that some 73,653 of 569,100 children aged 12 to 17 had yet to receive their first dose and efforts to get them vacci-

nated were being carried out by the state education department, district education office as well as non-governmental organisations.

Siti Mariah was responding to Elizabeth Wong (PH-Bukit Lanjan), who asked for an update on Selangor residents who had yet to be vaccinated.

She also said that only 132 civil servants out of 22,314 (based on

Human Resource Management Information System 2.0) had refused or were yet to receive their vaccinations.

"The Public Service Department had issued a circular requiring all public servants to be vaccinated

"Those who still remain unvaccinated from Nov 1, without being exempted for health issues, can be subject to disciplinary action," Siti Mariah added.

## Causeway finally reopens

Land crossings allowed again after 20-month closure

SINGAPORE: The 16km Singapore-Causeway, one of the longest border crossings in the world, has officially reopened with the launch of the Land Transport Management (LTM) Land.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob and his Singapore counterpart Lee Hsien Long were at the Woodlands Causeway yesterday to jointly launch the scheme yesterday.

The 97-year-old Causeway, also known as Tanah Jolok, was closed to the public for nearly two years after it was closed to all travellers since mid-March 2020 to curb the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Ismail Sabri crossed the 1km bridge to enter the Singaporean side while Lee Hsien Long was welcomed by Lee, who was accompanied by his wife and daughters.

Accompanying Ismail Sabri were Senior Minister and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Dr Wee Kim Wee, Transport Minister Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah, Transport Minister Datuk Seri Dr Wee Ka Siong and John Ibrahim, Besar Darul Hauz Muhammad.

With the reopening of the causeway and Coordinating Minister for National Security Teo Chee Hean, Foreign Minister Dr Vivian Balakrishnan, Trade and Industry

# RM174mil allocated for pipe replacement works

SELANGOR government has allocated RM174mil for next year as part of the state's pipe replacement programme, which aims to improve the quality of water supply services in the state.

Selangor infrastructure and public amenities, agriculture modernisation and agro-based industry committee chairman Izham Hashim said that the cost would comprise the design, site management and construction for the pipe replacement works.

"Between 2017 and 2019, the state allocated RM248.7mil to Air Selangor to carry out the works.

Allotment comprises design, site management and construction costs, says exco member

"As of October, the non-revenue water (NRW) recorded for Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya was 28.5% and we expect to have this figure down to 28% by the end of this year.

"In comparison, the national NRW figure last year was 36.4%," he said in response to a question by Lee Kee Hiong (PH-Kuala Kubu Baru).

Izham said they hoped to achieve

a minimum 1% reduction in NRW each year, with a target of 25% by 2025.

During the tabling of the state budget last week, Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said pipe replacement works estimated to involve 6,000km would be carried out.

On protecting Selangor's rivers from contamination, Amirudin said the state used the "polluters pay

principle" (PPP) where those found to have caused the contamination would be forced to pay the price.

To address flooding in the state, Amirudin said they proposed to allocate RM9.25mil for flood mitigation projects at Sungai Langat, Sungai Klang and Sungai Selangor river basins.

He said this would be done together with Federal allocation to resolve flooding holistically.

## Flashing out flood forecasts

A SYSTEM is being developed to predict flash floods in Kuala Lumpur.

The National Flood Forecasting, Warning System (NFFWS), which comprises three phases, is expected to be completed by the end of 2023.

The warning system will allow the Kuala Lumpur Drainage and Irrigation Department (DID) to use data provided by the Malaysian Meteorological Department to forecast floods and issue alerts.

The first phase of the project, costing RM10 million, started in May. This phase is intended to increase the number of hydrolog-

ical stations to collect data such as rainfall, river water level and water levels from retention areas in real time.

The system will also be used in the Malacca River Flood Model that will be developed in the second phase.

In the third phase, upon development of the system, it will be able to issue flood warnings between 12 hours and 24 hours in advance.

DID Agency director Rama Rajah Steepangganan said the department detect possible flooding within 10 minutes.

"Currently the contractor is installing instruments to collect data from various areas such as Sungai Relauan, Sungai

## Warisan to expand to peninsula, looking for pact with Muda

**KOTA KINABALU** Parti Warisan Sabah will work towards a coalition with the yet-to-be-registered Malaysian United Democratic Alliance (Muda) after the Sabah-based Opposition party spreads its wings to Peninsular Malaysia on Dec 17.

Warisan president Datuk Seri Mohd Shafie Apdal said he had met with Muda proton president Syed Saddiq Syed Abdul Rahman and his committee members to discuss a possible coalition with the youth-based party.

"Syed Saddiq and I have spoken. It's already quite clear on our working relationship."

"We'd see how best we can realise the coalition," he told reporters after opening the Putatan Warisan division meeting here yesterday.

The much-talked-about Warisan expansion to the peninsula is widely seen as the formation of a third political force in national politics as neither Warisan nor Muda has aligned itself with Pakatan Harapan since the coalition fell in 2020.

Shafie said an incumbent Selangor state assemblyman was expected to be among the new Warisan members when it launches in the peninsula on Dec 17.

Shafie, who did not name the assemblyman, said Warisan was getting a positive response from various groups for the party to expand to the peninsula.

He added that the party would gradually spread to certain areas in the peninsula and stressed that it had no ambitious plans.

"I will name the proton leaders and committee members in certain states."

"I have the list, and we are still studying and verifying the details on who could be the best choice for the party's proton leaders," he said.

Warisan, he said, would remain selective in the areas it launched in. "There are certain places that we

might not want go in (but) it would depend on our ability to have a better impact in the coming general election.

"What is important for us is that we just need to expand. We cannot be too ambitious to spread to the whole country. We know our capacity, but we must be ready for the general election to be called anytime next year or whenever," he added.

Meanwhile, Selangor's independent assemblyman Bryan Lai is the one being courted by Warisan to join the party's peninsula chapter.

When contacted, the Teratai assemblyman confirmed that he had been invited not only by

Warisan but also other parties such as Parti Kuasa Rakyat, which was recently set up by the Prime Minister's brother, Kamarazaman Yaakob.

Lai, 47, resigned from DAP earlier this year after he was accused of marital infidelity by an unknown third party on social media. He had said then that he was quitting the party to protect its image.

On the possibility of him joining Warisan, Lai said he had some close friends among Warisan leaders and they had pitched to him the idea of joining their party.

"I can't say much about it now as I have not made any concrete decisions yet," he added.

## Weaknesses in Selangor Smart Rent Scheme

**SHAH ALAM:** The Auditor General's Report 2019 Series 2 on the activities of agencies and management of Selangor government companies tabled at the state legislative assembly yesterday identified several weaknesses in the management of the Smart Rent Scheme under the Selangor Housing and Property Board.

Auditor-General Datuk Nik Azman Nik Abdul Majid said among the weaknesses were contracts not signed, late offer letters issued to tenants, no lease renewal letters between Hartanah Selangor, Perumahan dan Hartanah Selangor Sdn Bhd (PHS), as well as tenants and inefficient rental management.

"Overall, the scheme was able to assist the people of Selangor who are still without a home and could not get a housing loan, by renting a house provided by the state government at an affordable rate," he said in a statement.

However, he said the purchase of residential units under the scheme did not achieve the set target and an evaluation of the results had never been prepared by the Selangor Housing and Property Board and PHS to gauge the effectiveness of the programme.

On the management objectives of solid waste collection and public cleaning services at the Klang Municipal Council to improve the level of cleanliness and provide comfort to

residents, he said this has yet to be fully achieved.

On the management of state government companies, Nik Azman said the objective of establishing Worldwide Holdings Bhd as a whole has been achieved, as seen in the residential development projects for the people of Selangor and environmental management services.

"However, the Amber and Azalea projects selected for the audit sampling had experienced completion delays, which was beyond the reasonable period of project completion according to Public Works Department standards," he said.

The Amber Project could only be completed within 48 months while the Azalea project was completed within 44 months, and there were weaknesses in residential project sales management, such as irregular discount offers and price of houses exceeding the estimations made by the Valuation and Property Services Department.

He said all the heads of the relevant agencies had been informed in advance of the matters reported in the report for verification purposes and a closing meeting had also been held for the purpose of discussing the audit findings and seeking clarification and feedback on issues arising. – Bernama

## **Selangor records RM4.64b investment value in Jan-June**

**SHAH ALAM:** Selangor recorded a higher investment value of RM4.64 billion for the period of January to June 2021, compared with RM3.39 billion for the same period last year.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari told the Selangor State Assembly yesterday that the number of manufacturing projects approved was 122, similar to that last year.

He said according to data by the Malaysian Investment Development Authority, 9,179 jobs were created for the period of January to June 2021, comprising RM4.06 billion in local investments and

RM576.98 million in foreign investments, compared with 5,001 jobs created for the same period in 2020 (RM1.82 billion local investments and RM1.55 billion foreign investments respectively).

He said this in reply to a question from Mohd Najwan Halimi (PH-Kota Anggerik) who wanted to know the impact of Covid-19 on the state's investment performance.

"The state's investment promotion agency, Invest Selangor, has always implemented various programmes in an effort to ensure that Selangor remains relevant and trusted by investors as their

investment destination," he said.

Apart from specific strategies such as the Selangor Aerospace Industry Action Plan and the Selangor Biotechnology Action Plan, Amirudin said, the state government also implemented the Selangor International Business Summit Hybrid 2022 which has Selangor International Expo (F&B) components; Selangor International Expo; Selangor Industrial Park Expo; Selangor Asean Business Conference; Selangor Smart City and Digital Economy; and Selangor R&D and Innovation Expo. - Bernama

## Malaysia's export value exceeds RM1t mark in 1st 10 month

MALAYSIA'S exports surpassed the RM1 trillion mark for the period of January to October 2021, up 25% year-on-year (YoY), the fastest period export value breached the one trillion mark ever recorded, according to the Department of Statistics Malaysia.

Chief Statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin said the strong export value for the first 10 months of 2021 was in line with global economic recoveries and the opening of economic activities in more countries signified better external demand.

"Consistent with the export's performance, imports also registered a double-digit growth of 21.8% to RM801.2 billion. Total trade grew by 23.5% to RM1.8 trillion compared to the same period in 2020," he said in a statement yesterday.

Exports in October 2021 maintained its steady growth momentum and outperformed September with

another record high value of RM114.4 billion, rising by 25.5% YoY. The expansion was driven by both domestic exports and re-exports.

Domestic exports stood at RM91.3 billion and contributed 79.8% to the total exports, widened by 23.3%. Re-exports registered RM23.2 billion, an increase of 34.8% compared to October 2020, while imports were higher by 27.9% YoY to RM88.2 billion.

Total trade expanded by RM26.5 billion to RM202.6 billion from RM160.1 billion in October 2020, as reported in the *Malaysia External Trade Statistics Bulletin*, October 2021.

Trade surplus in October 2021, with a value of RM26.2 billion marked the 18th consecutive month of trade surplus since May 2020.

In accordance with the recovery in domestic economic activity, the month-on-month performance of exports, imports, total trade and trade surplus were also remarked the positive growth, higher by 3.2%,



4.1%, 3.6% and 0.5%, respectively.

Meanwhile, in a separate statement, Senior Minister cum International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali (*picture*) said that Malaysia's trade continued its remarkable achieve-

ment in October 2021, registering another round of record high monthly value for trade, exports, imports and trade surplus.

He said that trade expanded by 26.5% to RM202.61 billion compared to October 2020, breaching the RM200 billion mark for the first time and was the ninth consecutive month of double-digit growth since February 2021.

"Exports rose by 25.5% to RM114.43 billion, the 14th consecutive month of YoY expansion since September 2020. Imports were higher by 27.9% to RM88.18 billion and trade surplus increased by 17.9% to RM26.25 billion.

"The export growth was boosted mainly by higher shipments of petroleum products, manufactures of metal, electrical and electronic products, chemicals and chemical products as well as palm oil and palm oil-based agriculture products," he said in a statement issued by the Malaysia External Trade Development Corp.

Exports of manufactures of metal and electrical and electronics products registered the highest monthly value thus far. Meanwhile, exports to major markets notably ASEAN, China, the US, the European Union and Japan recorded double-digit growth. Exports to ASEAN registered the highest monthly value.

In October 2021, trade with Free Trade Agreement (FTA) partners which constituted 66.1% of Malaysia's total trade increased by 27.3% YoY to RM133.95 billion.

Exports to FTA partners rose by 24.5% to RM75.68 billion and imports grew by 31.1% to RM58.27 billion.

Trade with FTA partners during the first 10 months of 2021 which made up 66.7% of Malaysia's total trade, grew by 24% to RM1.203 trillion compared to the same period of 2020. Exports increased by 22.9% to RM670.74 billion and imports expanded by 25.3% to RM532.3 billion.

# “等20年未拿到屋”

(蒲种28日讯) 武吉布伦东Super Taipan因发展商倒闭，屋业发展计划搁置近20年，期间购屋者曾与各相关部门经过多番交涉，甚至集体抗议控诉，惟至今尚无下文，他们深感不满，要求雪州政府介入该计划，好让他们早日获得屋业单位。

受害业主是于90年代，向武吉布伦东Super Taipan购买产业，期间发展商倒闭，导致屋业发展被搁置，不少人仍在缴付房贷，不过屋业单位却遥遥无期。

过去近20年期间，众多业主组成武吉布

伦东购屋者委员会，曾向房屋及地方政府、乌鲁雪兰莪县议会及发展商交涉，一直没有下文。

他们认为，雪州大臣拿督斯里阿米鲁丁在这起屋业发展计划搁置事件中，扮演著重要角色，希望大臣能介入协助他们。

### 至至少400業主無法獲產業

约15名受害业主向国民团结党公共服务及投诉主任王松富求助，今日在蒲种区召开记者会做出申诉。

在记者会上，受害业主举起大字报，写有“等了20年还没拿到屋子？”、“我要

我以前买的屋子”字眼，以示不满和抗议。

王松富指出，他接受其中一名业主的邀请，加入武吉布伦东购屋者委员会的WhatsApp群组，不少苦主纷纷向他投诉，据悉至少有400间屋业单位的业主，至今仍无法获得产业。

他说，每名业者都想尽早取得购买的单位，不过经历近20年，不少人“等到老了”都未拿到屋业，当中许多人还得继续摊还房屋贷款。

他承诺会向雪州政府跟进该项屋业发展计划被搁置的进展，并为受害业主提供法律援助。



盛先生指出，受害业主在2003年期间组织武吉布伦东购屋者委员会，曾寻求过4任房屋及地方政府部长及数任雪州大臣的帮助，至今都没下文。

## 雪擬制定中長期方案 盼2025無效益水減至25%

(沙亚南29日讯)截至今年10月，雪州、吉隆坡及布城的无效益水(NRW)达28.2%，雪州政府将拟定有中长期的方案，致力将无效益水减至最低，以放眼在2025年达到减至25%无效益水的目标。

掌管雪州基本建设、公共设施、农业及农基工业事务的行政议员依兹汉今早在回答行动党新古毛州议员李继香的口头提问时表示，今年雪州、吉隆坡及布城的无效益水为28.2%，比起2020年的28.5%及全国的36.4%来得少。

### 明年拨1.74亿替换水管

他指出，州政府明年将拨出1亿7400万令吉作为州内的水管替换工程，工程包括设计、现场监督和工程的费用。


他也说，州政府于2017年通过贷款方式给予雪州水务管理公司2亿4870万令吉，作为2017至2019年的水管替换计划。

当李继香在附加提问时，质问为何雪州的无效益水比其他州，如马六甲来得更高时，依兹汉则回应雪州不能与其他州属一概而论，因为雪州是拥有最多，且长达6000公里水管的州属。

他补充，须知道要减低无效益水并不是一项容易的事，也涉及许多方面，不只是替换水管而已，还涉及水供的基建、物流等，因此费用相当高。

他指出，每替换1公里的水管需要耗资100万令吉，因此州政府每年拨出逾1亿5000万令吉拨款，而明年更是增加至1亿7400令吉拨款来更换水管。
