## Malaysia seru kerjasama perkukuh APEC

**PETALING JAYA:** Malaysia meneru kerjasama yang lebih kukuh dalam kalangan negara-negara Kerjasama Ekonomi Asia Pasifik (APEC) dalam menyokong pemulihan yang mampan dan inklusif, bagi memastikan rautan itu bersedia untuk cabaran masa hadapan.

Seruan itu akan disampaikan delegasi negara ke Minggu Pemimpin Ekonomi APEC (AELW) 2021 yang bermula semalam hingga 12 November ini.

Selain itu, menurut Kementerian Perdagangan Antarabangsa dan Industri, Malaysia akan tu-



rut berkongsi pandangan berkenaan kepentingan mempercepat pelaksanaan pendigitalan, inovasi dan kemampunan untuk mewujudkan lebih banyak peluang untuk komuniti APEC.

Kata kementerian itu, dengan usaha pemulihan ekonomi menjadi tema utama APEC ta-

hun ini, seruan tindakan tersebut adalah kunci untuk rautan tersebut merealisasikan aspirasi rautan yang inklusif, mampan dan makmur untuk semua.

"Dengan sasaran mempercepat pemulihan serantau, Malaysia akan menekankan komitmen dan solidariti tidak berbelah bahagi untuk membina semula rautan ini dengan usaha keras menuju pemulihan ekonomi dan memastikan kesihatan rakyat," katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

AELW tahun ini merupakan yang kedua dianjurkan secara maya selepas Malaysia mem-

pengerusikannya dengan berjaya tahun lalu.

AELW akan dimulakan dengan Mesyuarat Kementerian APEC (AMM) dan Malaysia akan diwakili secara bersama oleh Menteri Perdagangan Antrabangsa dan Industri, Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali dan Timbalannya, Datuk Kamarudin Jaffar.

Menurut kementerian itu, New Zealand sebagai Pengerusi tahun ini akan menganjurkan AMM secara maya selama dua hari yang dipengerusikan Menteri Perdagangan dan Pertumbuhan Eksportnya, Damien

O'Connor dan Menteri Hal Eh-wal Luar, Nanaia Mahuta.

"Pada penghujung AMM, menteri-menteri dijangka memuktamadkan Kenyataan Kementerian Bersama AMM 2021 yang akan membuka jalan untuk usaha pemulihan serantau.

"Ia selari dengan keutamaan yang ditetapkan New Zealand sebagai tuan rumah APEC 2021 iaitu tema utama pemulihan melalui dasar ekonomi dan perdagangan yang tangkas, mempertingkat keterangkuman dan kemampuan serta memajukan inovasi dan pendigitalan," katanya.

# Tugas sukar menanti Terengganu

**PETALING JAYA:** Pengendali Terengganu, Nafuzi Zain lebih suka untuk mengatasi satu persatu halangan yang bakal ditempuh terutama di peringkat suku akhir Piala Malaysia terlebih dahulu.

Mengakui gembira dengan prestasi cemerlang diperagakan anak buahnya sepanjang saingan berprestij itu yang memasuki edisi 100 tahun, Nafuzi menjelaskan bahawa dia masih belum di tahap terbayang pasukannya menjulang trofi.

Jurulatih berusia 43 tahun itu tidak kisah sama ada berdepan Kuala Lumpur (KL) City atau Sarawak United di suku akhir namun paling penting pasukannya perlu sentiasa bersedia untuk berdepan mana-mana pasukan.

“Bagi saya belum sampai tahap untuk bawa pulang lagi (Piala Malaysia). Sekarang ini peringkat pertama dalam Kumpulan B kita sudah layak ke suku akhir.

“Tapi perjalanan masih

jauh, kita kena bekerja keras lagi. Kita tahu suku akhir lagi mencabar, (tugas) lagi sengit menunggu kita selepas ini,” katanya selepas perlawanan dengan Selangor FC, semalam.

Kemenangan 3-1 ke atas Selangor di Stadium Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya (MBPJ) membolehkan Terengganu mara selaku juara Kumpulan B dan bakal berdepan naib juara Kumpulan A, sama ada KL City atau Sarawak United di suku akhir.

# Selangor kutip RM2 bilion

*Kerajaan negeri pungut premium tanah cecah RM900 juta sehingga Jumaat lalu*

Kerajaan negeri memperoleh kutipan premium tanah bernilai kira-kira RM900 juta sehingga Jumaat lalu.

Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari (**gambar**) berkata, jumlah itu adalah sebahagian daripada keseluruhan hasil kutipan yang sudah mencecah RM2 bilion pada Jumaat lalu.

"Tanah menjadi salah satu daripada penyumbang terbesar (hasil kutipan) hasil cukai dan hasil bukan cukai. Hasil cukai seperti cukai pintu masih lagi berkaitan tanah, cukai premium juga hasil kita."

"Tahun ini sahaja kita da-

pat hampir RM900 juta dari RM2 bilion itu, separuh daripadanya hasil premium dan hasil tanah. Tahun lalu, kita dapat capai RM1 bilion dengan kutipan hasil tanah," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian dalam sidang media selepas Perhimpunan Penjawat Awam bersama Menteri Besar Selangor di Auditorium Dewan Jubli Perak, Bangunan Setiausaha Kerajaan (SUK) di sini, semalam.

Amirudin berkata, jumlah kutipan RM2 bilion yang di-

peroleh sehingga Jumaat itu

alah 95 peratus daripada sasaran awal RM2.2 bilion bagi tahun ini.

"Saya yakin kita boleh capai sekurang-kurangnya RM2.1 bilion namun begitu untuk capai pada sasaran, kita lihat akhir tahun ini."

"Tahun ini tempoh Pe- rintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) le- bih pan-

jang, kita juga mampu capai sudah mencecah RM2 bi- lion...saya yakin kita akan dapat hasil pendapatan yang baik."

"Dengan itu, kita da- pat berbelanja tahun depan termasuk untuk pemulihan ekono-

momi yang memberikan kebaikan dan kebajikan kepada rakyat," katanya.

"Kita ada menerima laporan membabitkan kejadian itu dan siasatan segera akan dilakukan sebelum tinjakan sewajarnya diambil. "Saya tidak mahu bercakap mengenai kegagalan kawalan keselamatan kerana penganjuran kejohanan

besar seperti Piala Dunia pun ada penyokong lari masuk ke padang," katanya.

Kegagalan pasukan untuk mengawal penyokong masing-masing daripada bertindak di luar batasan termasuk memasuki kawasan padang boleh dikenakan hukuman denda.

Antara pasukan yang pernah dikenakan tindakan itu adalah Persatuan Bolasepak Negeri Johor (Johor Darul Ta'zim) membabitkan perlawanan menentang Felda United apabila penyokong

pasukan berkenaan memasuki padang sebaik permainan tamat pada saingan Liga Super 2015.

Pasukan lain yang turut dikenakan hukuman sama adalah Selangor dengan penyokong mereka turut mencorob masuk ke dalam padang selepas perlawanan Piala Malaysia 2015 antara pasukan terbabit menentang Pahang di Stadium Shah Alam pada 6 Disember 2015.

Kedua-dua pasukan itu di-denda RM5,000 hingga RM7,500 oleh Jawatankuasa Tata tertib FAM.

Perlawanan malam kel-

marin menyaksikan Terengganu turut membuktikan mereka jaguh pantas timur apabila berjaya menundukkan Selangor 3-1 dalam saingan Kumpulan B Piala Malaysia.

Skuad kendalian Nafuzi Zain turus mengekalkan rekod tanpa kalah selepas mengharungi lima perlawanan peringkat kumpulan.

Pasukan pelawat terlebih dahulu berada di depan merusuri lincinnya Faisal Halim yang berjaya menyumbat gol pembukaan pada minit ke 15 untuk kedudukan 0-1.

# **Selangor kutip hasil tanah RM900 juta**

Disumbangkan melalui pembayaran dalam talian yang dilaksanakan di negeri itu

**K**erajaan Selangor berjaya memperoleh hasil kutipan premium tanah sebanyak RM900 juta yang merupakan penyumbang terbesar pendapatan di negeri tersebut.

Menteri Besar, Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari berkata, jumlah itu adalah sebahagian daripada kutipan keseluruhan sebanyak RM2 bilion setakat Jumaat.

Menurutnya, jumlah tersebut didorong oleh inisiatif pendigitalisasian dan pembukaan semula ekonomi yang melibatkan

pihak-pihak yang memulakan rancangan pembangunan di negeri tersebut dan perlu membayar premium tanah, cukai dan sebagainya.

“Sebahagian daripada inisiatif pendigitalisasian itu membantu kita untuk mencatat kutipan cukai yang tinggi iaitu hampir empat hingga lima pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) dan pejabat daerah tanah mencatat kutipan lebih 89 peratus.

“Ini membuktikan bahawa pembayaran secara dalam talian yang dilaksanakan di Lembah Klang menjadi pilihan serta kita

harus bersedia untuk memasuki era digitalisasi dan negeri pintar,” katanya selepas Perhimpunan Penjawat Awam bersama Menteri Besar Selangor di Auditorium Dewan Jubli Perak, Bangunan Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah di sini pada Isnin.

Mengulas mengenai Bajet Selangor 2022, Amirudin maklumkan penjawat awam di negeri itu akan menerima berita gembira yang bakal diumumkan pada 26 November ini.

“Insya-ALLAH bonus (untuk penjawat awam) akan lain sedikit tahun ini,” katanya.

Jurutera Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS) Daerah Gombak, Mohd Hasrulhisham Abdullah ketika diminta mengulas mengenai perkara itu berkata, kesedaran masyarakat mengenai penjagaan alam se-

kitar termasuk sungai dan sistem saliran masih di tahap rendah.

Menurutnya, sebanyak RM140,000 diperuntukkan bagi kos kerja berkala kutipan sampah tersebut.

“Mengikut jadual, kutipan sampah dibuat seminggu sekali tidak termasuk kutipan yang dibuat terus selepas hujan lebat bagi mengelak limpahan air sungai ke jalan.

“Sampah sarap yang dibuang ke dalam sistem saliran dan sungai menyebabkan aliran air terhalang. Setiap kutipan boleh mencecah sehingga 15 tan,” katanya pada Isnin.

## RM4mil facelift for food court

Bazaar Melawati traders to be moved to another location while works are underway

THE Federal Government has approved RM4mil for Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) to upgrade a food court in Taman Melawati.

Gombak MP Datuk Seri Azmin Ali said works on the food court known as Bazaar Melawati would start next month and was expected to be completed within 18 months.

"MPAJ has submitted a technical report to me, suggesting the improvements needed.

"Some parts of the place are in a poor state, and it is keeping customers away," said Azmin, who is also International Trade and Industry Minister.

He added that traders at the site would be moved to a suitable location while works were ongoing.

Azmin said this during a high tea at Bazaar Melawati. It was attended by local residents and traders associations.

Also present were council president Mohd Fauzi Mohd Yatin, Selangor development director Datuk Rosli Isa and Gombak district

officer Nor Azlina Abdul Aziz.

MPAJ Property Management and Valuation Department deputy director Khairul Azmi Abdul Rahman said works would involve repainting the premises, replacing the roof as well as upgrading the clean water supply system and surrounding drainage.

He added that the upgrade would also see 12 additional lots being built, in addition to the 81 existing ones.

Zulkiflee Abdul Latiff, who represented the traders, thanked MPAJ for initiating the upgrade. The food court was built in the early 1990s and comprises two floors.

MPAJ handles the rental collection, as well as cleaning and general upkeep.

Separately, Azmin also announced a RM2.64mil allocation to upgrade the Al-Khairiah mosque in AU3, Taman Keramat in Hulu Kelang.

Meanwhile, the Darussa'dah surau in AU1, Taman Keramat Permai, received RM1.1mil for its upgrade. — By FARID WAHAB

# RISING ABOVE CHALLENGES IN TIMES OF CRISIS

KPS continues to strengthen fundamental resilience for steady growth trajectory

THE proactive measures taken by Kumpulan Perangsang Selangor Bhd (KPS) in its business strategy before and throughout Covid-19 have evidently paid off. Yet this global investment holding company remains committed to further strengthening its fundamental resilience.

KPS' resilience is evident from its strong financial achievement, even during the height of the pandemic, despite unprecedented challenges such as supply chain disruption and raw material shortage, to name the least.

For the six months ended June 30, 2021, the group posted a 38.7% increase in revenue to RM632.1mil, compared with RM455.9mil recorded in the previous year. Its manufacturing businesses grew by 49.5%, contributing RM543.6mil or 86% to group revenue.

KPS also more than doubled its operating profit to RM40.2mil, compared with RM16.3mil, while profit before zakat leapt to RM28.7mil from RM2.8mil in the corresponding period last year. This is on top of crossing a new milestone in achieving RM1.1bil in revenue for its 2020 fiscal year.

According to its managing director and group chief executive officer Ahmad Fariz Hassan, this shows KPS' success in balancing tactical decisions to build operational and financial capacity, while staying focused on its long-term strategic goals.

"Our financial performance for the first half of the year in 2021 is a testament to the potential for KPS in the coming future, as it illustrates the potential and agility of the industries we are involved in."

"KPS has its core focus on investments with businesses in the manufacturing, trading, licensing and infrastructure. Our subsidiaries are well prepared to manage the challenges and risks of the pandemic. Addressing such challenges requires a concerted effort by every single personnel. The effectiveness of the management team in KPS and its subsidiaries has enabled us to steer our way and rise above the challenge."

"These are all exciting reasons for existing as well as future investors to look forward to KPS' future, since we've got a clear plan on how to grow our earnings based on strong fundamentals and commitment," he explained.

### Success in enhancing business focus

Such resilience traces back to the group's efforts in diversifying its business across various sectors and geographies worldwide, reflecting the success of its business transformation plan (BTP) that started in 2016.

KPS has since transformed into a global player with activities not only in Malaysia but also in China, Vietnam, Indonesia and the United States, alongside shifting its business focus to one that creates value for its stakeholders through sustainable financial performance.

Moving away from its beginnings as an infrastructure and utility investment player limited to Selangor, KPS has expanded most of its business activities beyond the state.

Today, KPS' manufacturing subsidiaries make up about 85% of its business. This includes Toyoplant Manufacturing (M) Sdn Bhd, a one-stop solutions provider for mould fabrication, precision injection moulding and secondary processes and assembly at its seven manufacturing facilities across Malaysia, China, Indonesia and Vietnam; integrated thermoplastics injection moulding CPI (Penang) Sdn Bhd; integrated packaging solutions provider Century Bond Bhd operating from its plants in Senai and Ipoh in Malaysia and Medan in Indonesia; as well as King Koil Manufacturing West LLC in Arizona, the US, which manufactures one of the long-standing and established brand for mattress and bedding, while King Koil Licensing Company Inc operates the King Koil brand licensing over 89 countries.

KPS also owns 51% stakes in Aqua-Flo Sdn Bhd, which supplies water chemicals and provides technical services to water, waste and sewage treatment plants.

### No plans to slow down

Reinforced by its success thus far, KPS has an eye on the future to improve its momentum

tum, in tandem with the gradual recovery of the world's economies in the final quarter of 2021.

KPS investor relations and strategic communications director Zul Mawardi opined: "For the remainder of 2021, the outlook is becoming more optimistic. As most KPS subsidiaries are export-driven, the current economic development should bode well for KPS' top-line, given our geographical and sectoral diversification."

Moving into 2022, Fariz noted that the group's current aspirations can be distilled into LEAP25, a five-year business strategy that is focused on enhancing KPS' strategic position.

"We will be focusing on enhancing our return on equity and total shareholder return. To achieve this, we must ensure we keep improving efficiency and continue creating value in our subsidiaries," he said.

Another critical element of LEAP25 is to outwardly communicate the achievements that KPS has attained.

He explained: "We expect a lot of engagements with the investment community, stakeholders and third parties. This is key, because we have been getting feedback that there are a lot of people who are not aware of our achievements."

On top of its performance, KPS has a lot to be proud of. It has also been lauded for its sustainability and corporate social responsibility efforts, with its most recent accolades

for our carton products and materials for mattress production."

For instance, the cost can increase from a range of 10% to 70% for paper and 10% to 50% for resin.

"Learning from the experience and recognising the importance of building a resilient and flexible supply chain, we're currently working very hard to diversify our supply sources by exploring alternative materials with the customers or working with another to procure raw materials."

"Another factor is logistics, where the lack of availability of ships could cause longer lead times in delivering raw materials or finished goods," he shared.

While he acknowledged that other factors could affect operations, Fariz pointed to a proactive approach that KPS has taken via its supply risk management framework.

"We identify and assess the risks. This has allowed us to prepare, react and respond appropriately, as well as recover from all the potential adverse events that arrive in our way in the future.

"As a measure, we communicate with our customers to better understand their requirements under the current conditions and with our suppliers to ensure an alternative and more sustainable supply of raw materials," he said.

At the meantime, KPS is also negotiating an increase in unit selling prices that it charges to customers on a case-to-case basis, in light of the steep increase in costs.

The move has had some success, Fariz said, noting that KPS' subsidiary companies will continue to explore the possibilities of passing on the costs to clients if the situation is prolonged.

On the flip side, the adverse effect of Covid-19 on business sectors also saw the abilities and tenacity of the KPS management team and its workforce shining through in navigating the crisis, in order to ensure that the group remains on track with its business objectives.

"We need to show objectivity and transparency, so that everyone understands the situation at hand. With clarity, we can keep focused on executing our tasks, identify problems in our operations and find solutions to address them," he added.

This operational structure ties in with KPS' business strategy, with Zul stressing the importance of ensuring that the group moves in line with the overarching vision, missions and long-term corporate objectives, rather than being defined by temporary and, in most cases, fleeting challenges.

"Internally, we engage with our employees throughout the group regularly, providing awareness and understanding of the challenges that we are facing, emergent priorities and new expectations."

All business units and subsidiaries work in concert towards the common goal, which is to ensure the viability of the business and deliver sustainable results," he said.

He added that on the external front, KPS engages with its different stakeholders such as customers and suppliers to reset priorities and communicate new plans to manage and mitigate risks.

### What's next for KPS

LEAP25 aims to lead KPS to a strategic position, fortify its fundamentals further and accelerate delivery of its subsidiary business, thus making further progress towards a more robust earnings prospect.

As KPS advances, investors can look forward to the performance guided by LEAP25 strategy.

The challenges that the group has faced are showing signs of easing up, as the overall economy and industries begin to pick up momentum. When it is time to sprint, Fariz is confident that KPS will be armed and ready to reach its growth potential.

"Given its strong fundamentals, we have full confidence that KPS' performance will continue to ascend, guided by its sustainable growth and goals and most importantly, supported by the relentless commitment of our people and the support of our stakeholders," he concluded.



# Forest degazettement improper?

WE refer to the ongoing controversy regarding the status of the Bukit Cherakah Forest Reserve in Section U10, Shah Alam. Various NGOs and civil society groups are protesting plans to develop parts of the forest reserve.

Selangor state executive councillor Hee Loy Sian commented on the matter on Oct 23, emphasising that the reserve has been excised (colloquially referred to as "degazetted"), with land titles issued to private developers, and that it had been degazetted without any notice being published. He is reported to have said, "If the said plots of land had not been degazetted, land titles could not be issued", and "The NGOs should ask the previous state government about the move to degazette the land and why a notice was not published" ("Hee: Developers hold land titles for plots of Shah Alam forest reserve", *The Star*; online at [bit.ly/star\\_reserve](http://bit.ly/star_reserve)).

The law relating to forest reserves is the National Forestry Act 1984 and the respective state enactments. Section 13(1) of the Act stipulates that whenever any land is excised from a permanent reserved forest, the state authority shall cause to be published in the

*State Government Gazette* a notification setting out the details of such land and declaring a fixed date when it shall cease to be a permanent reserved forest.

Section 13(2) follows up with the provision that the land shall

cease to be a permanent reserved forest from the fixed date.

It is not disputed that there is no such publication of the purported excision of the forest in the *Selangor State Government Gazette*. Hence, as long as a per-

manent reserved forest has not been excised through the publication of a notice in the Gazette, the subject land – in this case, the Bukit Cherakah Forest Reserve in Section U10 – continues to be a permanent reserved forest.

The Malaysian Bar is therefore deeply concerned by the Selangor state government's position as expressed by Hee. This case highlights fundamental legal issues. The state government must demonstrate its commitment to the rule of law. It cannot refer to the *de facto* position (that land titles have been issued to private developers) as a determination of the *de jure* position, ie the legal status of the land. It is no answer to concerned members of the public that the purported excision was carried out by the previous administration.

Besides the issues of good governance, accountability and transparency, this issue also relates to the sustainable management of our natural environment.

On Oct 8, the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) recognised for the first time that having a clean, healthy and sustainable environment is a human right ("Access to a healthy environ-

ment, declared a human right by UN rights council"; online at [bit.ly/unhr\\_right](http://bit.ly/unhr_right)).

Further, Malaysia was recently elected to the UNHRC for the 2022–24 term, with the Prime Minister announcing that, "Malaysia will work closely with UN member states to advance the global human rights agenda, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights". It is therefore imperative that we lead by example.

The Malaysian Bar calls on the Selangor state government, and indeed all state governments, to approach any excision of permanent reserved forests conscientiously and vigilantly, in order to protect the human rights of present and future generations. State governments must act as the protector and custodian of nature and not be a facilitator of its destruction. Where the due process of excision of any permanent reserved forests has not been followed, the state must take the position that the status of the land remains protected.

# A knockout show

Sarawak send Pahang packing from group stage

**PETALING JAYA:** Sarawak coach E. Elavarasan has hailed his side's fighting spirit to reach the Malaysia Cup quarter-finals.

The team's dogged determination saw their attacking midfielder Abdul Rahim Razak make a last-ditch goal to surprise Pahang with a 2-1 away win in Group A at the Darulmakkum Stadium on Sunday.

The Premier League runners-up were prepared to leave Kuantan with a point before a late counter-attack move in the 92nd minute by Rahim yielded an unlikely outcome for the visitors.

Pahang only had themselves to blame for failing to translate their domination into a desired result.

The home side had raced ahead with a 13th minute opener by Kenny Athiu but it did not last long after Sandro Mendonca struck in the 31st minute to draw level -

despite Sarawak being hardly a threat.

The defeat meant Pahang, the four-time winners, crashed out from the group stage for the first time since 2016.

With 10 points in the bag, second-placed Sarawak hold an unassailable lead over third-placed Pahang in Group A, who could only muster just six points with a match remaining.

Kuala Lumpur also confirmed their qualification for the knockout stage after beating Penang 1-0 at home to remain top of the group on 11 points.

Elavarasan admitted that Pahang were clearly the better team of the day and would have been happy with a draw.

"From the start, Pahang were playing a lot better than us. In the second half, they forced us to defend for almost 40 minutes but we're lucky to score from the counter-att

tack," said Elavarasan.

"The early goal from Pahang had shocked the team but we managed to respond to it. The equaliser was really crucial in boosting the players' spirit.

"With the match tied at 1-1 and Pahang being the dominant side, we opted to defend and hold out for a point. As long as we don't lose, we still have a good chance to reach the knockout stage through our last match (against rock bottom Penang at home).

"But fortunately our well-executed attacking move in the dying minutes gave us the win."

Pahang coach Dollah Salleh refused to blame his players for the late collapse, saying that the team had given their best.

"I'm proud of their performance despite the disappointing result," said Dollah, who guided the Elephants to Malaysia Cup success in 2013.
